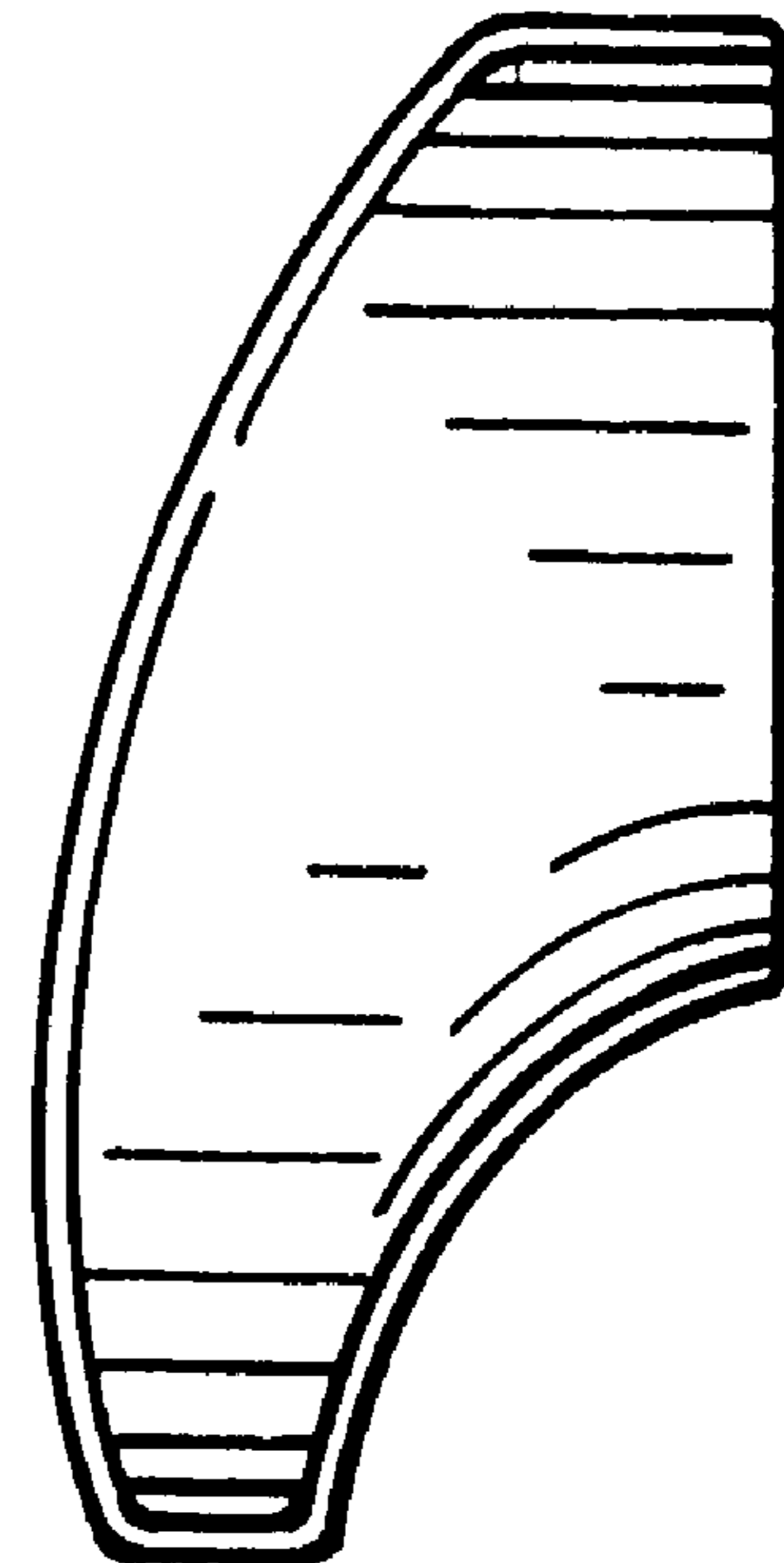
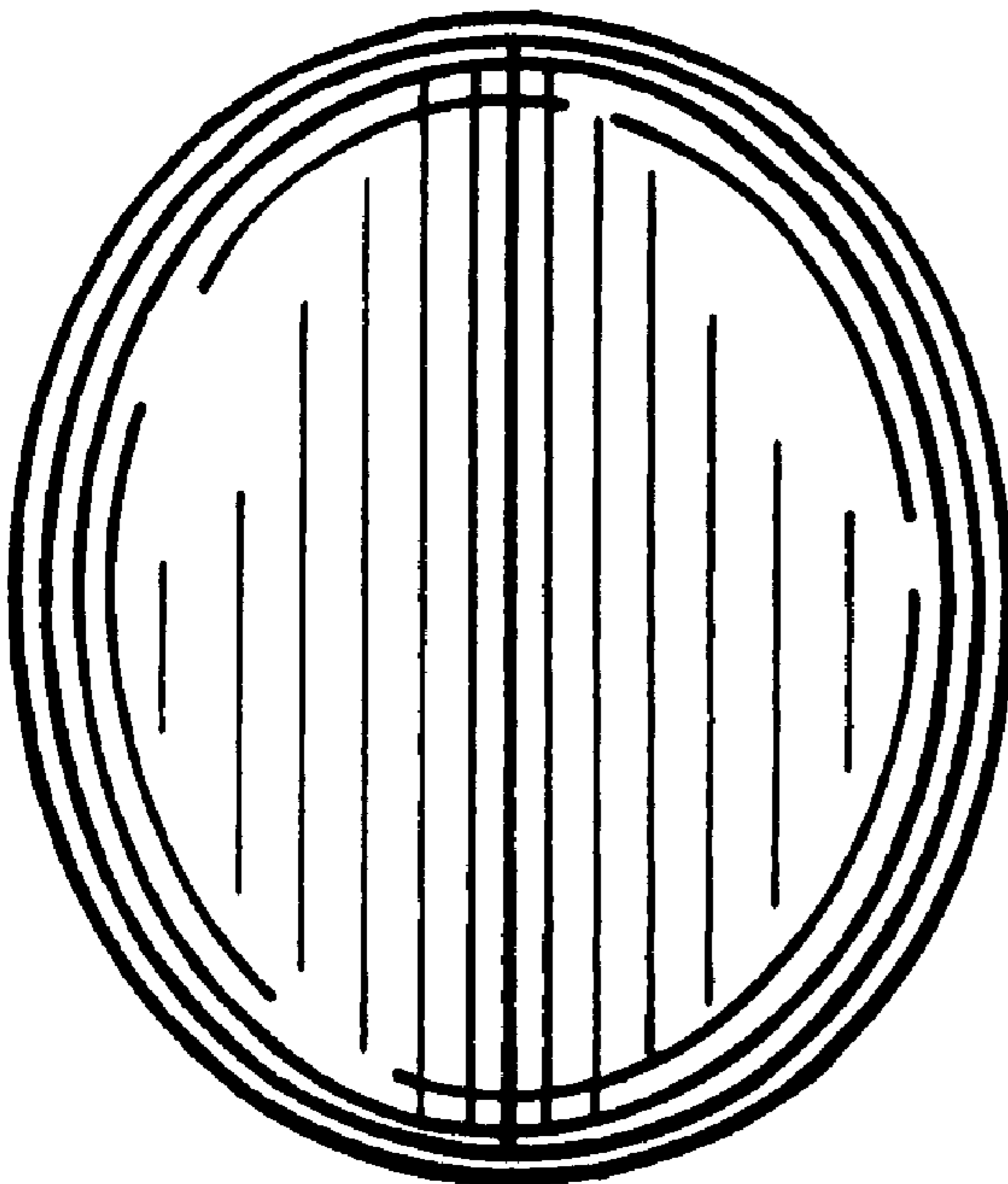

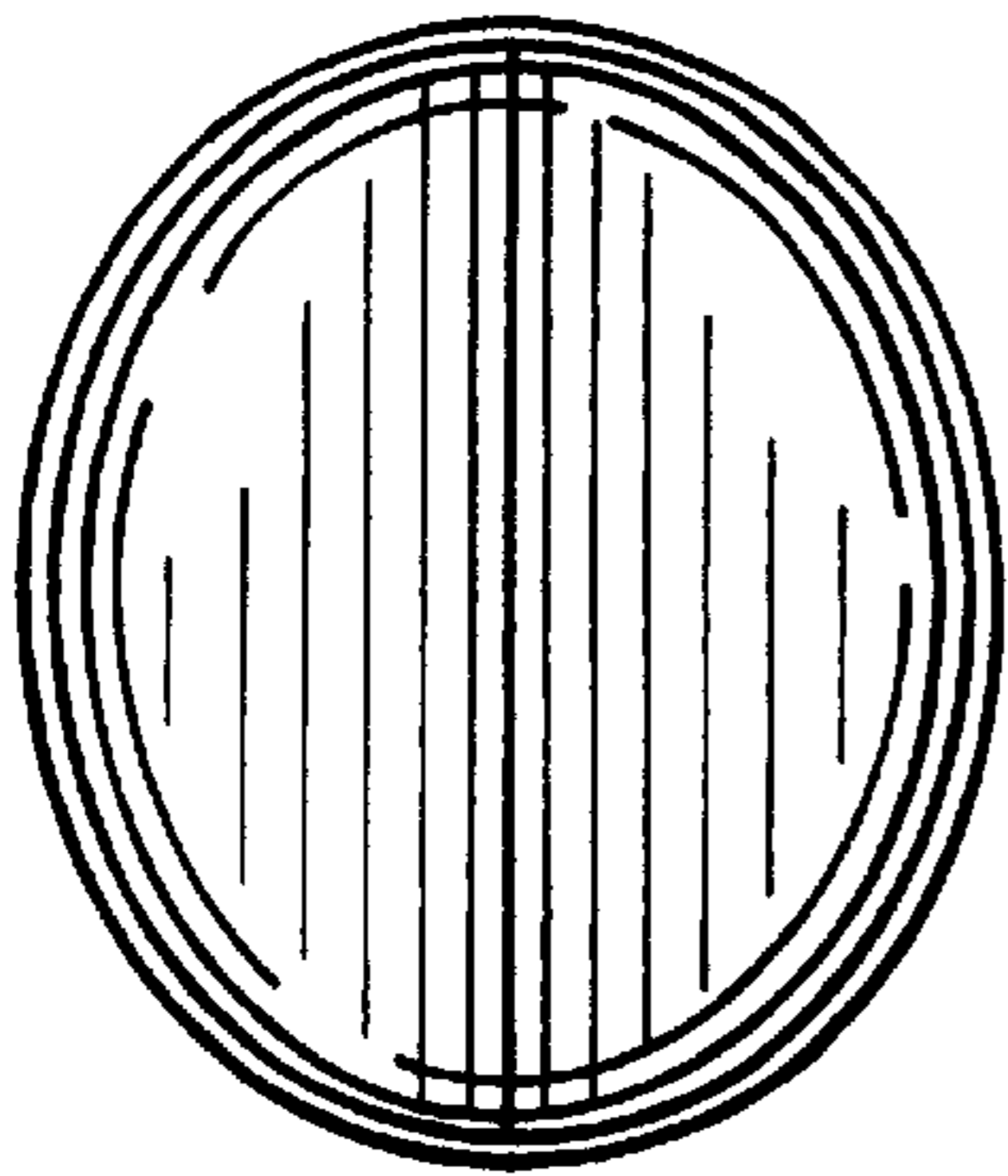
The ornamental design for a pull for furniture, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

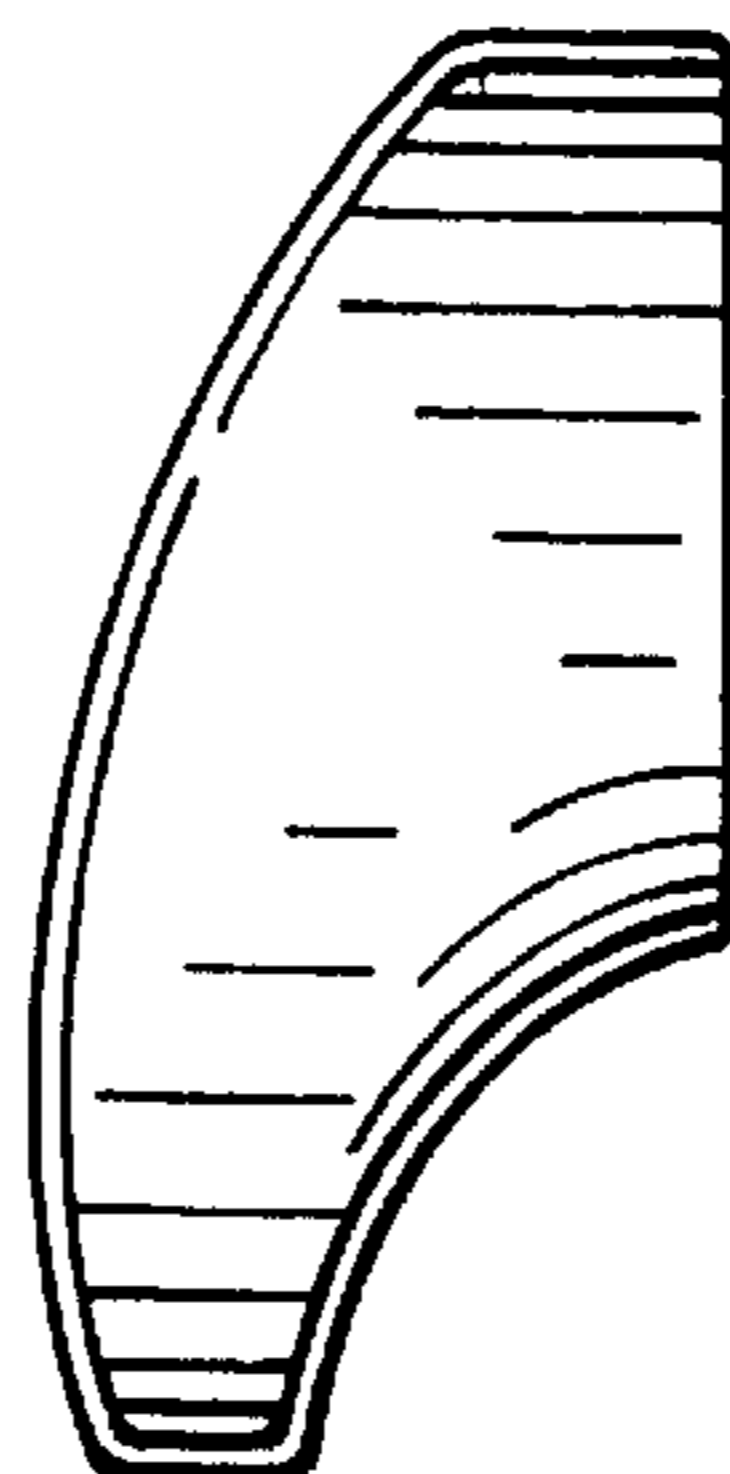
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the pull incorporating my design of the present invention;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the pull shown in FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the pull shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the pull shown in FIG. 1; and,  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the pull shown in FIG. 1.

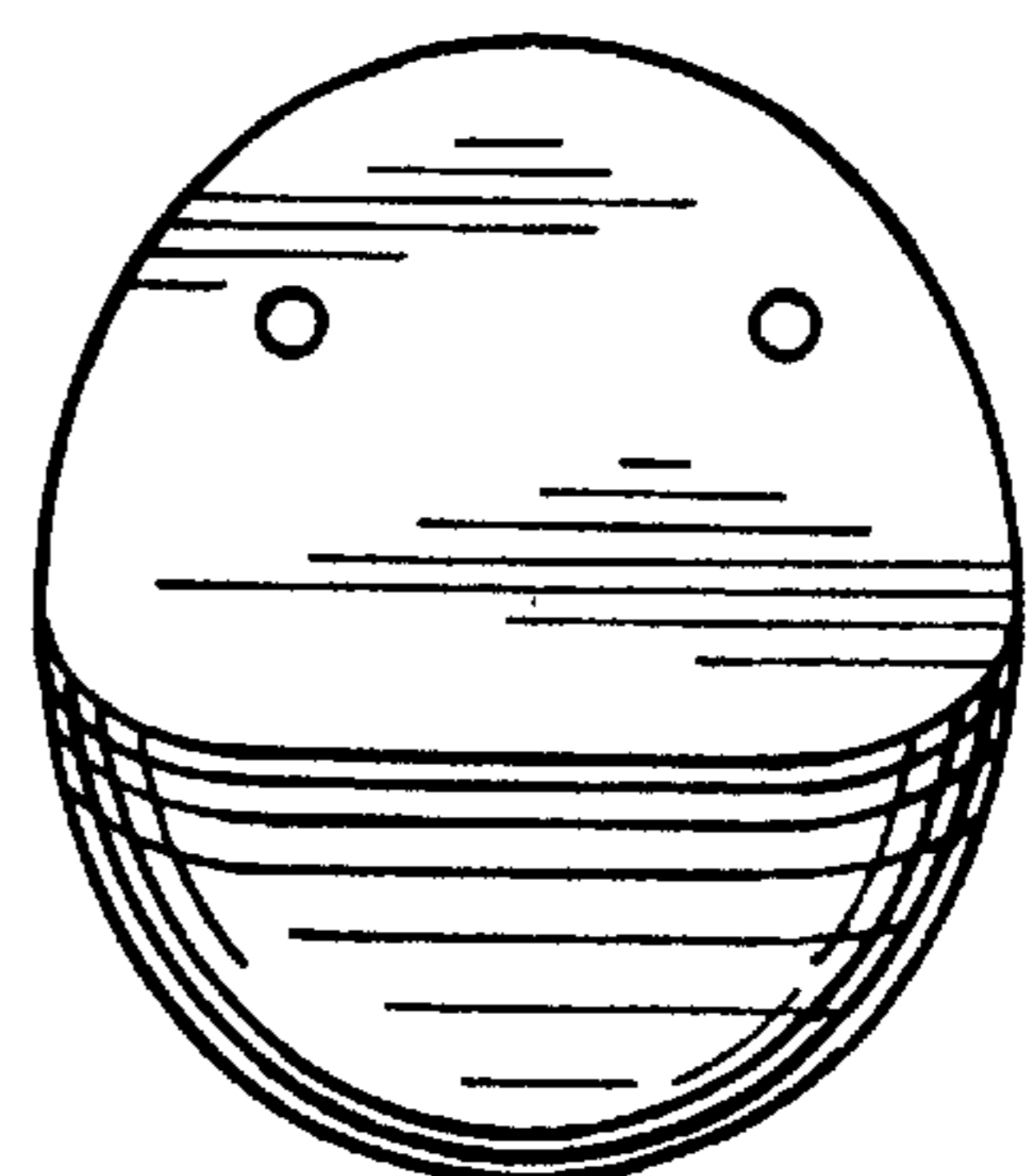




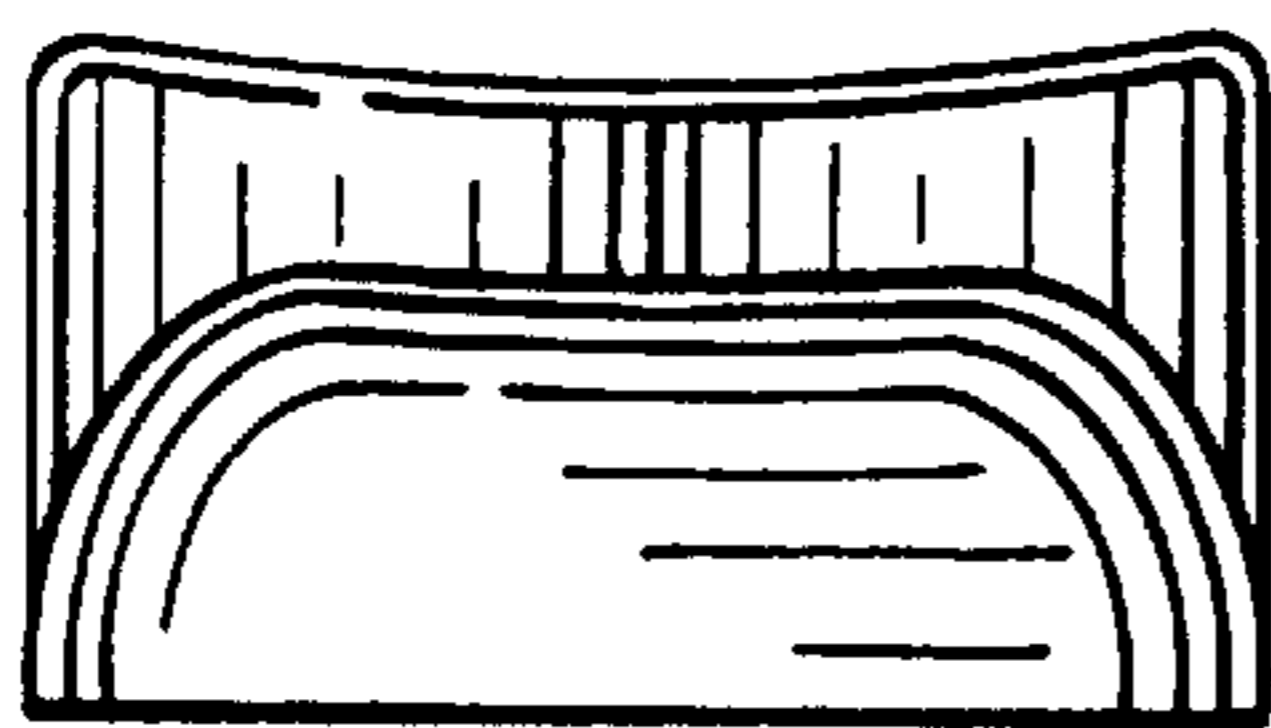

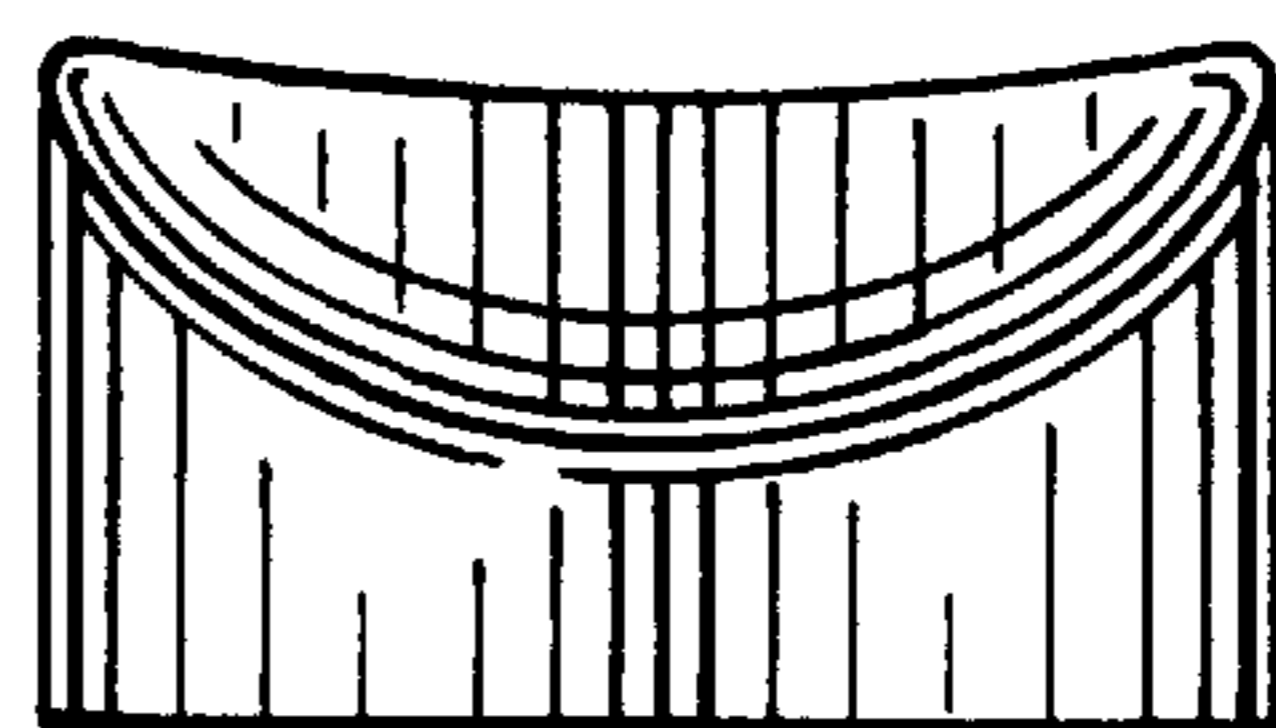
