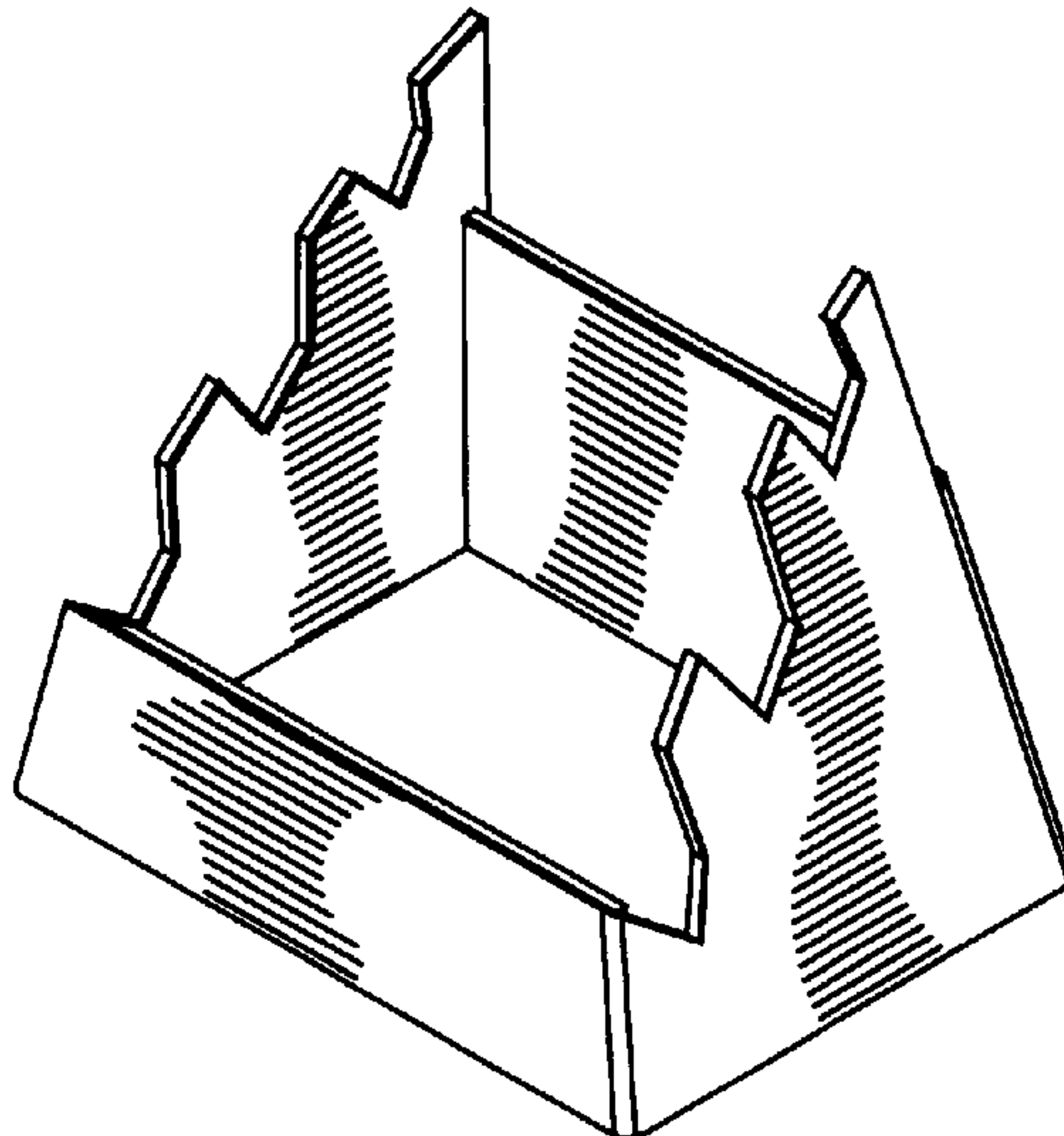
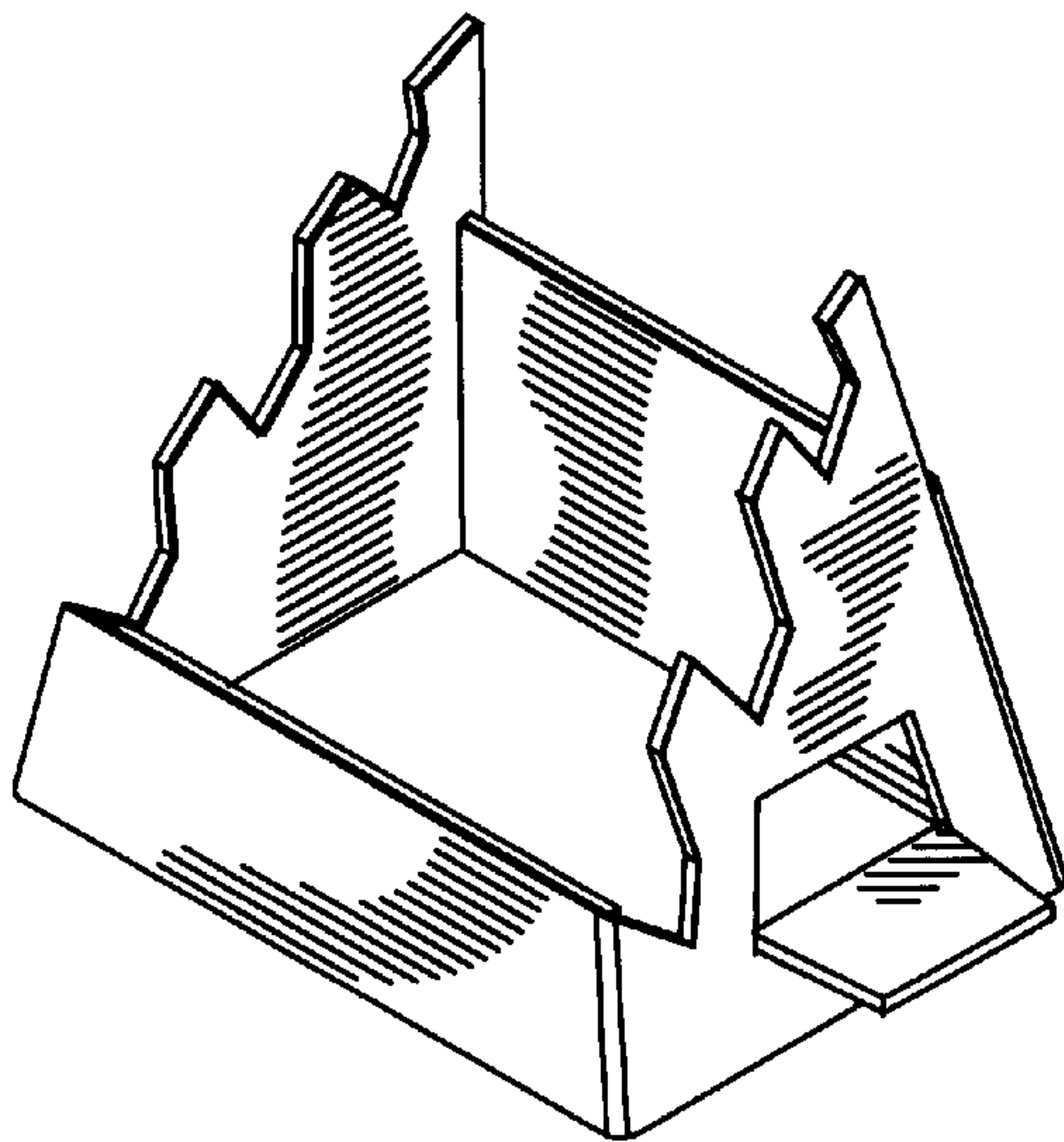
FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of the utensil holder

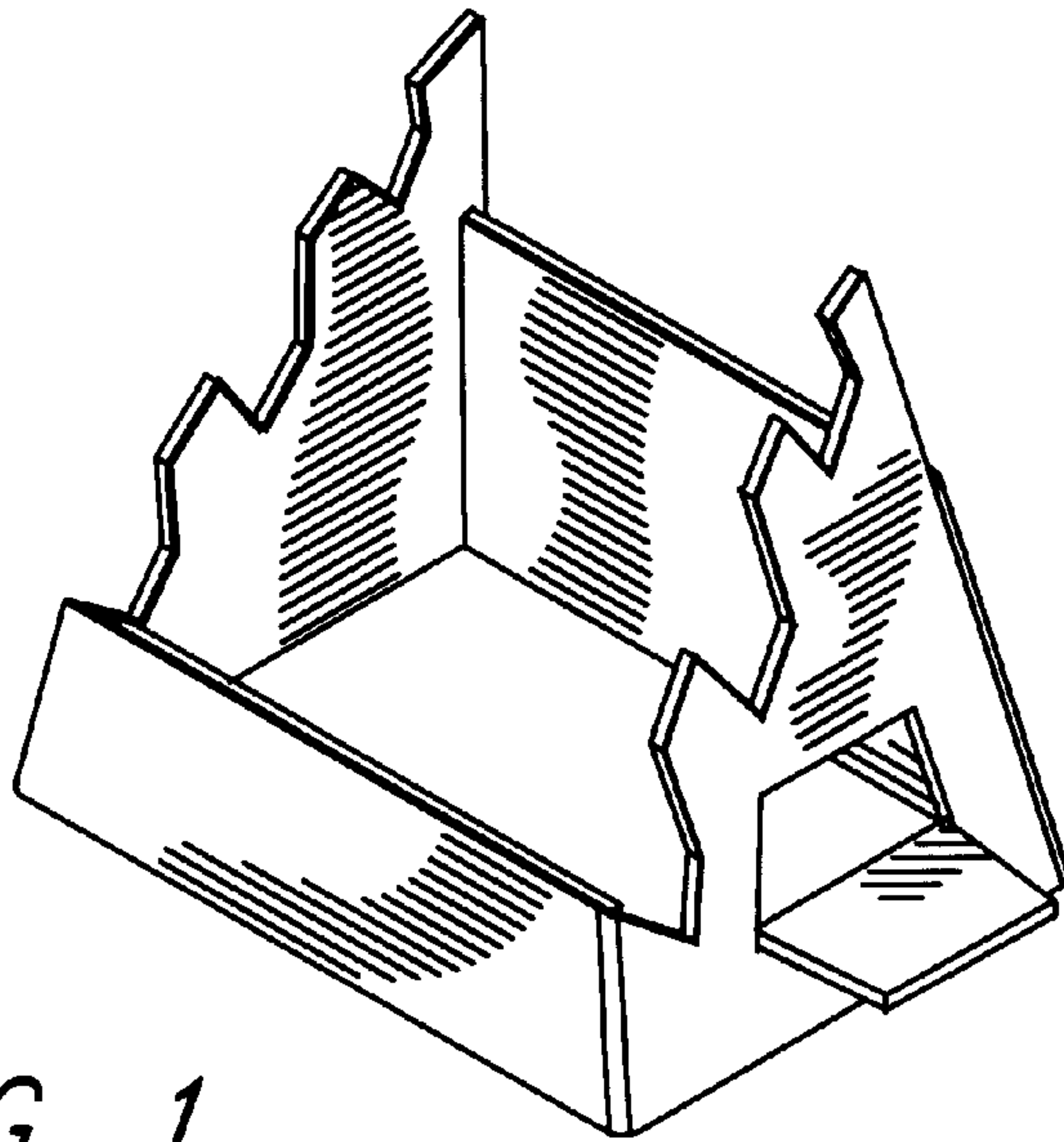

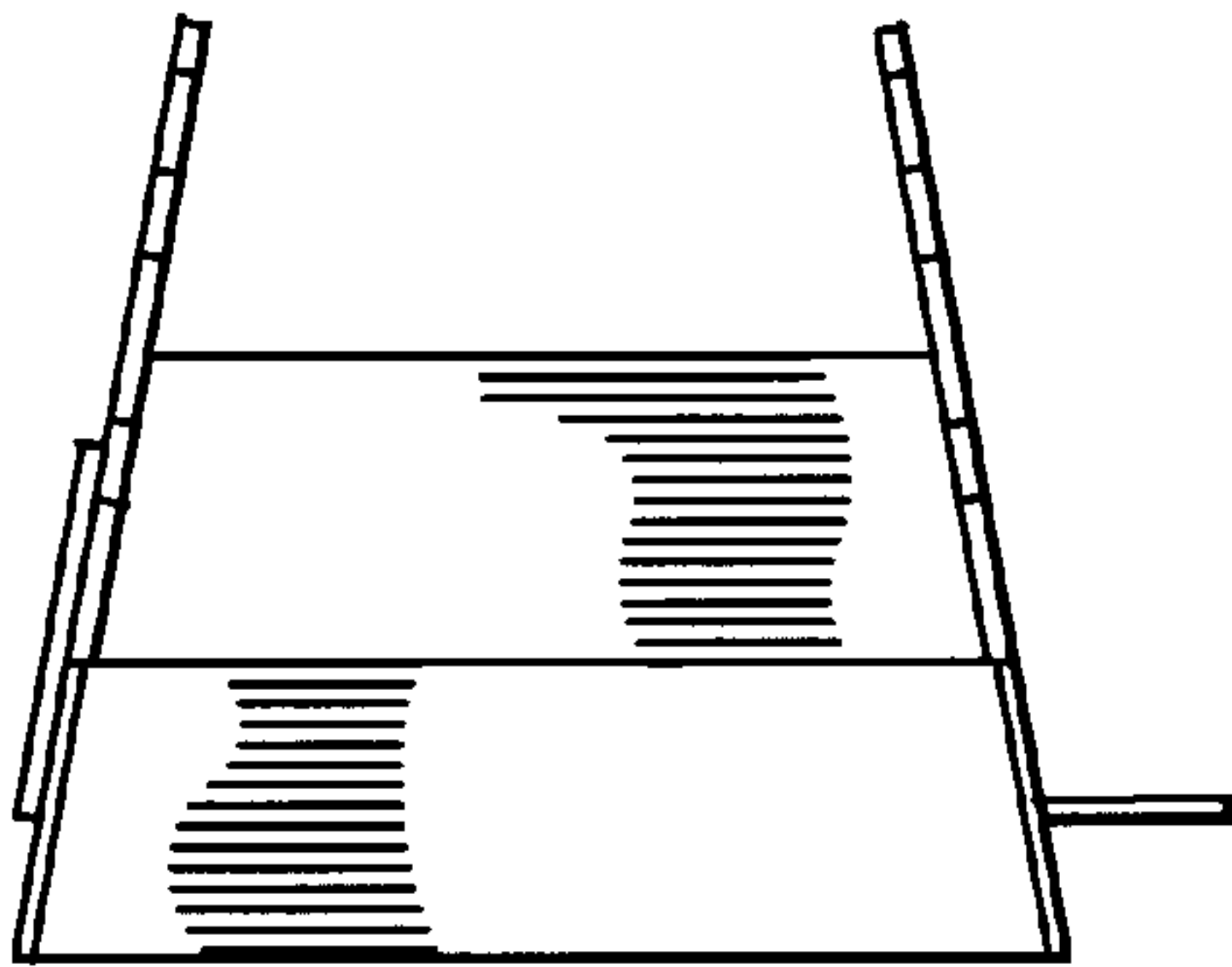

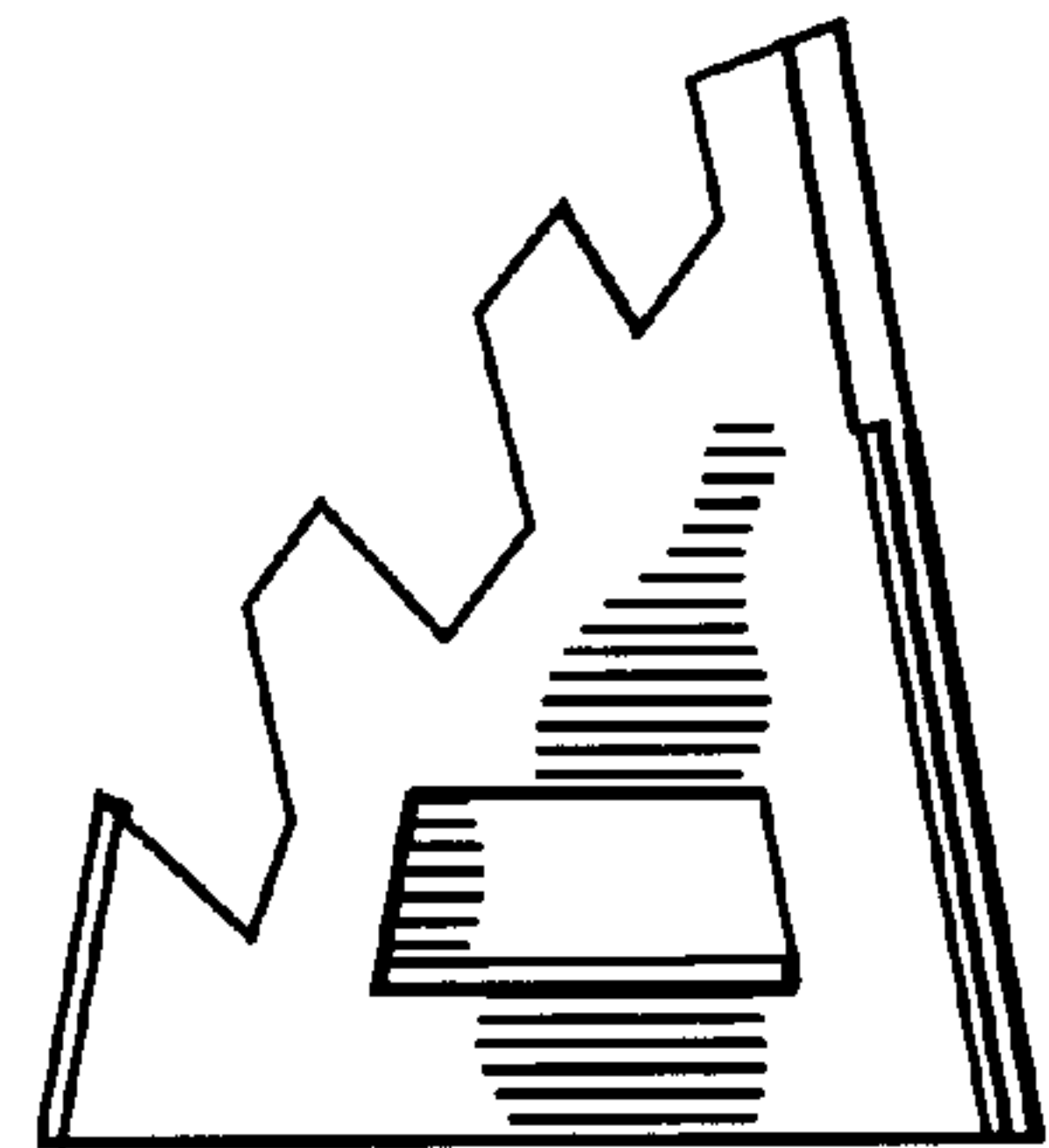

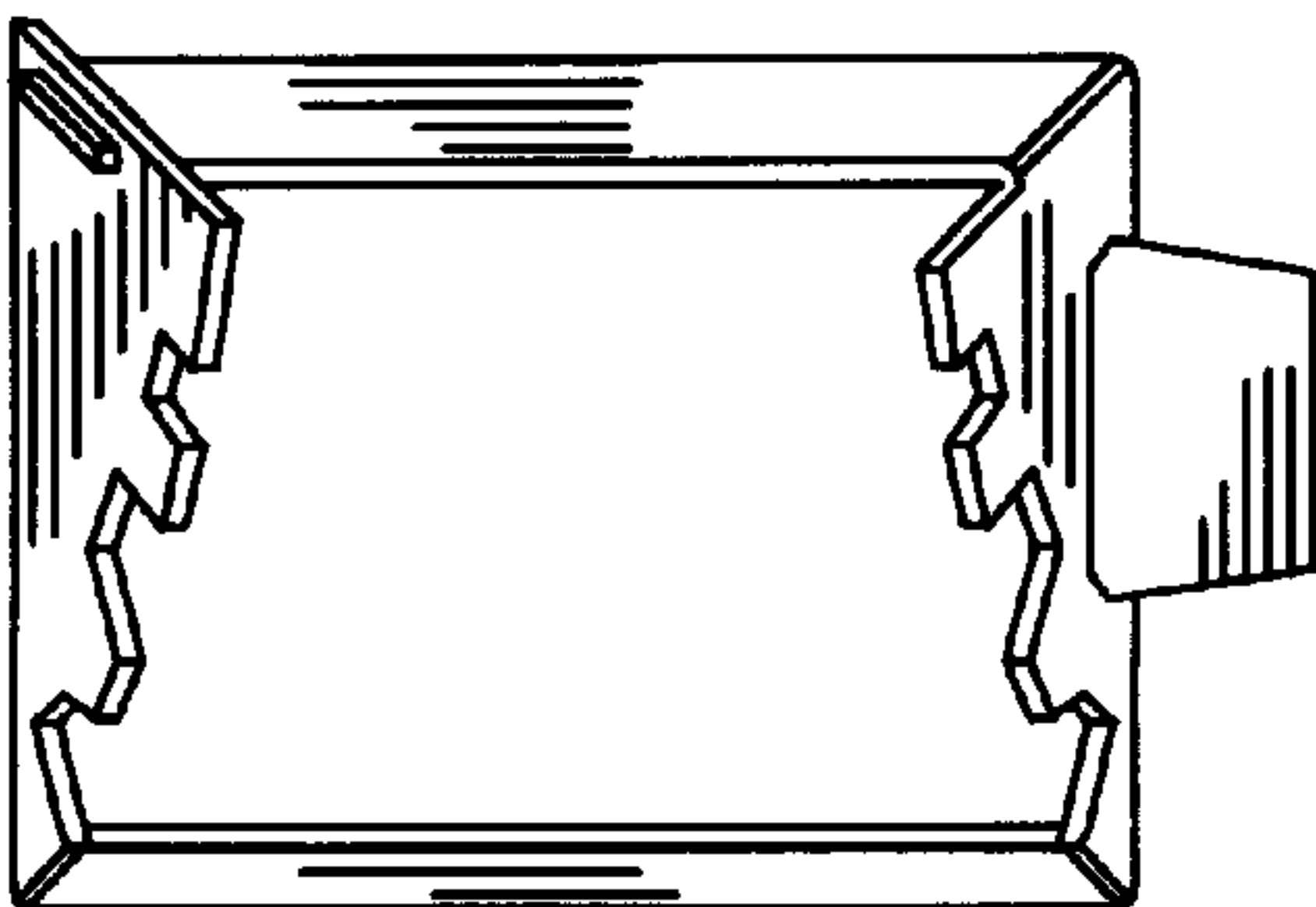

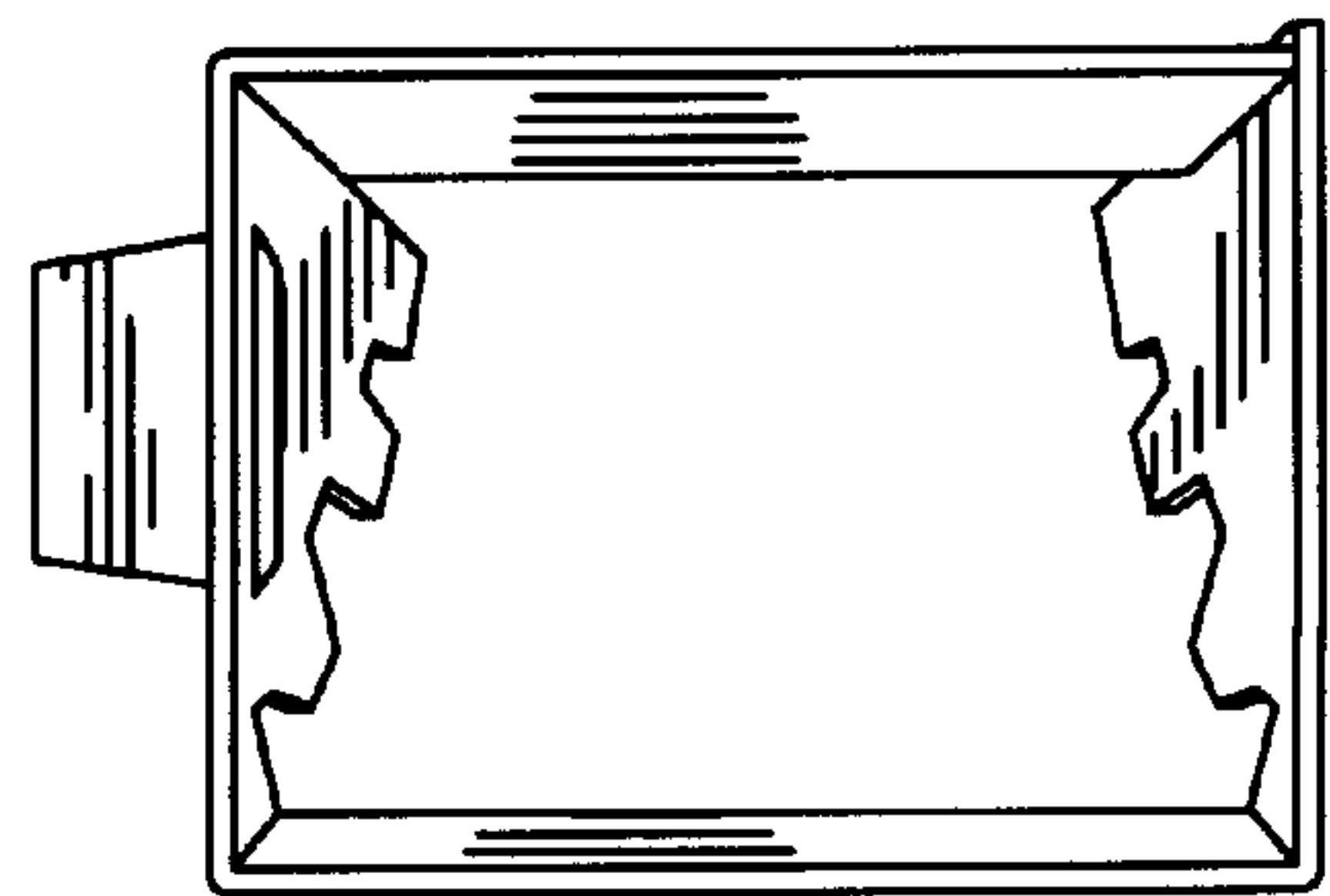

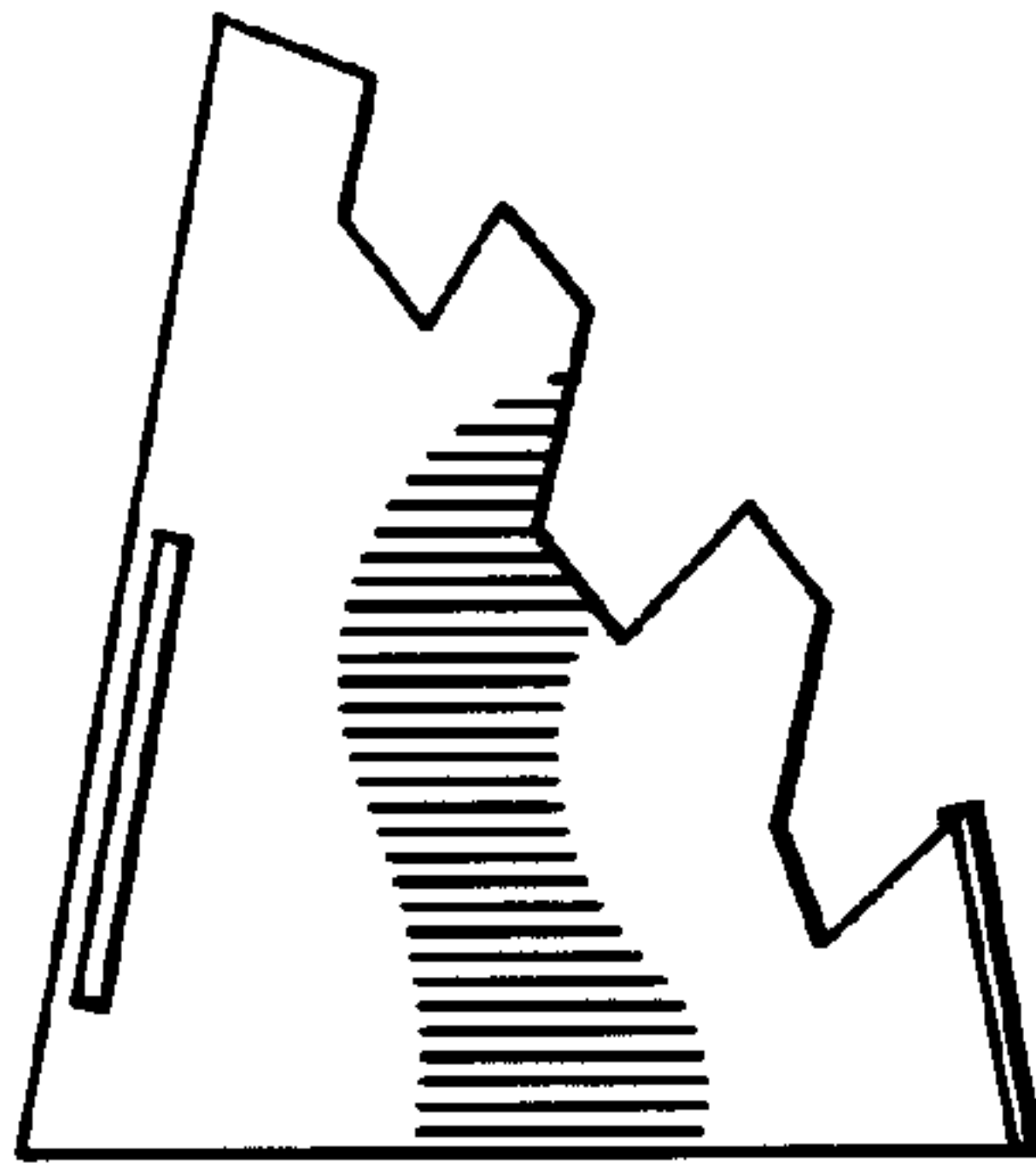

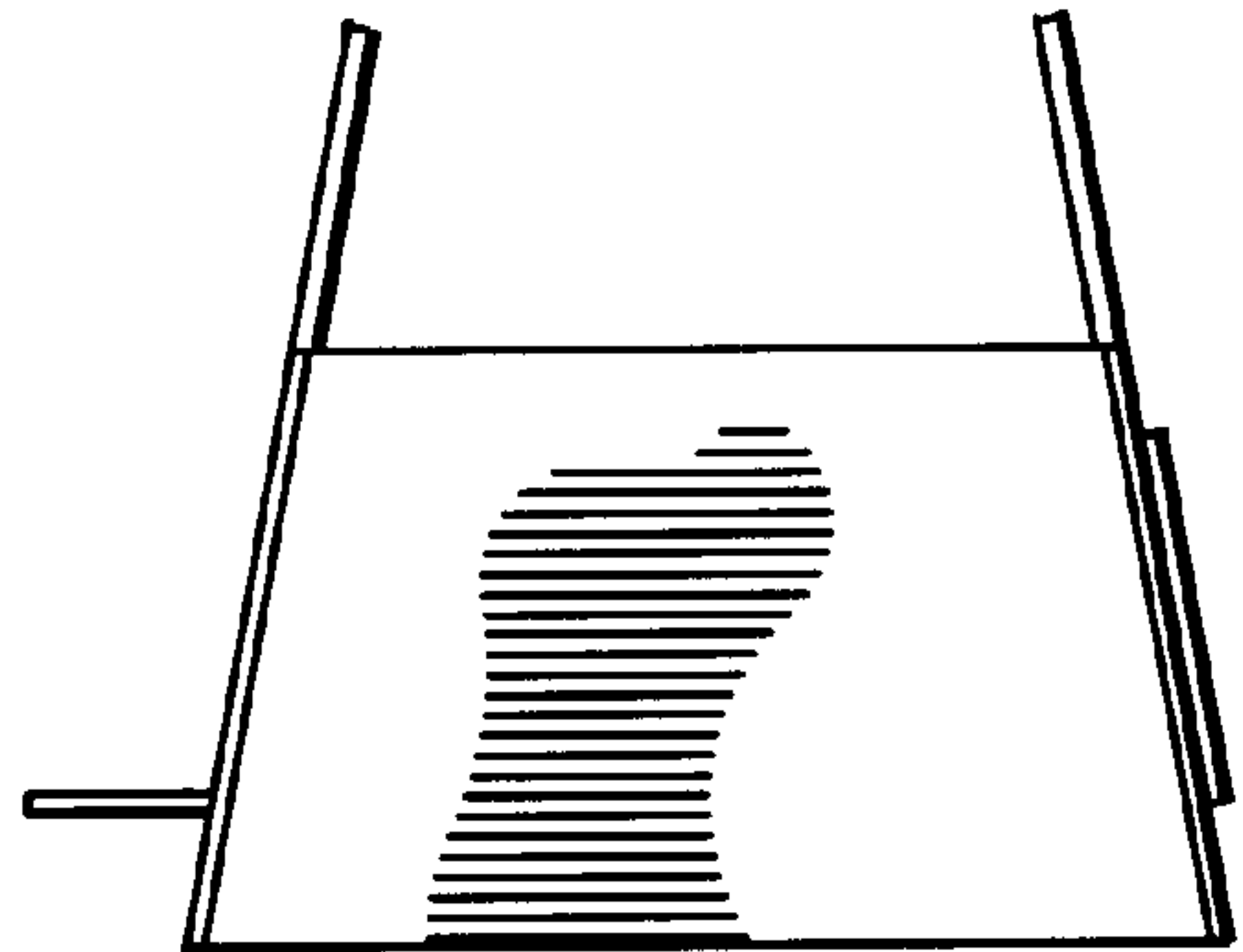

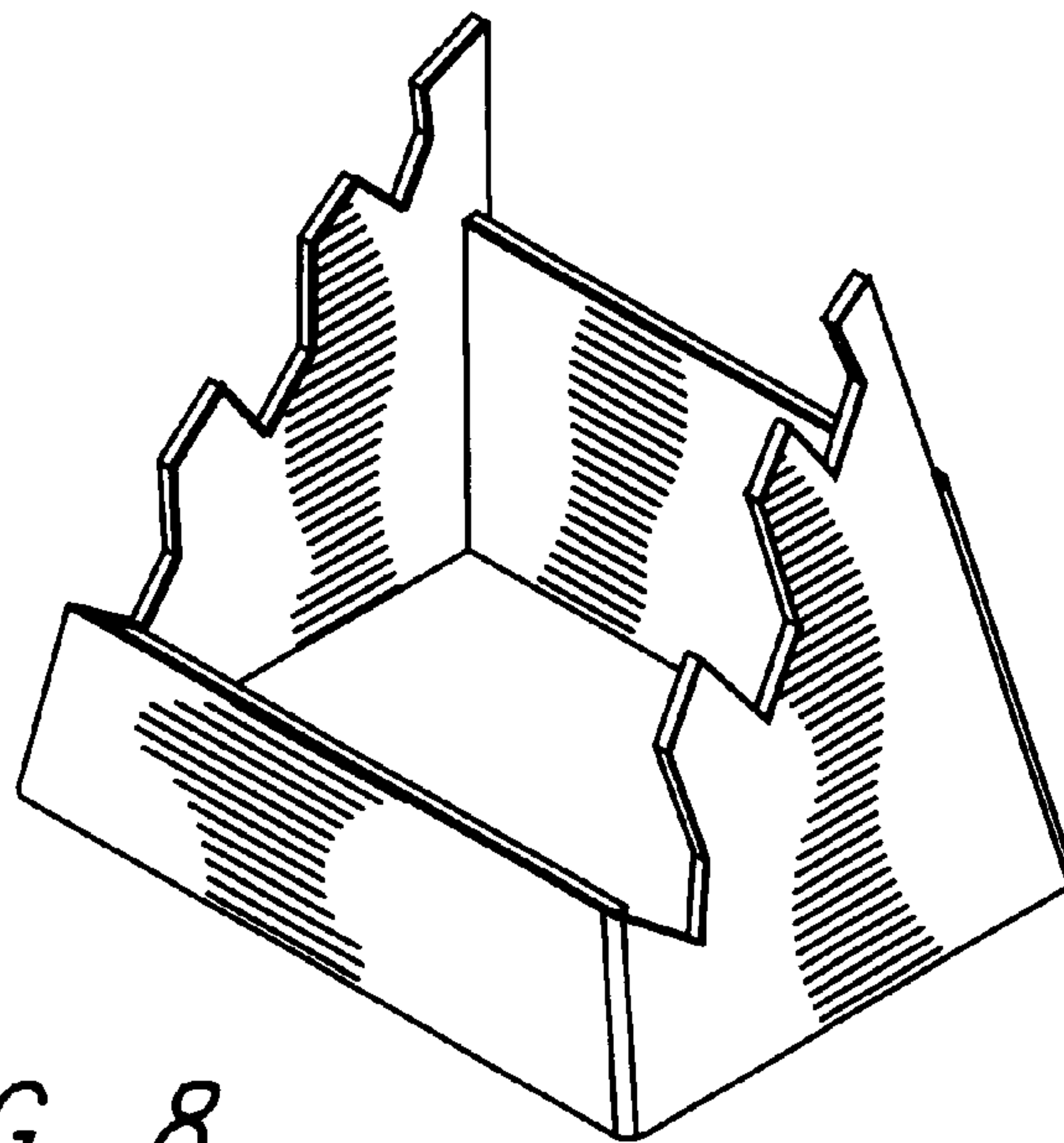
