DESCRIPTION

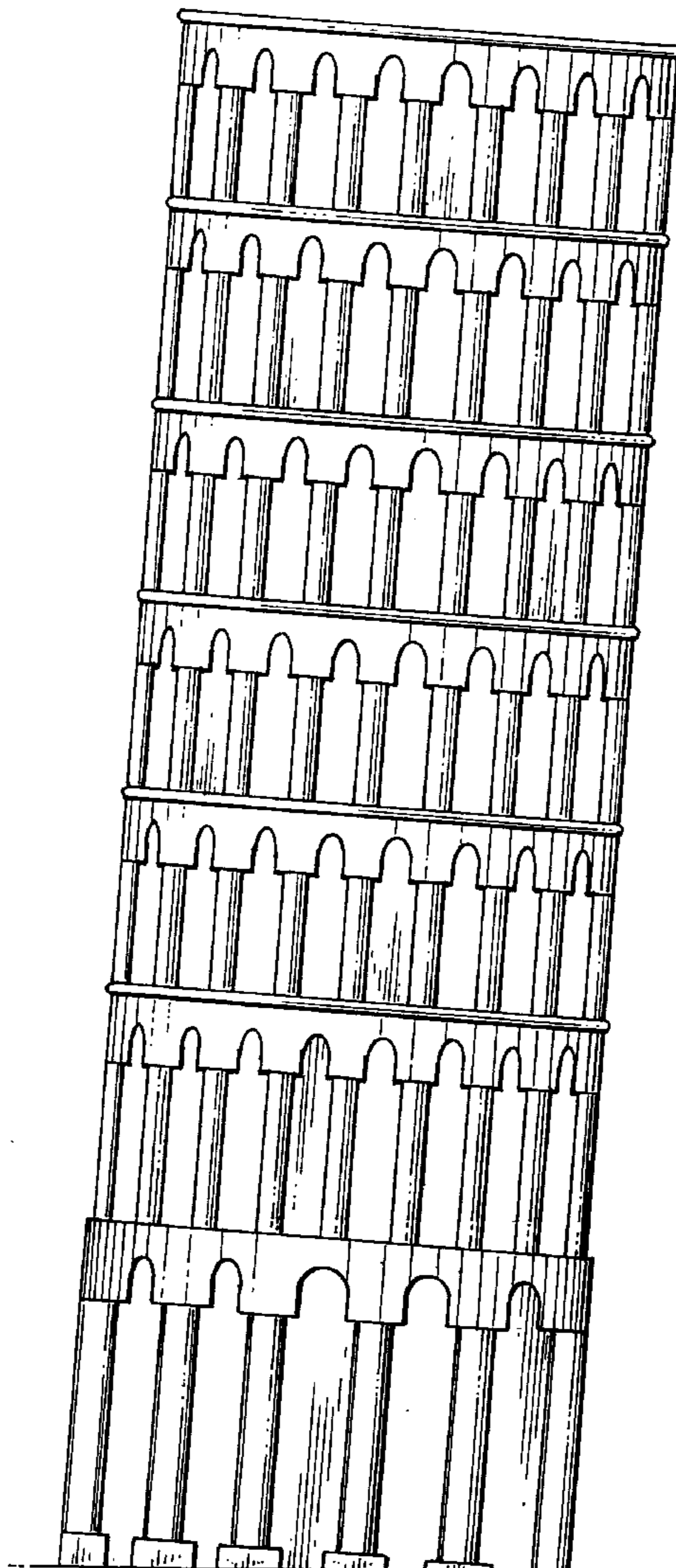

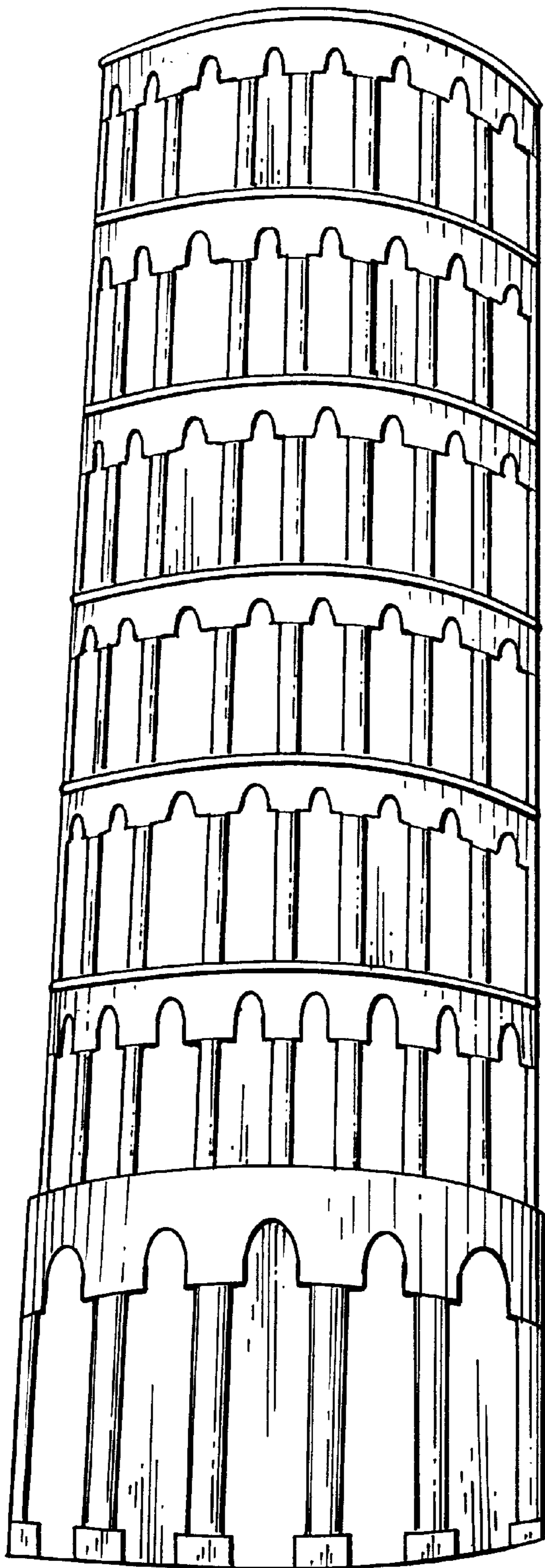

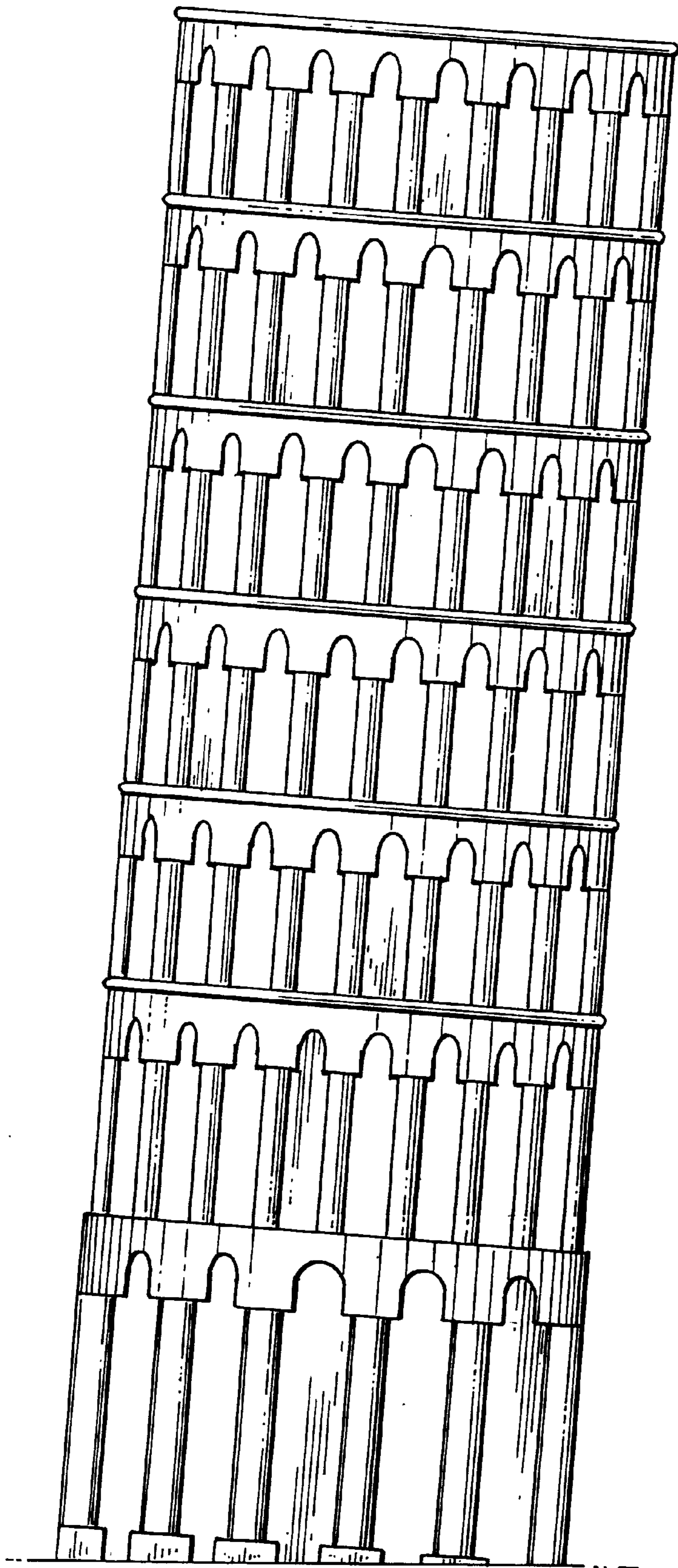

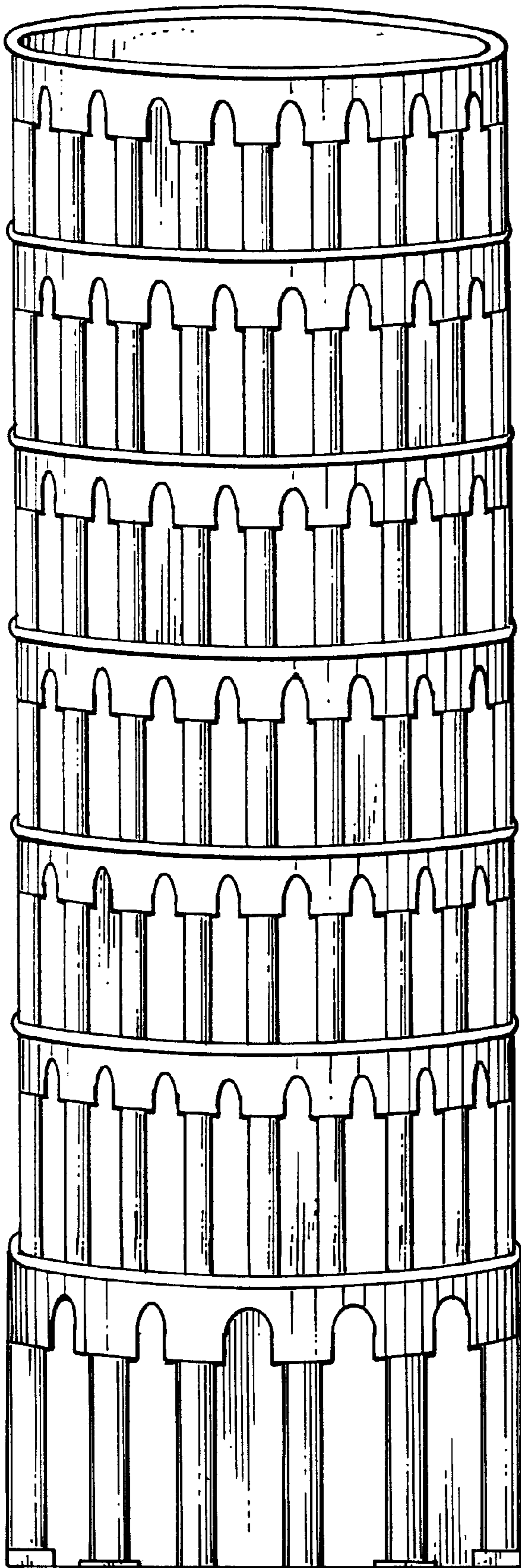
