DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side, top, perspective view of the utensil handle with fish cutouts showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view thereof being a mirror image of the left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a left side view thereof, the right side view thereof being a mirror image of the left side view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof; and,


FIG. 10 is a front view thereof.








