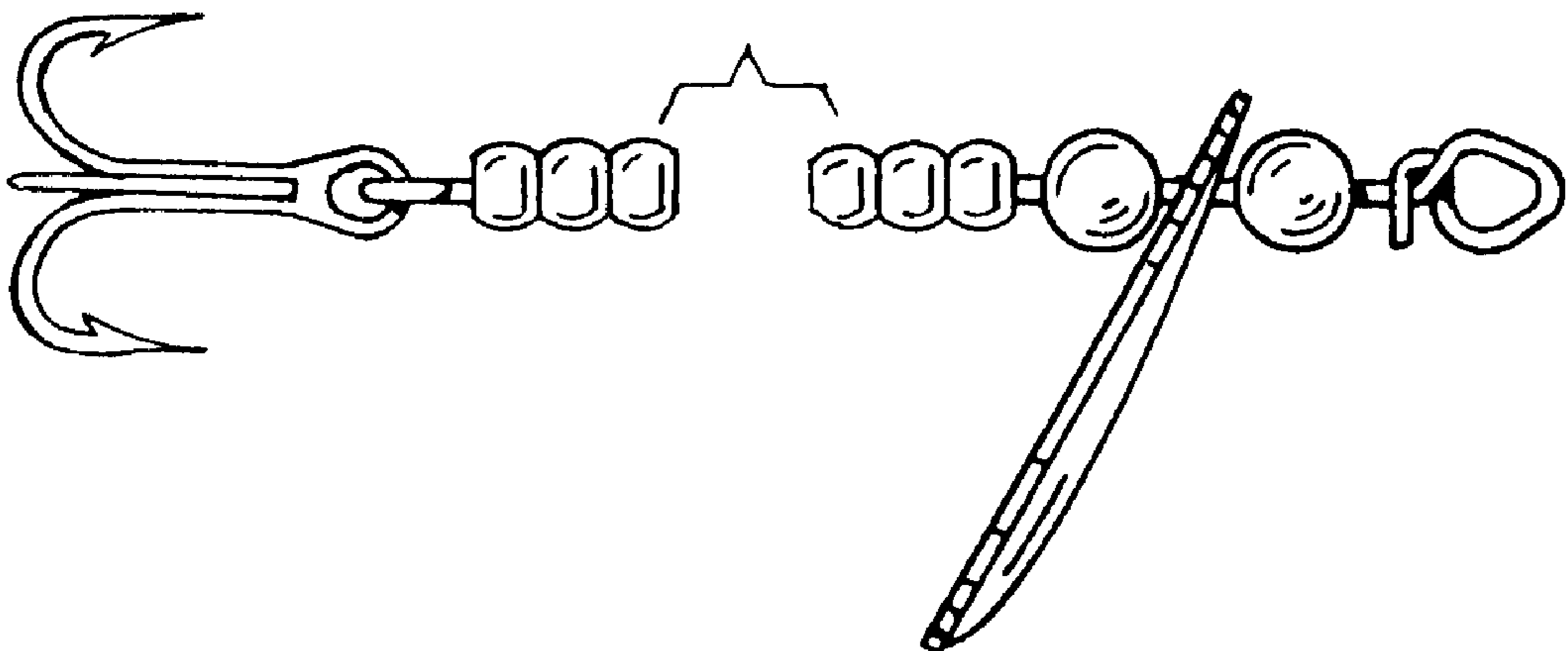
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a fishing lure showing a first form of my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view showing another form of my fishing lure.  
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 7.  
FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 7; and,  
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 7.  
The fishing lure has been shown broken away in FIGS. 1, 2, and 5-10 in the drawing to indicate indeterminate length.

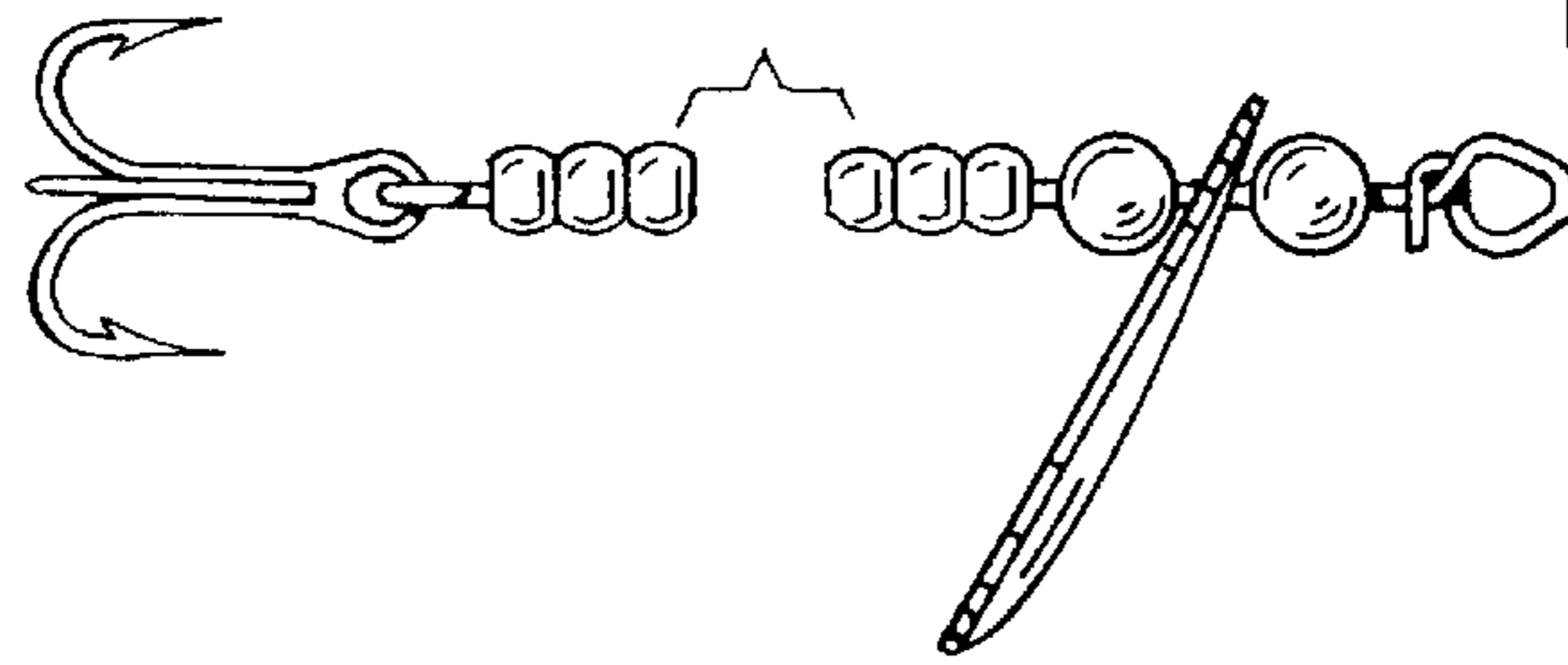

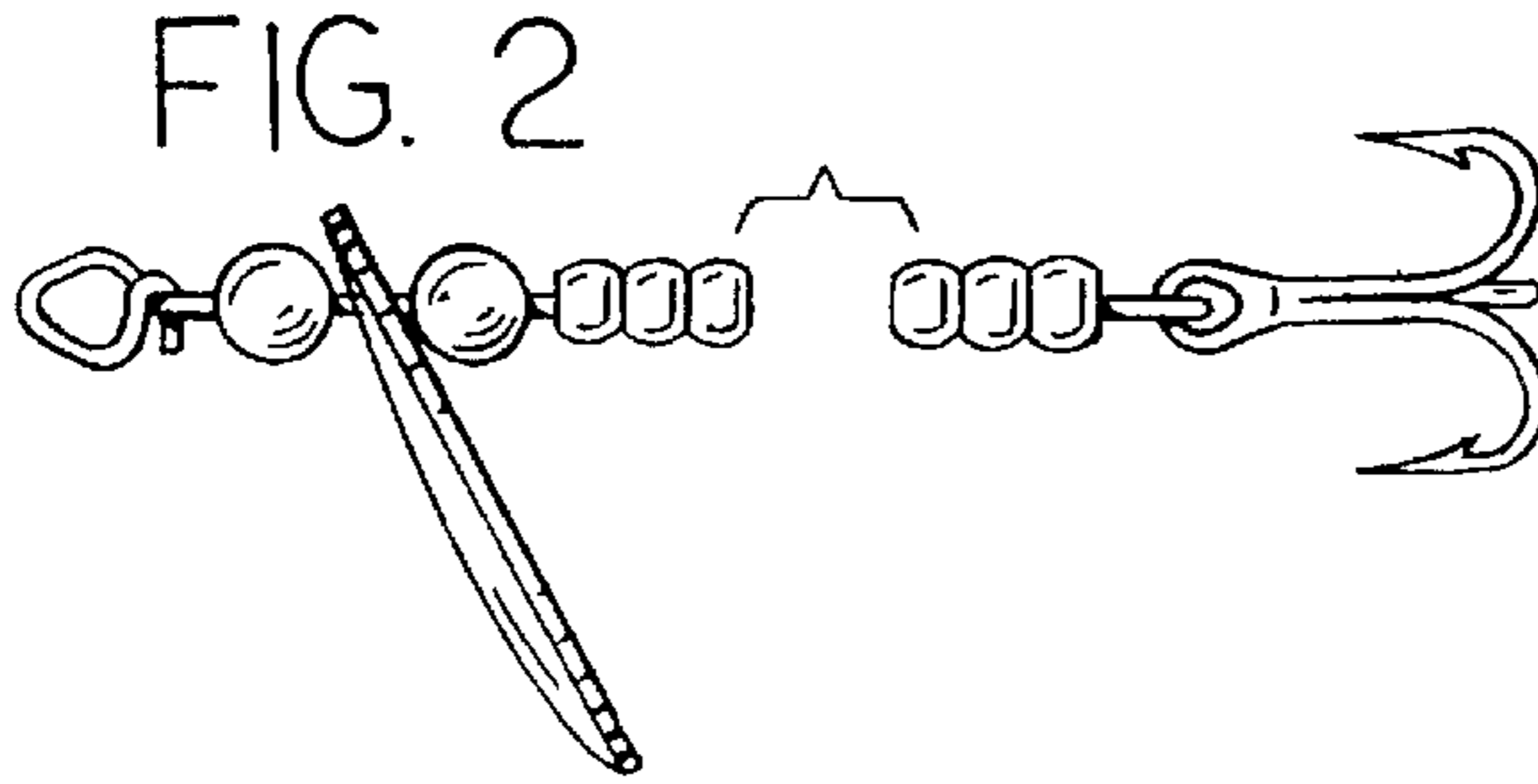

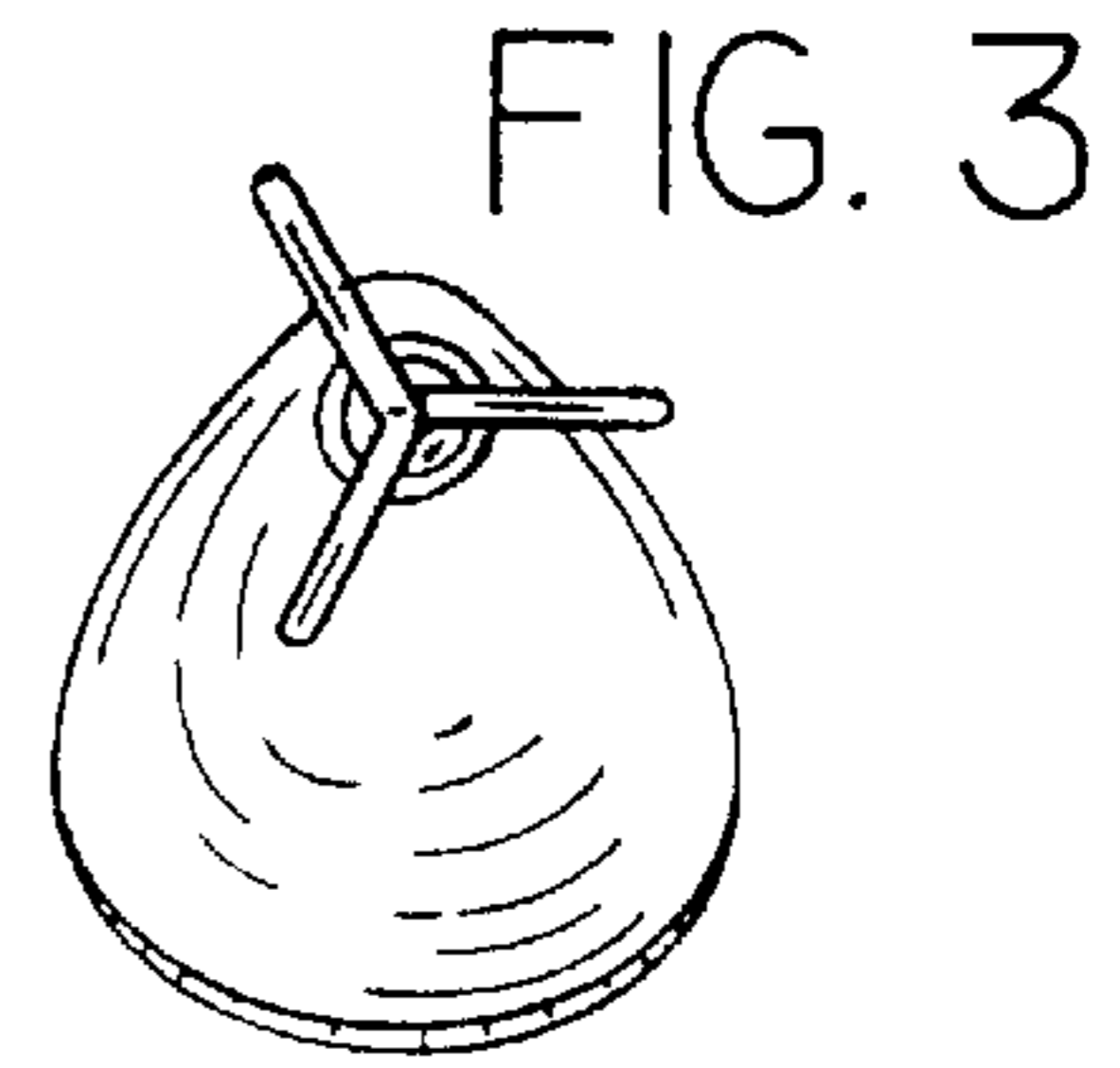

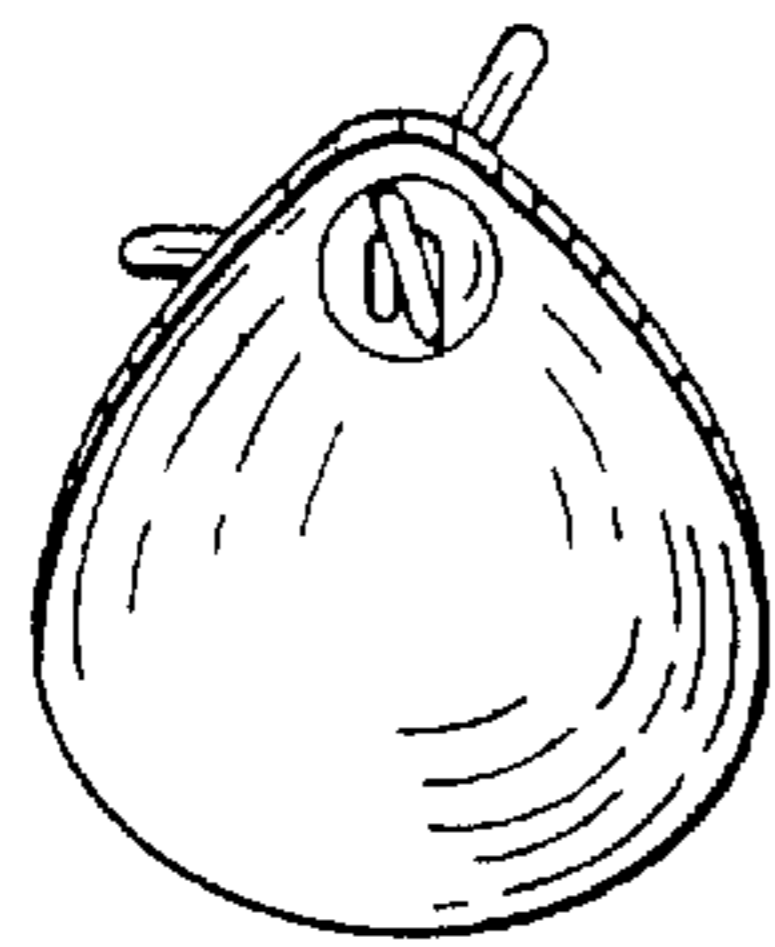

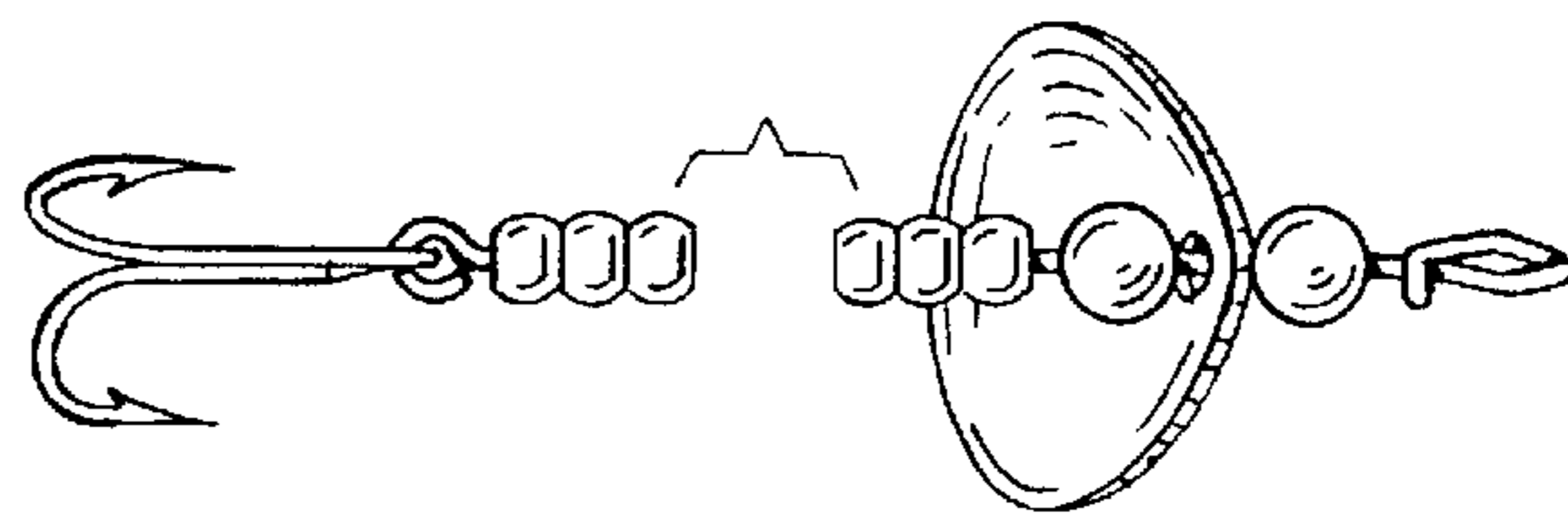

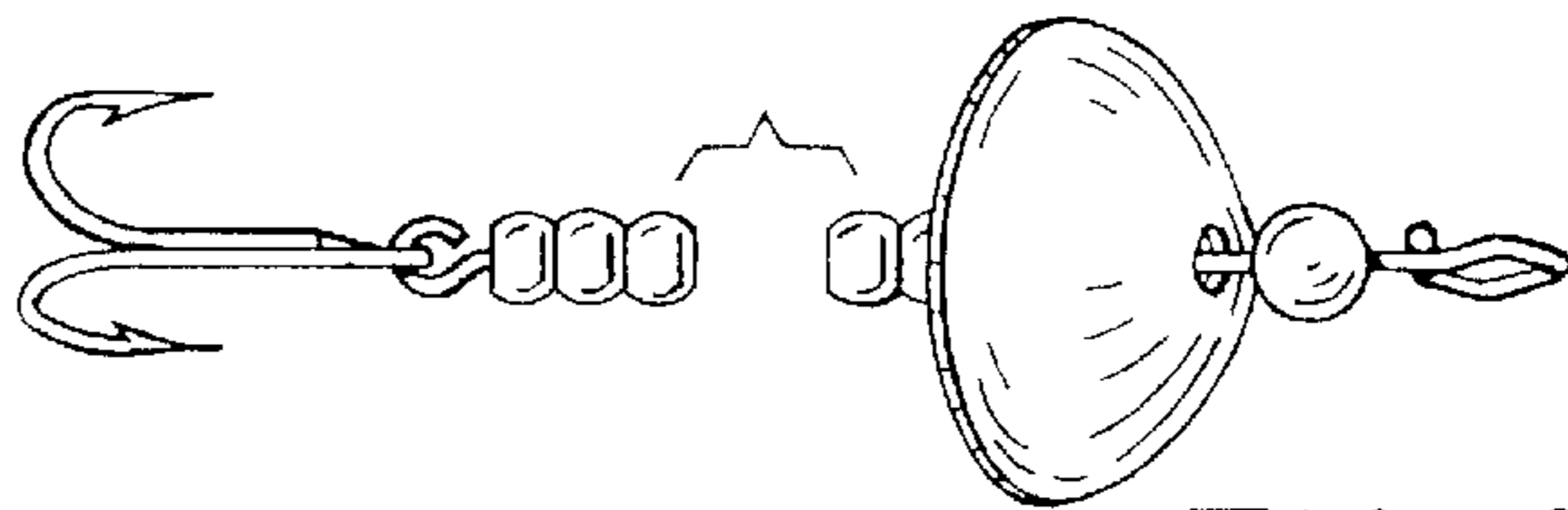

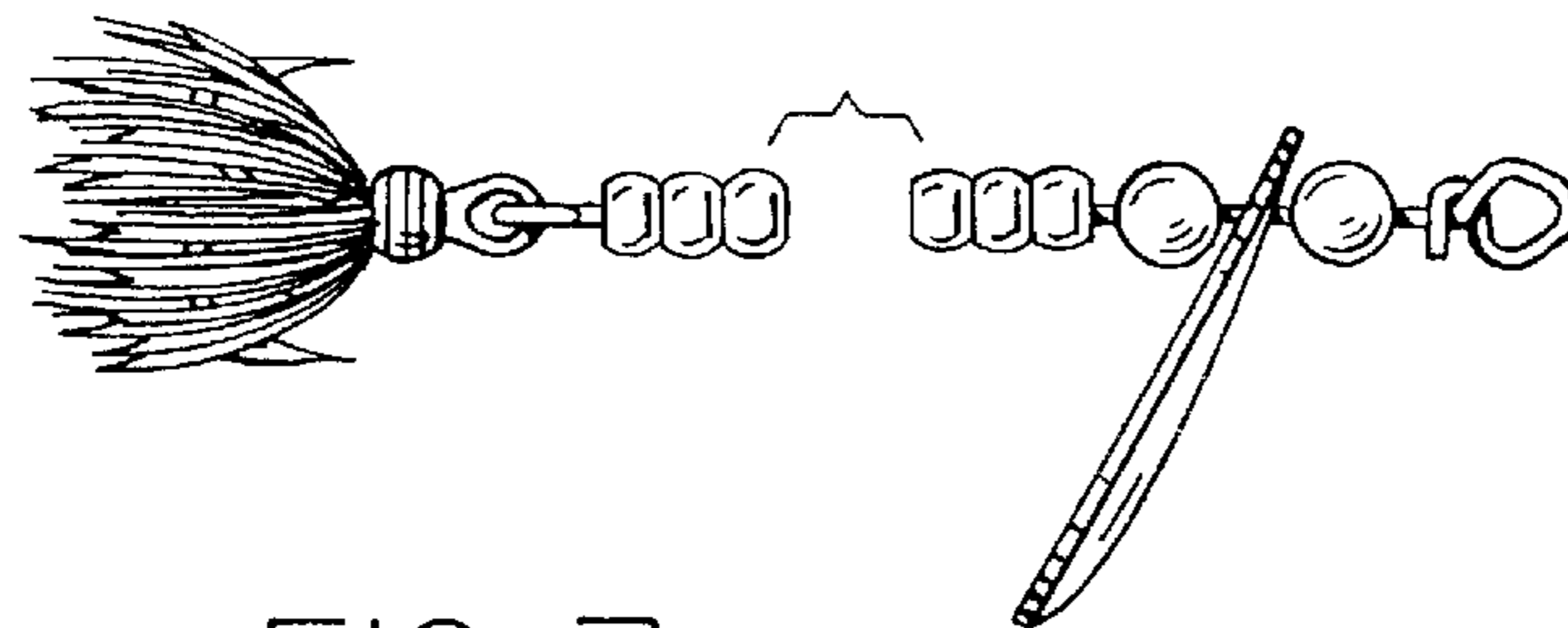

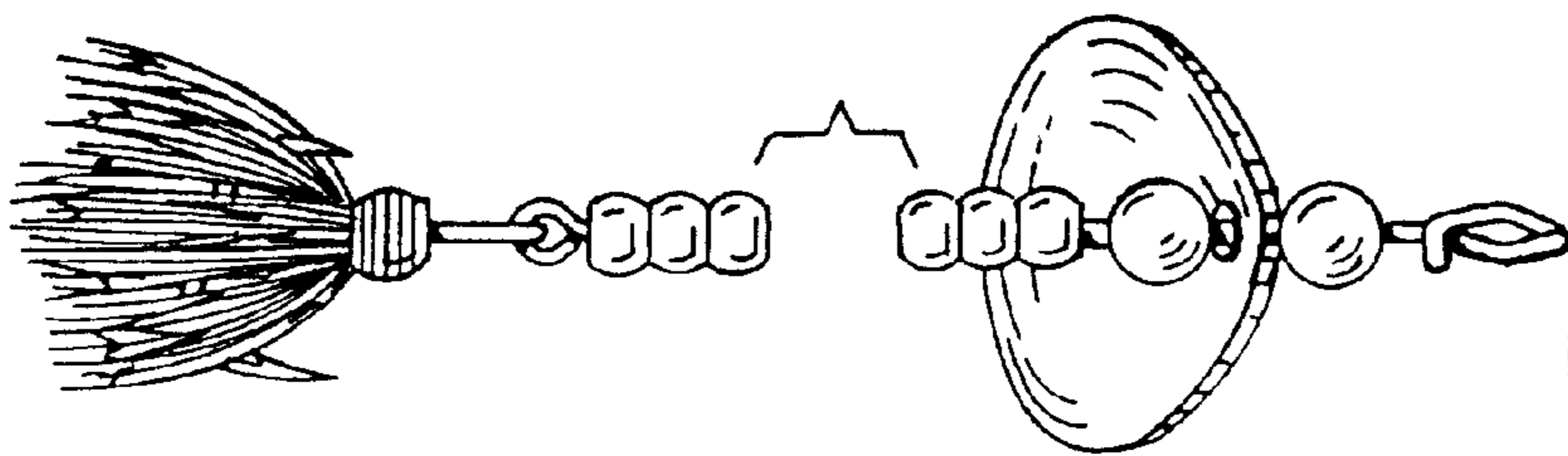
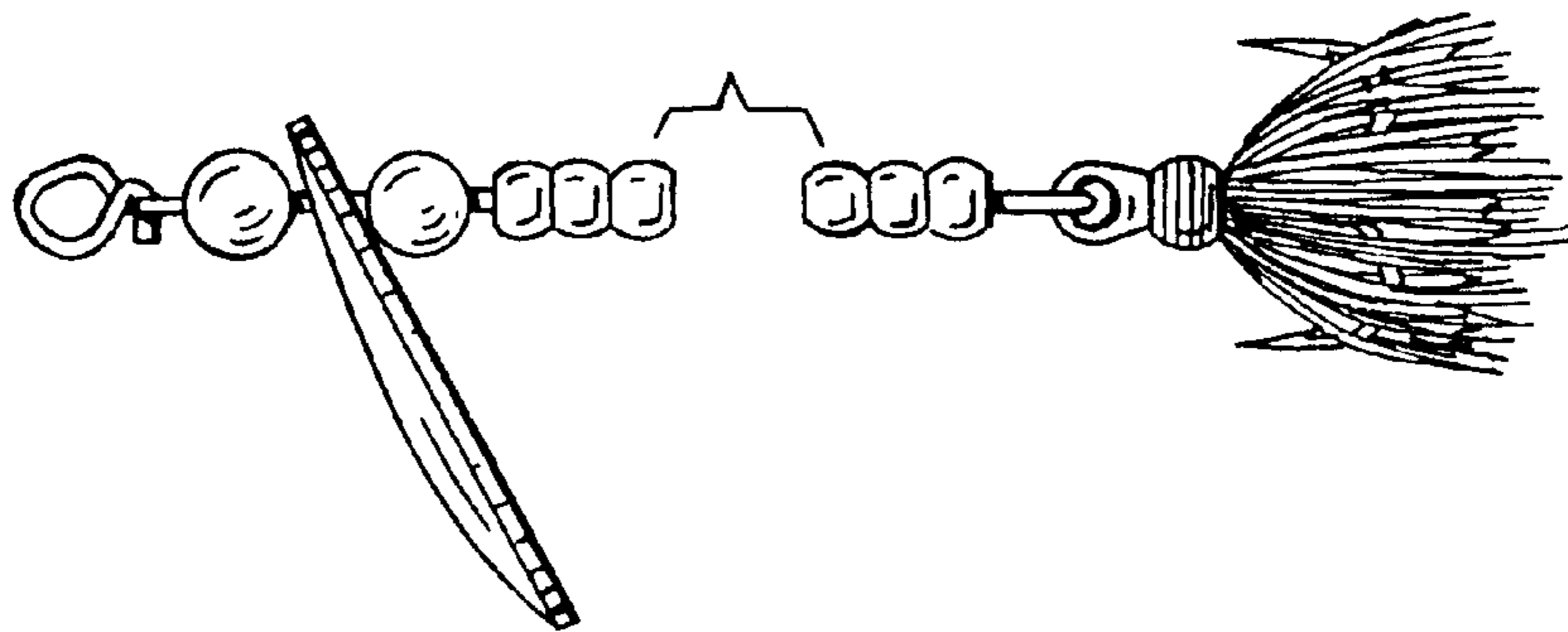

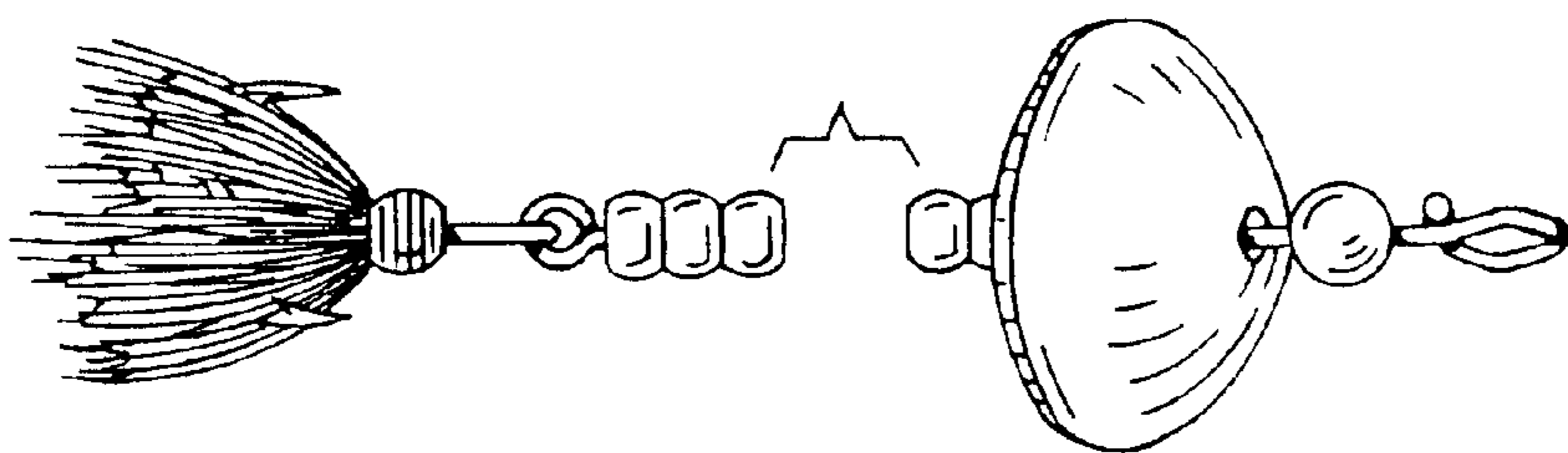
