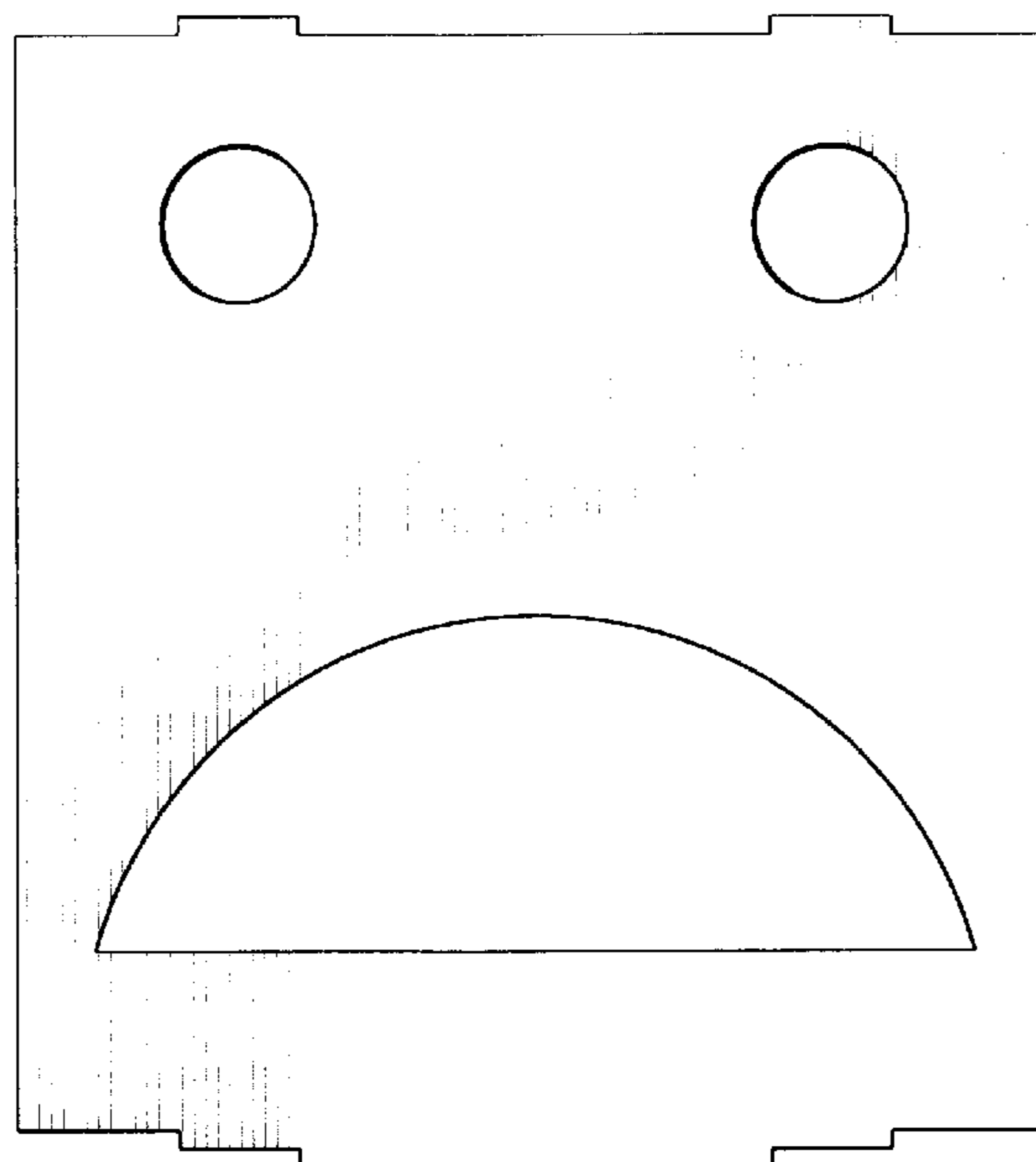

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of an entrance for a bird house showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view with the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof. The broken line showing of the bird house in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The top, bottom, and side views of the two embodiments are identical.

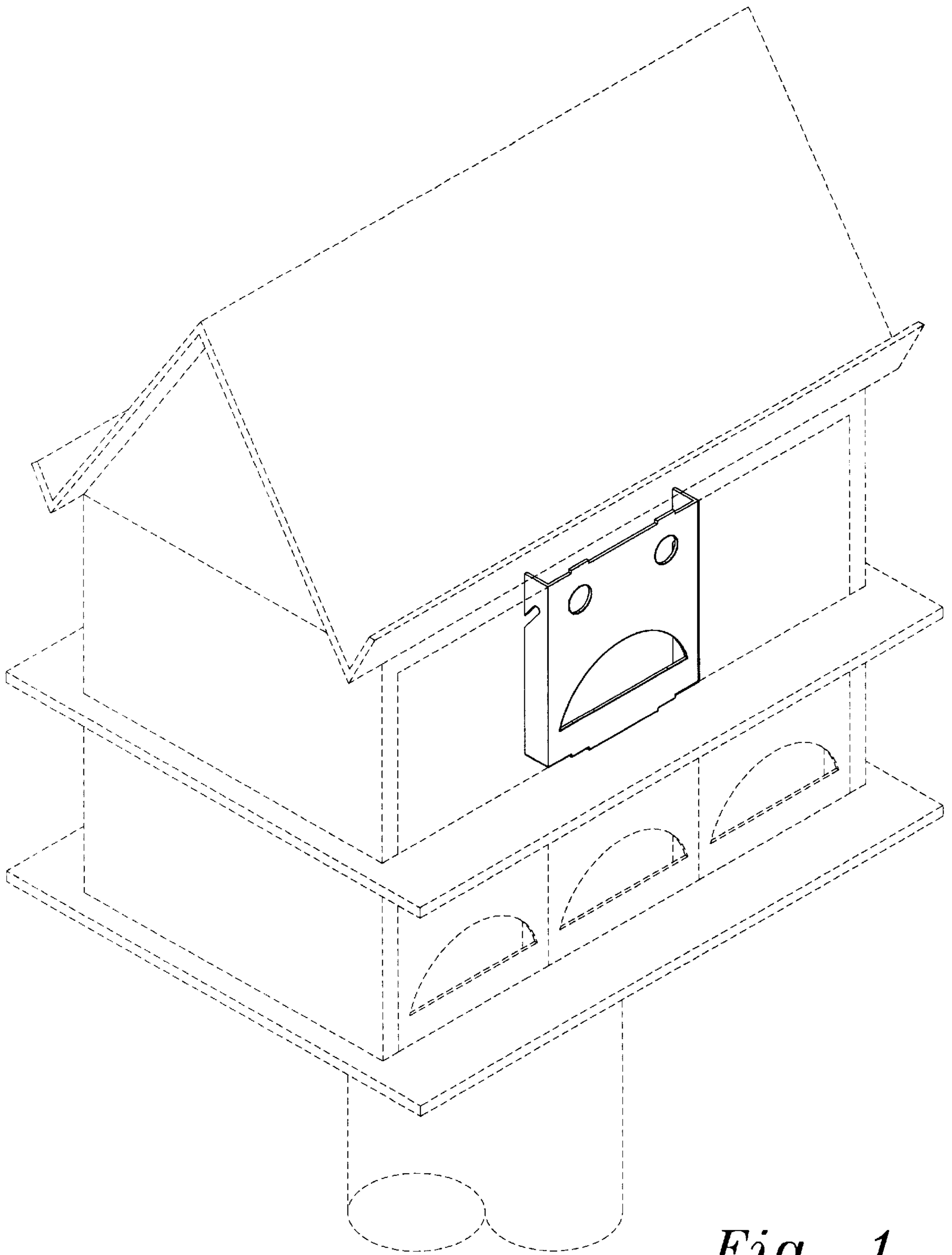

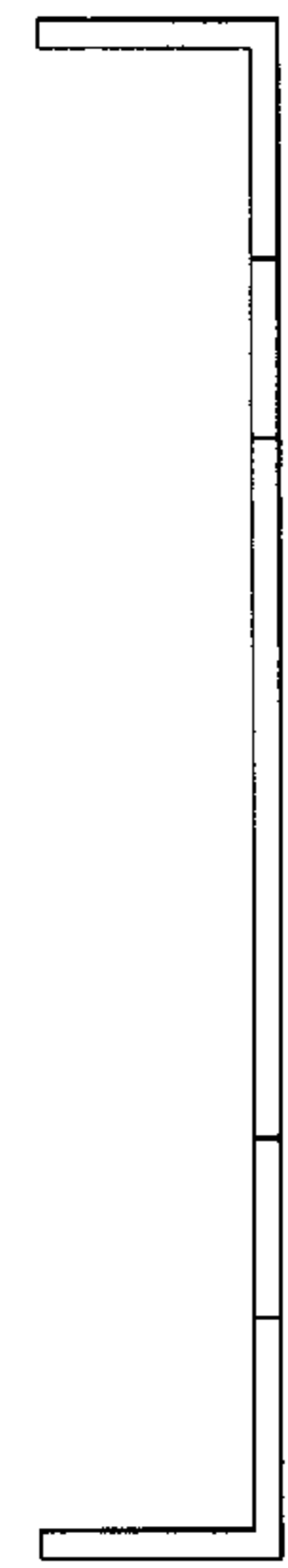

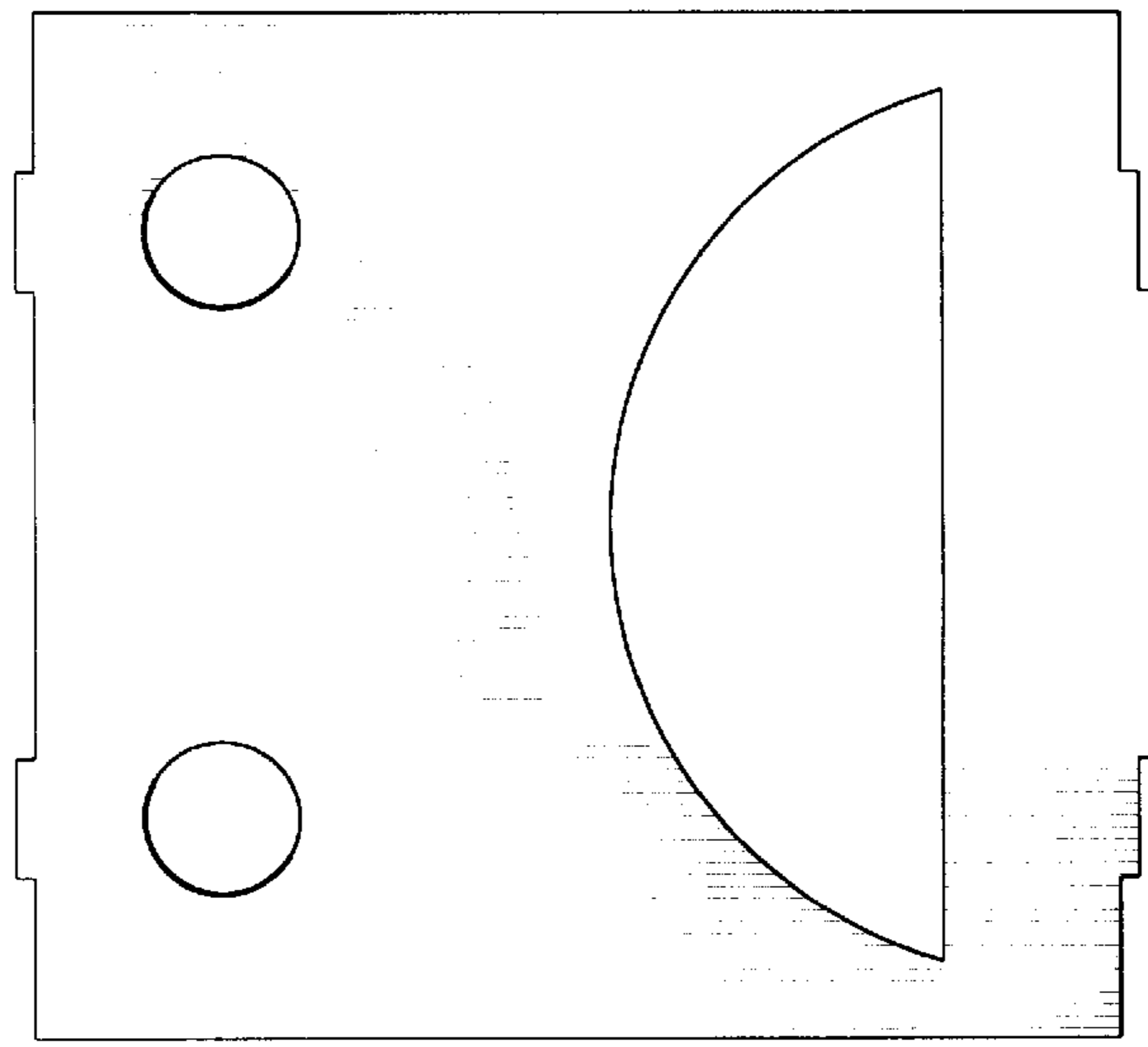

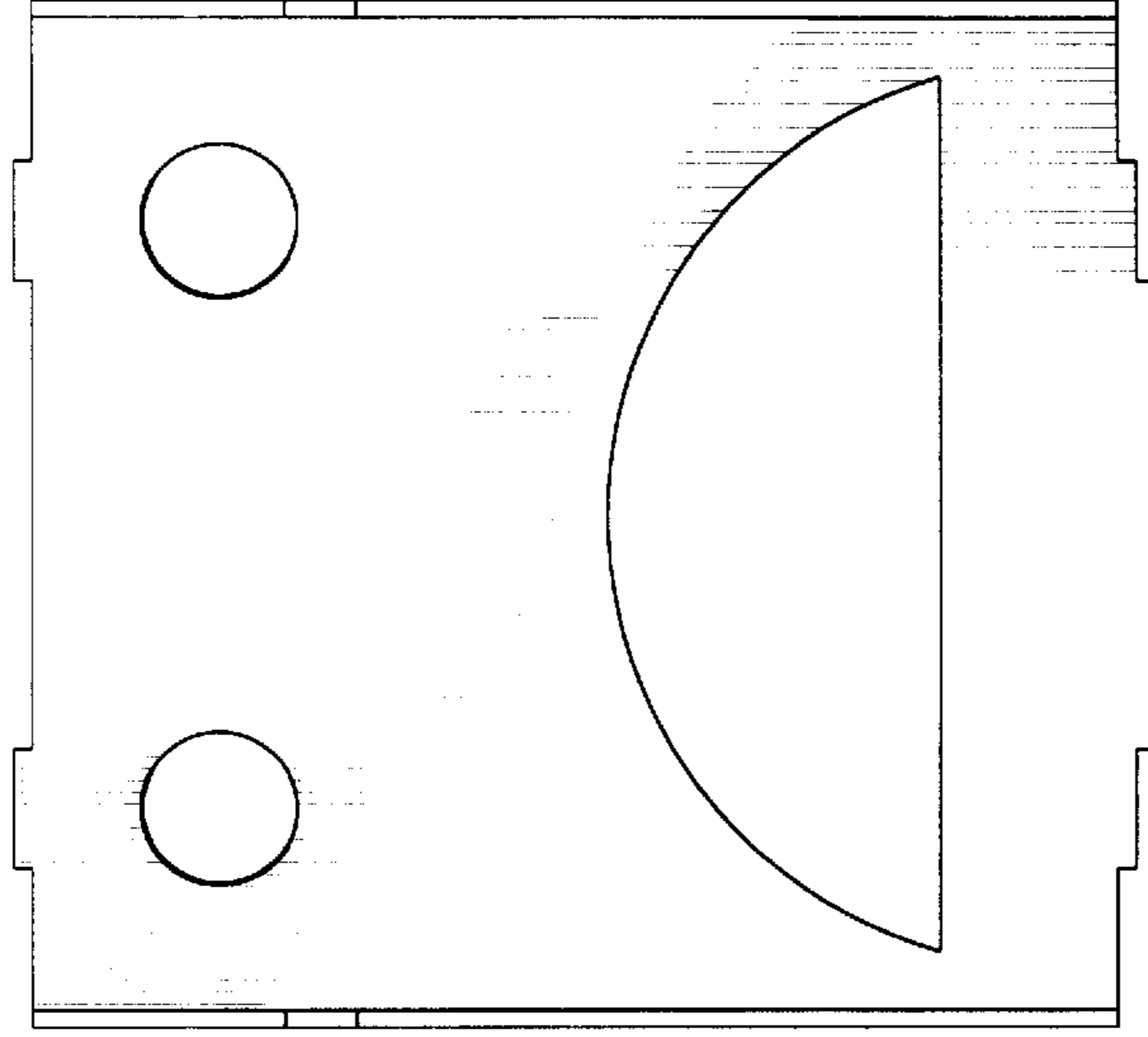

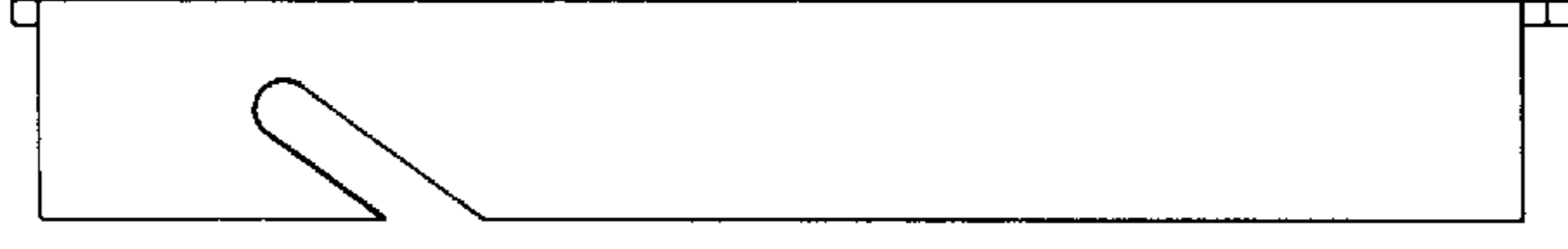

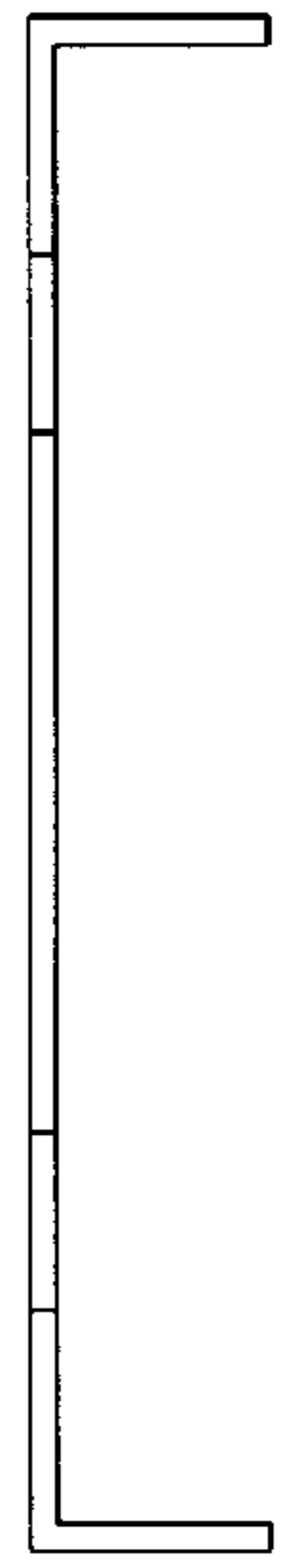

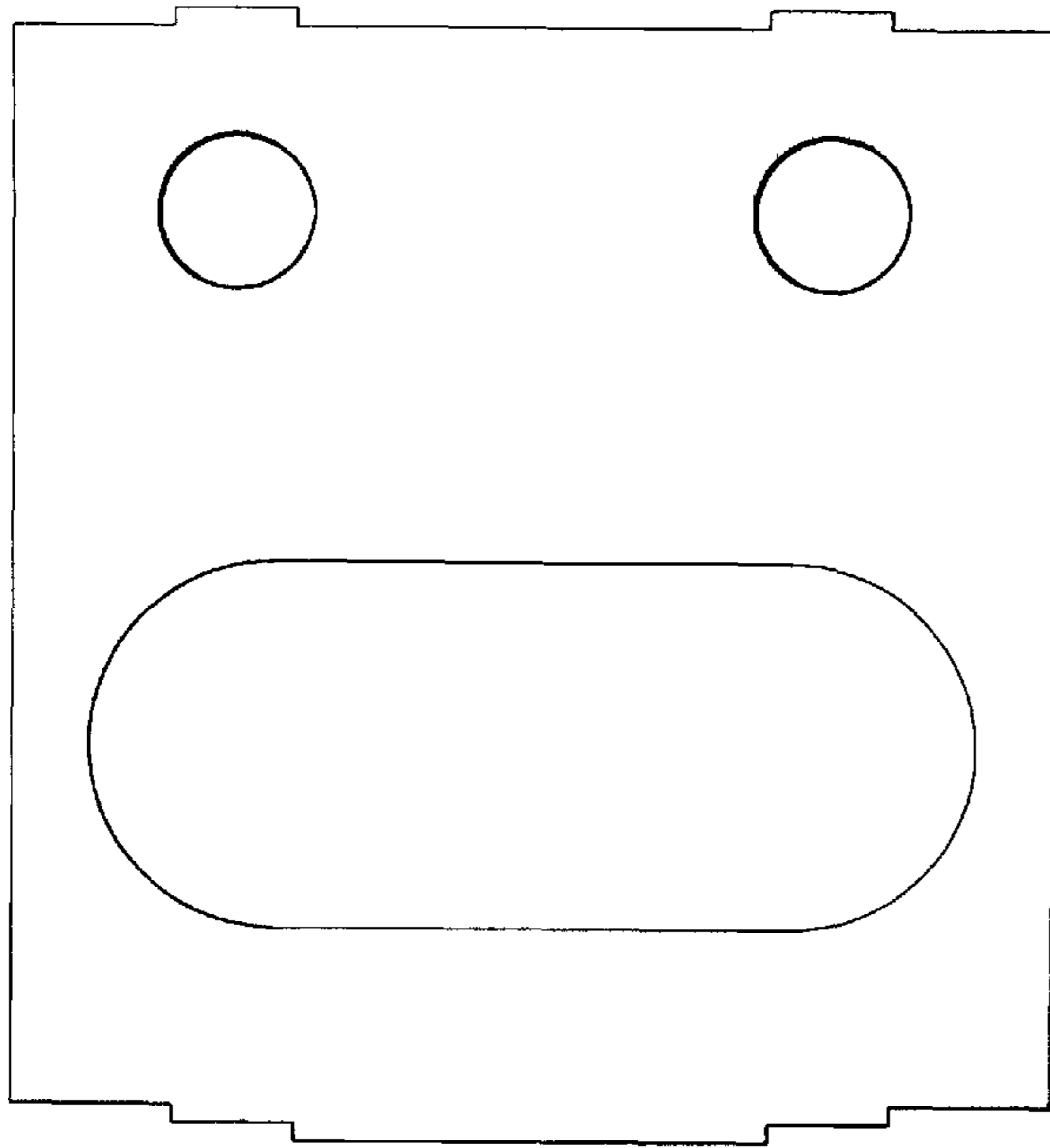

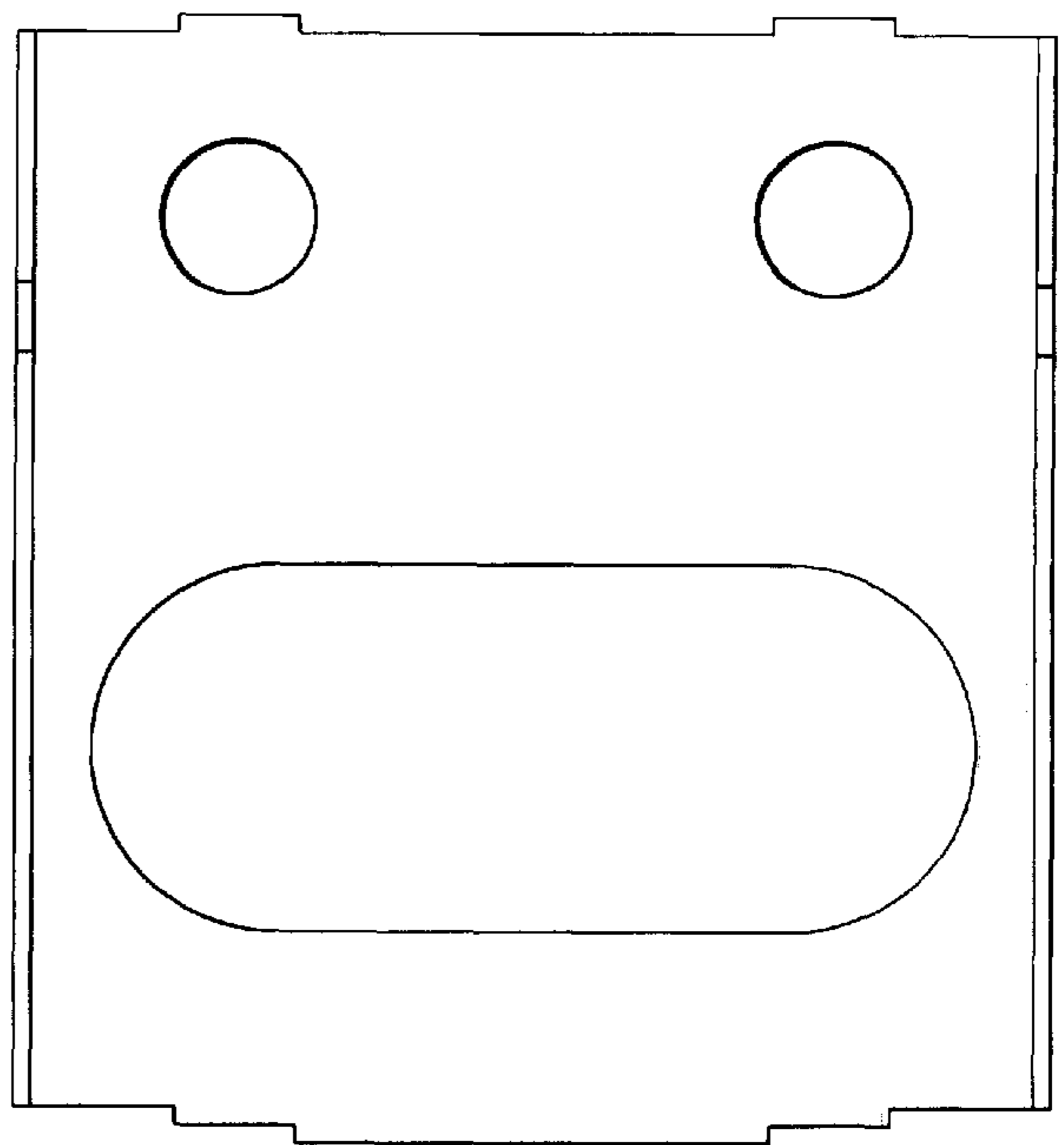
