The ornamental design for a cosmetics container kit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a cosmetics container kit showing my new design;

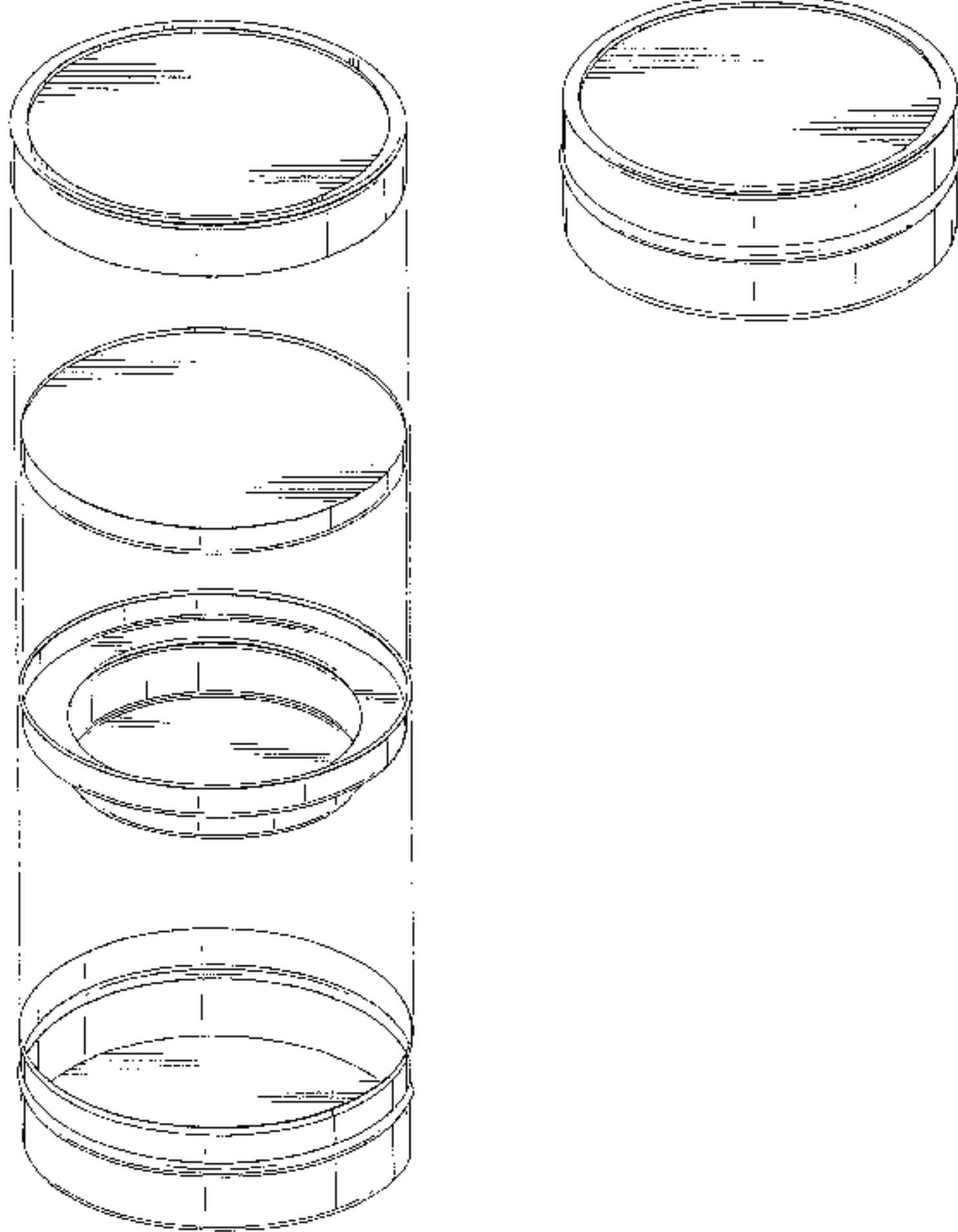

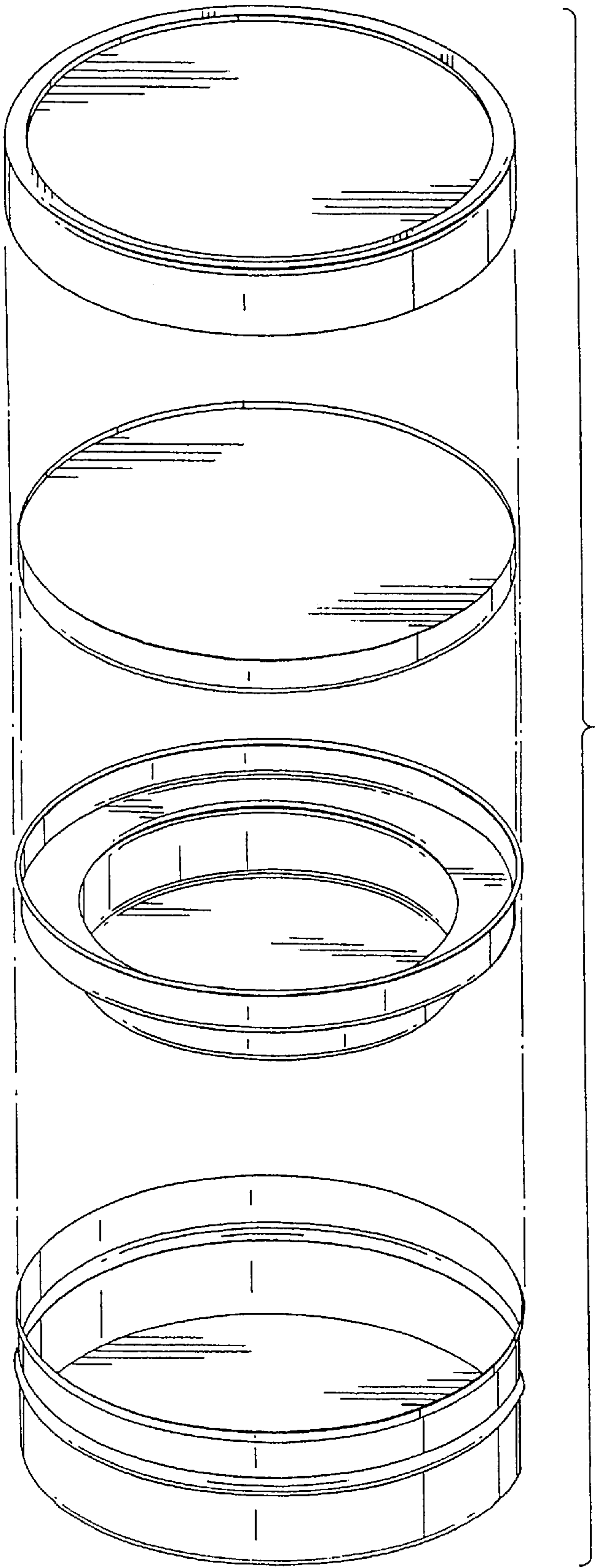

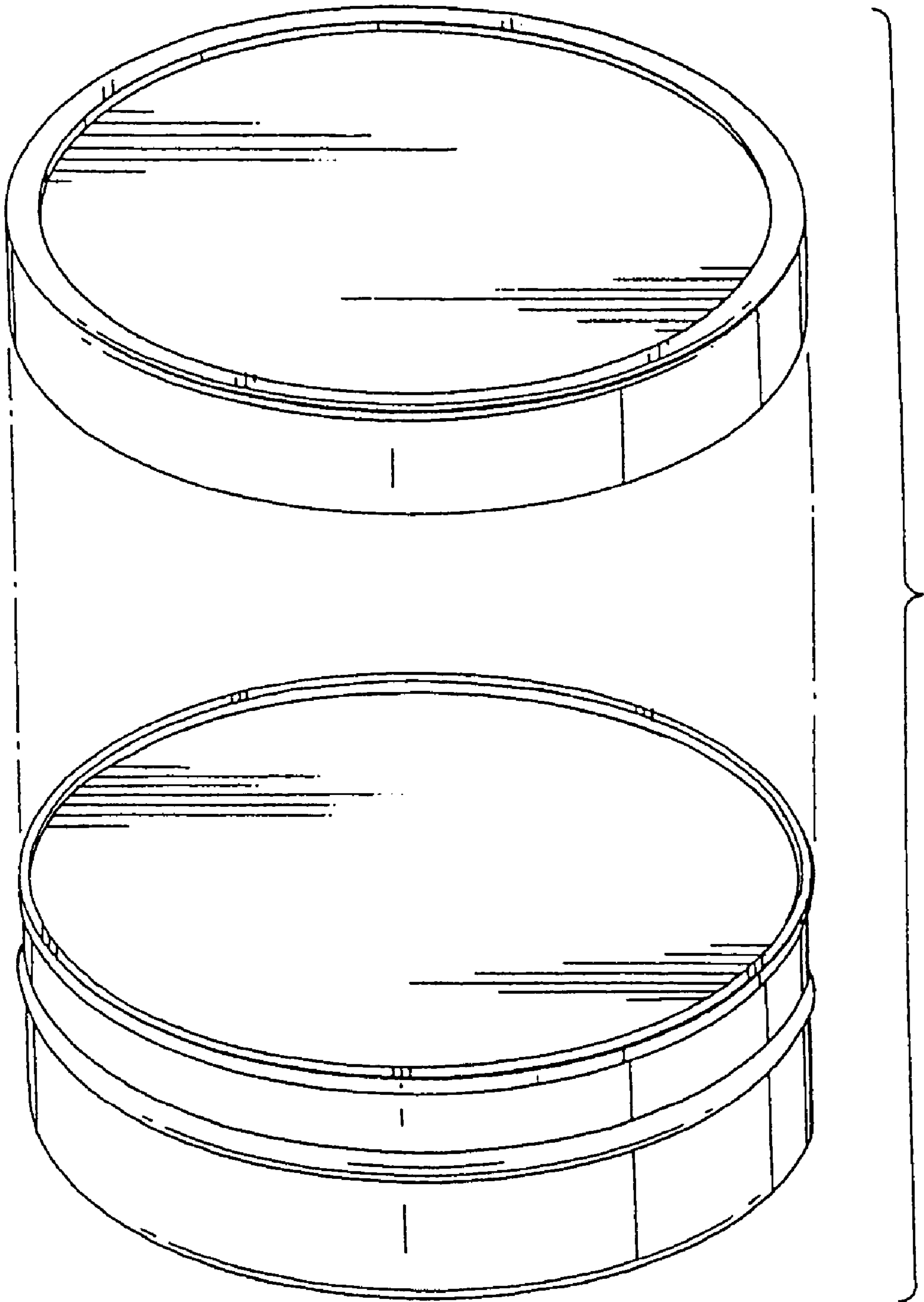

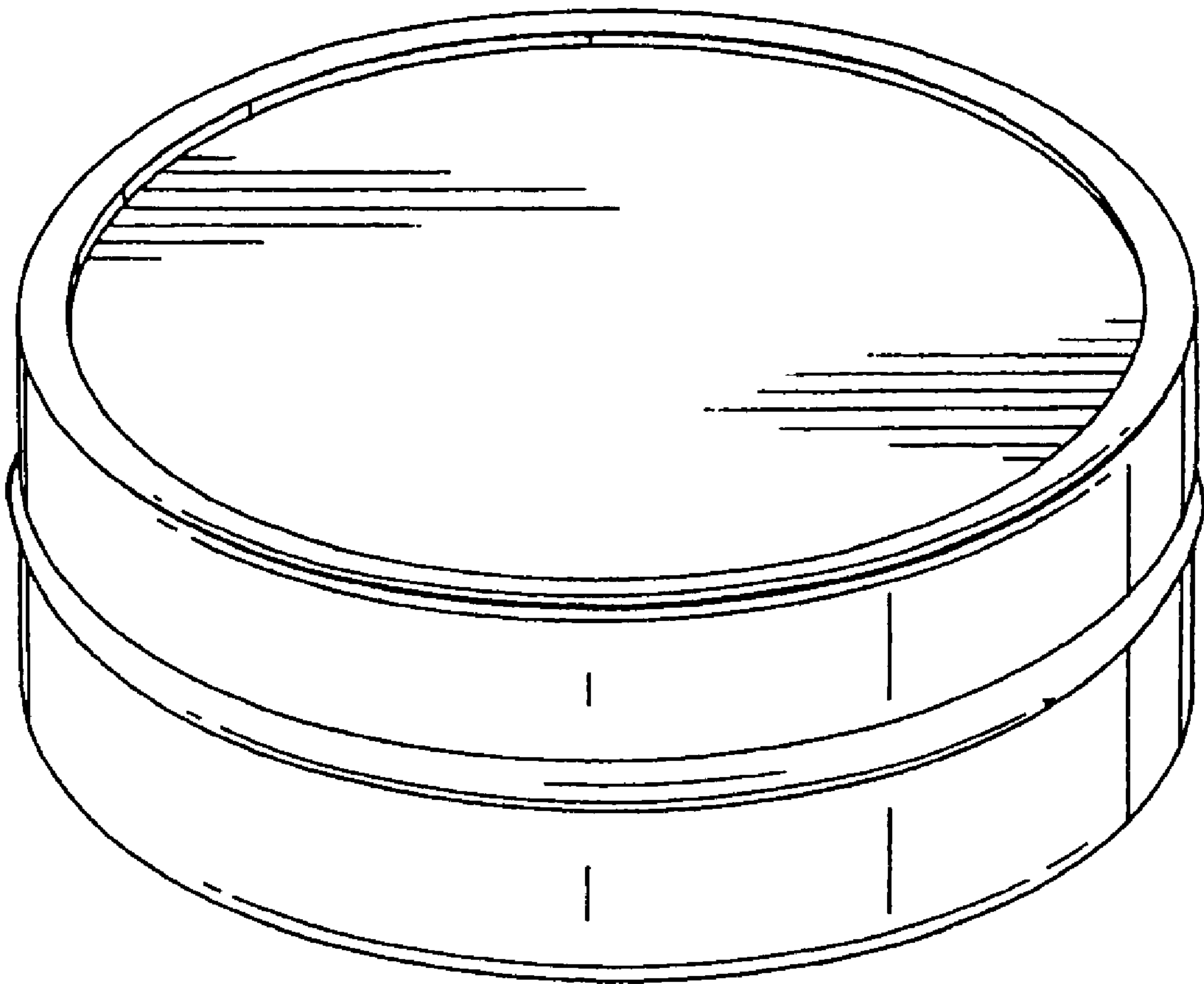

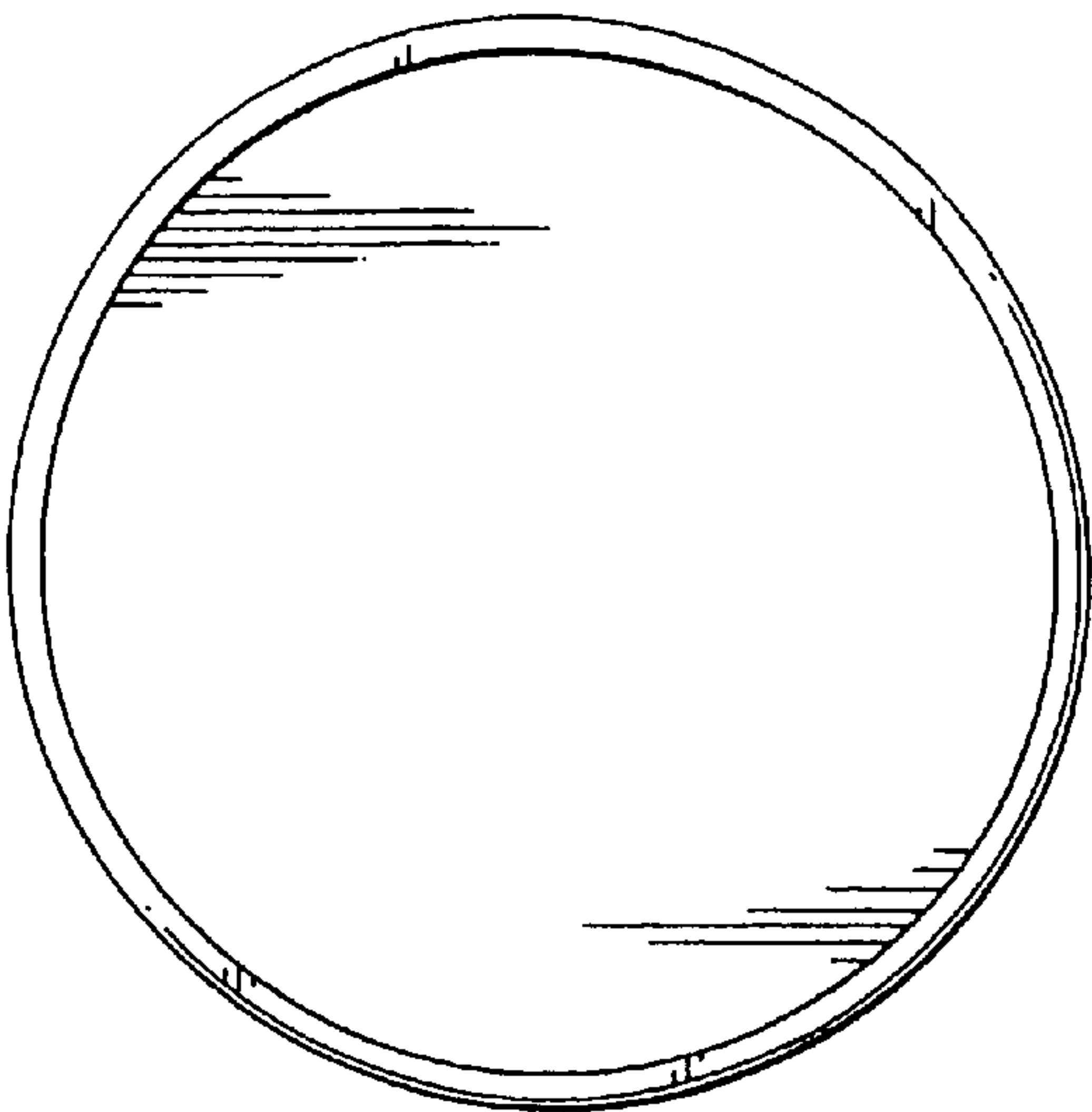

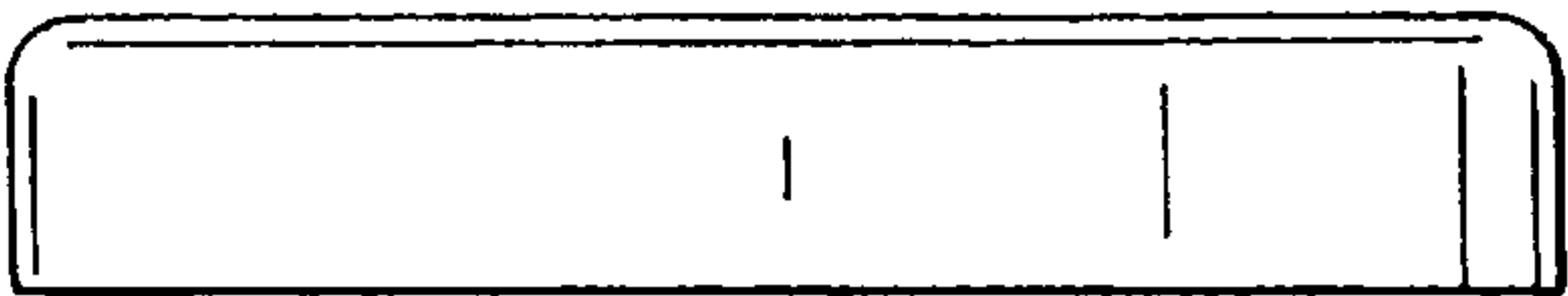

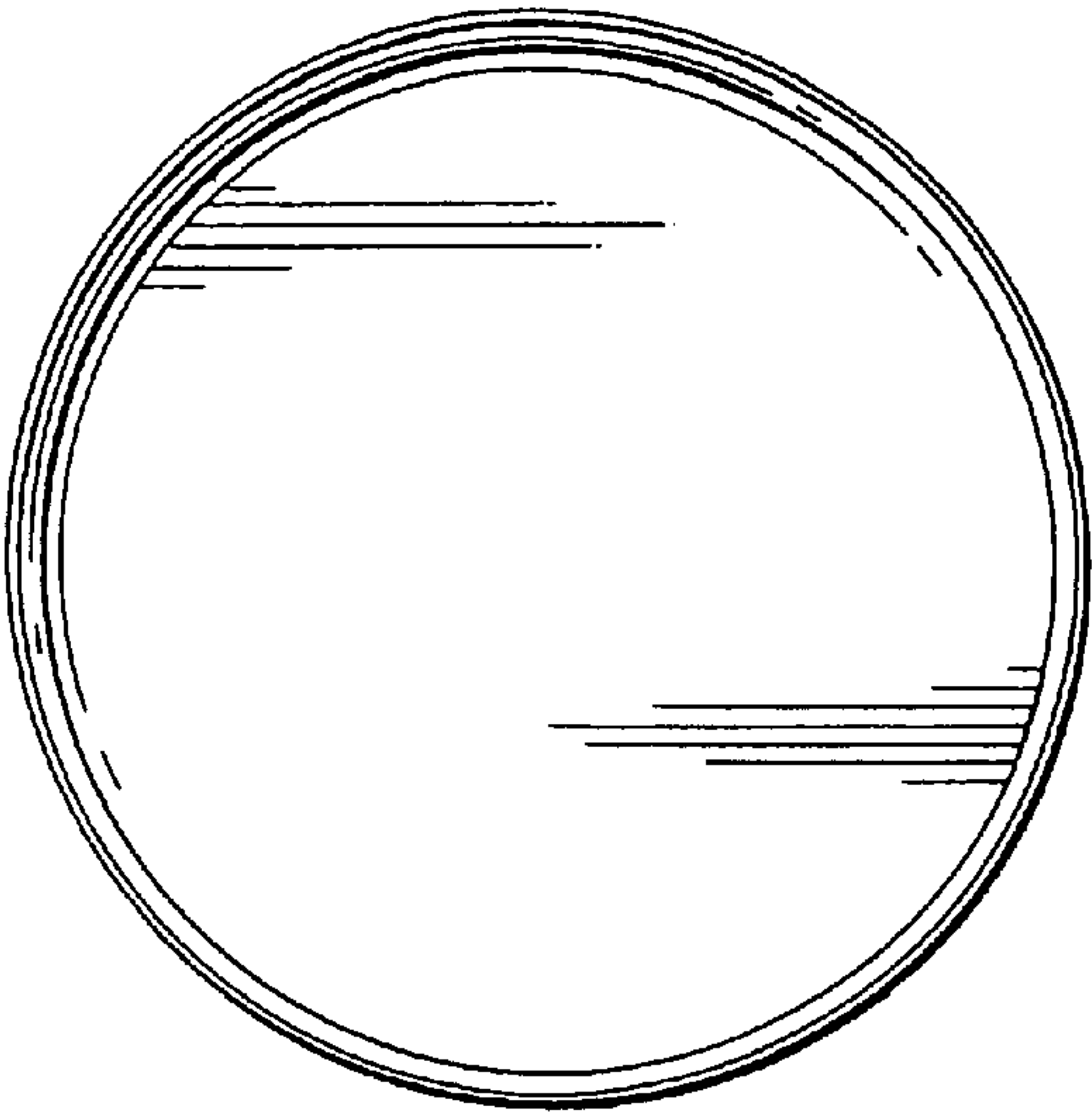

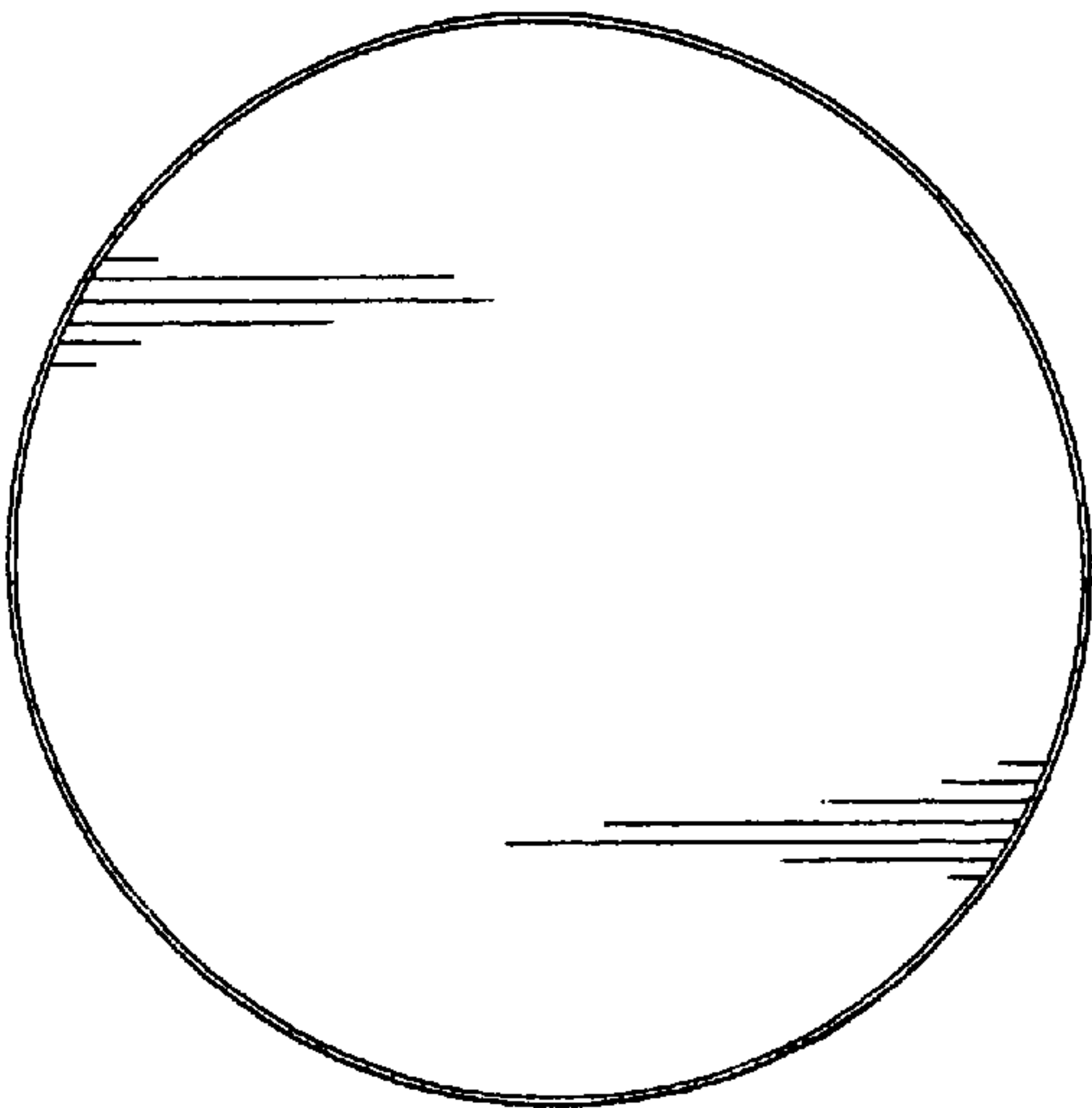

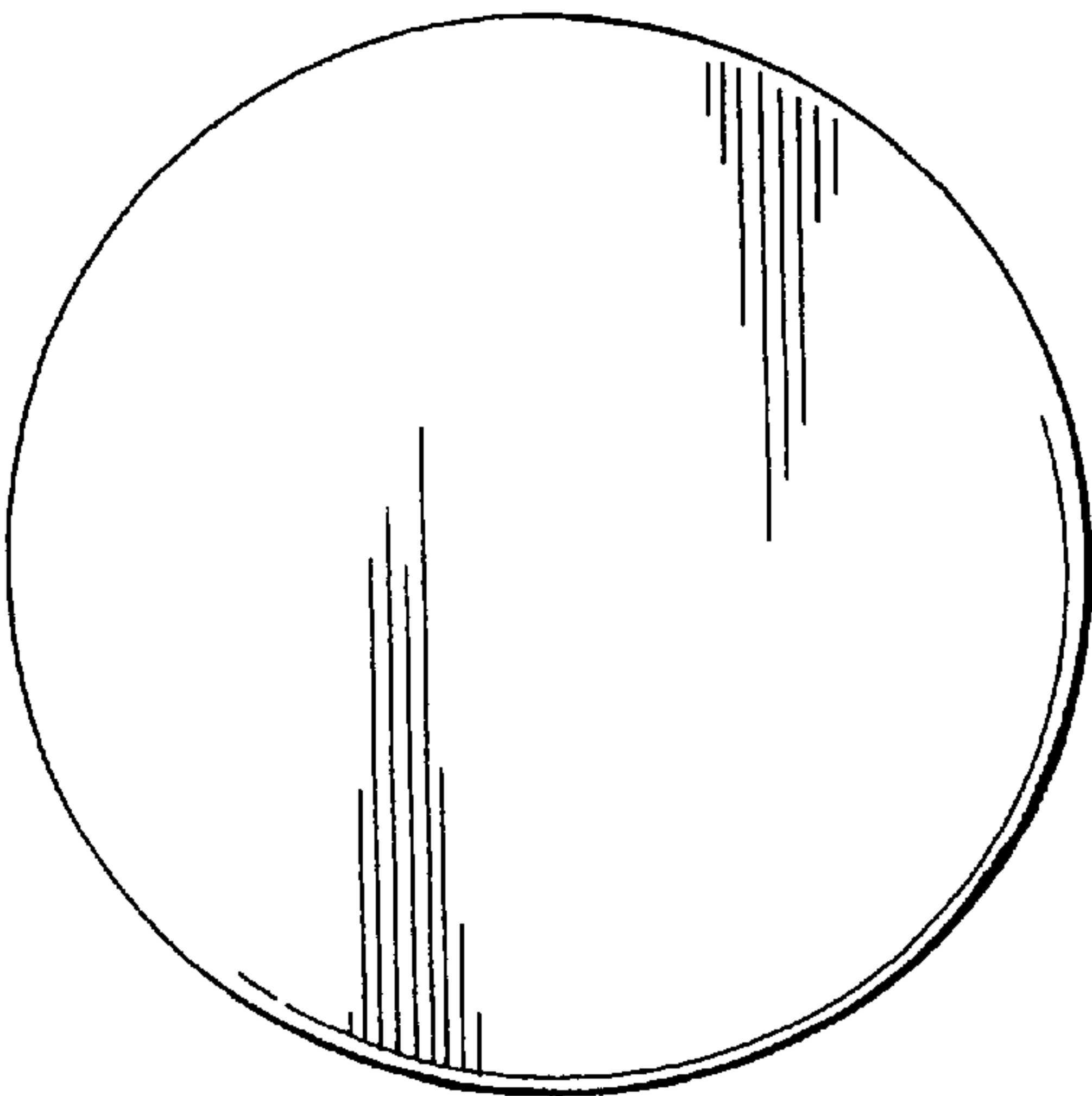

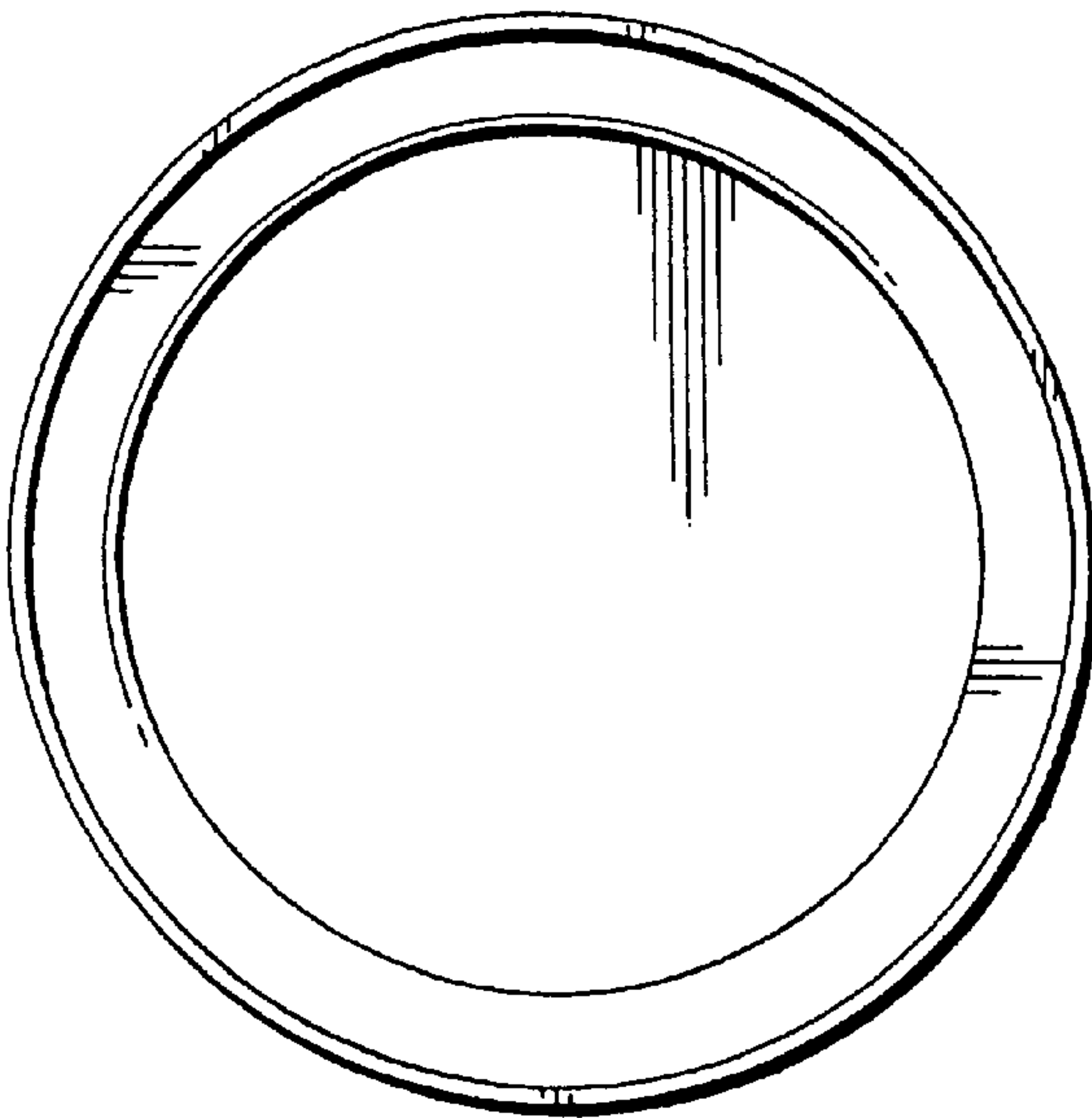

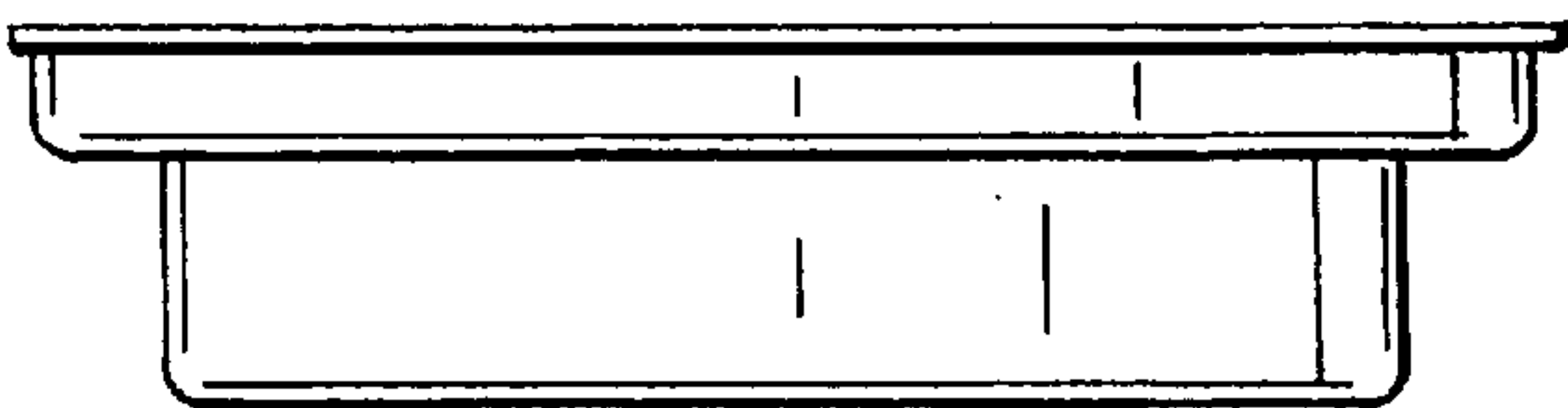

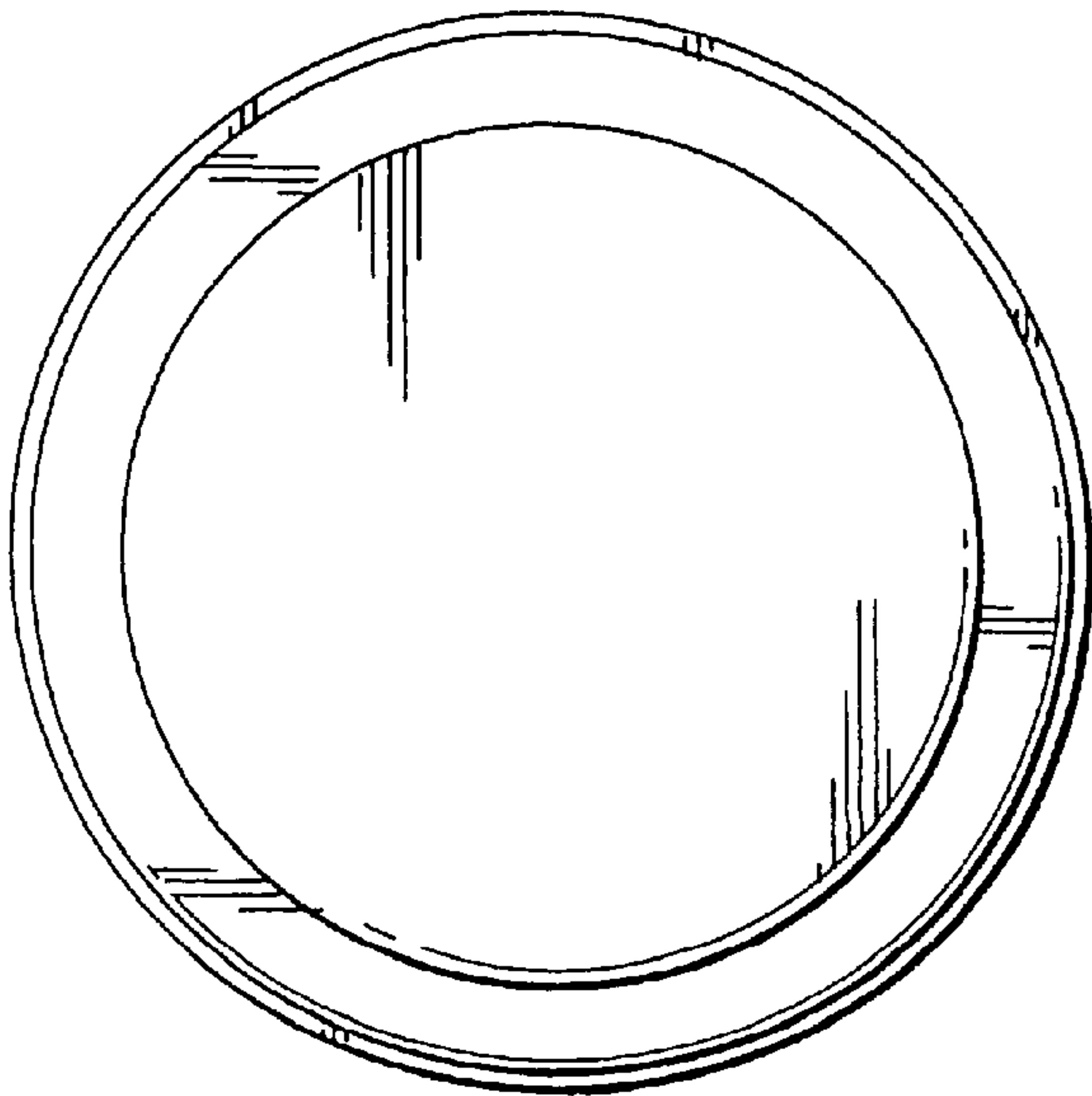

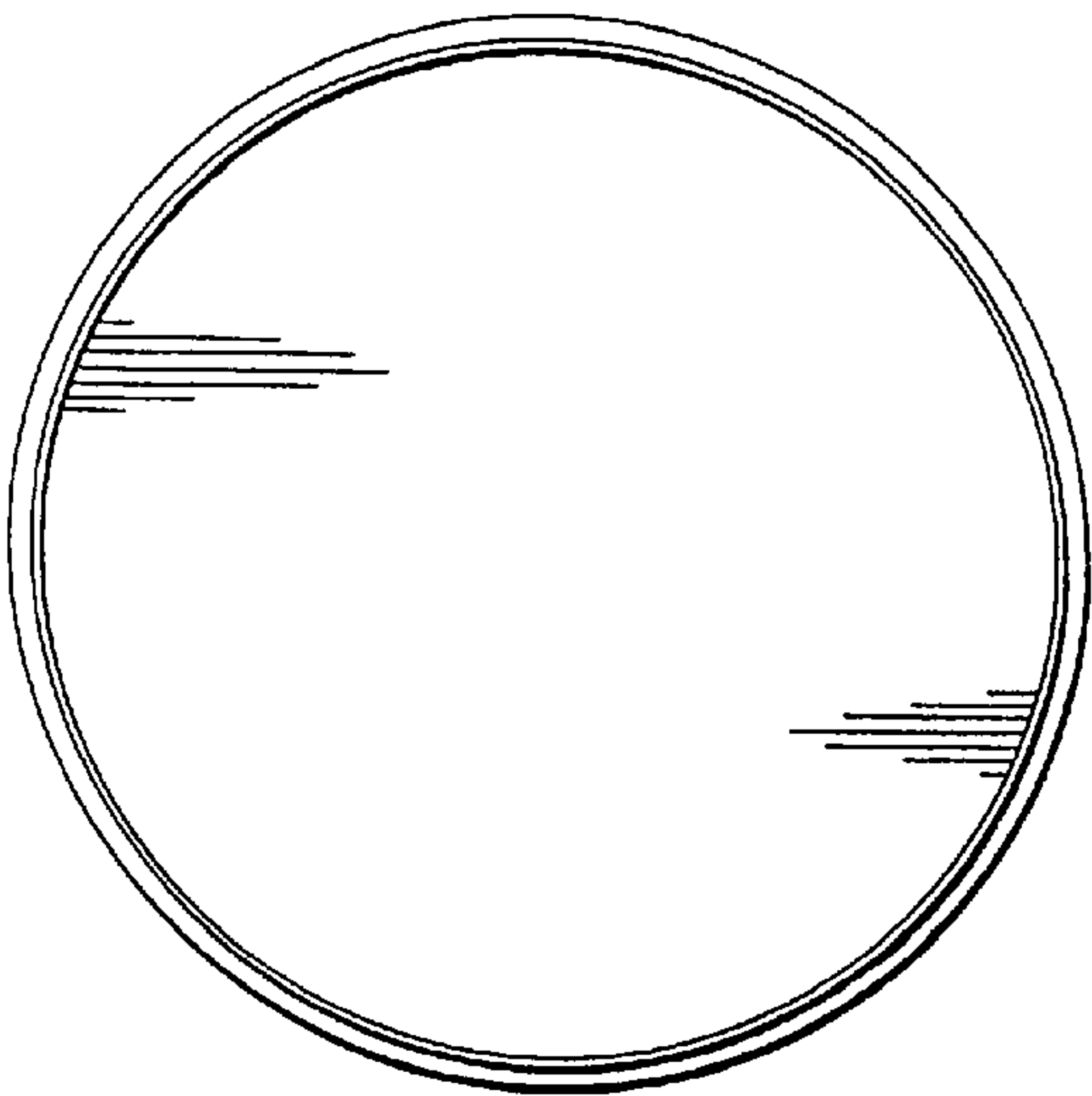

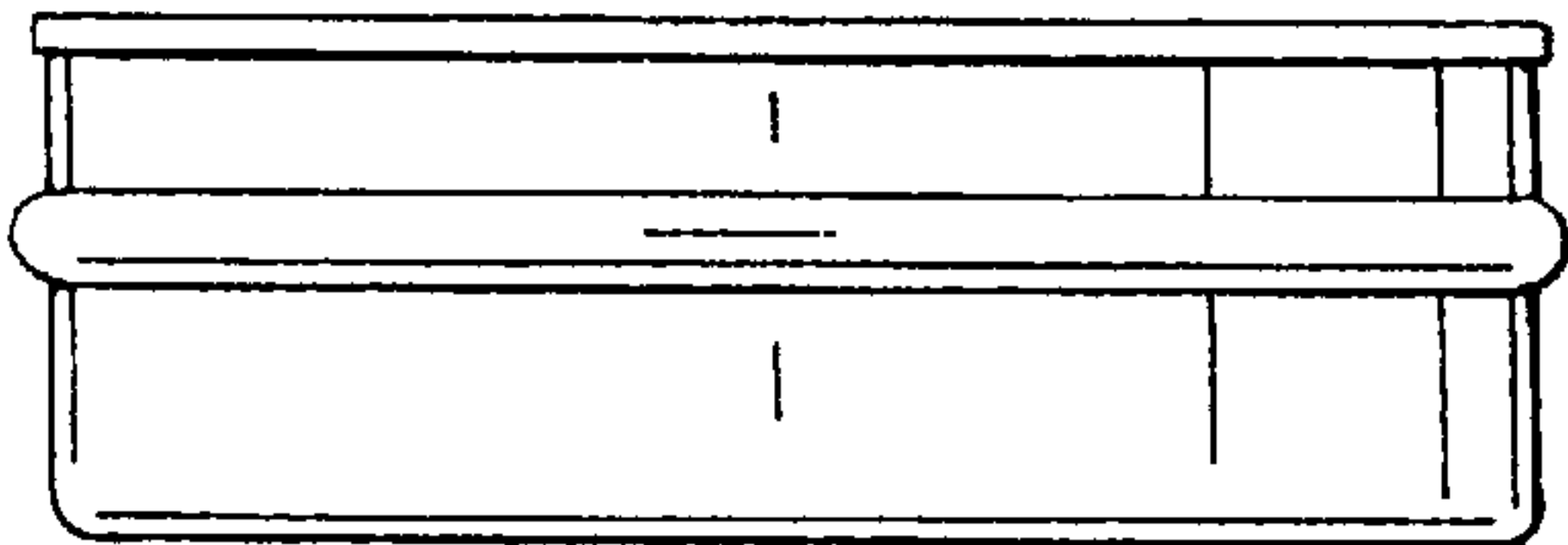
