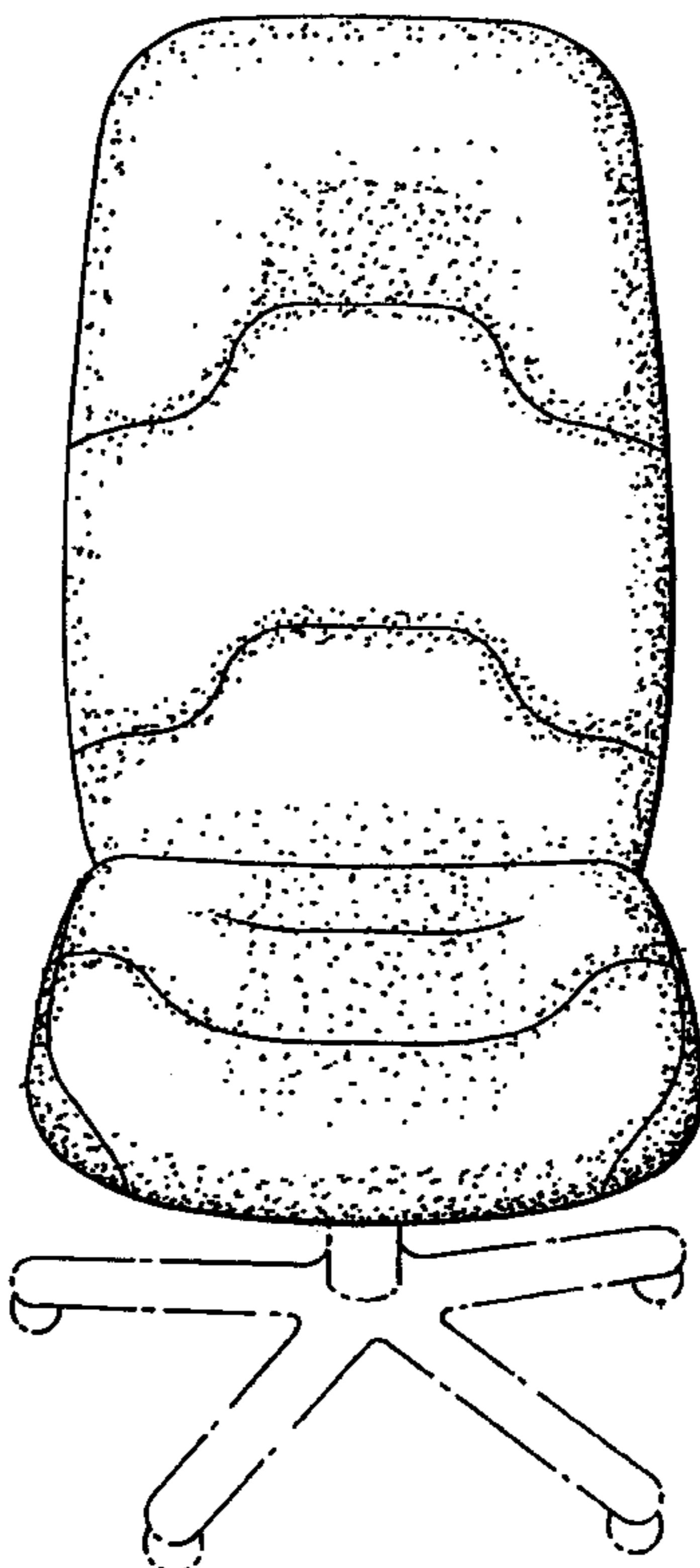

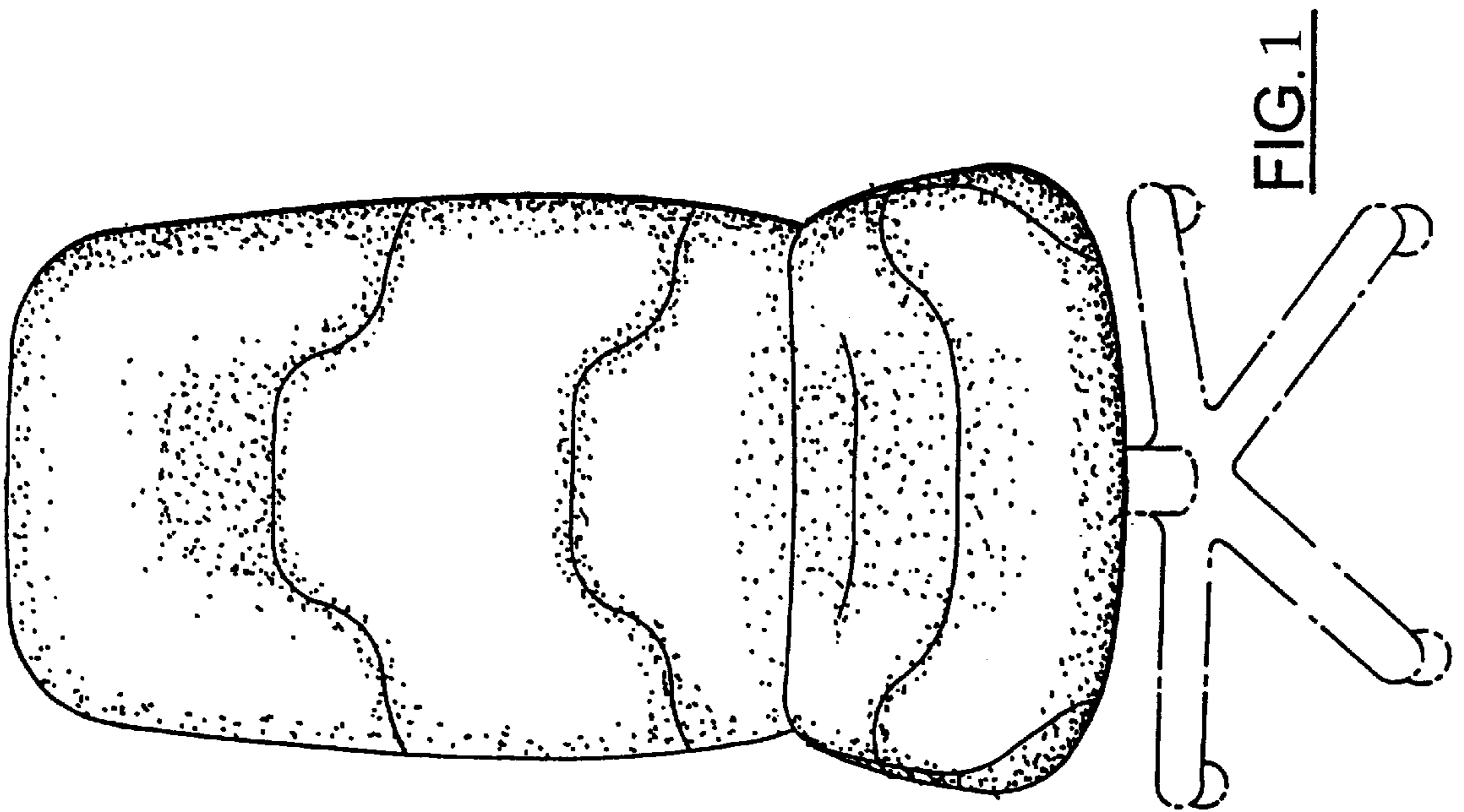
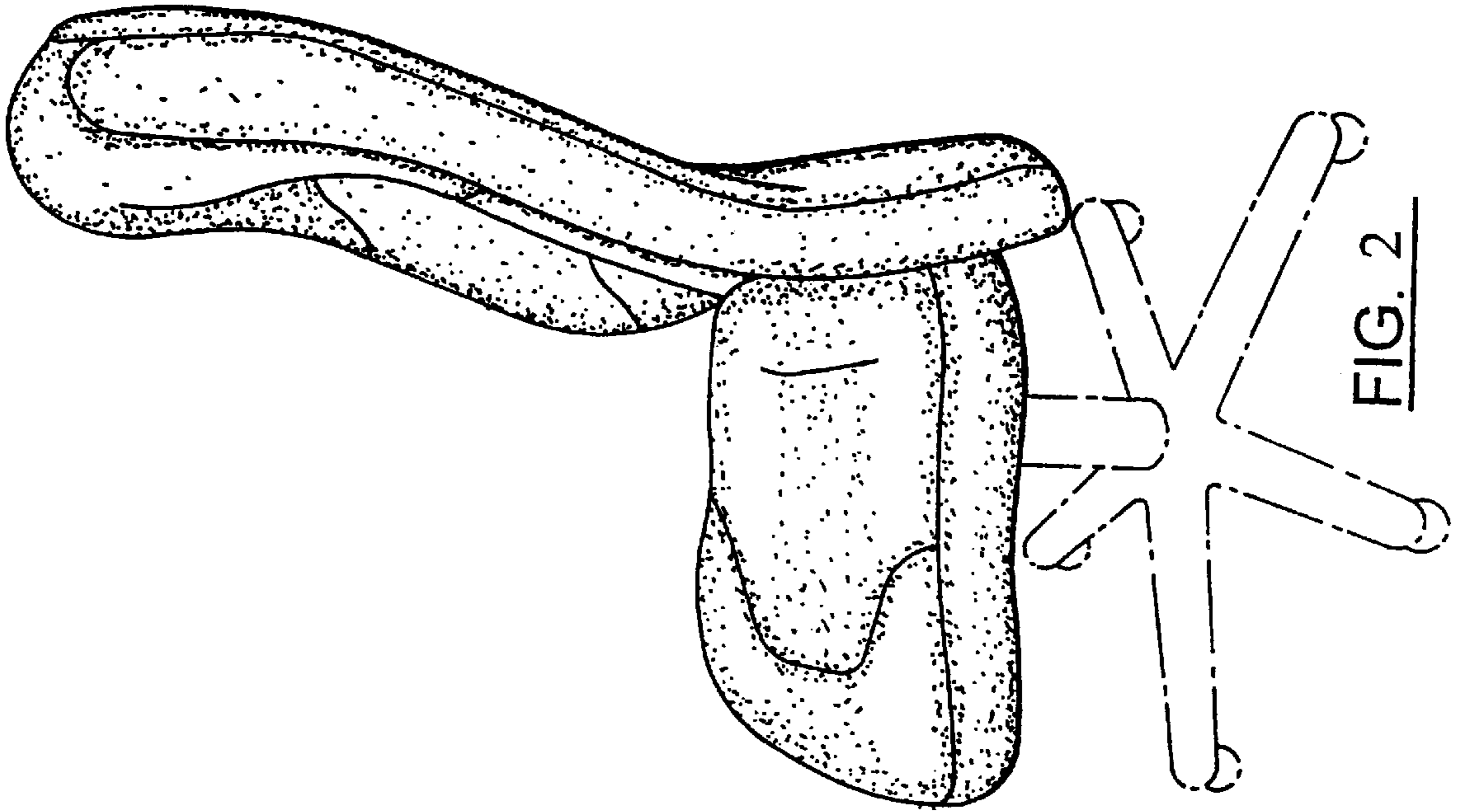
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the chair.
 FIG. 2 is a side view of the chair of FIG. 1, the other side of the chair being the mirror image of this view.
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the chair of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 4 is a rear view of the chair of FIG. 1.
 FIG. 5 is a front view of a first variant of the chair of FIG. 1. The chair also has two C-shaped members positioned on opposed sides of the chair.
 FIG. 6 is a side view of the chair of FIG. 5, the other side of the chair being the mirror image of this view.
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the chair of FIG. 5; and,
 FIG. 8 is a rear view of the chair of FIG. 5.
 The portions of the chair shown in broken lines have been shown for illustration purposes only and do not form part of the claimed design.

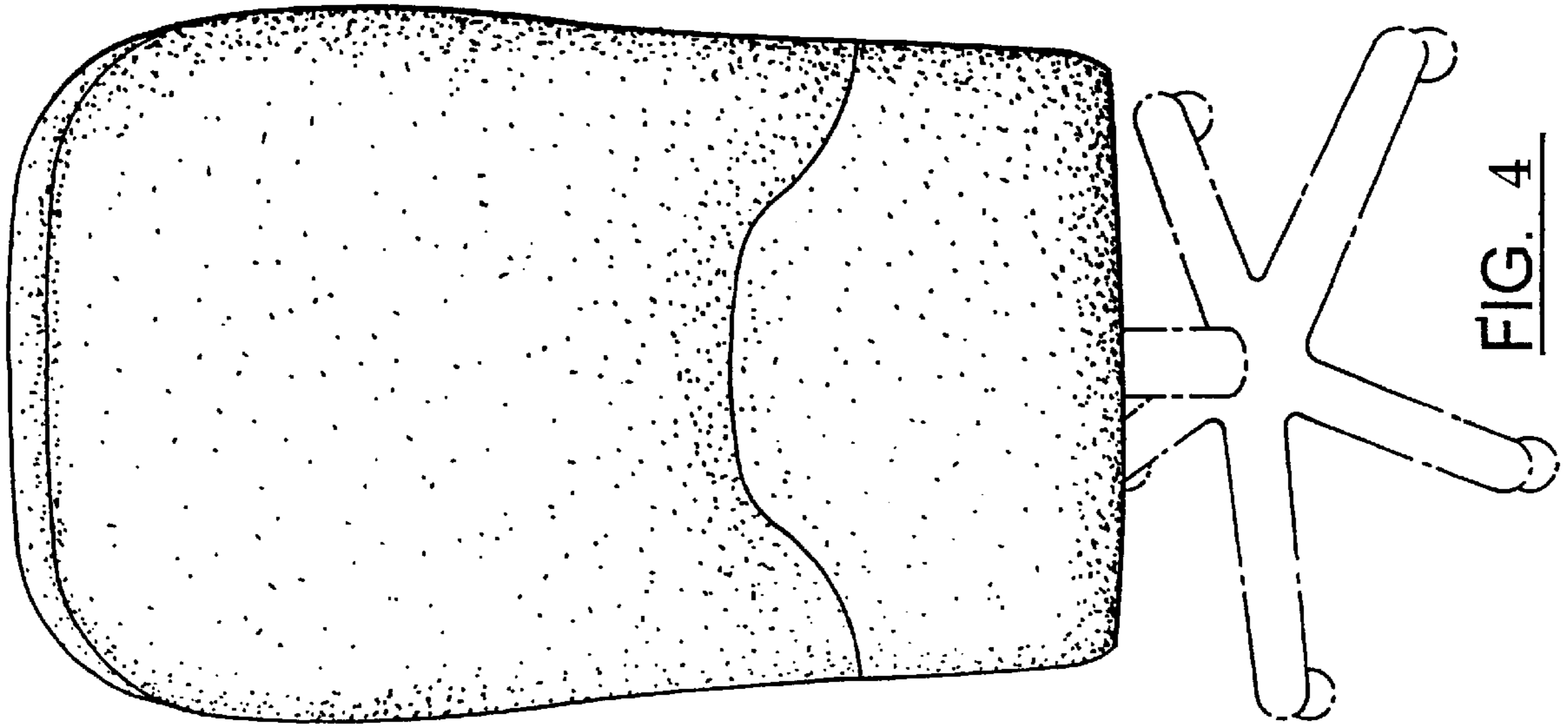

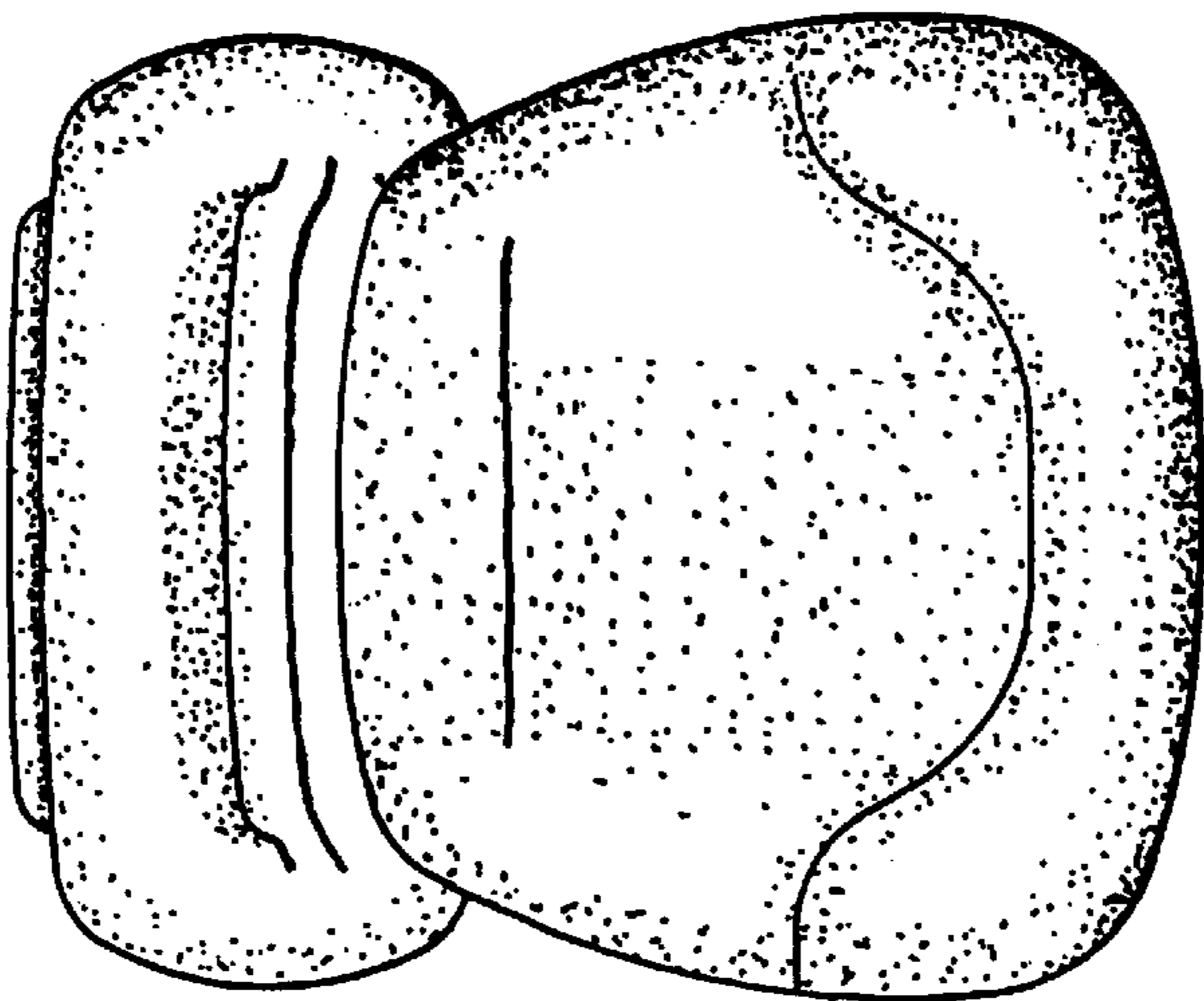

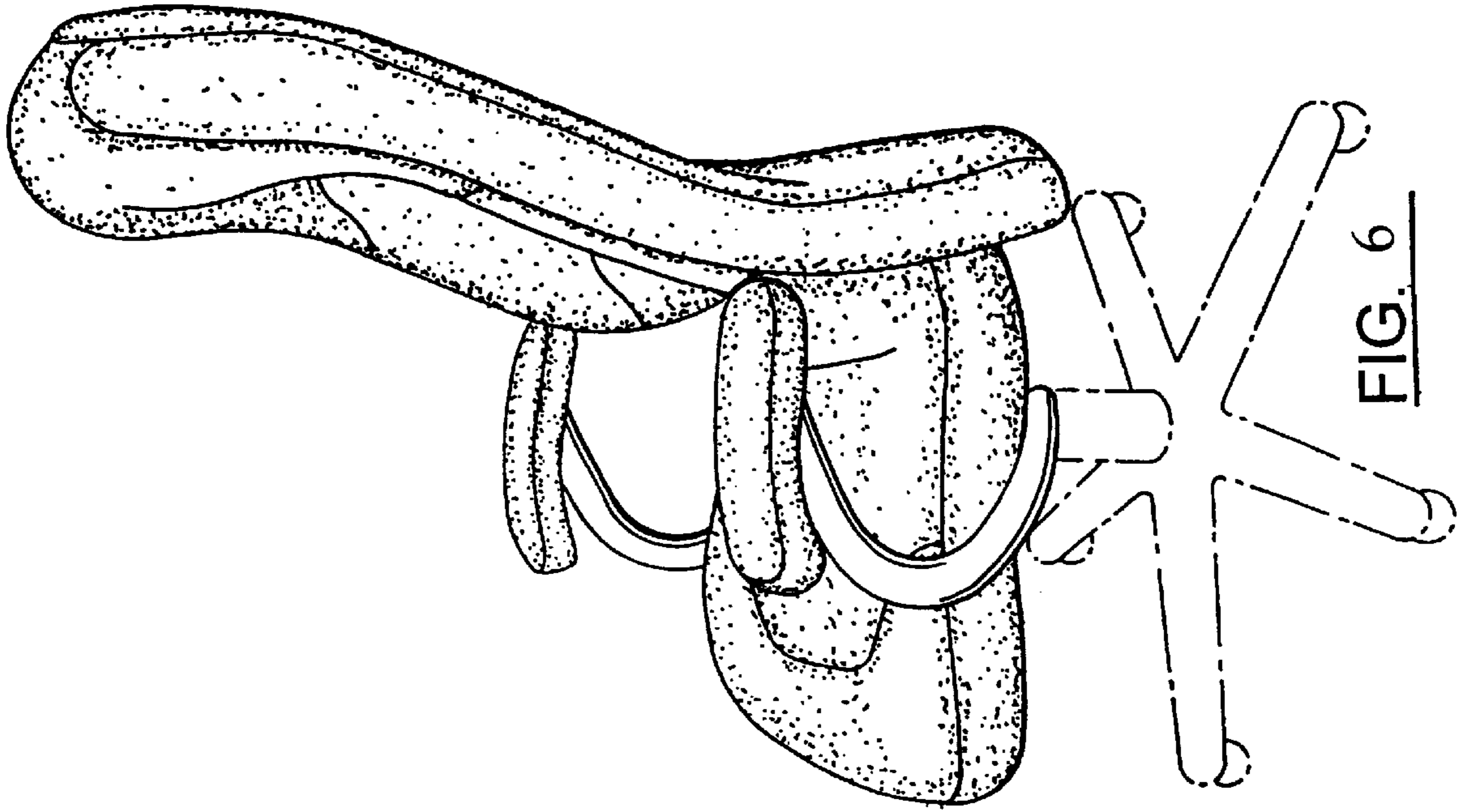

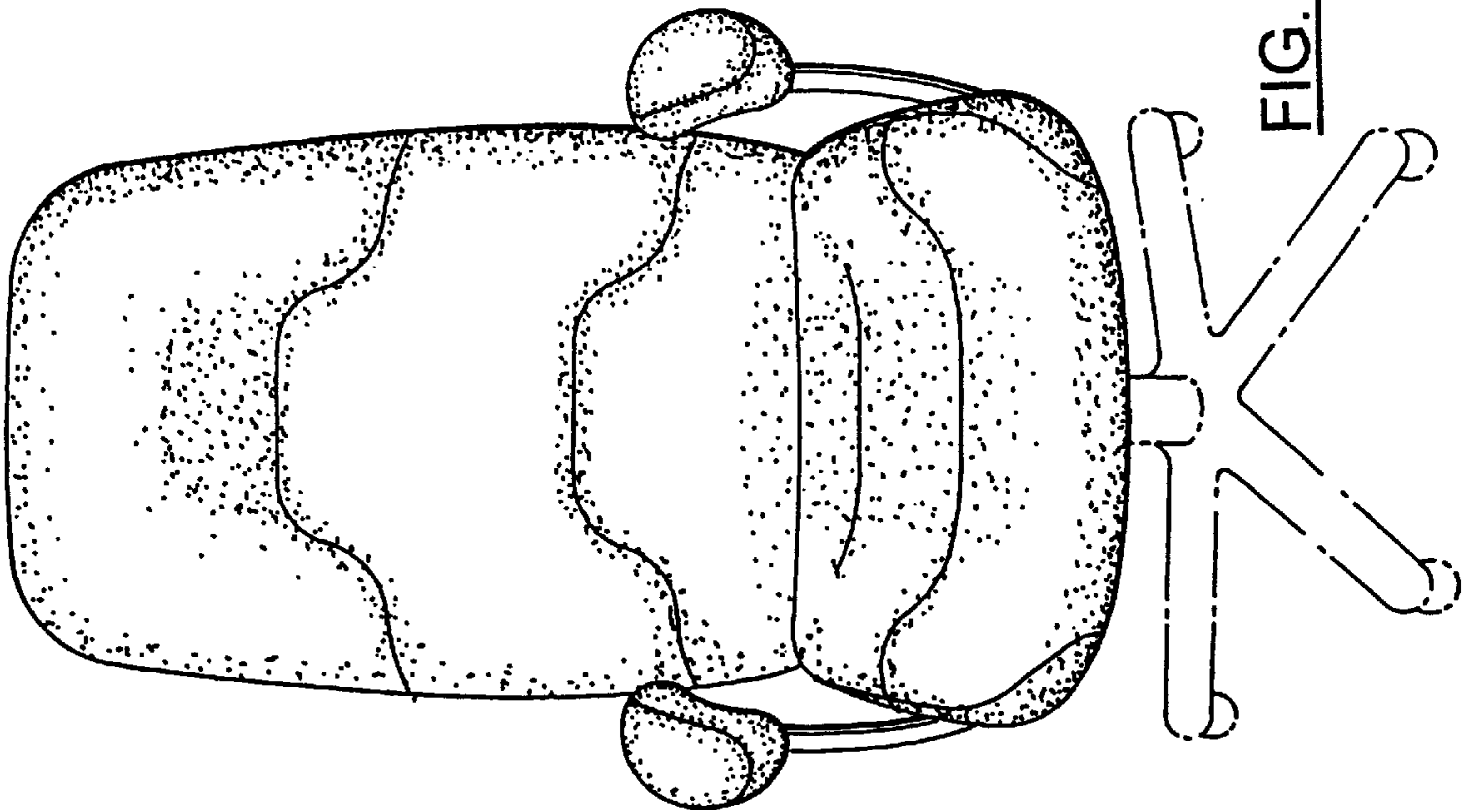

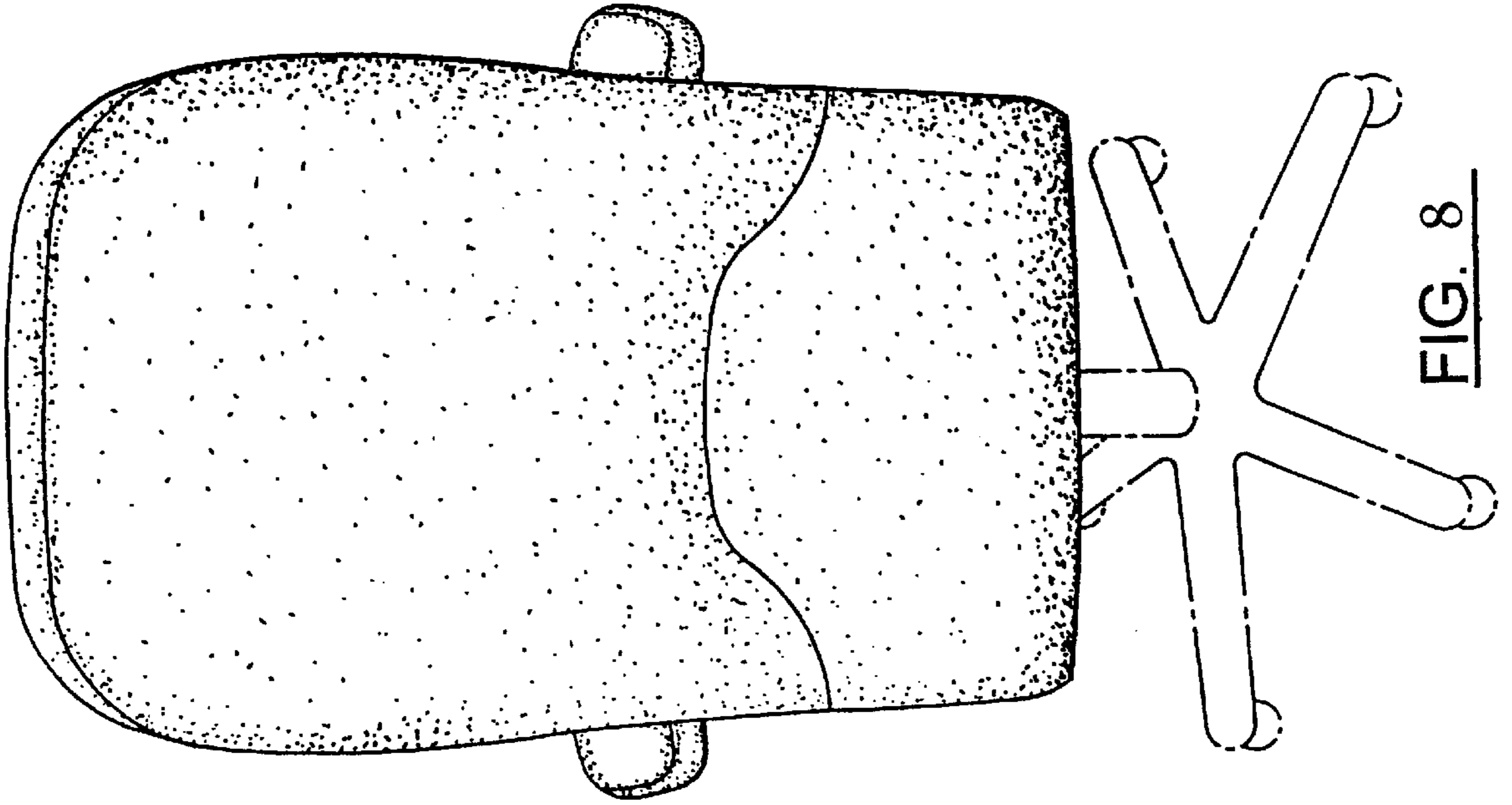

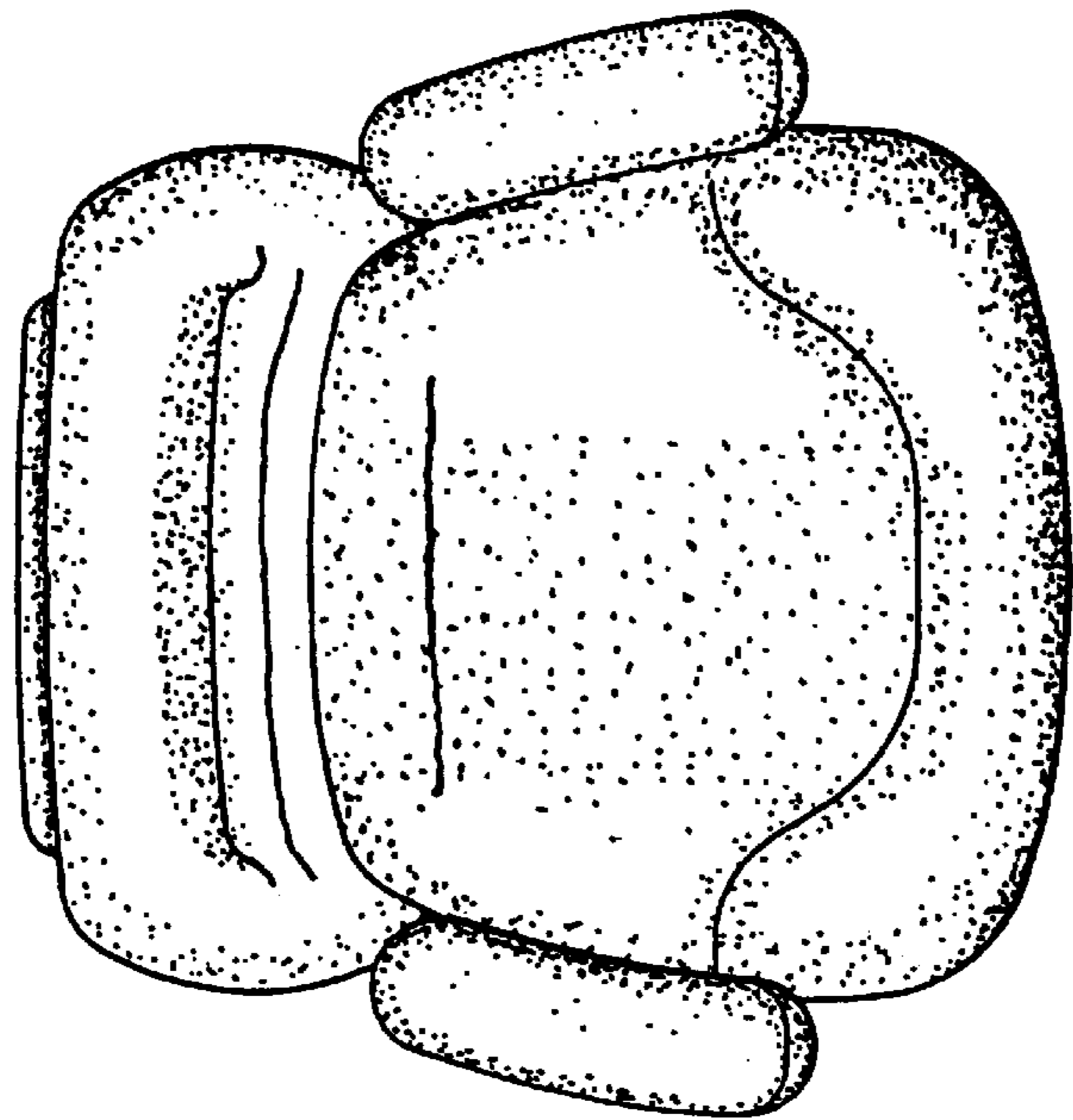
