DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side isometric view of a beverage container showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the design.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the design.

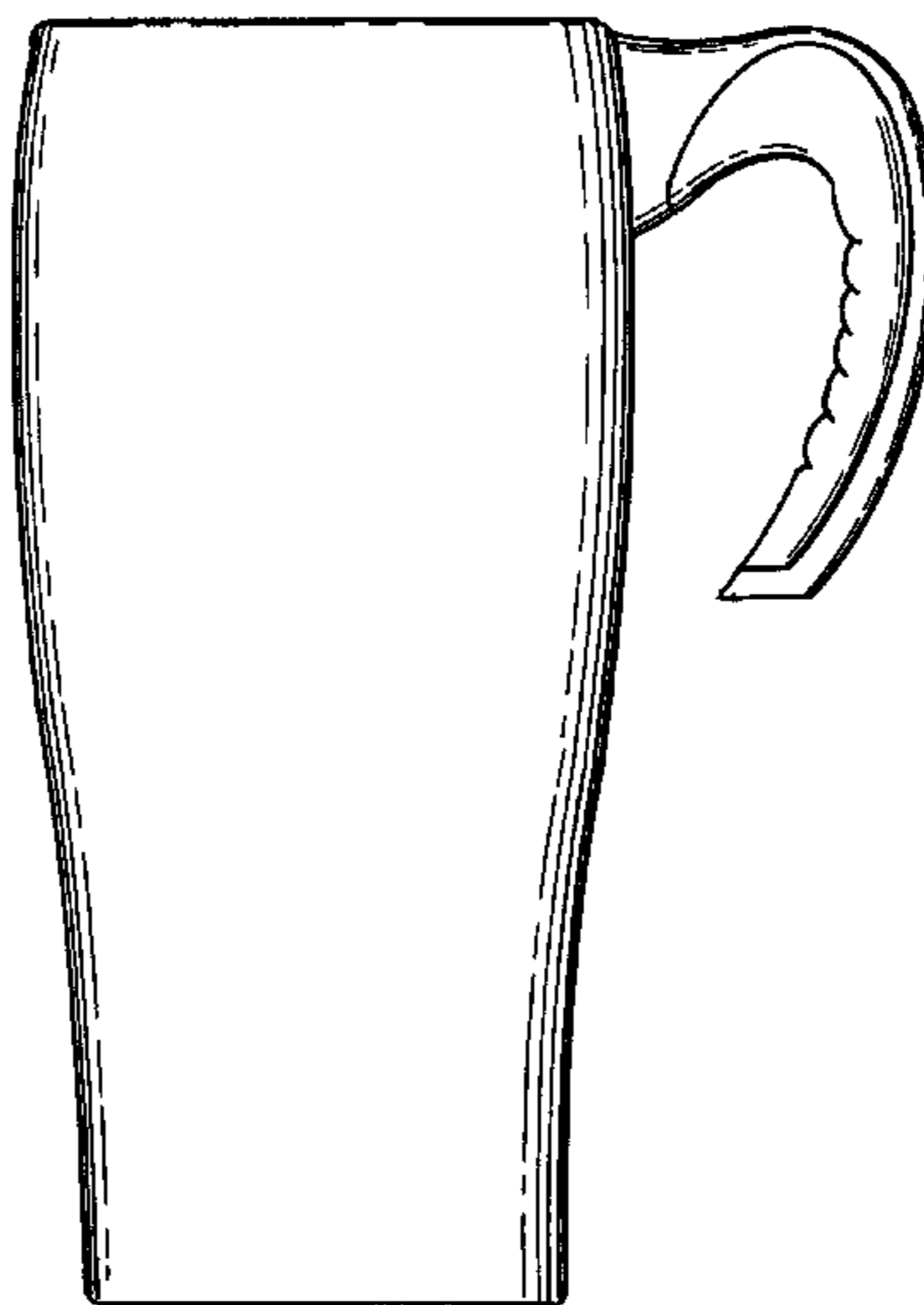
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the design.

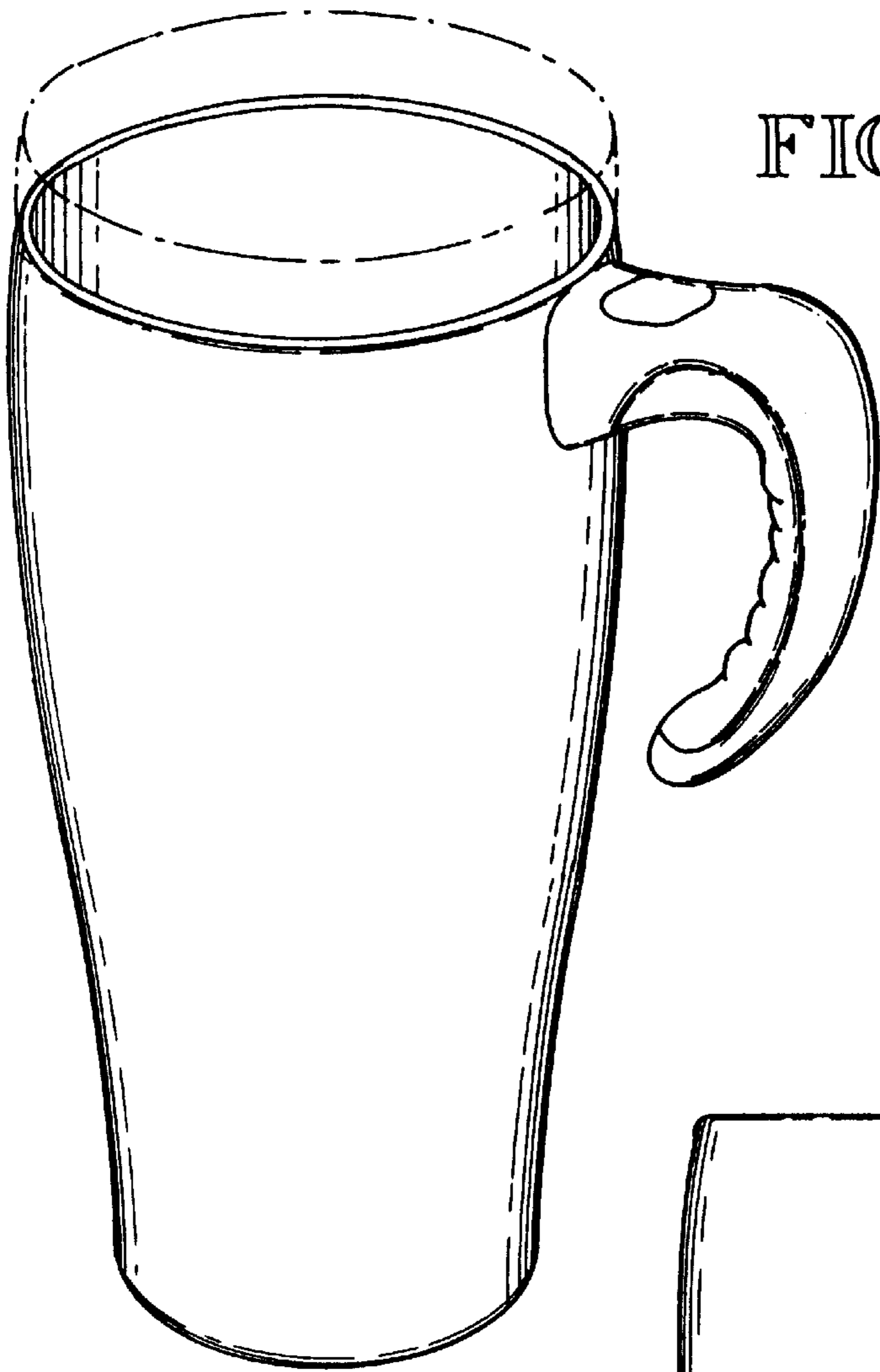

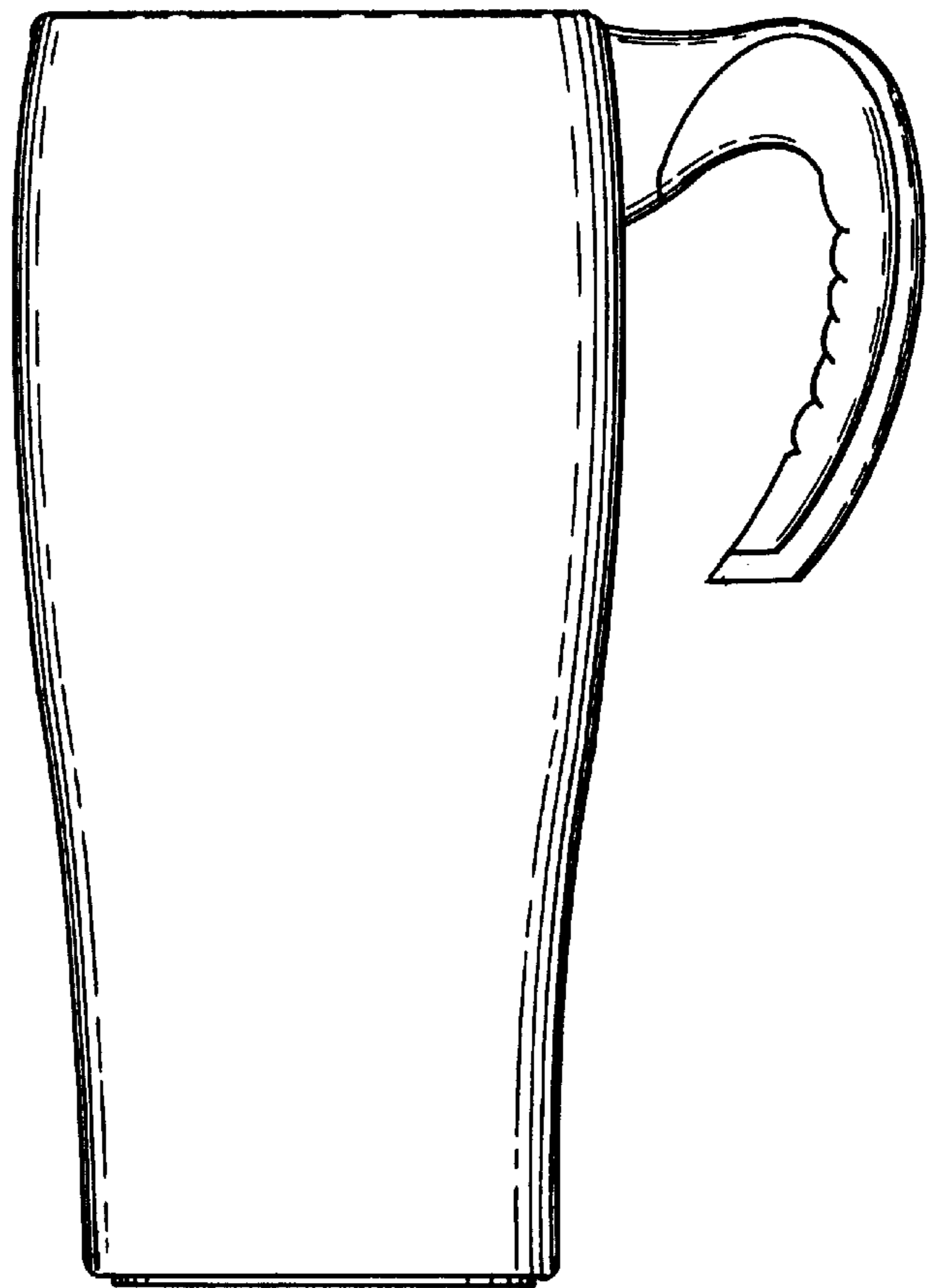

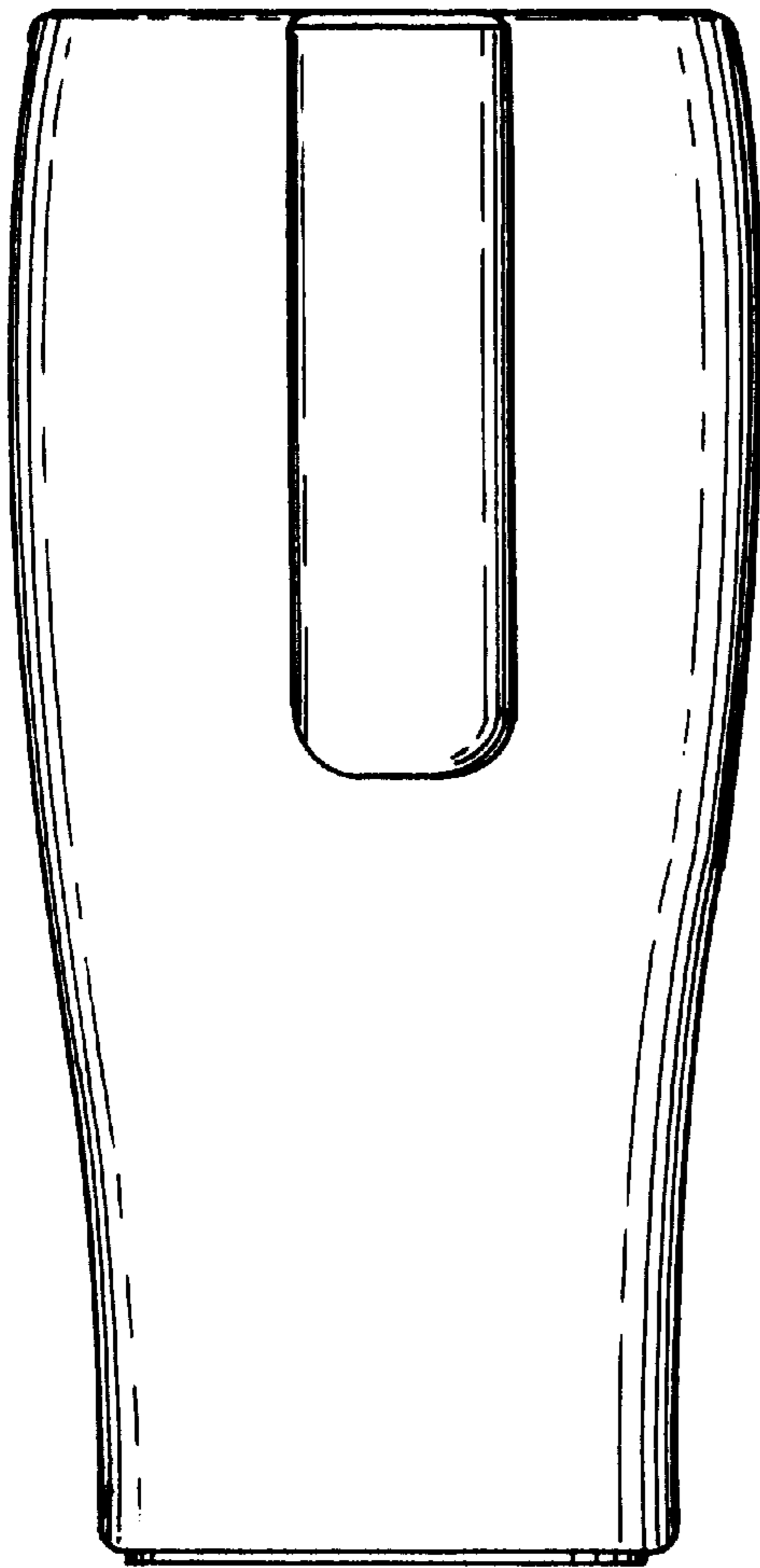

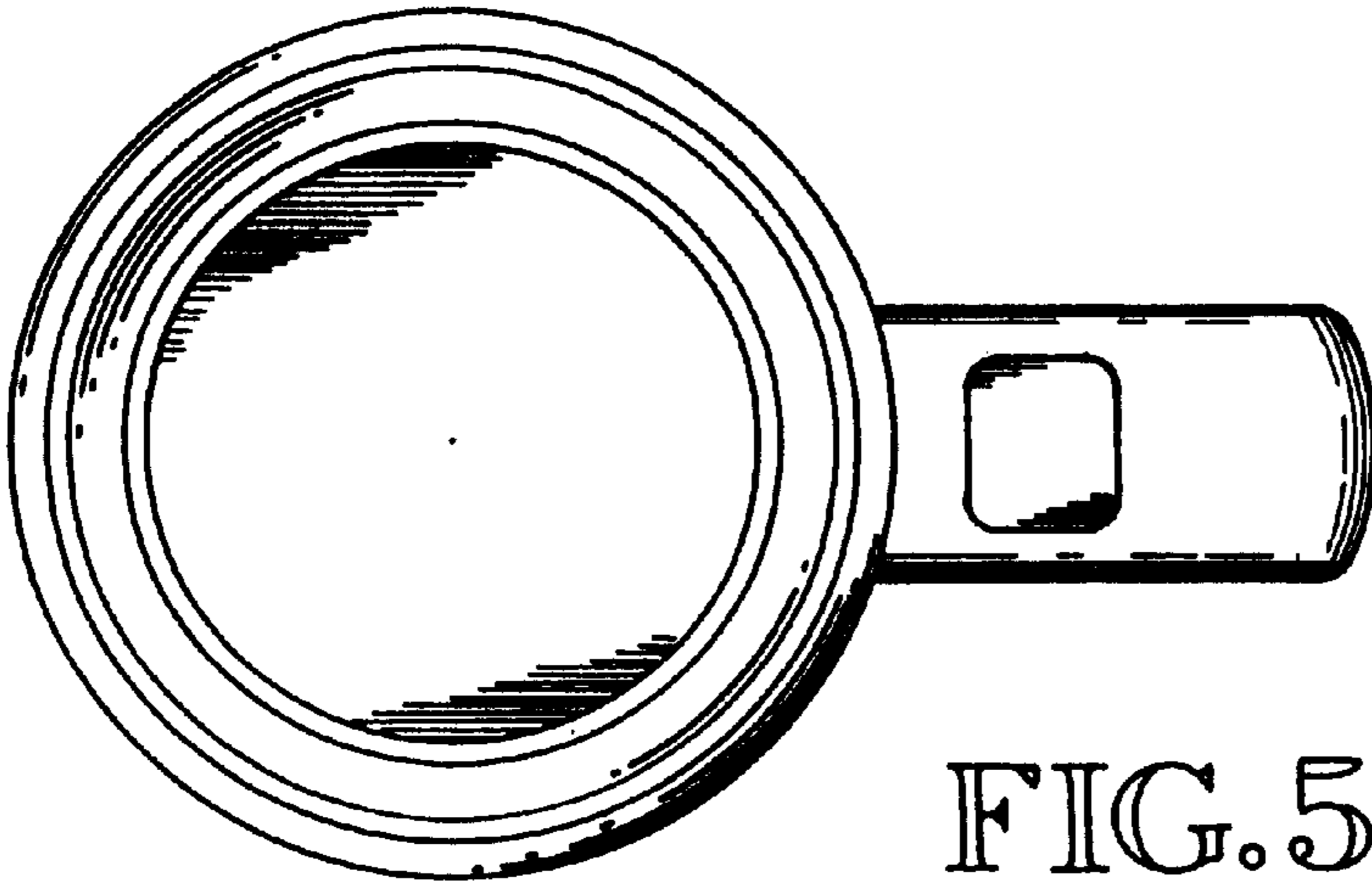

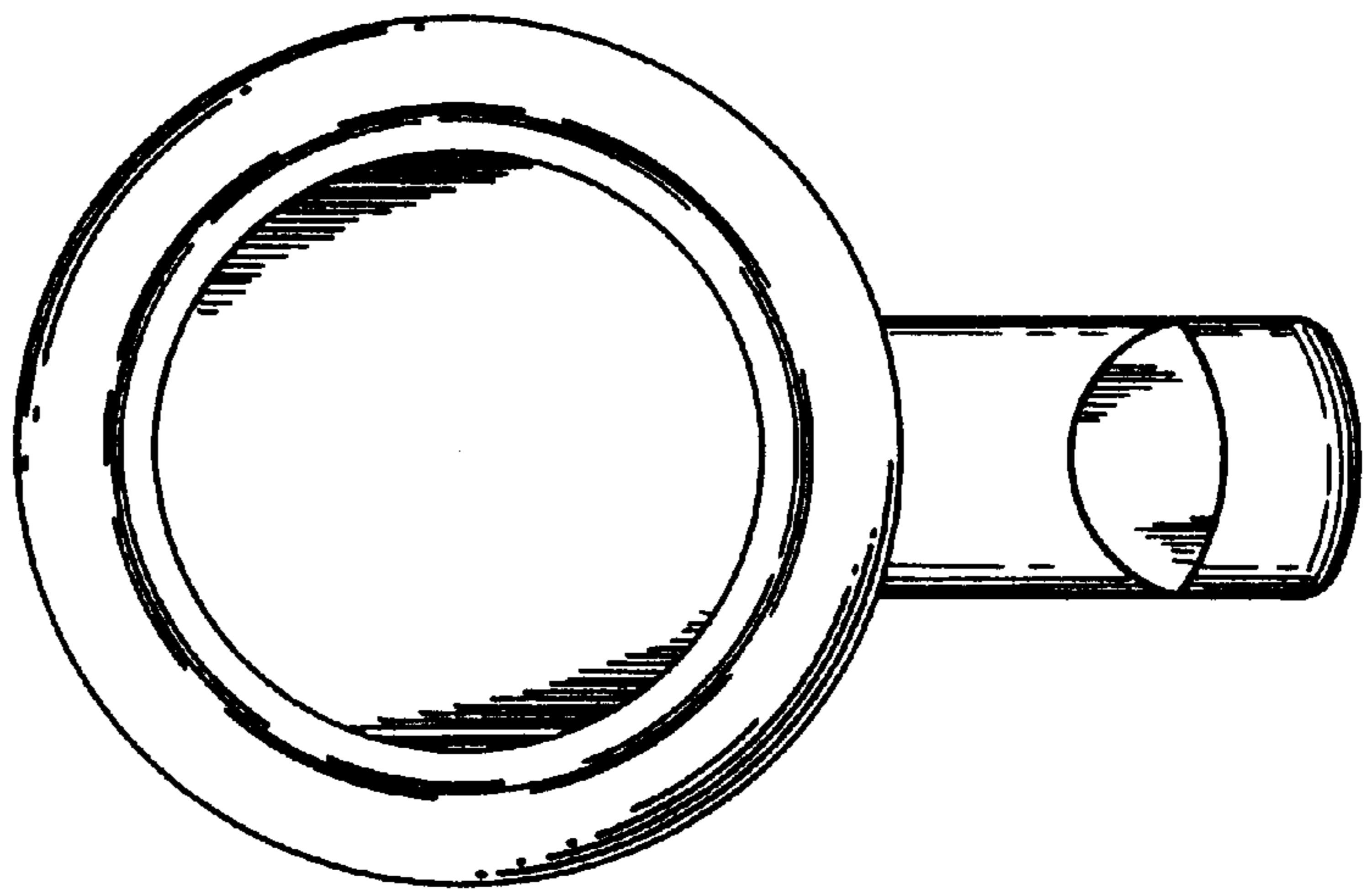
