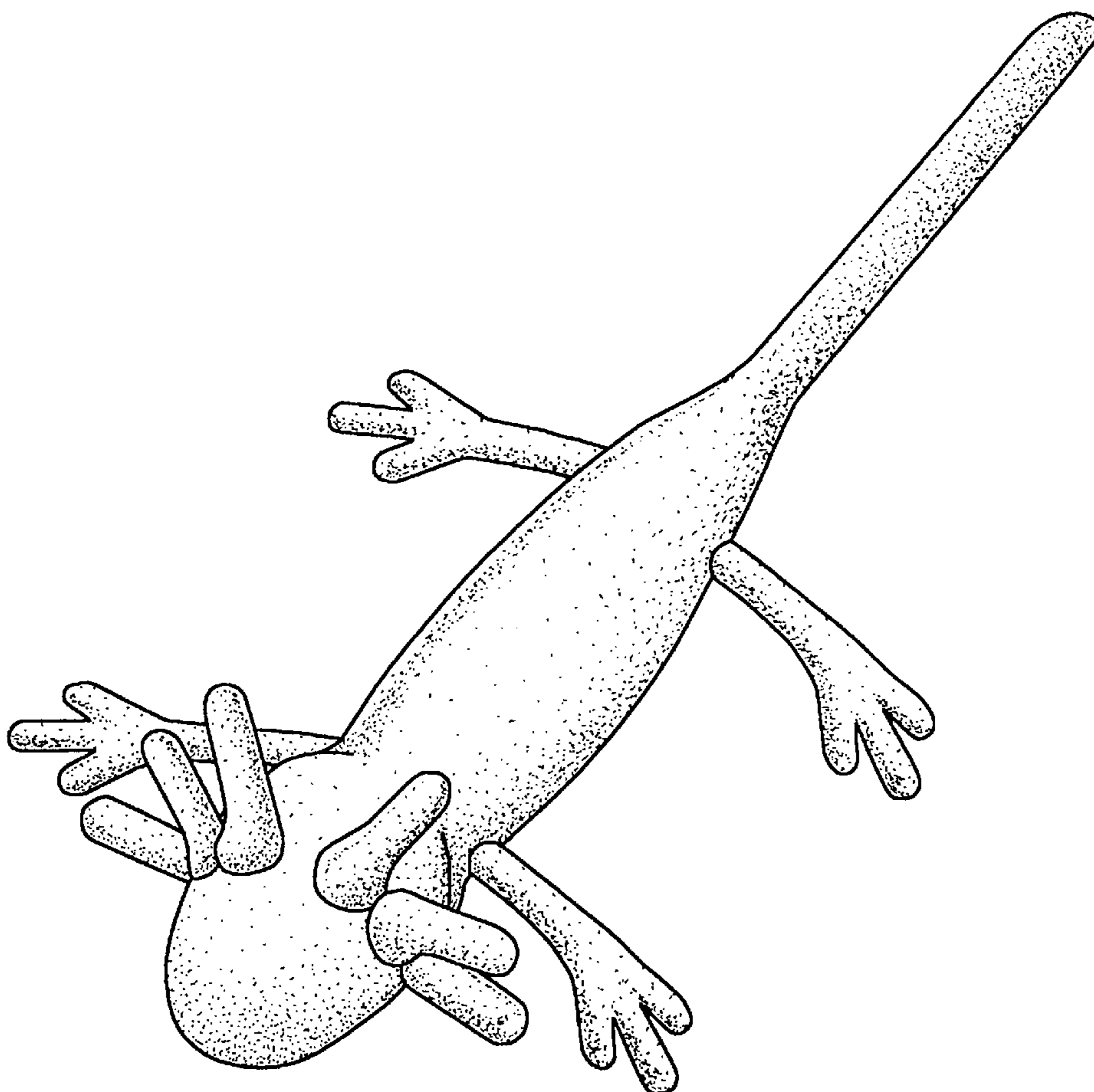
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a salamander fishing lure, as
shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the salamander fishing lure.
FIG. 2 is a view of the right side (as viewed from the front)
thereof.
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a left side view (as seen from the front) thereof.
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the salamander fishing lure.

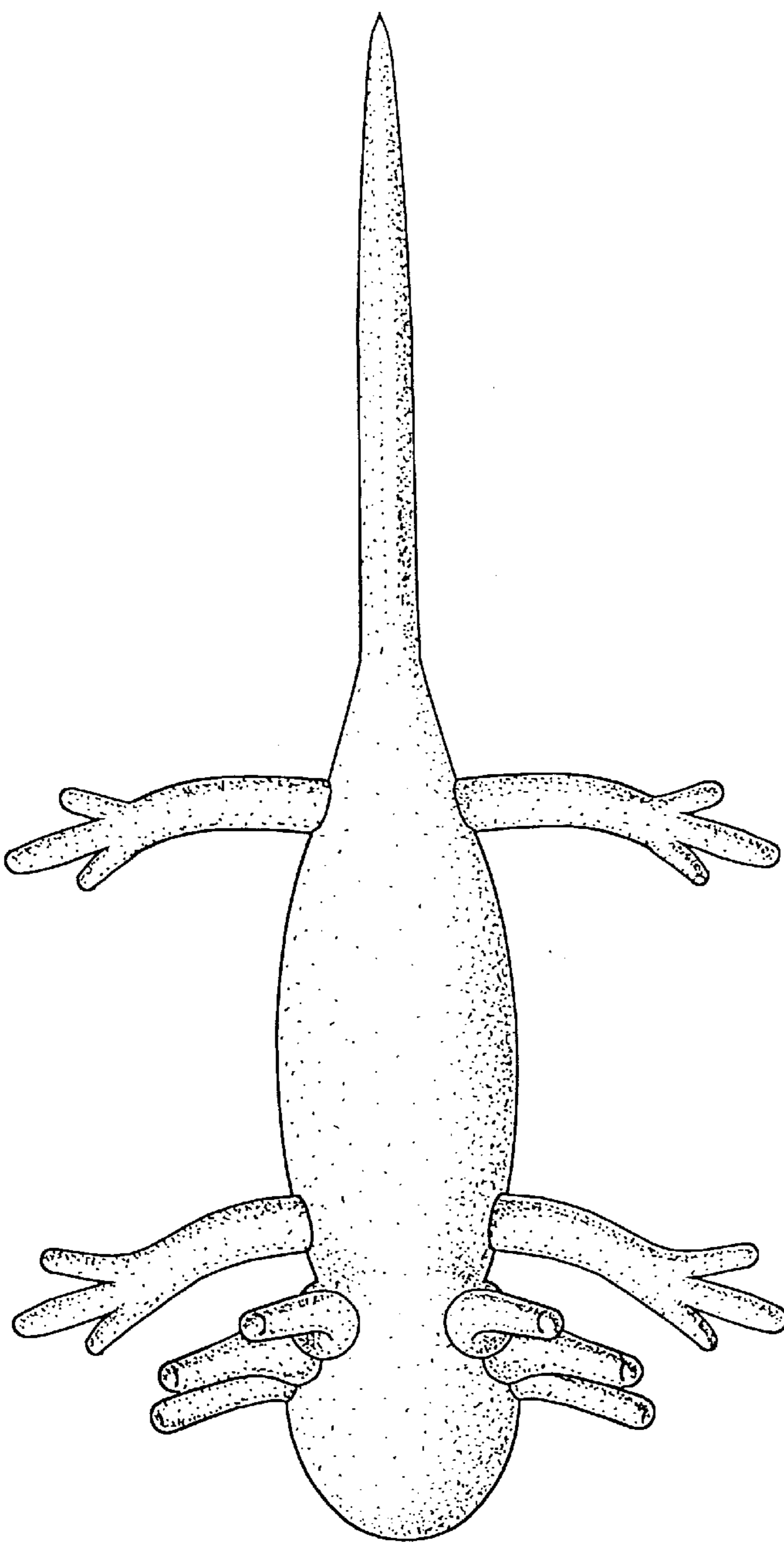

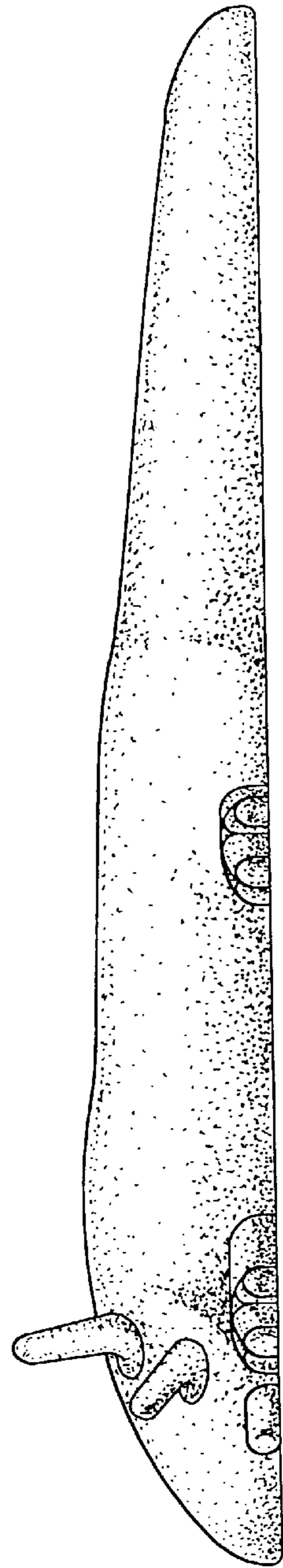

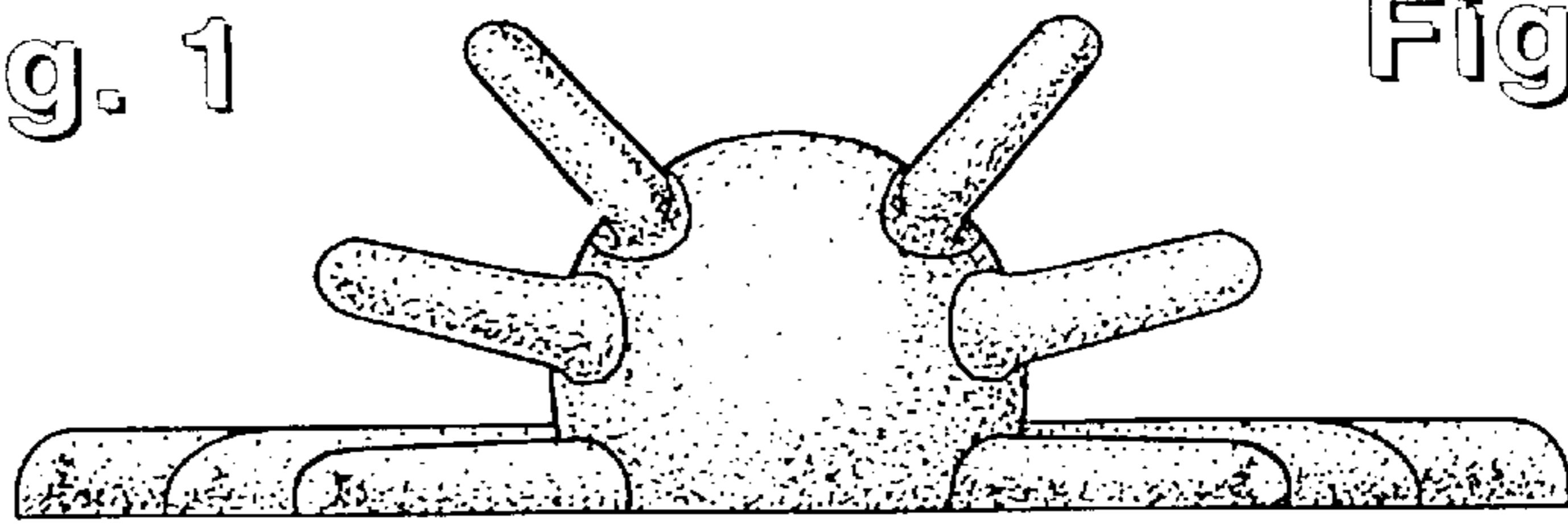

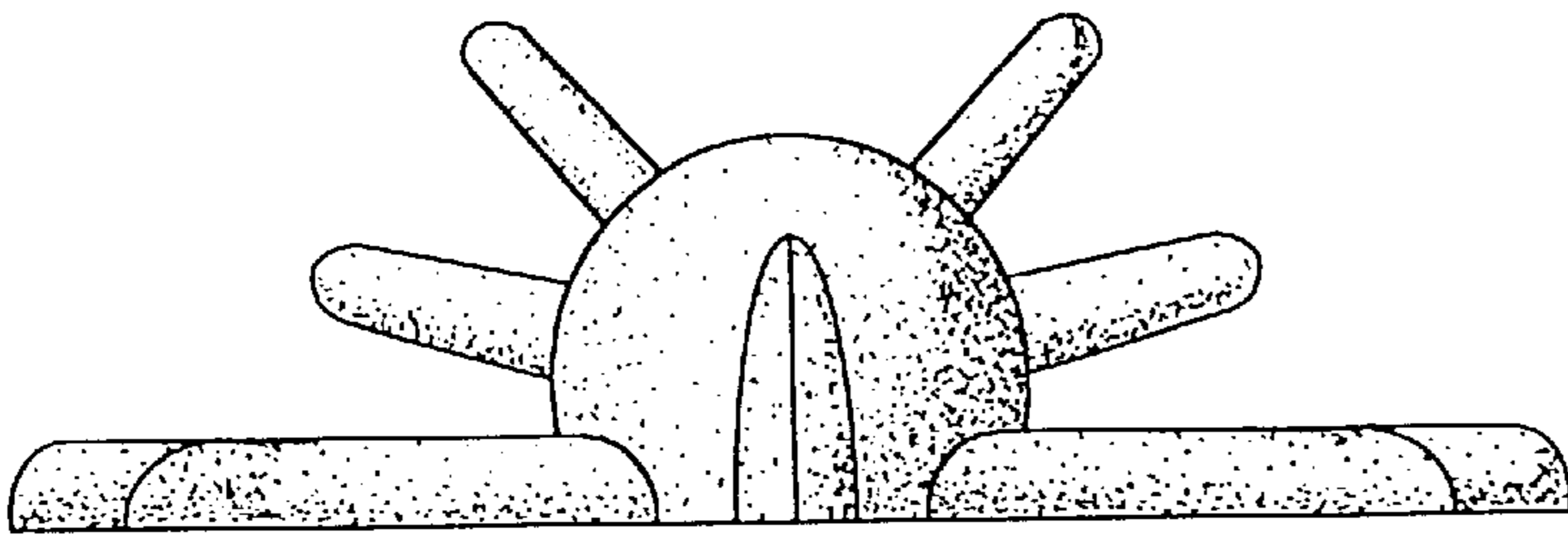

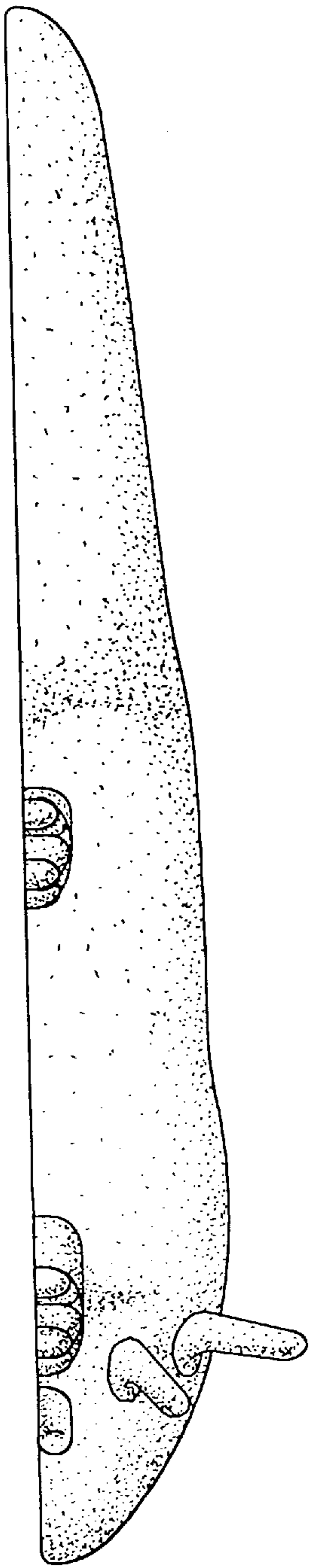

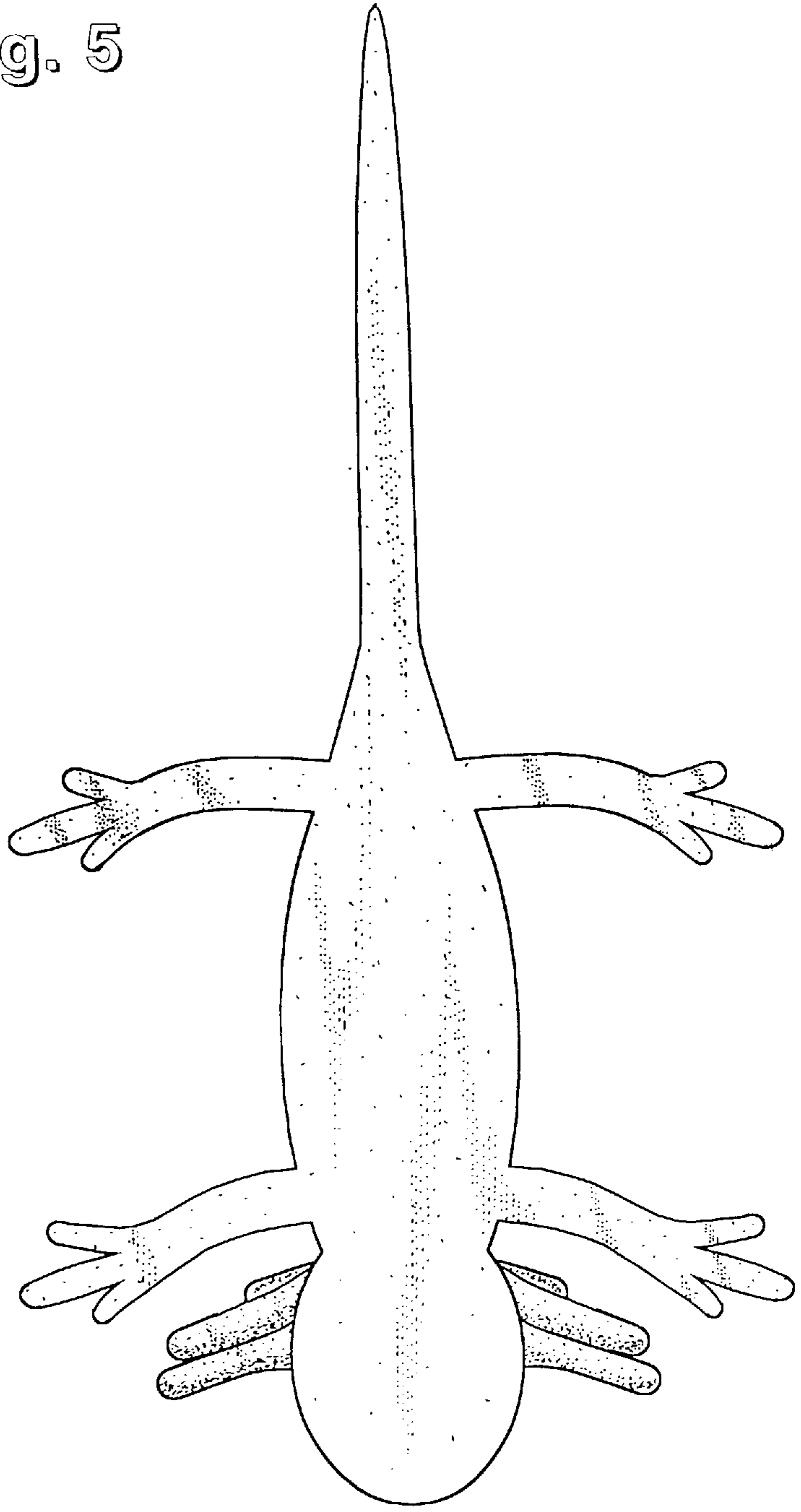

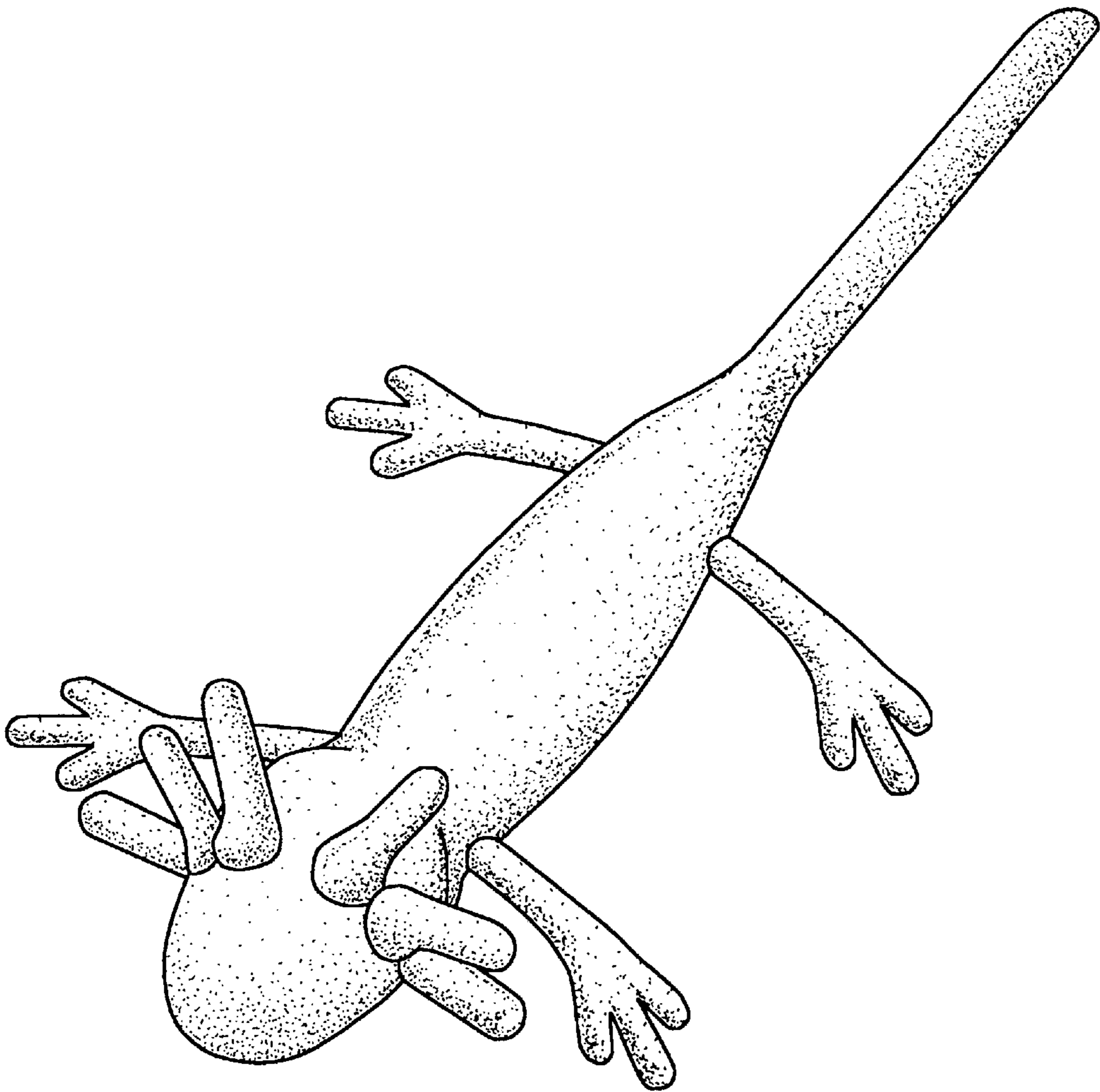
