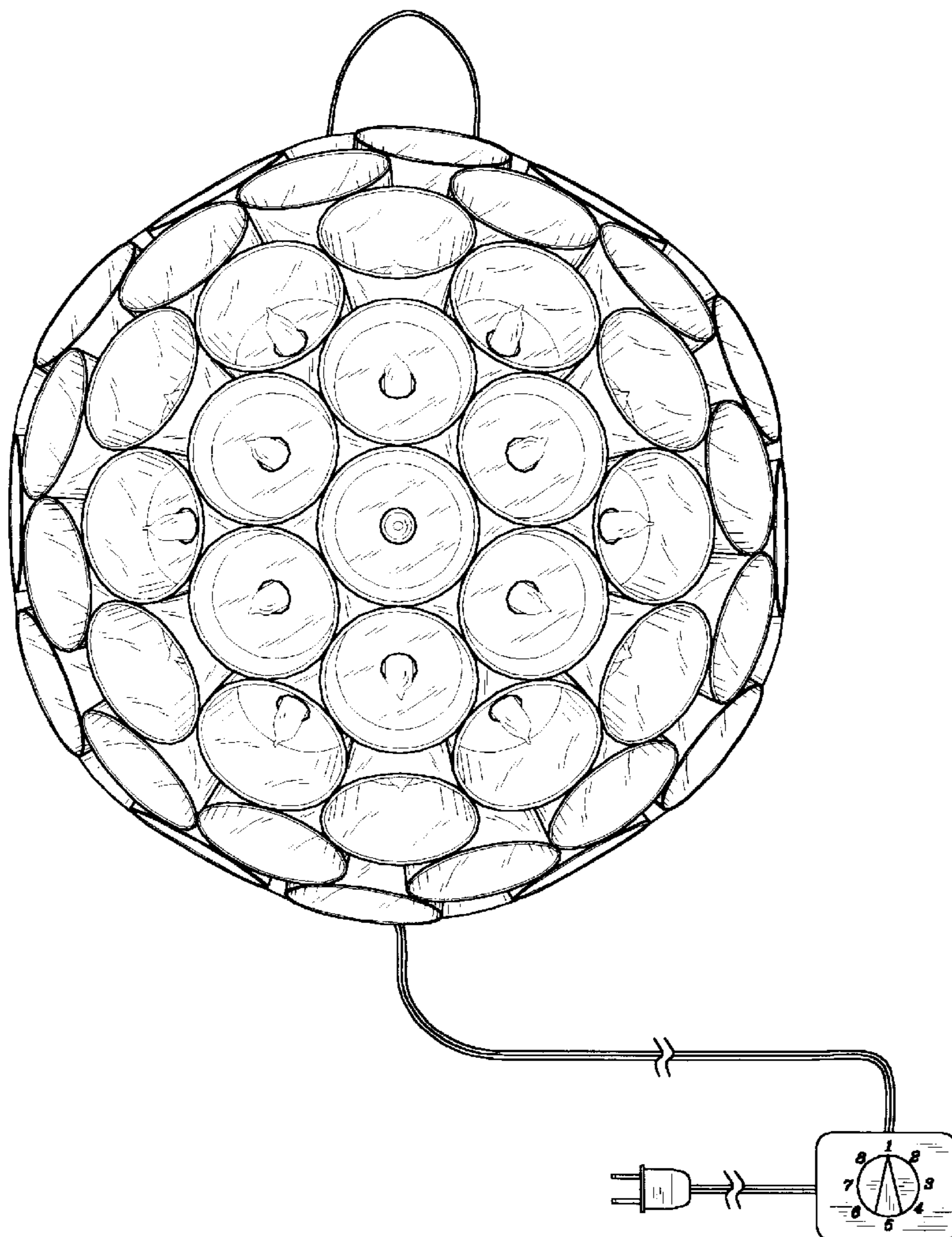
FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view of one light portions of the lighted ornament of FIG. 1.

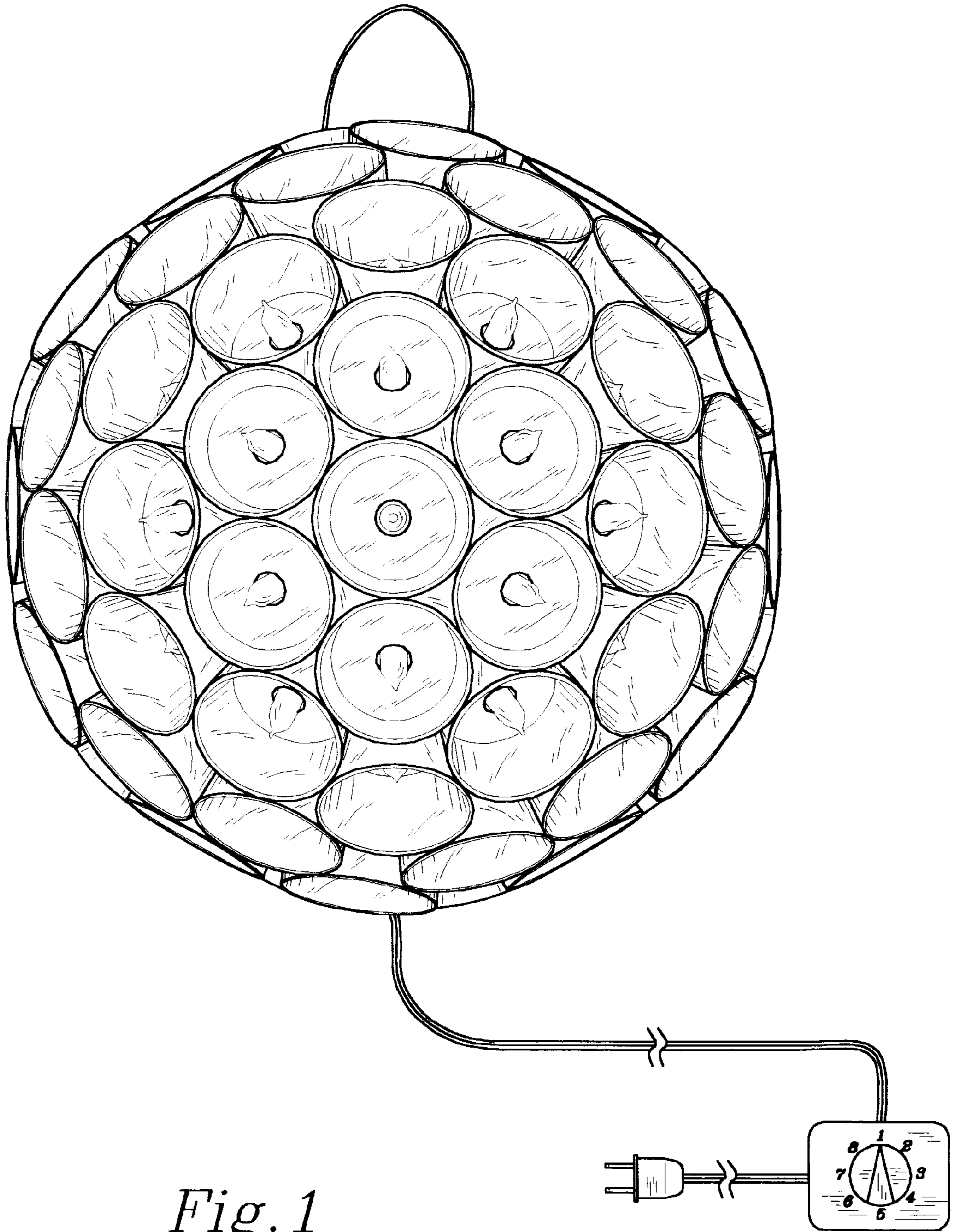

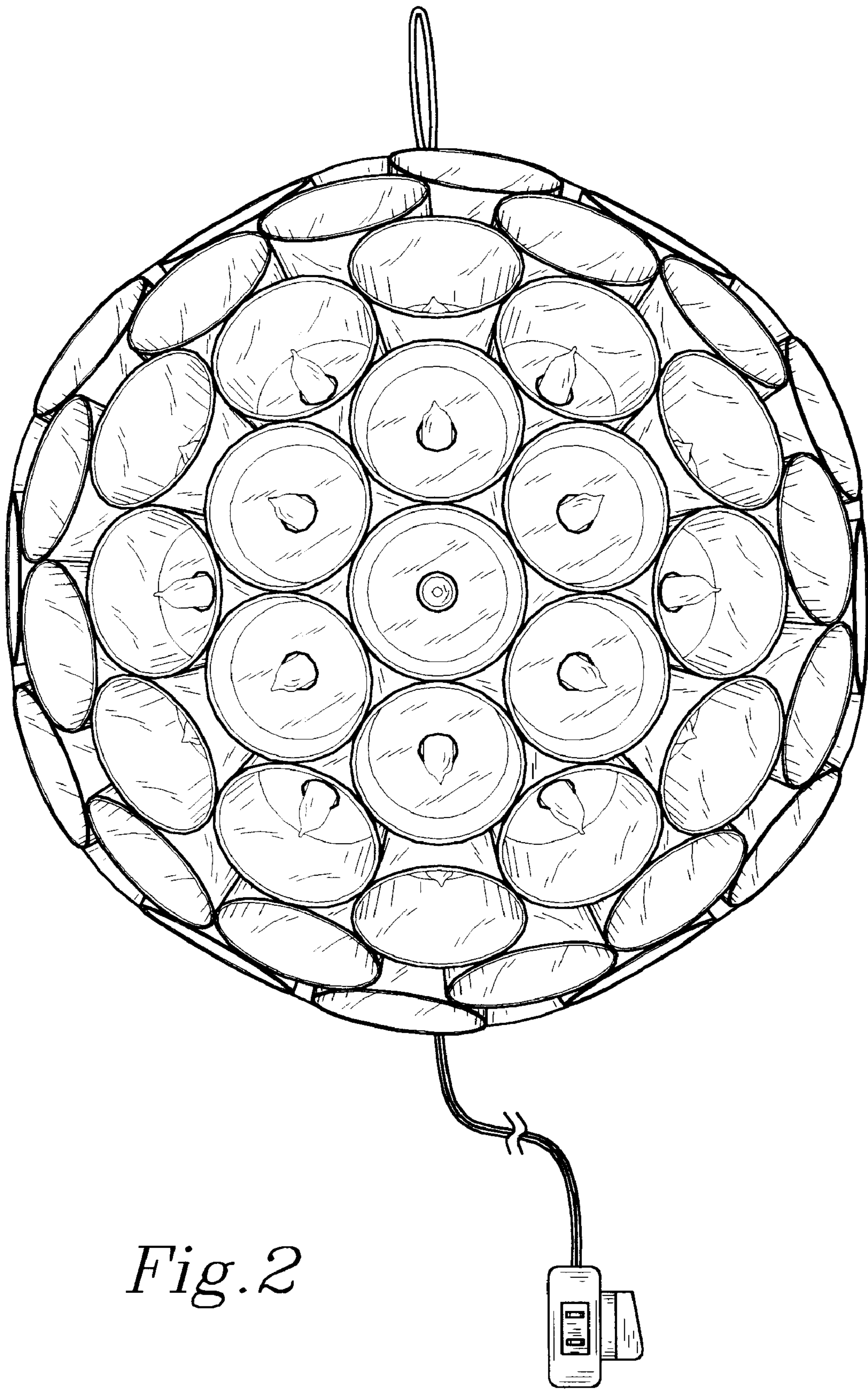

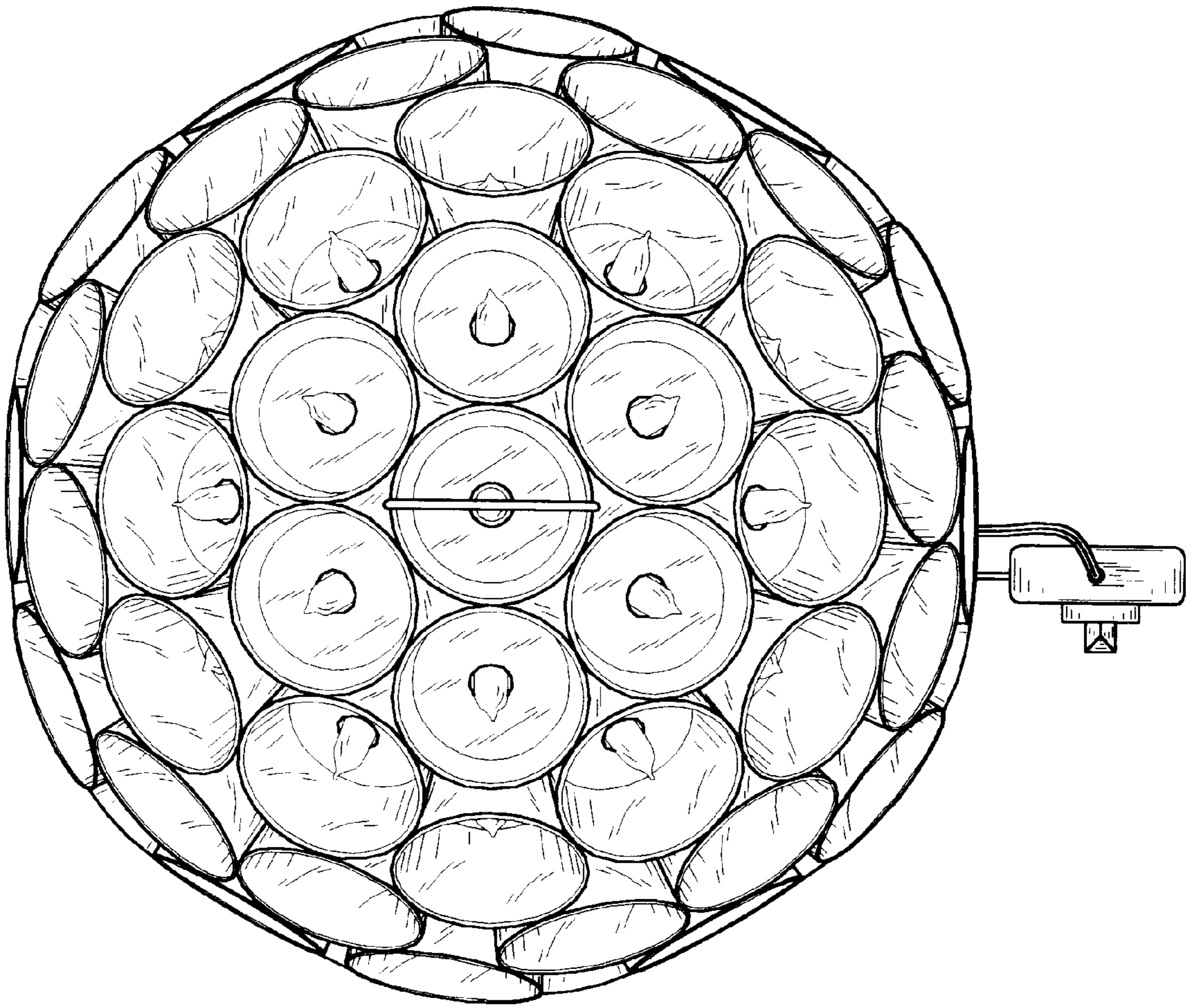

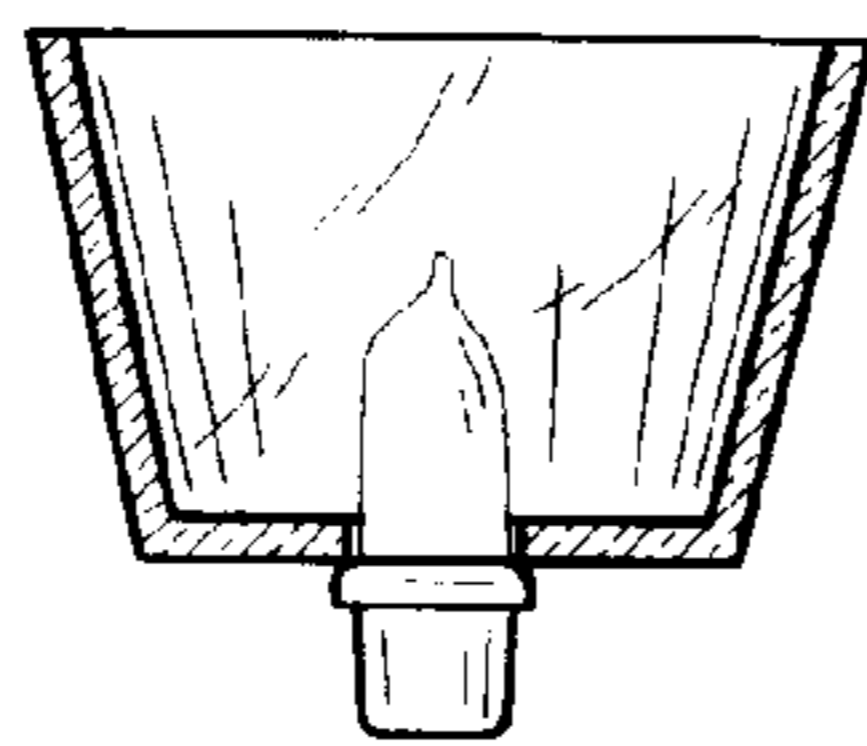
