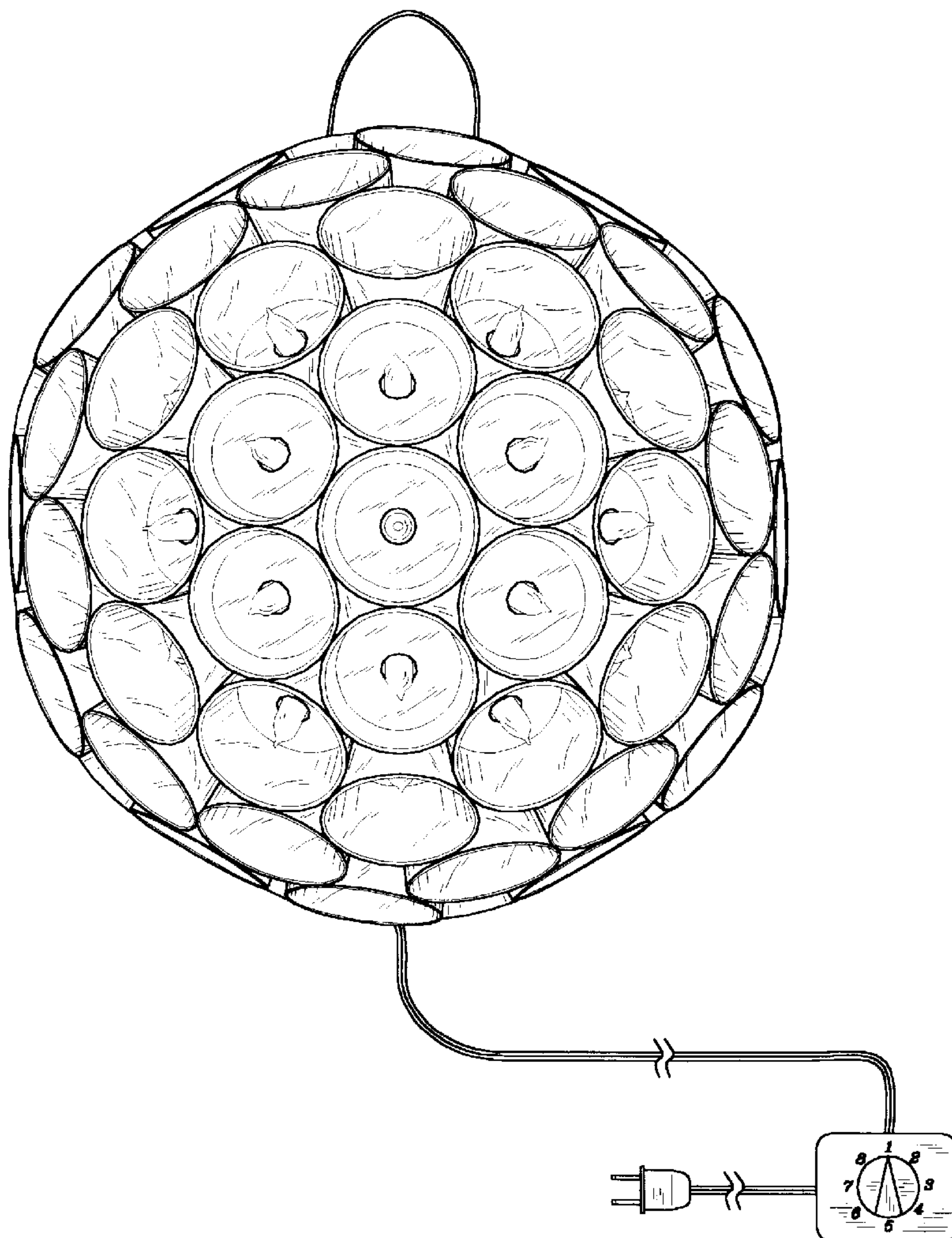

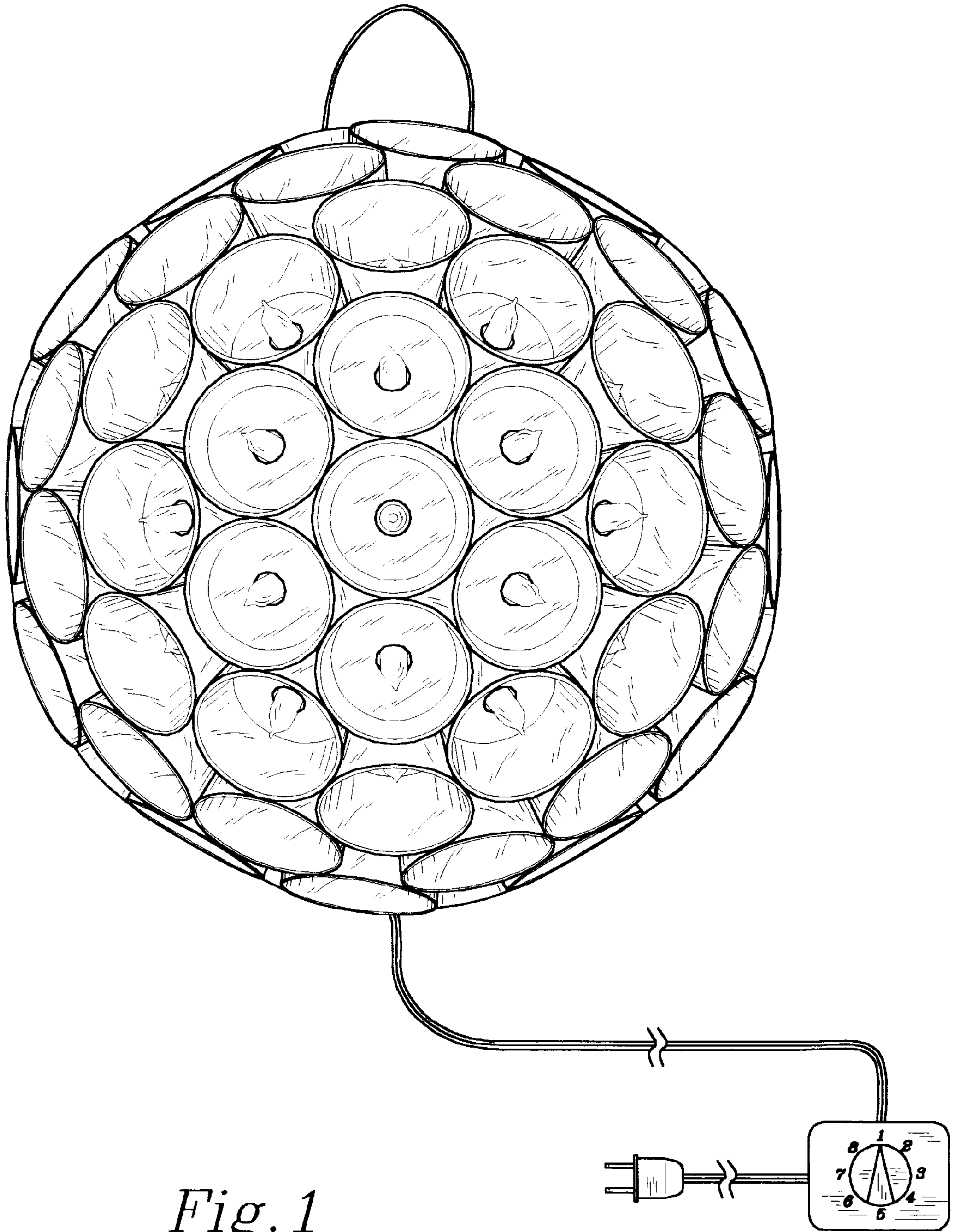
The broken away portions of the chords in FIGS. 1 and 2 is to signify indefinite length.

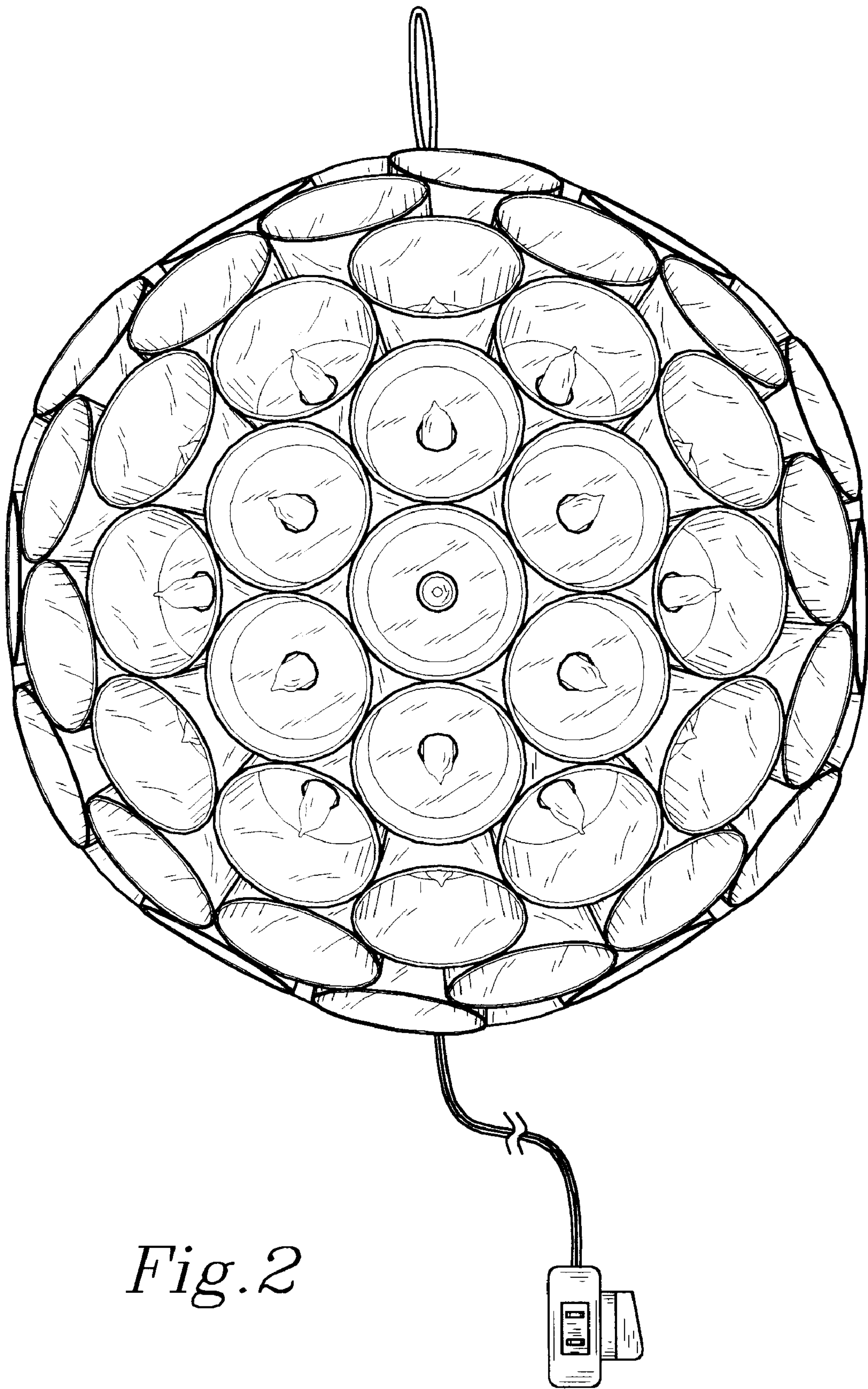

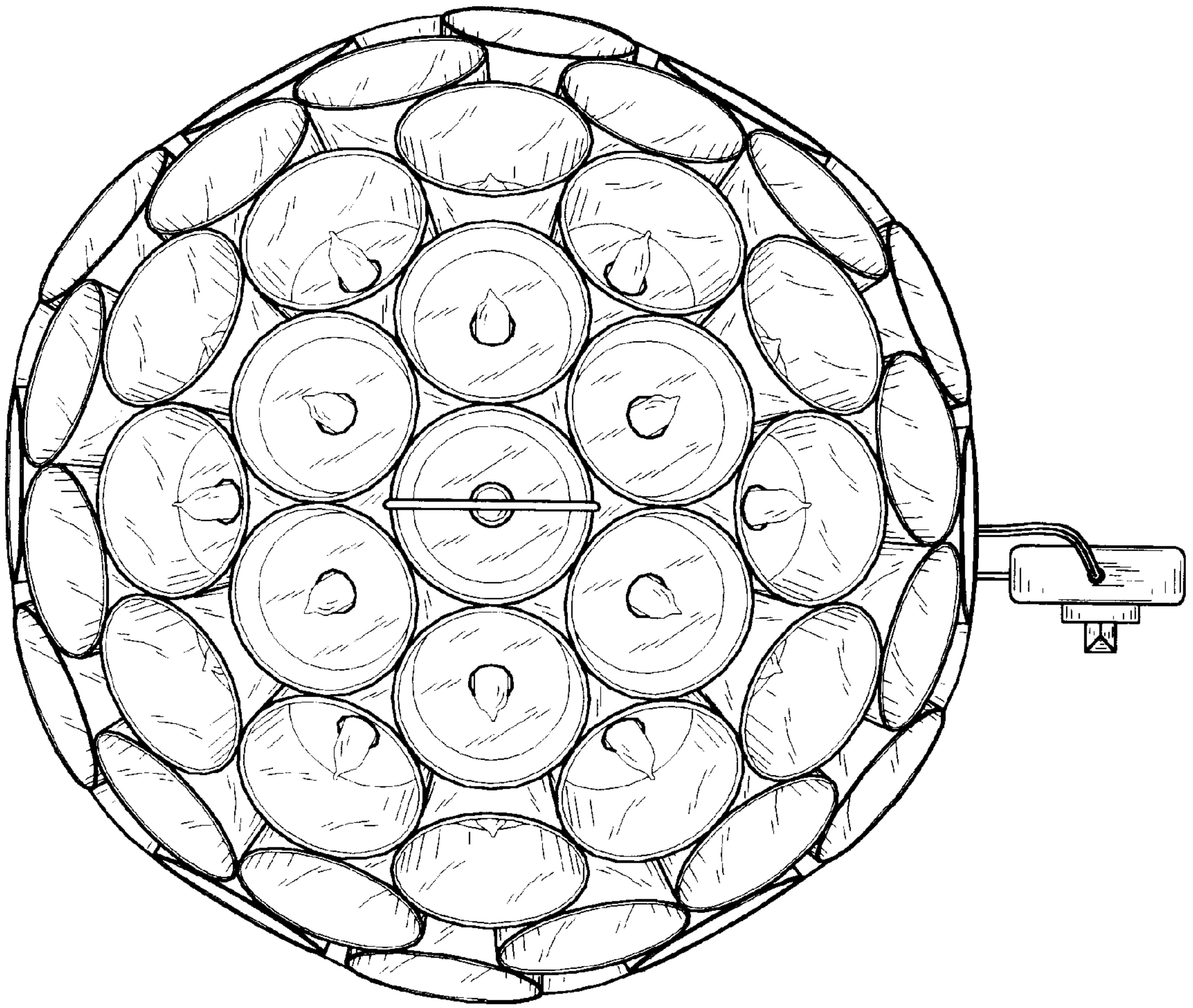

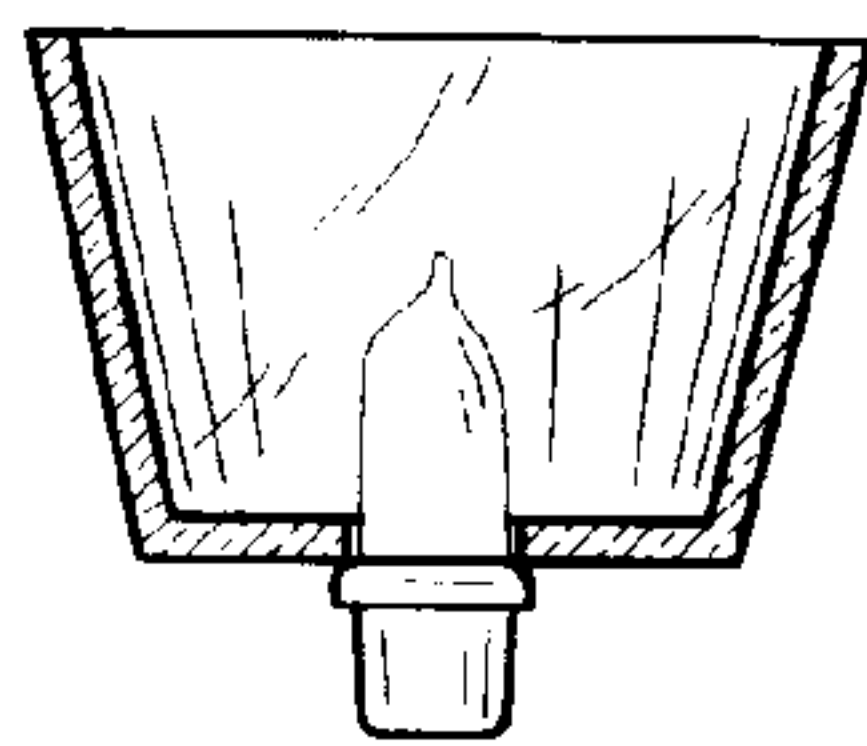
