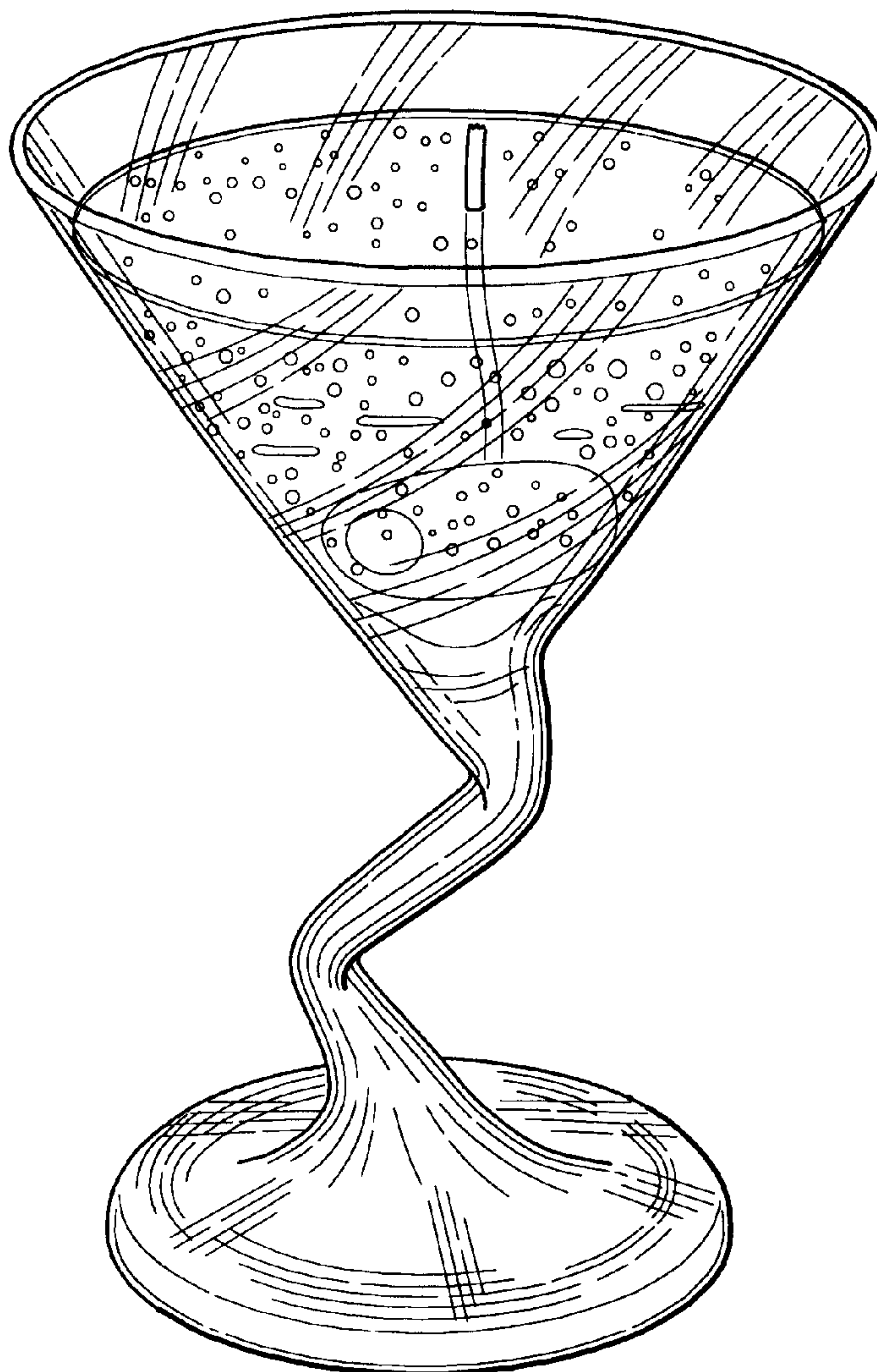
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

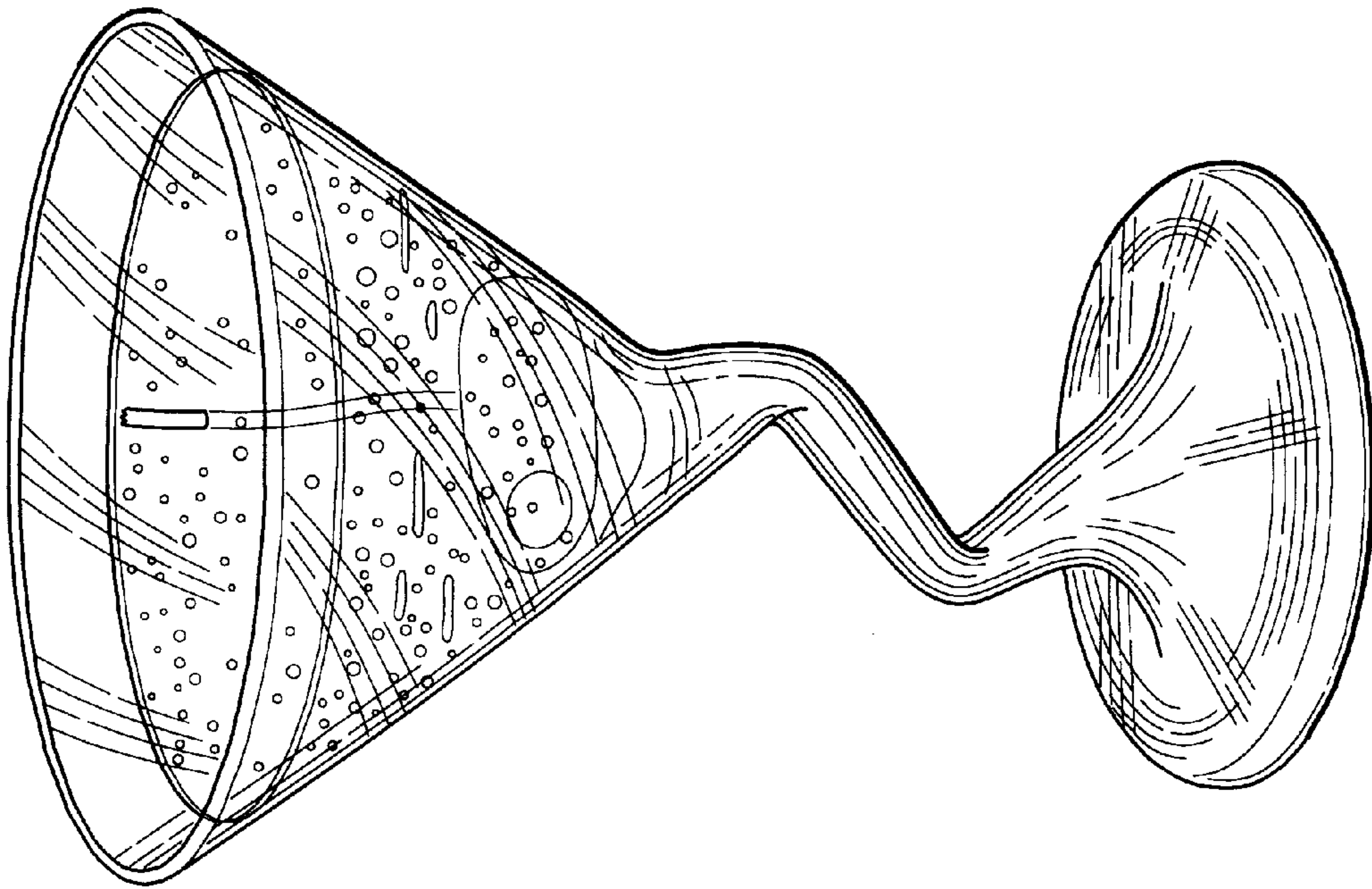

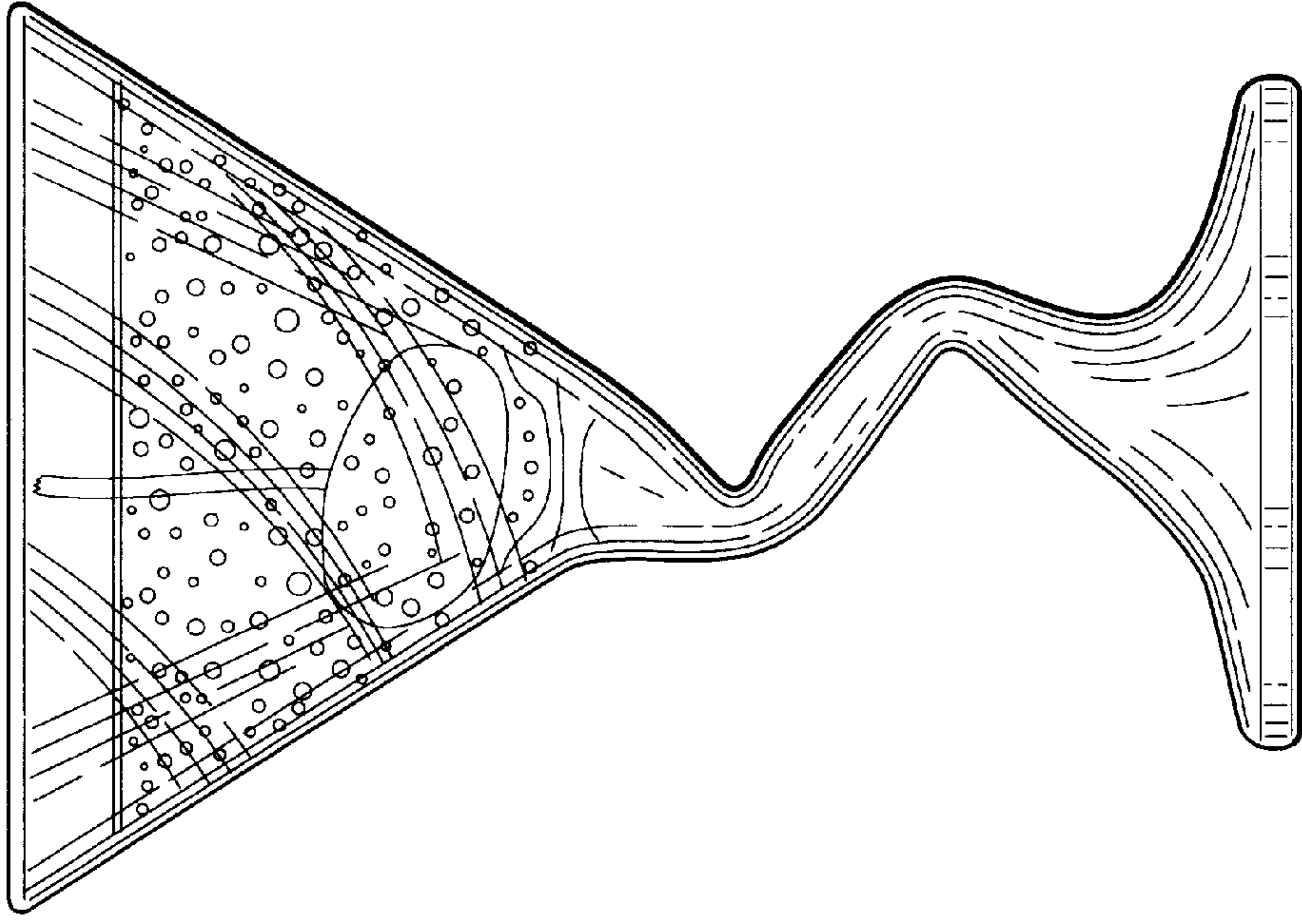

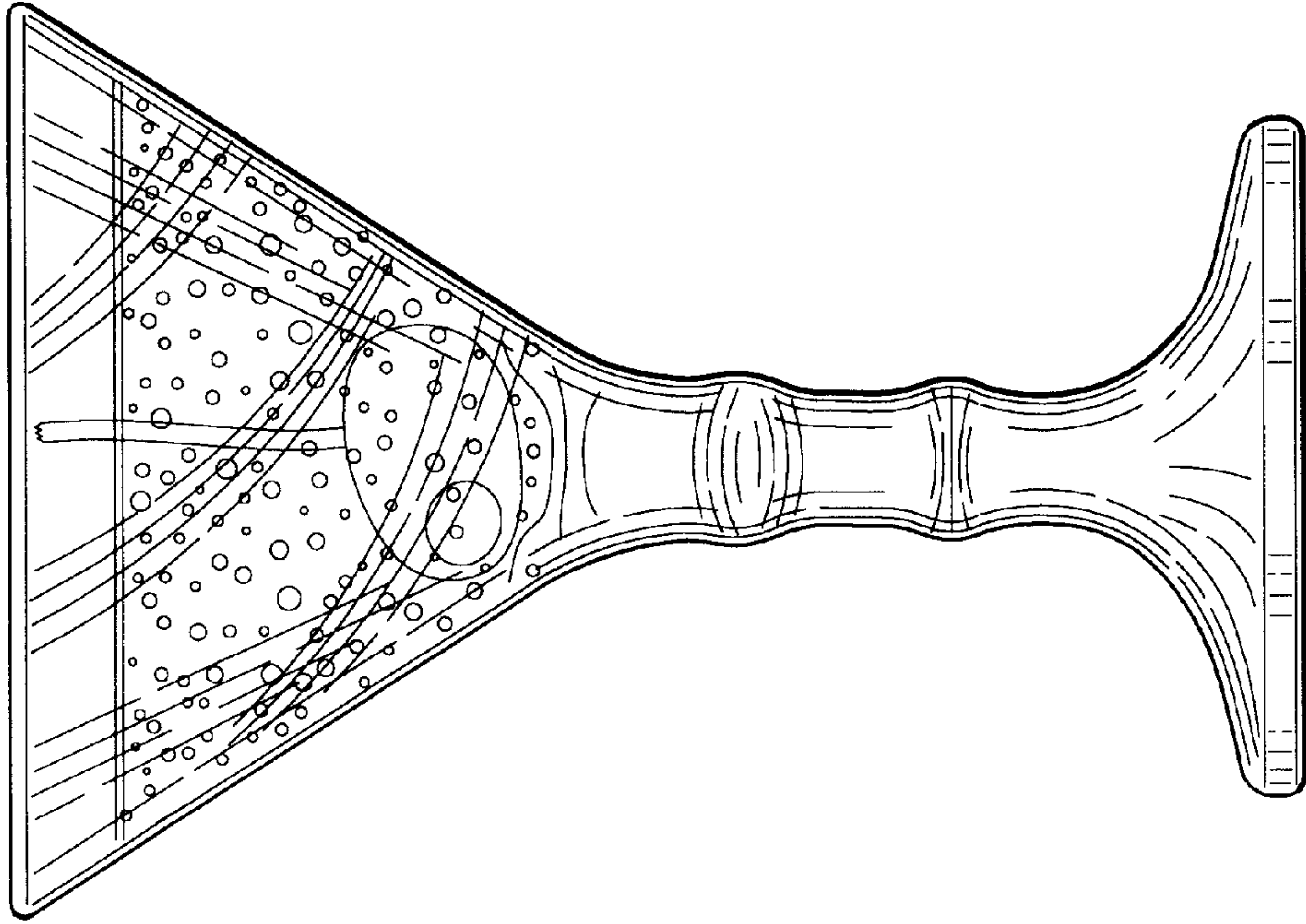

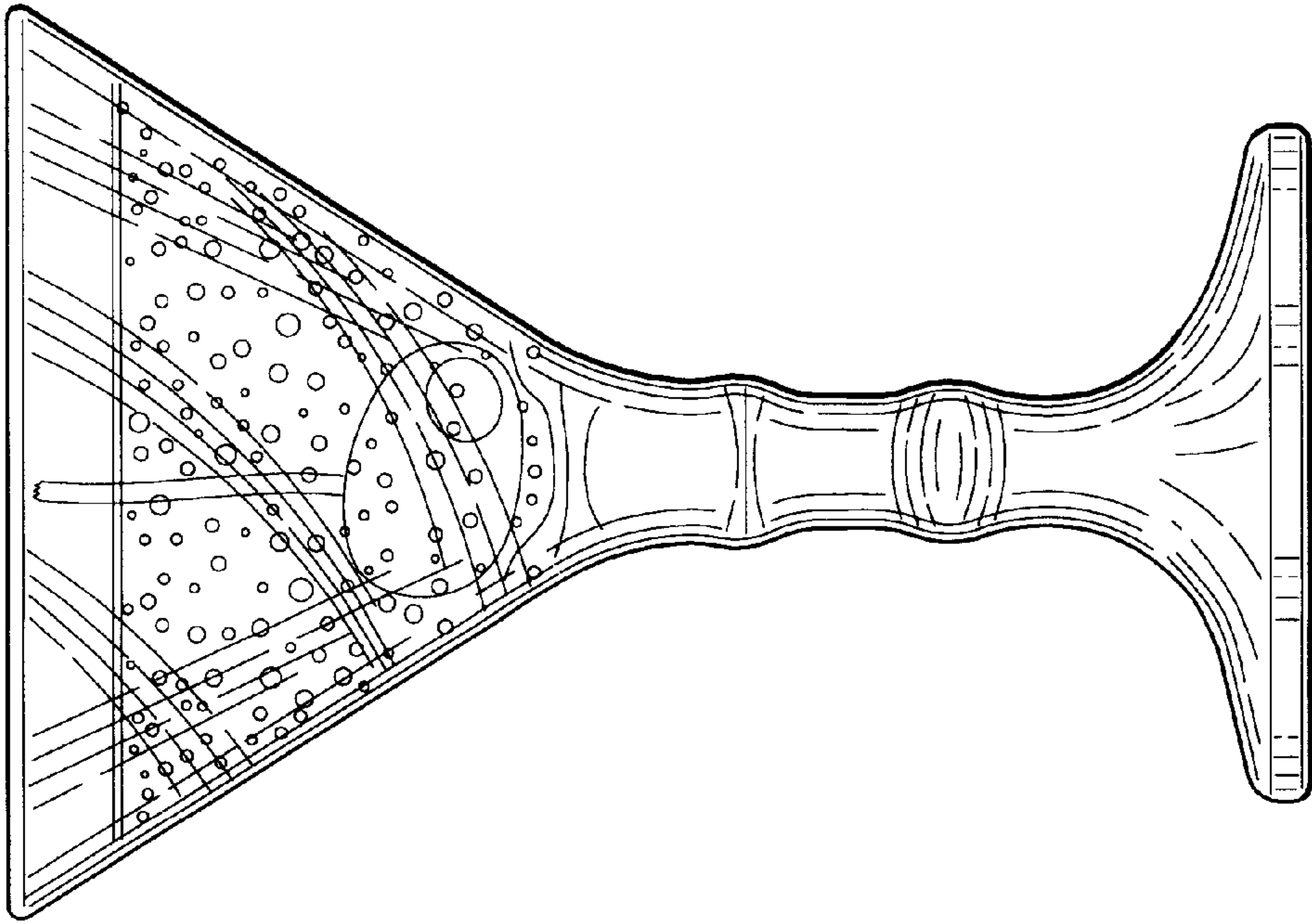

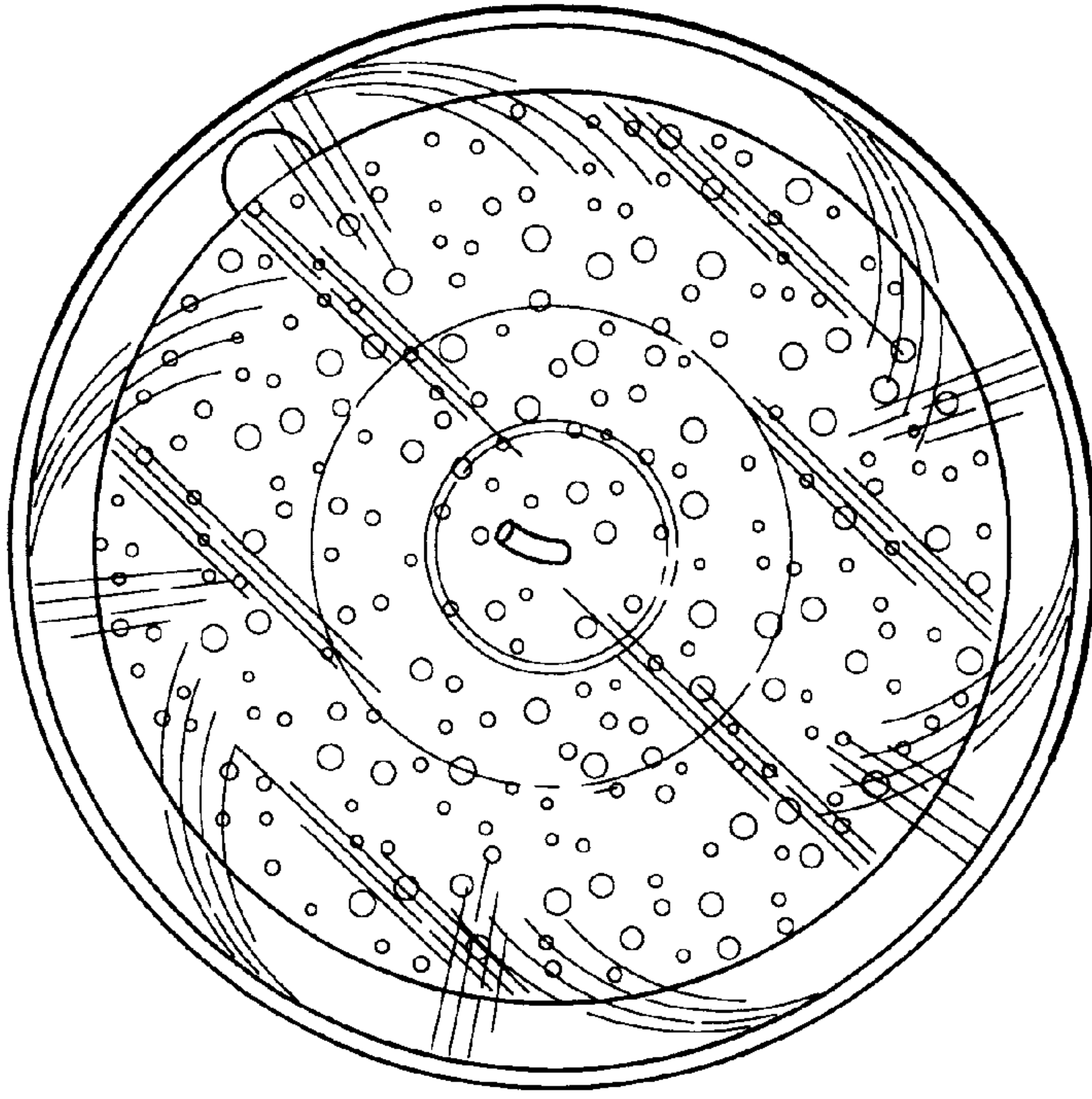

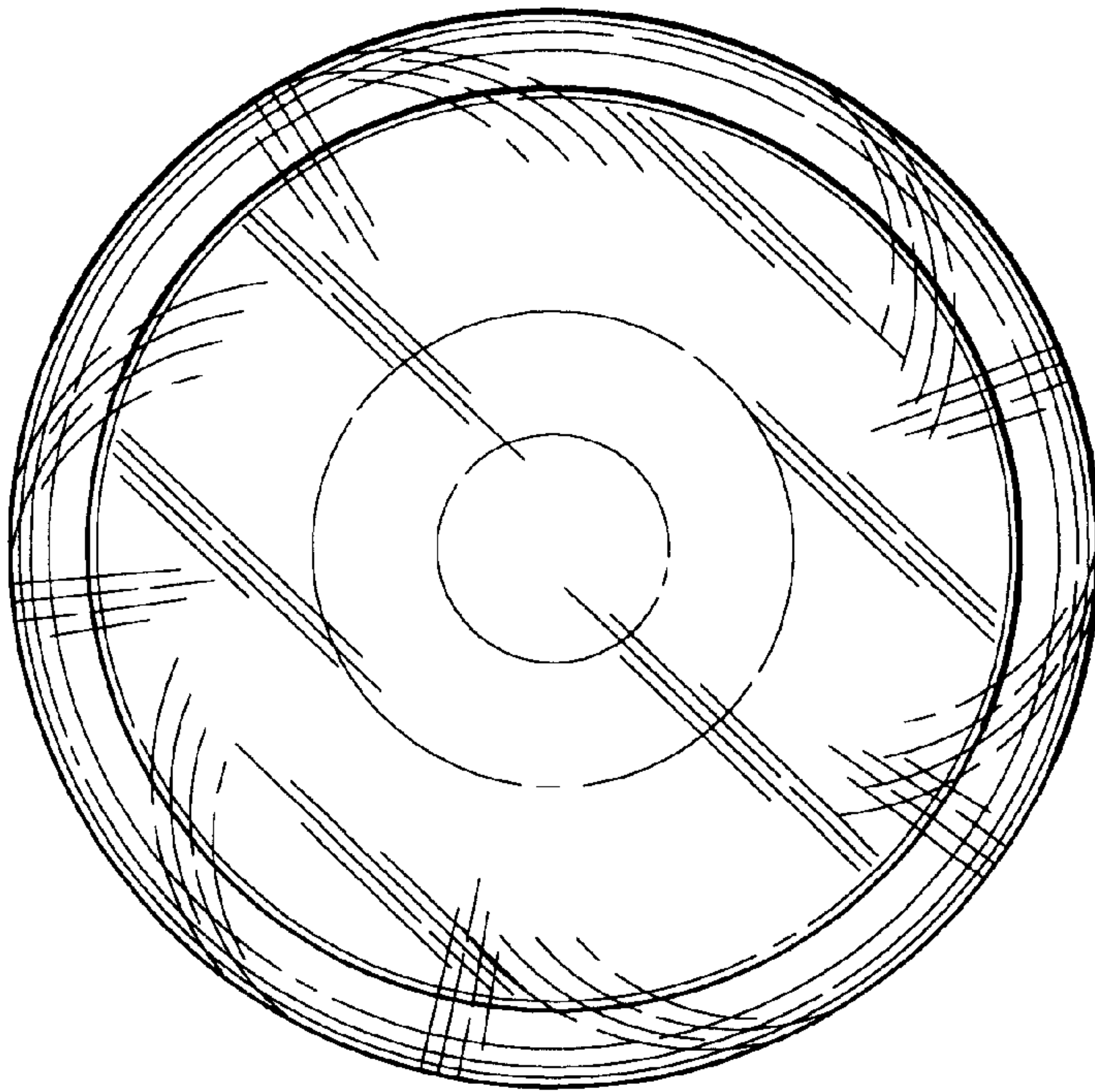
