FIG. 10 is left end elevation of FIG. 6; and,

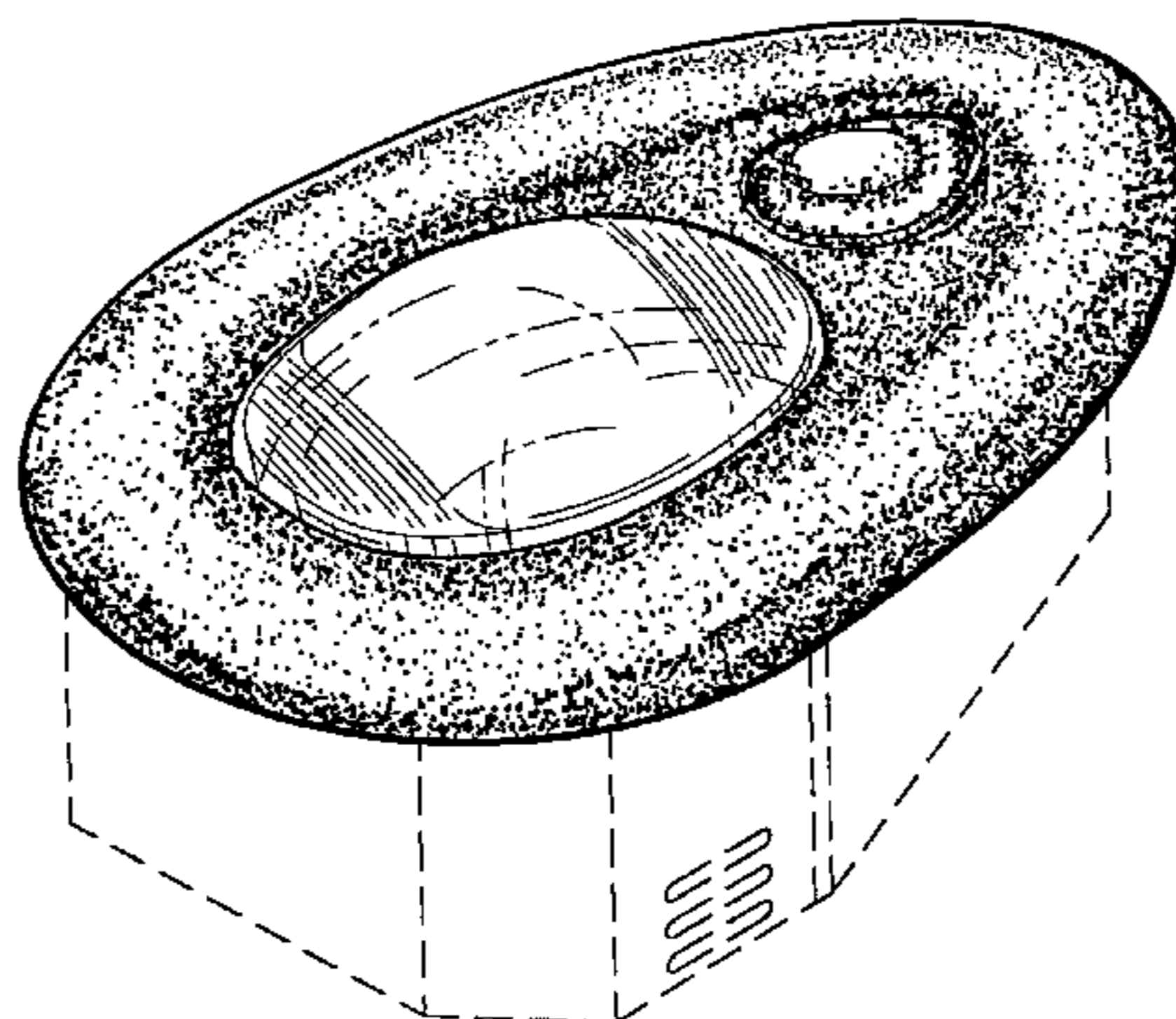
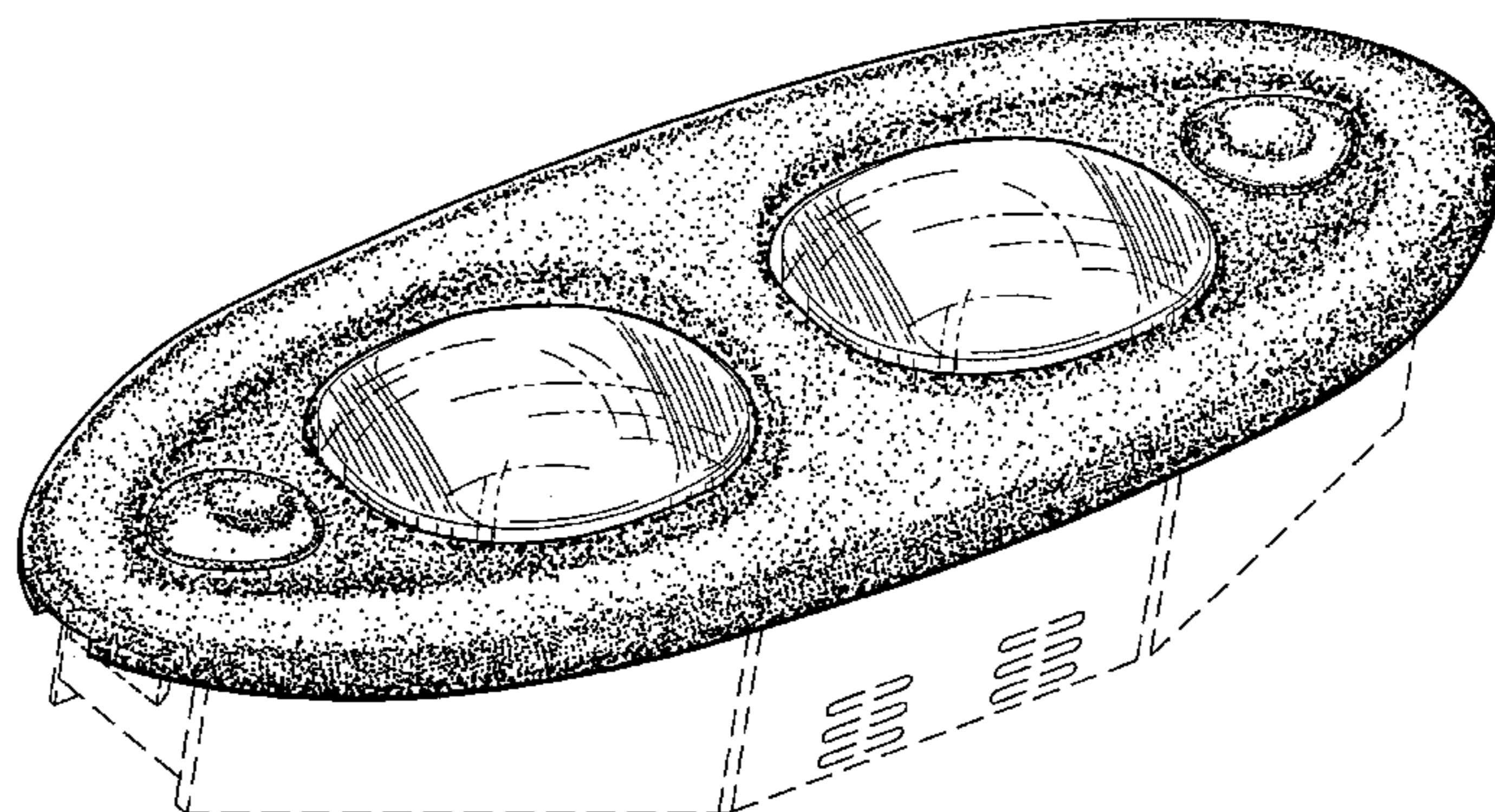
FIG. 11 is bottom plan view of FIG. 6.

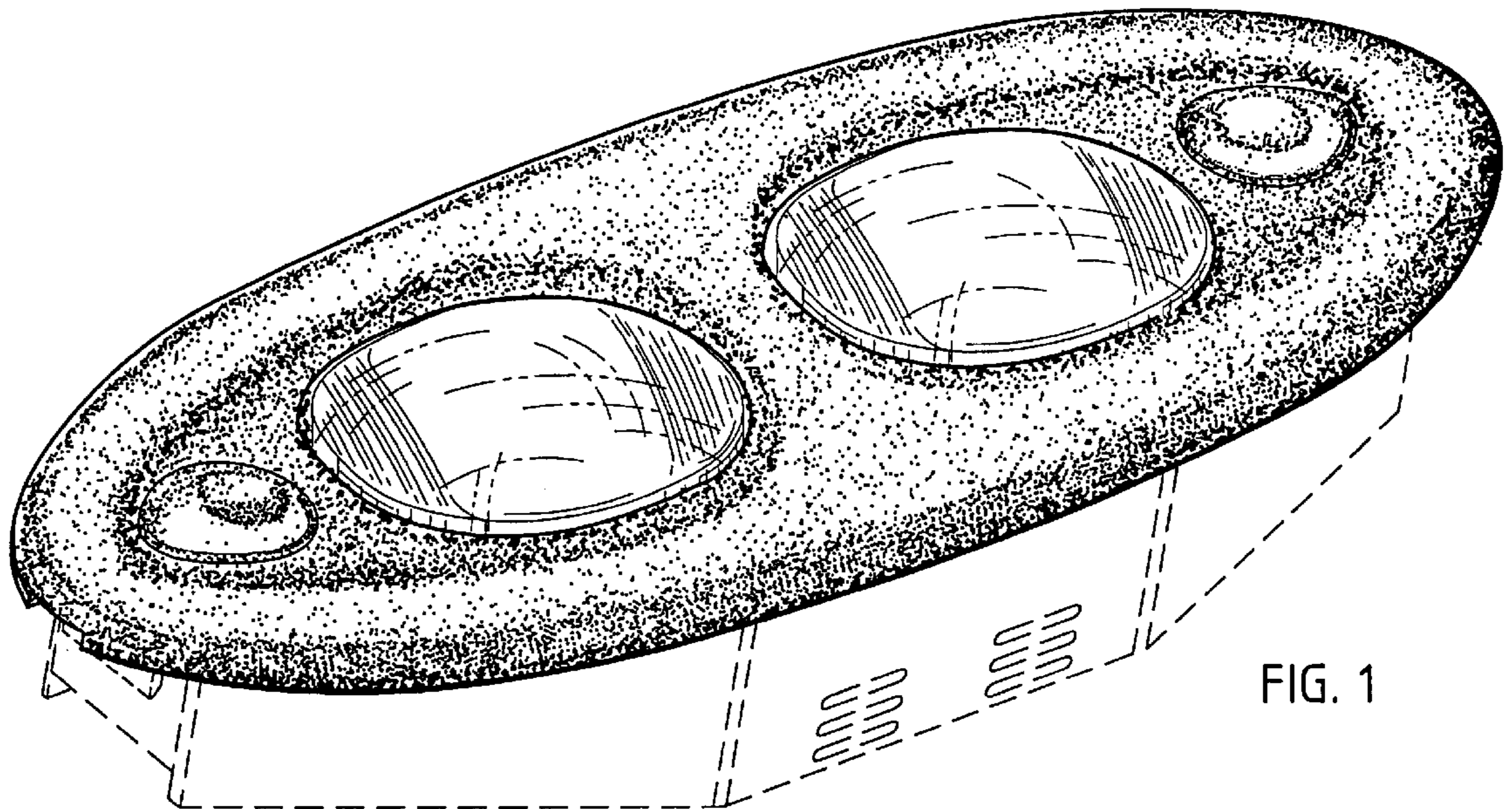

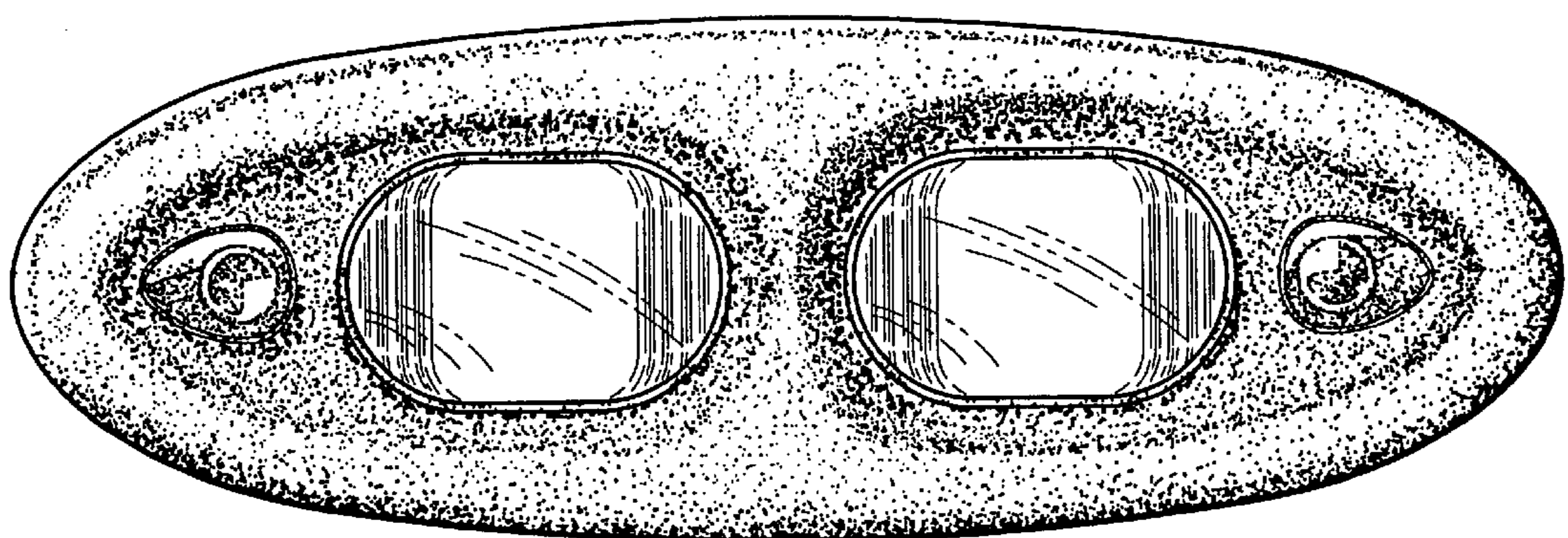

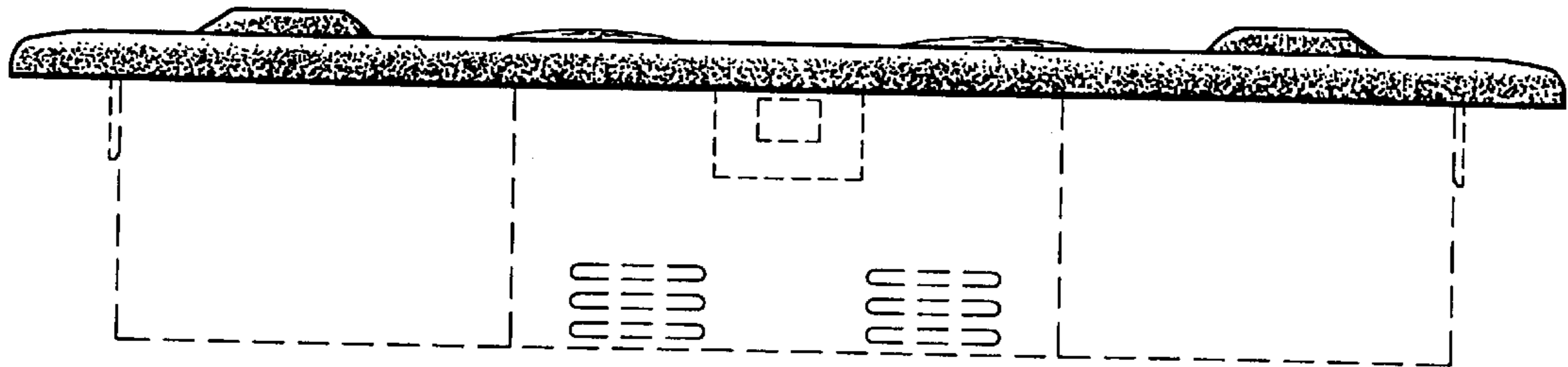

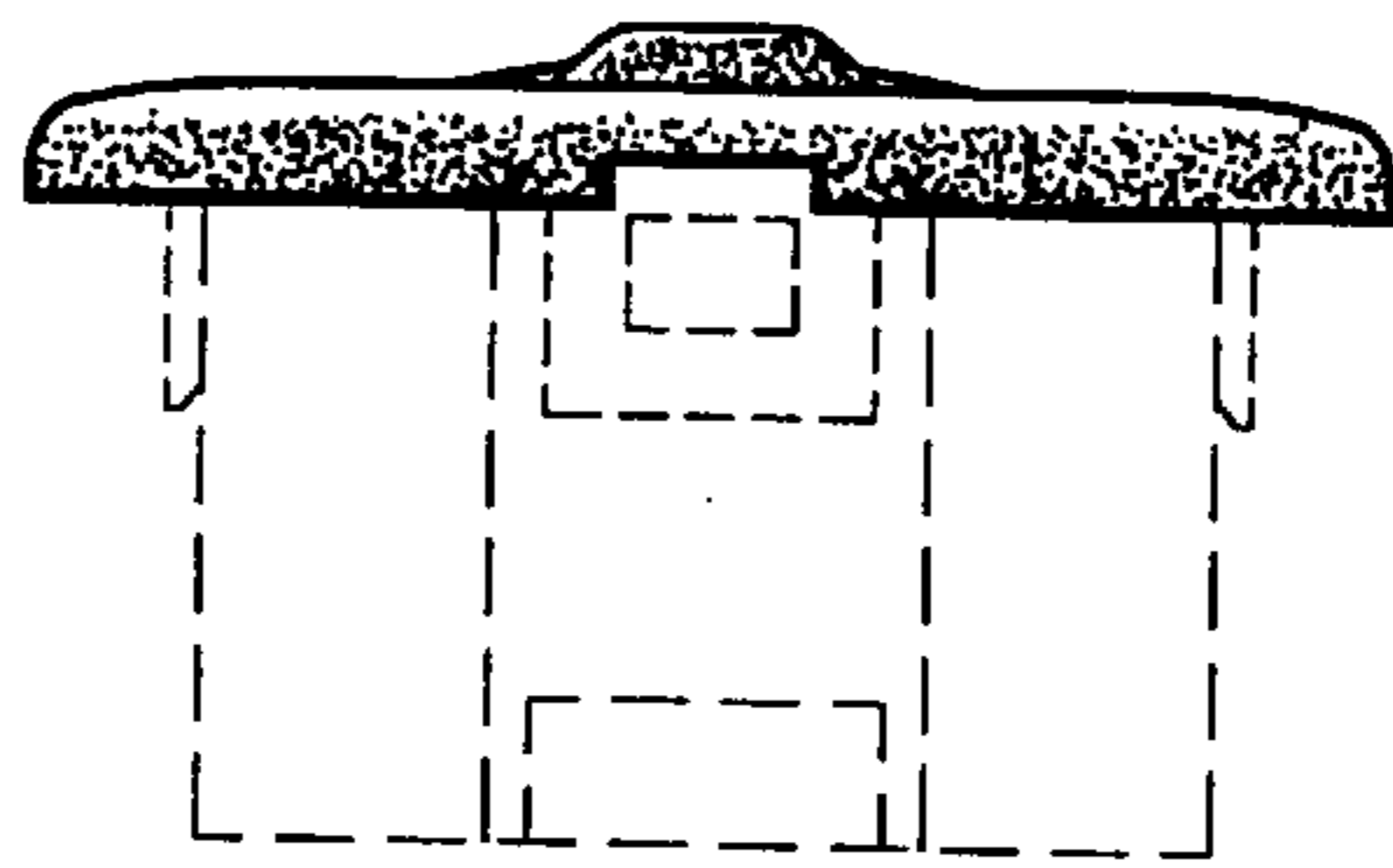

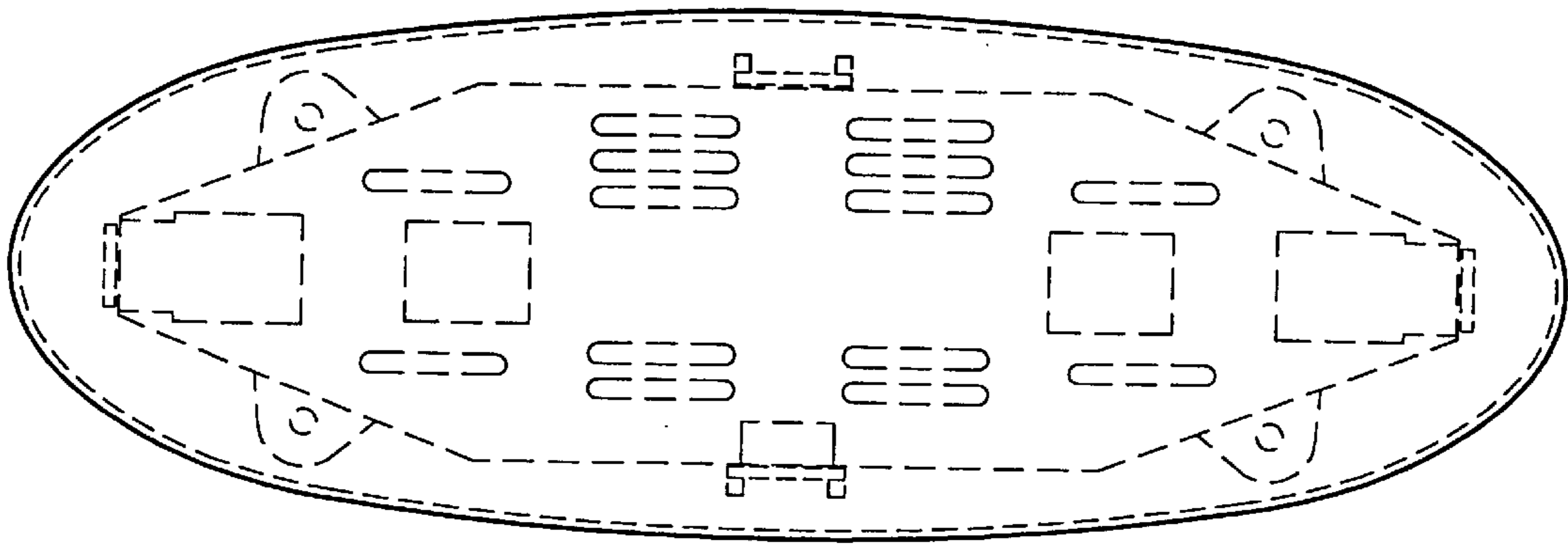

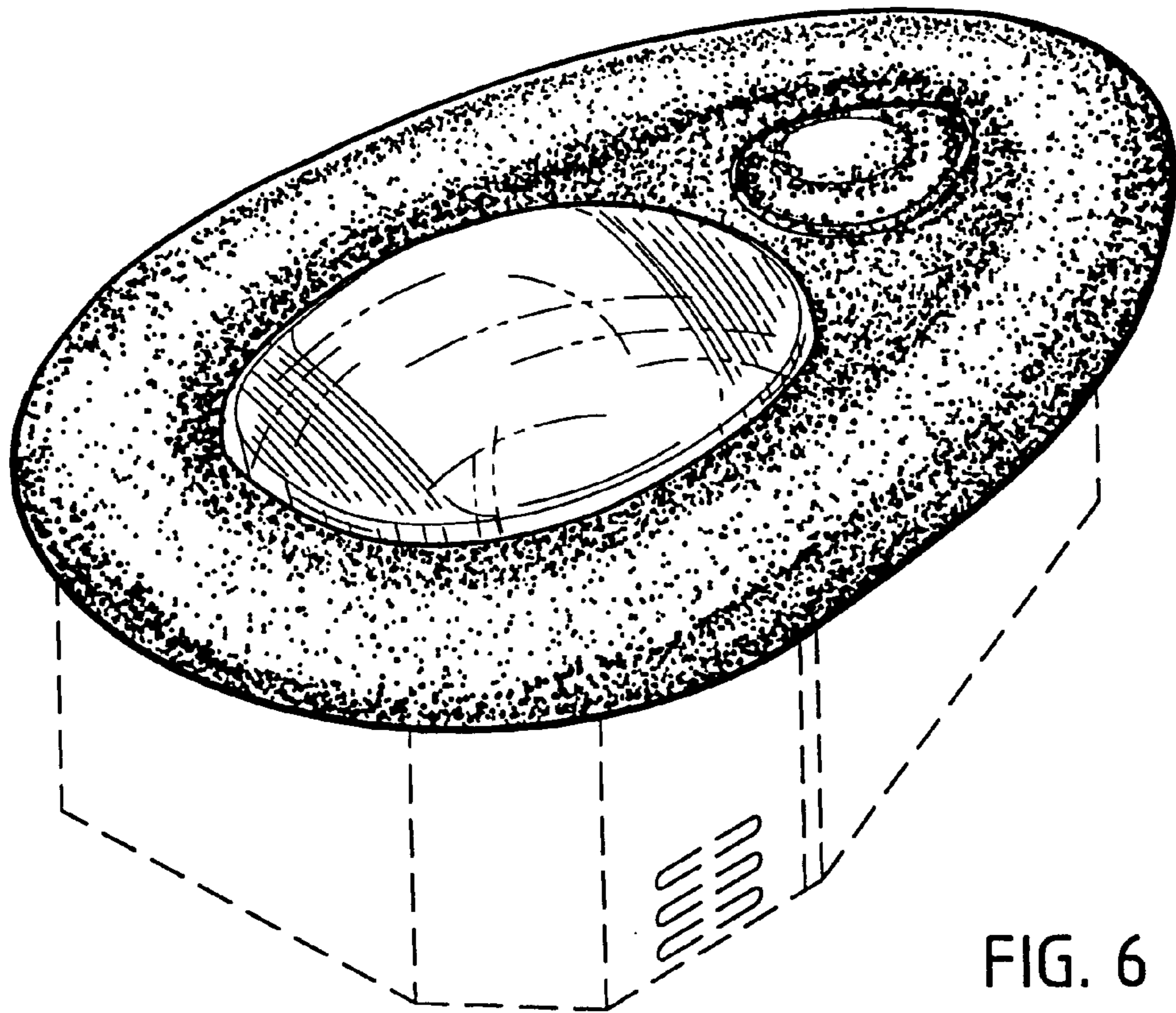

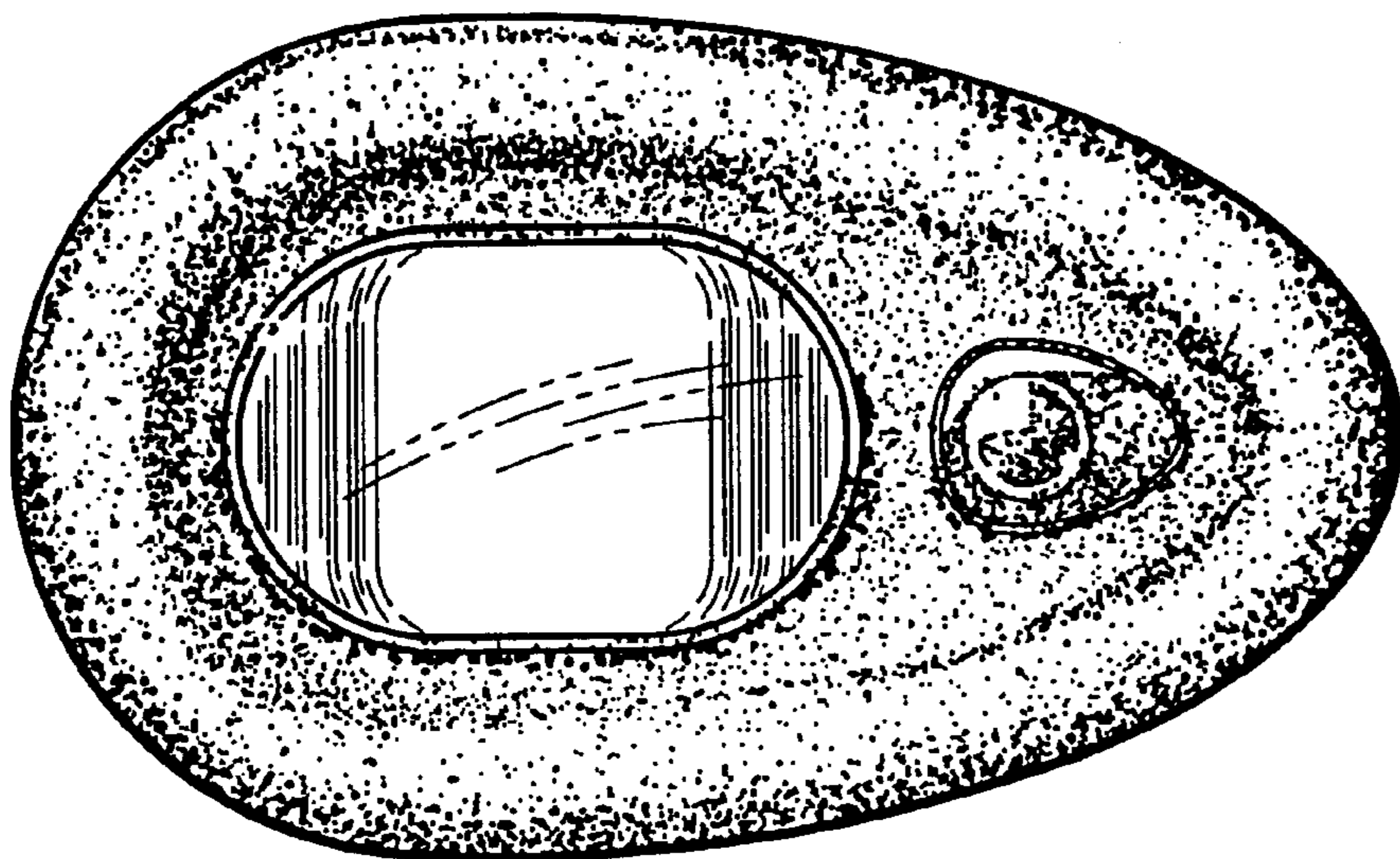

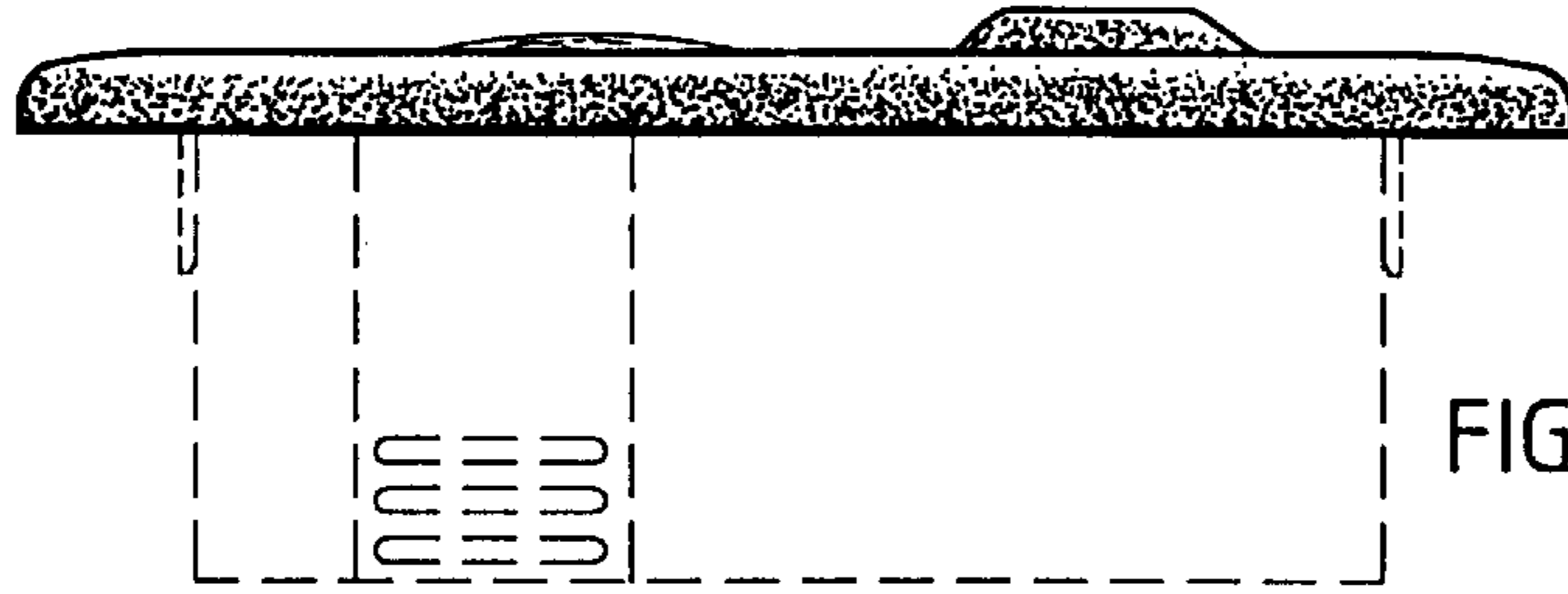

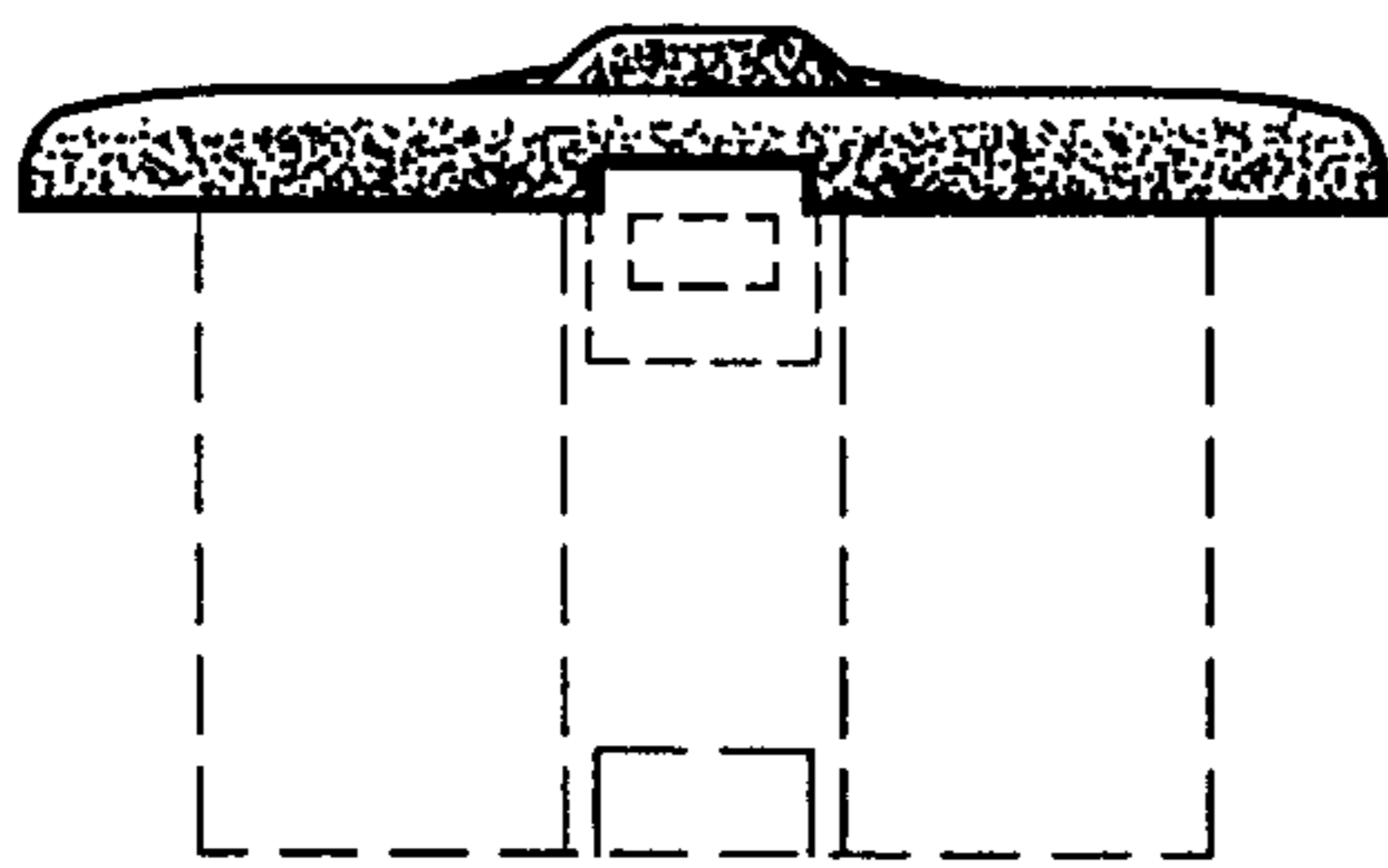

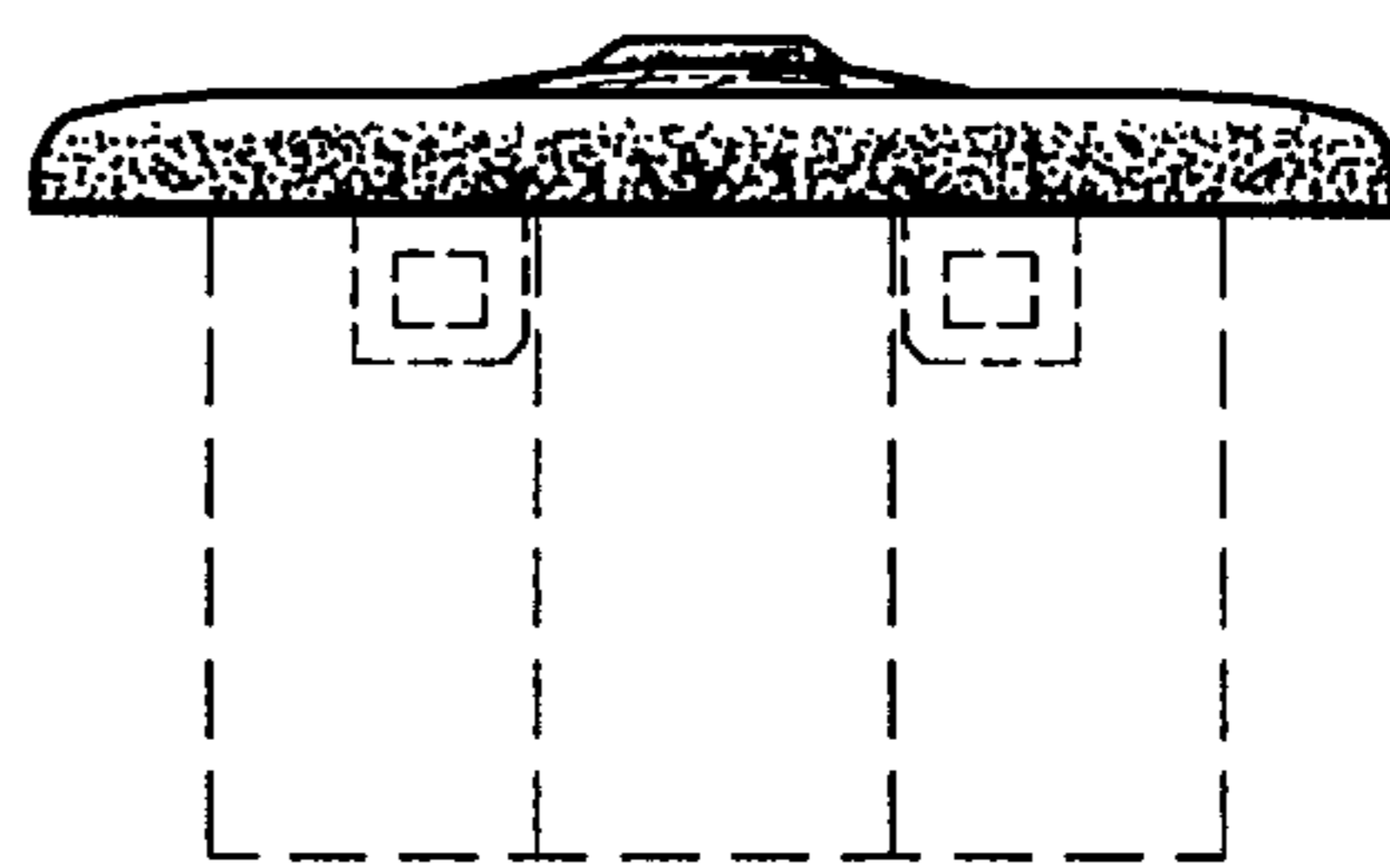

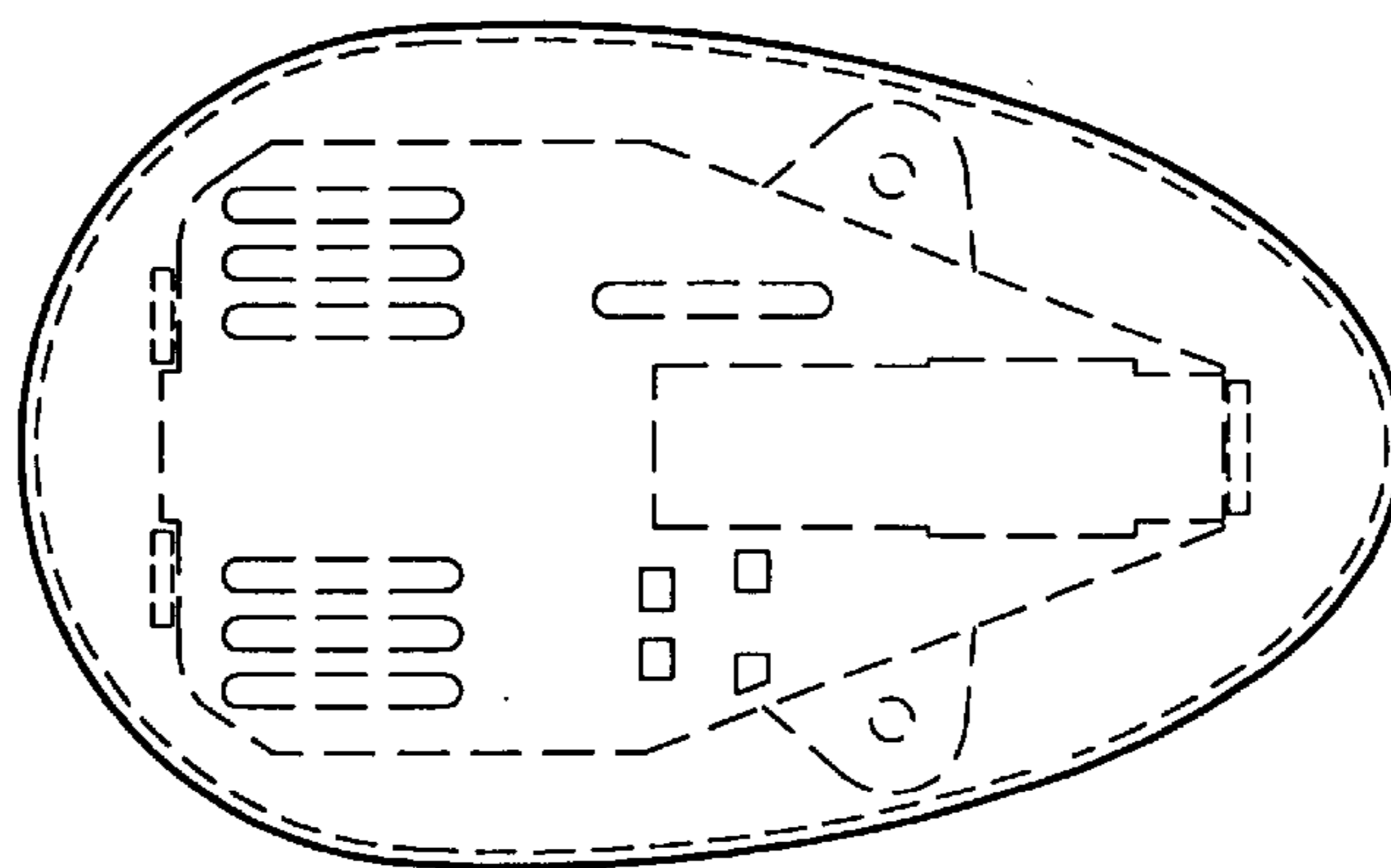
