[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shaving aid strip for a razor cartridge, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shaving aid strip for a razor cartridge showing an embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 1, the other side elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 1, the rear elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a shaving aid strip for a razor cartridge showing a second embodiment of our new design;

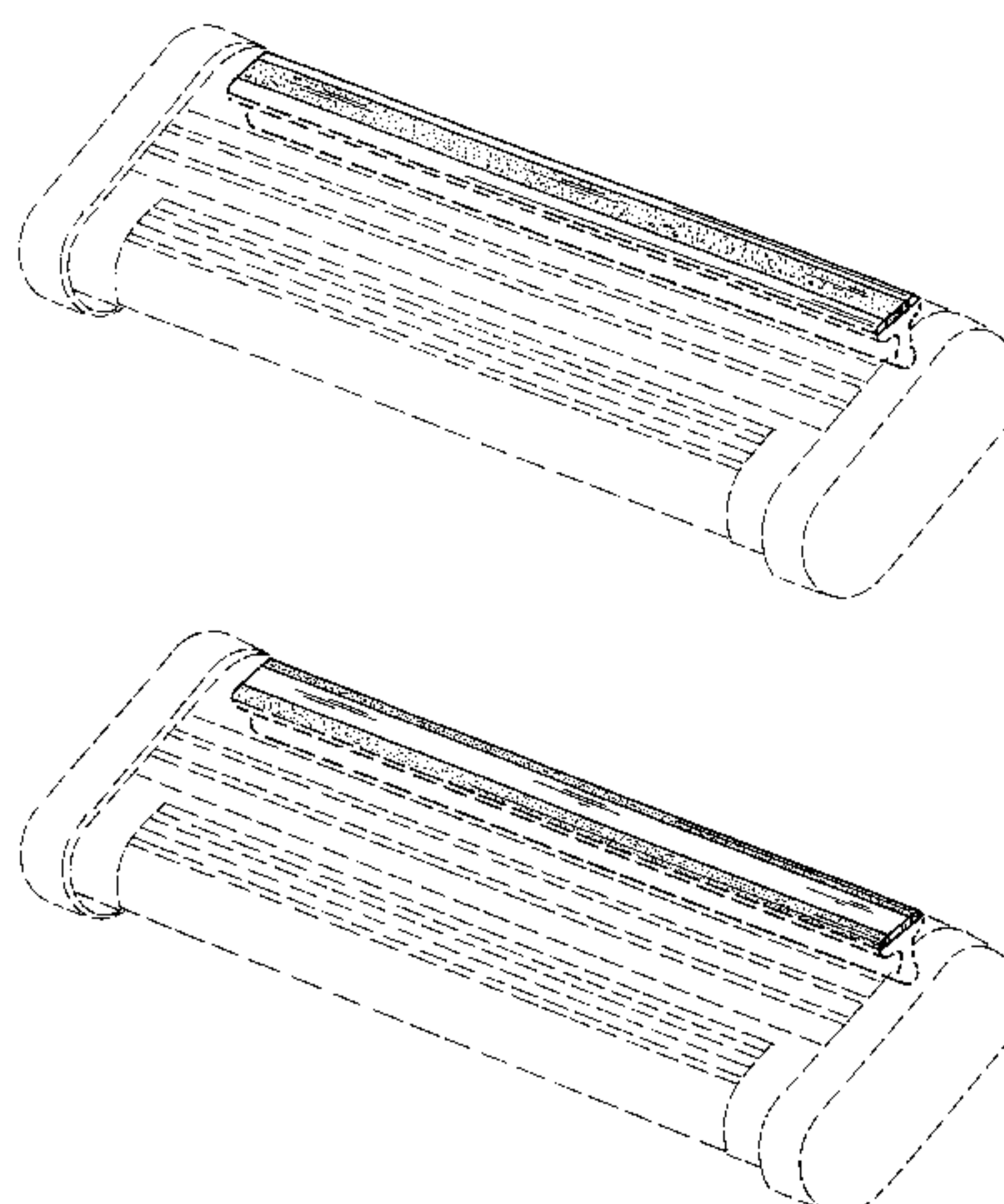
FIG. 6 is a side elevation view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 5, the other side elevation view being identical thereto;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the shaving aid strip of FIG. 5, the rear elevation view being identical thereto.

The broken lines showing the razor cartridge and parts underlying the broken line boundary are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. The stippling represents a color contrasting surface.”

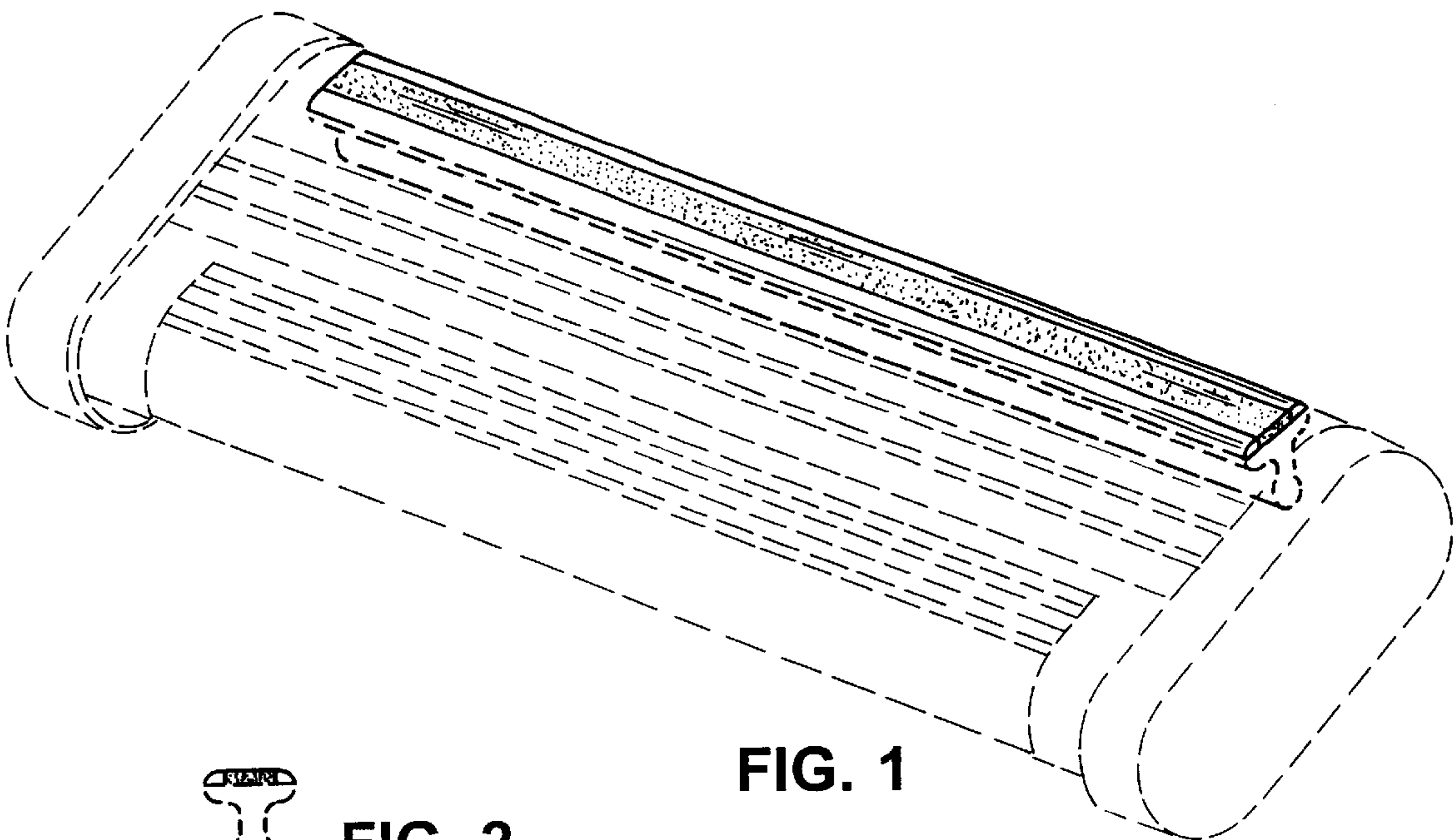

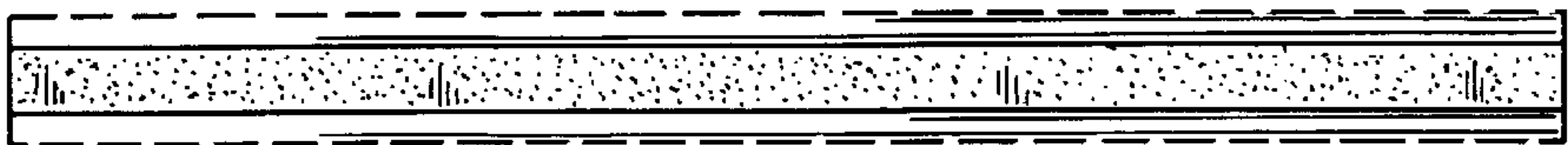

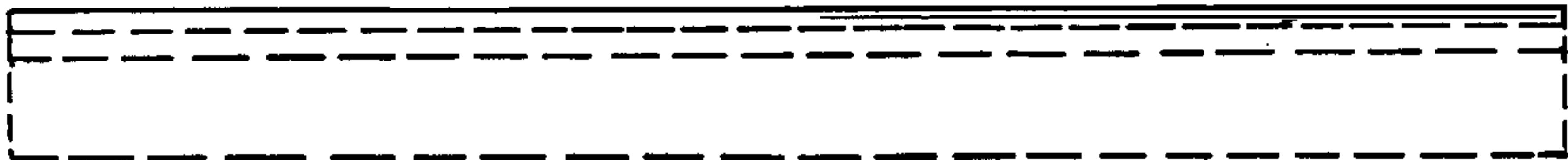

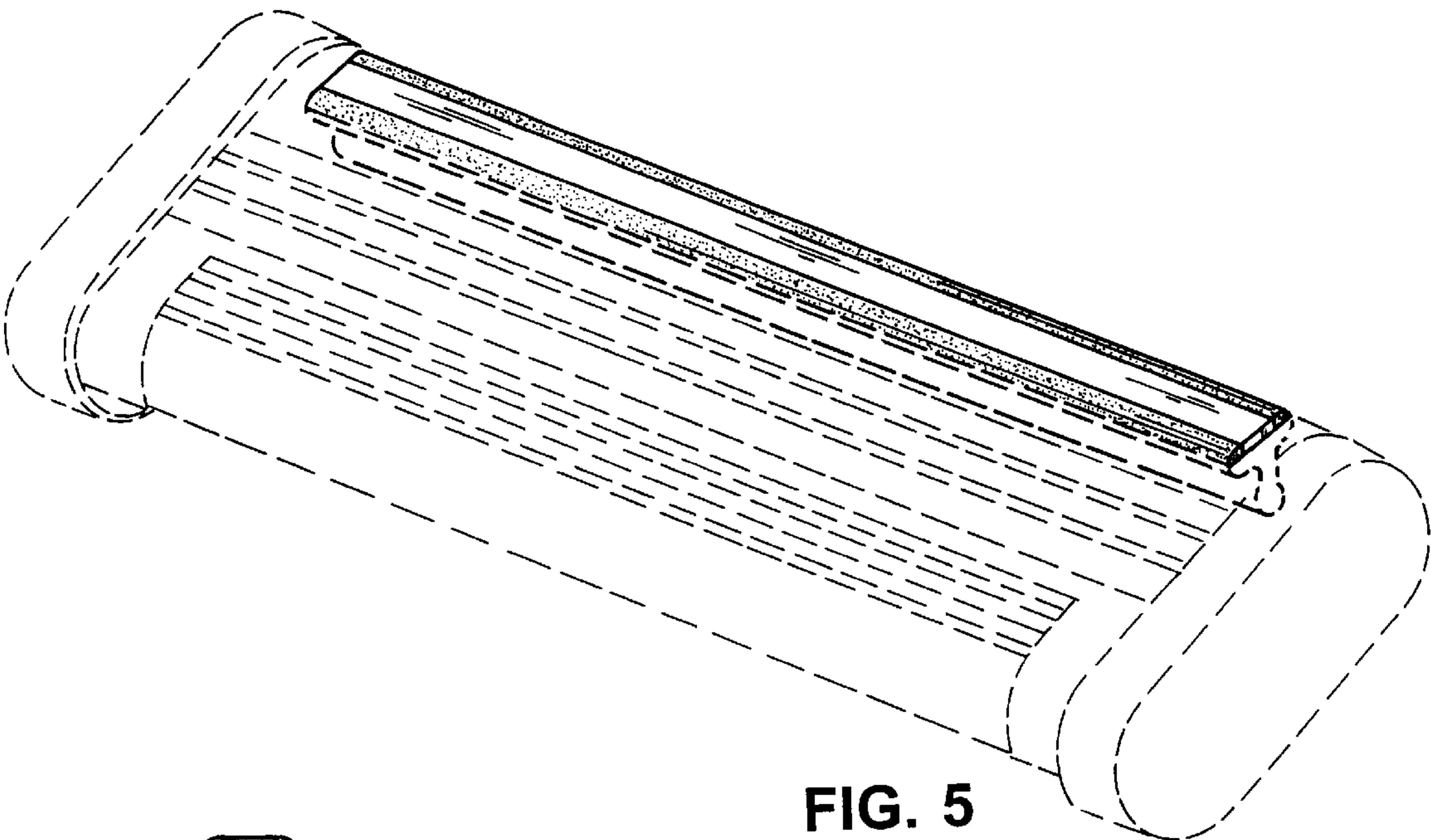

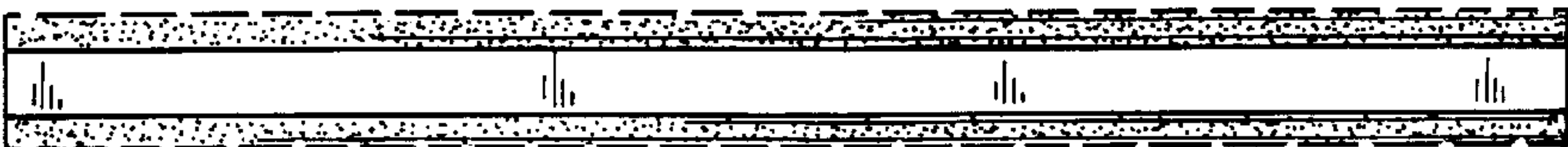

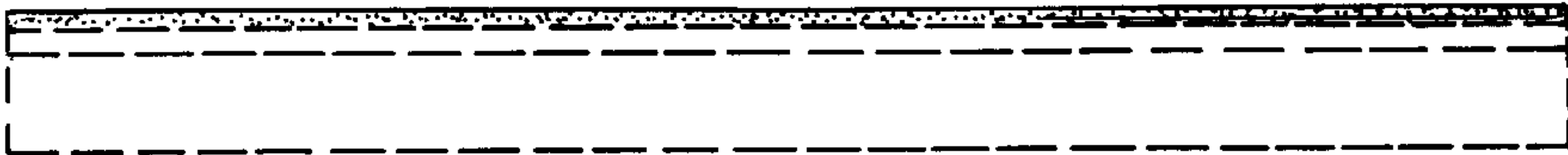
