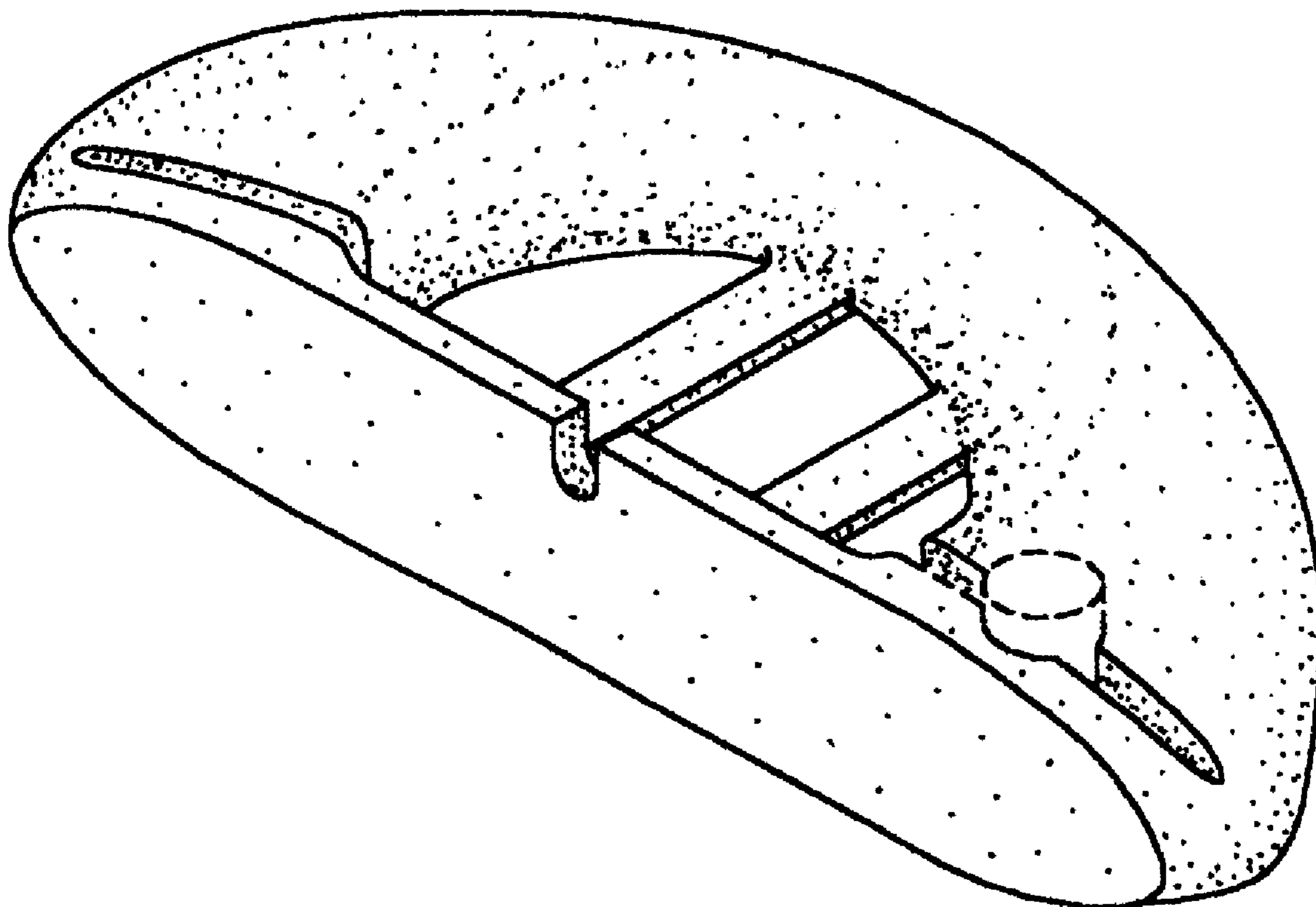
[57] **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a putter head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the putter head.
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the putter head.
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the putter head.
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the putter head.
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the putter head.
FIG. 6 is a top right perspective view of the putter head; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom left perspective view of the putter head.
The broken line showing of fragmented shaft in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

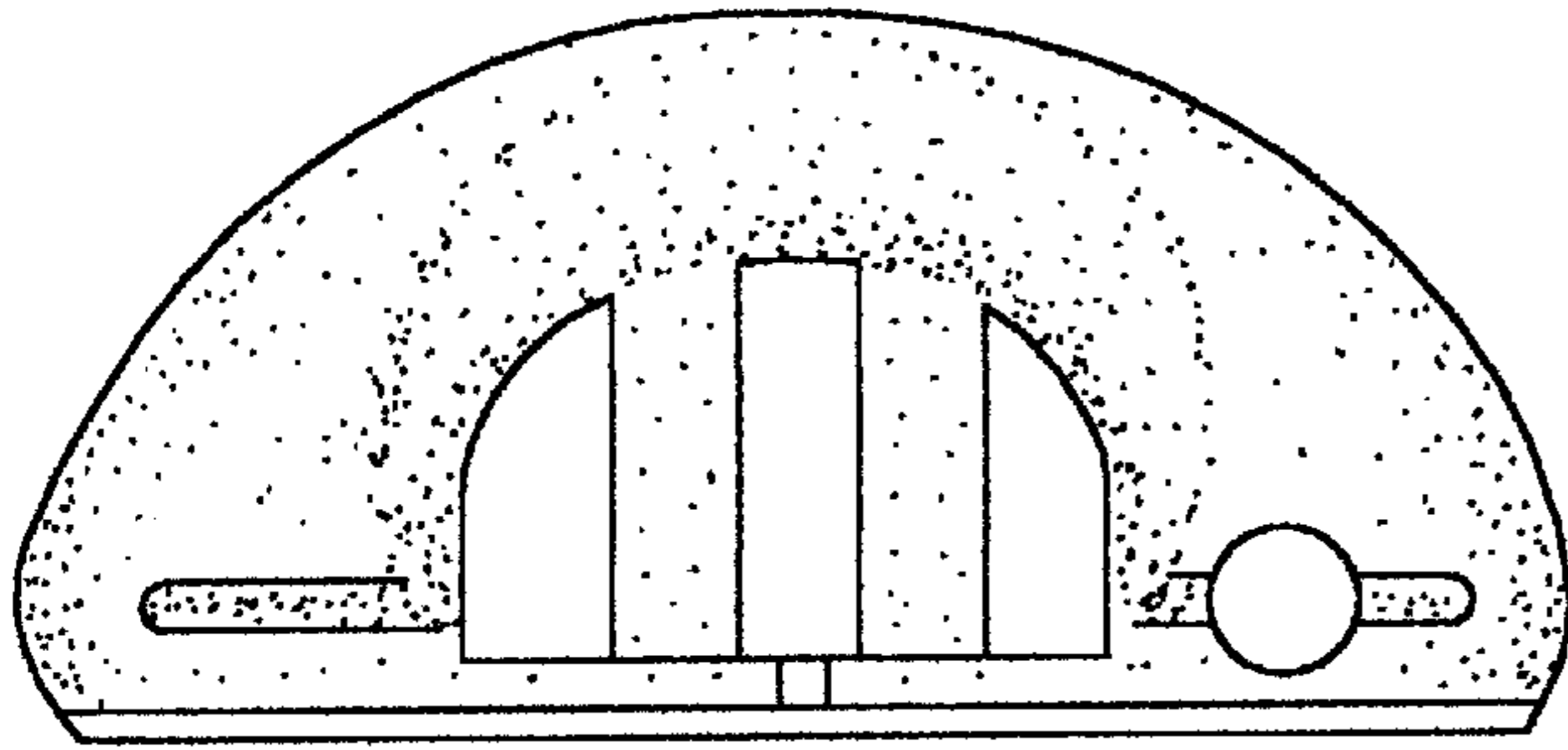

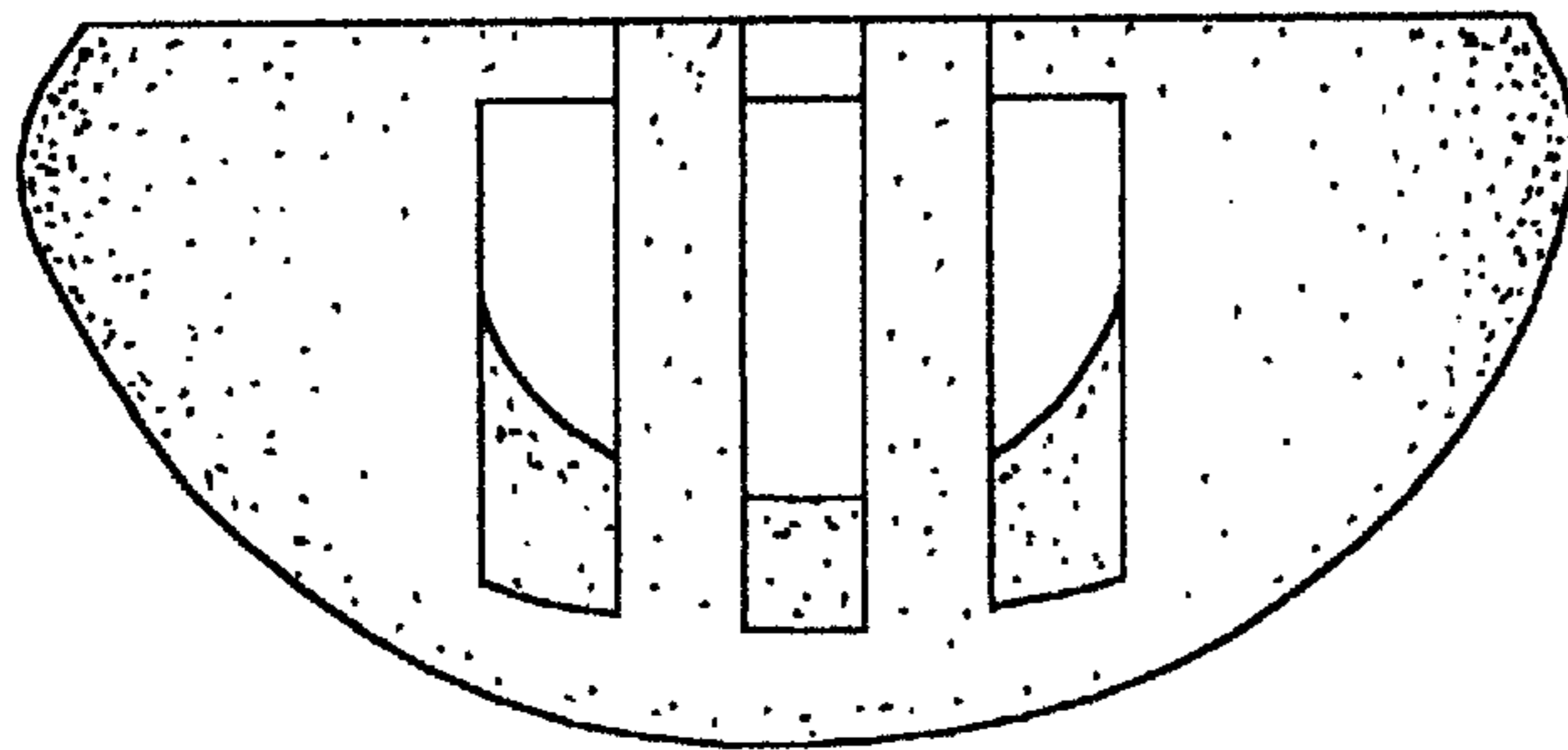

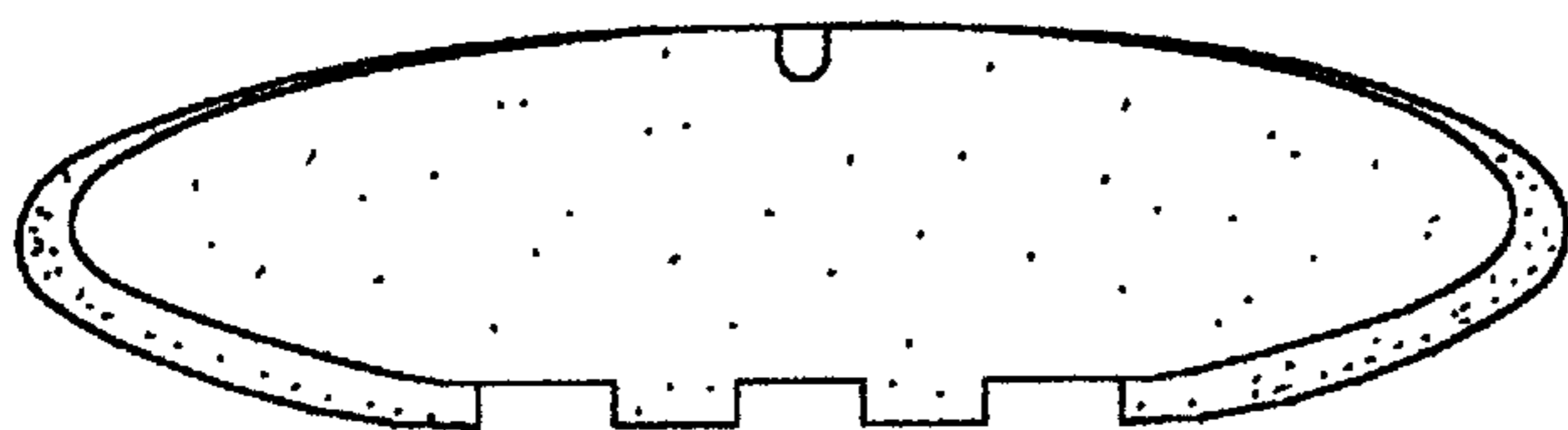

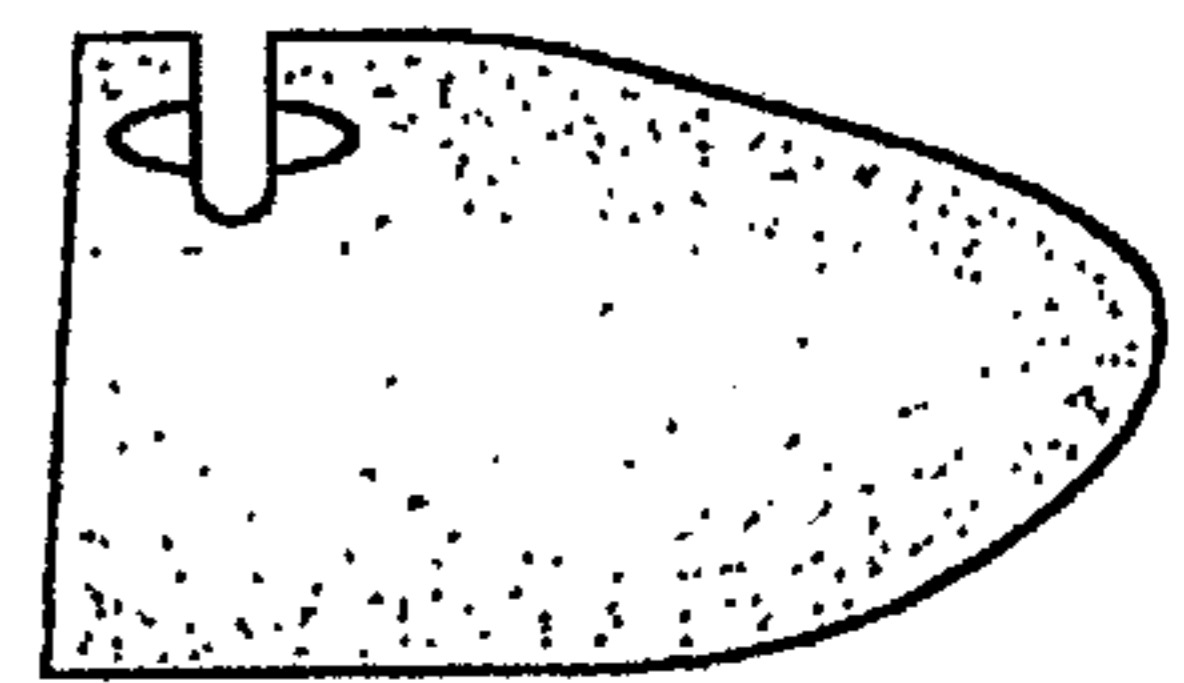

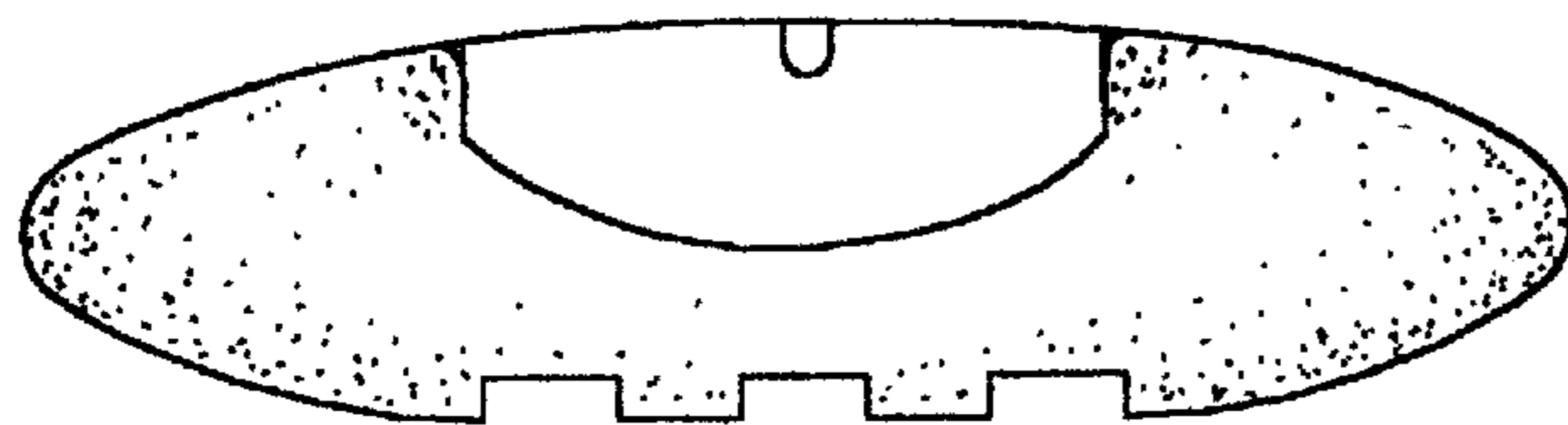

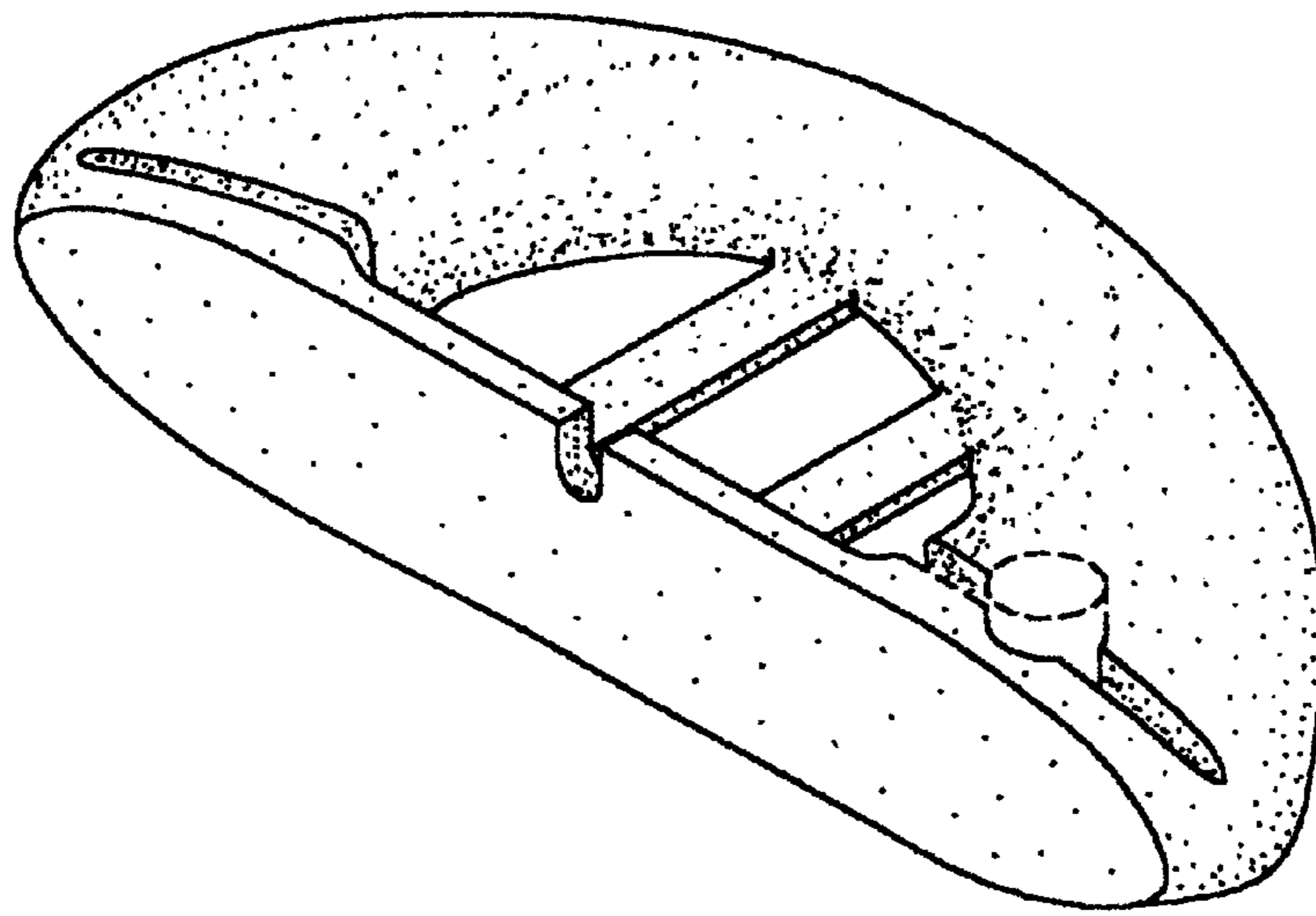

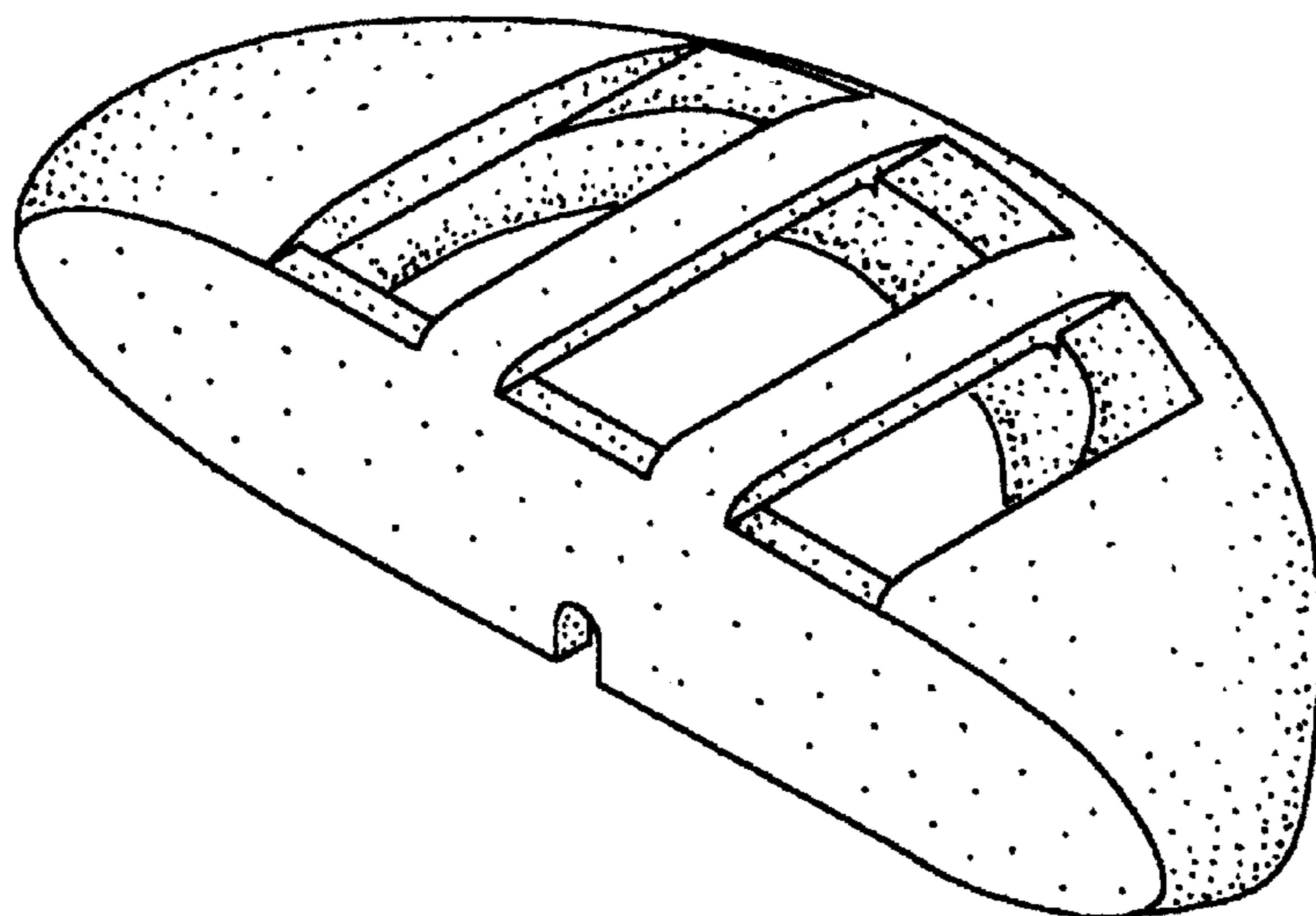
