The ornamental design for a floor lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a floor lamp constructed in accordance with the invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the floor lamp of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the floor lamp of FIG. 1;

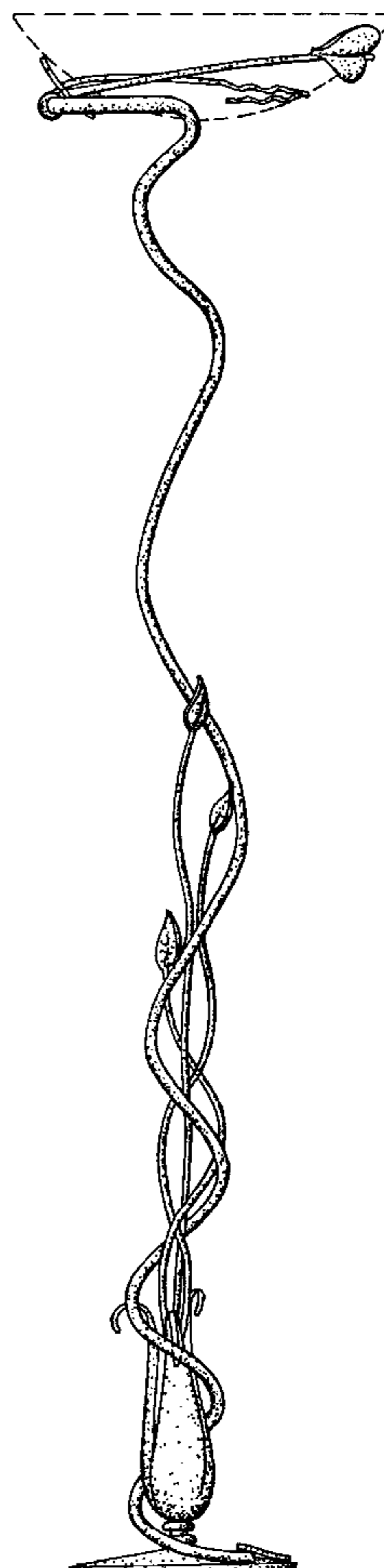
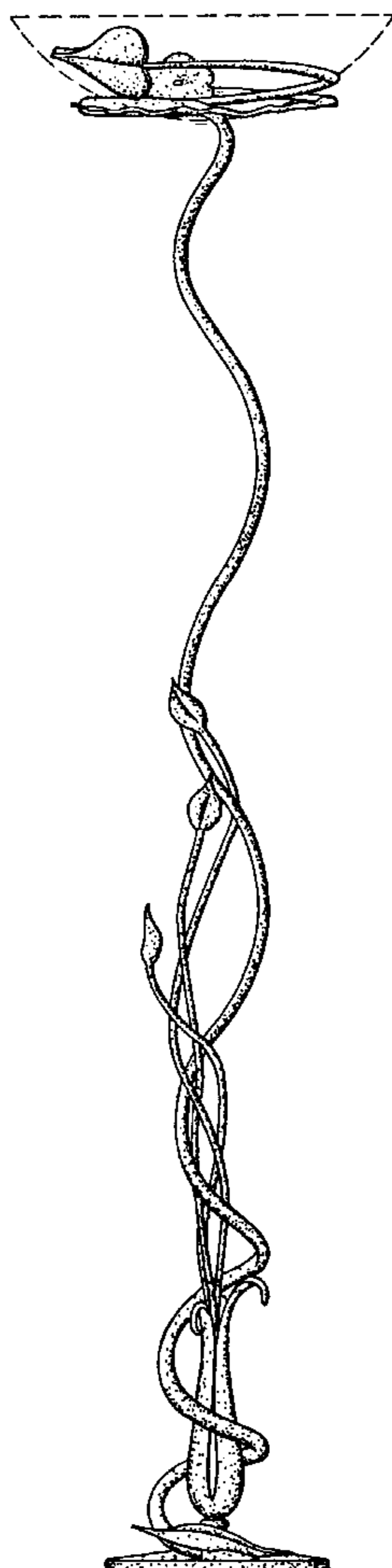
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the floor lamp of FIG. 1;

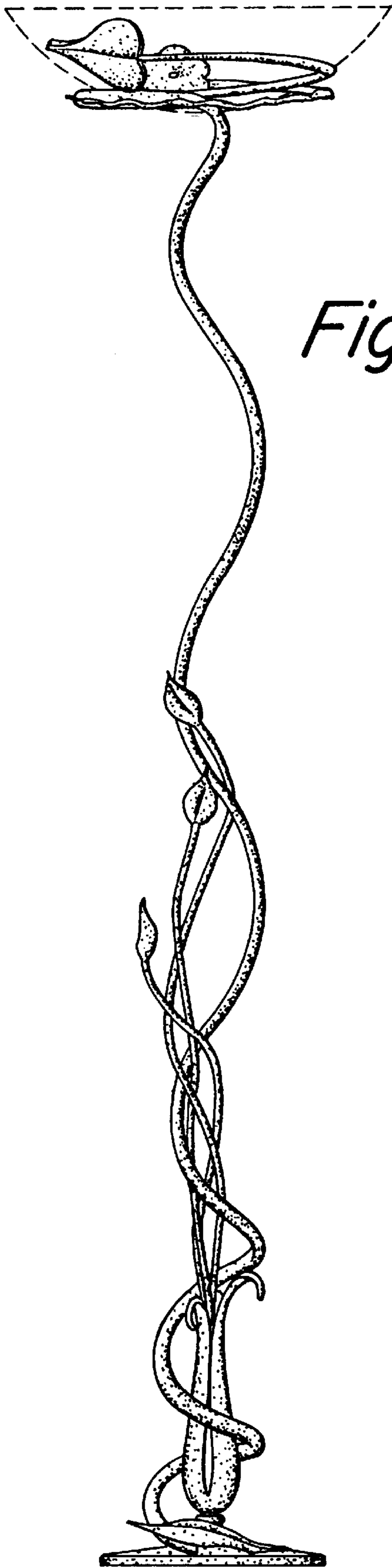

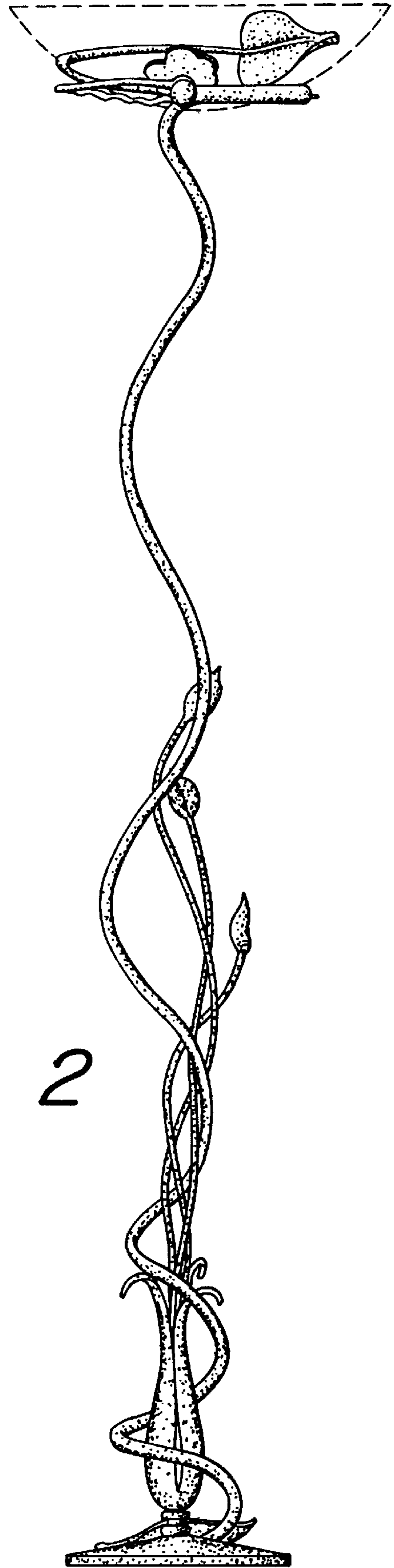

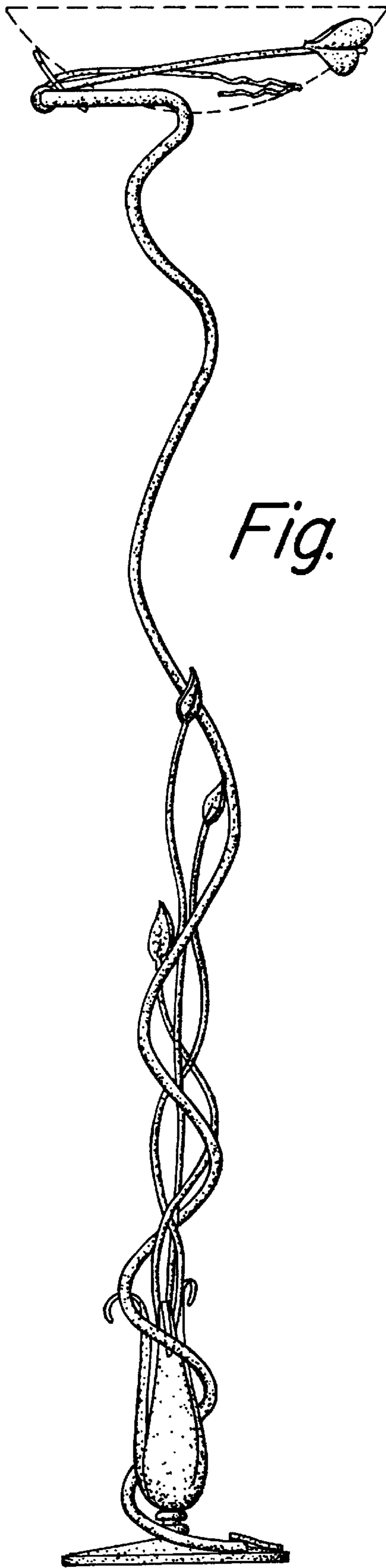

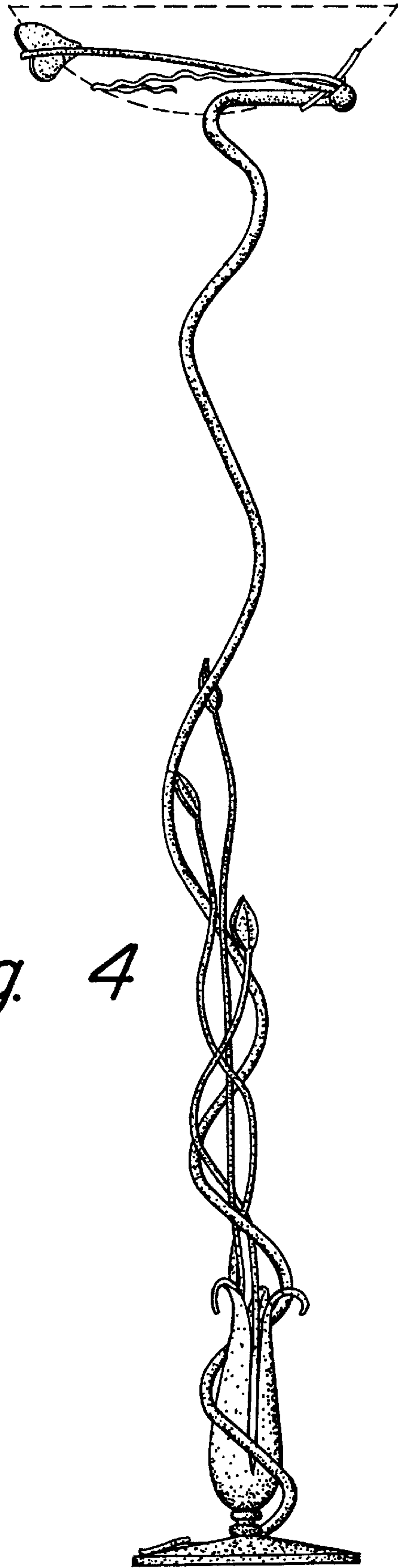

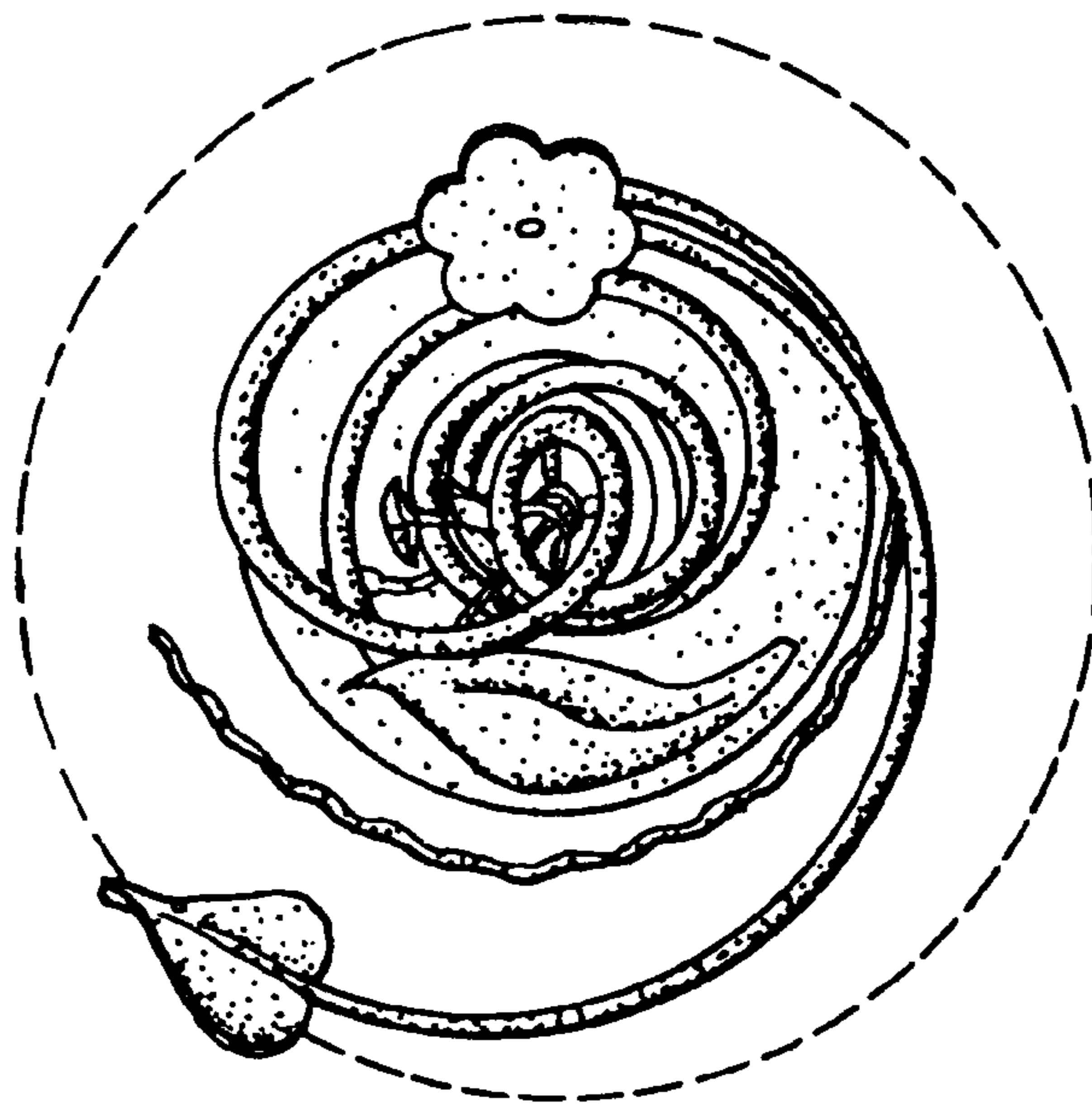

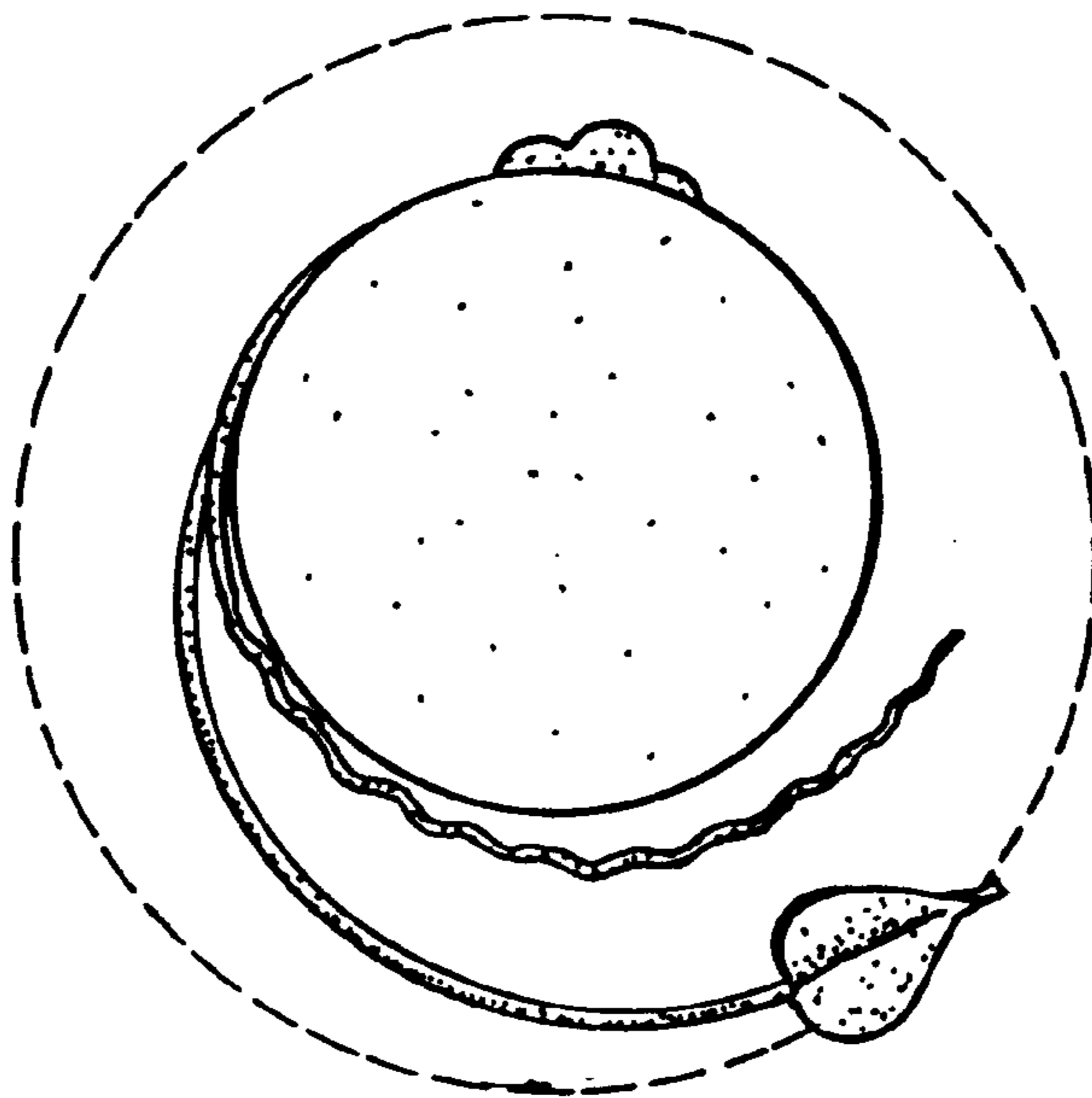
