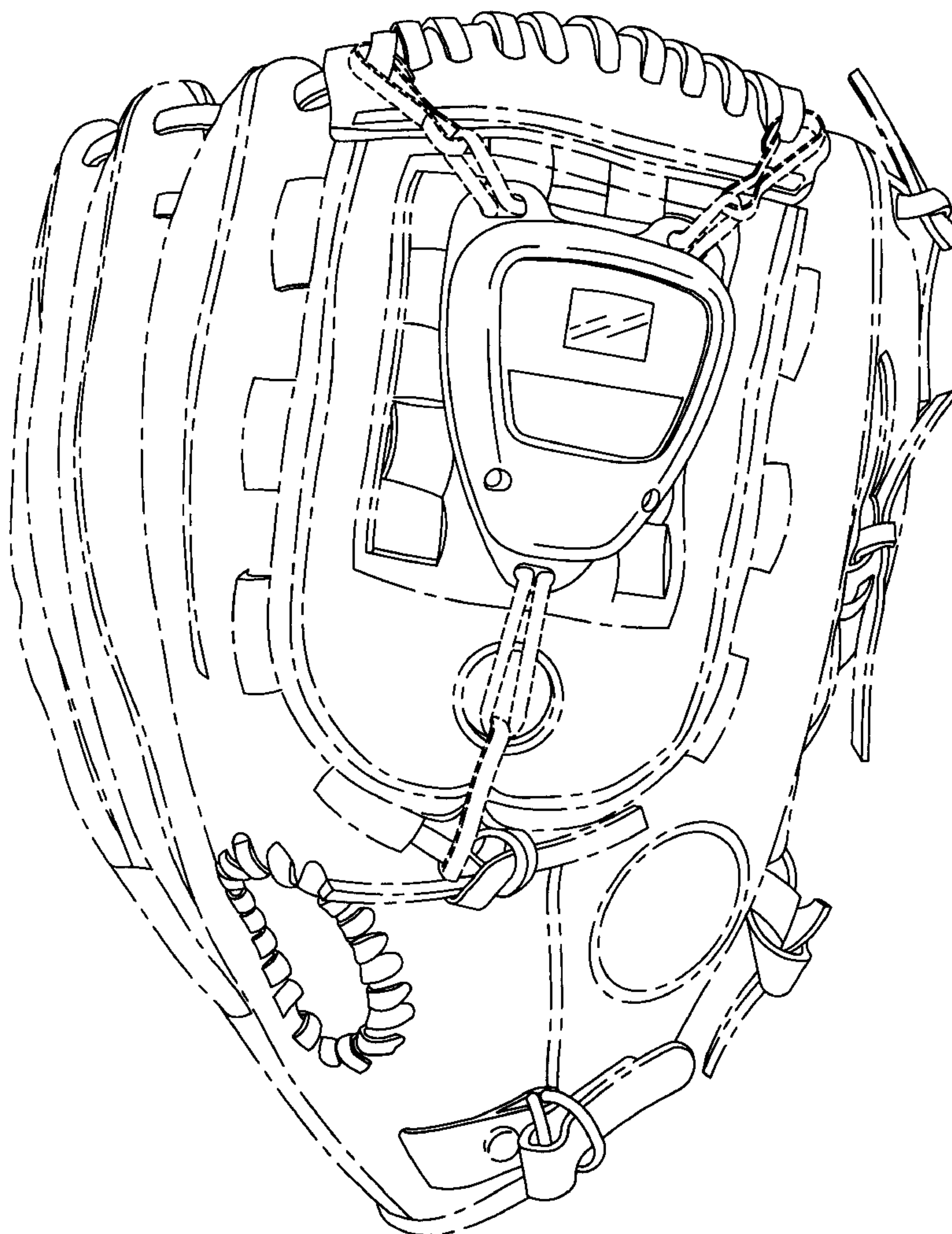
FIG. 6 is a left side view of the sports radar device of FIG. 1.

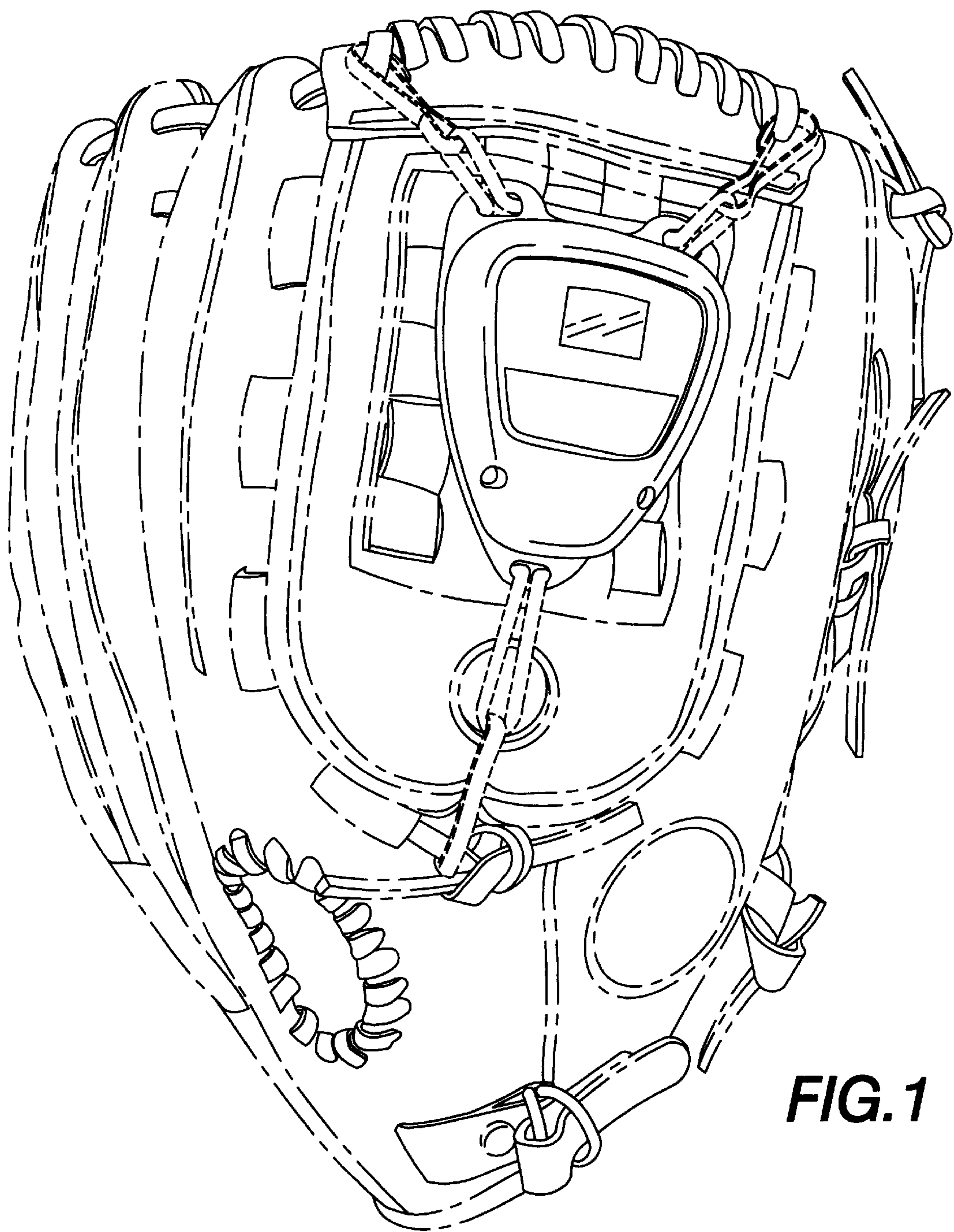

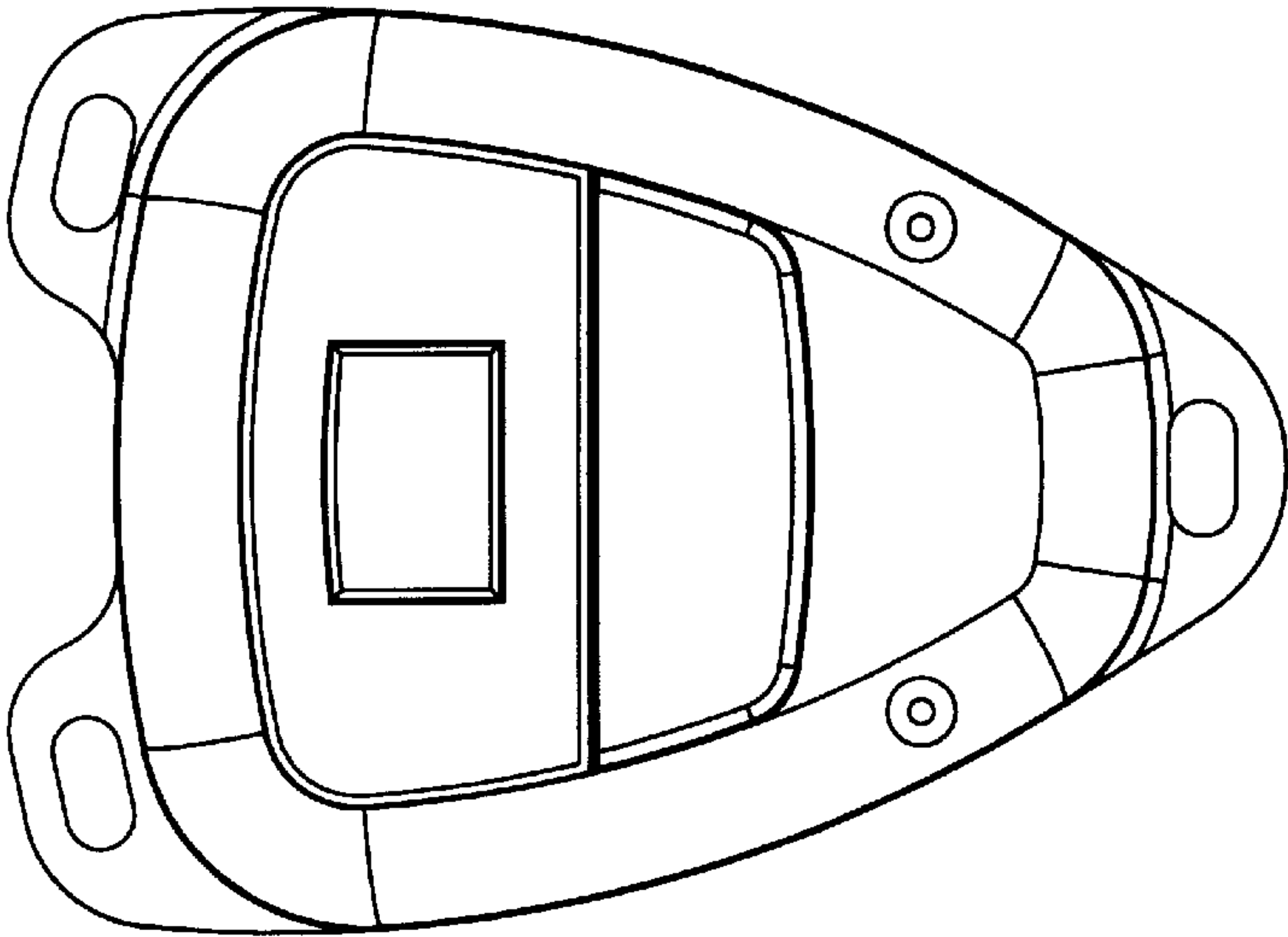

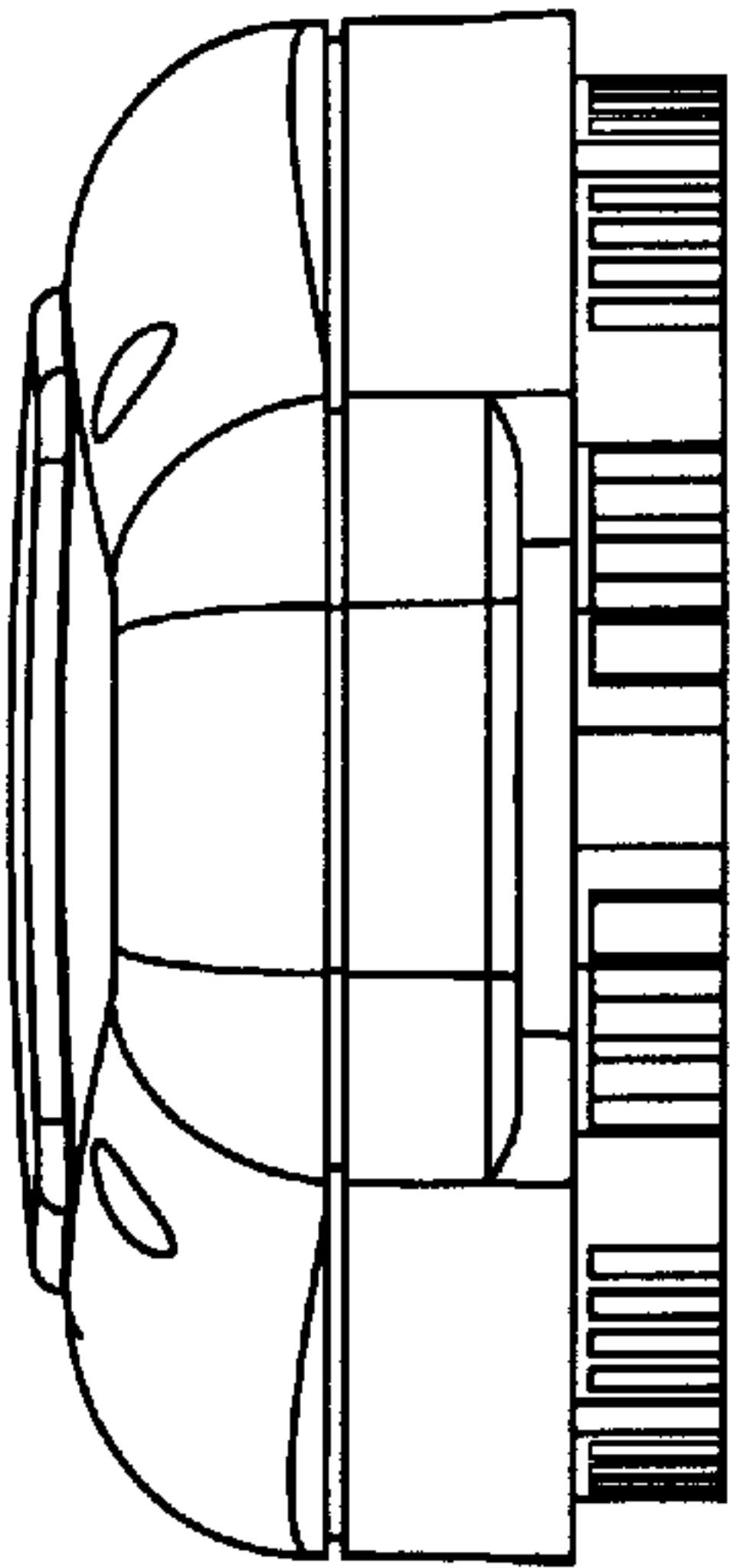

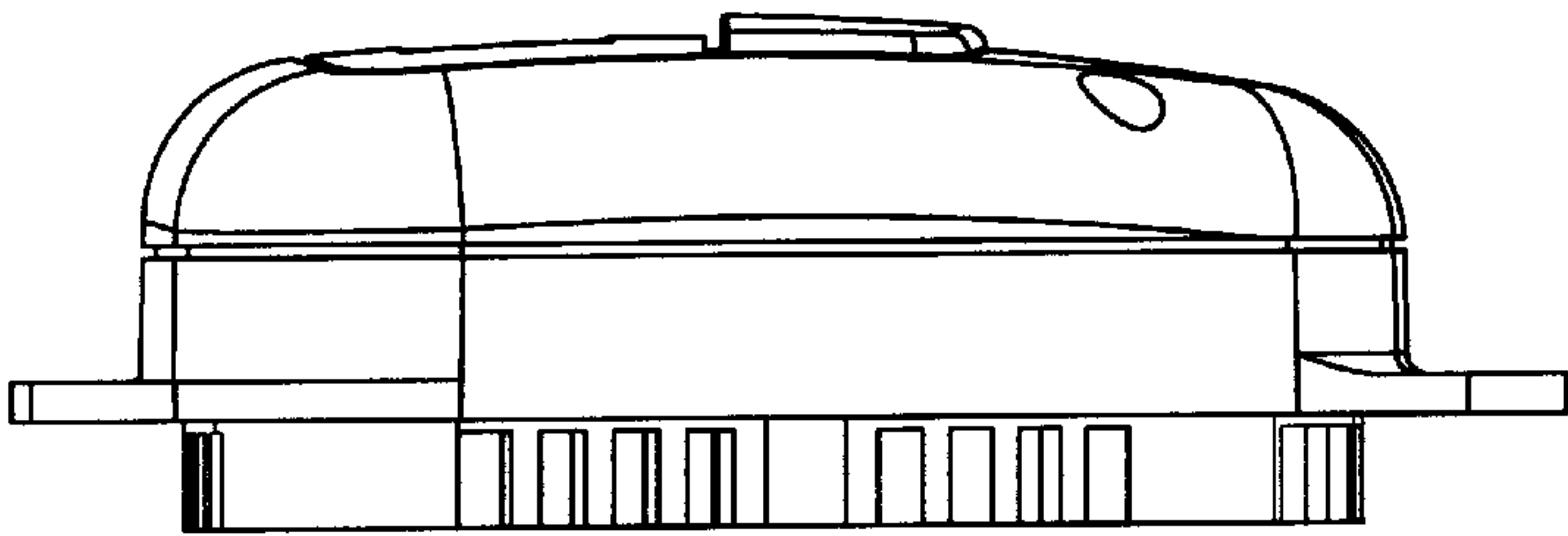

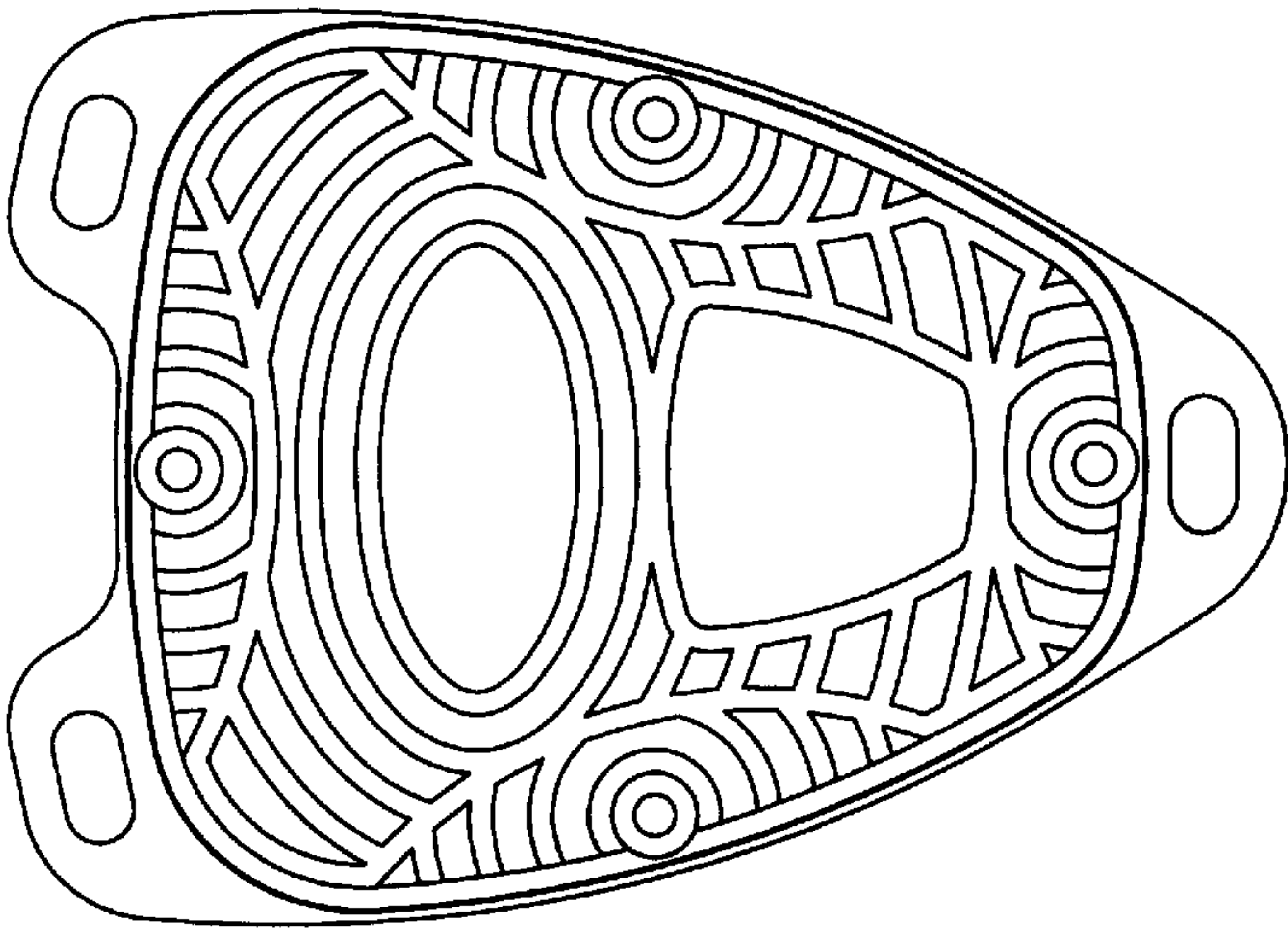

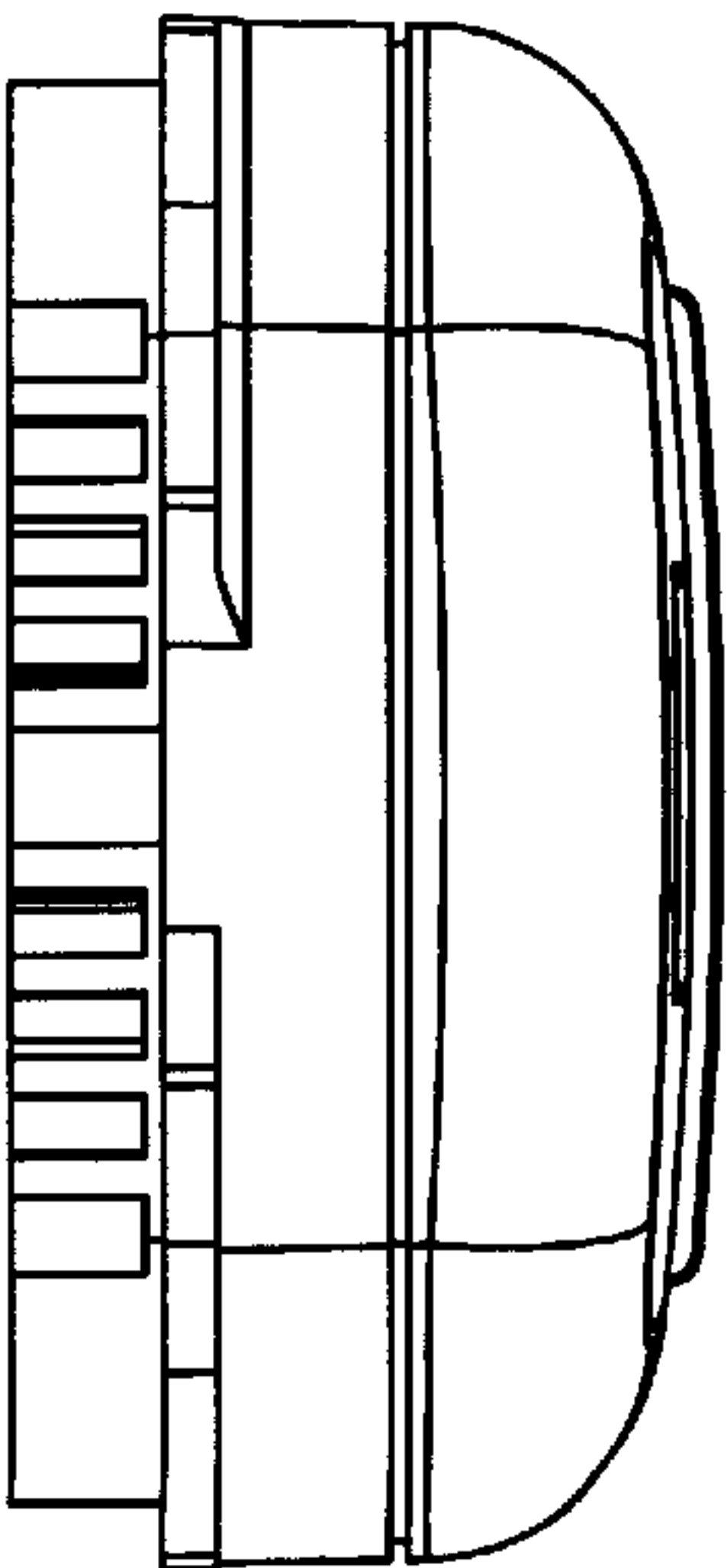
