The new, original and ornamental design for a cheerleading skirt with decorative cutouts, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a frontal view of the cheerleading skirt with decorative cutouts showing our new design incorporating square cutouts, it being understood that the side views are mirrors thereof;





















