### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a merchandiser with a curved front, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a merchandiser with a curved front showing our new design, with a broken line showing of a handle for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1; the broken line showing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the design;

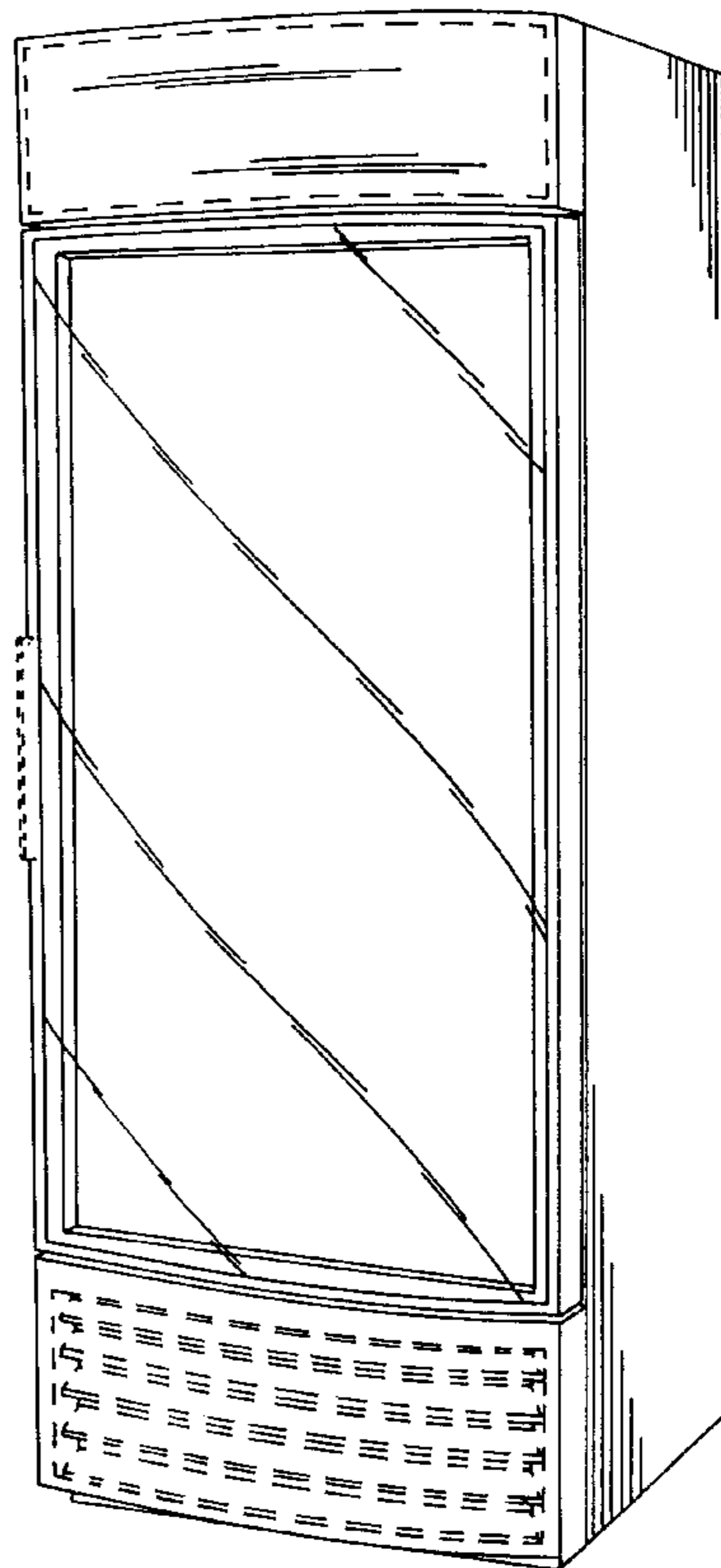
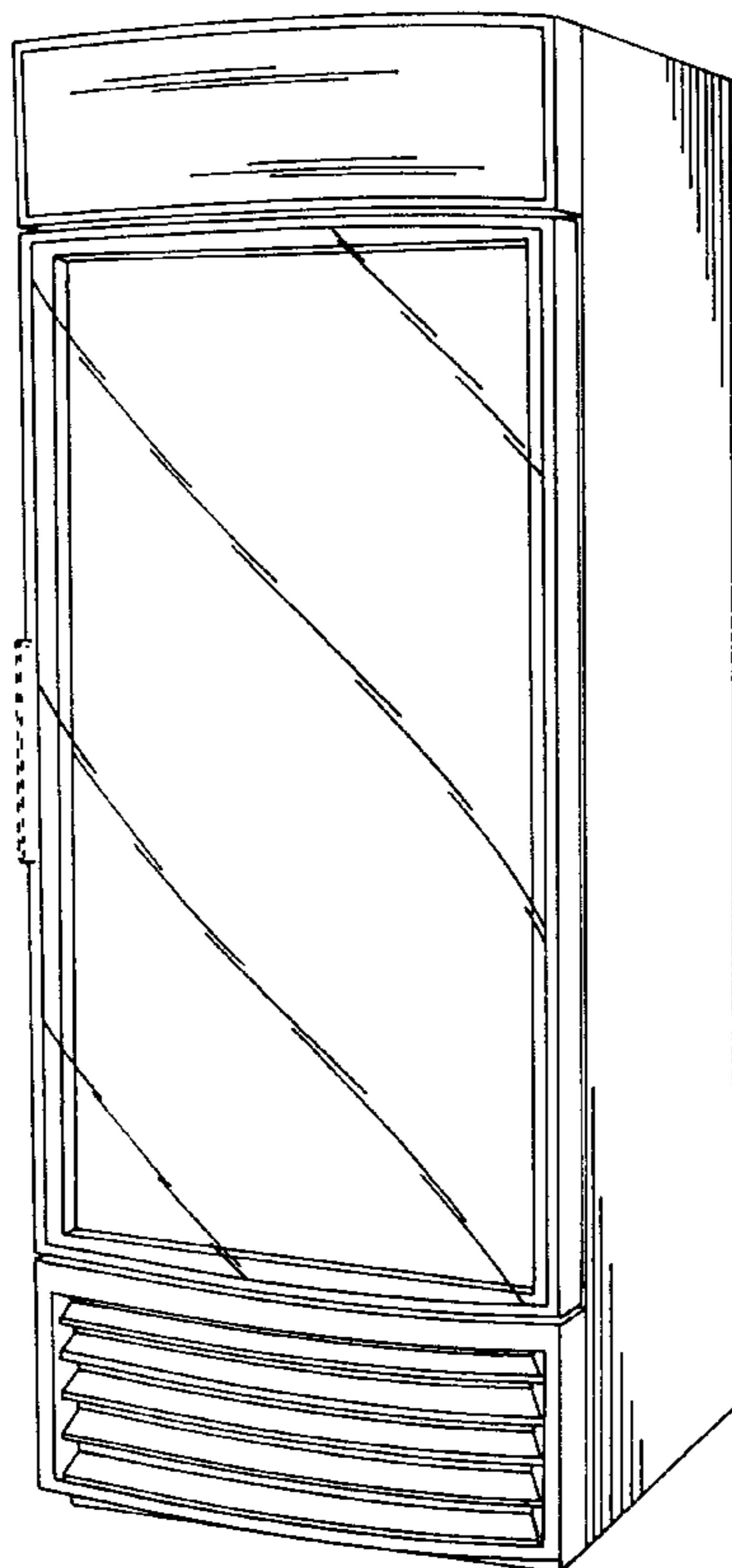
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 8;

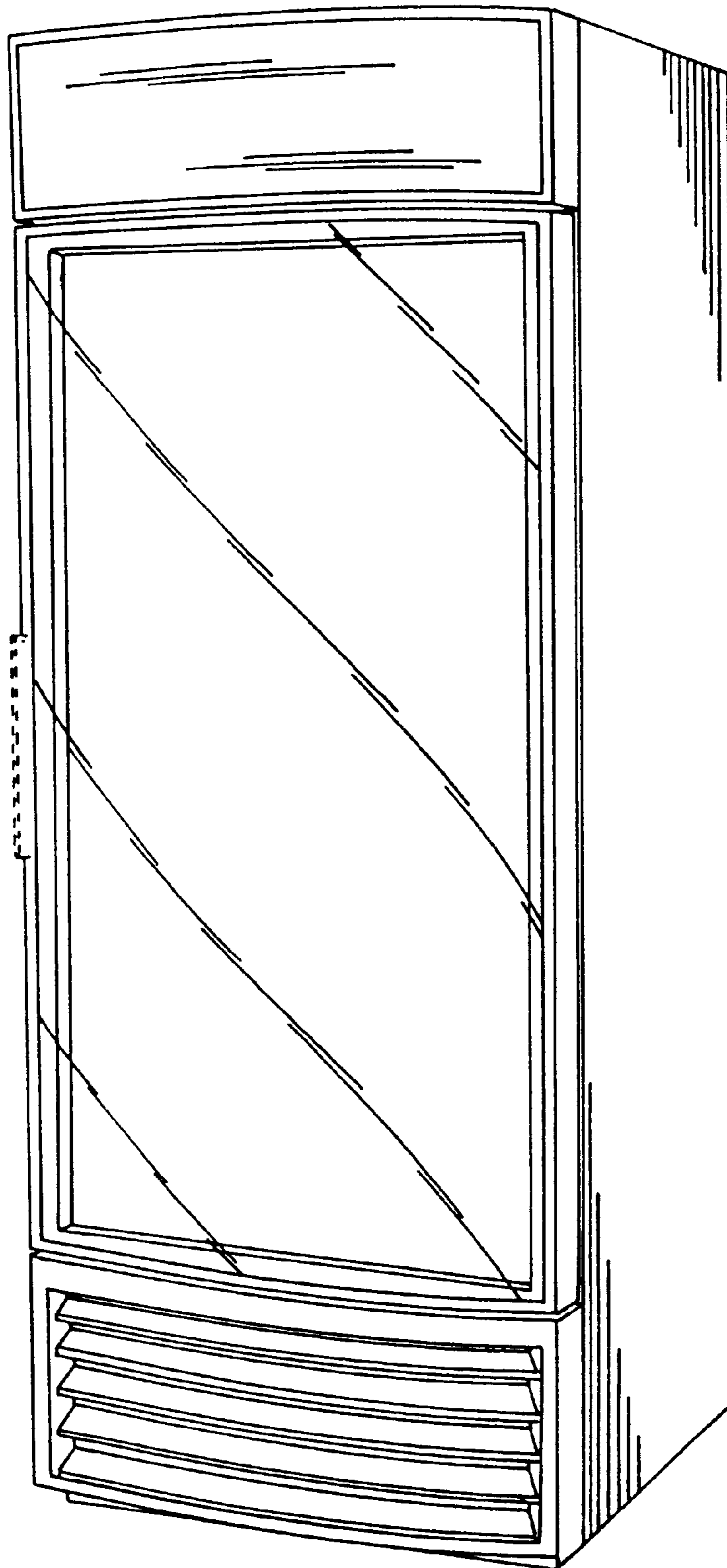
FIG. 10 is left side elevational view of FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 9.

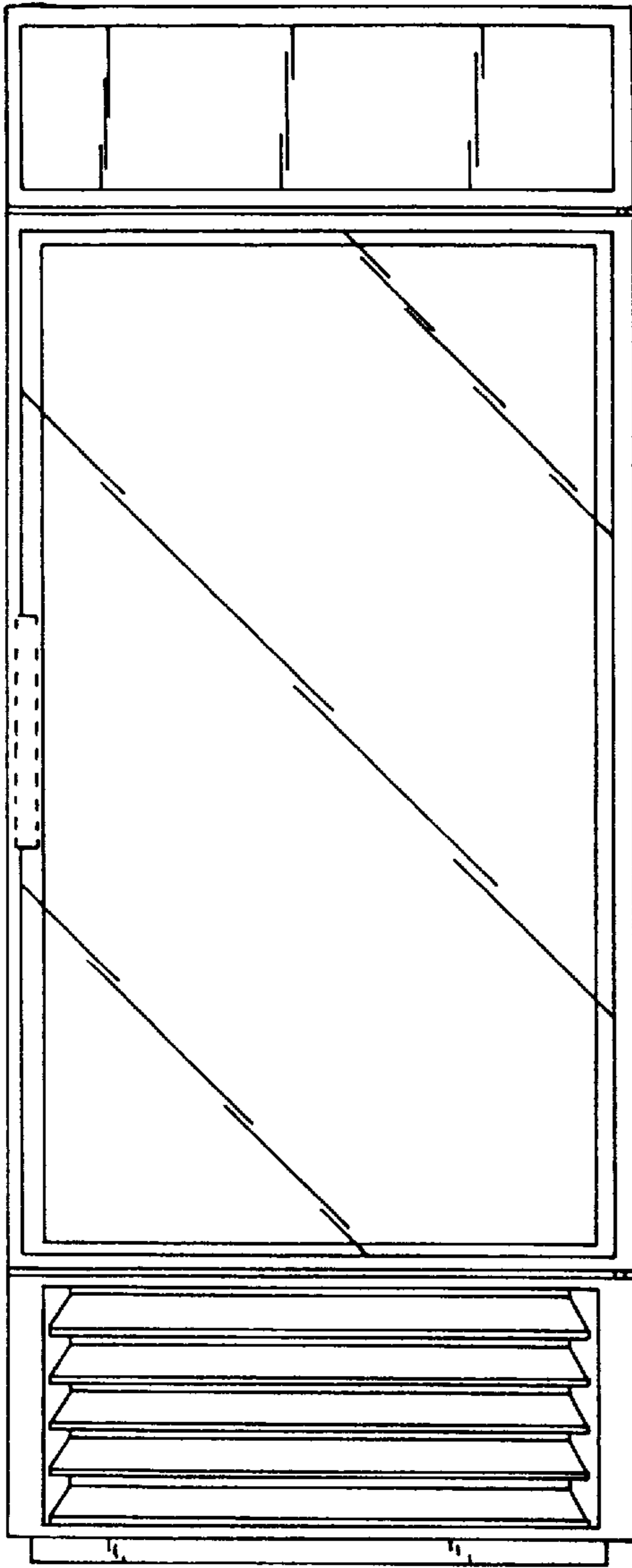

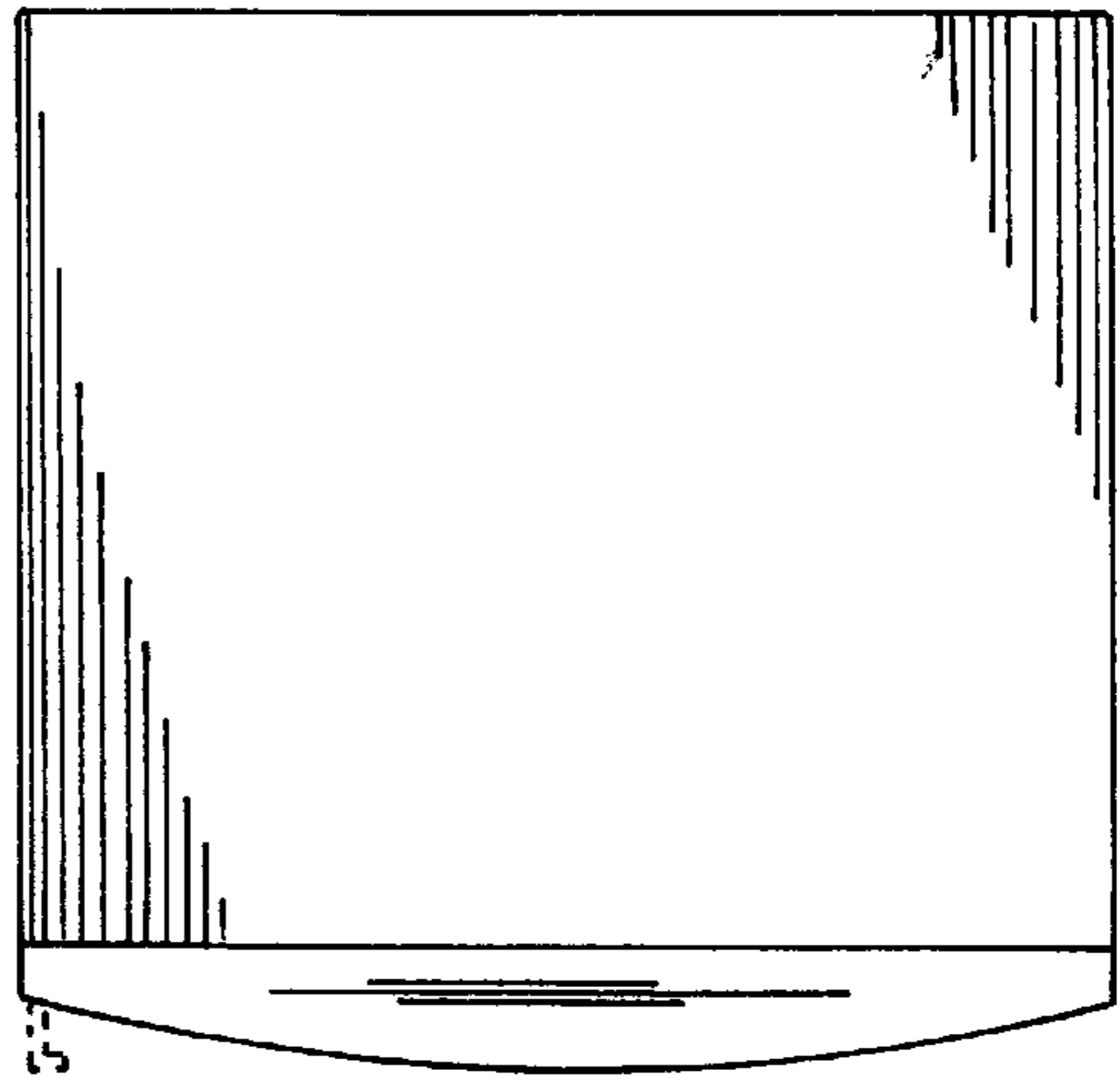




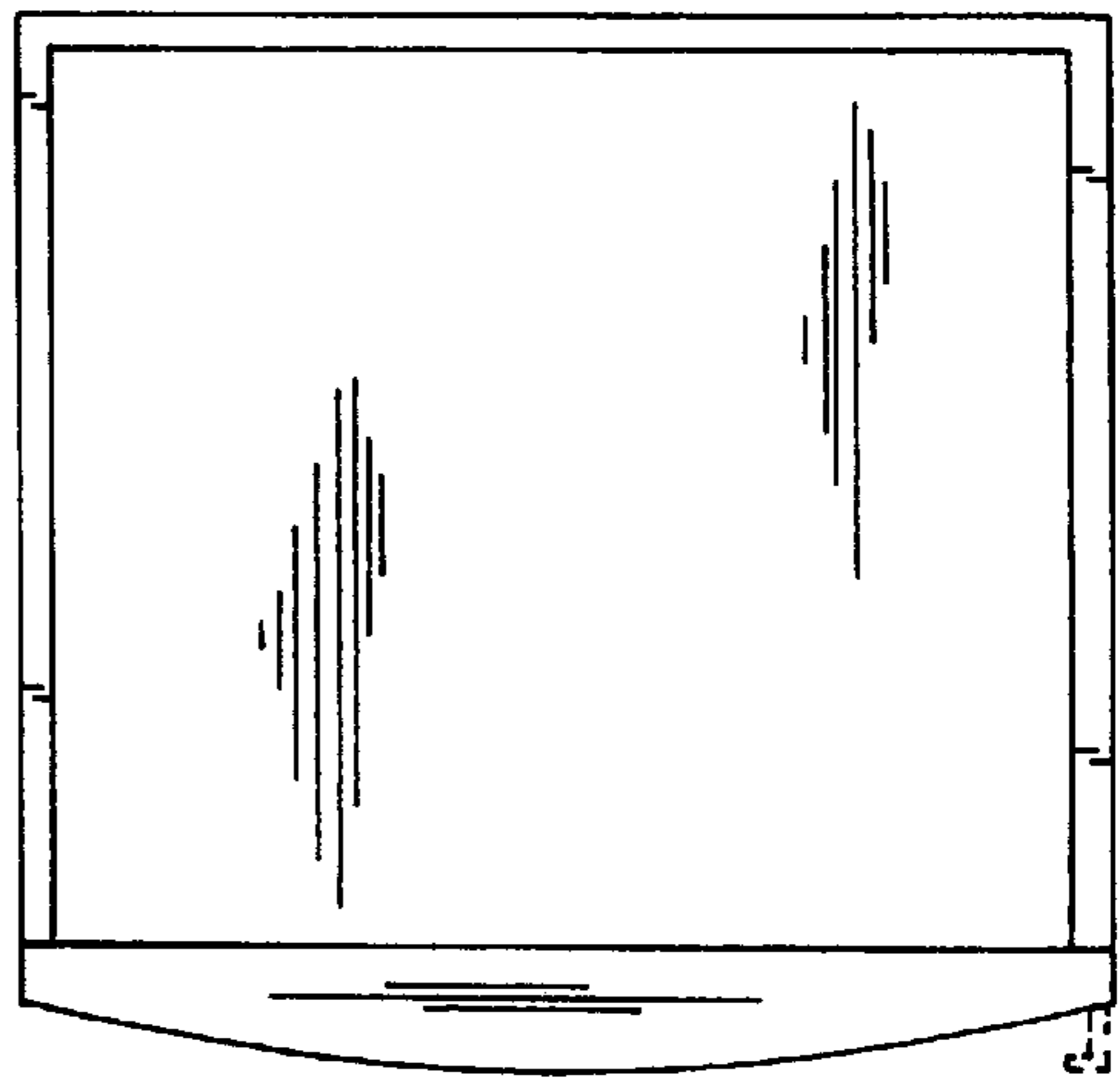

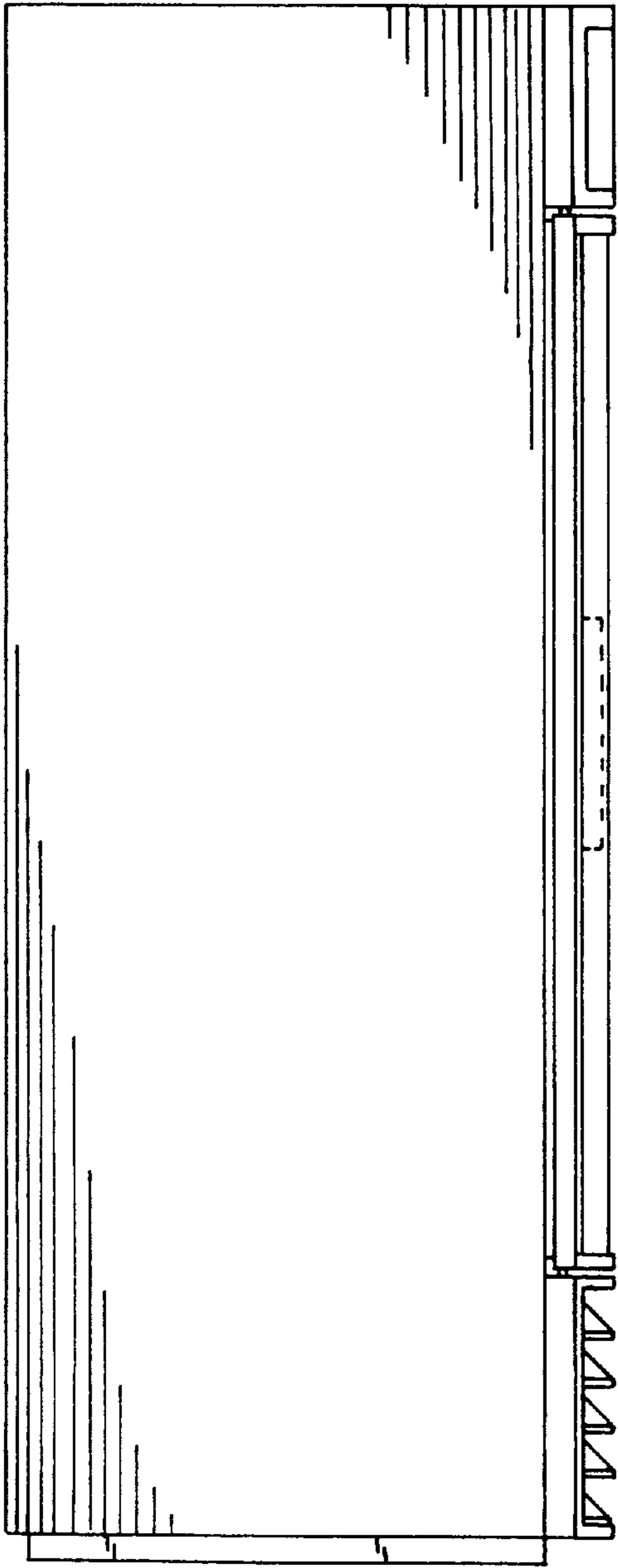

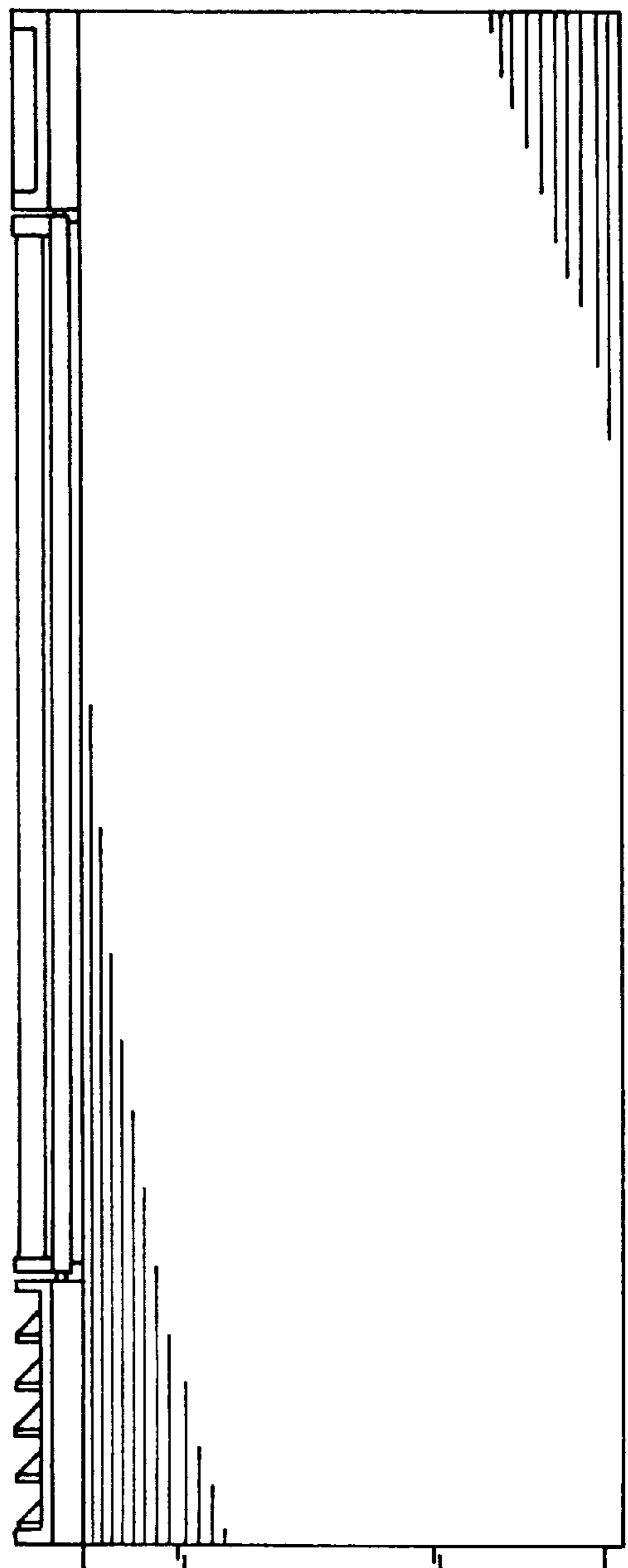

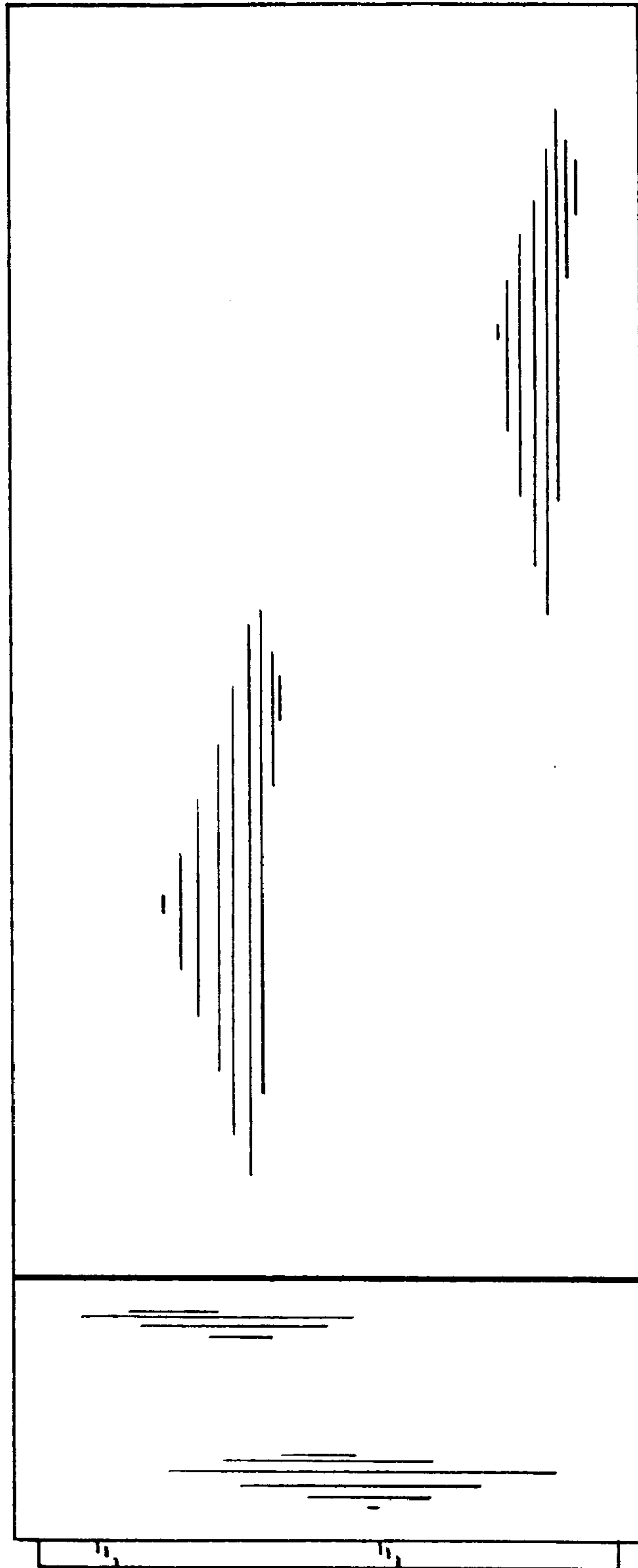

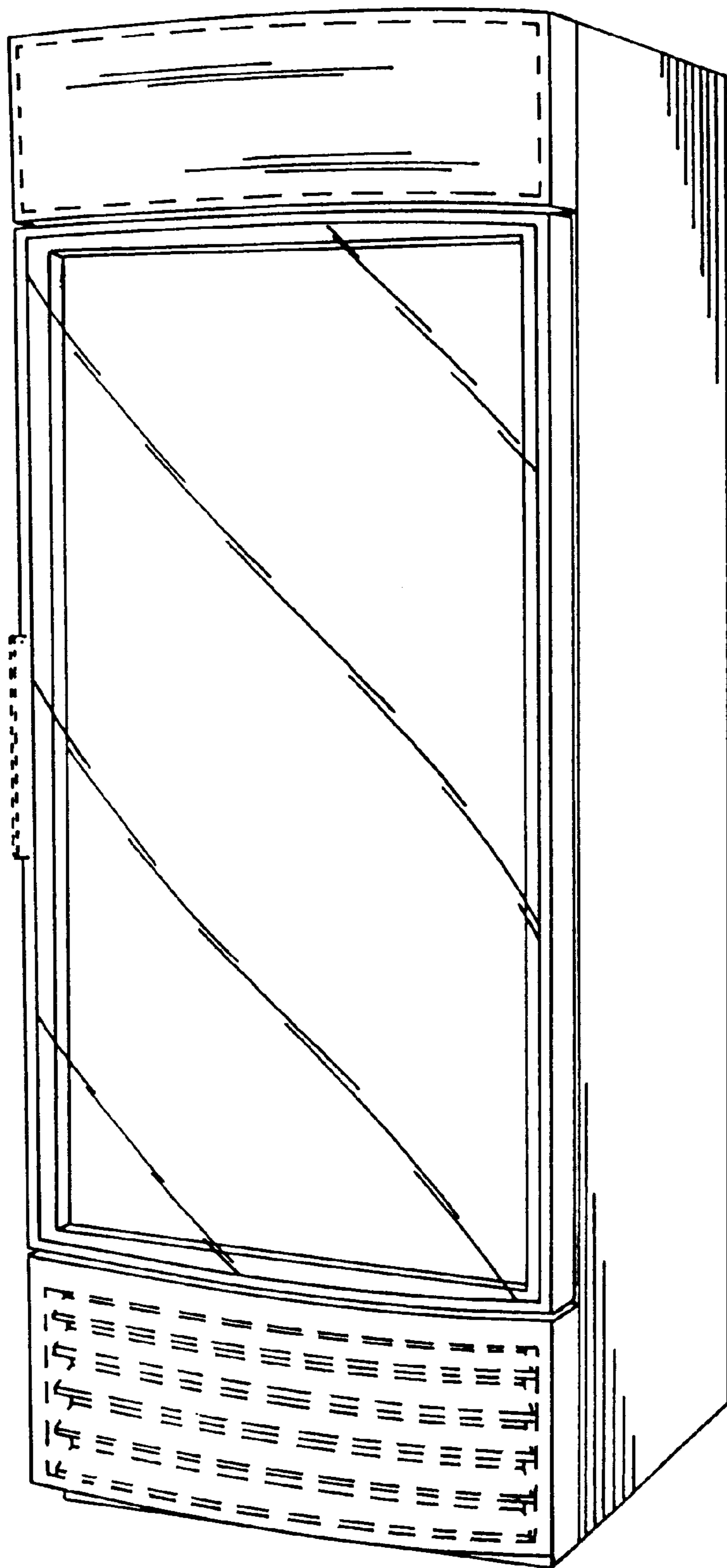

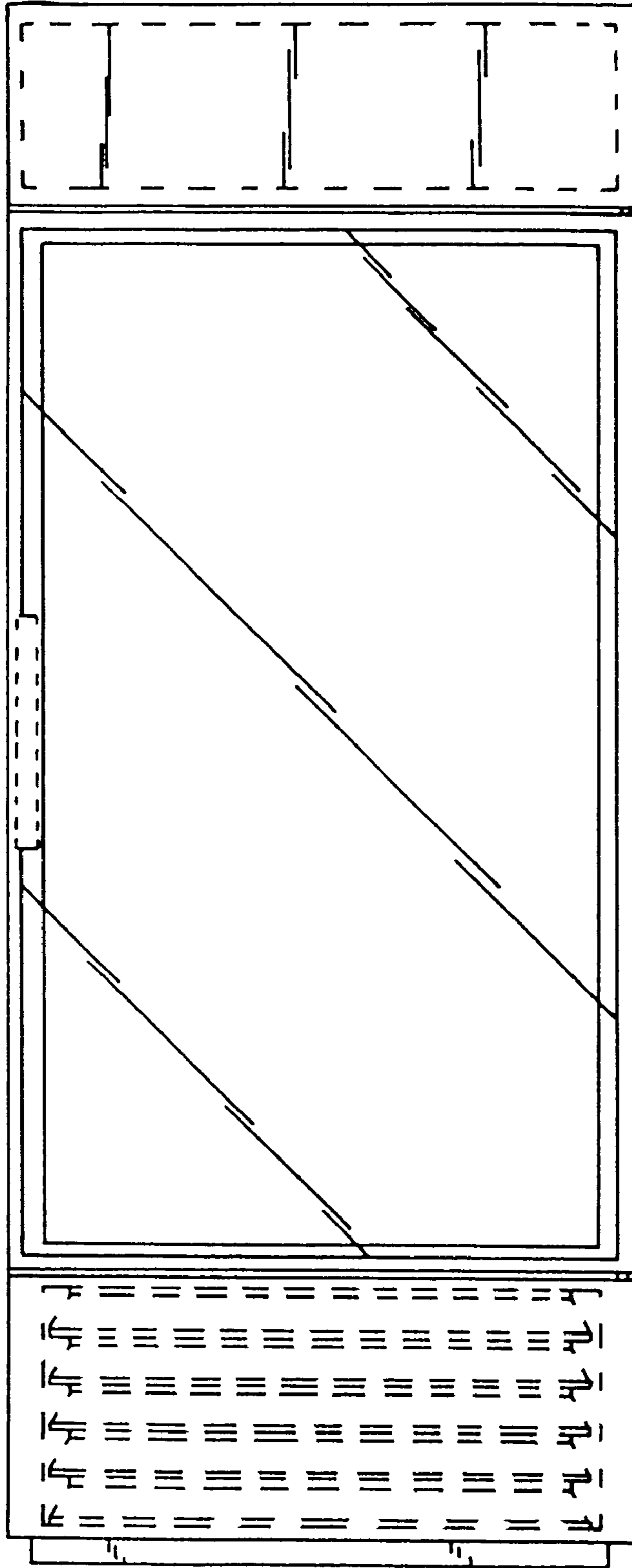
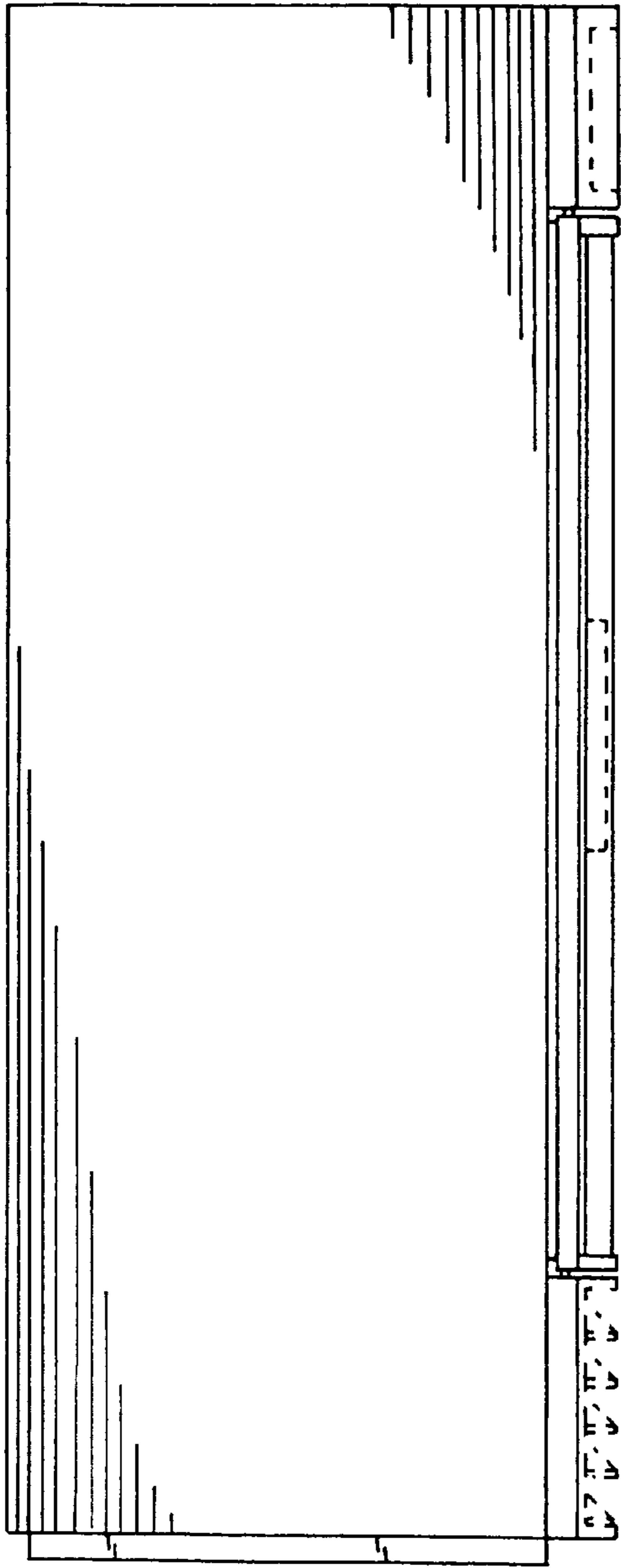
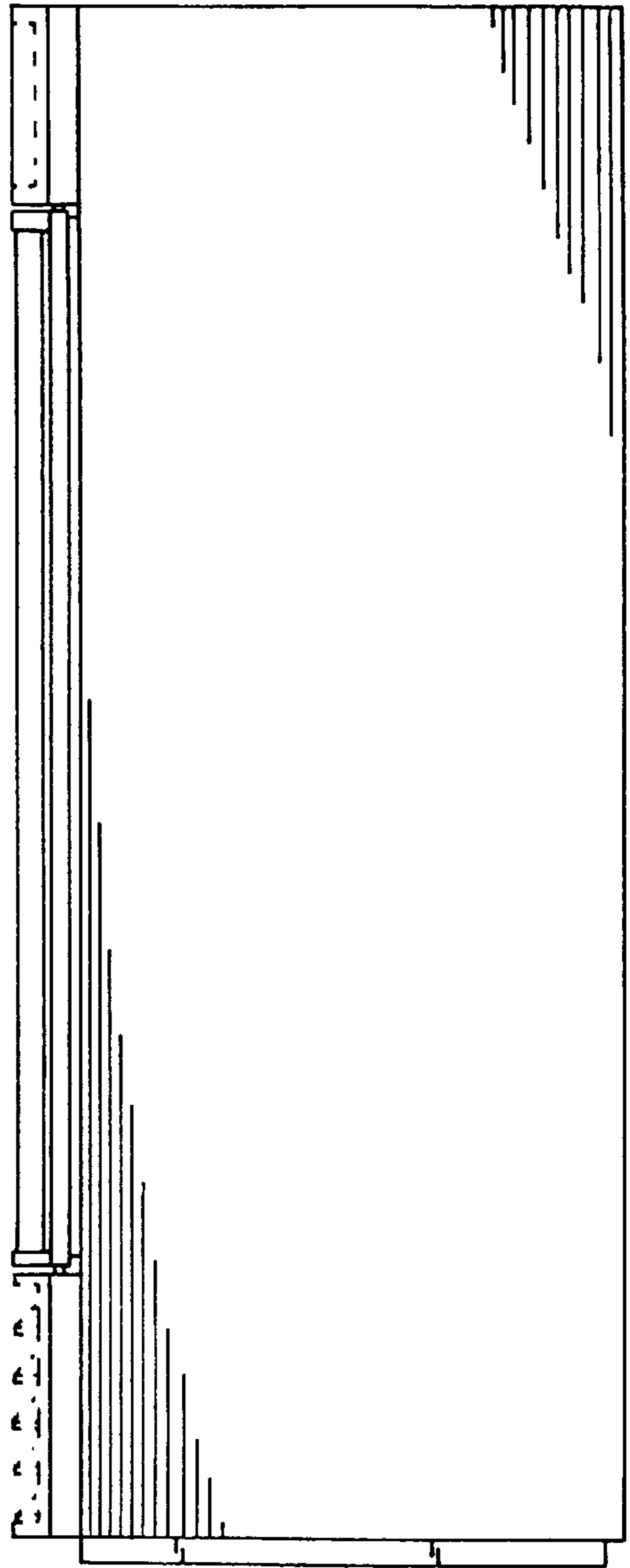
