The ornamental design for a lighting fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lighting fixture constructed in accordance with the invention;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1;

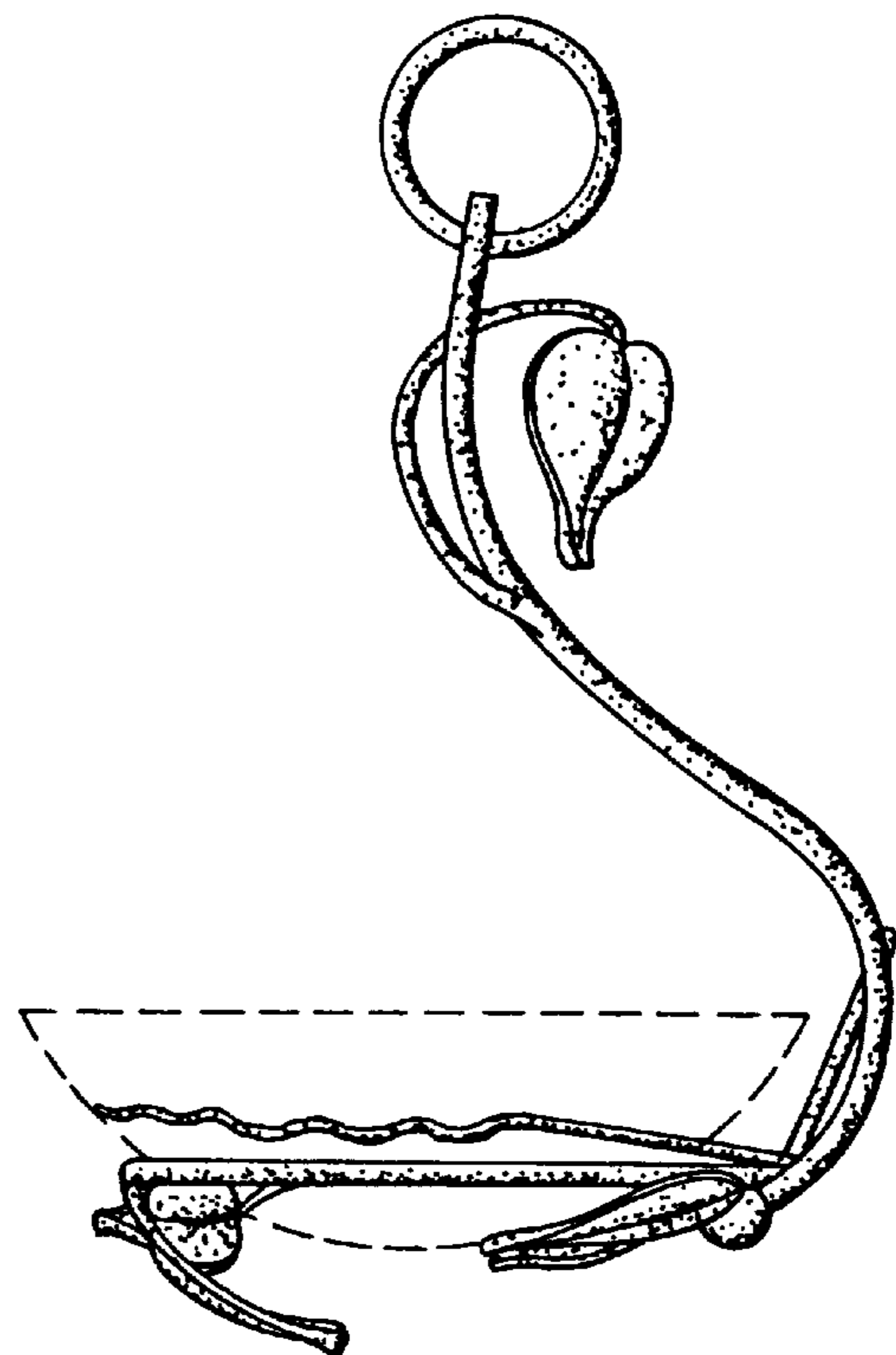
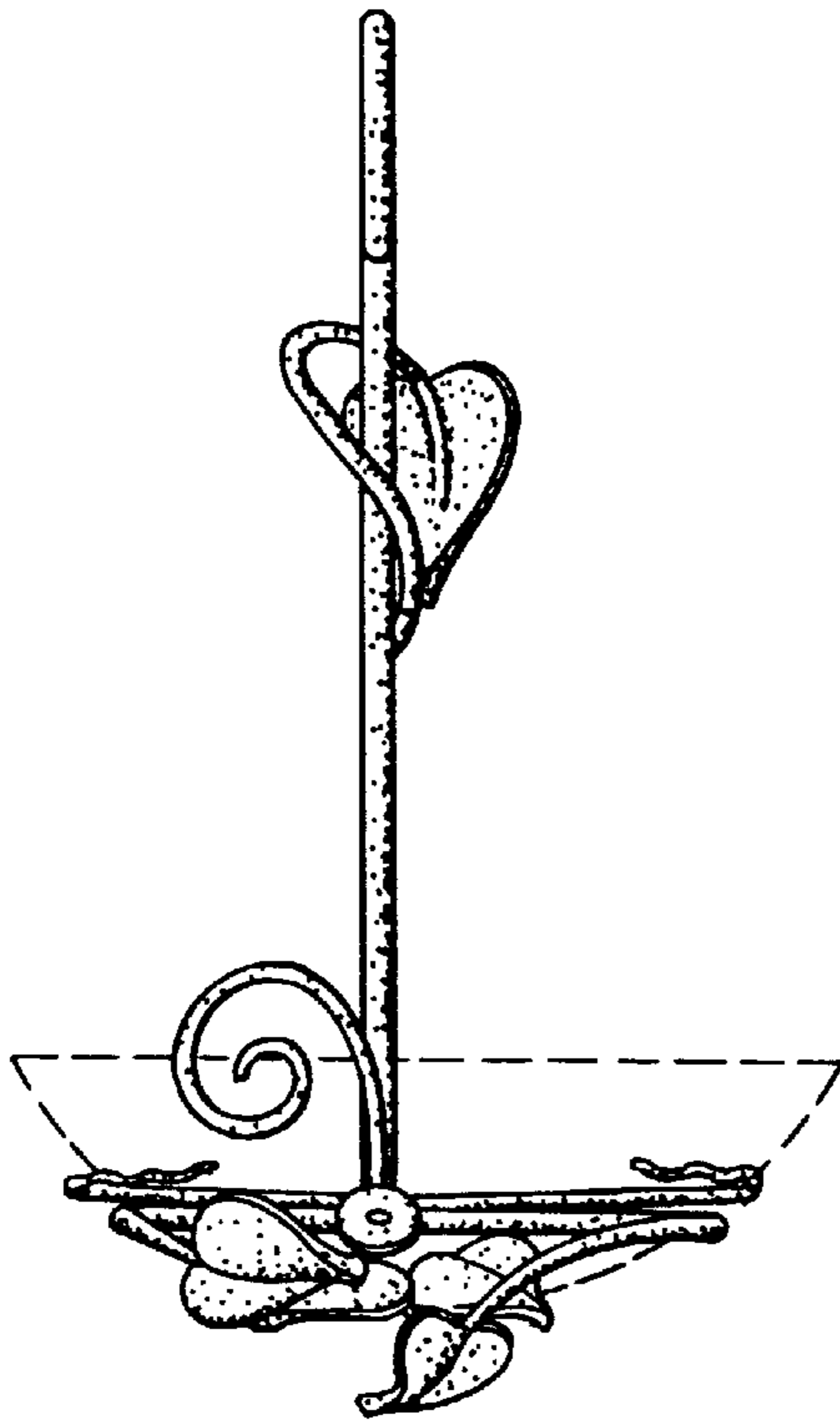
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the lighting fixture of FIG. 1;

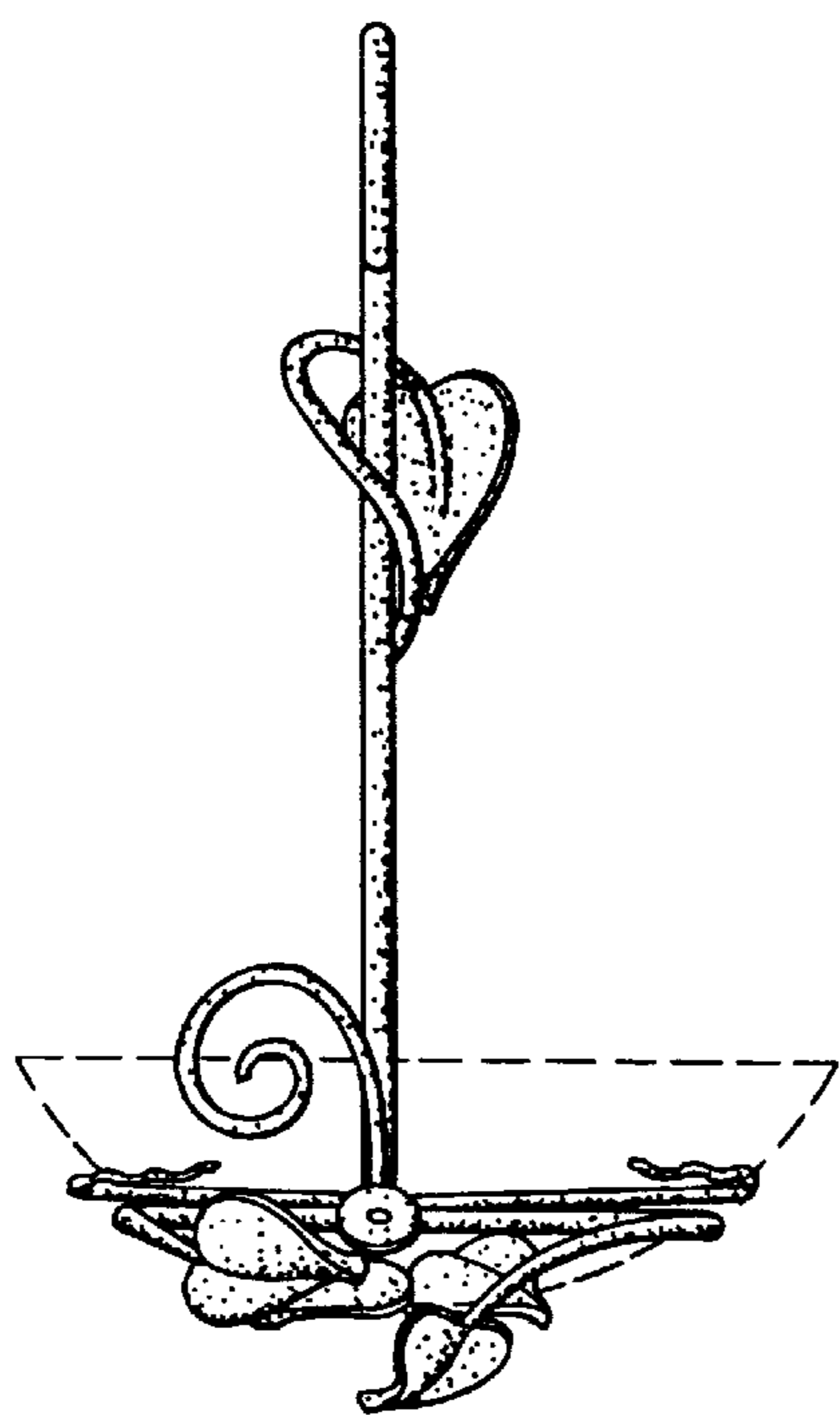

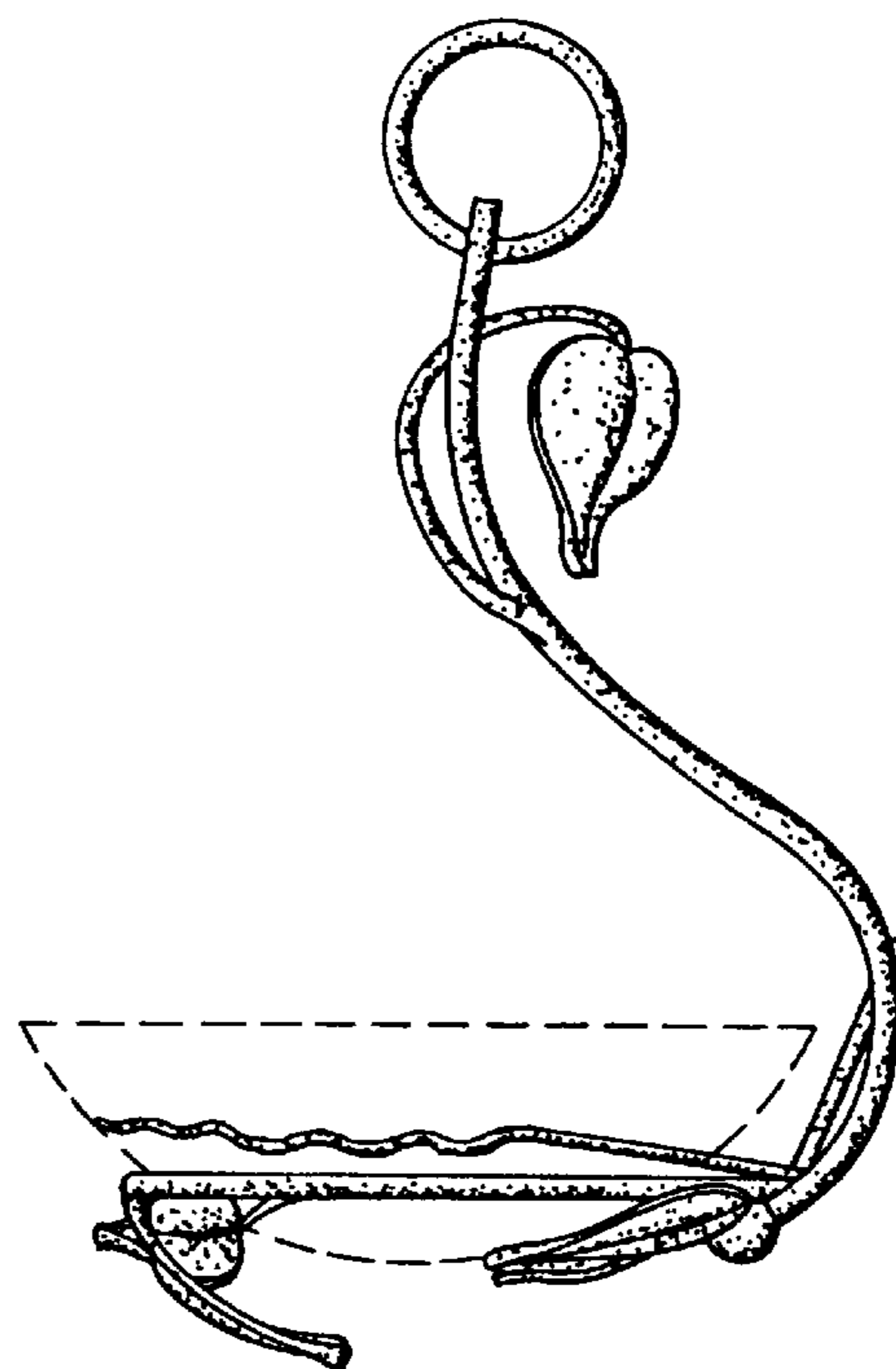

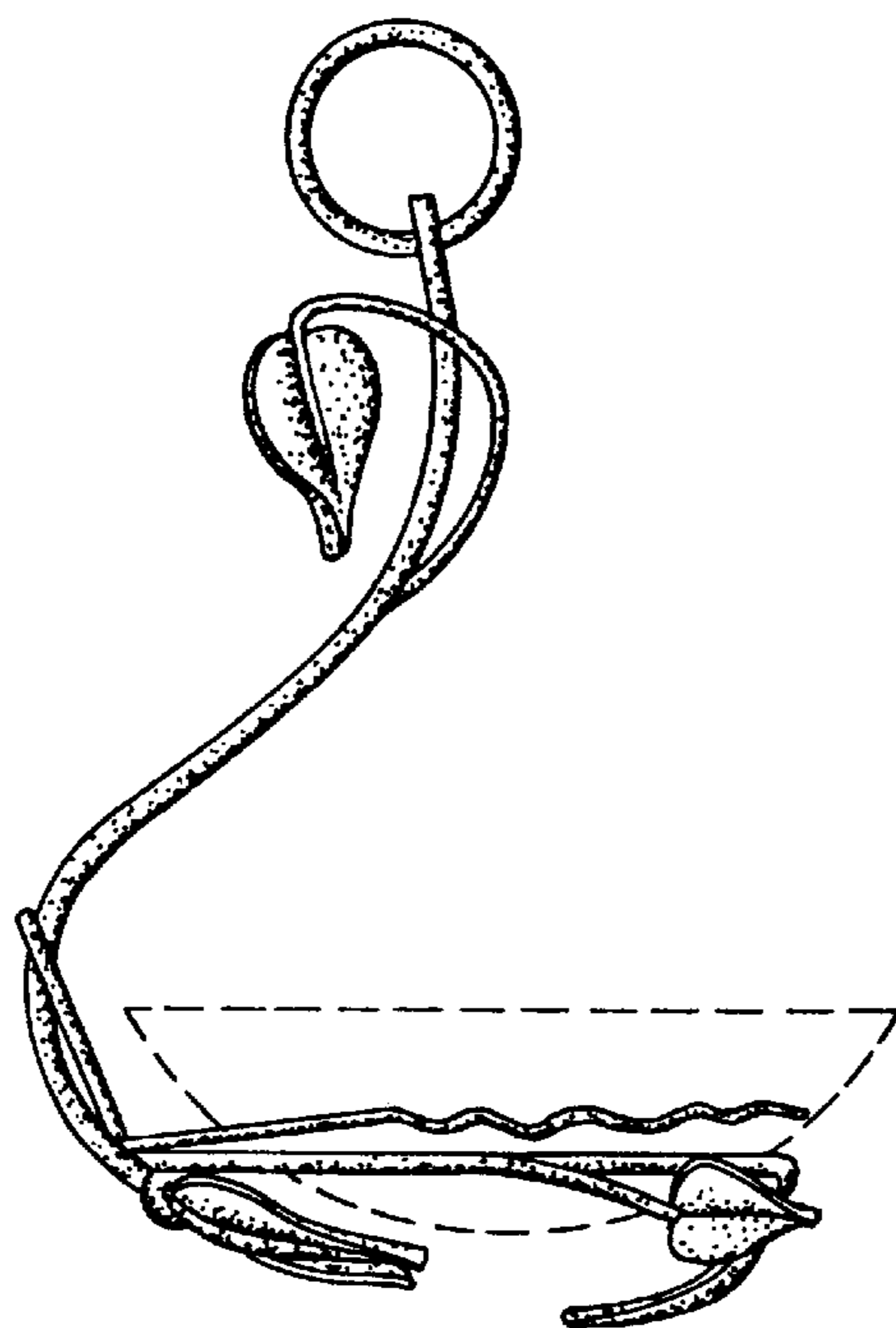

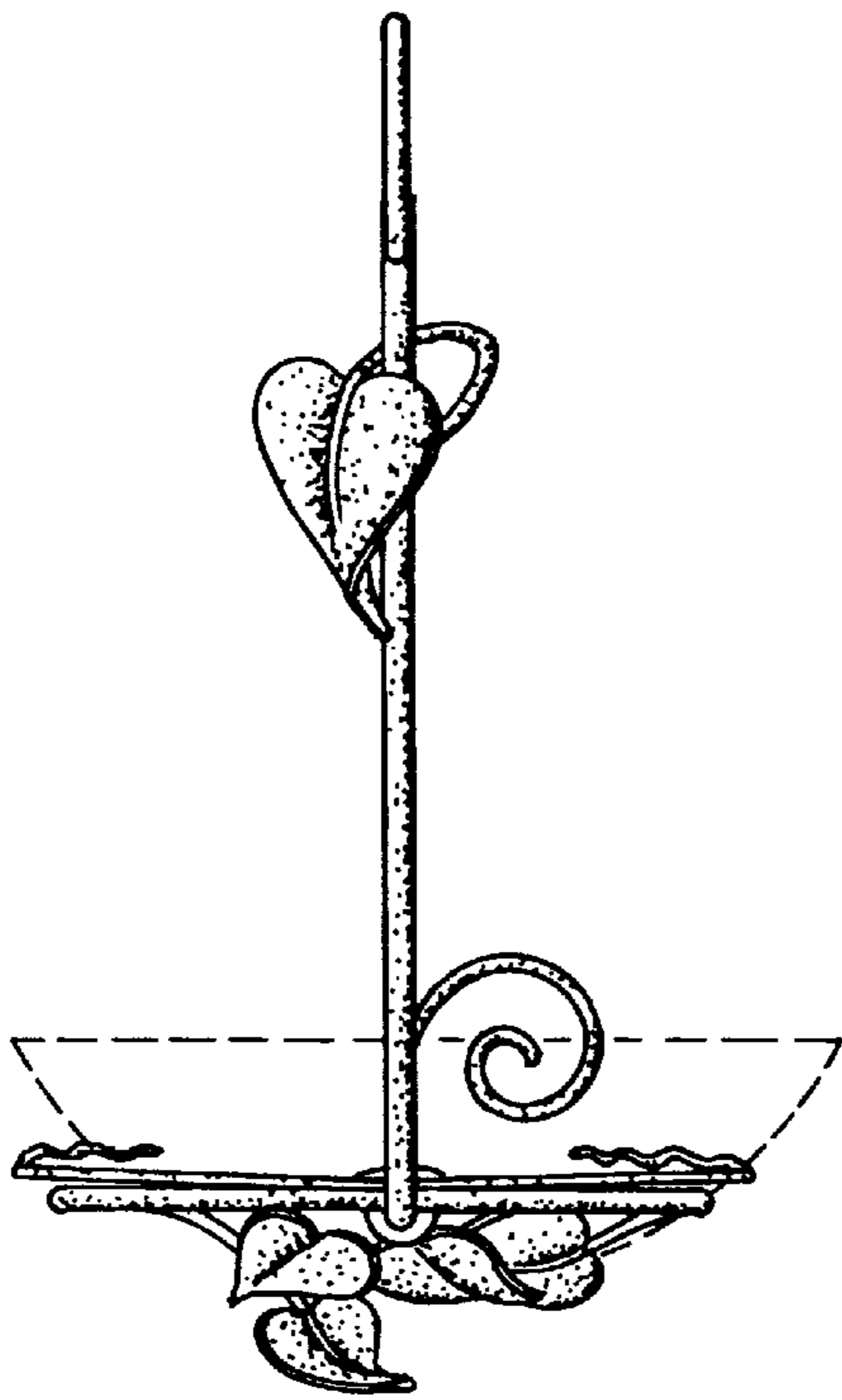

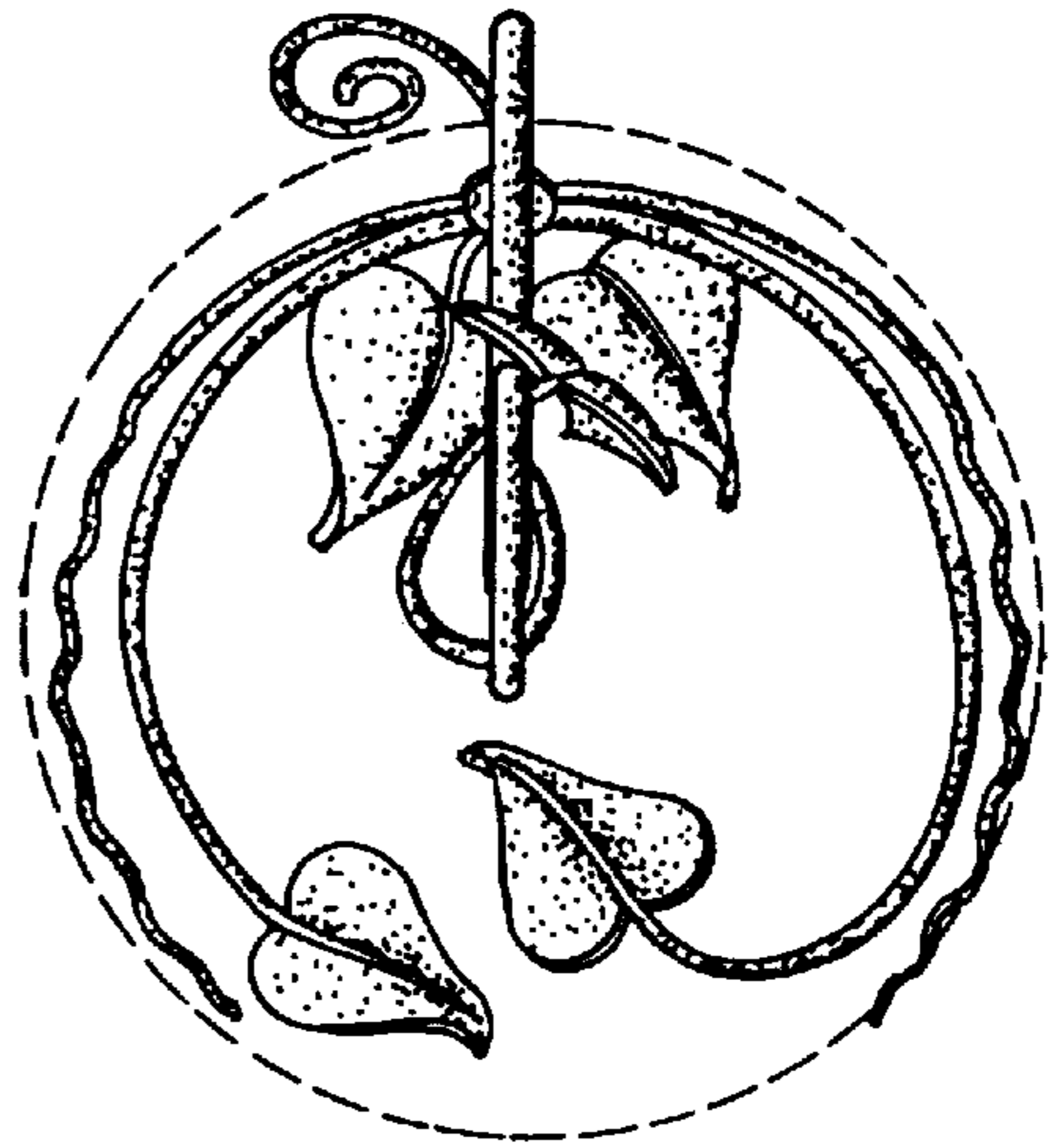

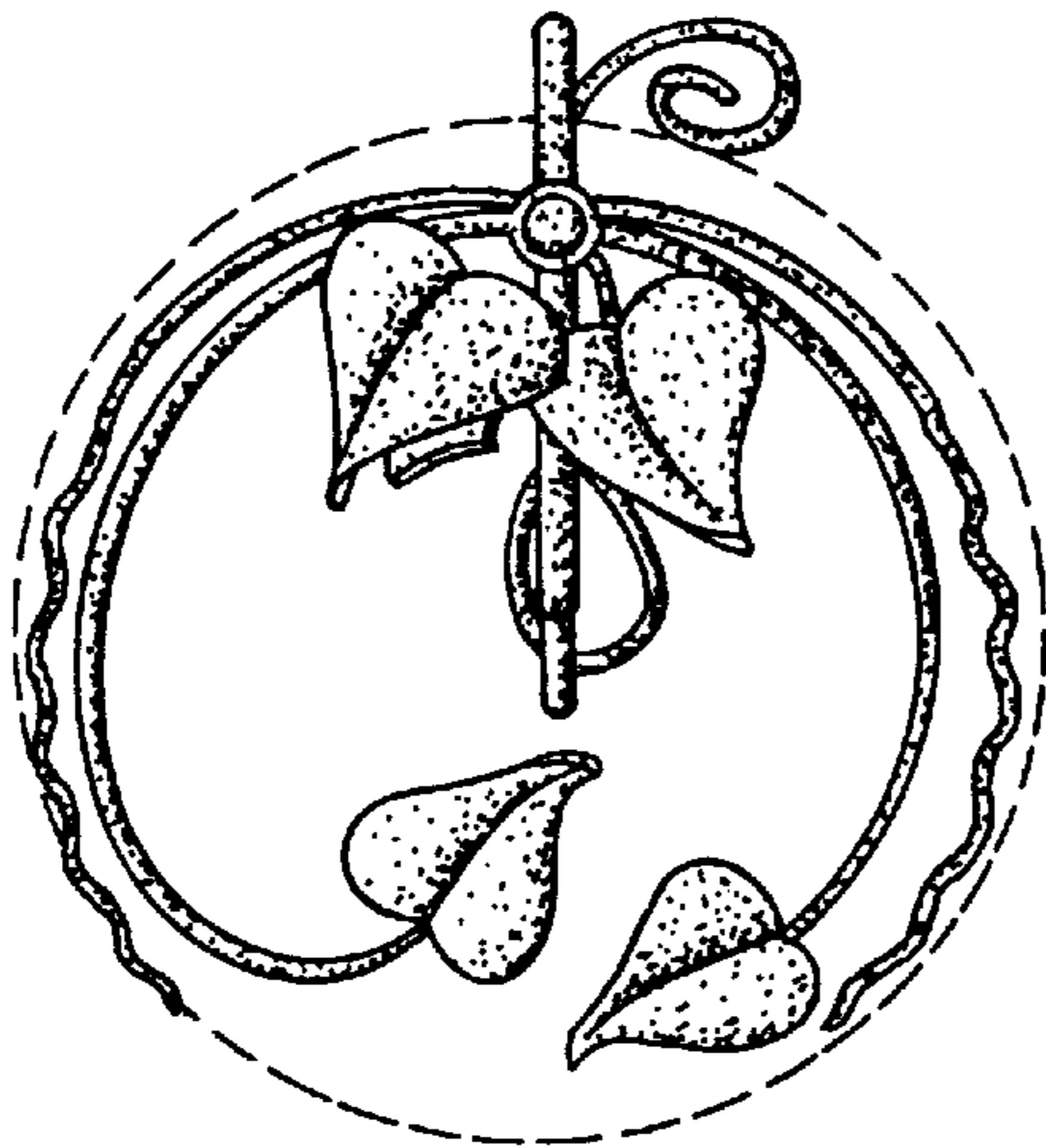
