FIG. 2 is an end elevational view of the desk shown in FIG. 1 opposite the end shown in FIG. 1, but shown at an enlarged scale;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the desk shown in FIG. 1, but shown at an enlarged scale;


FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the desk shown in FIG. 1, but shown at an enlarged scale;
















