[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined hook and rail, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined hook and rail showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged elevational view with the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the rail with the hooks detached from the rail;

FIG. 4 is a right end view of the rail of FIG. 3, the other end view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the rail of FIG. 3, the bottom view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a back view of the rail of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a front view of a first type of hook;

FIG. 8 is a right side view of the hook of FIG. 7, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 9 is a back view of the hook of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a top view of the hook of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a bottom view of the hook of FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a front view of a second type of hook;

FIG. 13 is a left side view, the right side view being a mirror image thereof of the hook of FIG. 12;

FIG. 14 is a back view of the hook of FIG. 12; and

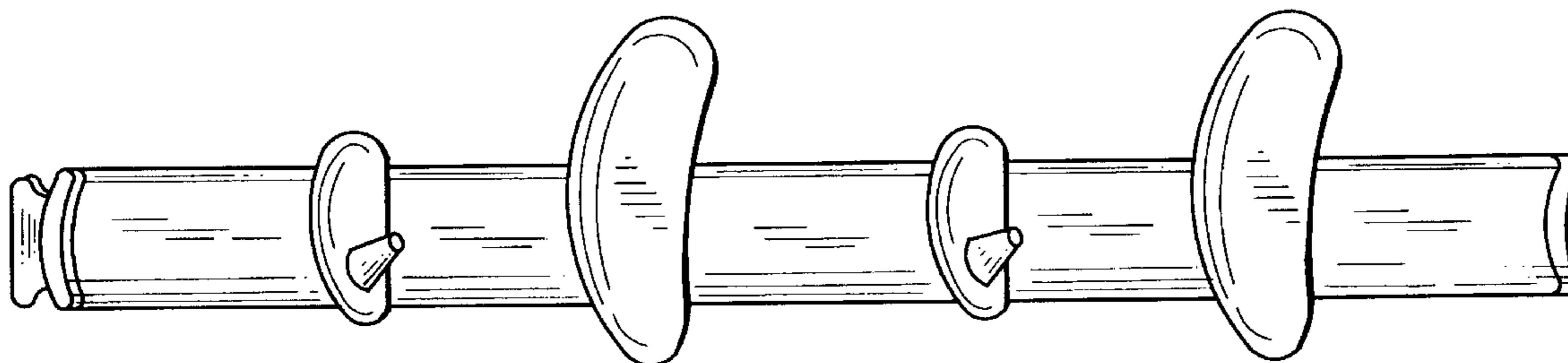
FIG. 15 is a top view of the hook of FIG. 12; and,

FIG. 16 is a bottom view of the hook of FIG. 12.

The elements of the claimed design are shown detached in FIGS. 3–16 for clarity of illustration.

The rail is shown broken away in FIGS. 3, 5 and 6 for ease of illustration.

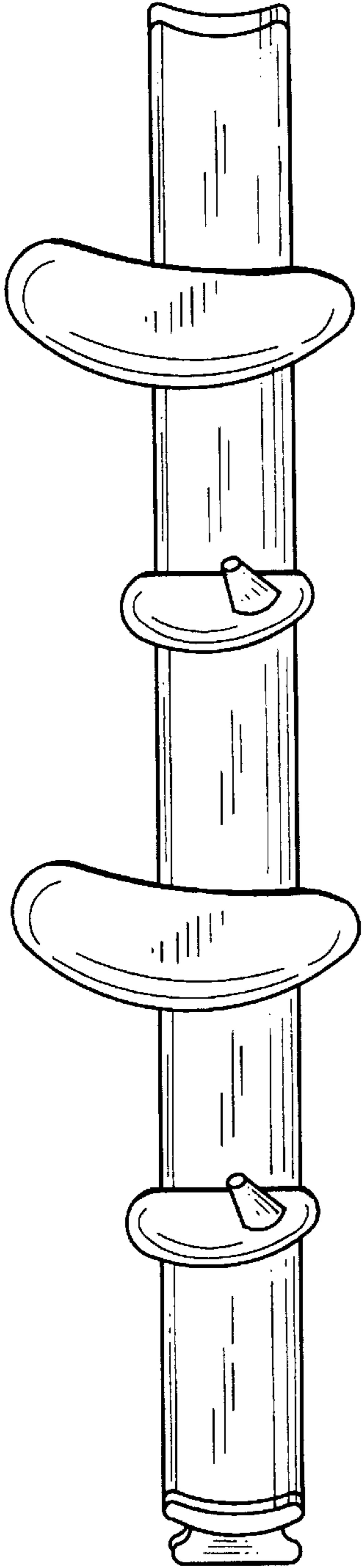

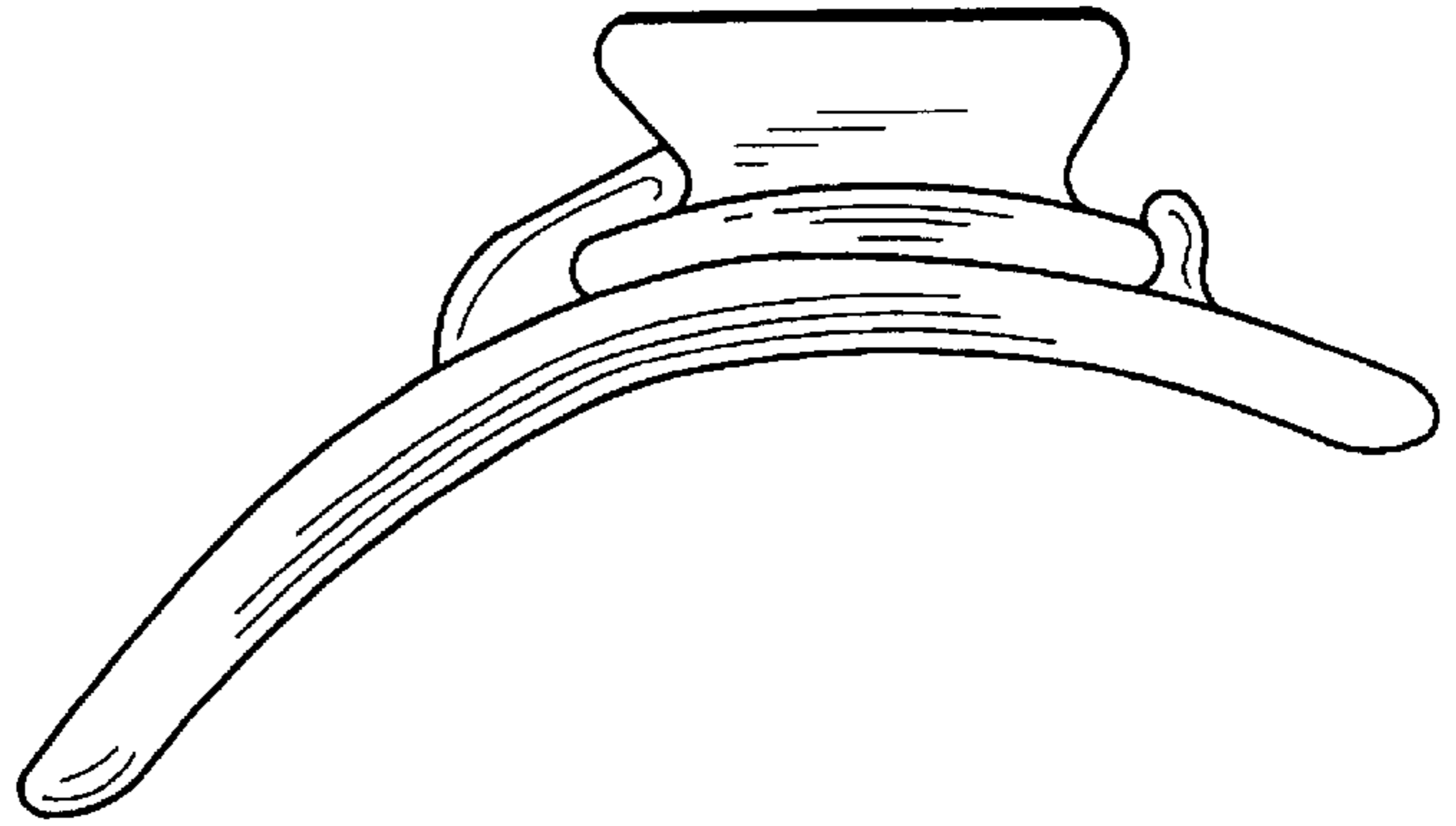

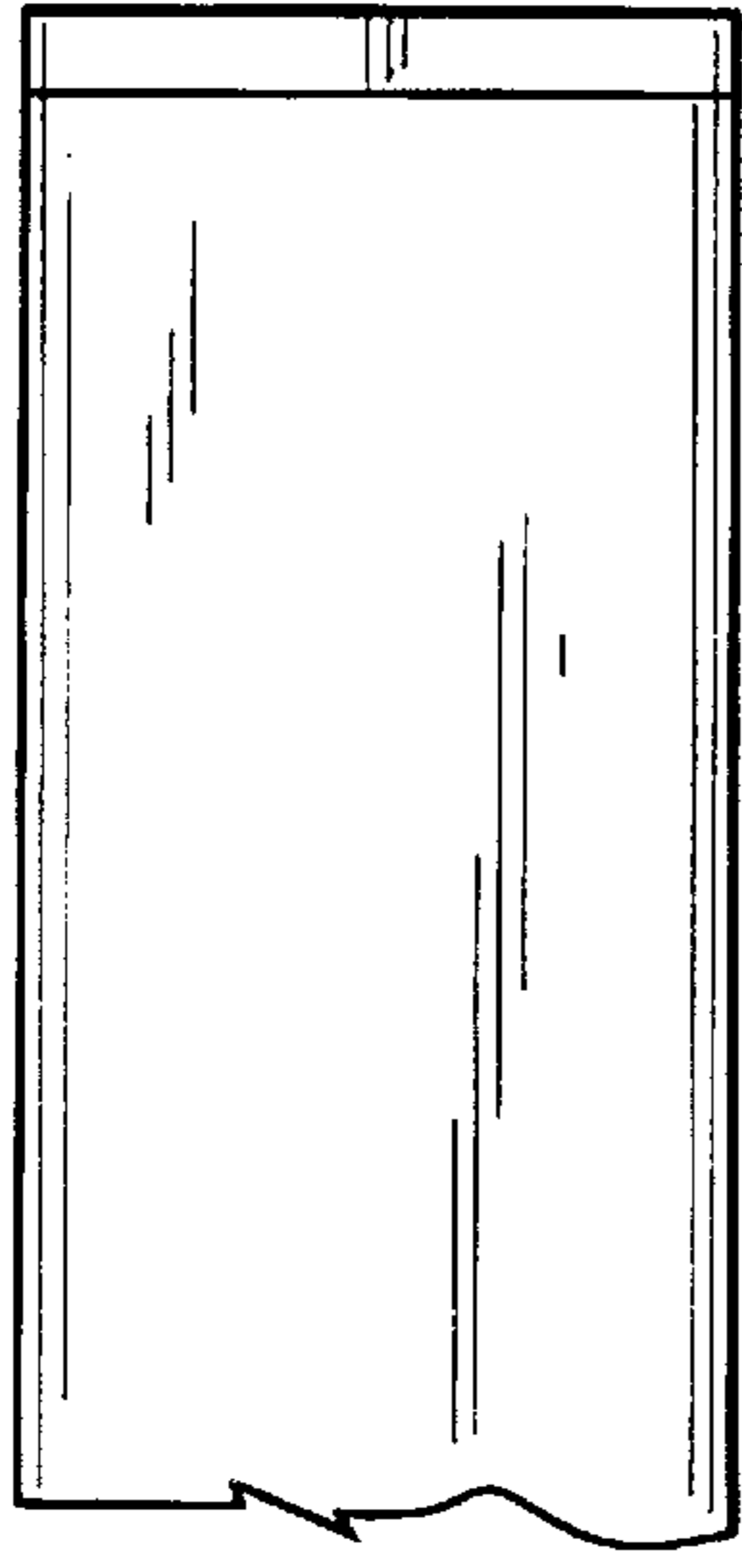

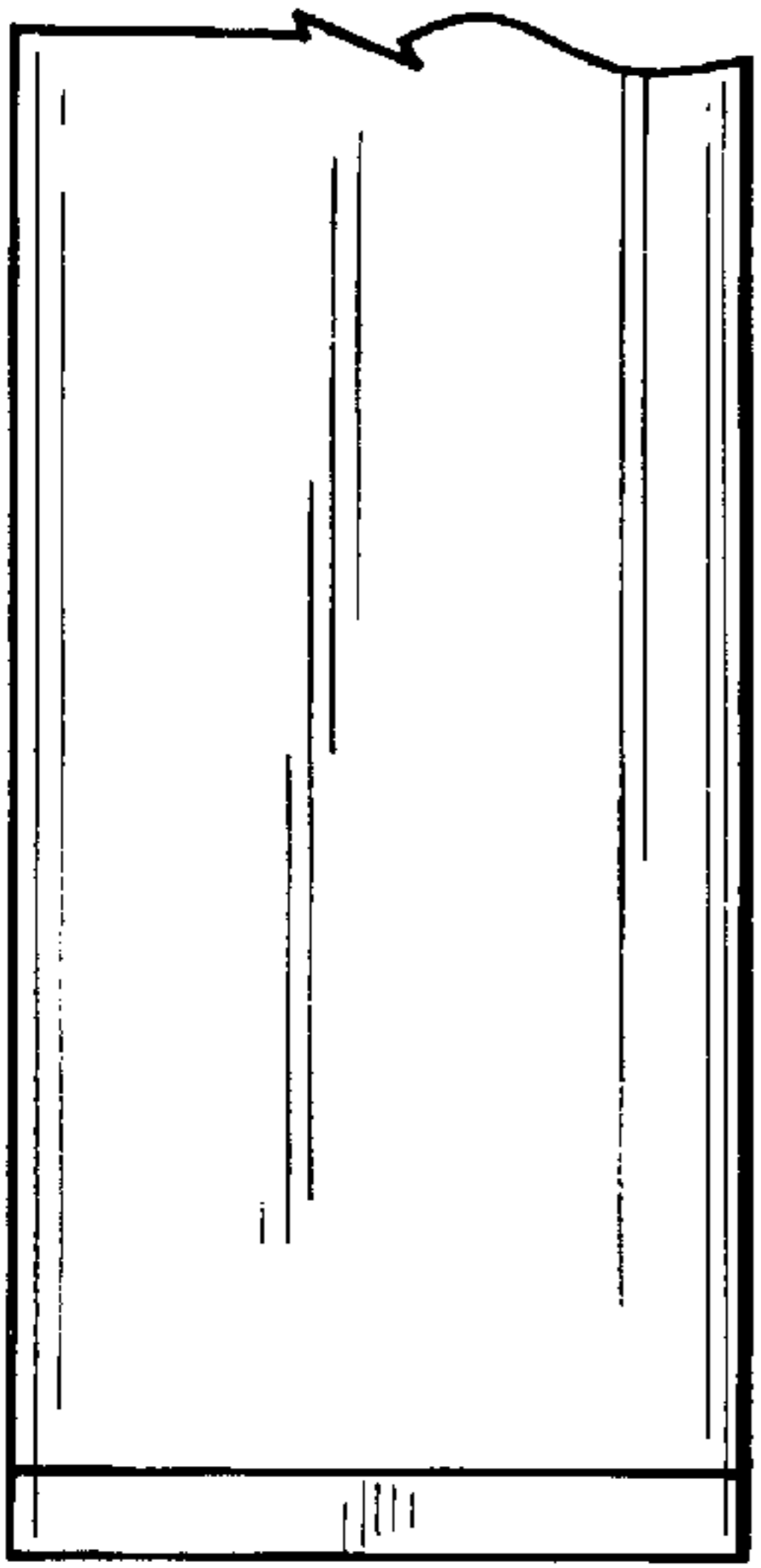

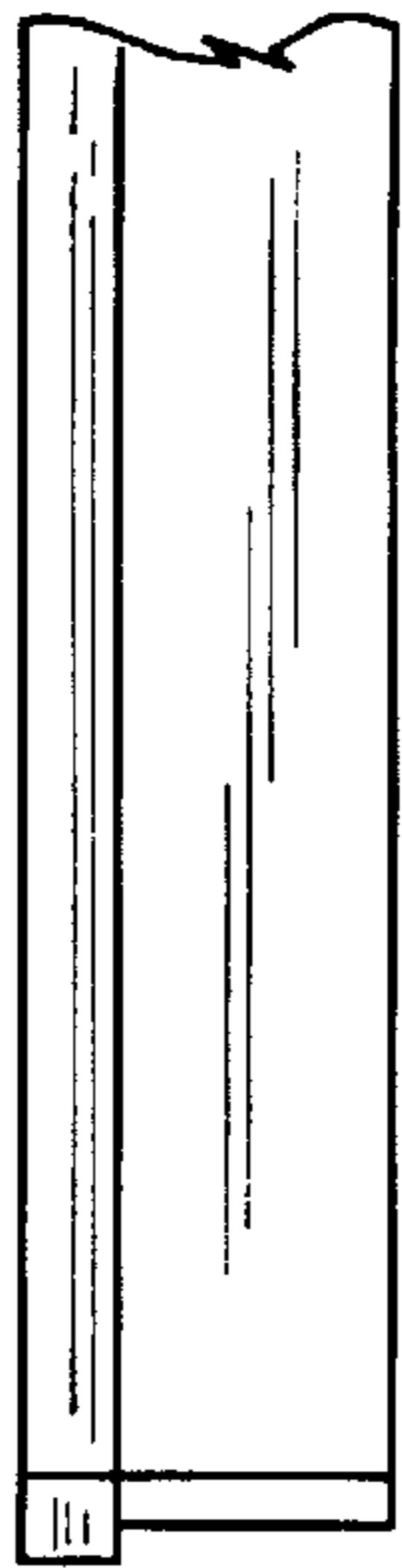

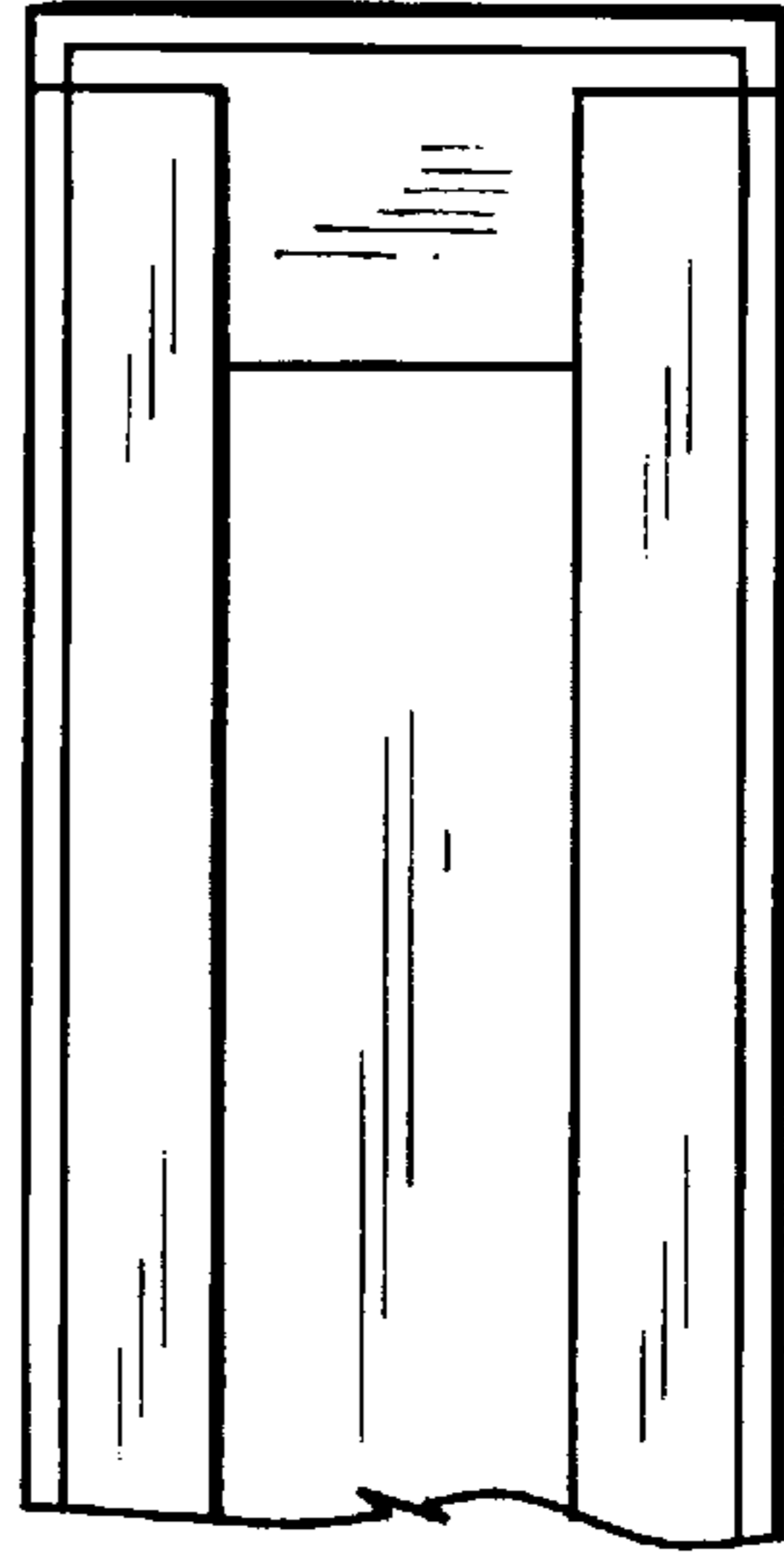
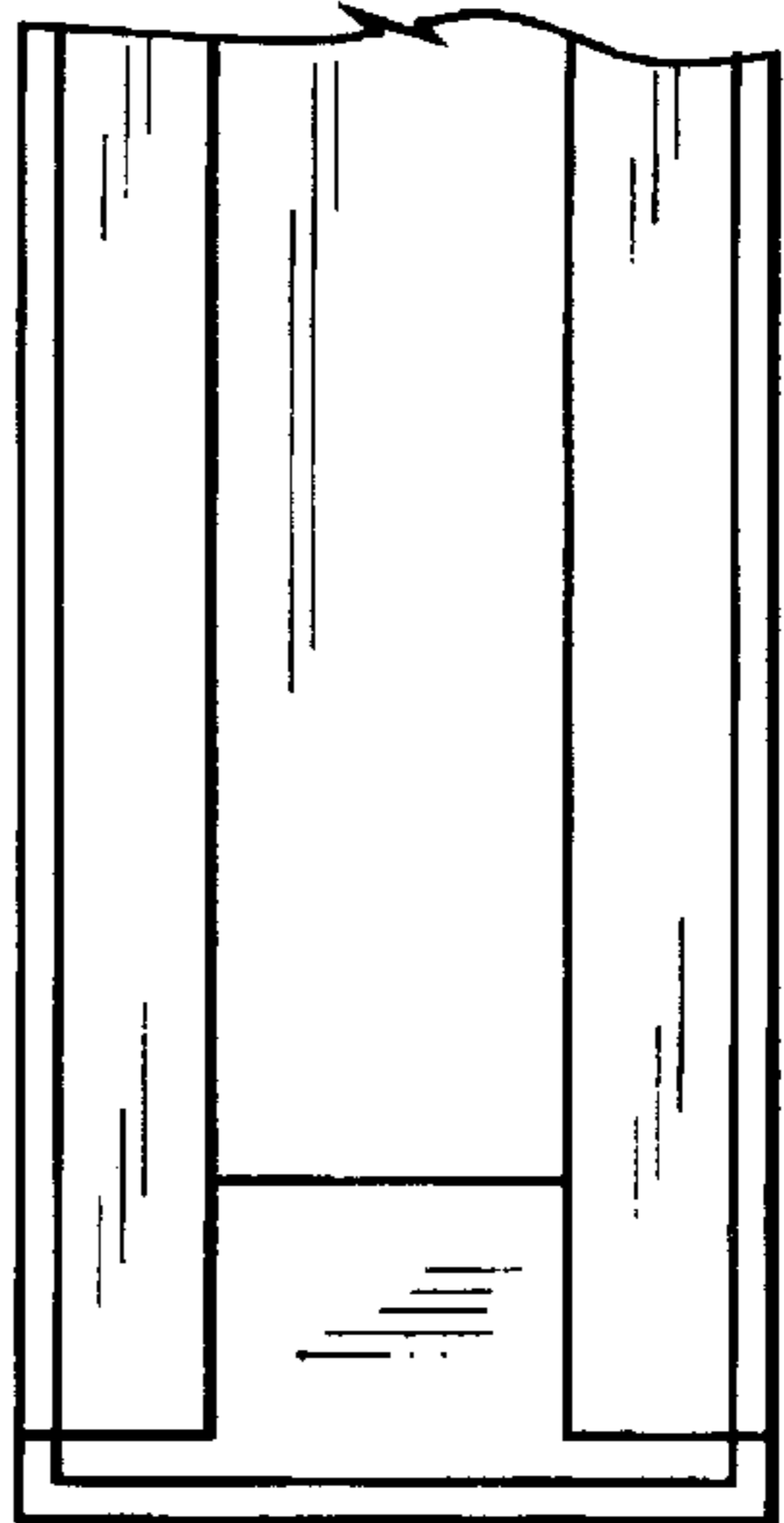

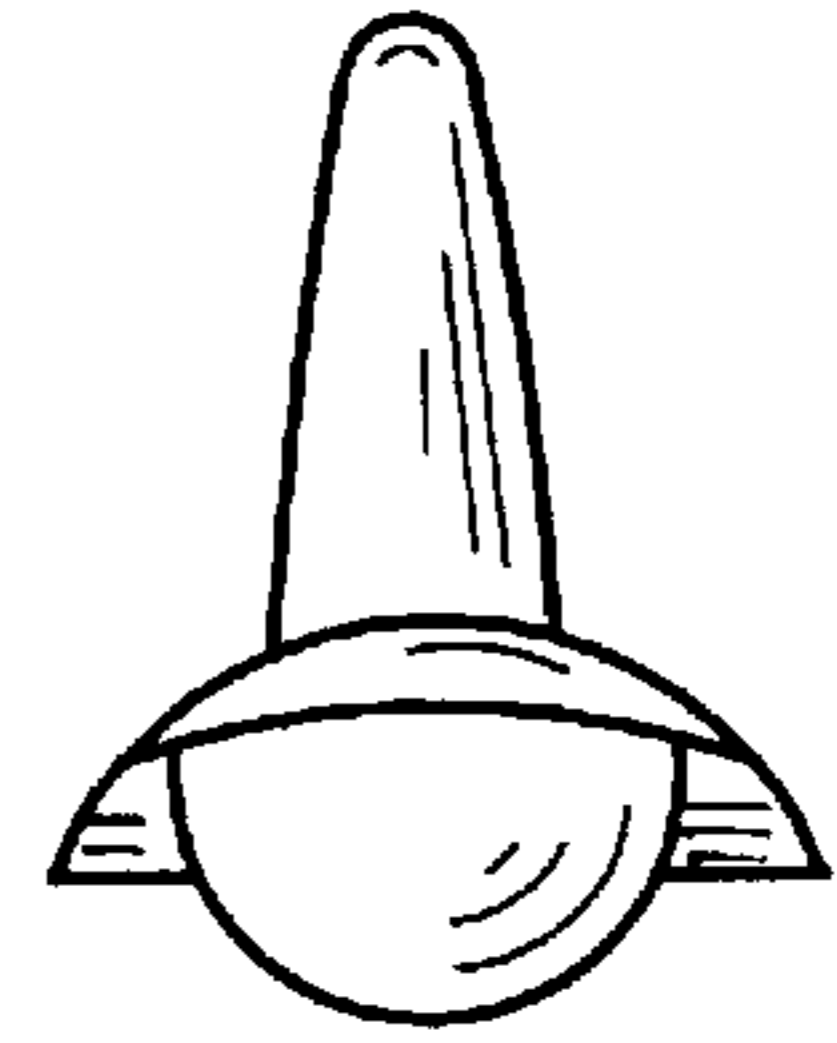

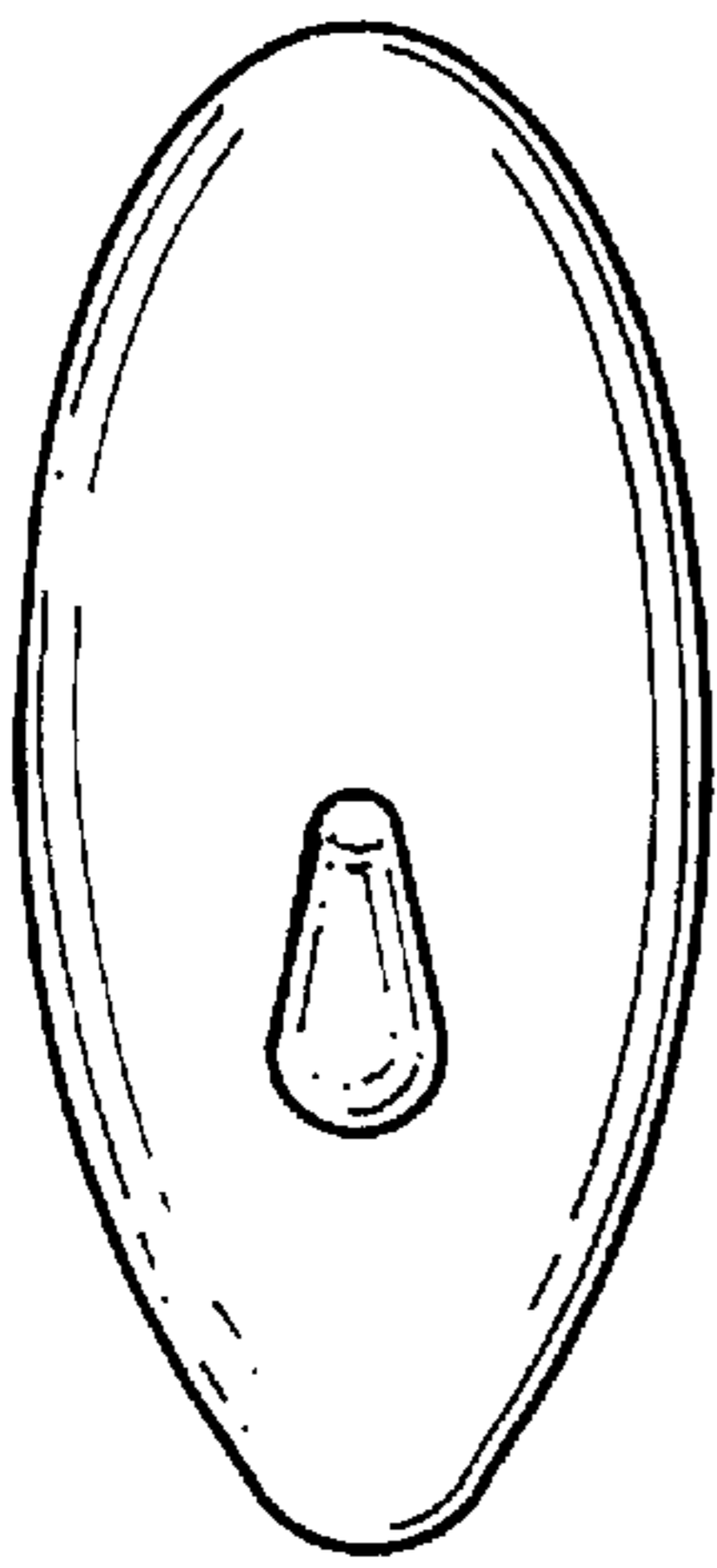

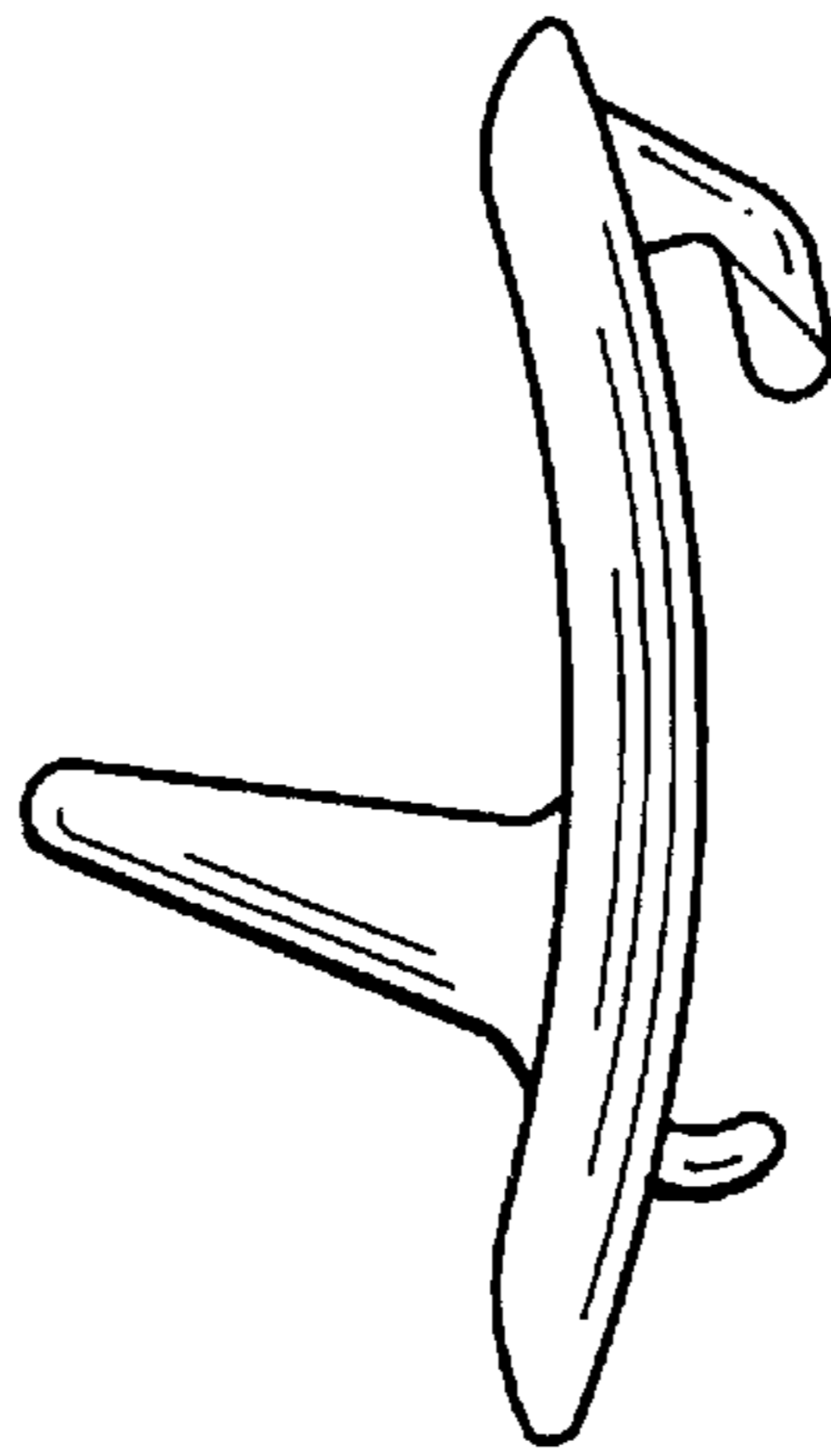

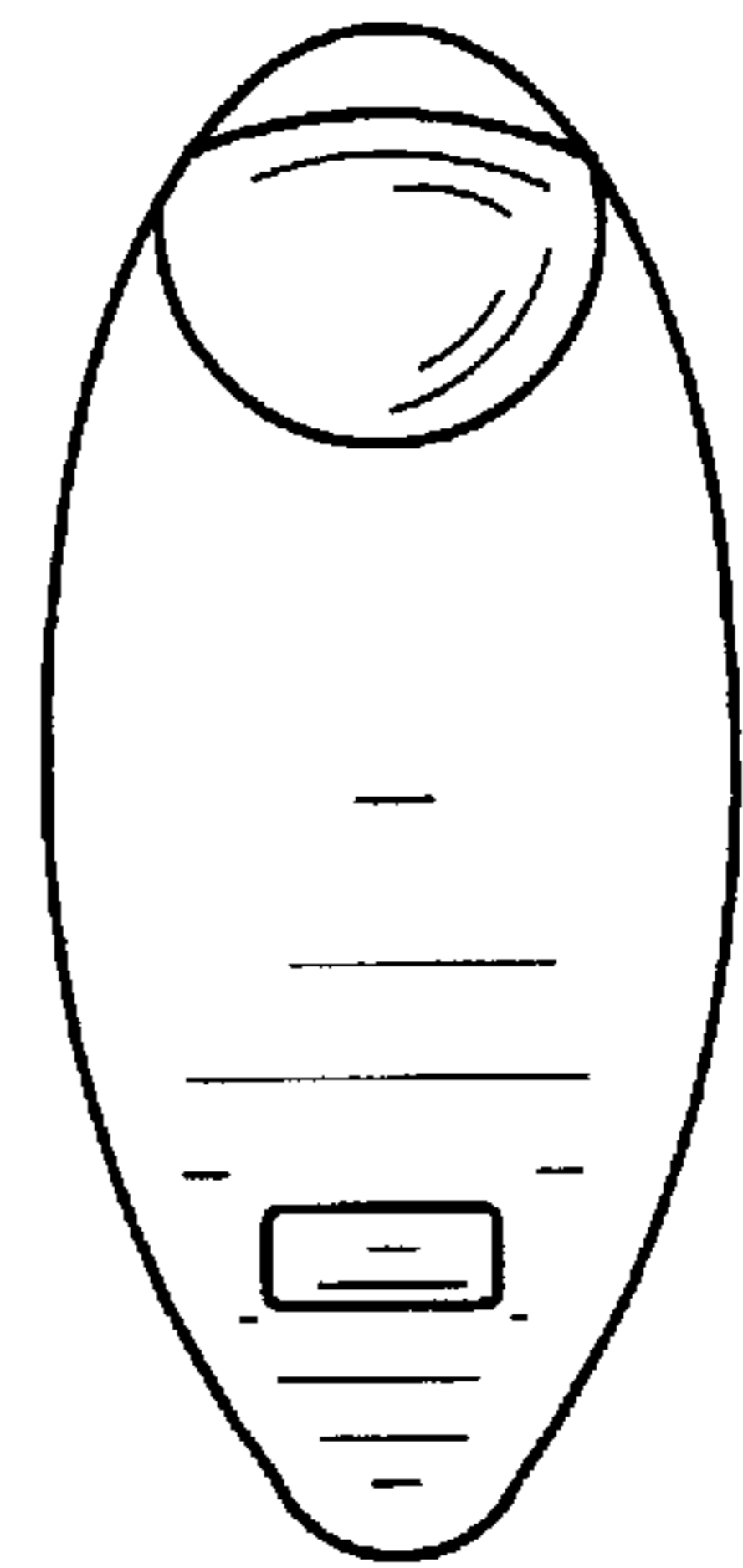

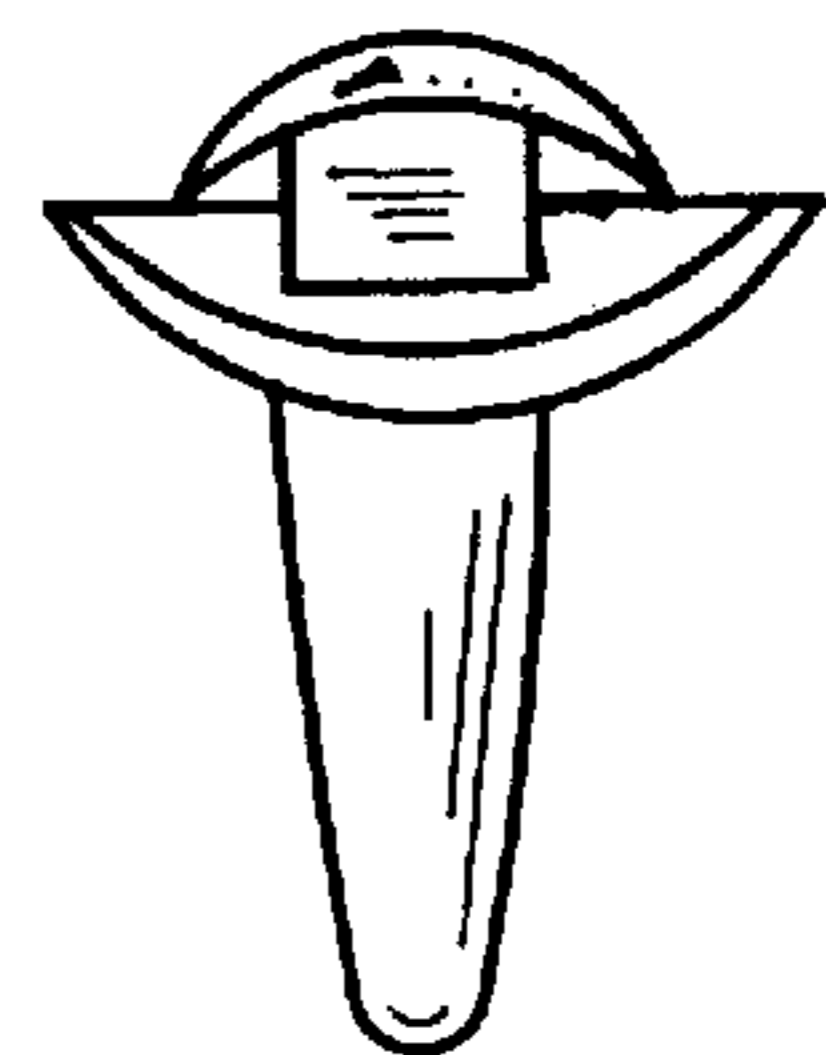

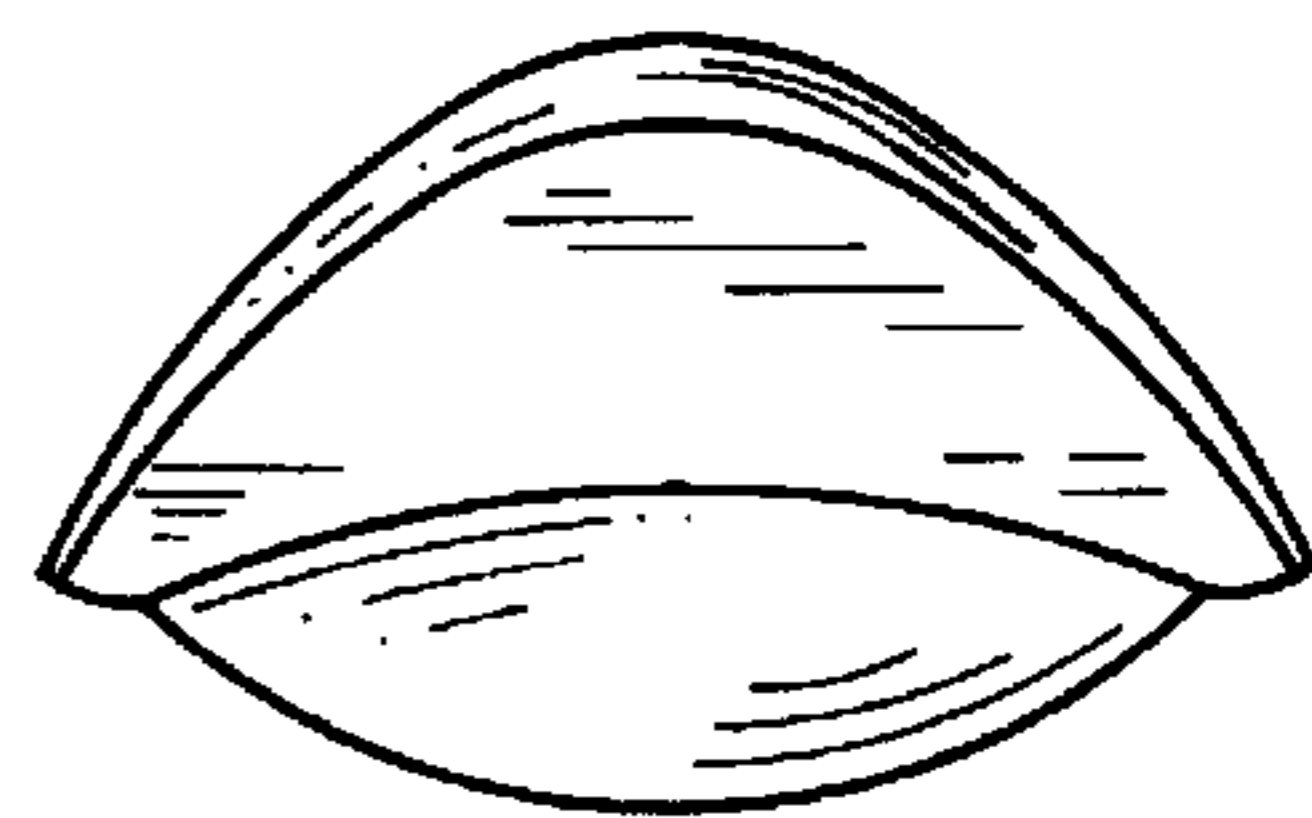

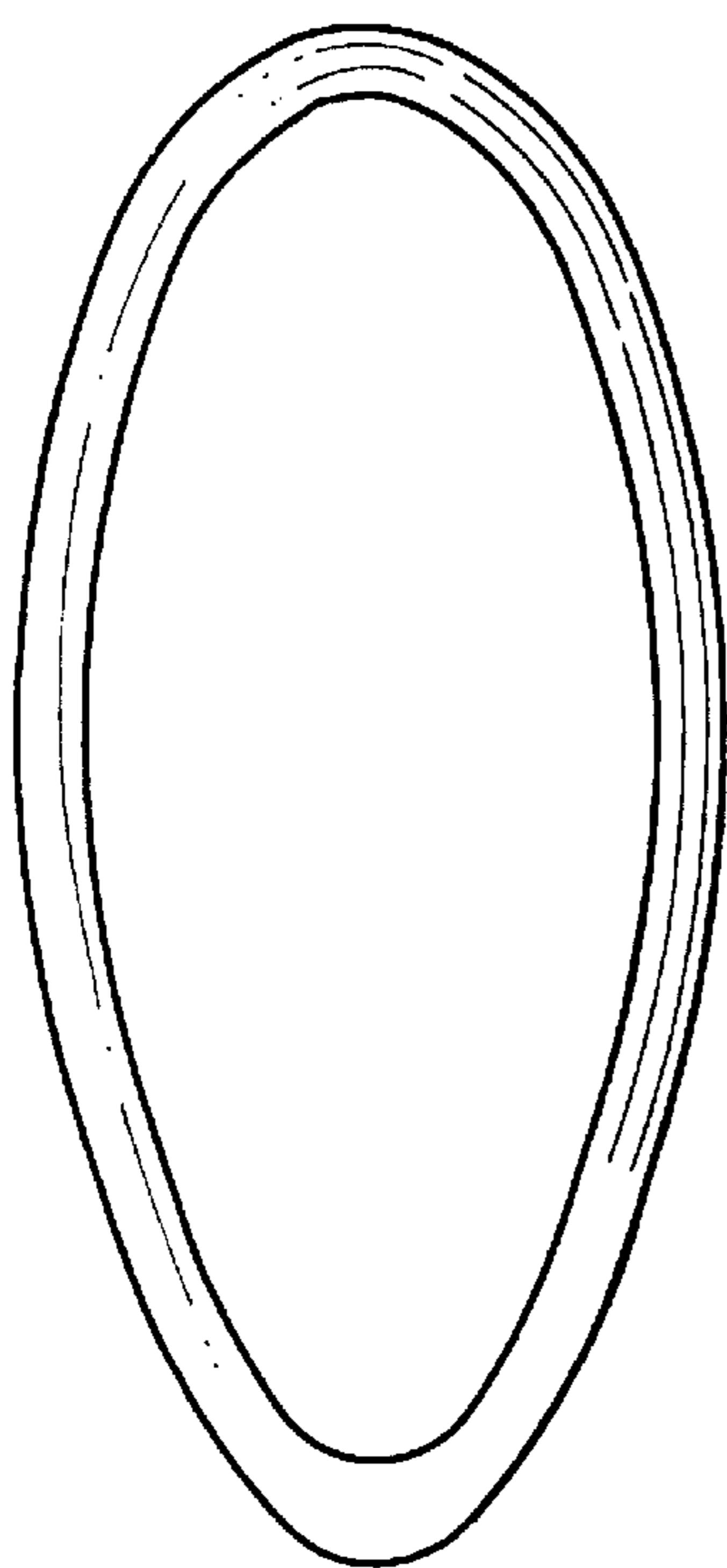

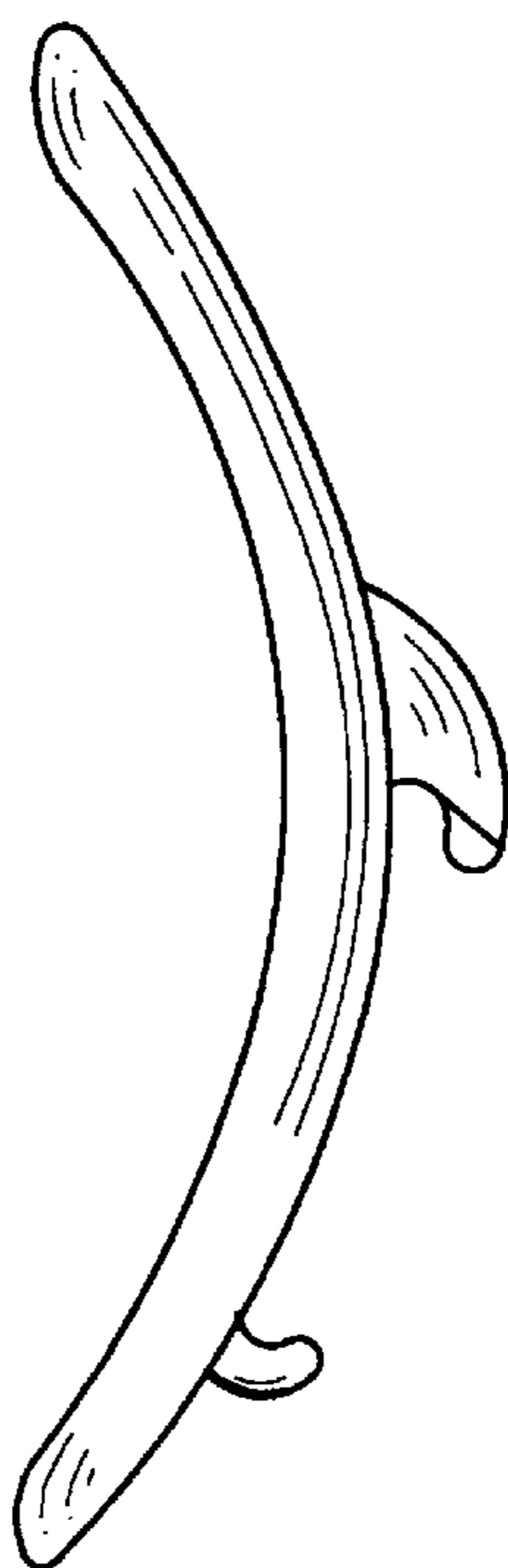

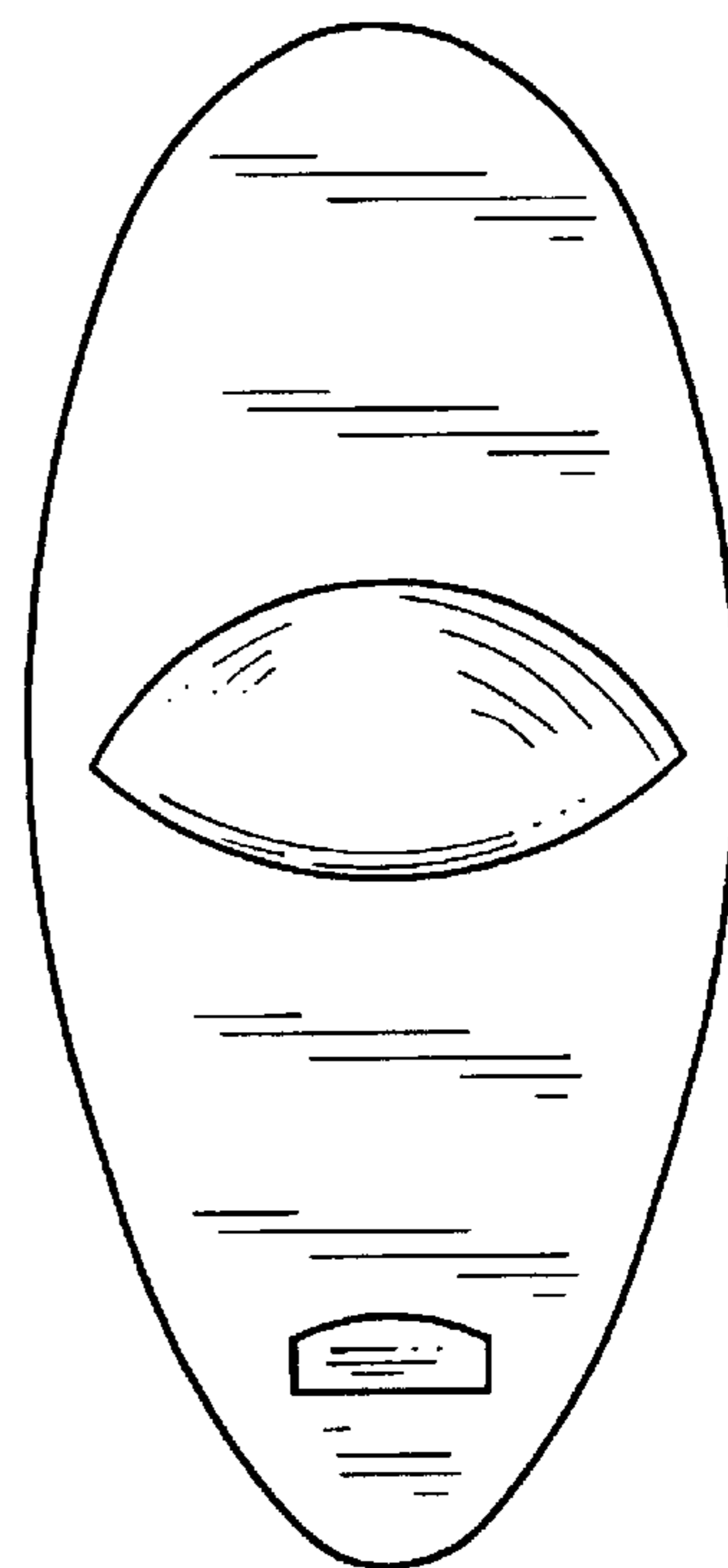

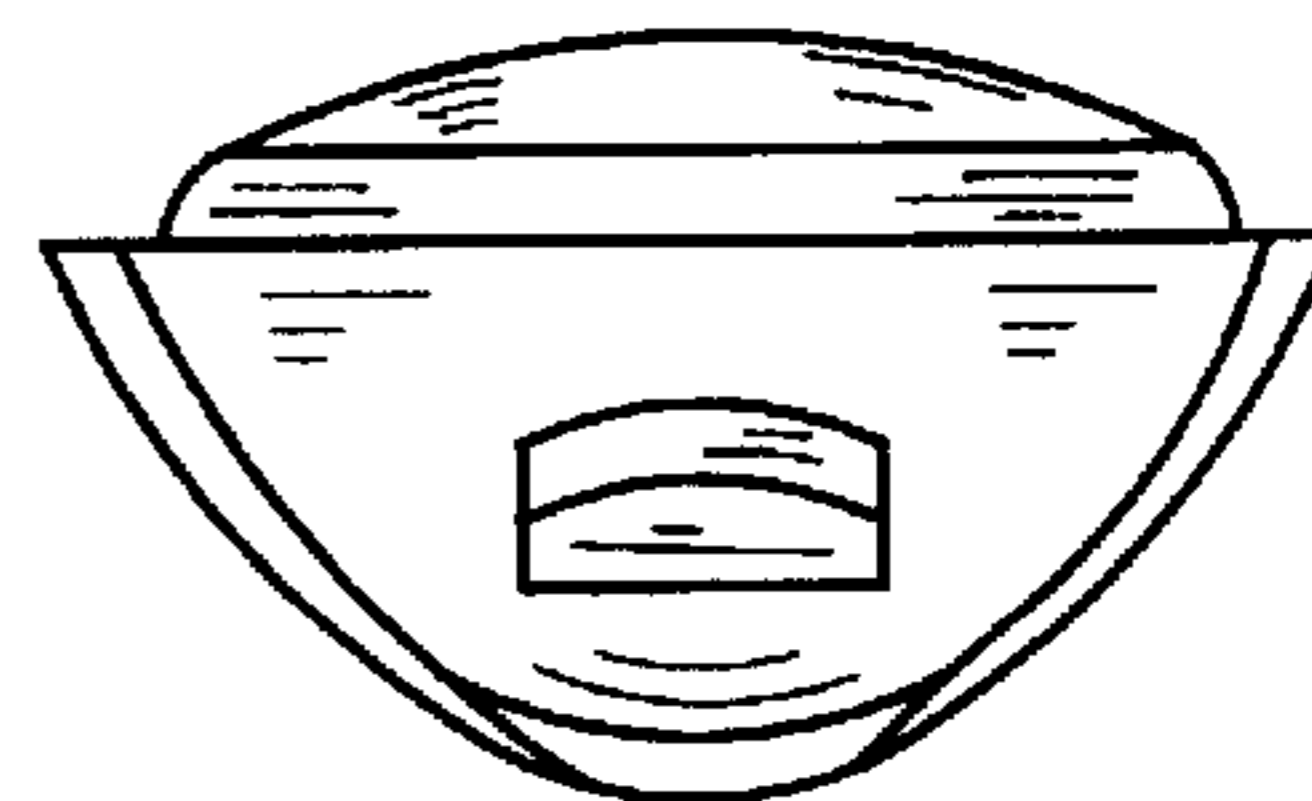
