[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of decorative cake-shaped gift boxes, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the set of decorative cake-shaped gift boxes.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the set of decorative cake-shaped gift boxes of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a side view of the set of decorative cake-shaped gift boxes of FIG. 1, it being understood that the opposite side is a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of one of the decorative cake-shaped gift boxes of the set shown separately for clarity of illustration.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the gift box of FIG. 4, it being understood that the bottom view is a mirror image.

FIG. 6 is a side view of the gift box of FIG. 4, it being understood that the opposite side is a mirror image.

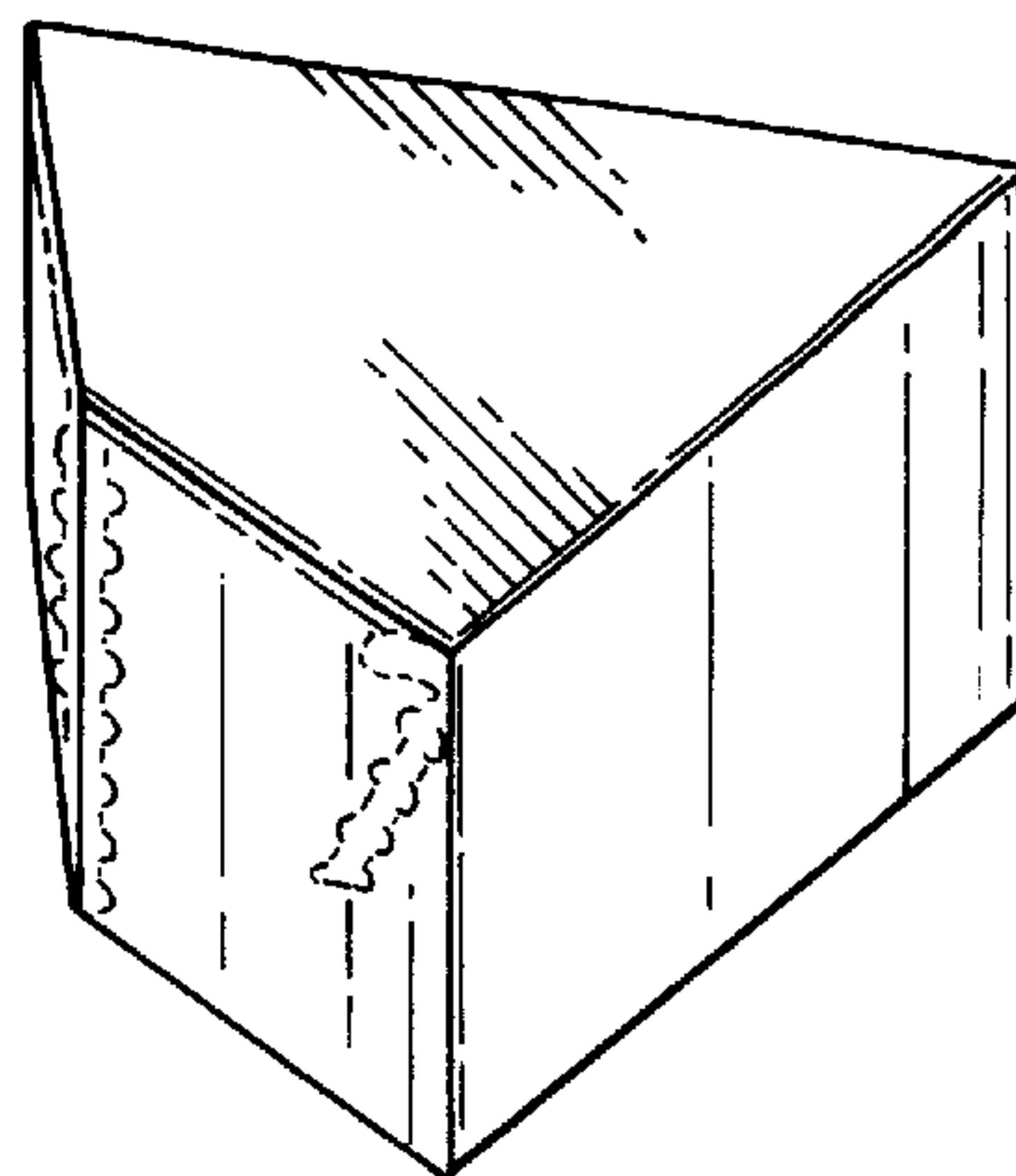
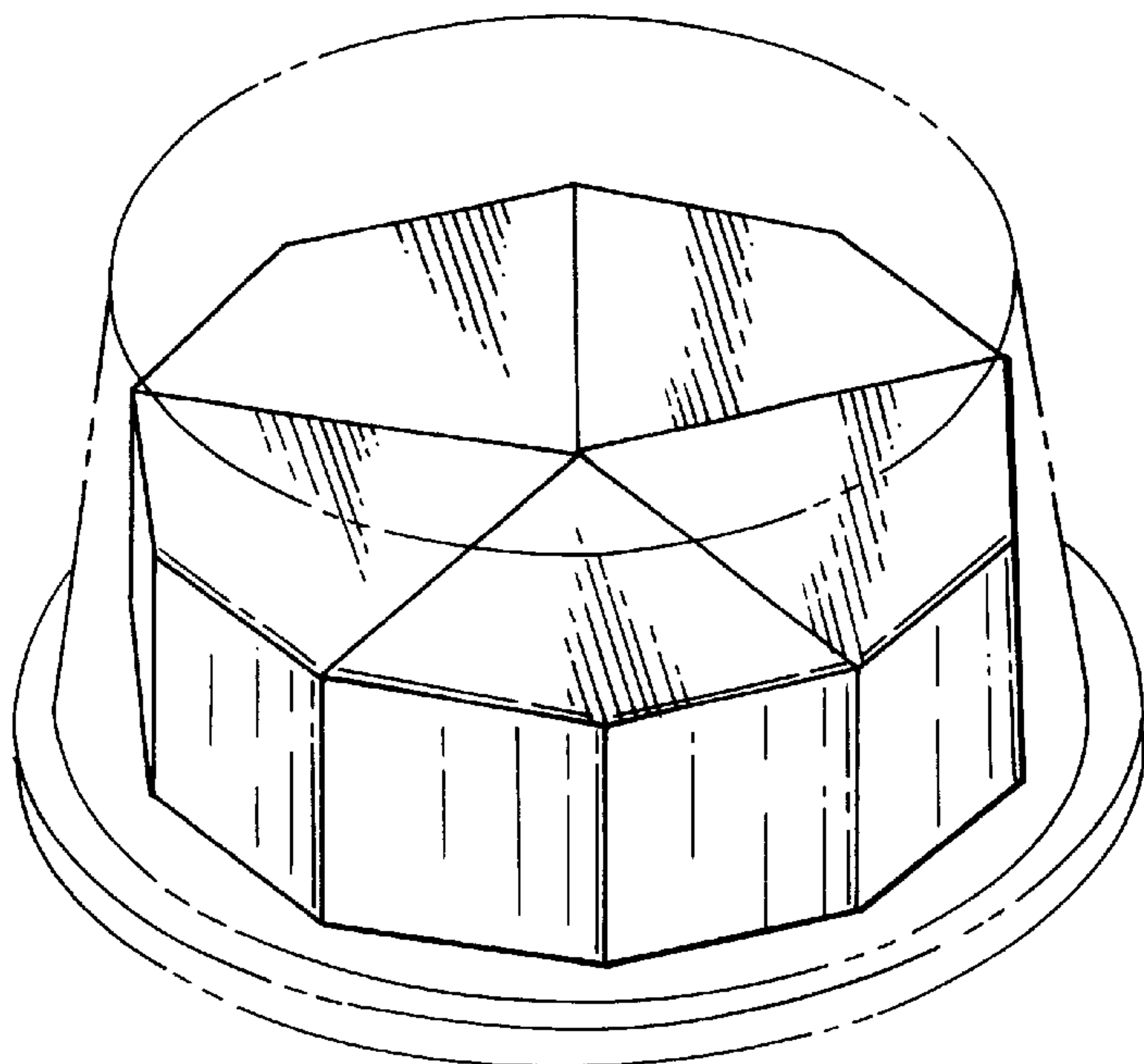
FIG. 7 is a front view of the gift box of FIG. 4, it being understood that the rear view is a mirror image; and,

FIG. 8 is a top view of one of the decorative cake-shaped gift boxes of the set shown separately in an unfolded position.

The dash-dot-dot broken line showing of the cake plate and the cake plate cover in FIGS. 1-3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The dotted broken lines shown in FIG. 7 represent fold lines.

Any broken line illustrations in the drawing disclosure merely demonstrate optional and additional features which may be utilized with the invention and are not part of the design sought to be patented.

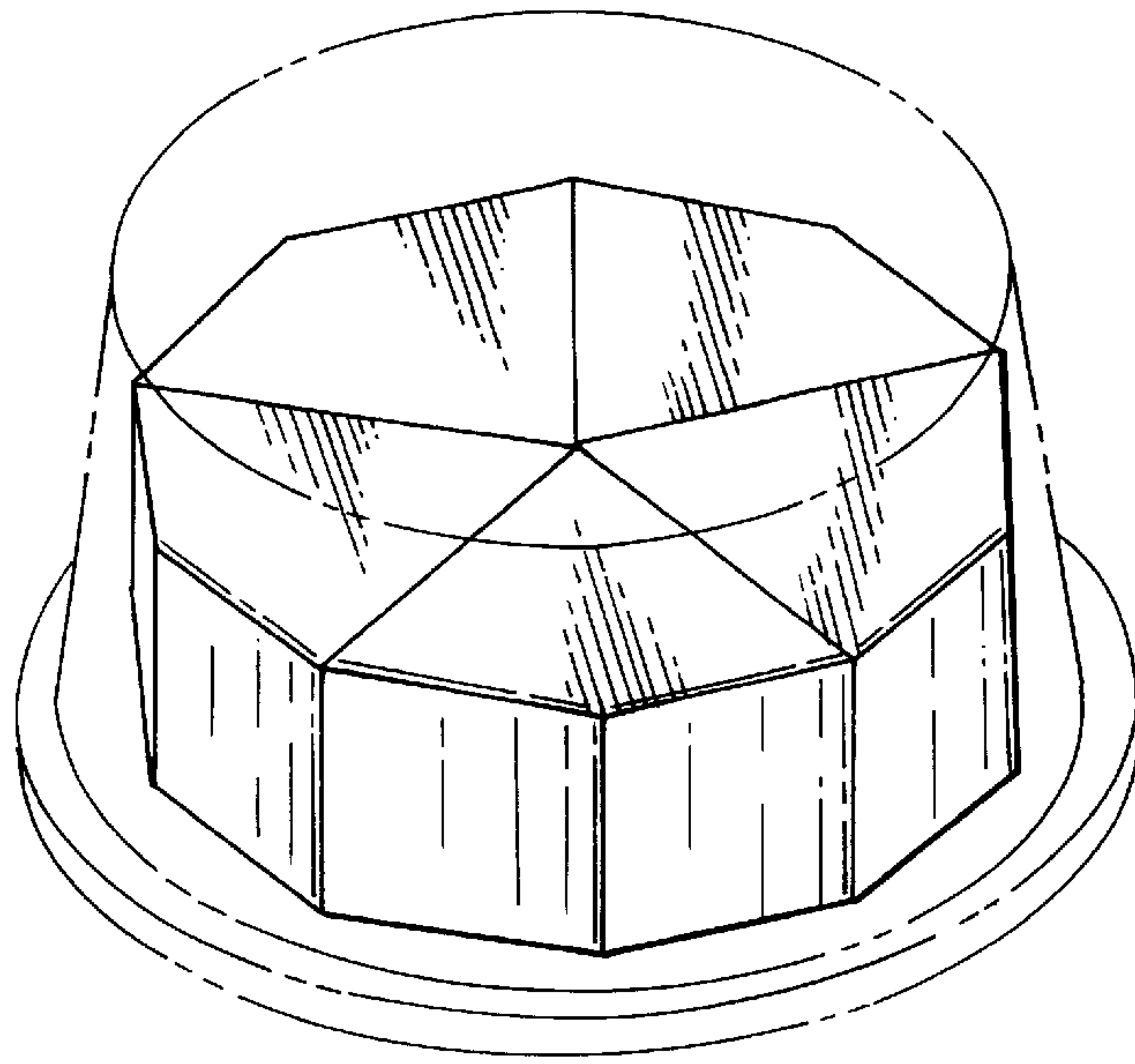

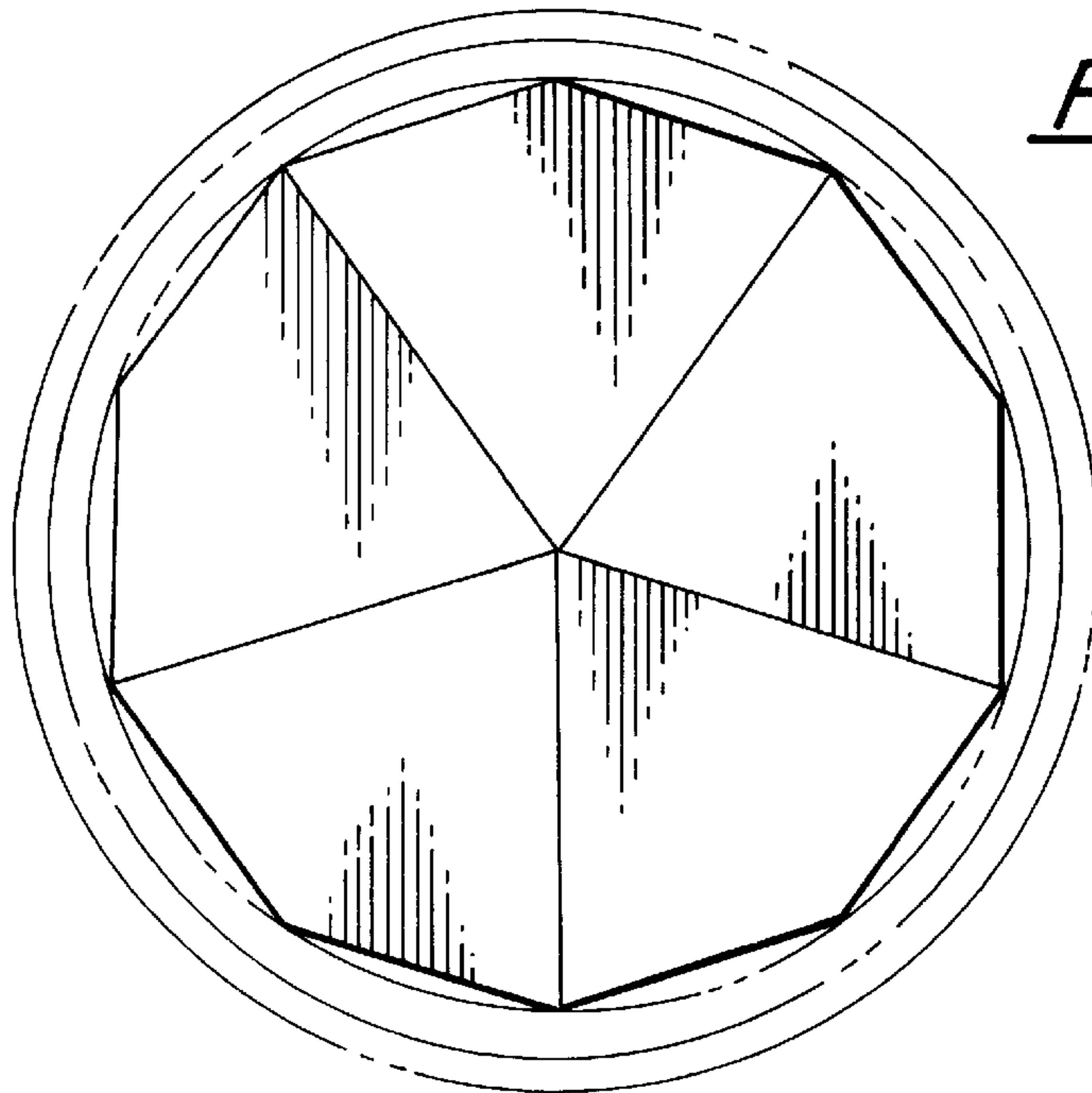

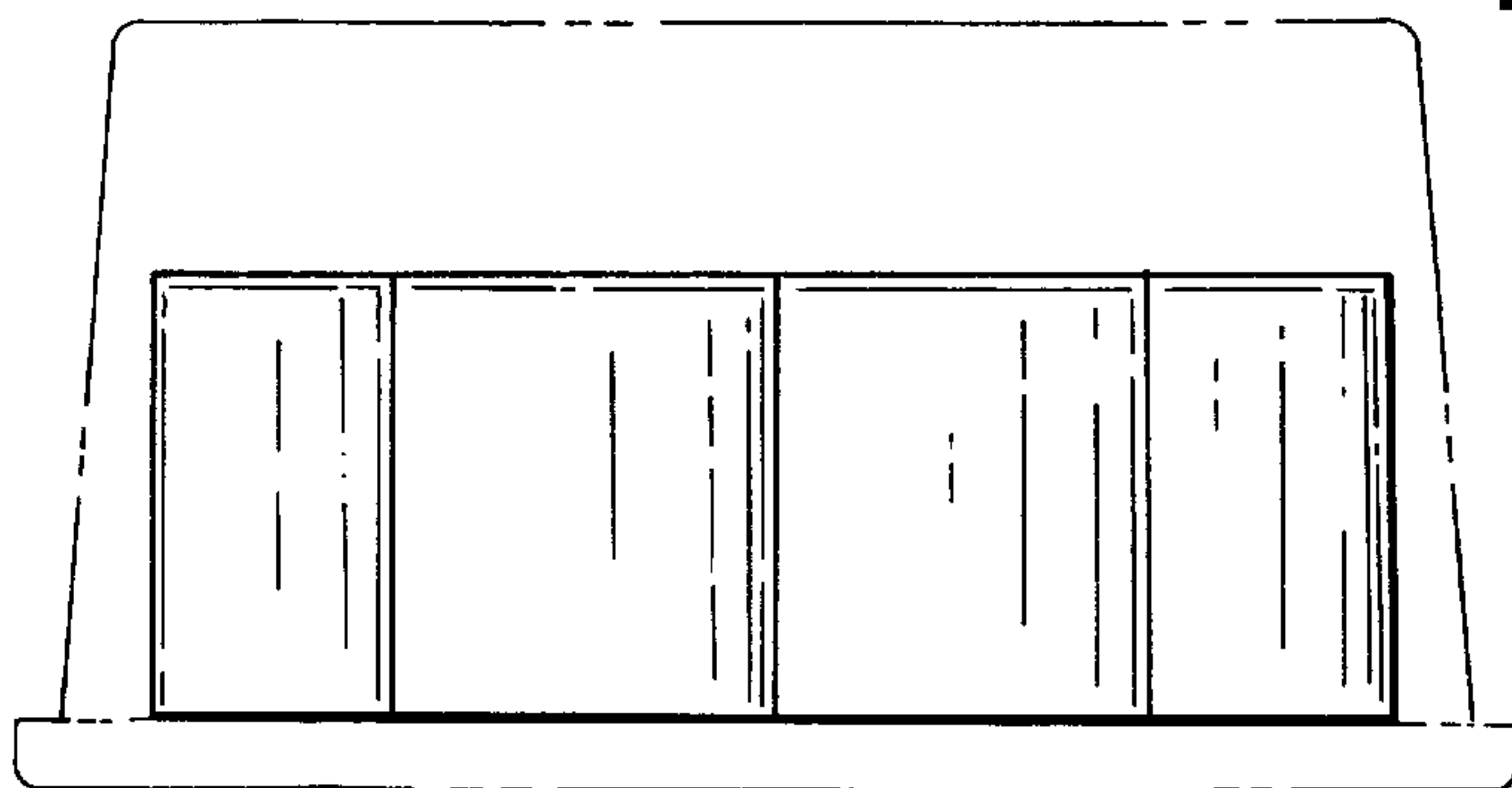

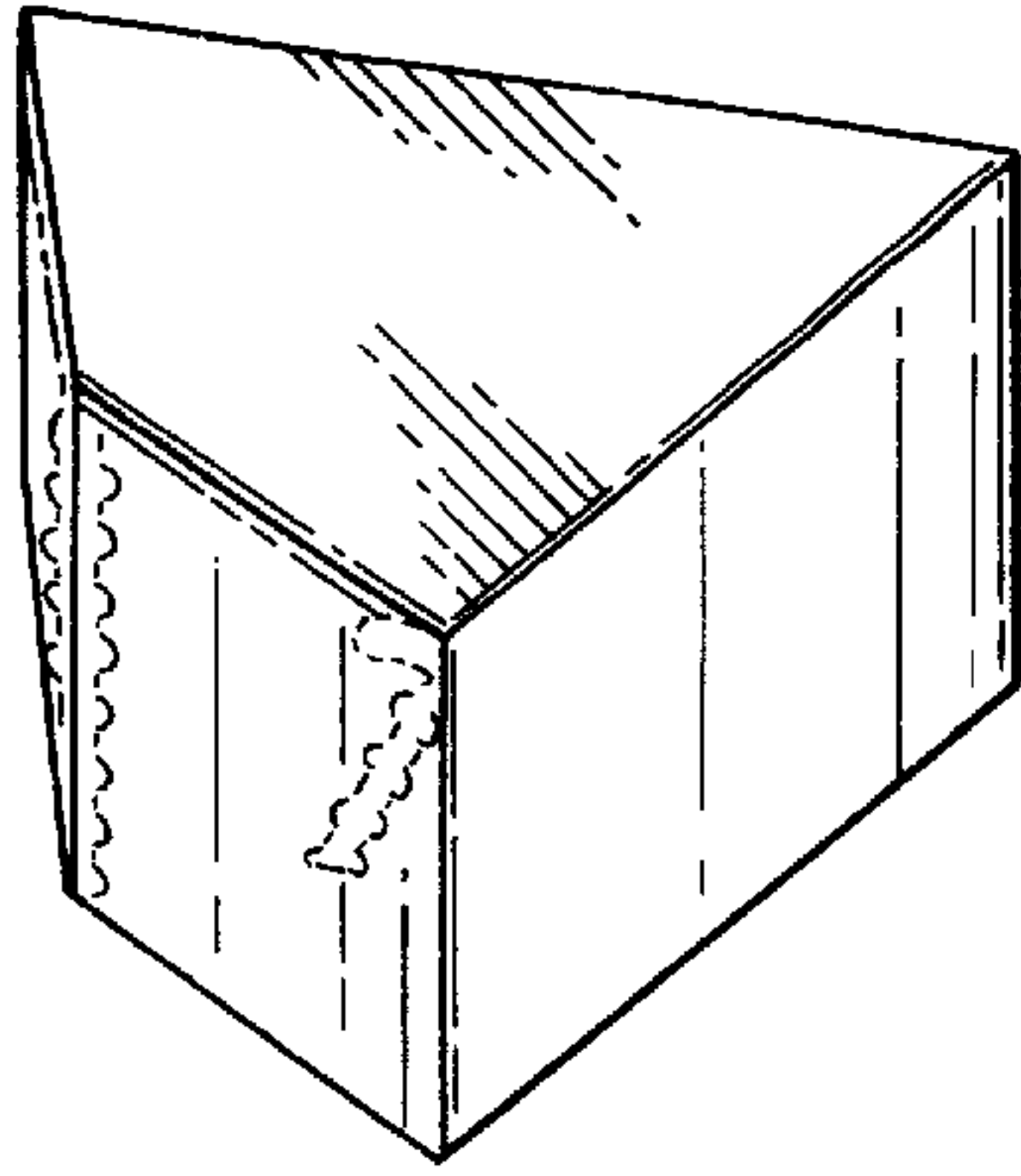

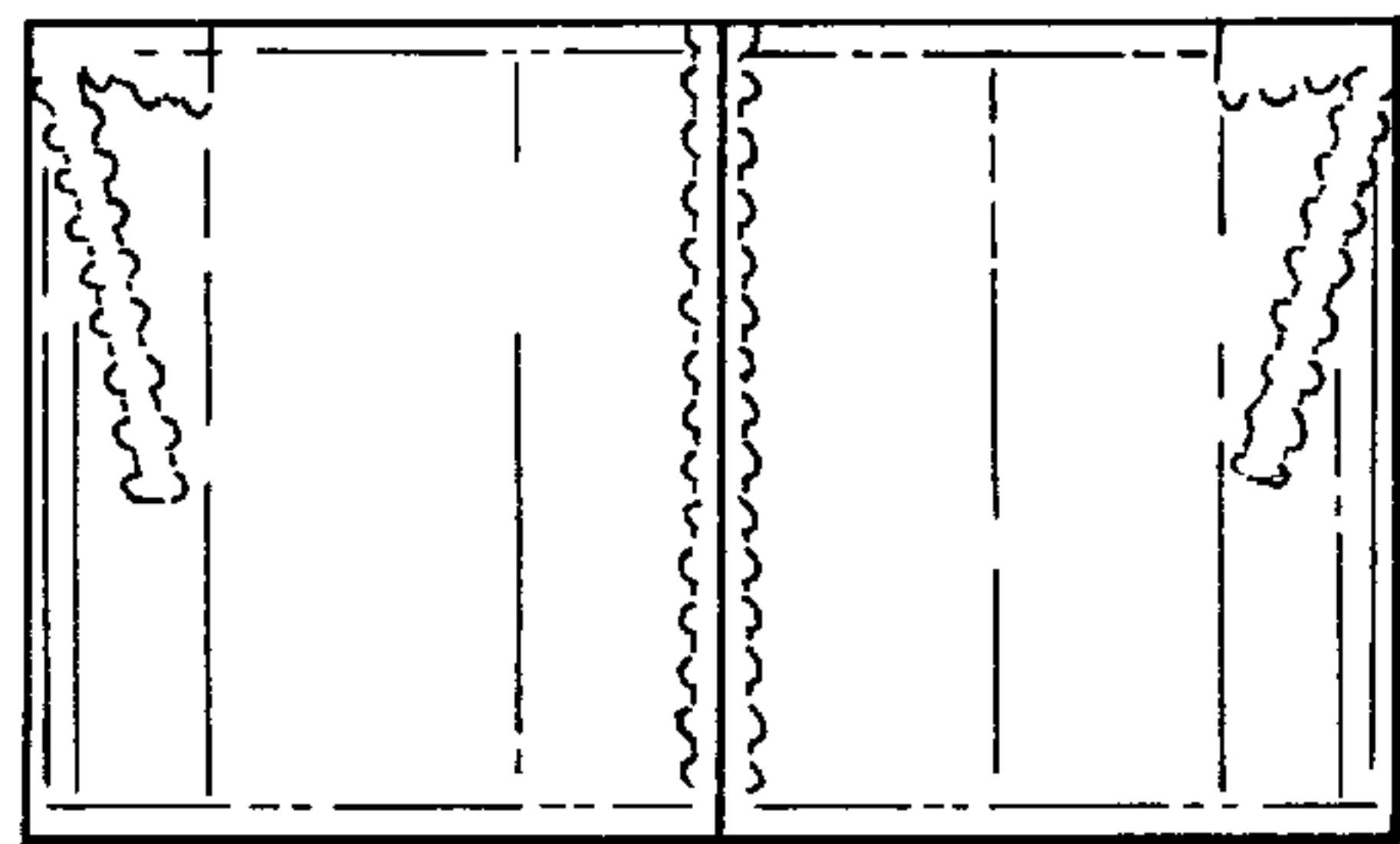
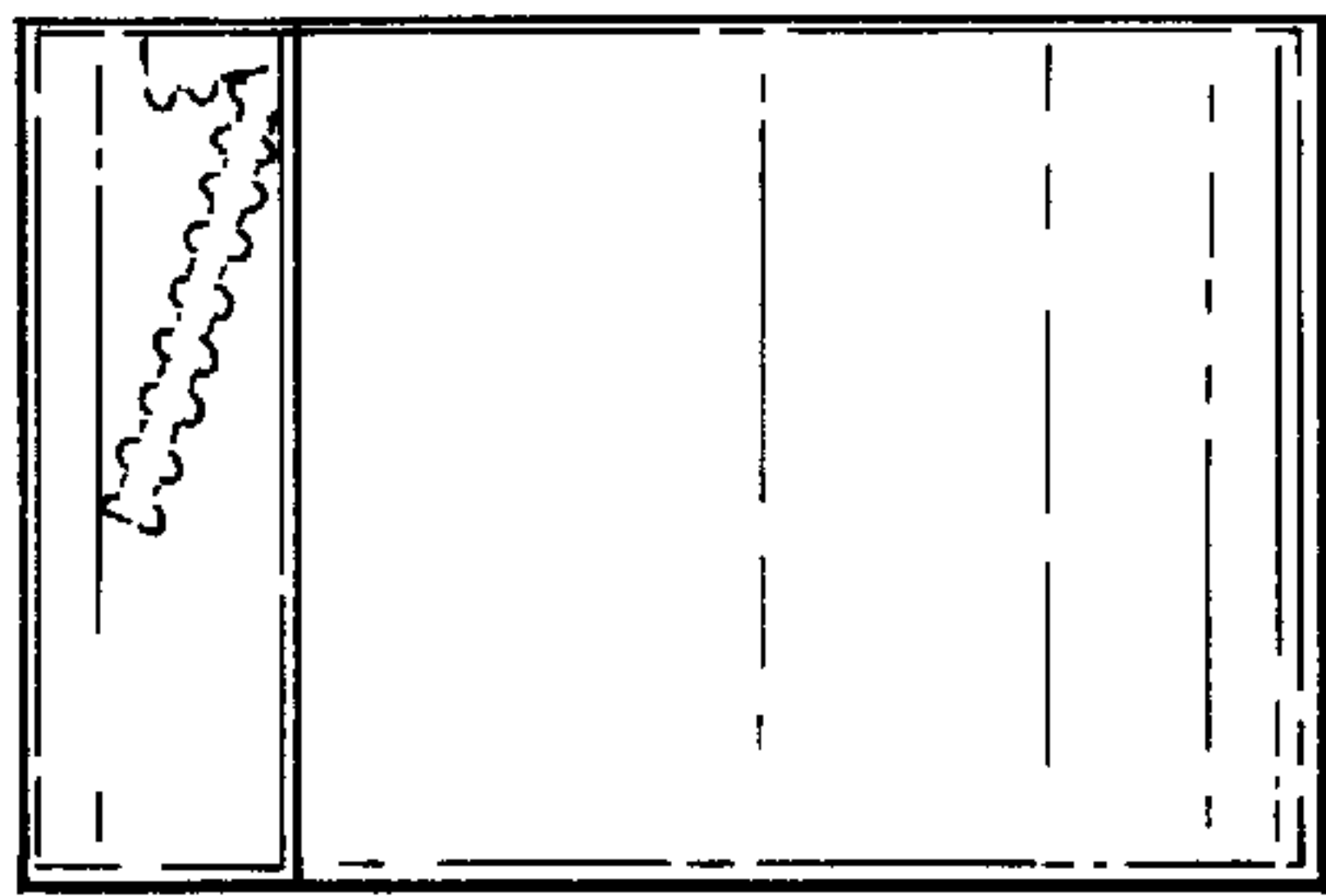
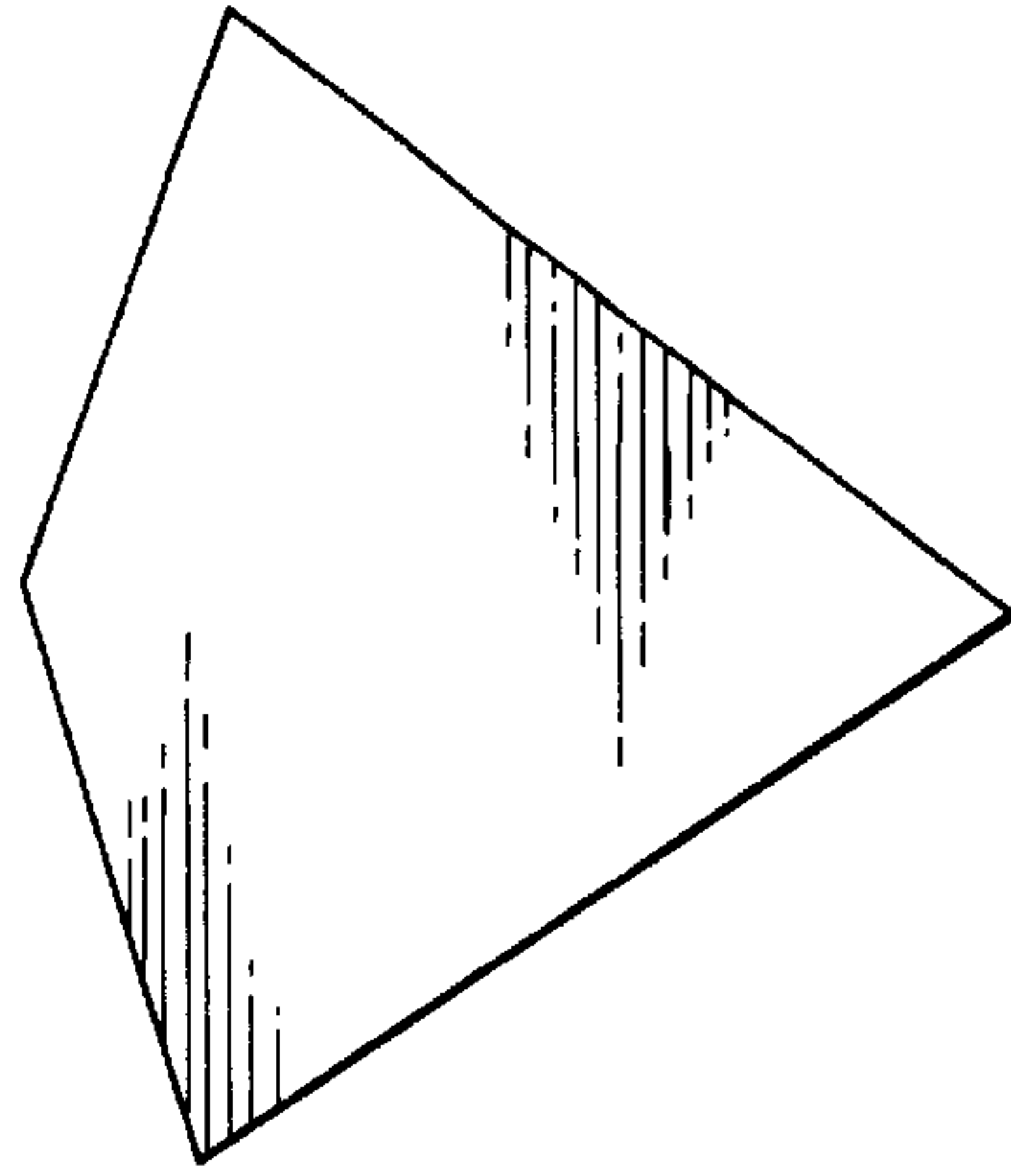

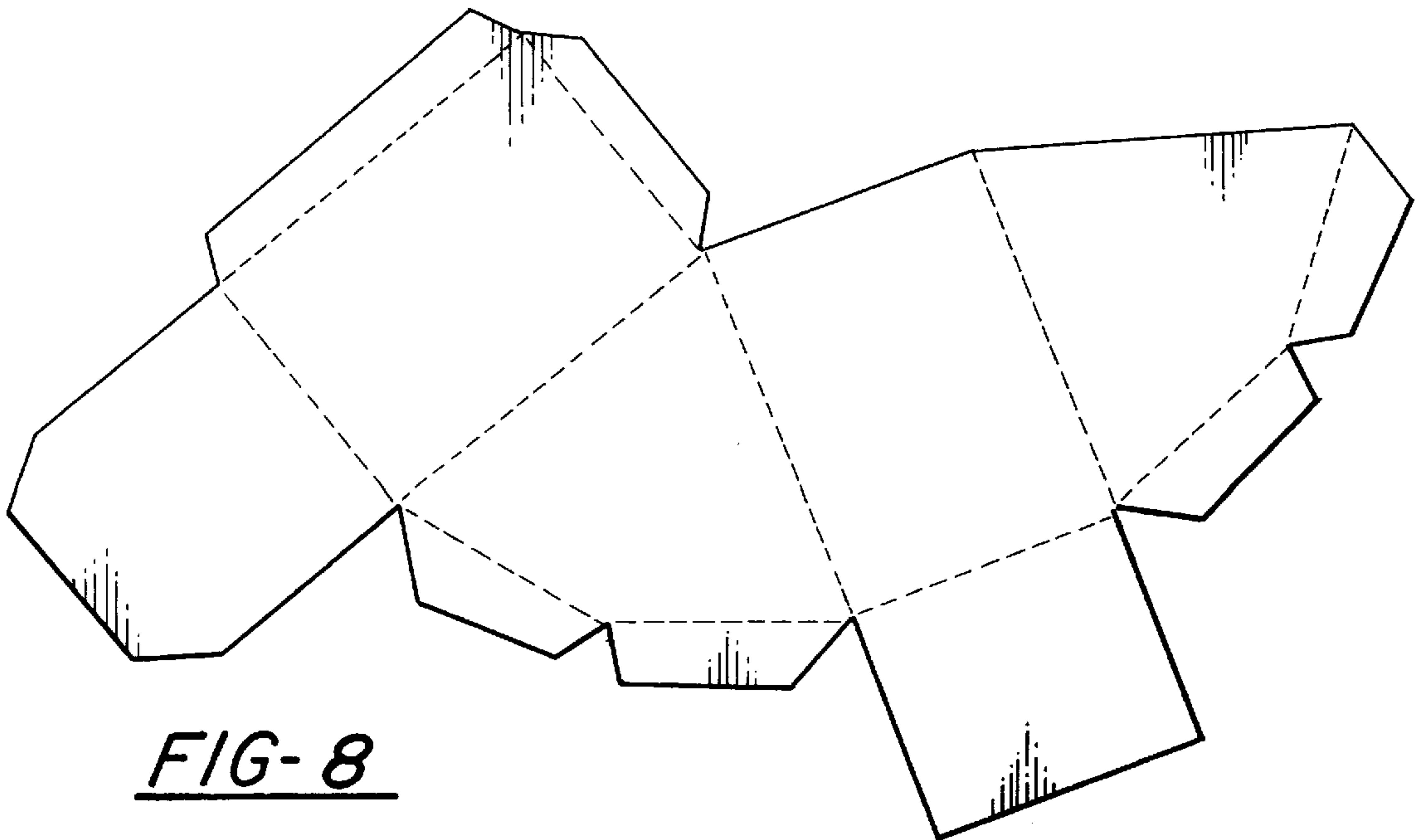
