FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

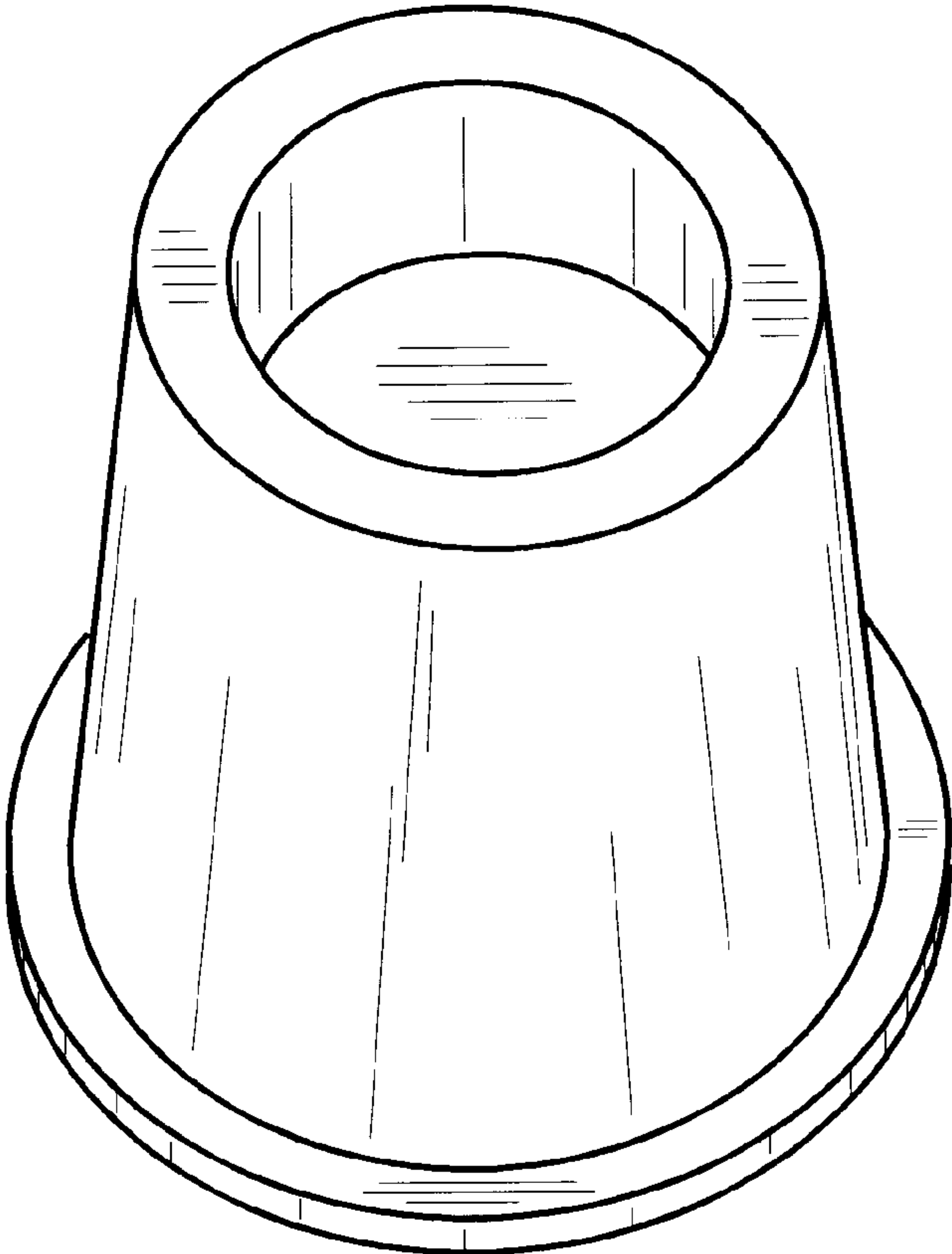
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the first embodiment of the present invention;

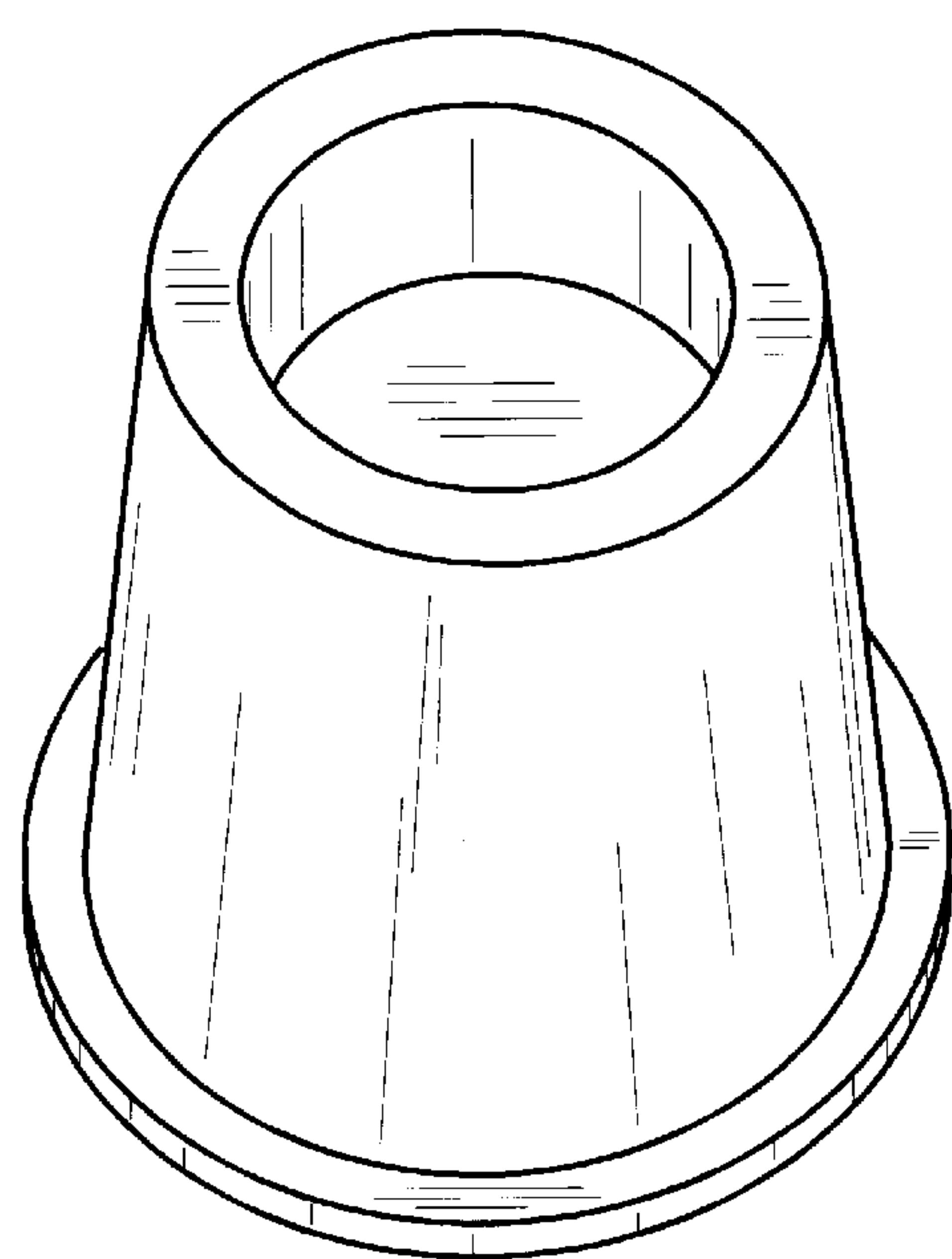

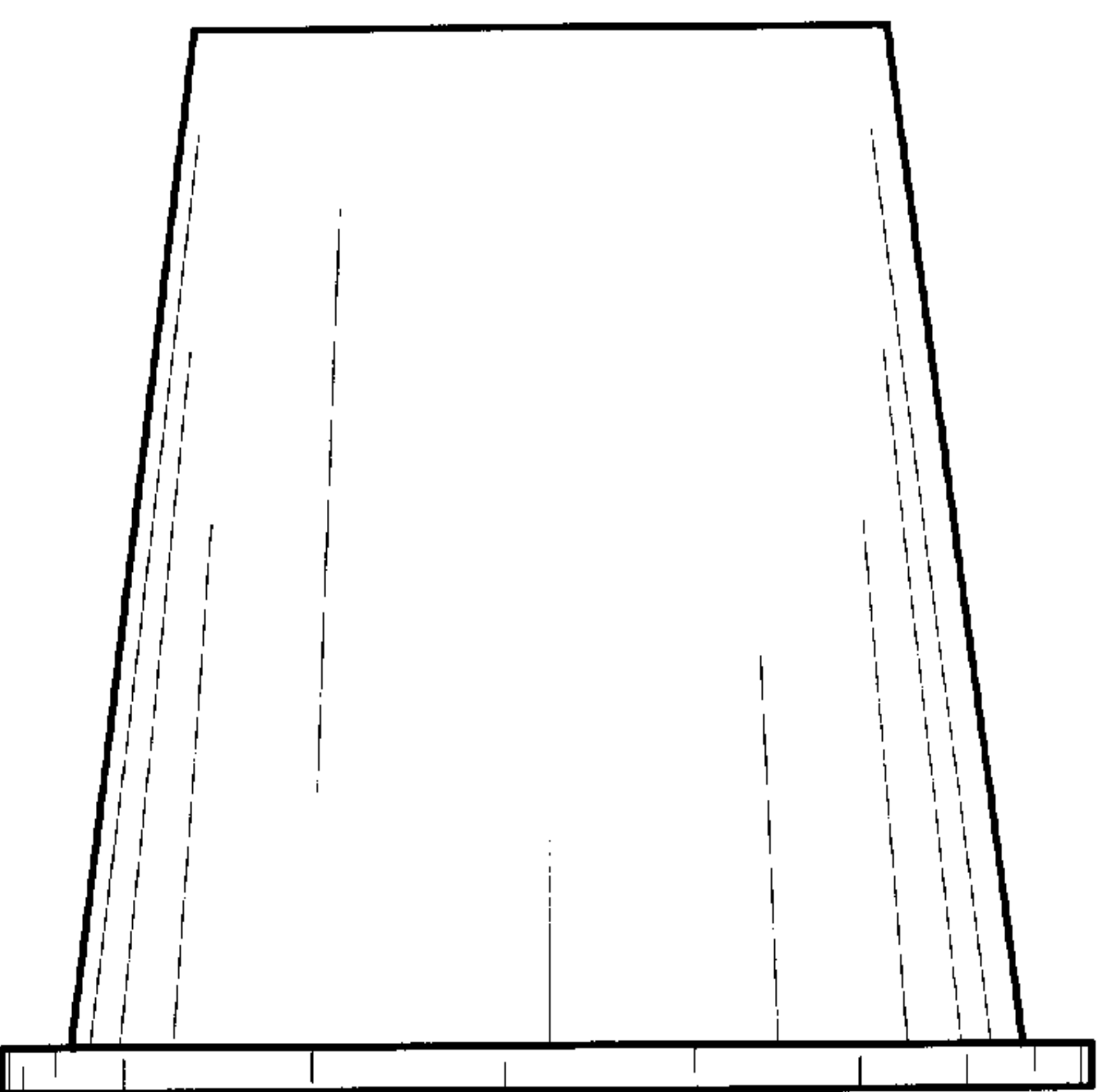

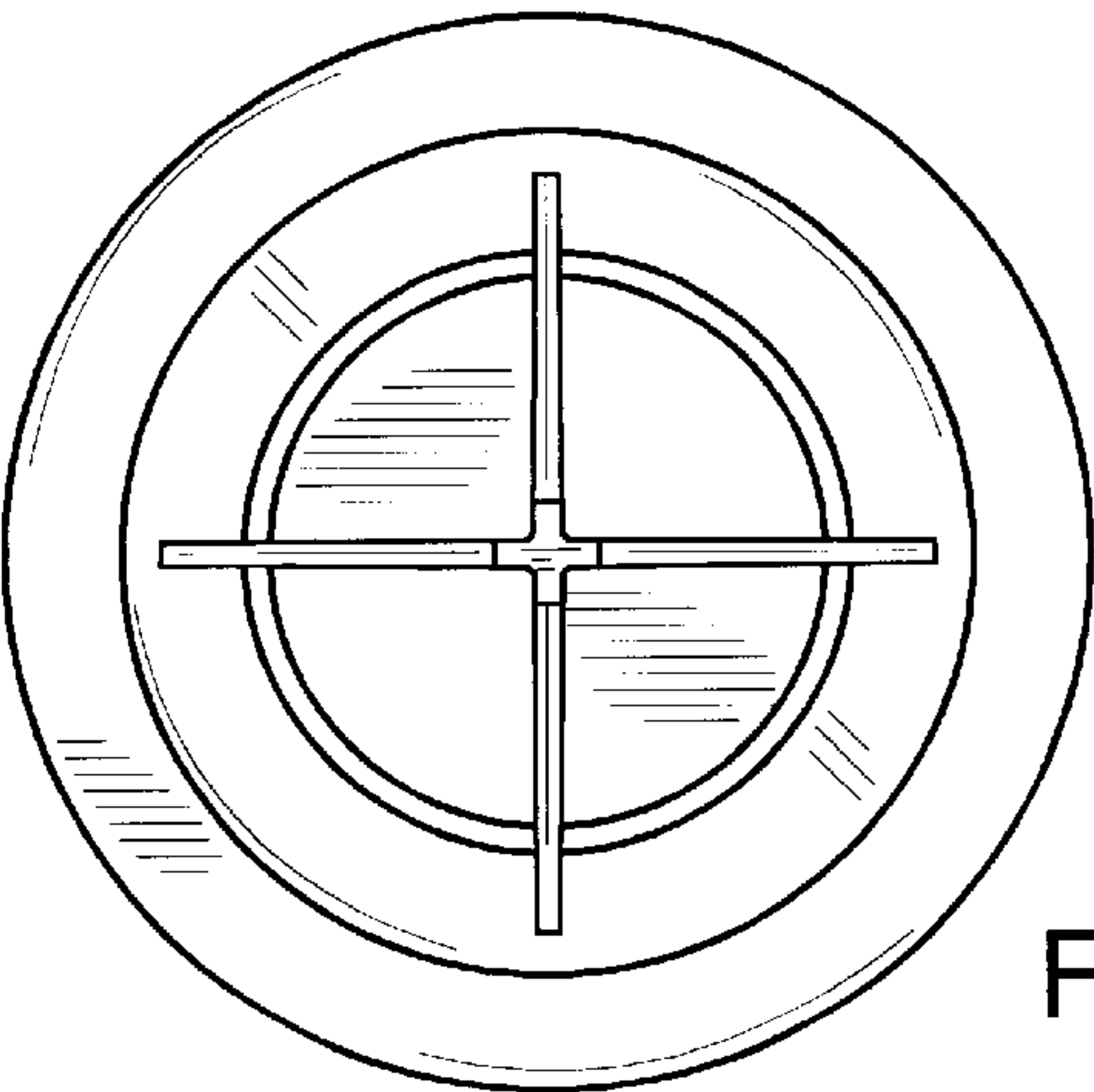

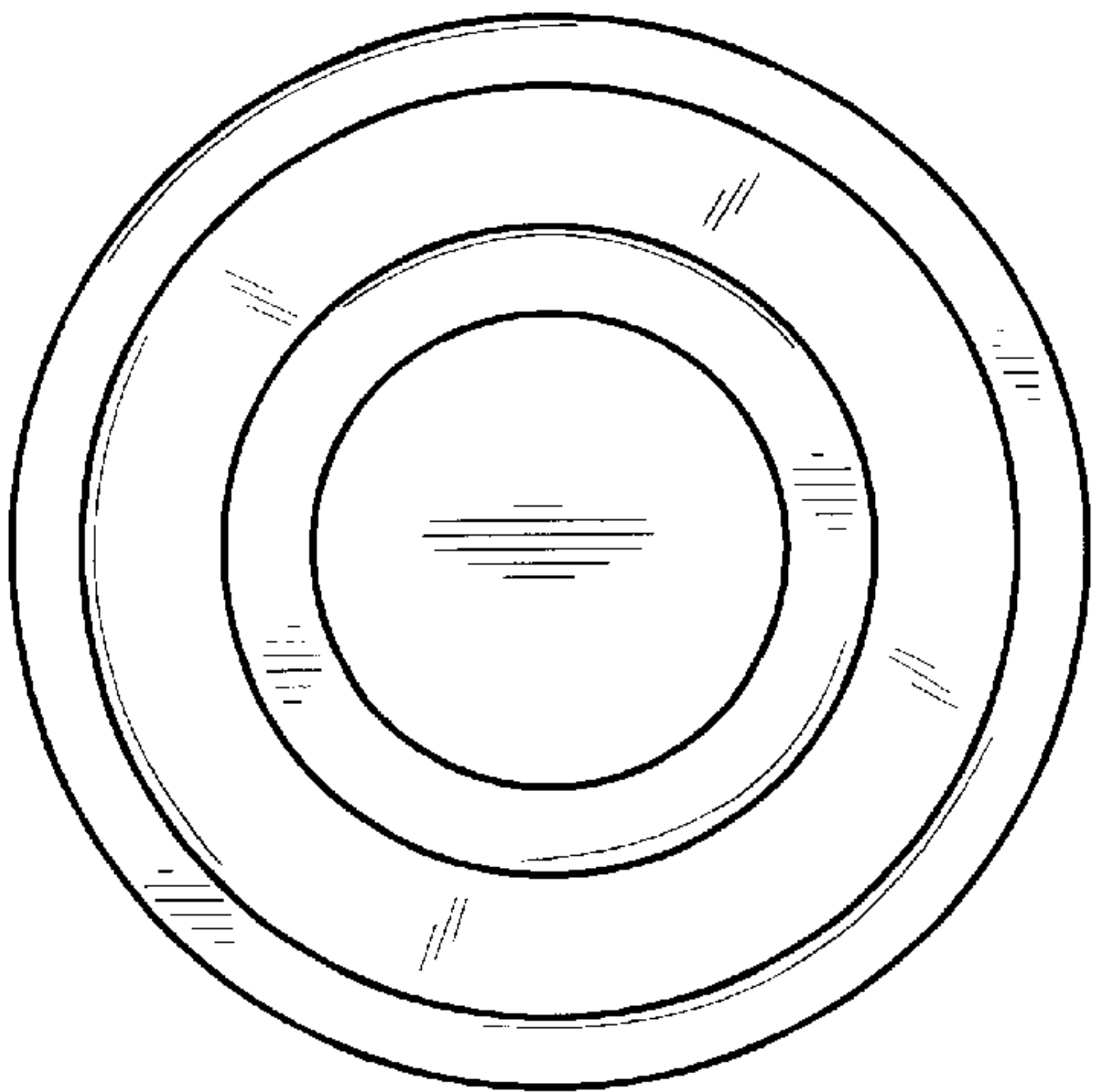

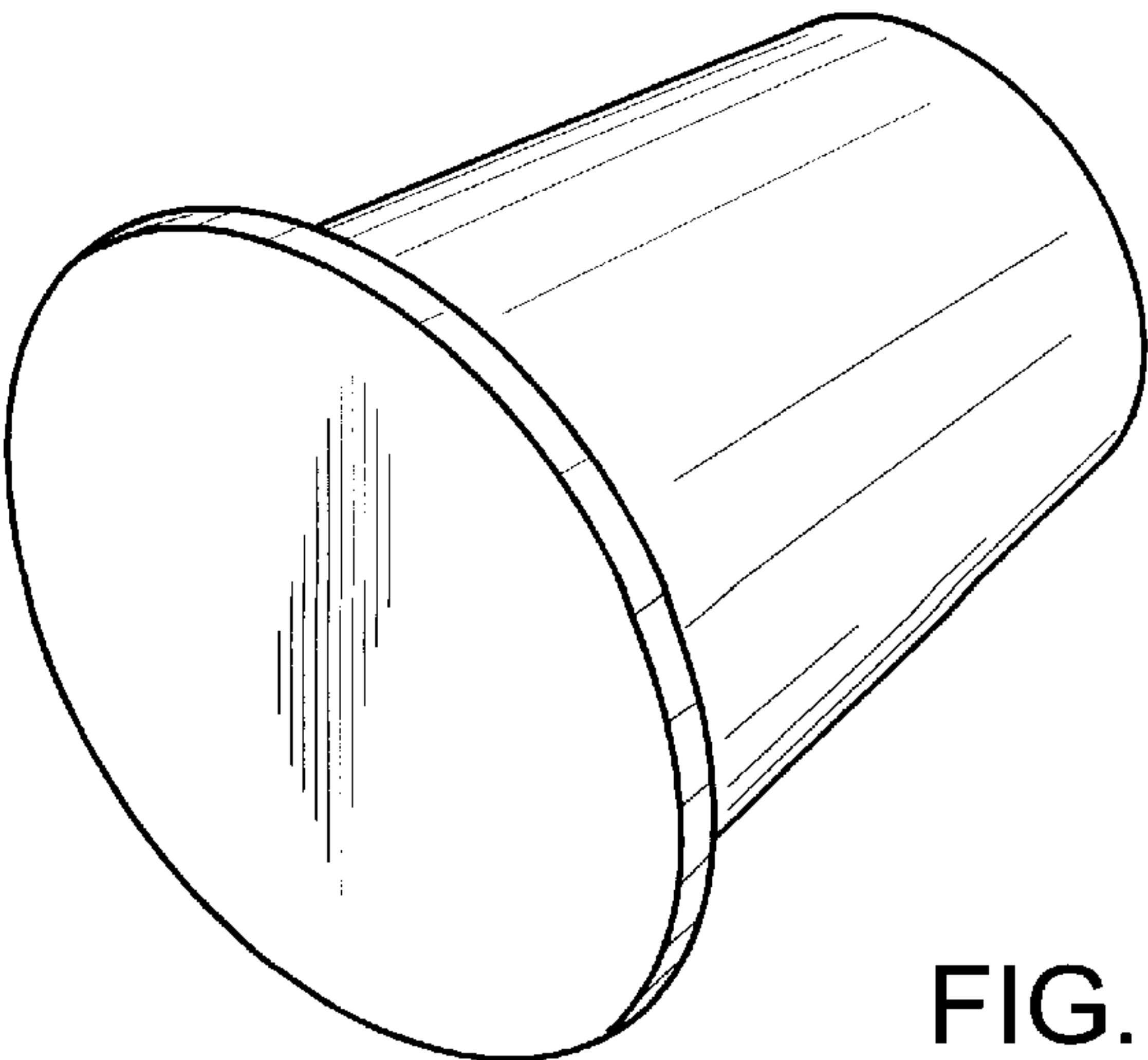
