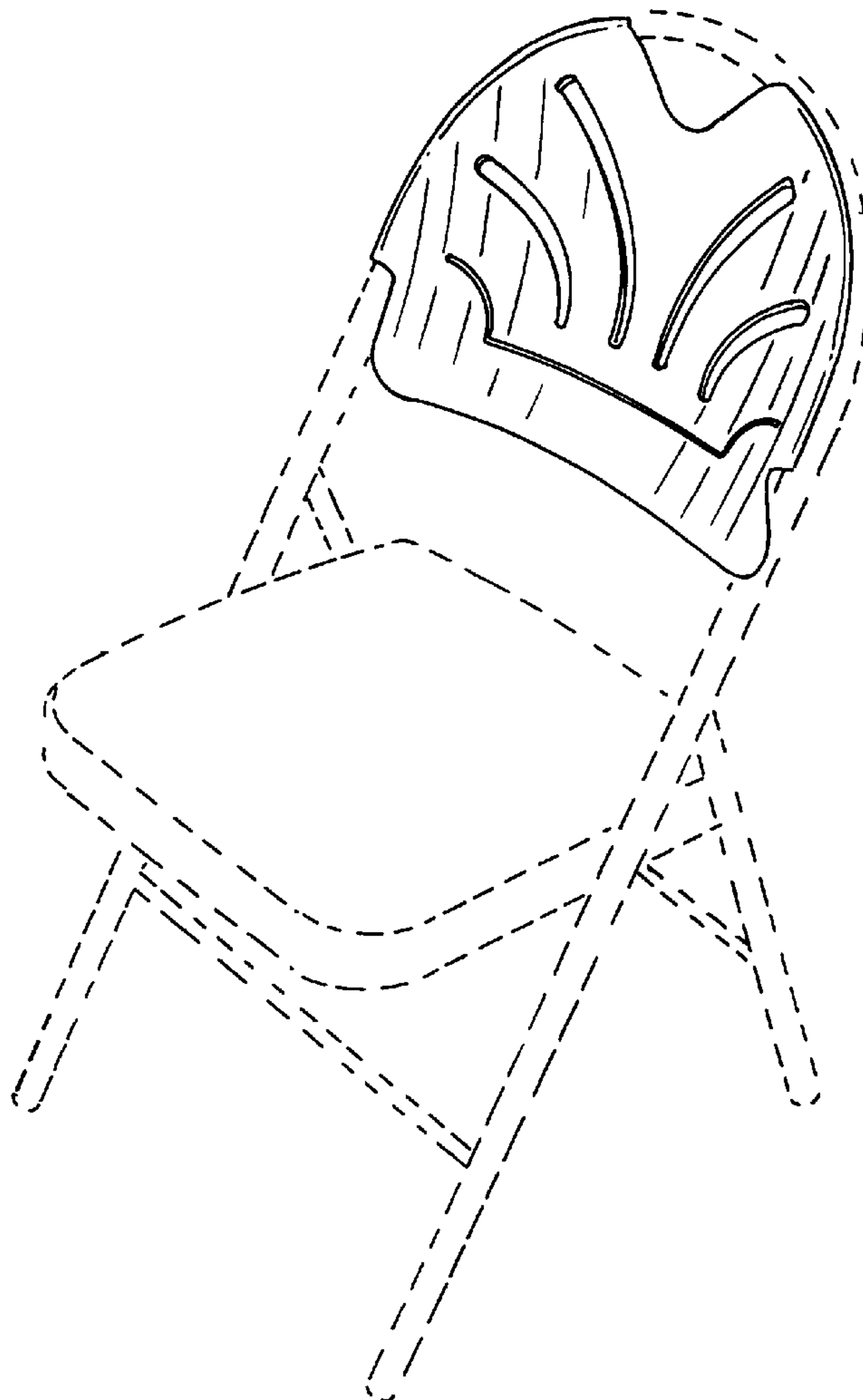
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair back in accordance with our design;

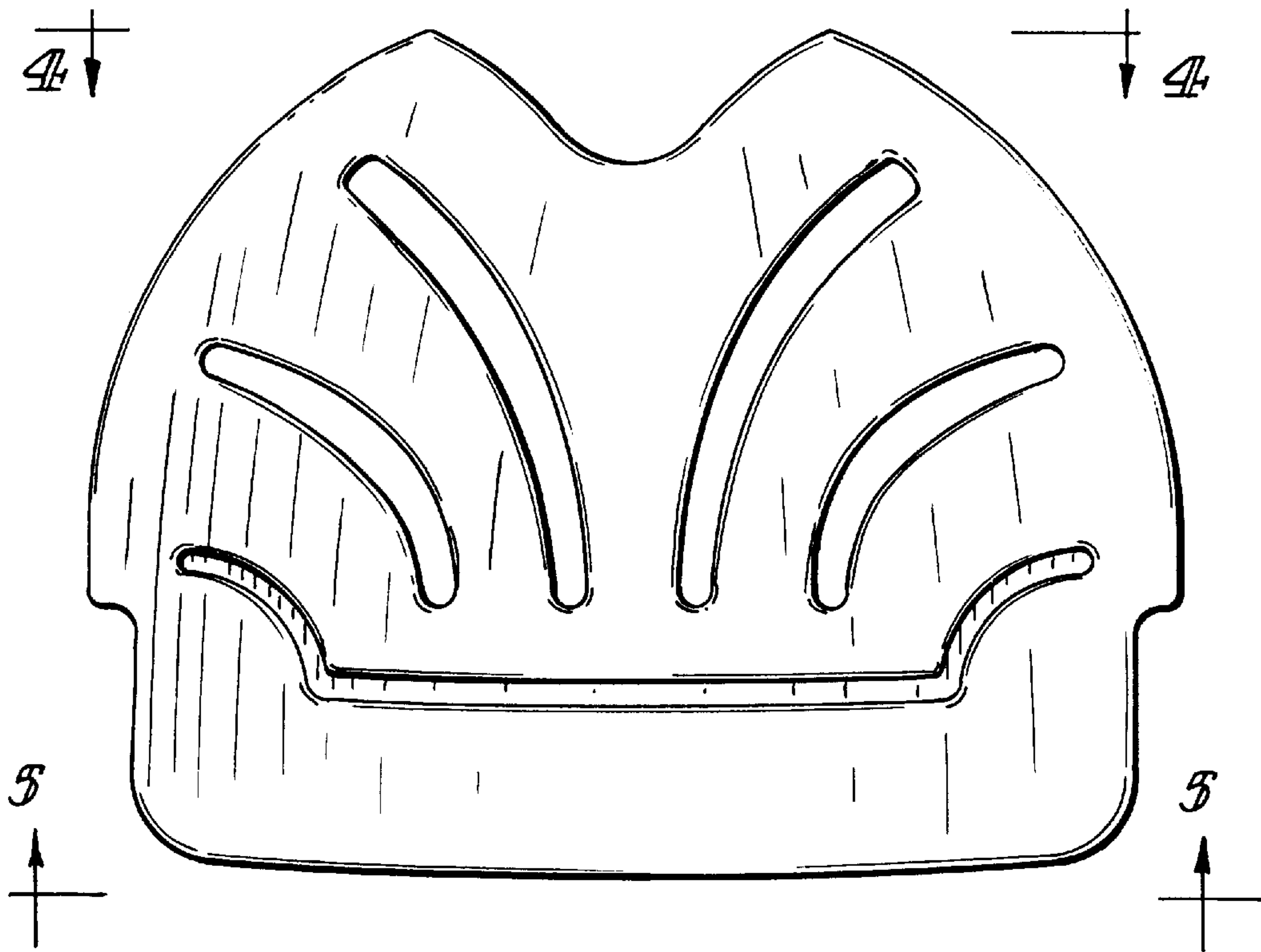

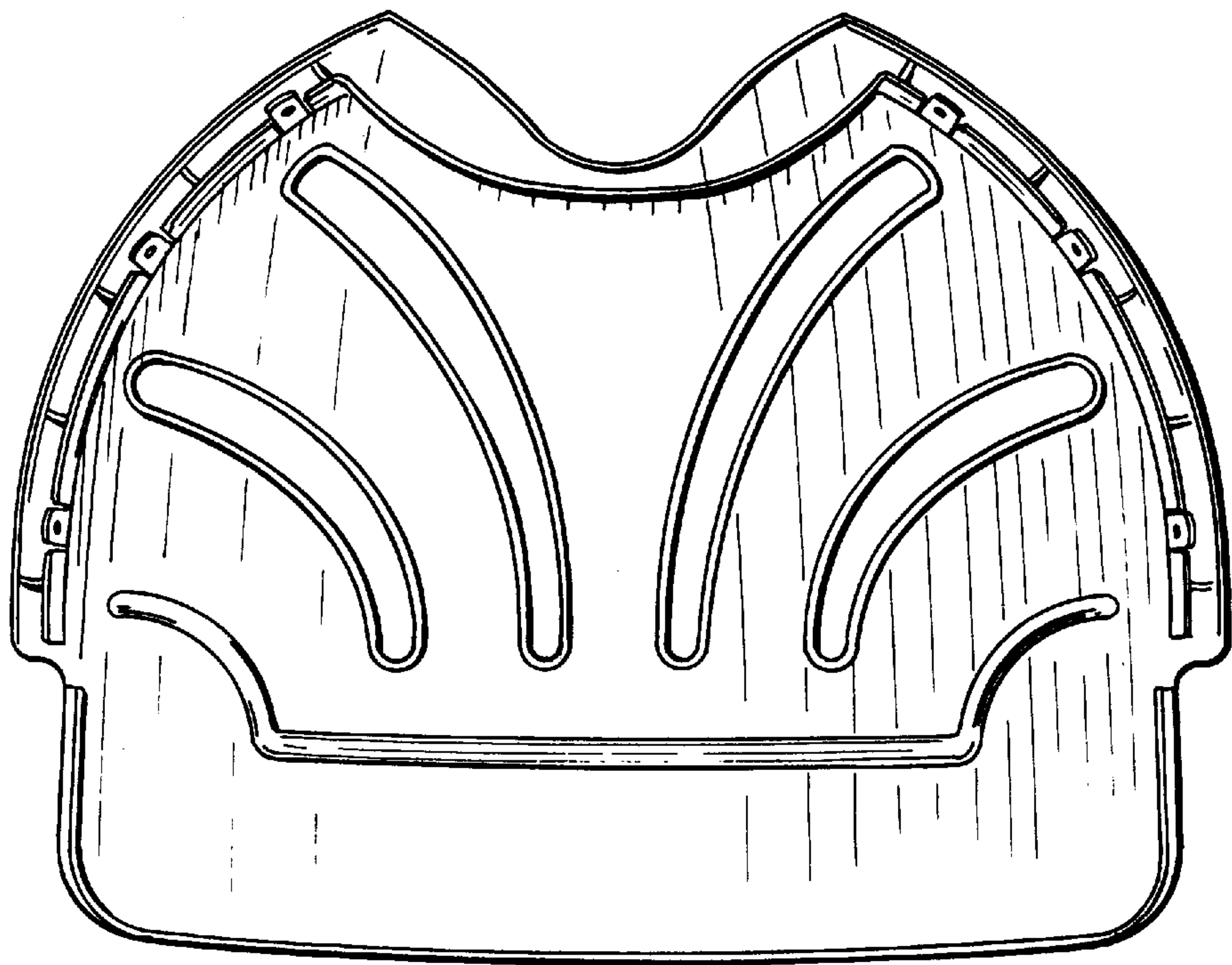

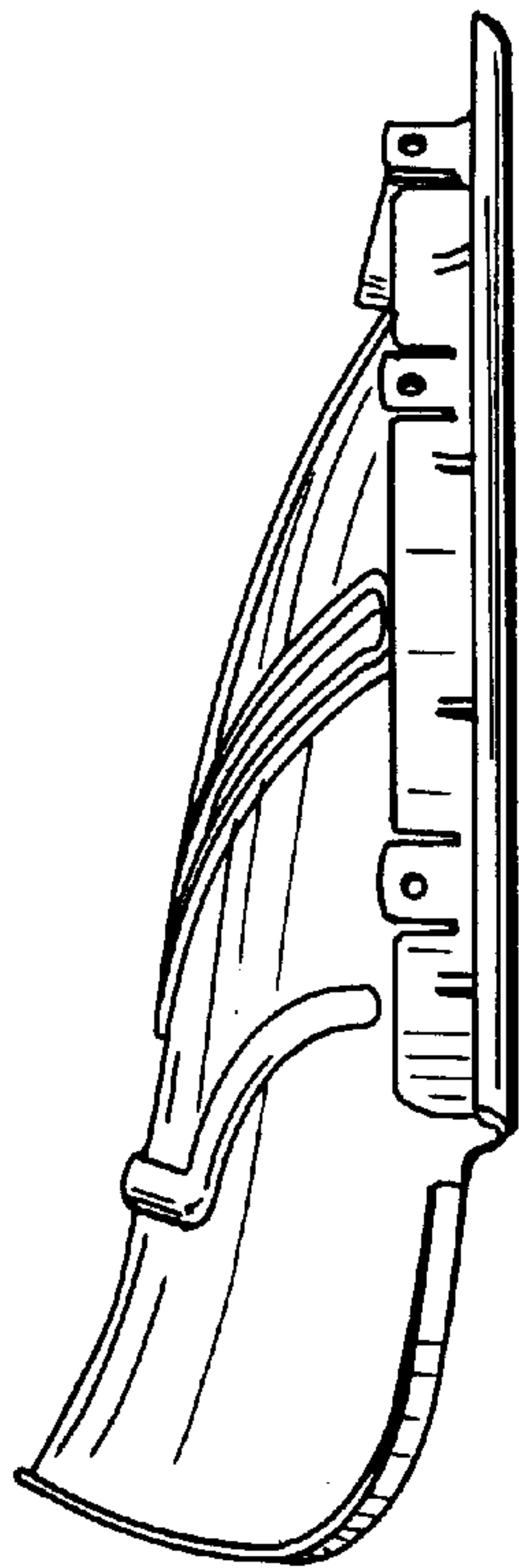

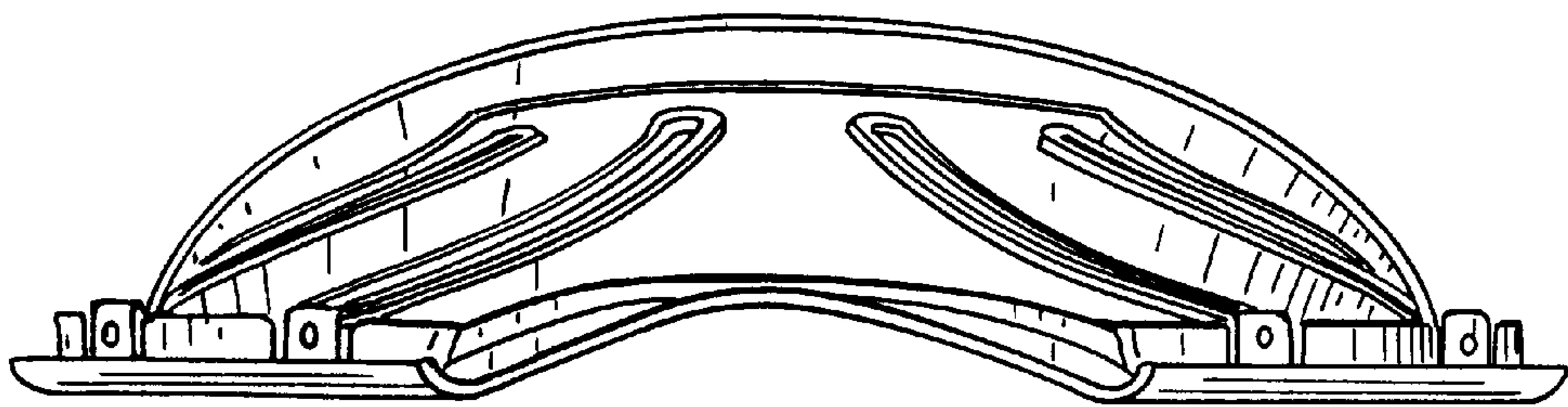

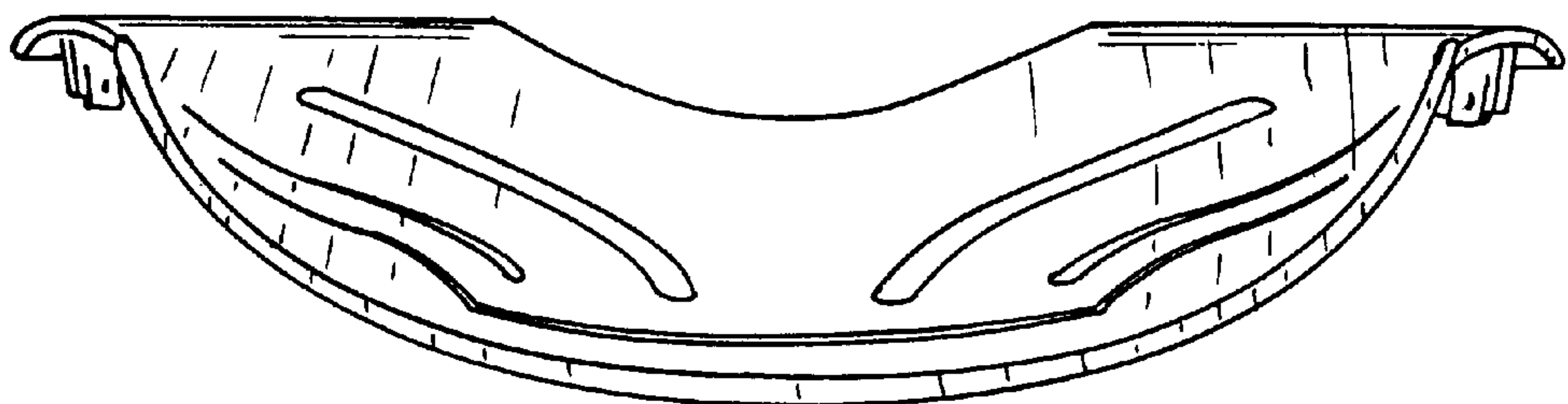

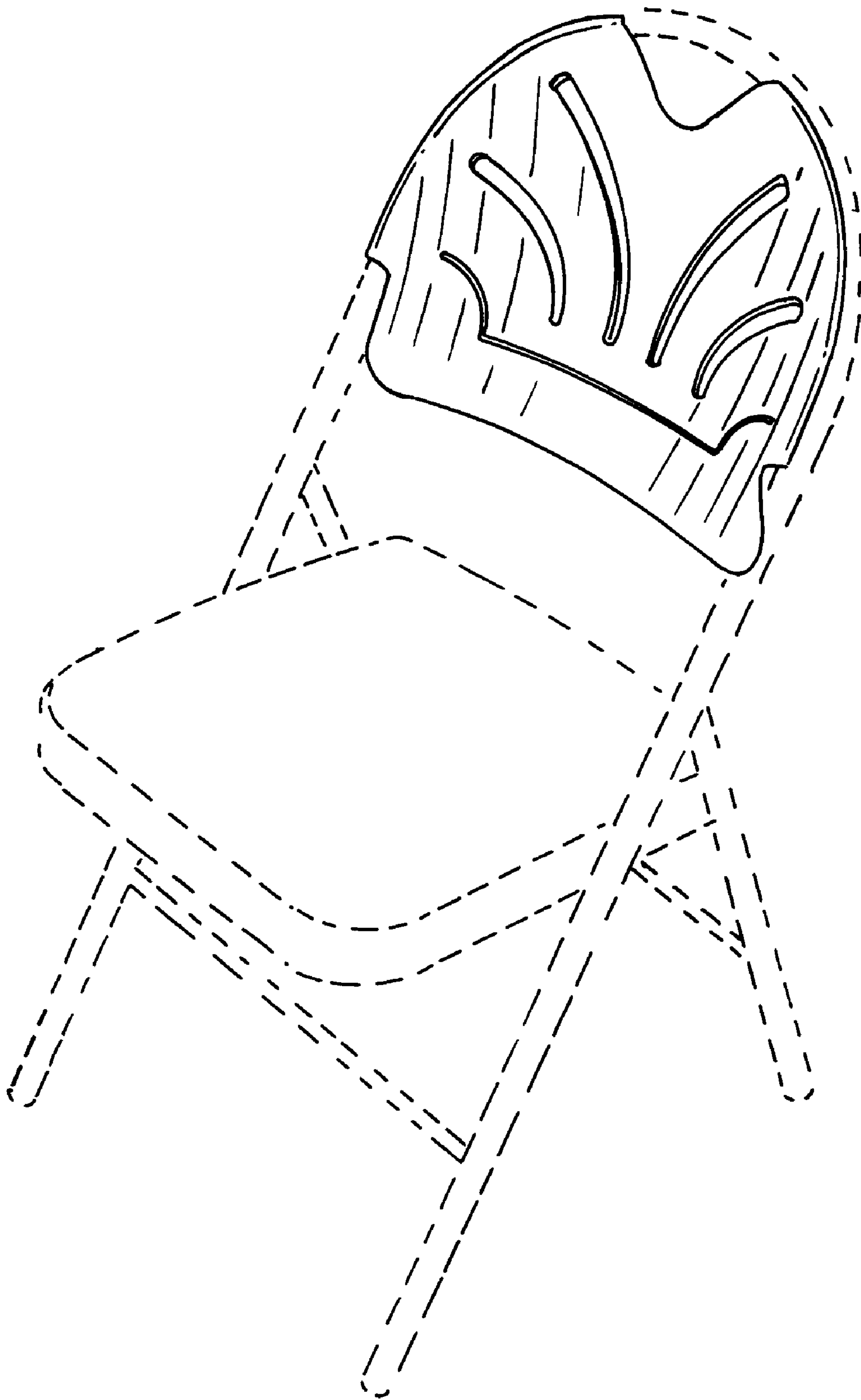
