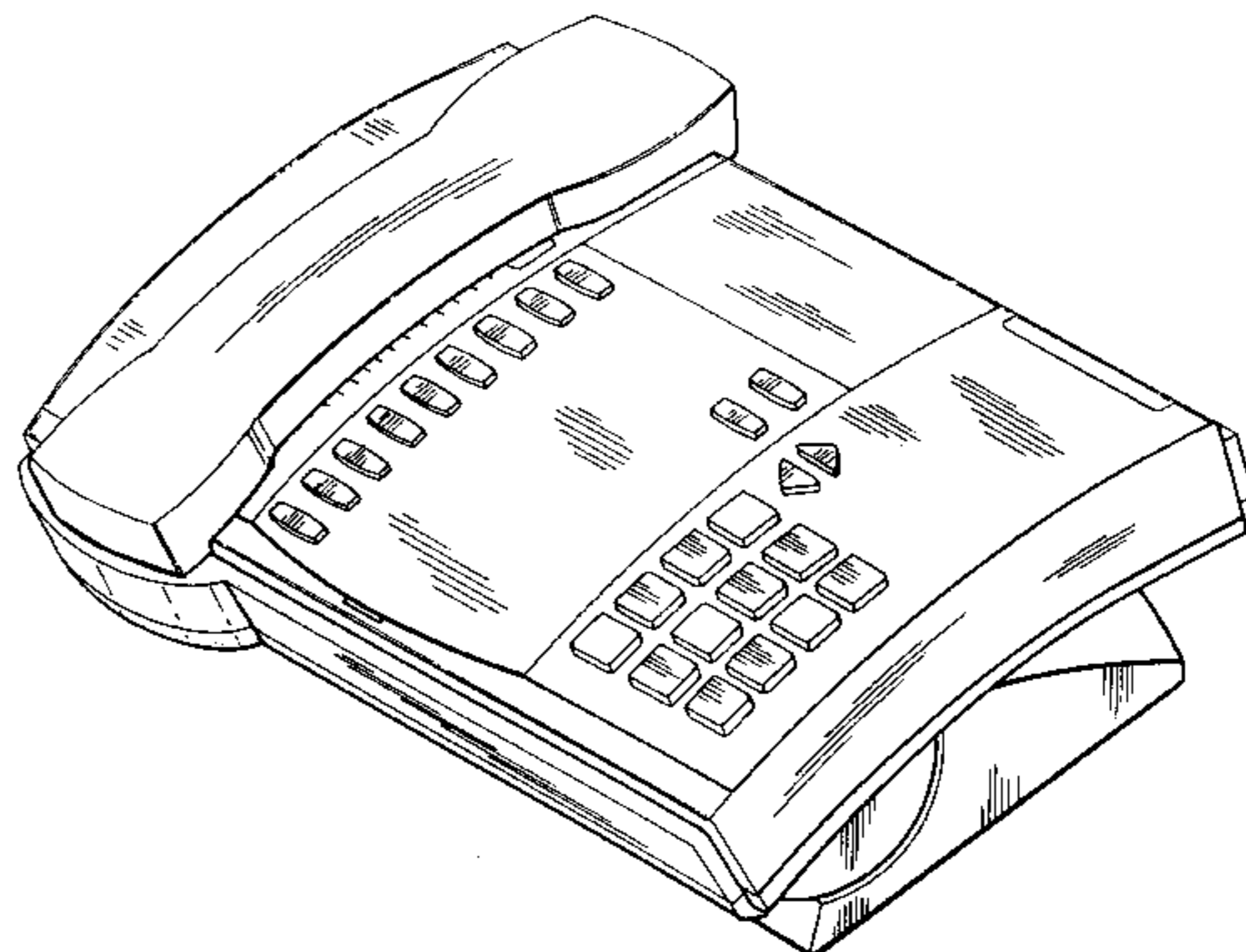
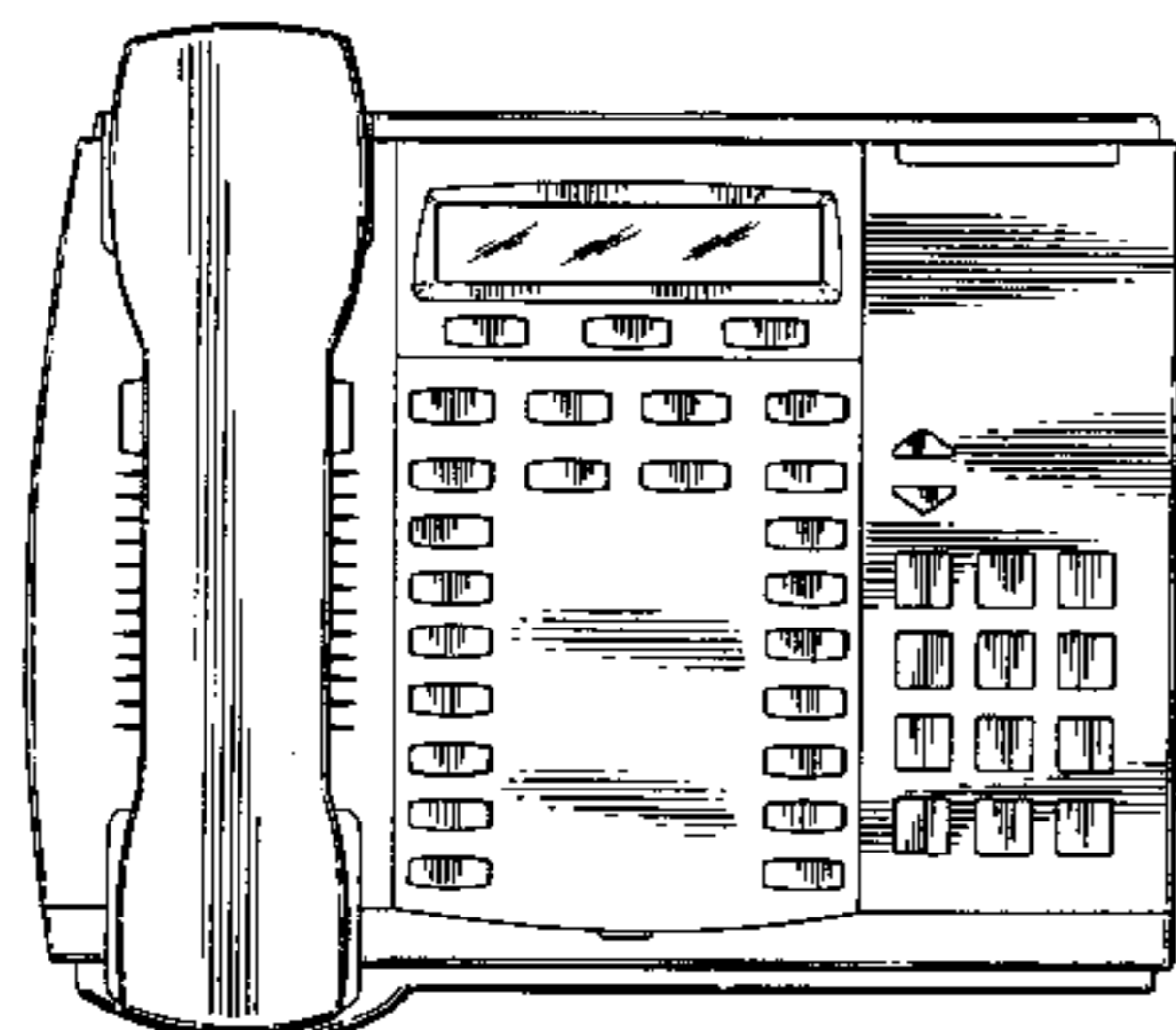
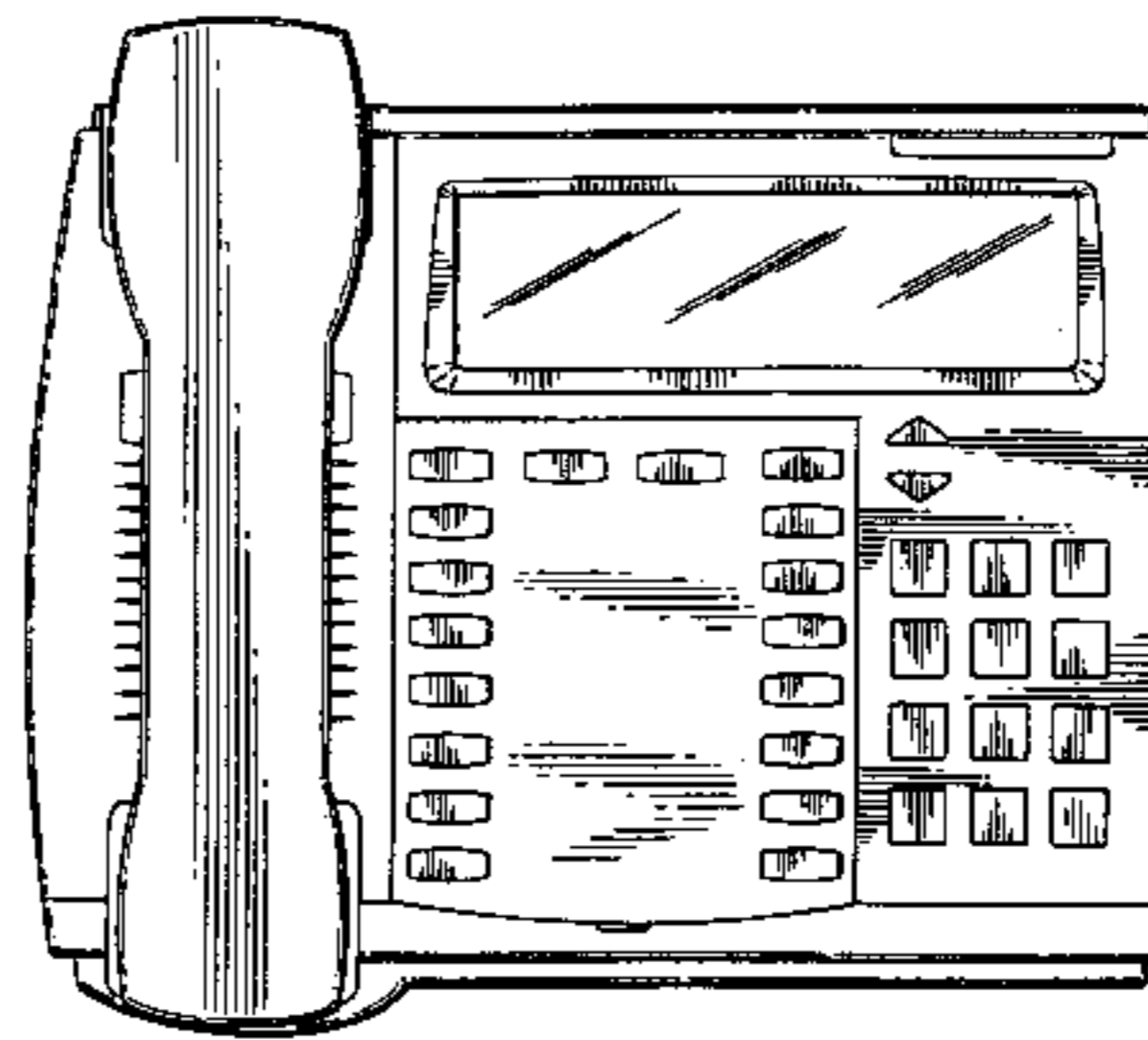
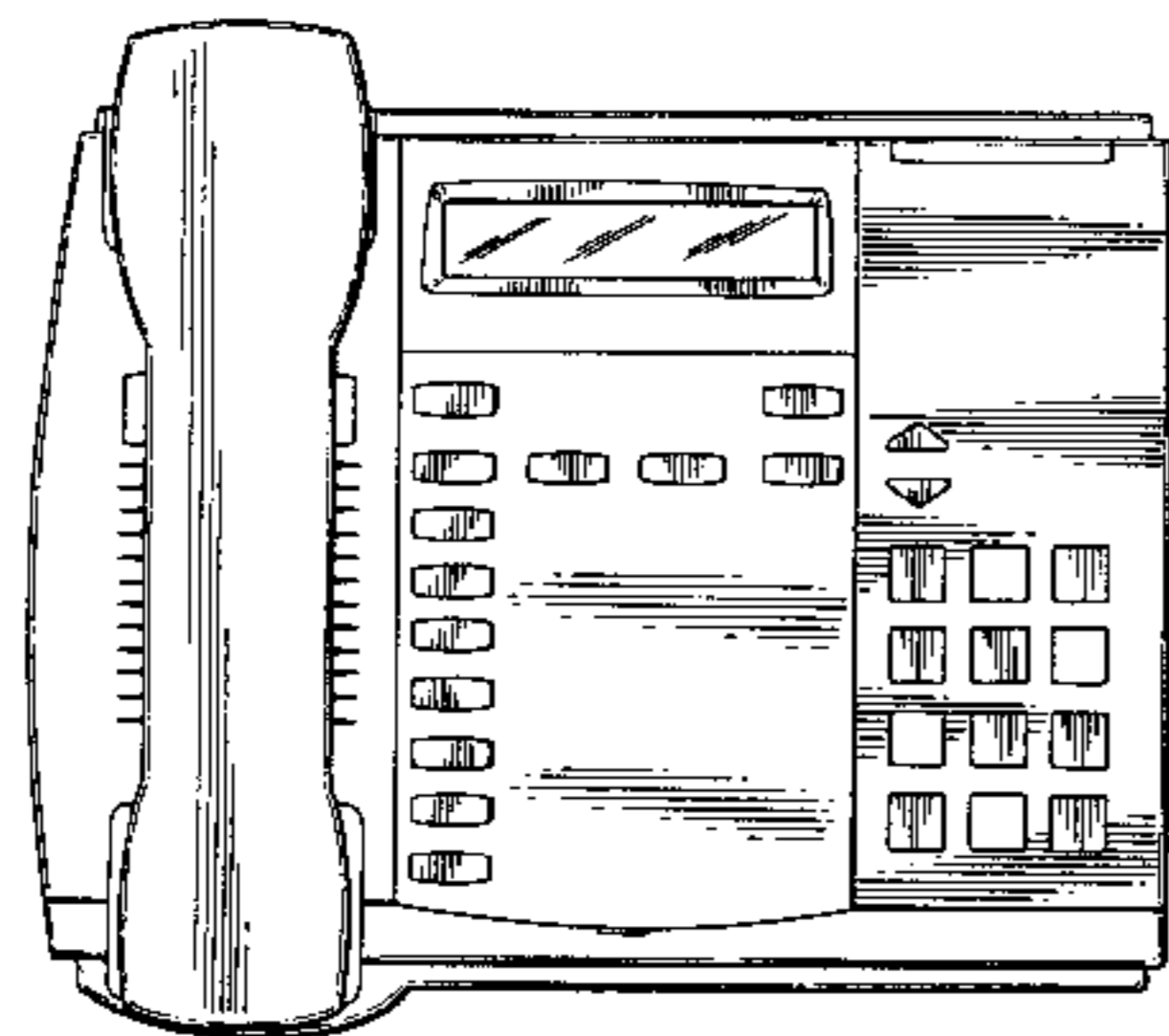

 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the telephone set shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of the telephone set shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of the telephone set shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the first and second embodiments, the right side elevational views being the same for the third and fourth embodiments except for showing one additional and one fewer rows of keys respectively, as shown in the top plan views. The left of each embodiment being a mirror image thereof except that no keys are visible; and,
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the first embodiment.
 The portions of the claimed article not shown in the drawings are not considered to be part of my claimed design.

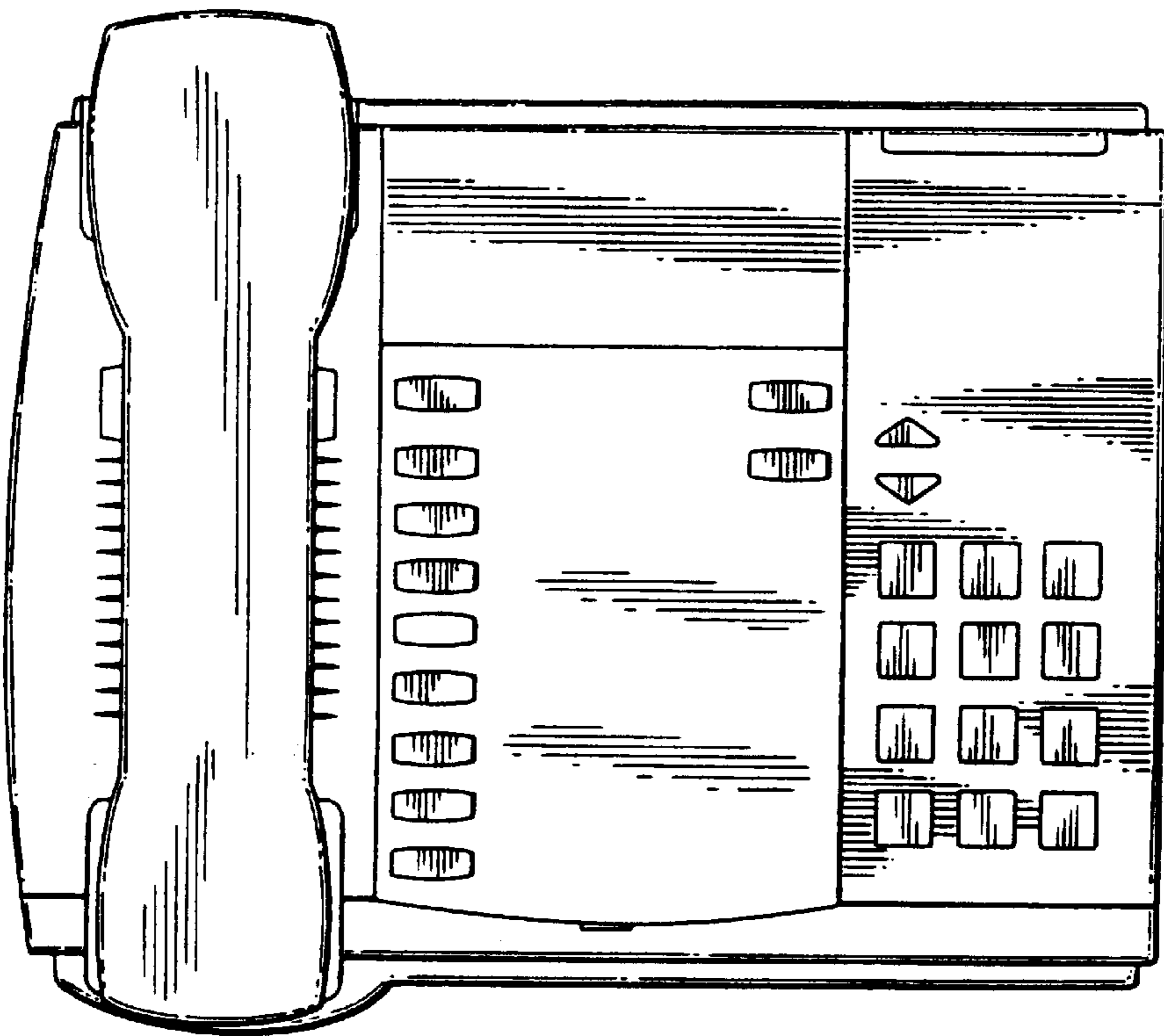

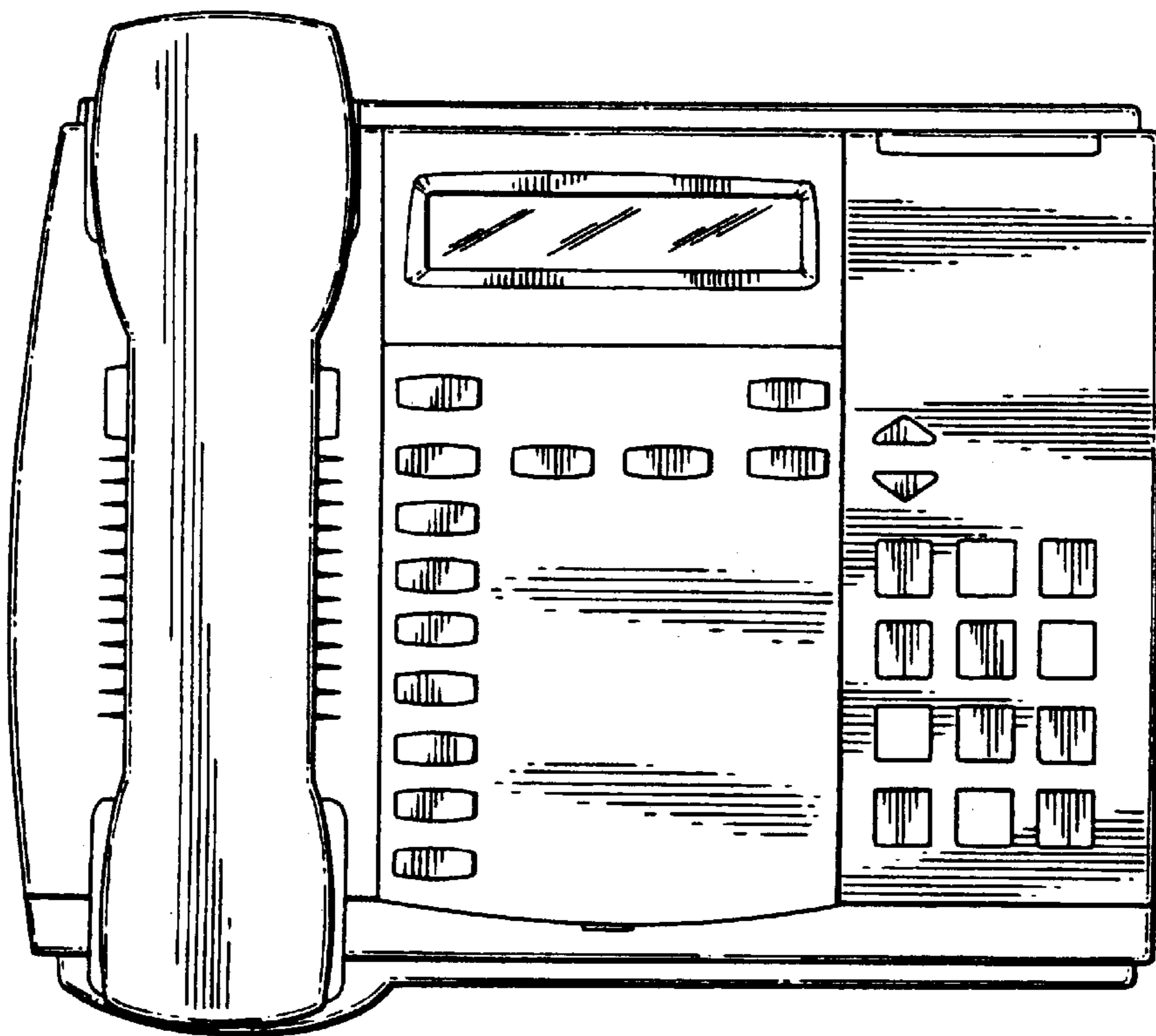

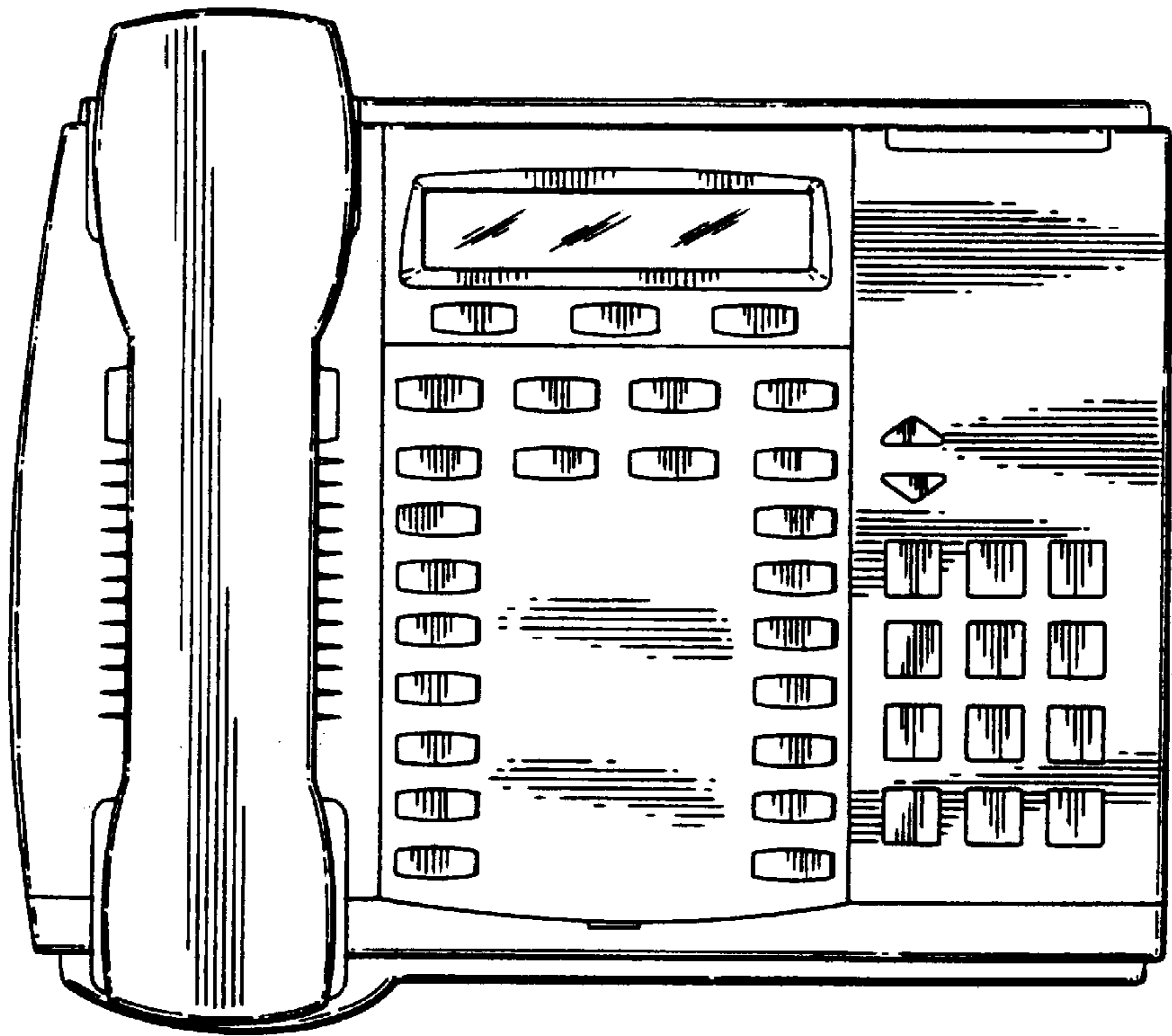

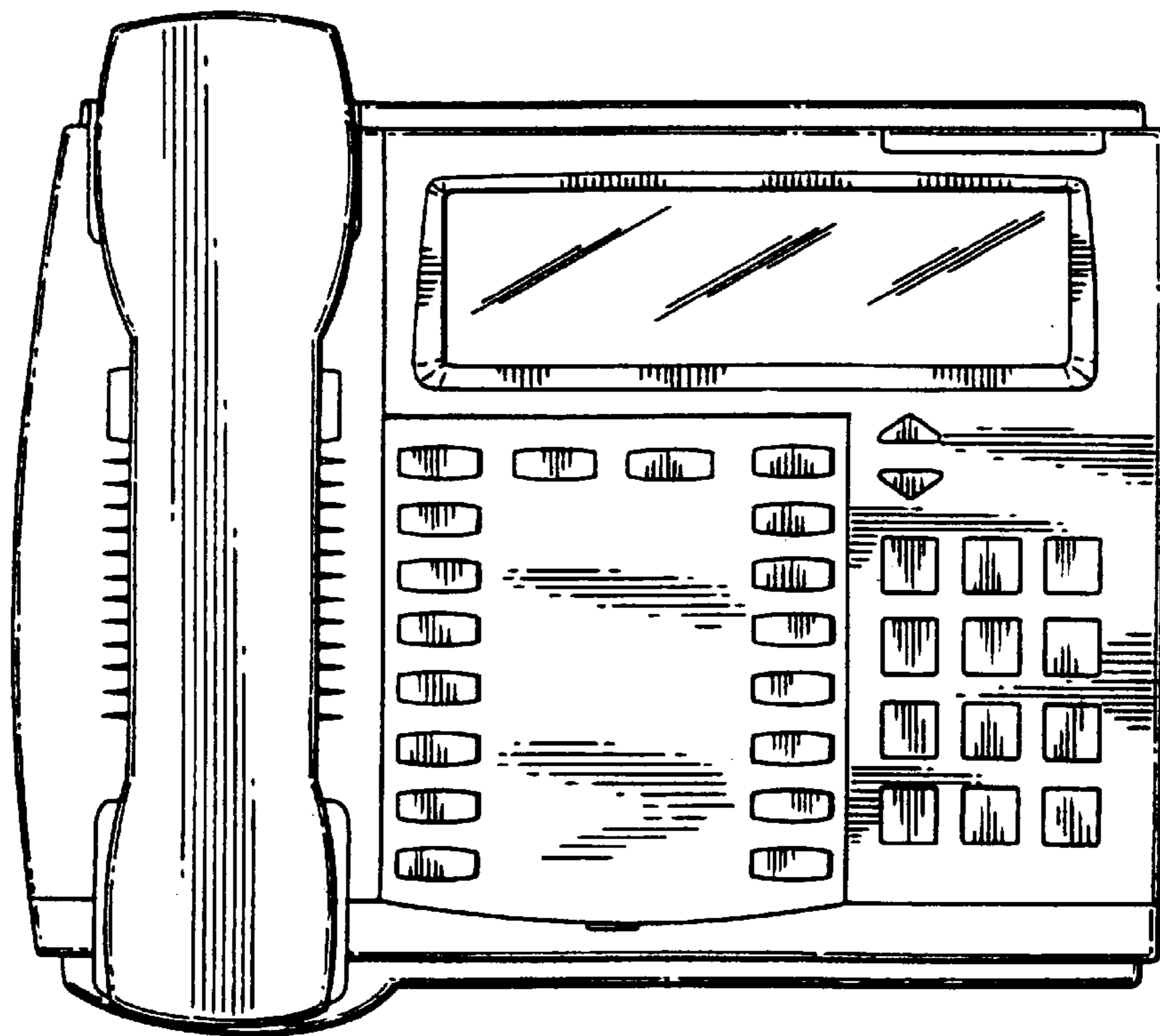

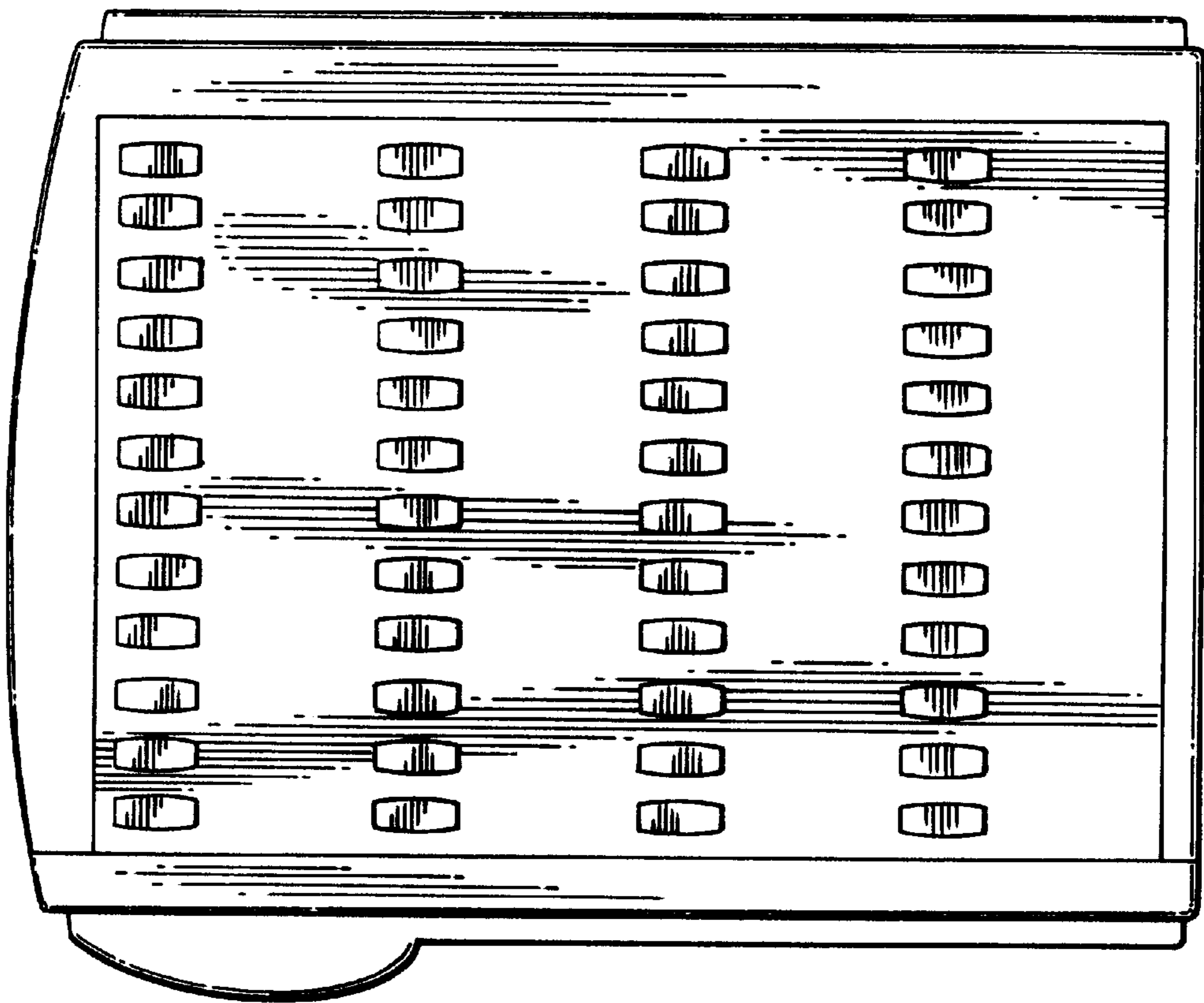

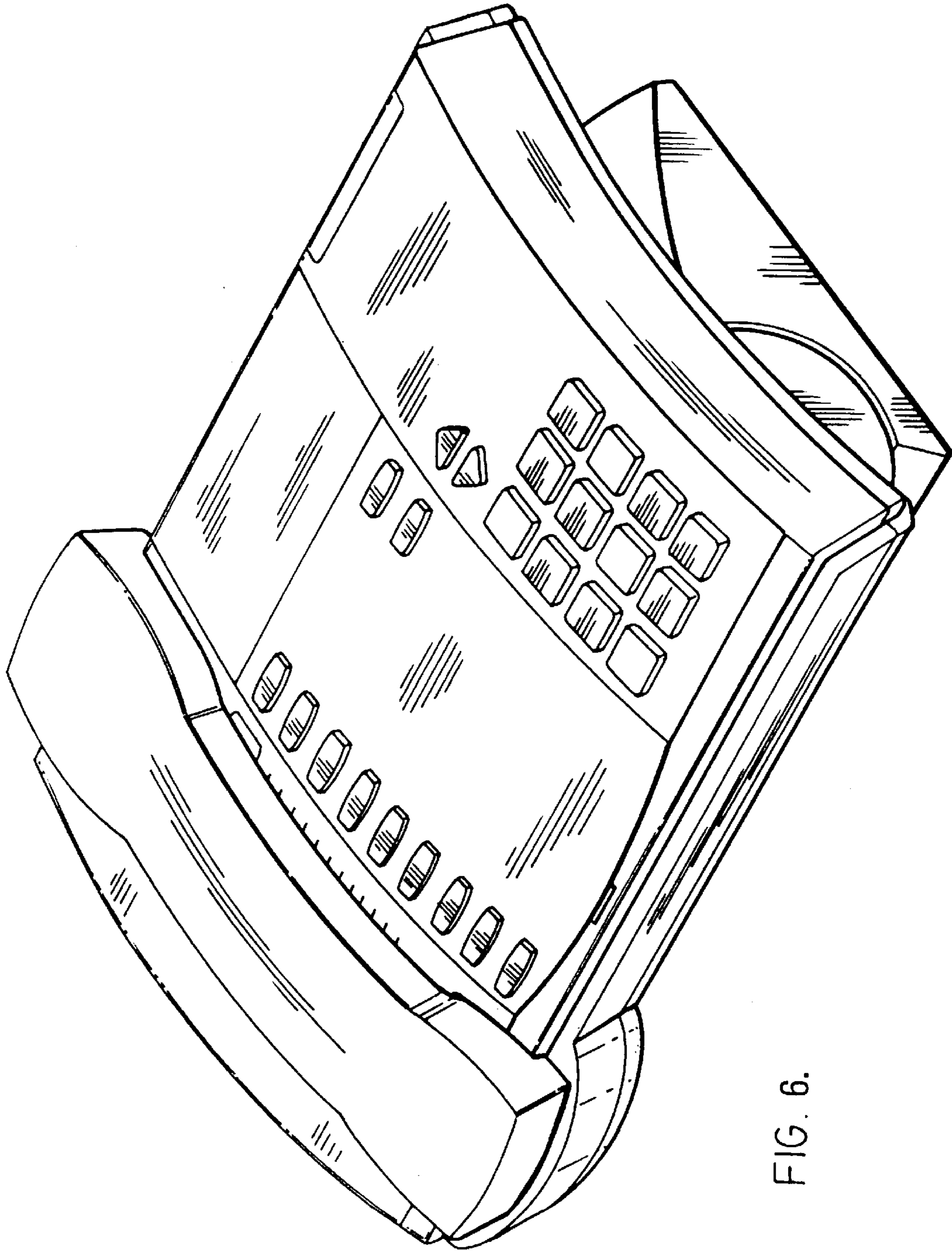
