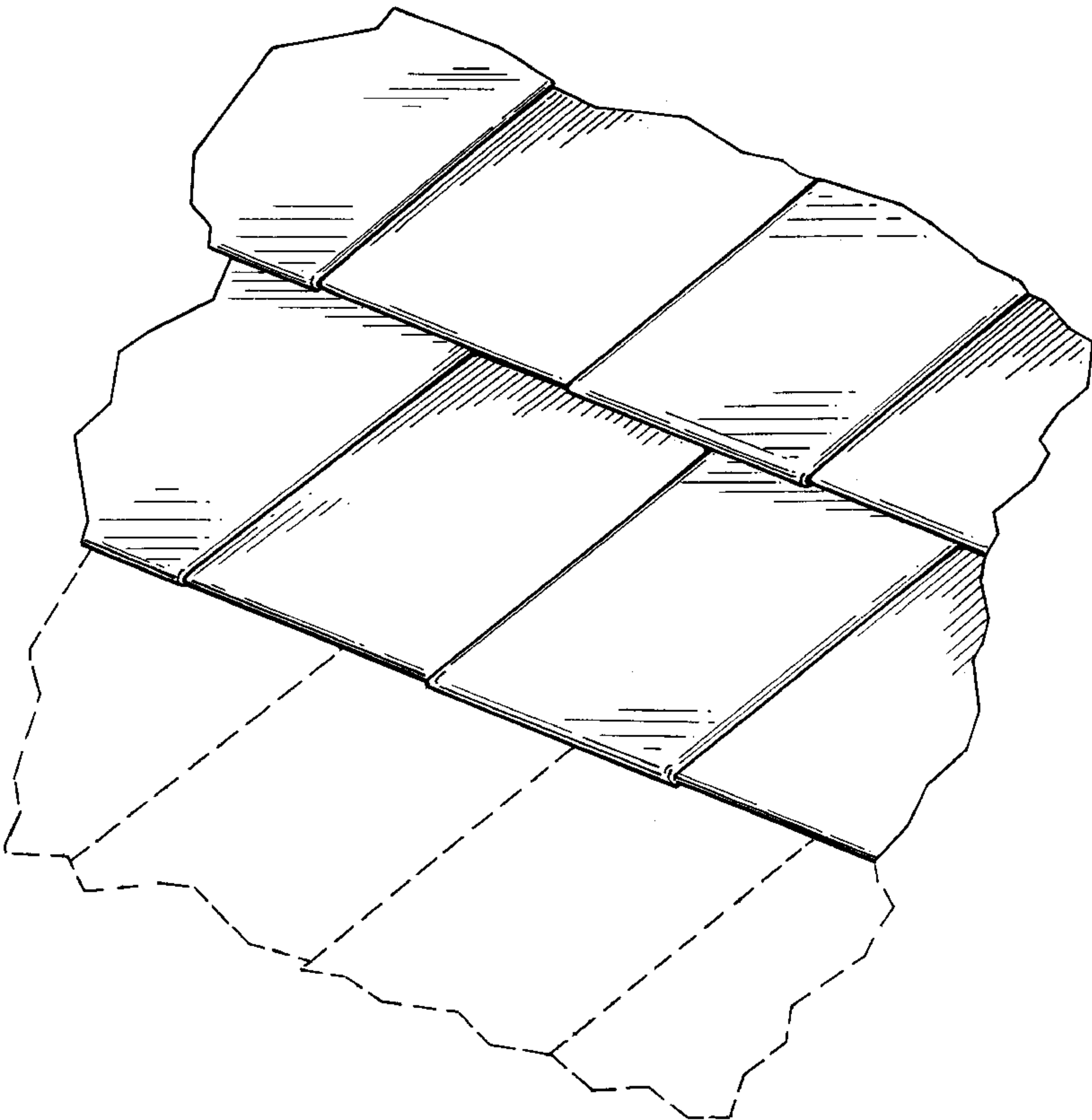
An ornamental design for interlocking shingle pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of interlocking shingle pattern showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2.

The pattern, as illustrated, is repetitive throughout the width and length of the design.
The broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

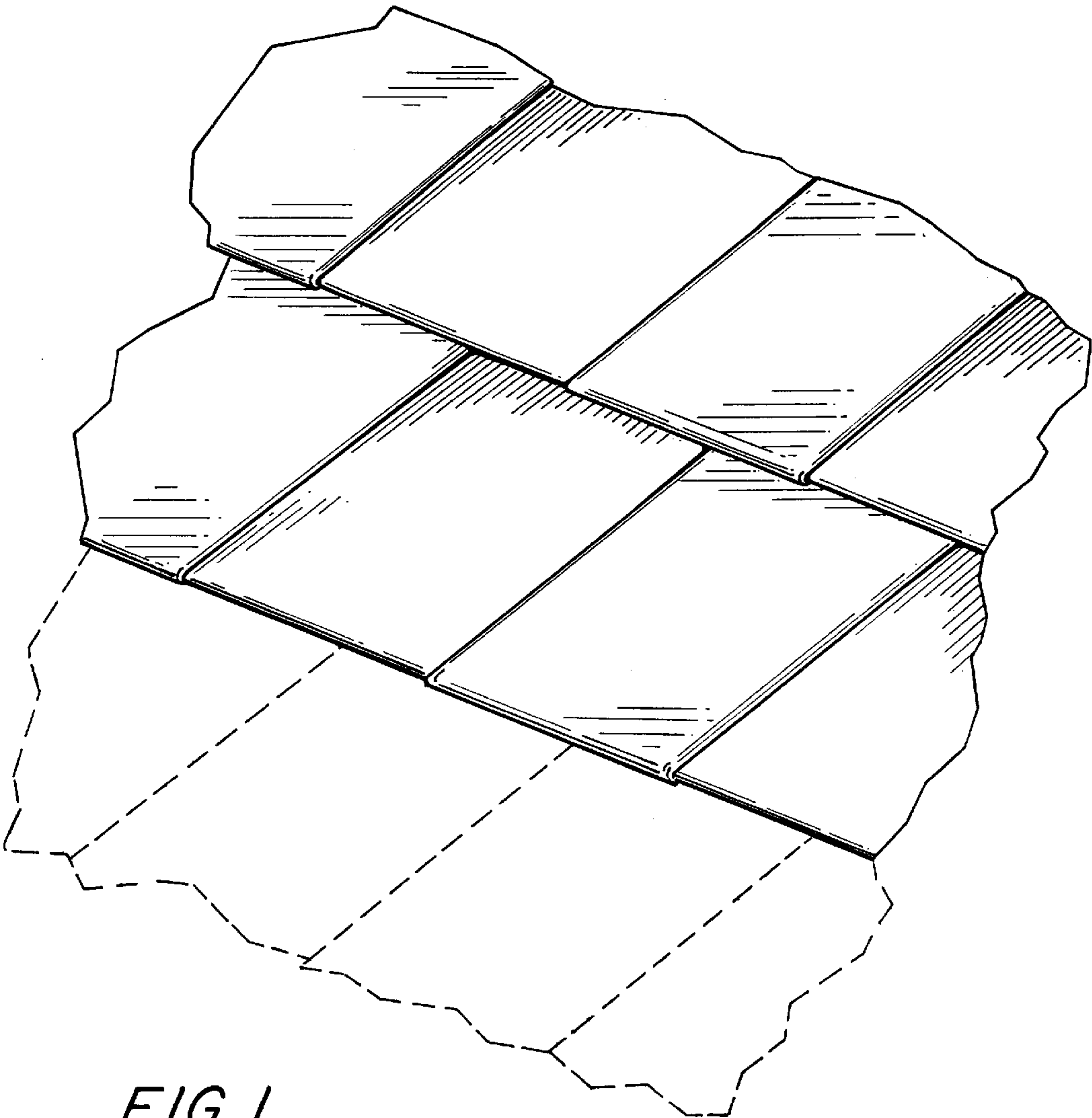

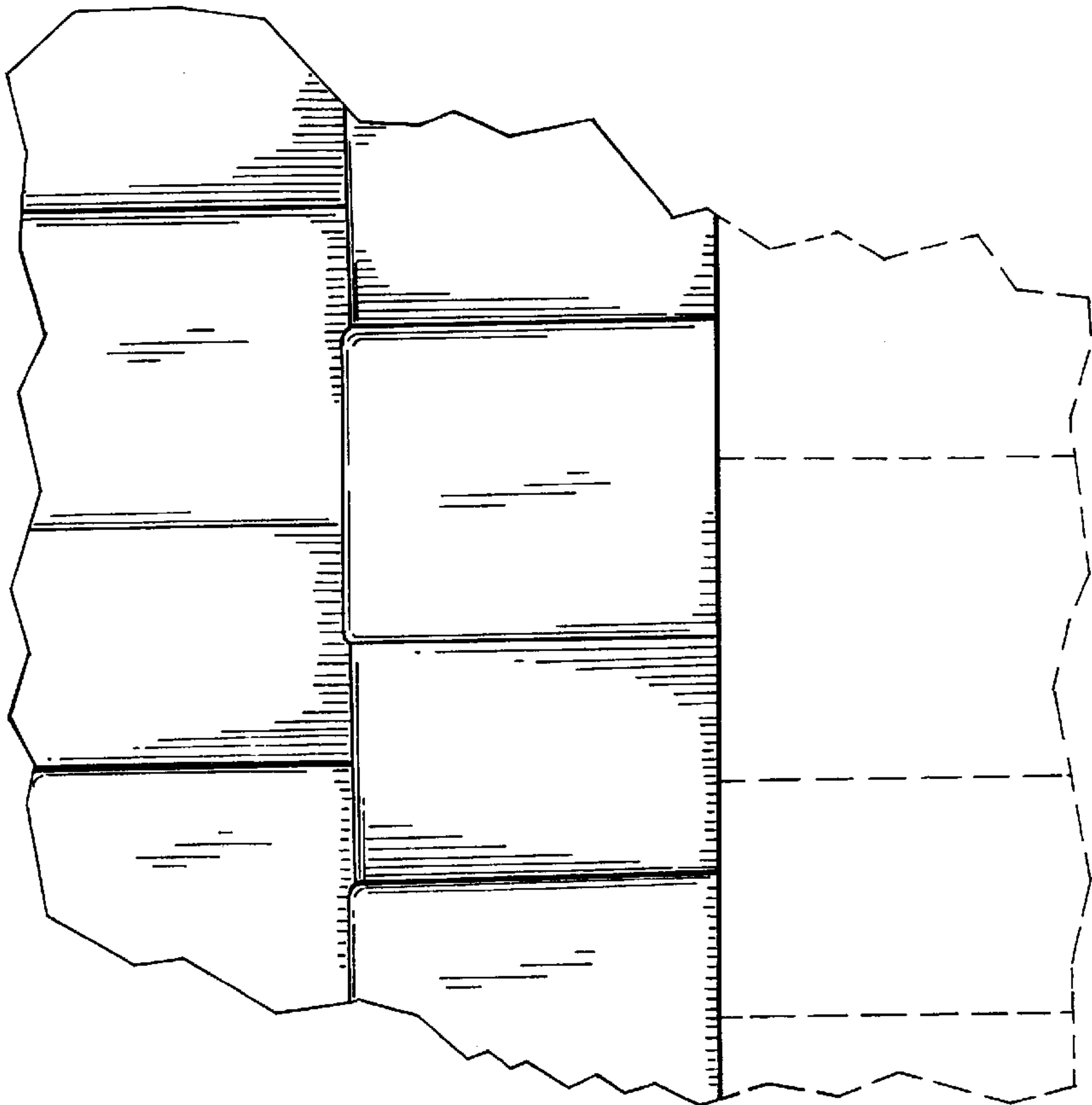

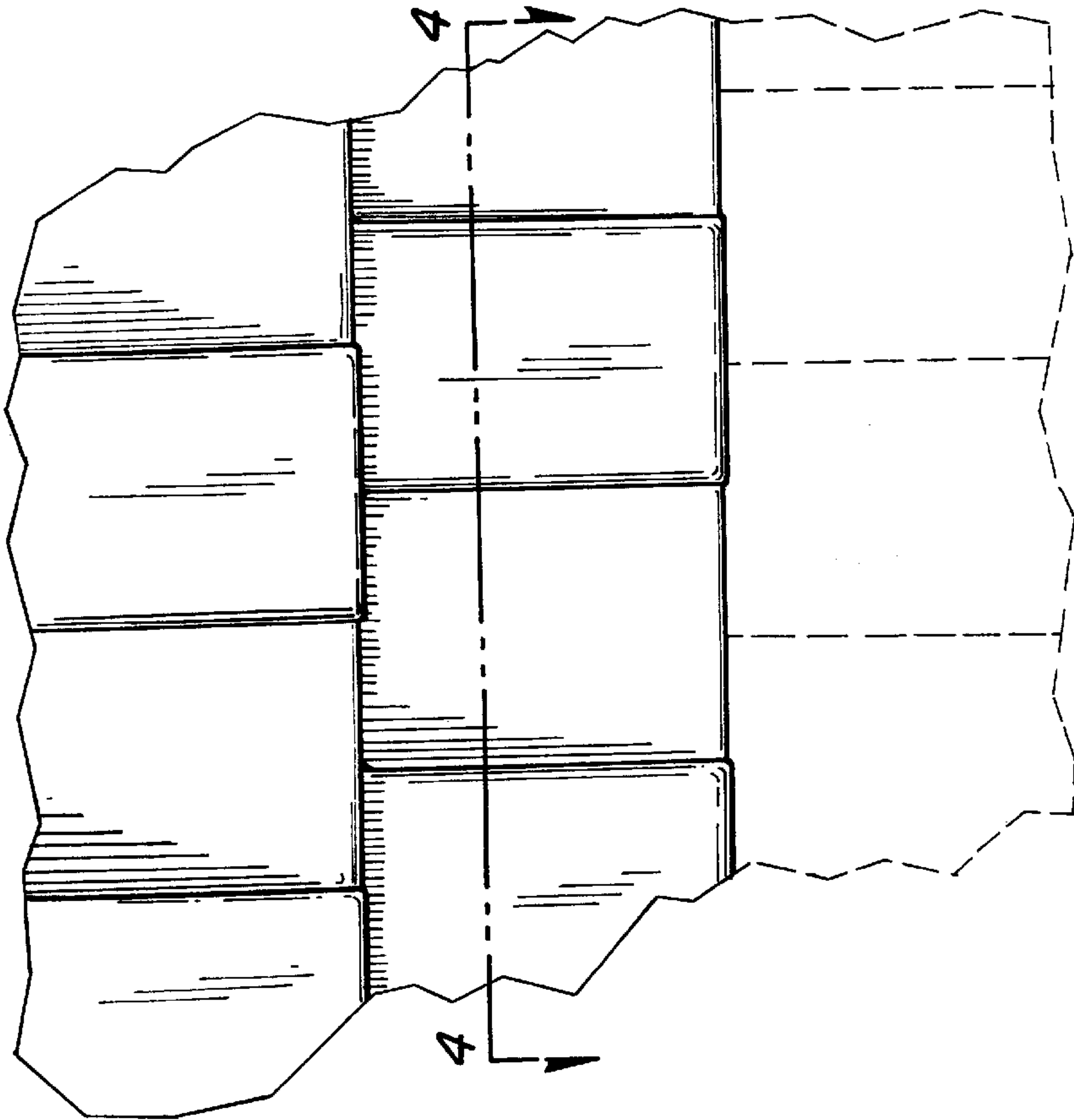
