FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.

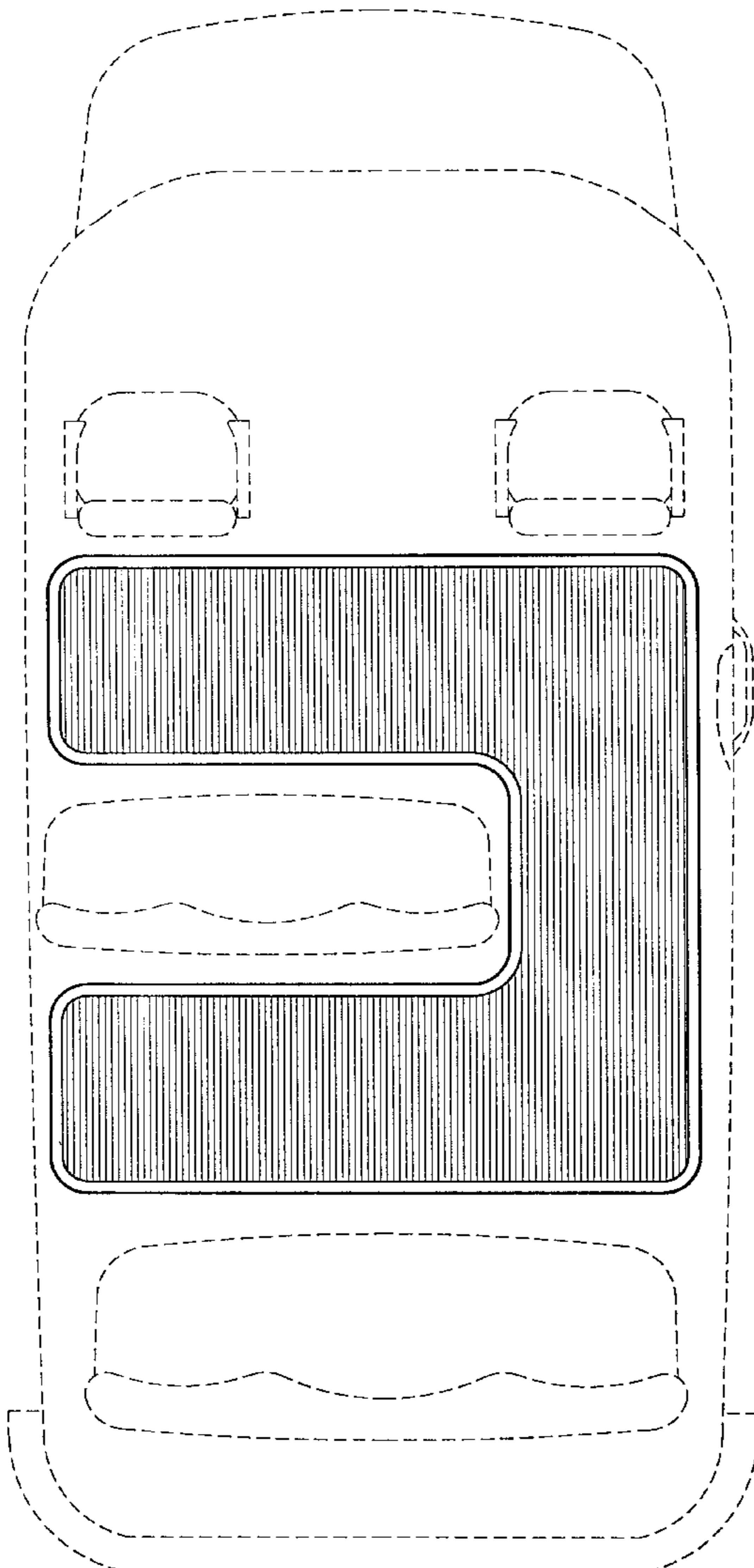
In the drawings, the broken line showing of environmental structure is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

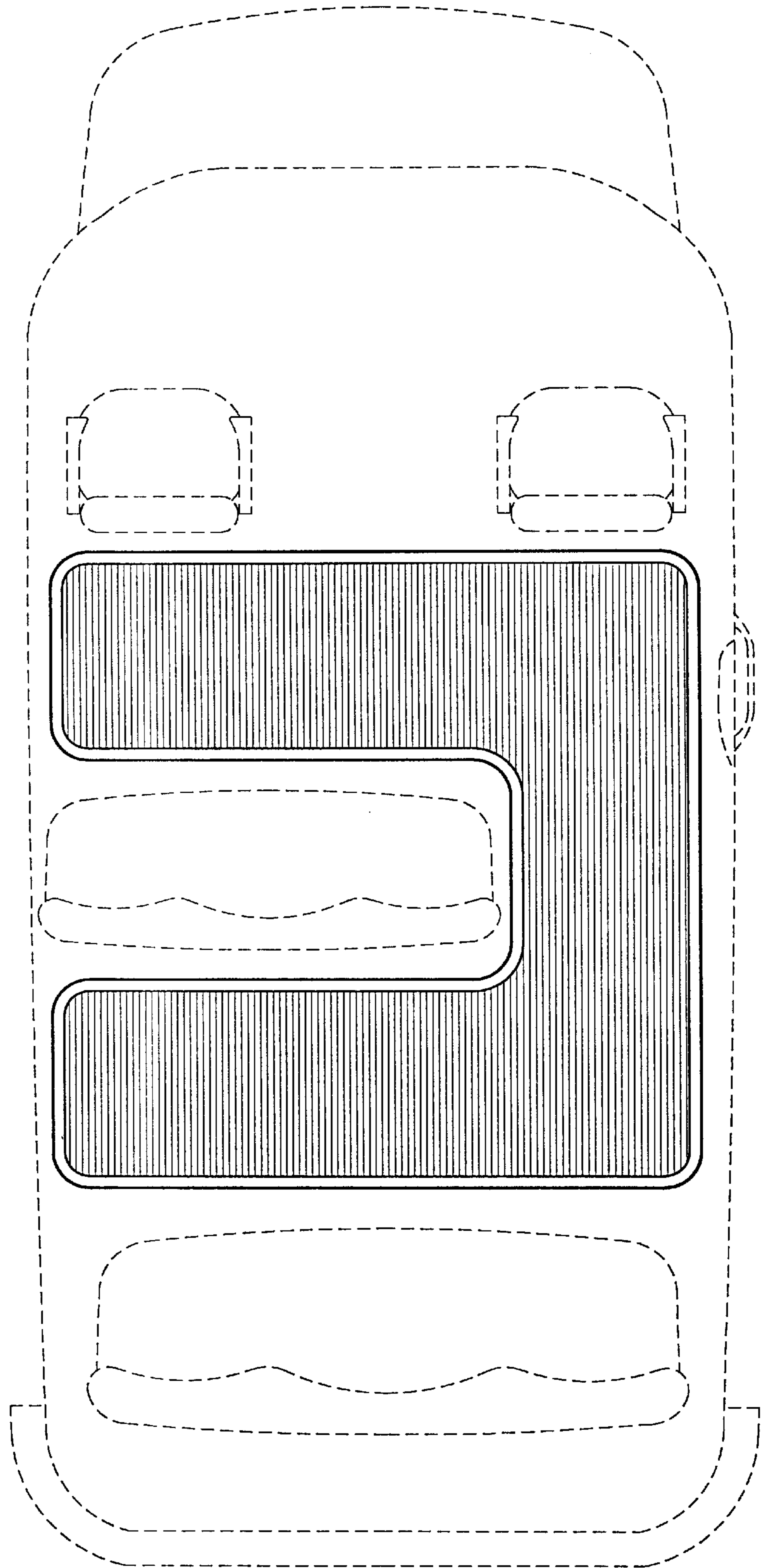

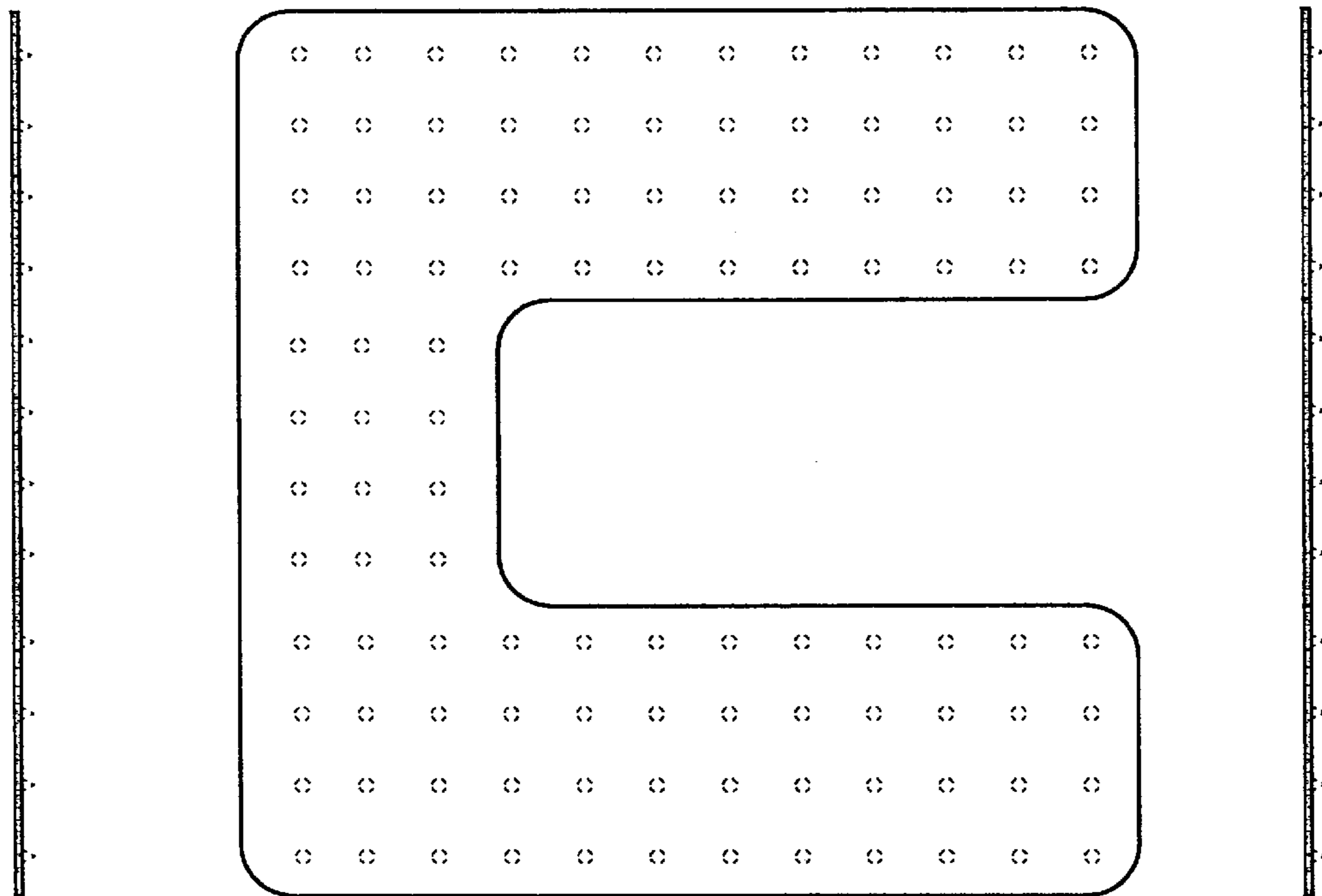
