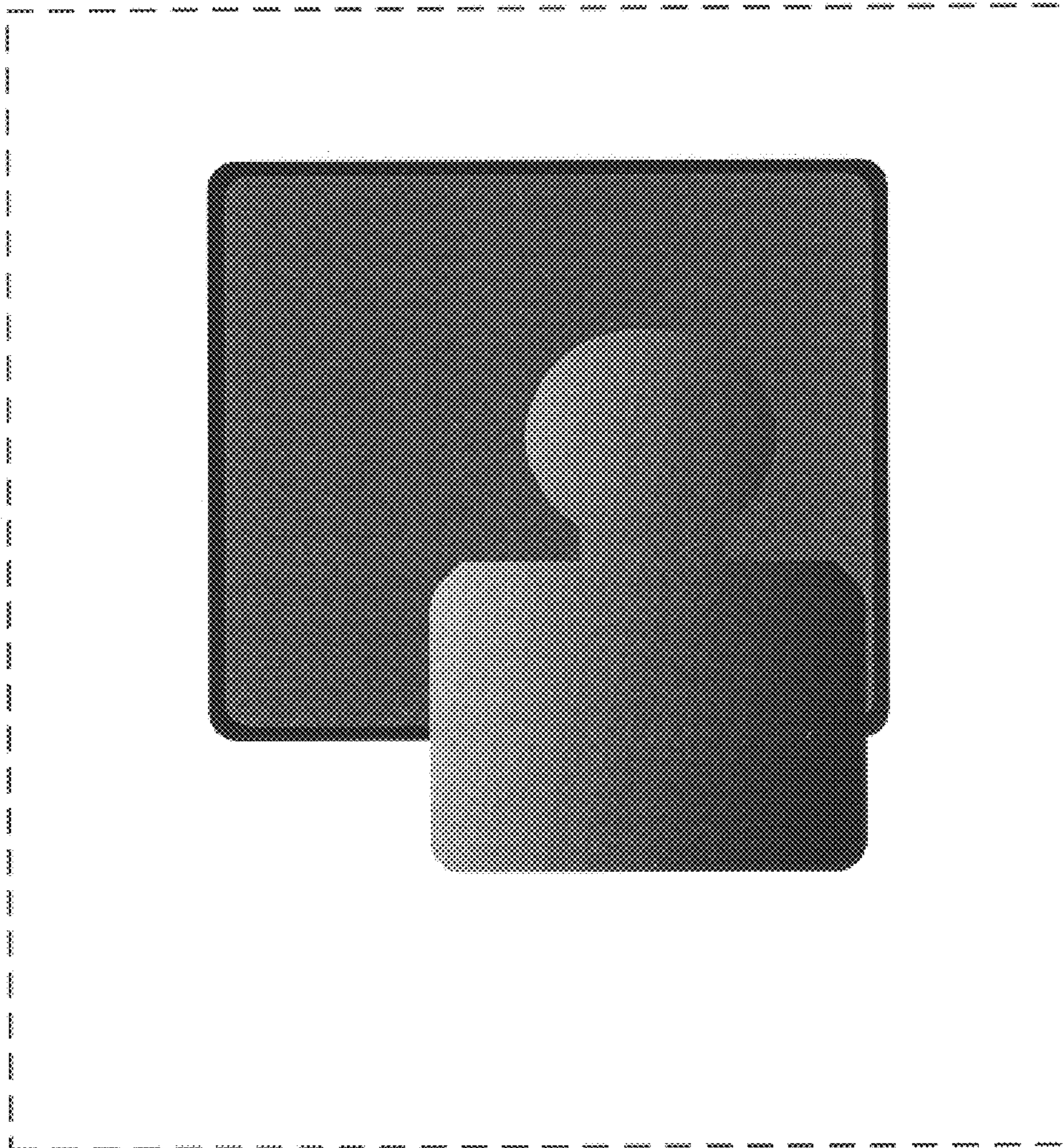
FIG. 1 is a front view of a icon for a computer screen; and,

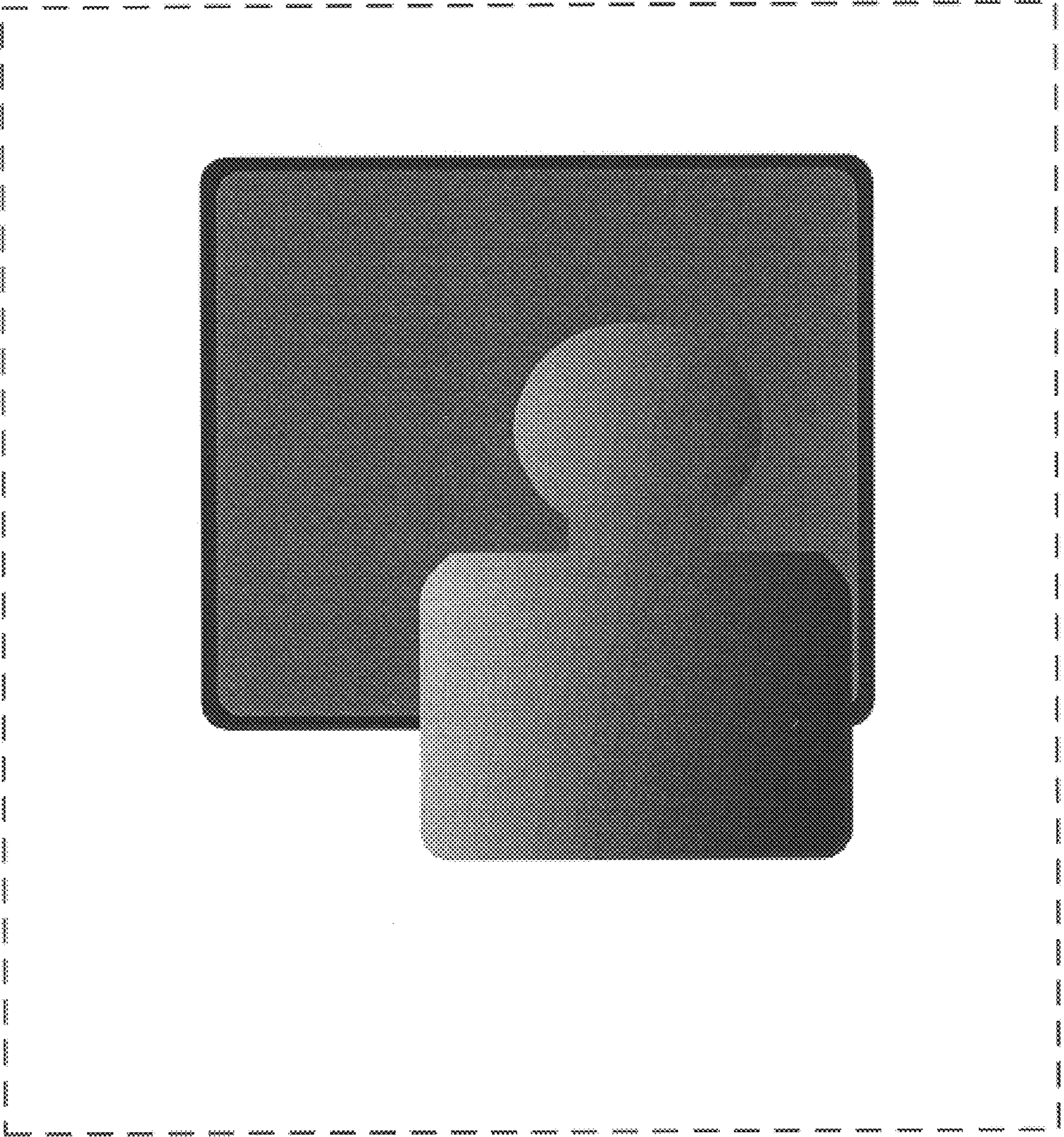

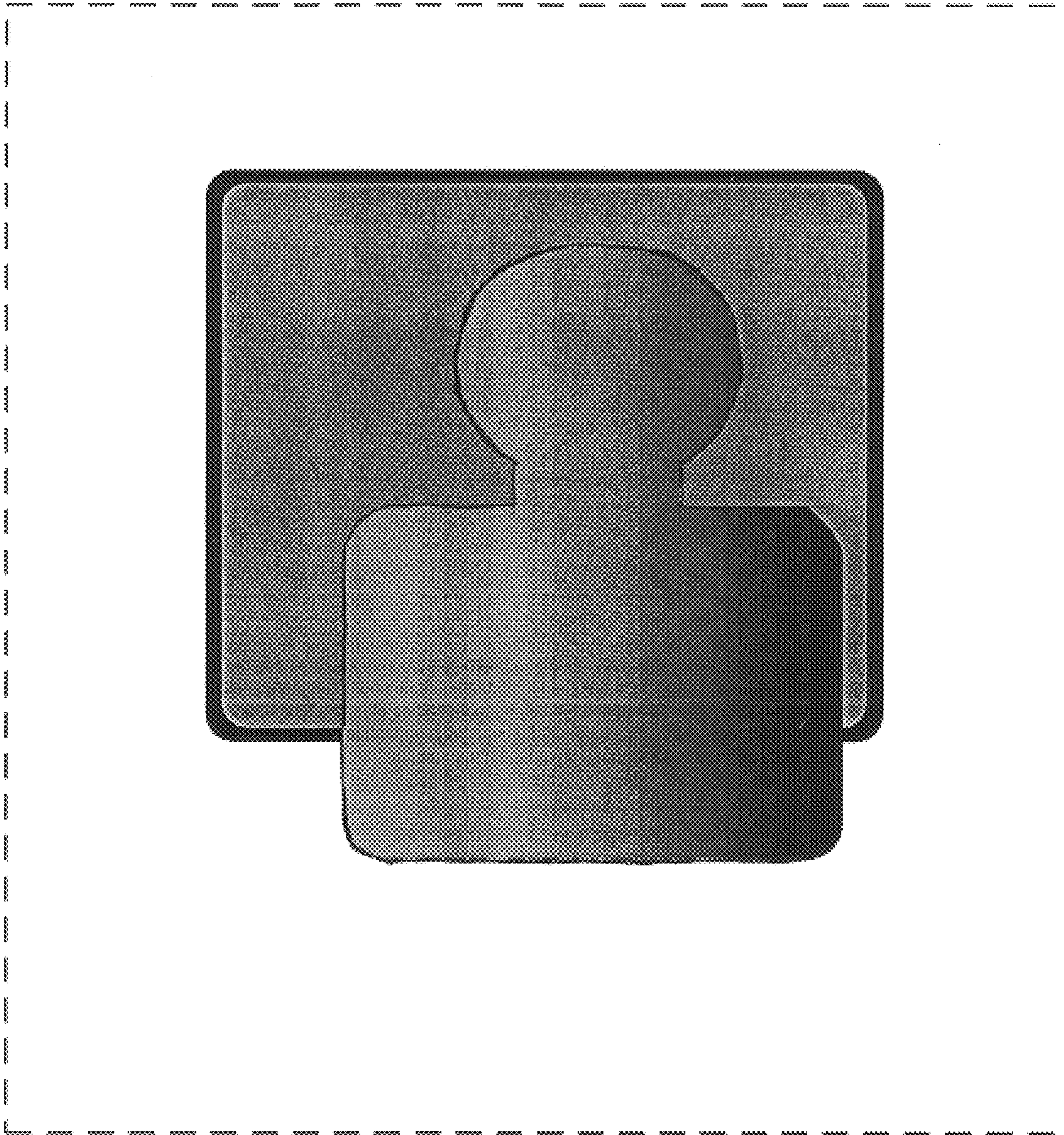
