DESCRIPTION

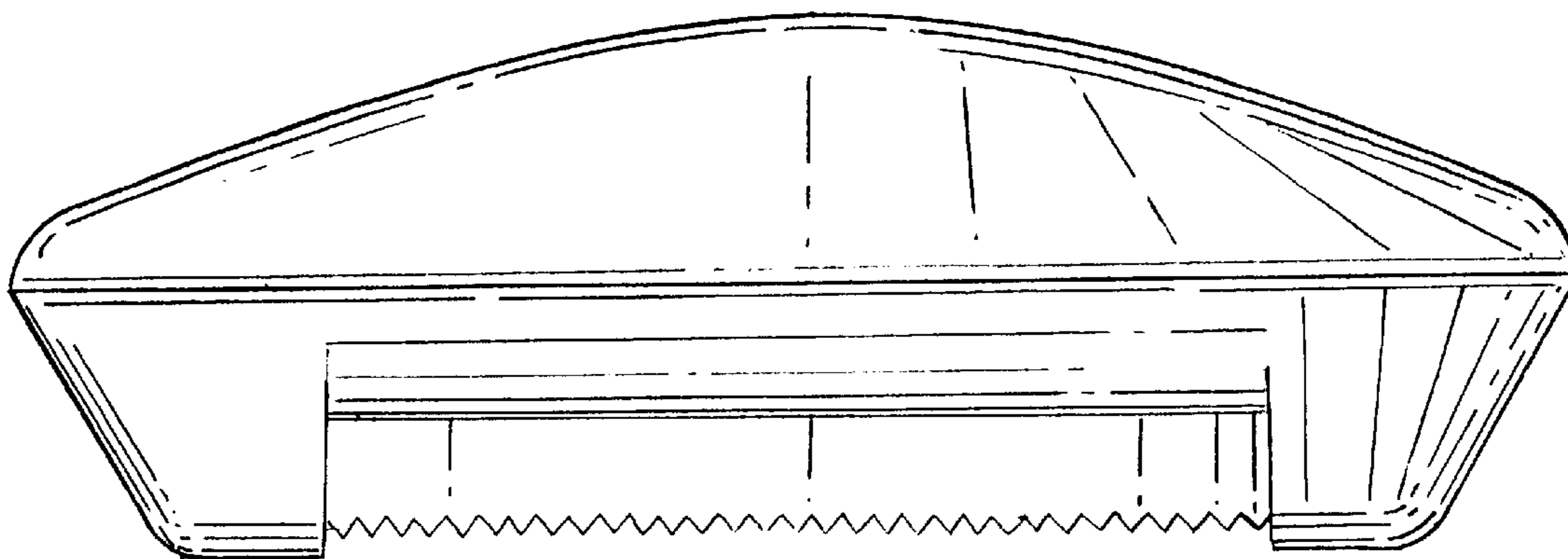
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a animal grooming tool showing our new design.

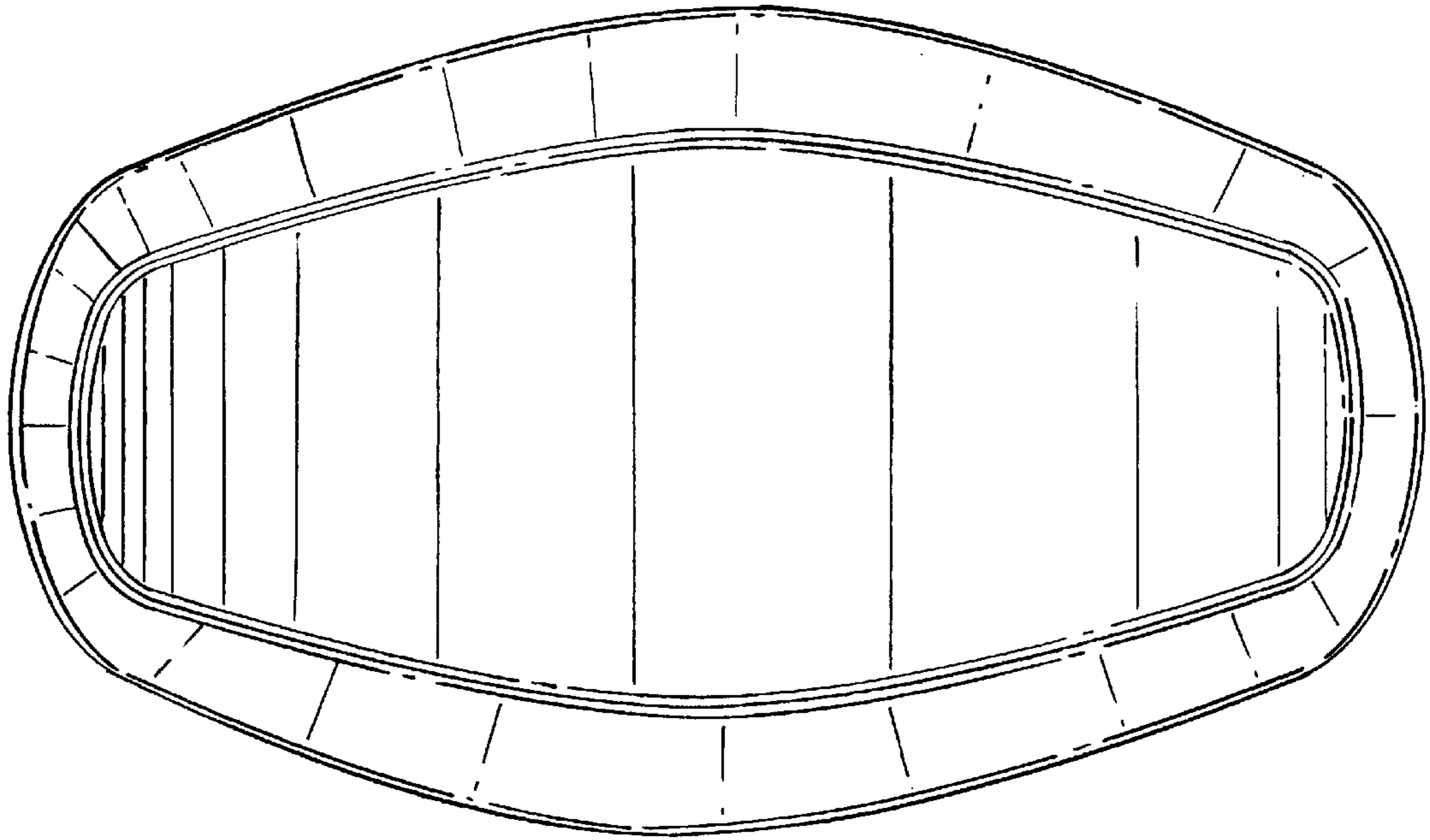

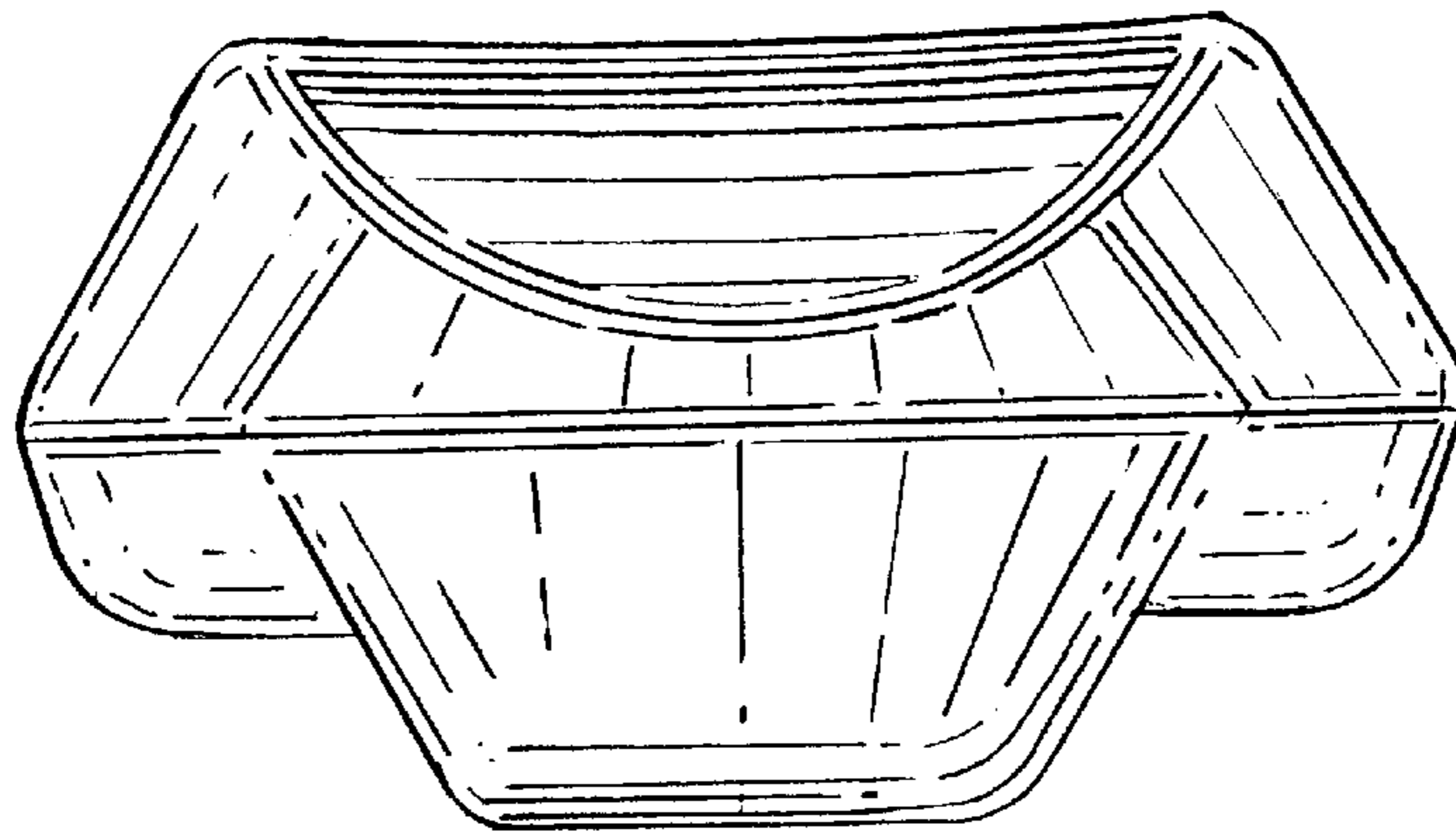

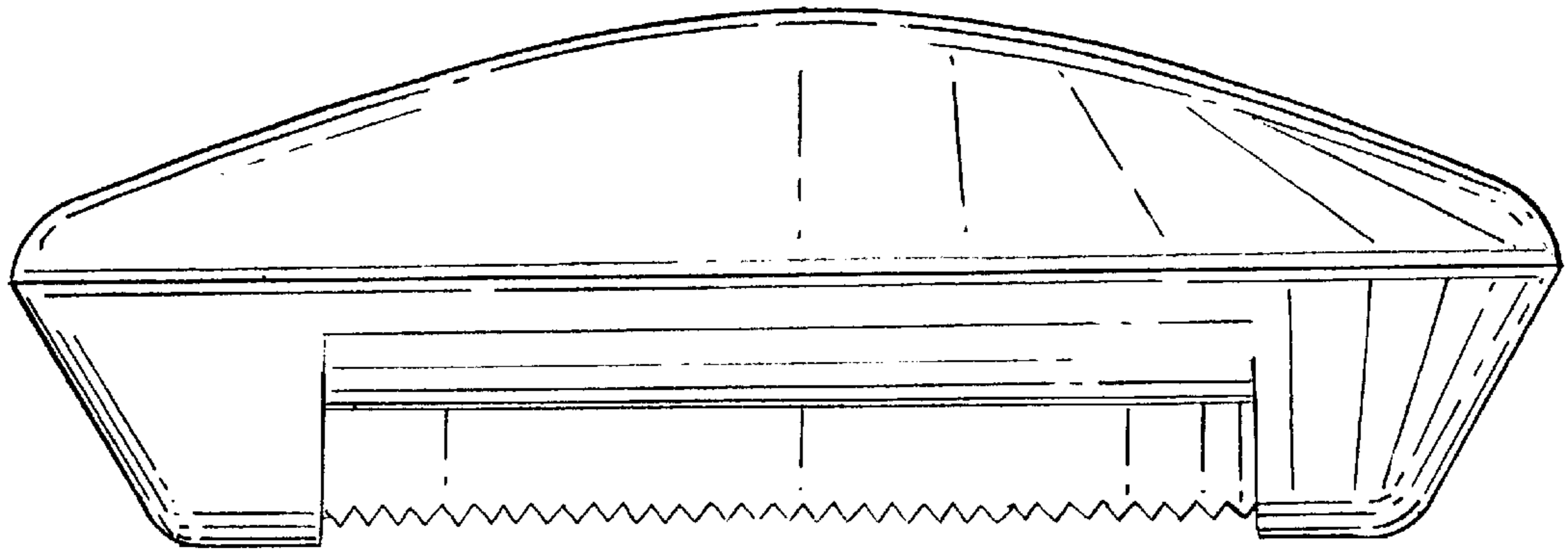

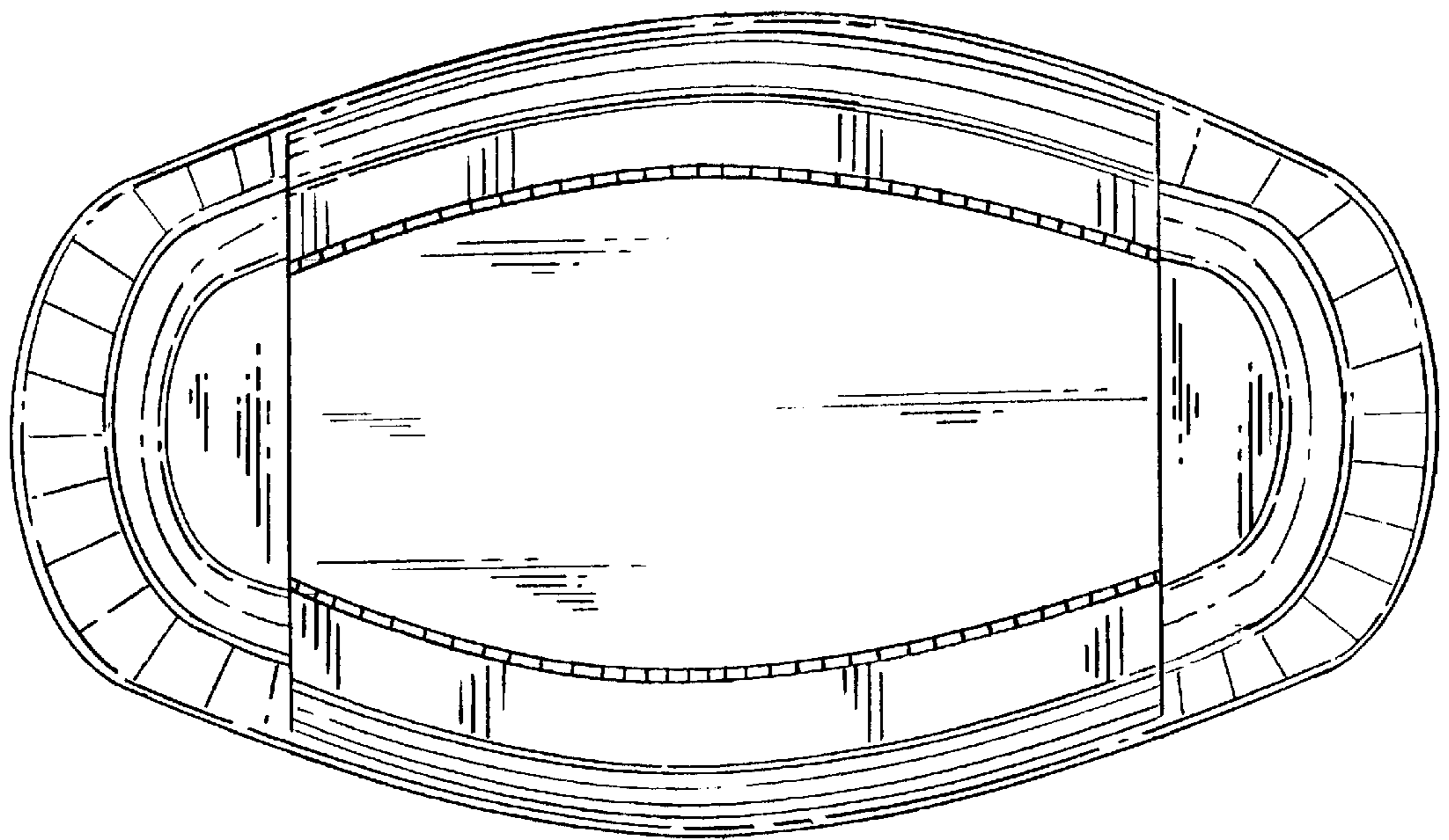
