FIG. 1 is a right side elevation view of an in-line skate, showing our new design;

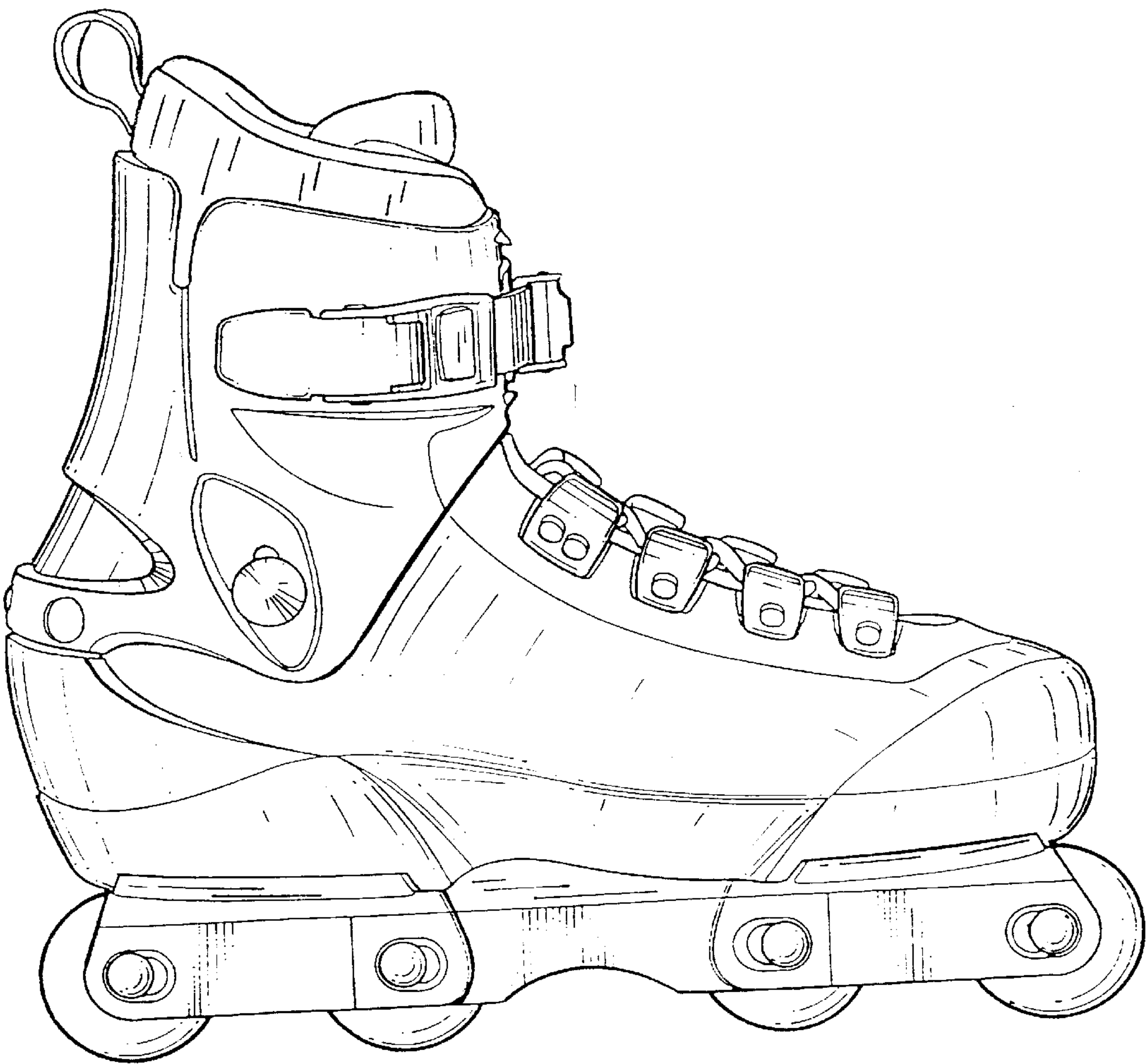

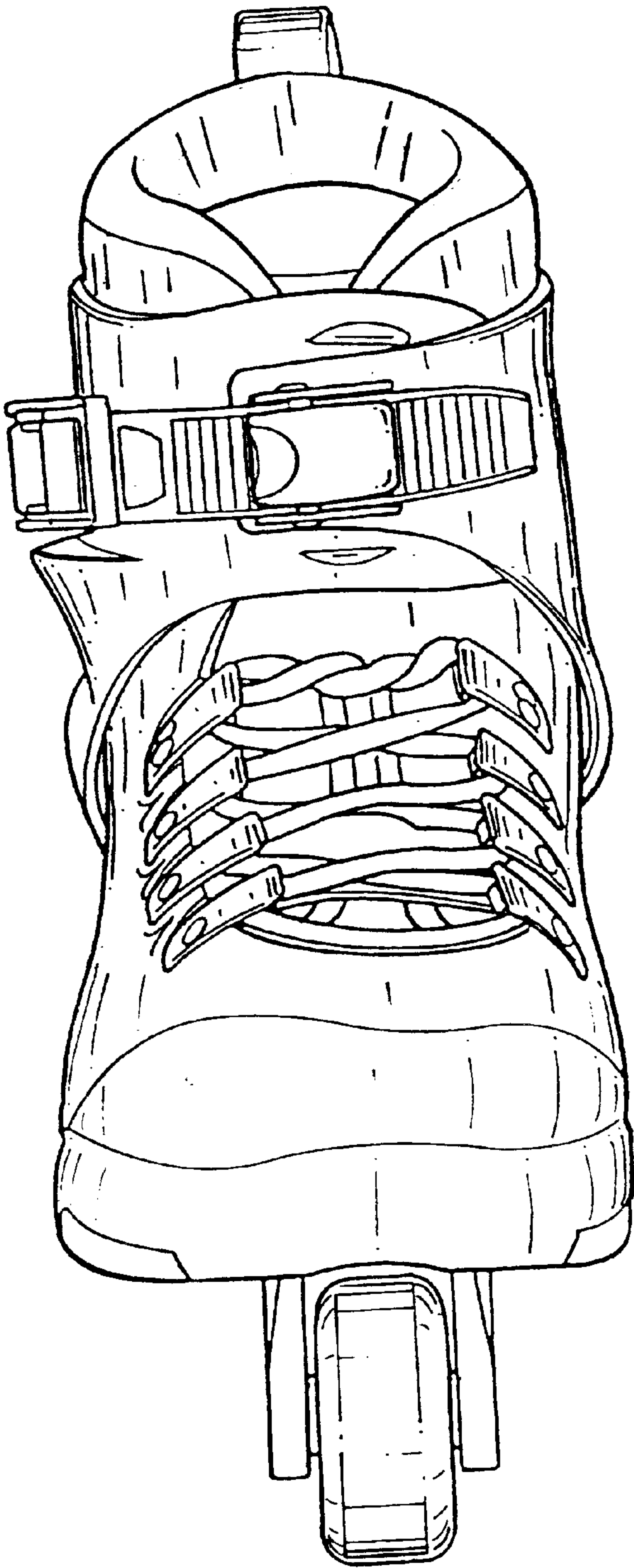

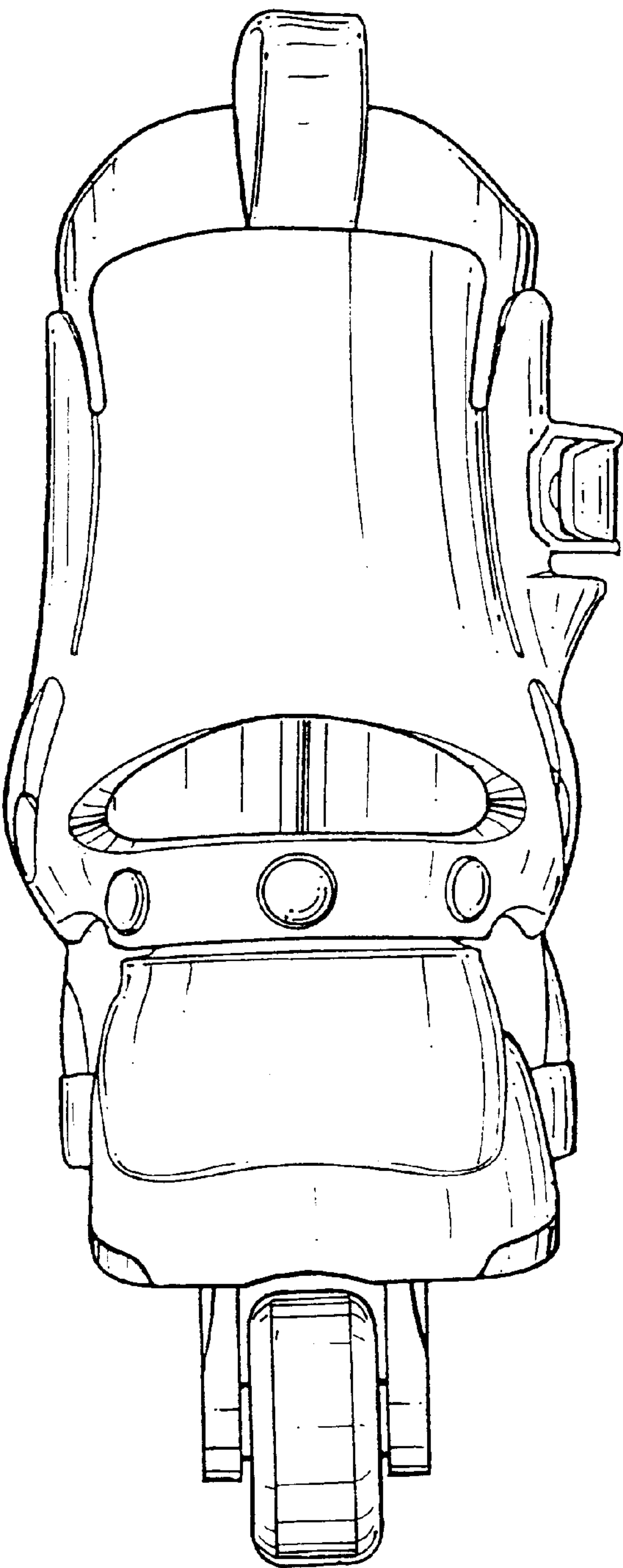

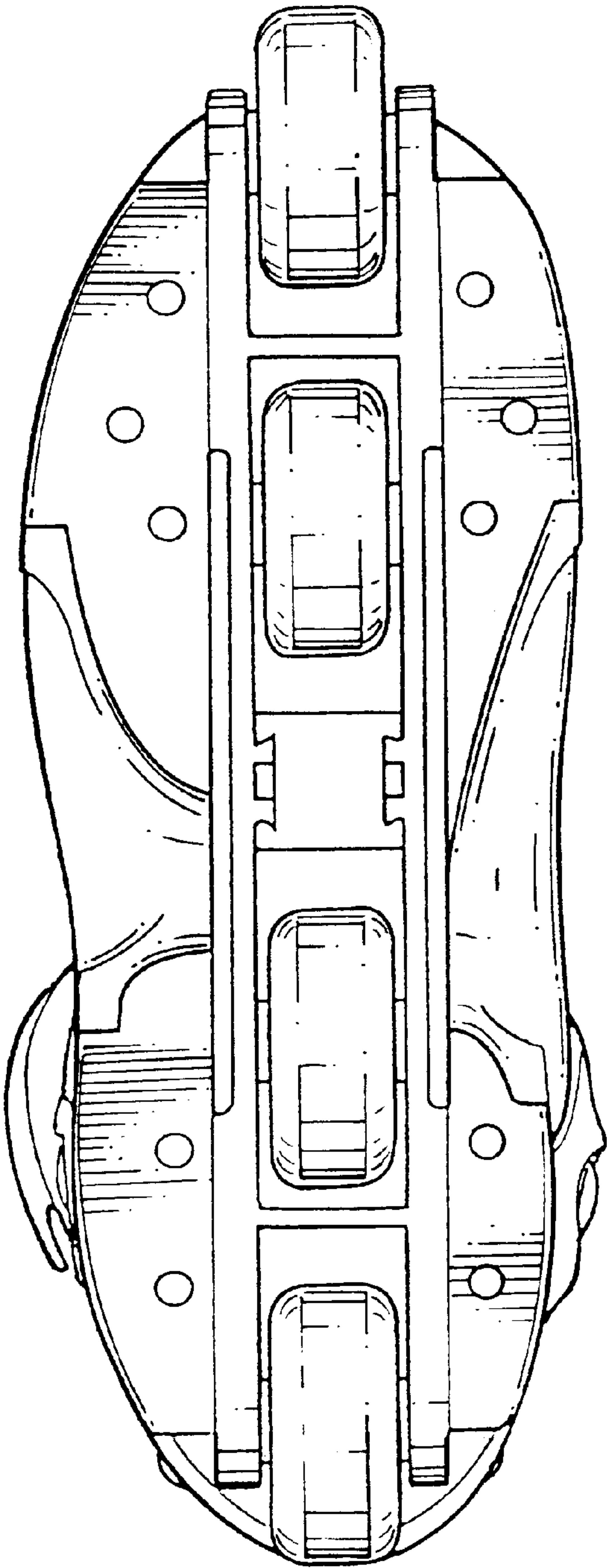

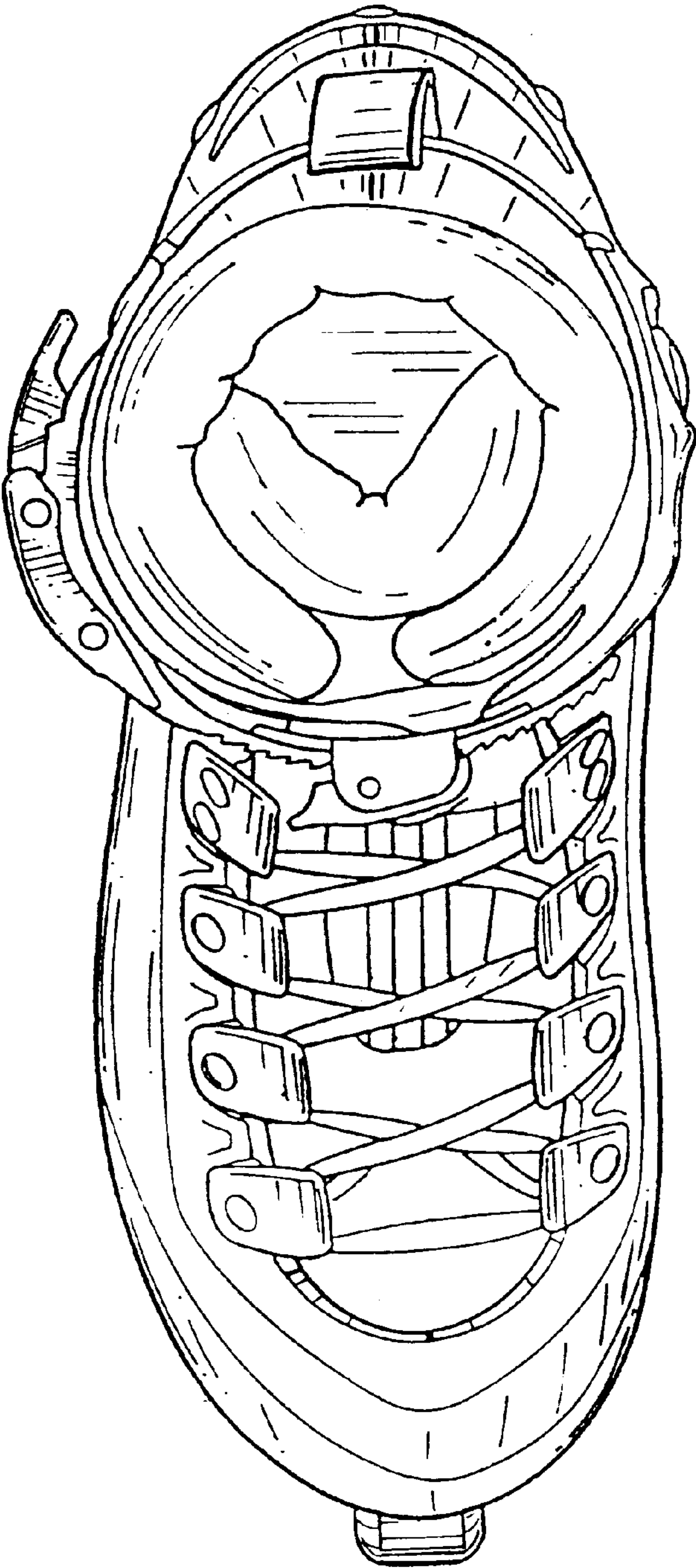
