[57] CLAIM

The ornamental designs for a toy sandal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper pictorial view of the toy sandal and its design features with attachment straps generally shown in phantom for illustrative purposes only and do not form a part of the present invention;

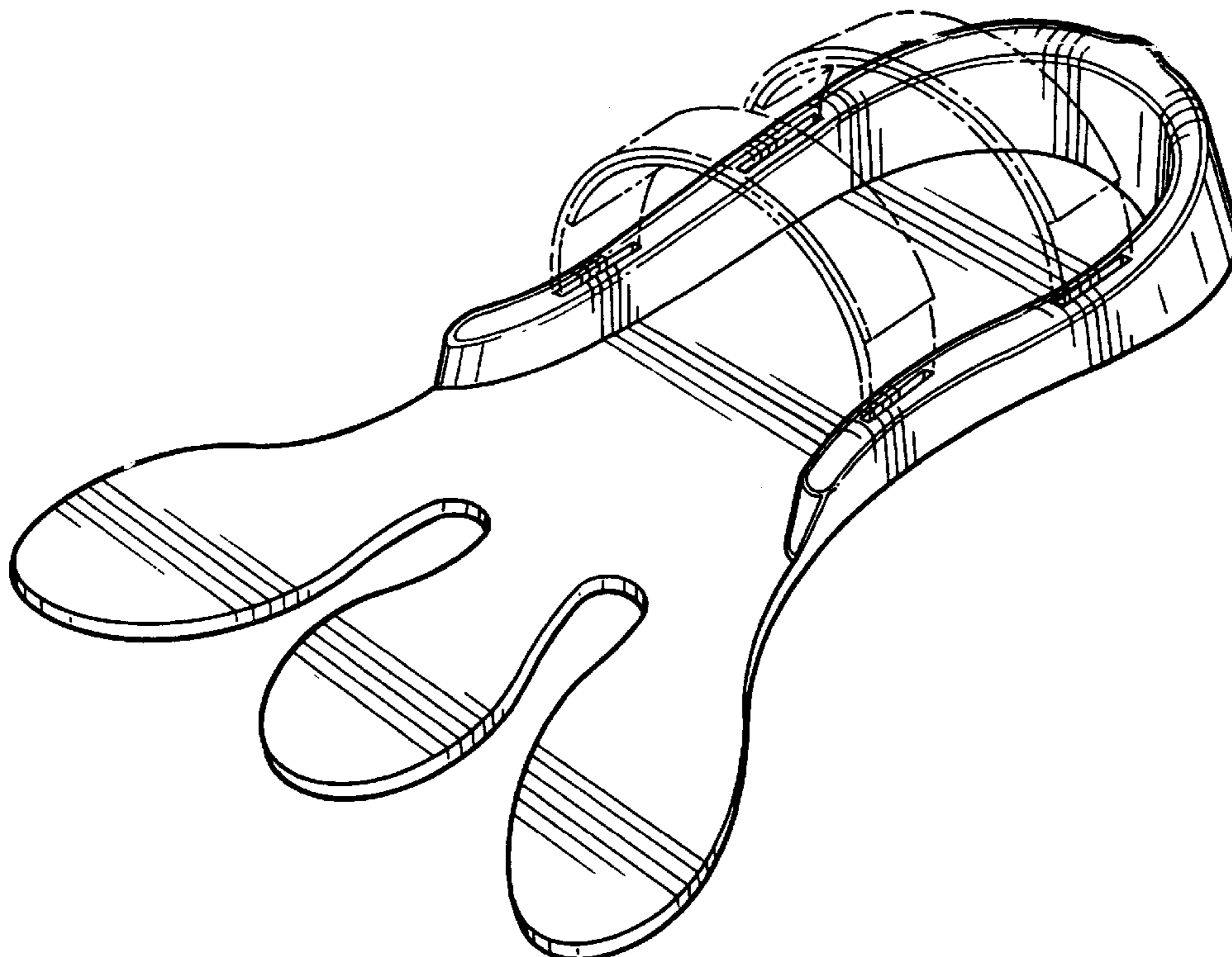
FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a bottom elevational view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1 taken in a direction towards the toes;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1 taken generally along the line in the direction of the arrows 7—7 in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view of the toy sandal of FIG. 1 taken along the line in the direction of the arrows 8—8 in FIG. 2.

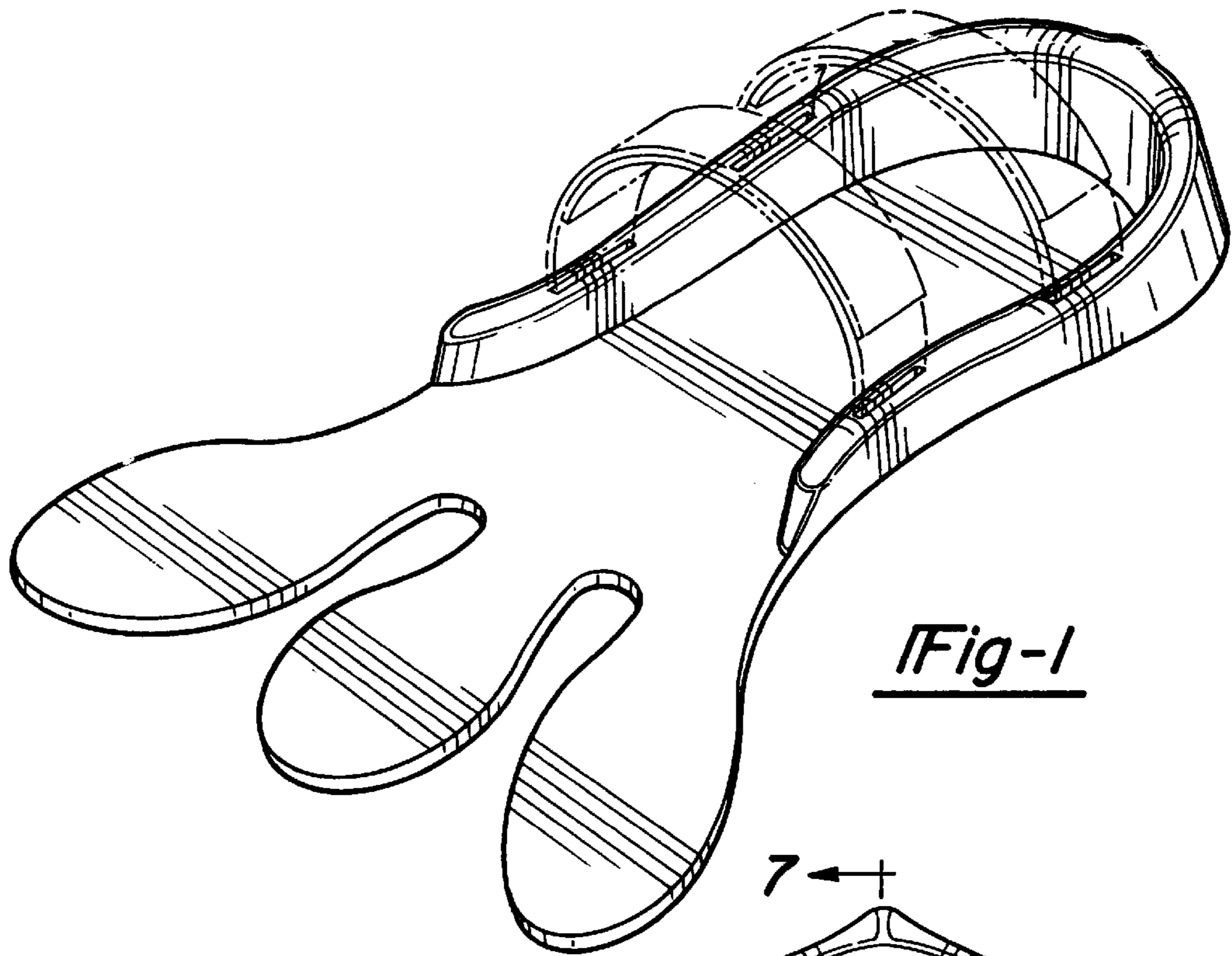

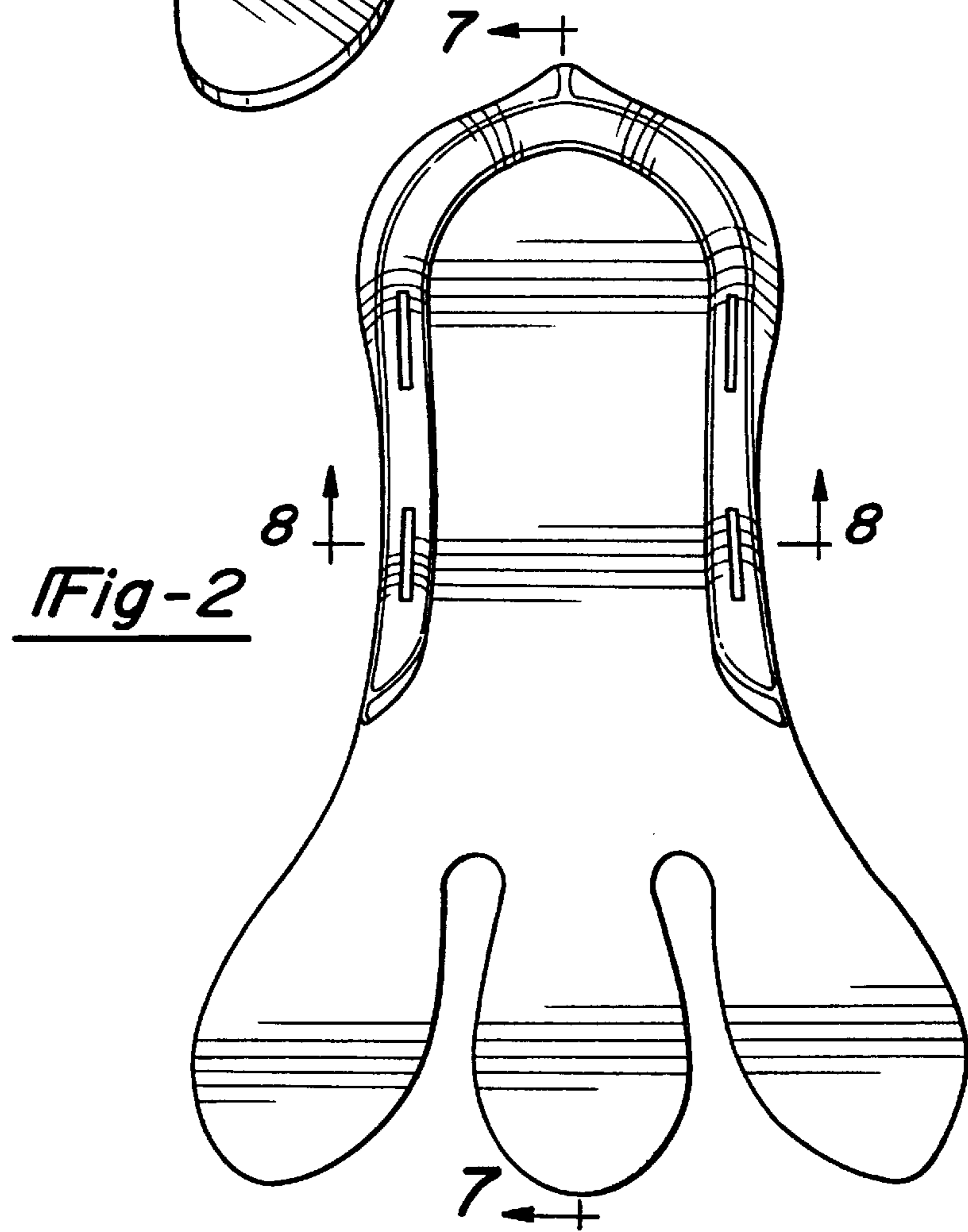

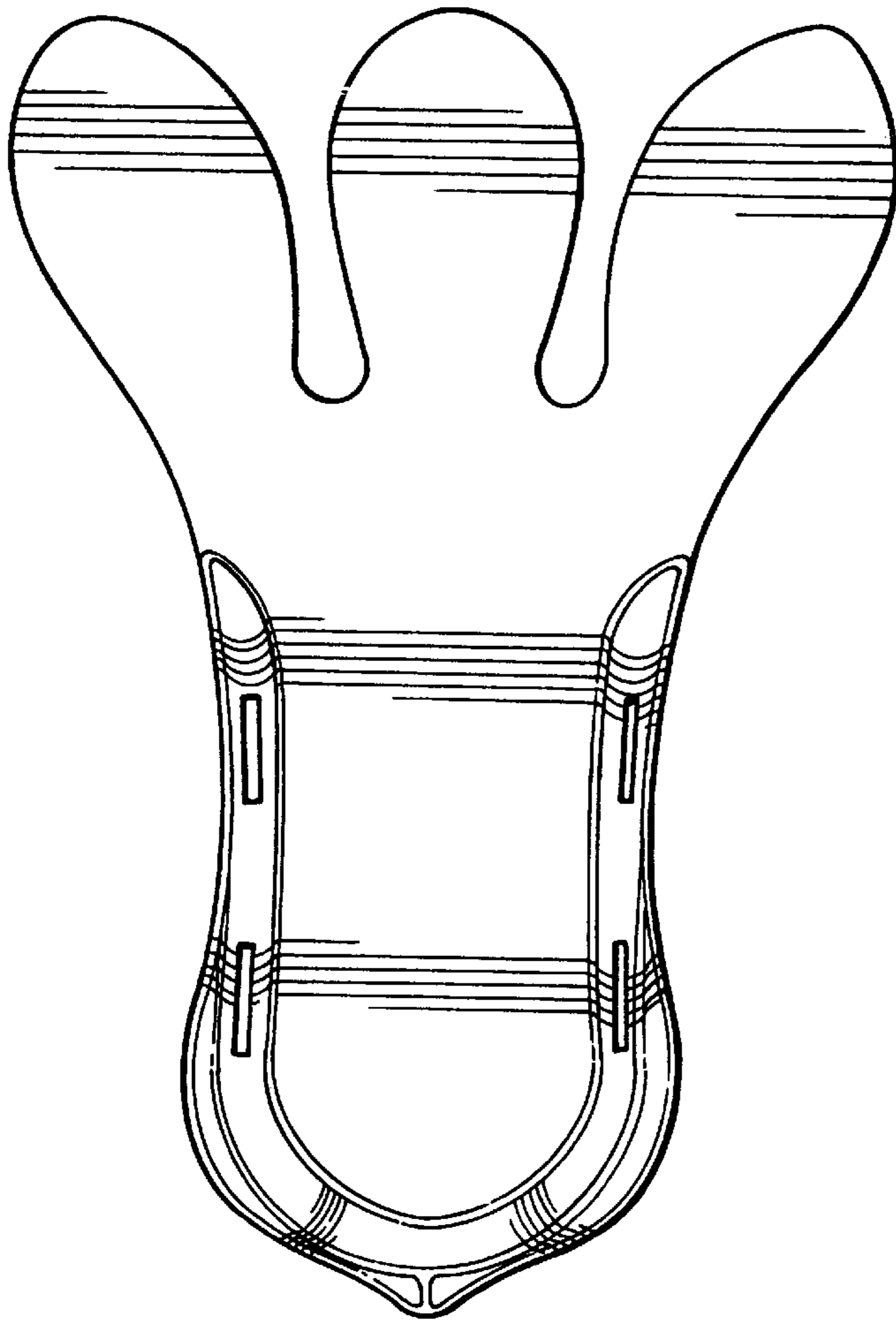

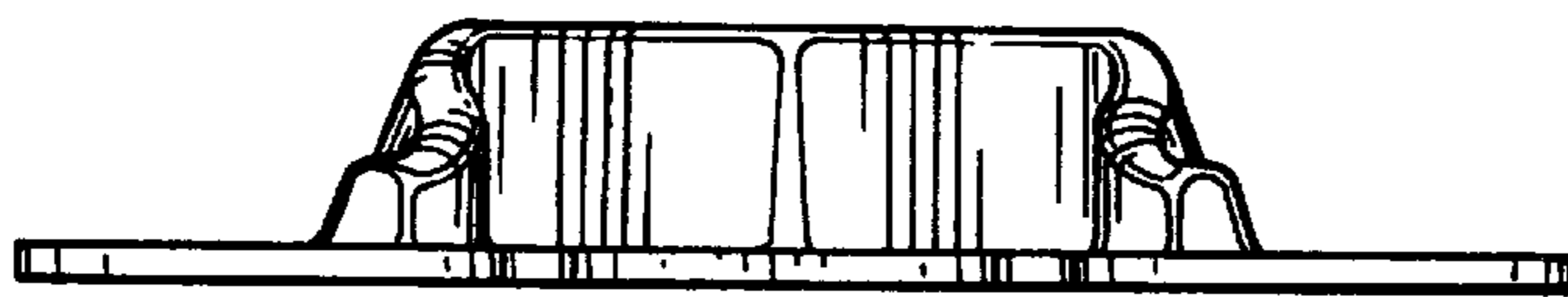
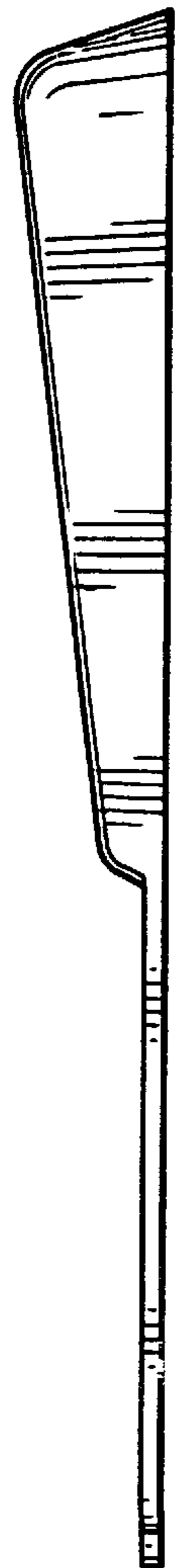

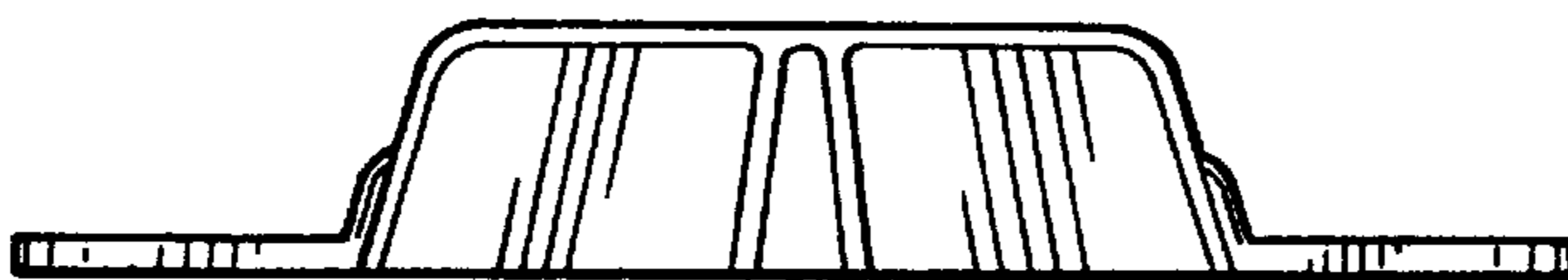

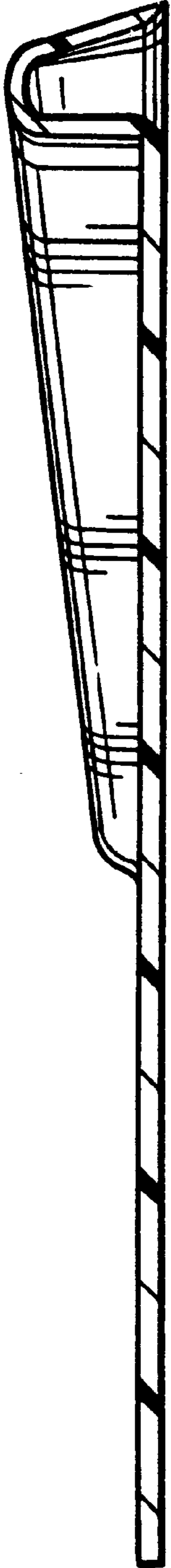

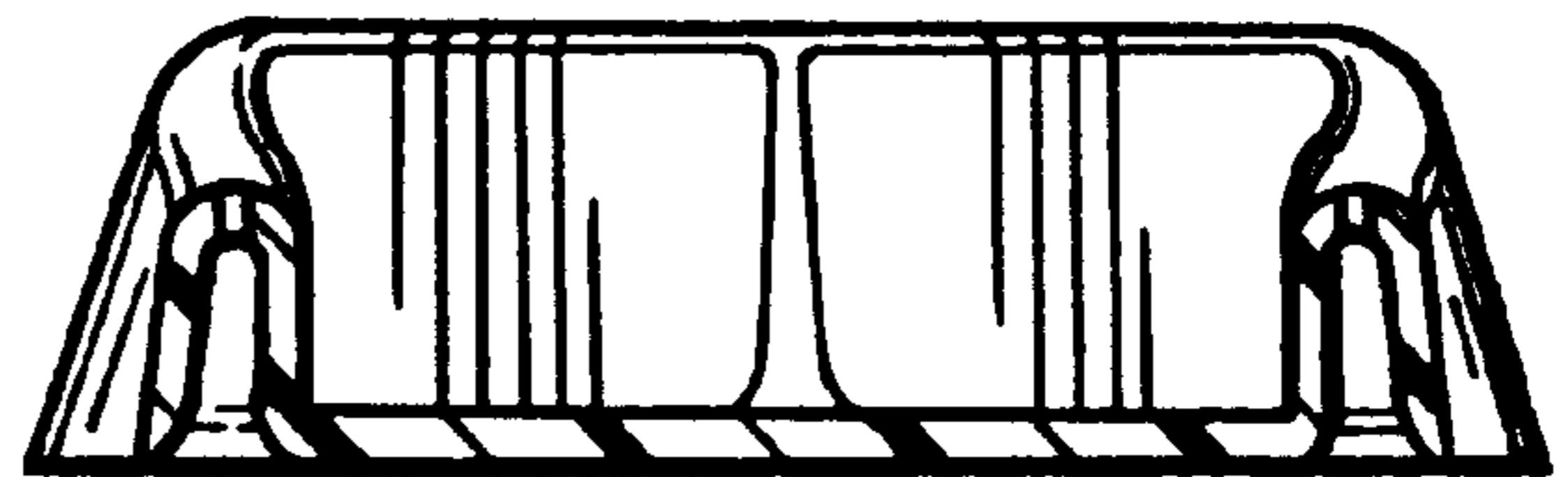
