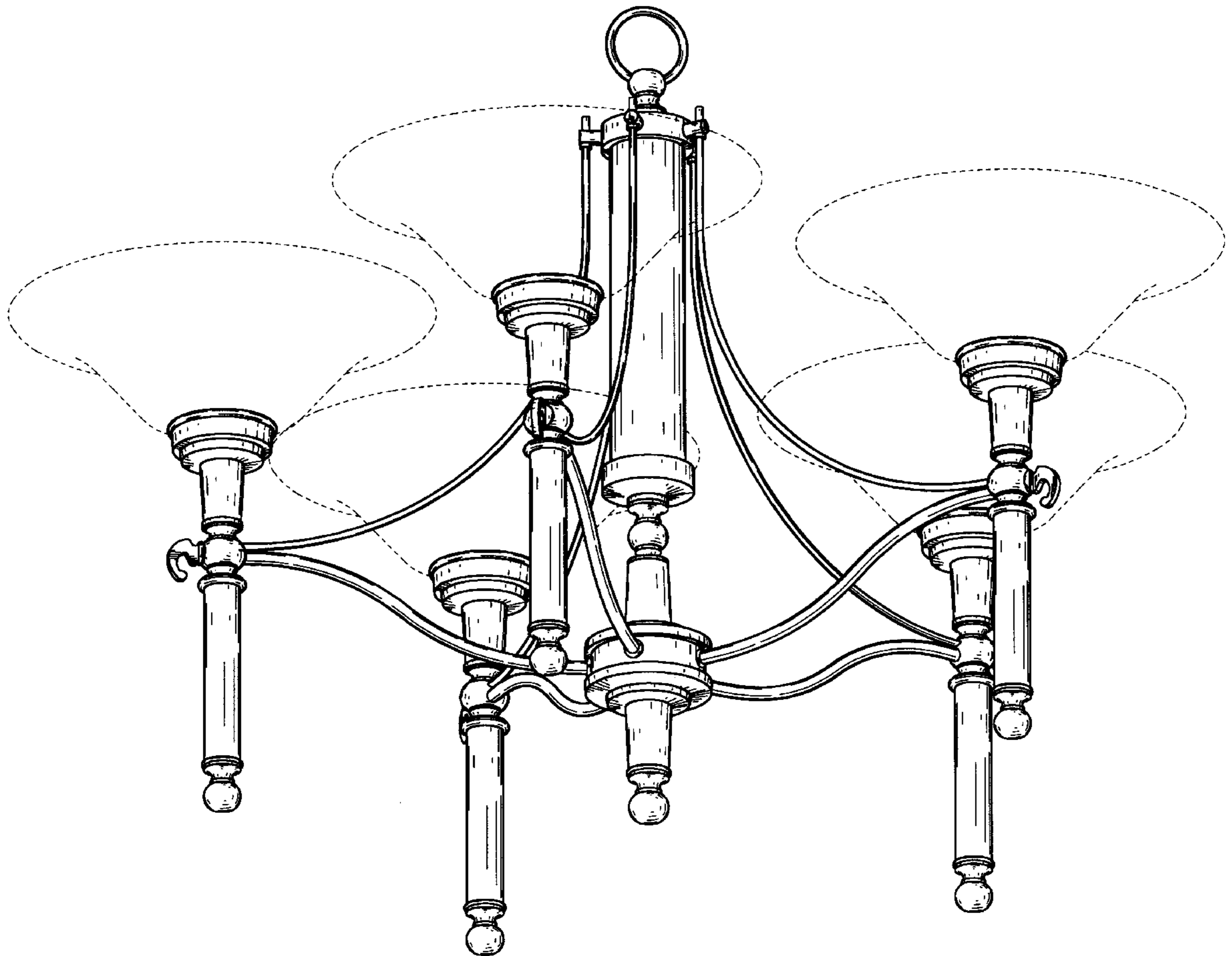
[57] **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a chandelier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chandelier showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front side elevational view of the chandelier, the rear side elevational view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the chandelier;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the chandelier;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chandelier; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the chandelier.
 The broken lines shown are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

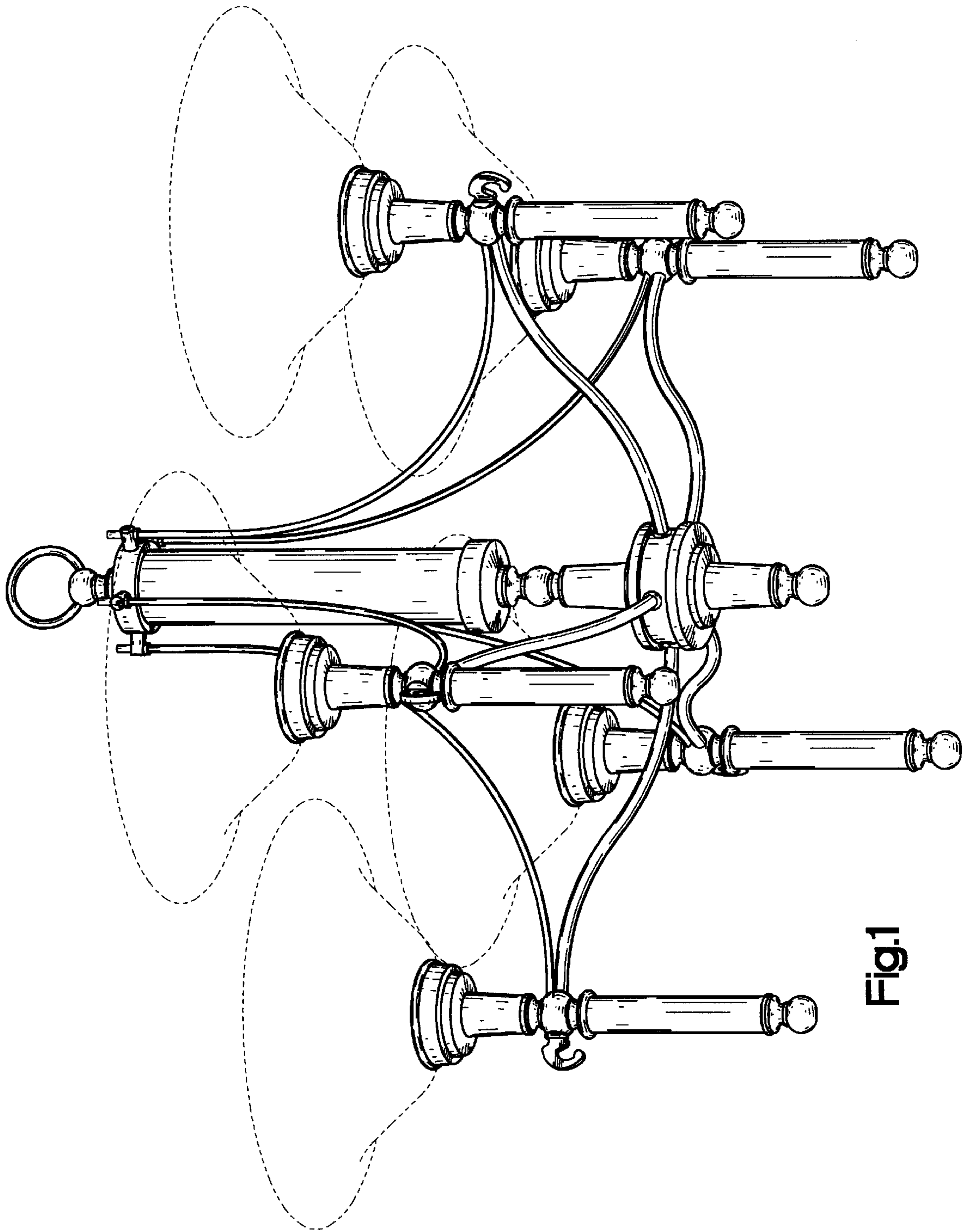

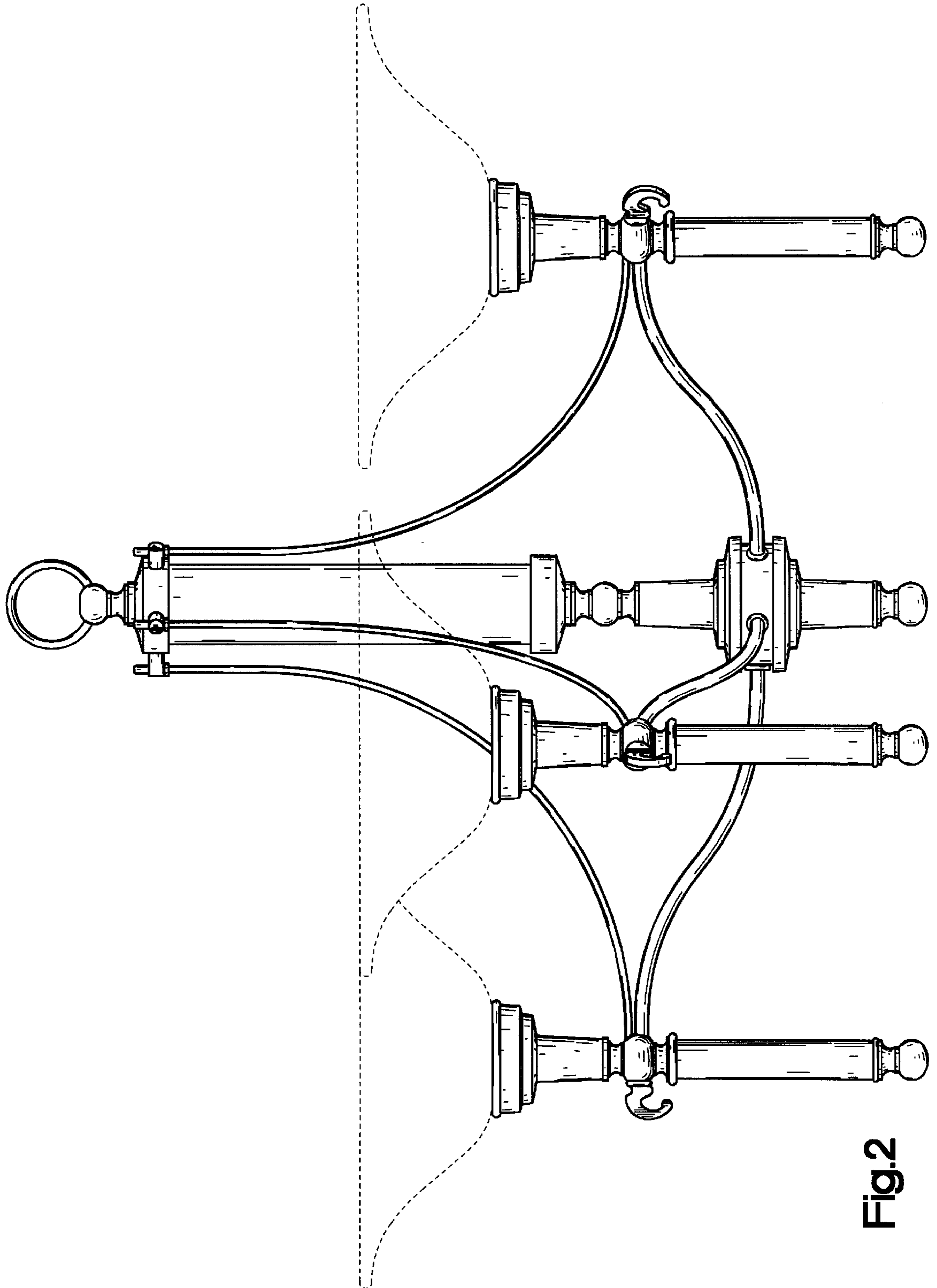

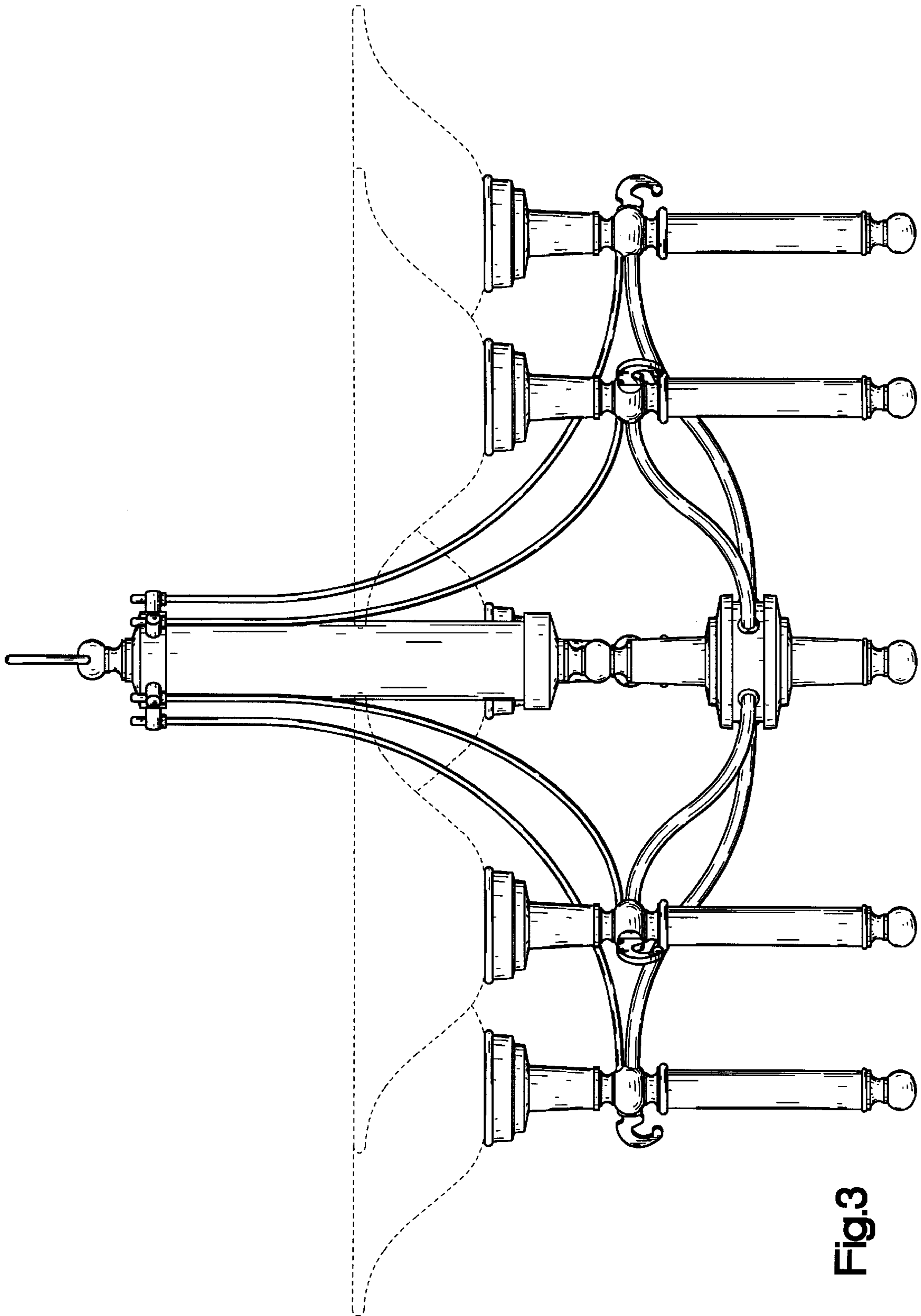

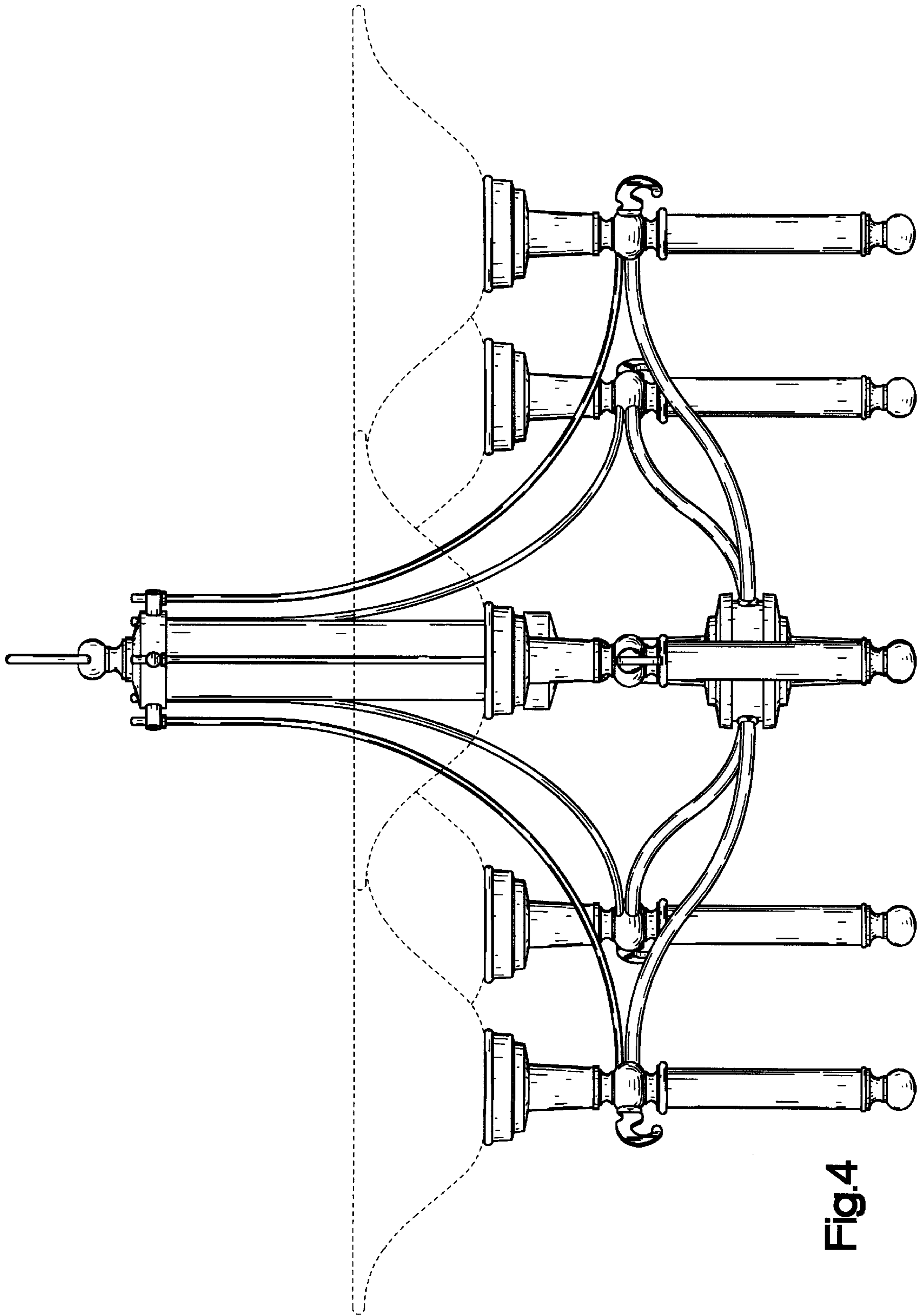

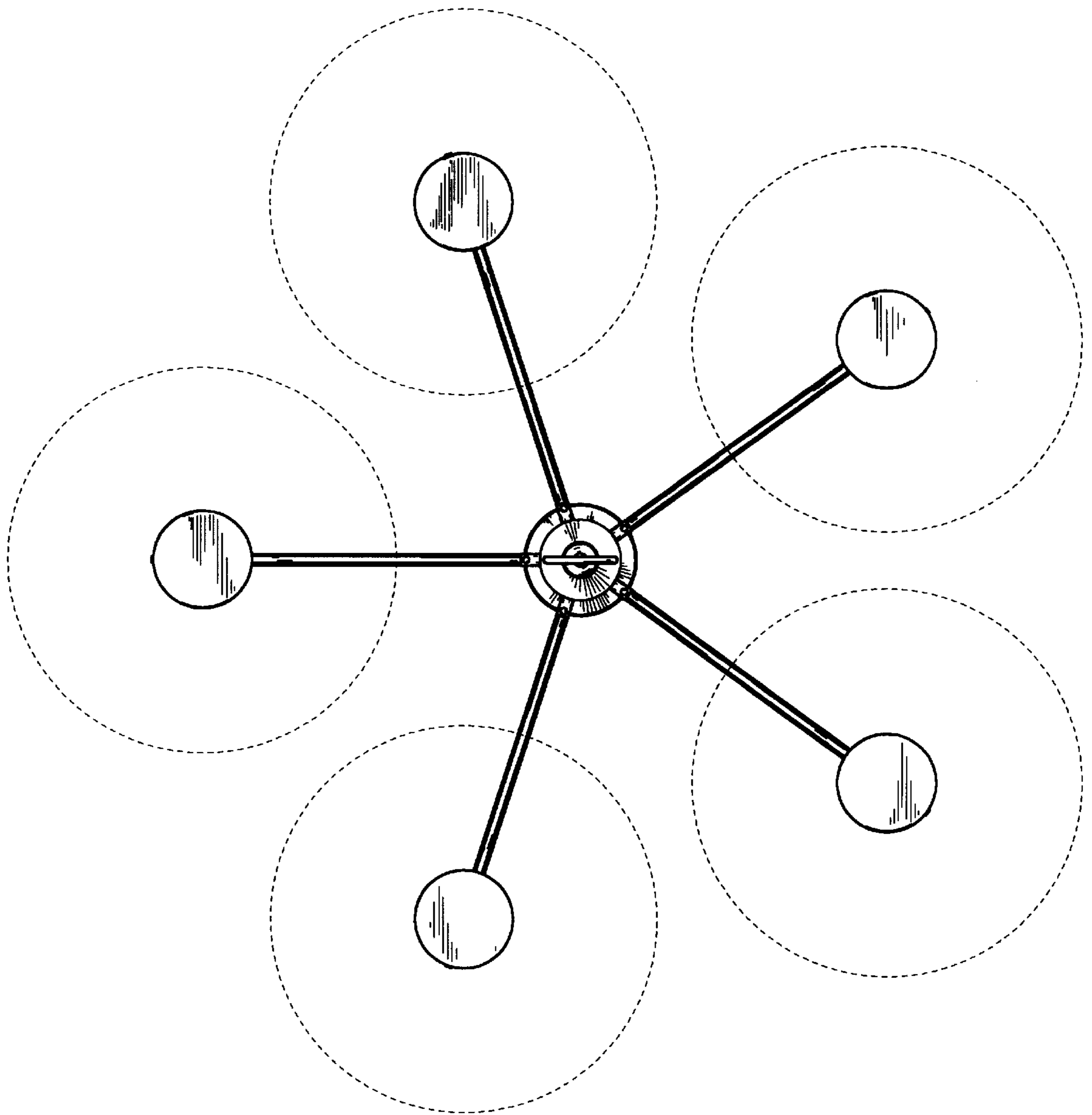

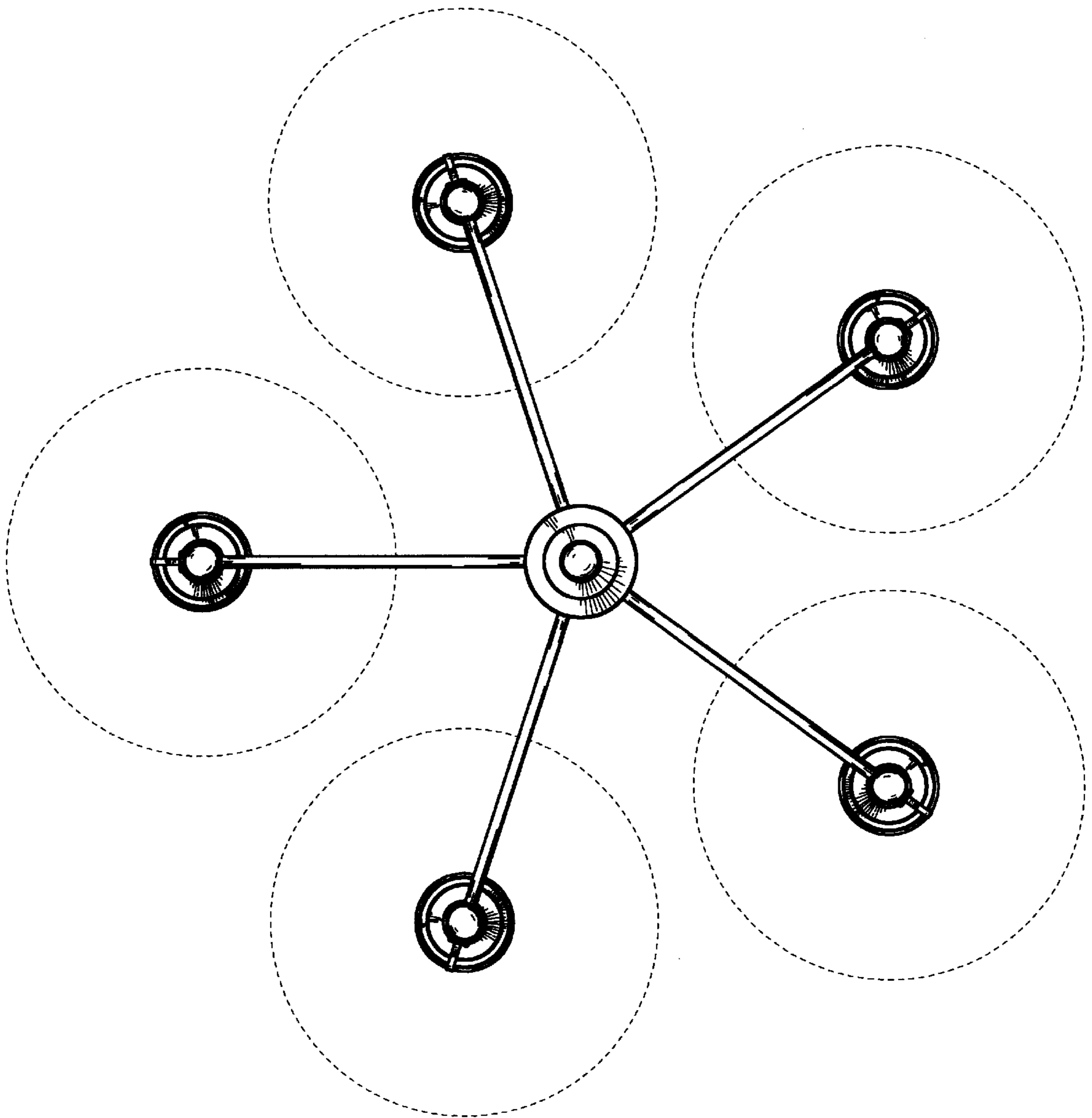
