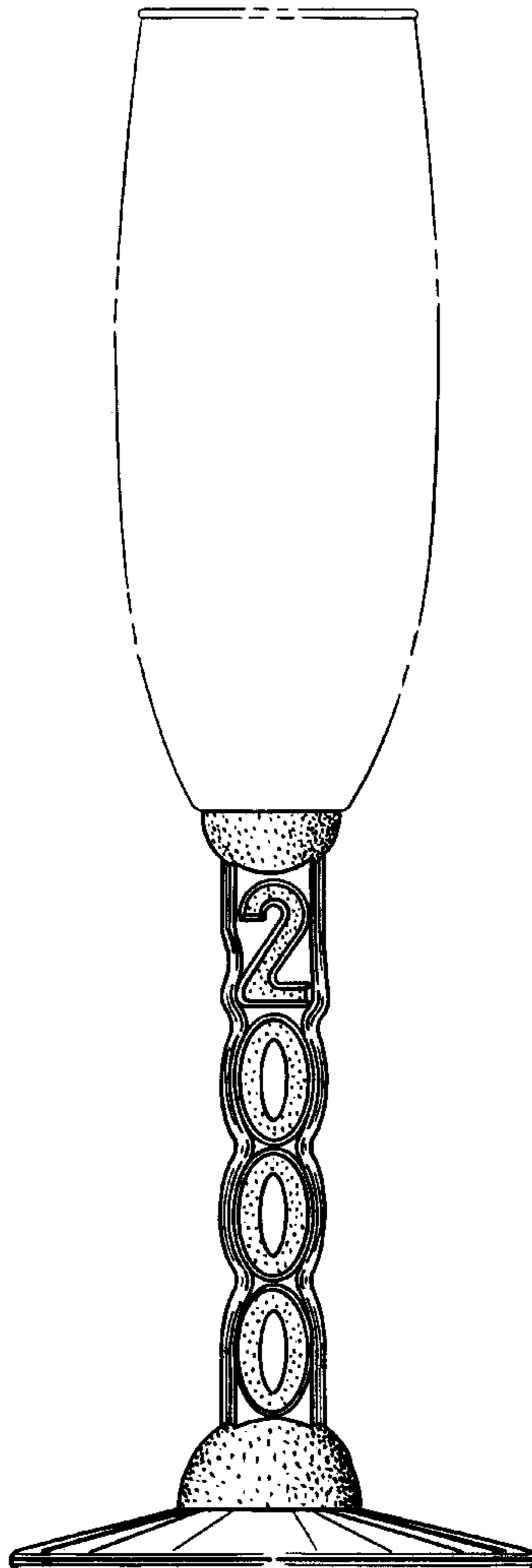
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stem for an article of stemware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a stem for an article of stemware according to the present showing the design; the rear elevational view being the same;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side elevational view being the same;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 being a top view thereof.
The broken lines in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

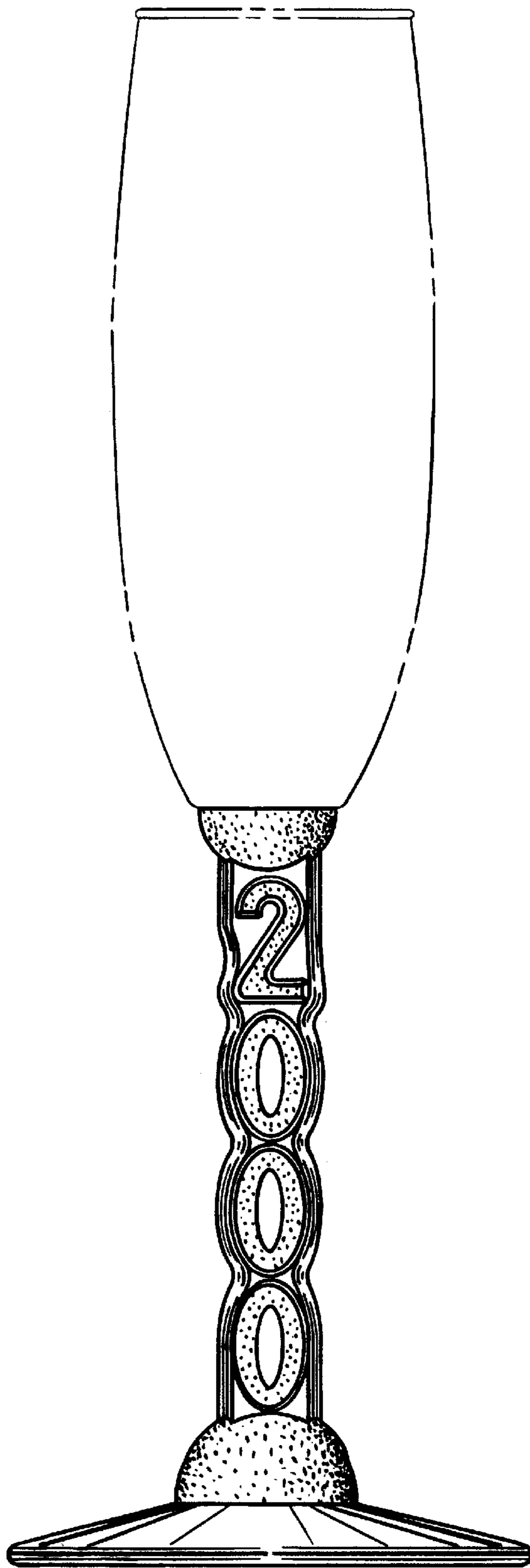

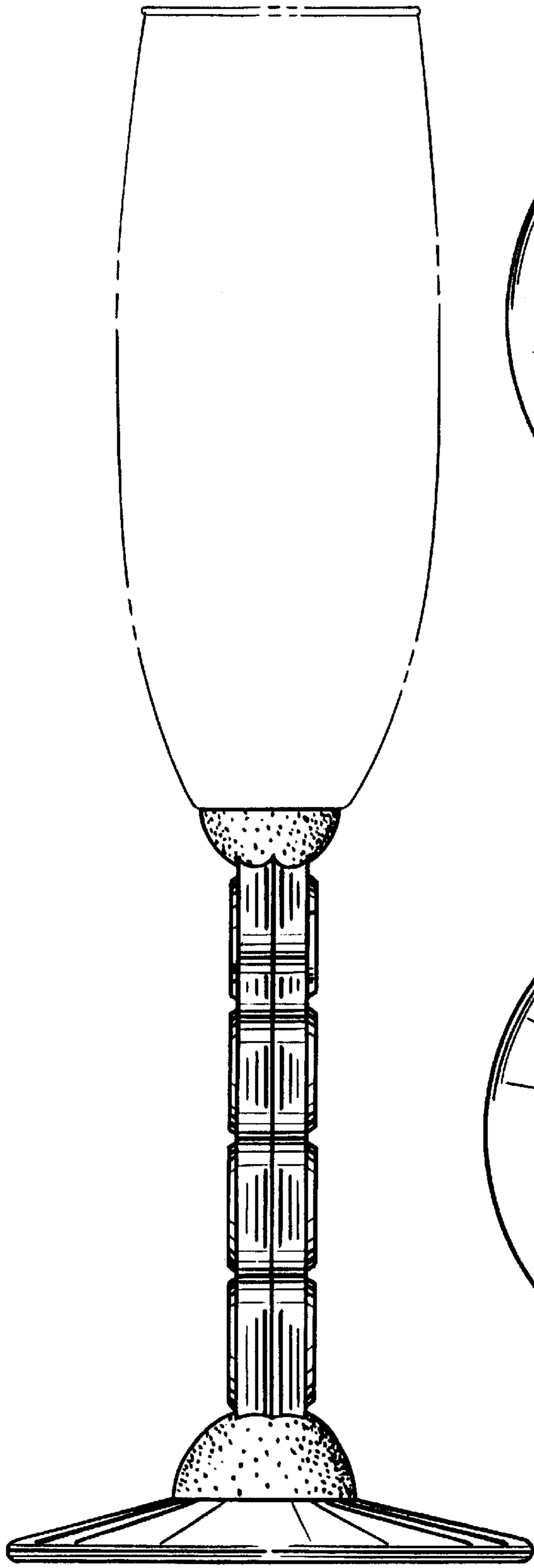

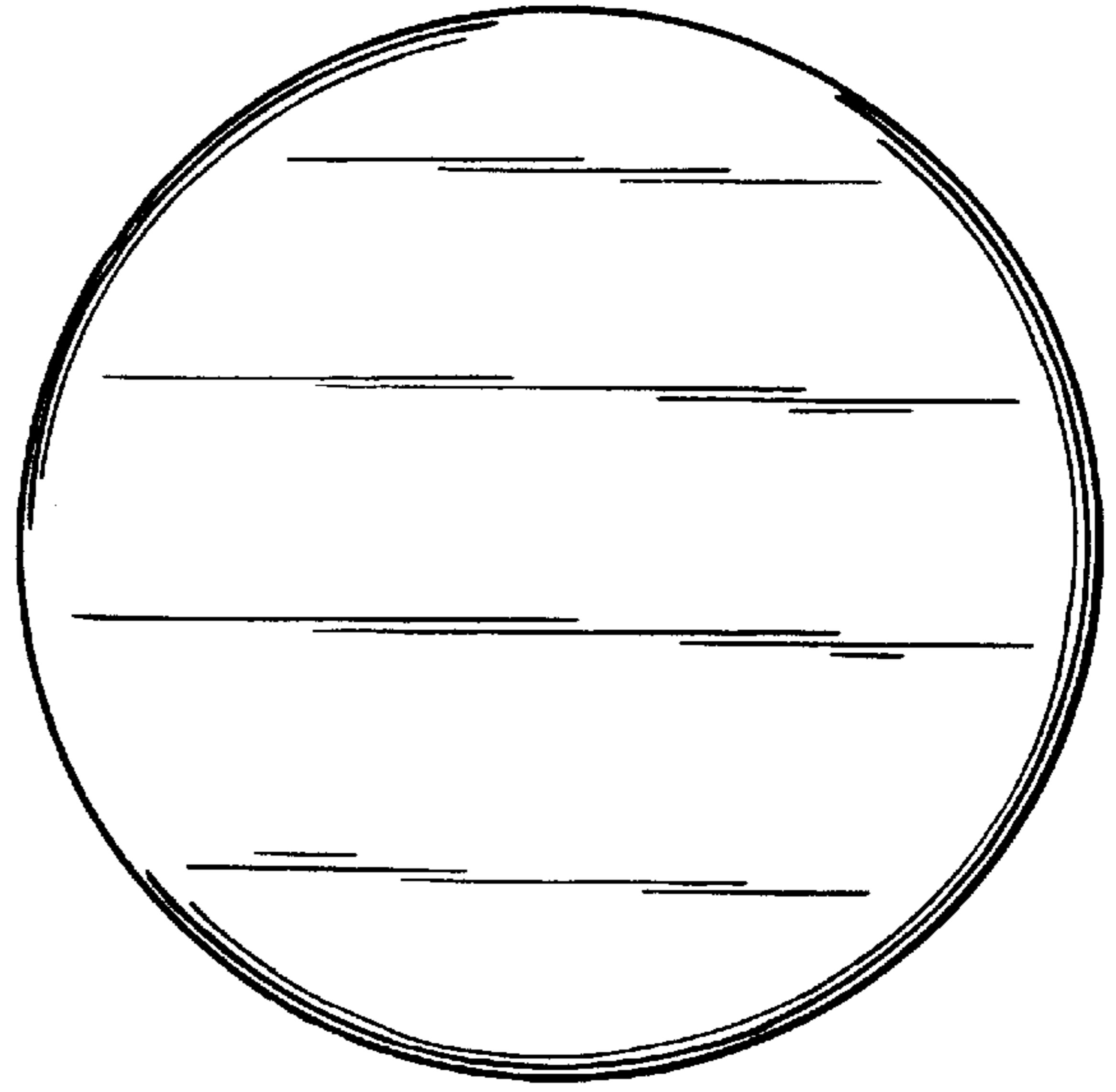

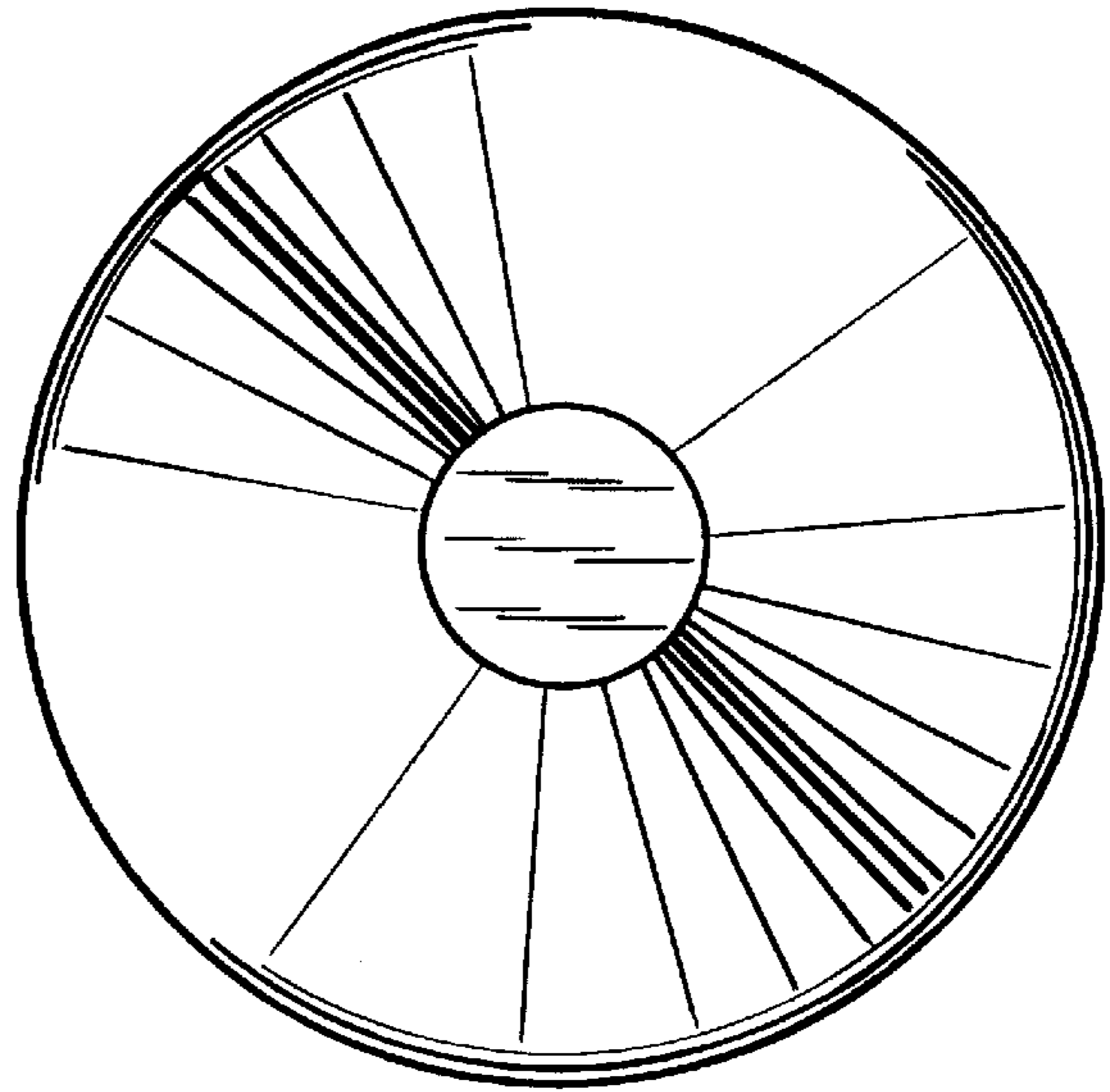
