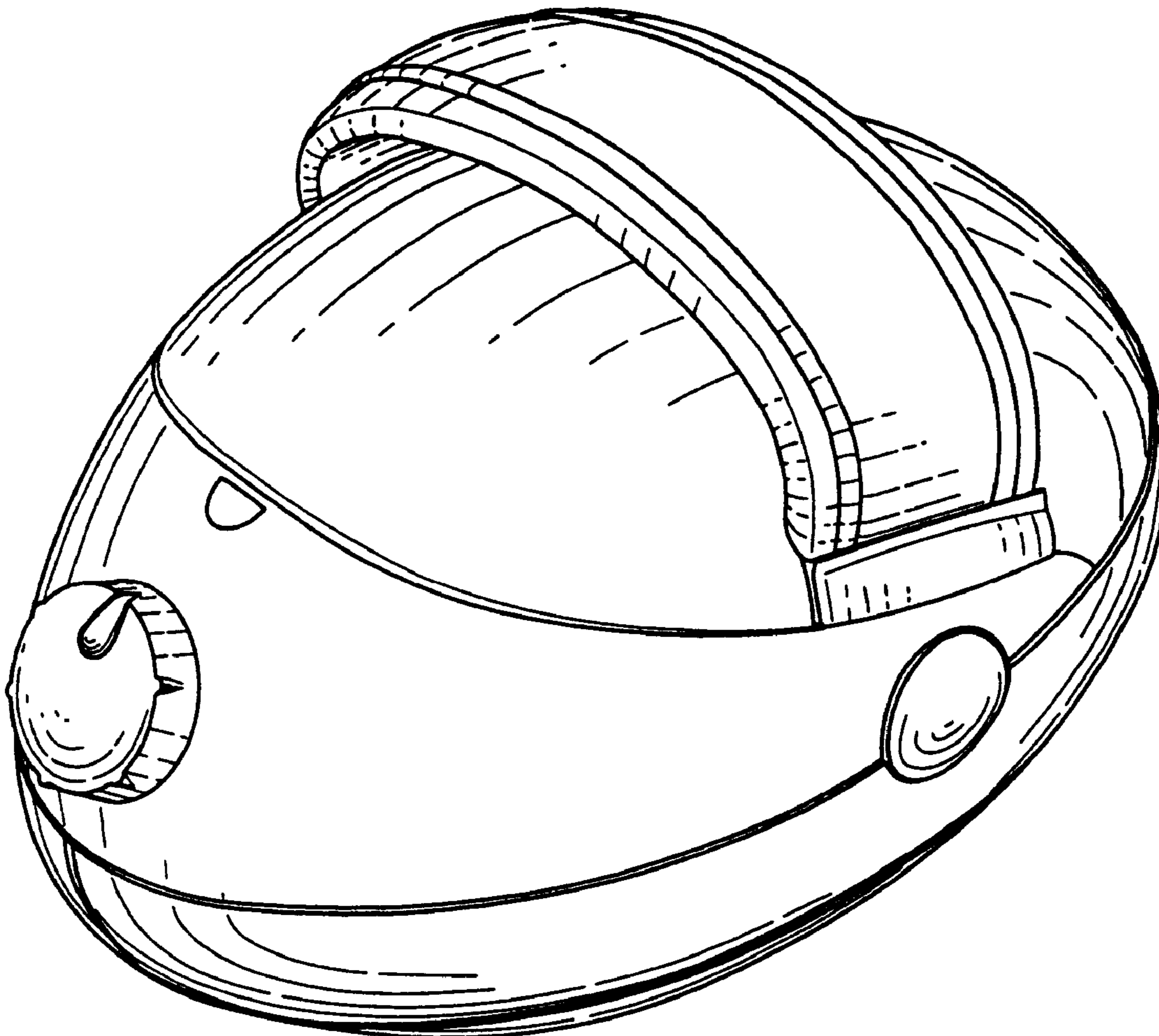
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cellulite reducing device, showing my new design;

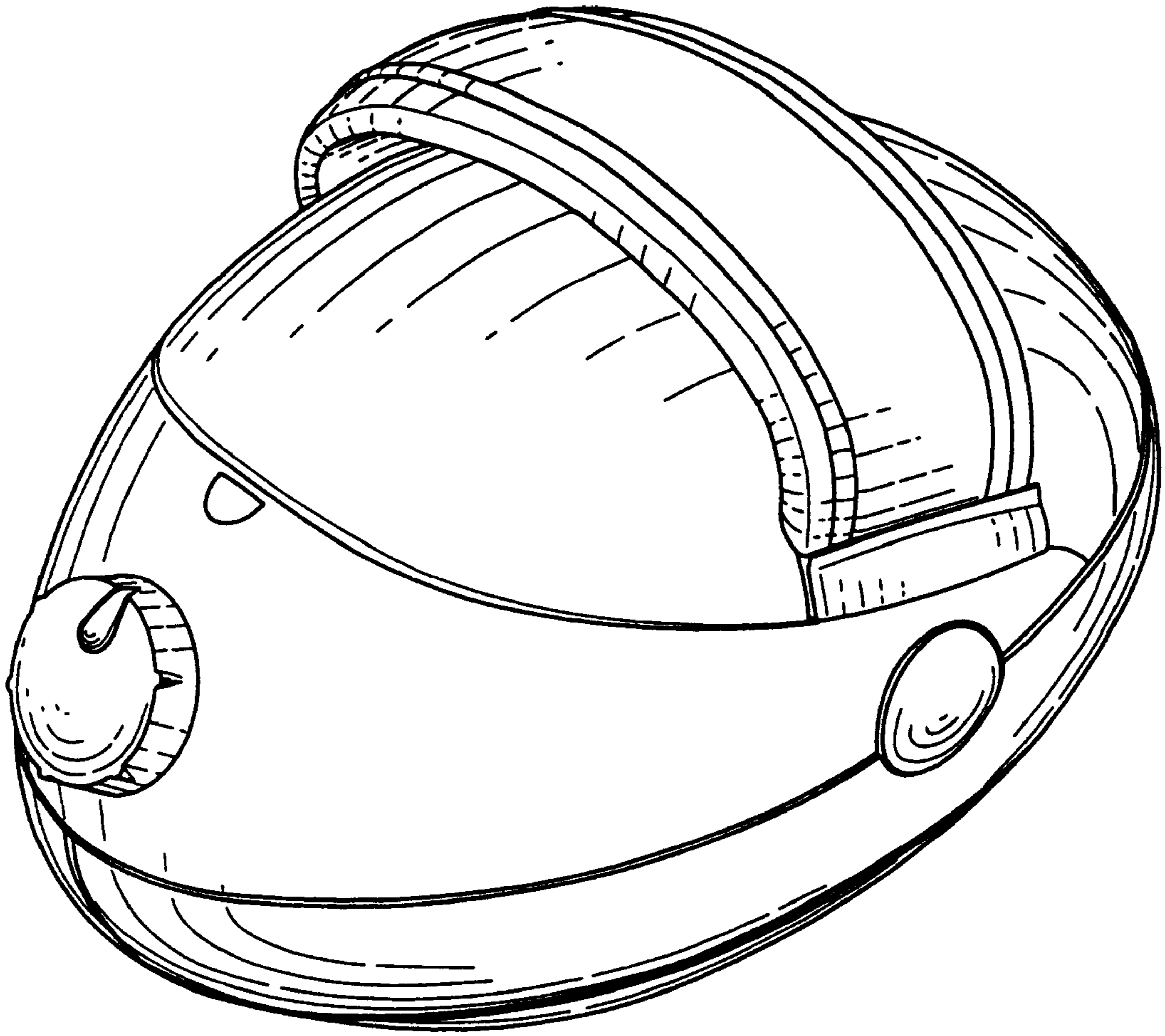

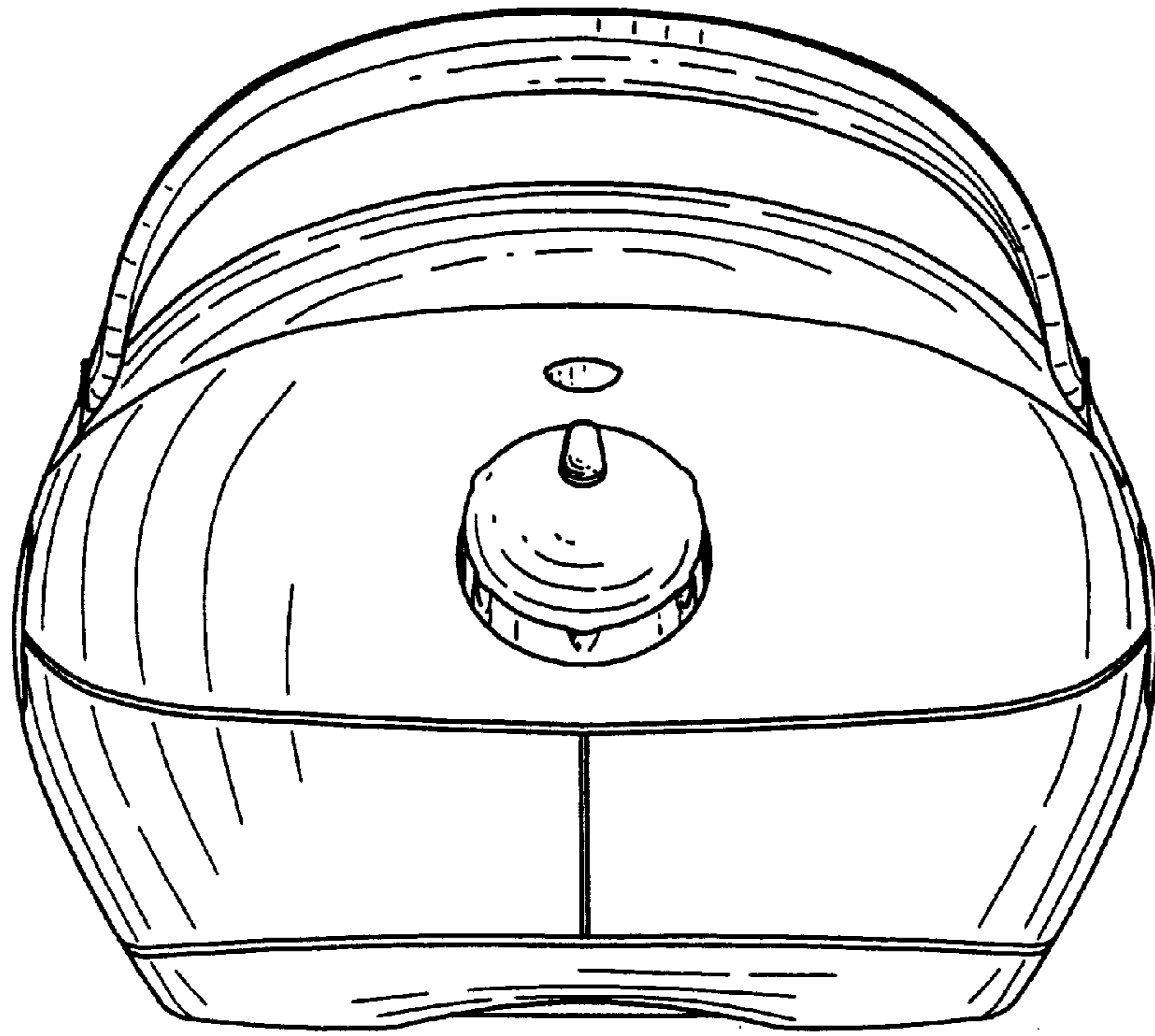

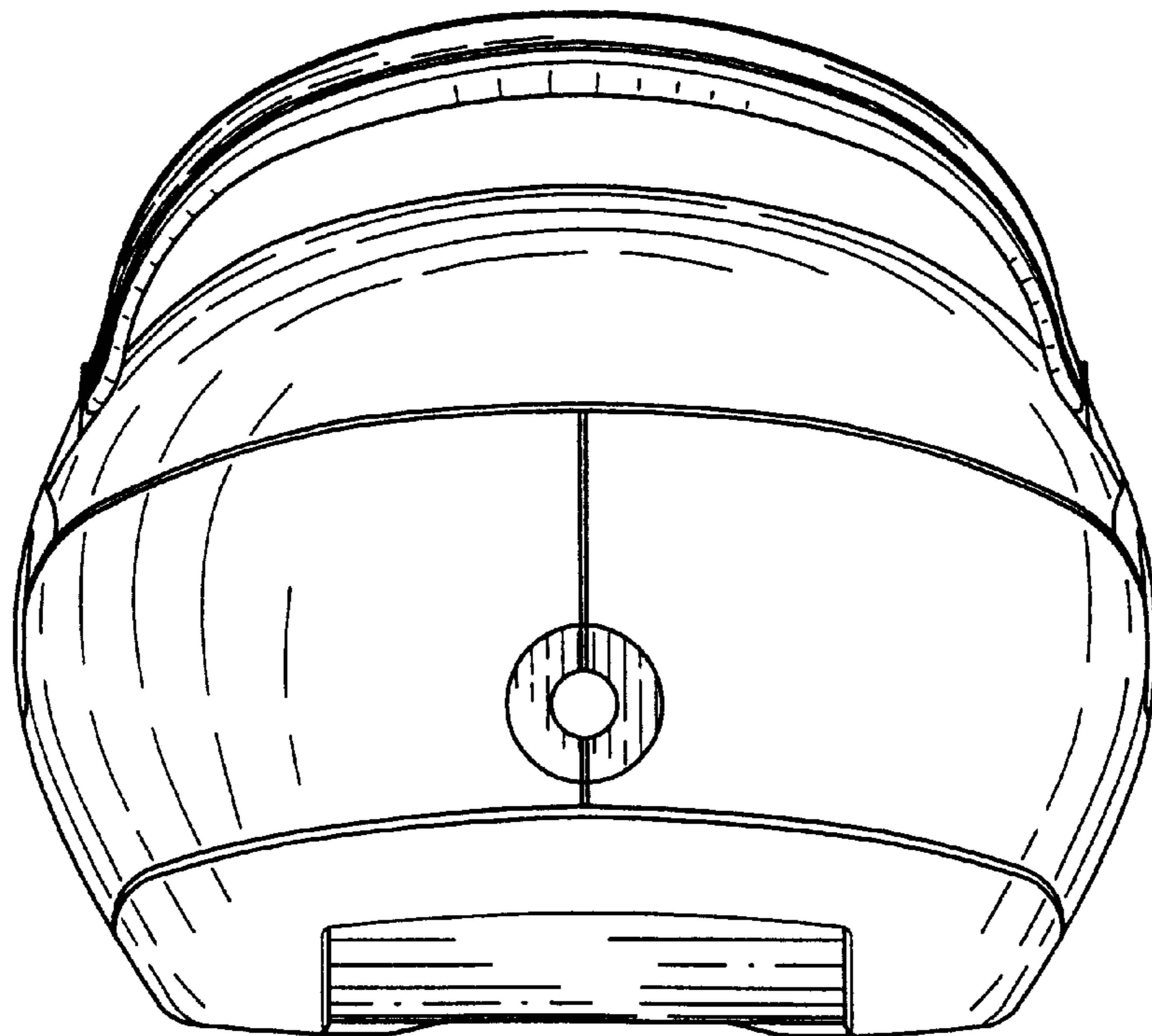

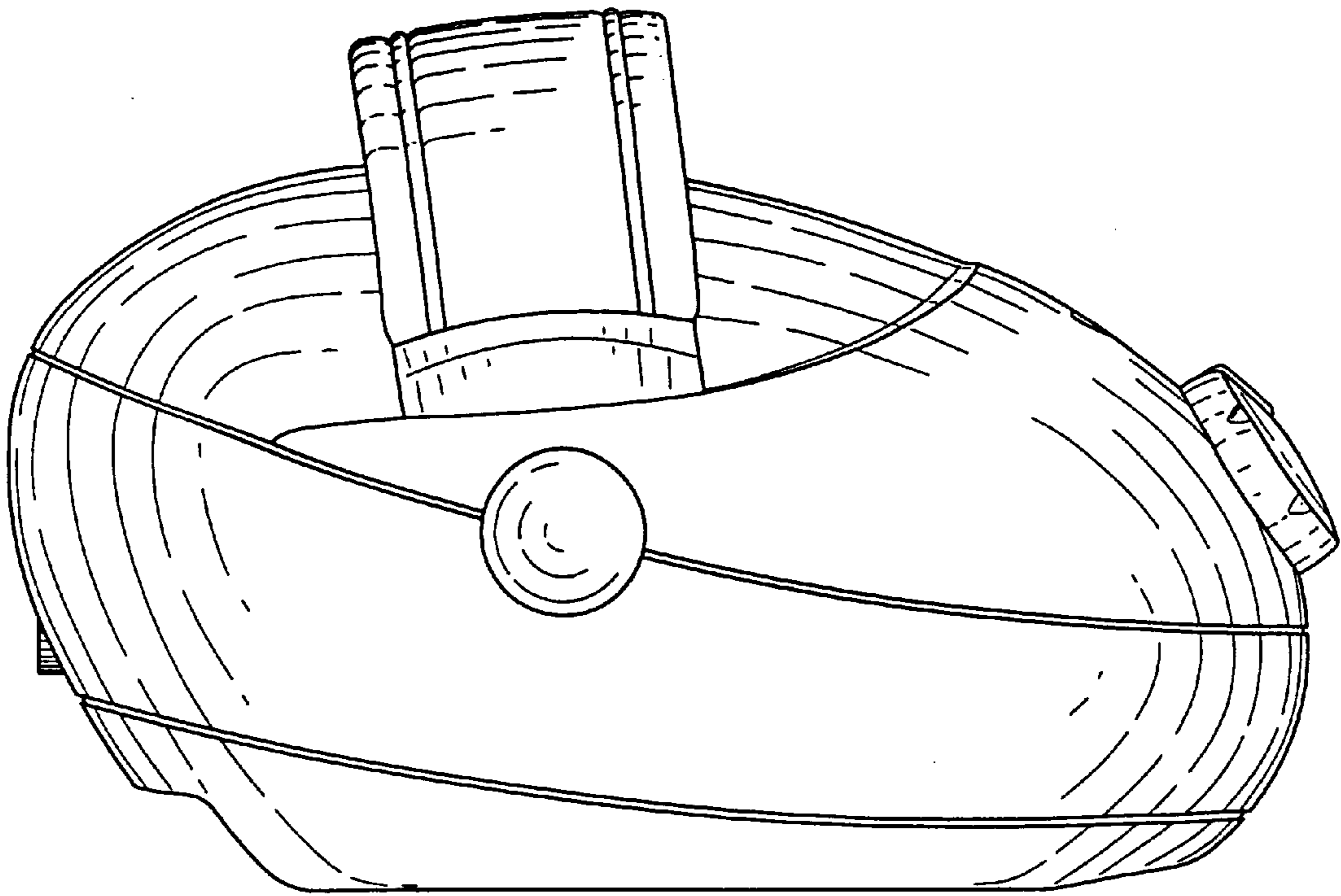

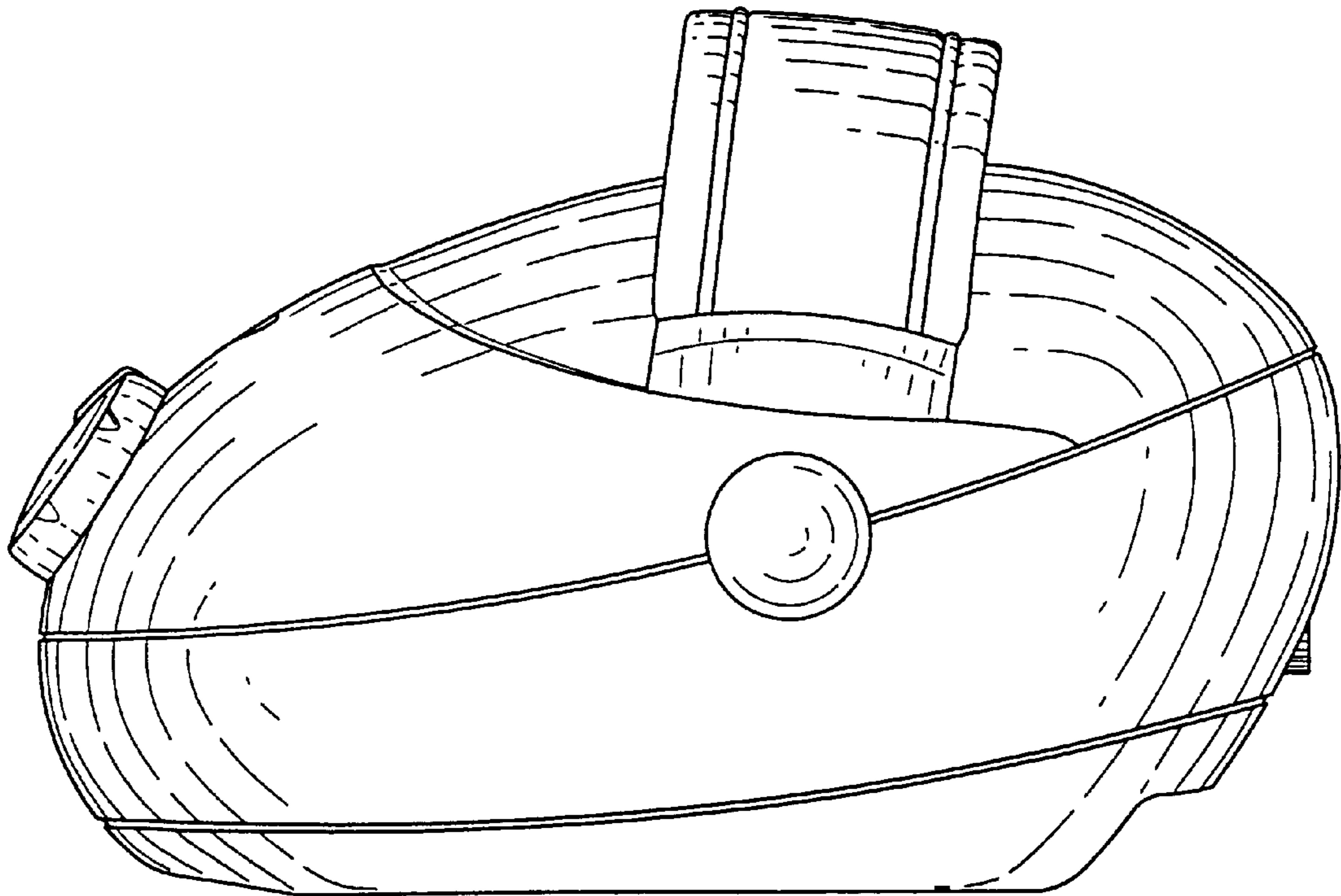

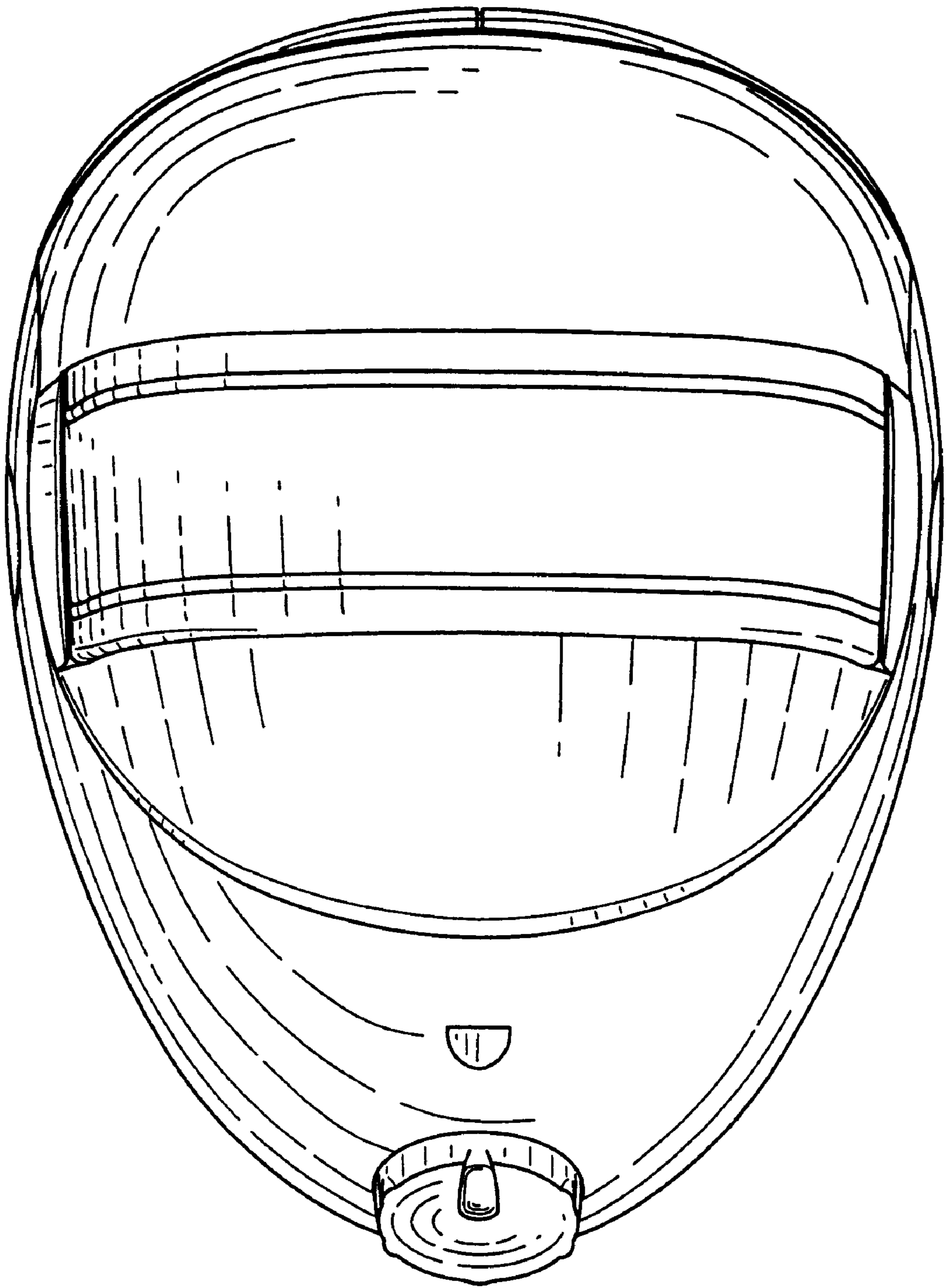

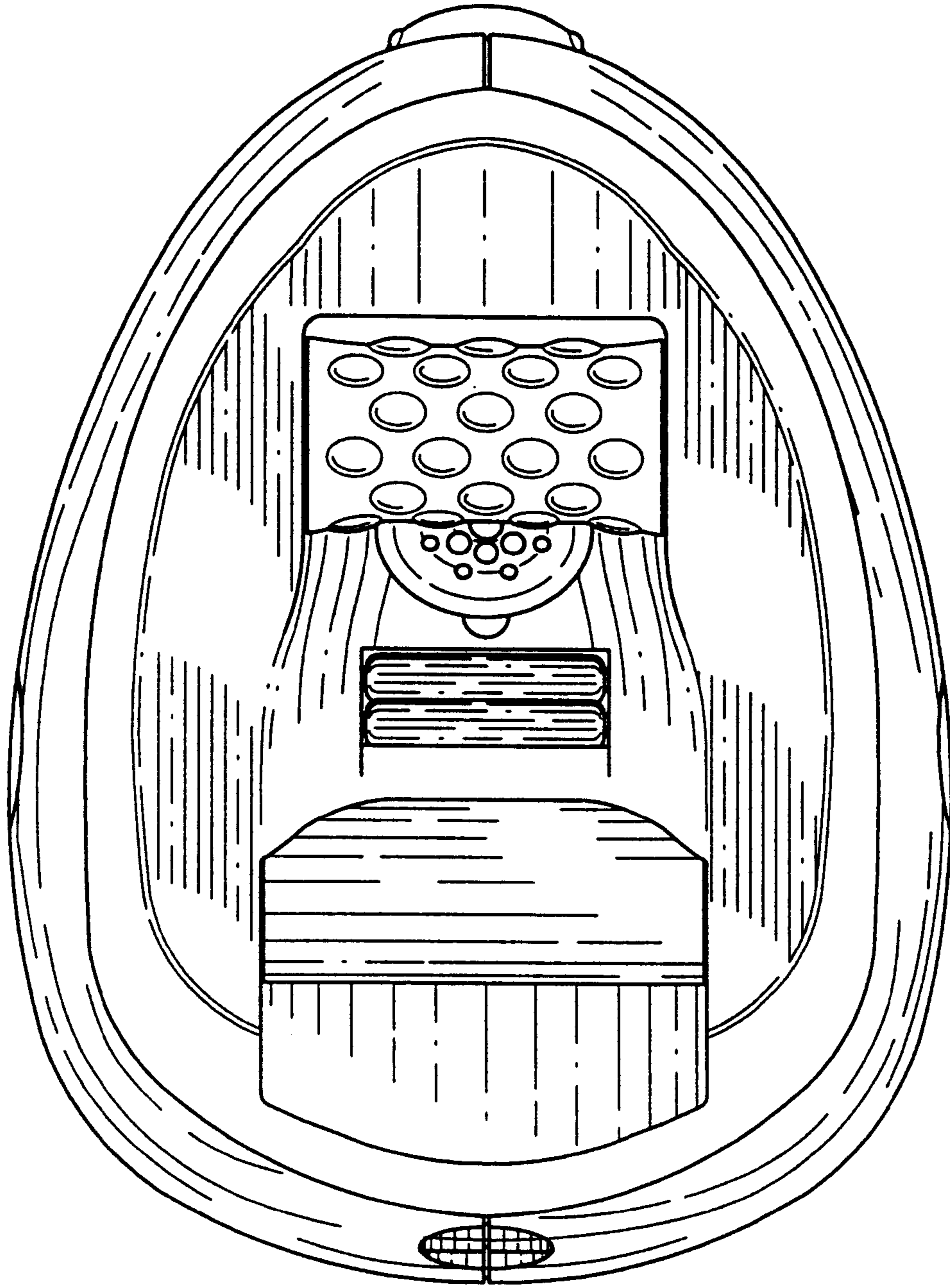
