[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a convertible backpack/shoulder bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a convertible backpack/shoulder bag showing our claimed design with the bag straps configured for wearing the bag as a backpack;

FIG. 2 is rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a convertible backpack/shoulder bag showing our claimed design with the bag straps configured for wearing the bag as a shoulder bag.

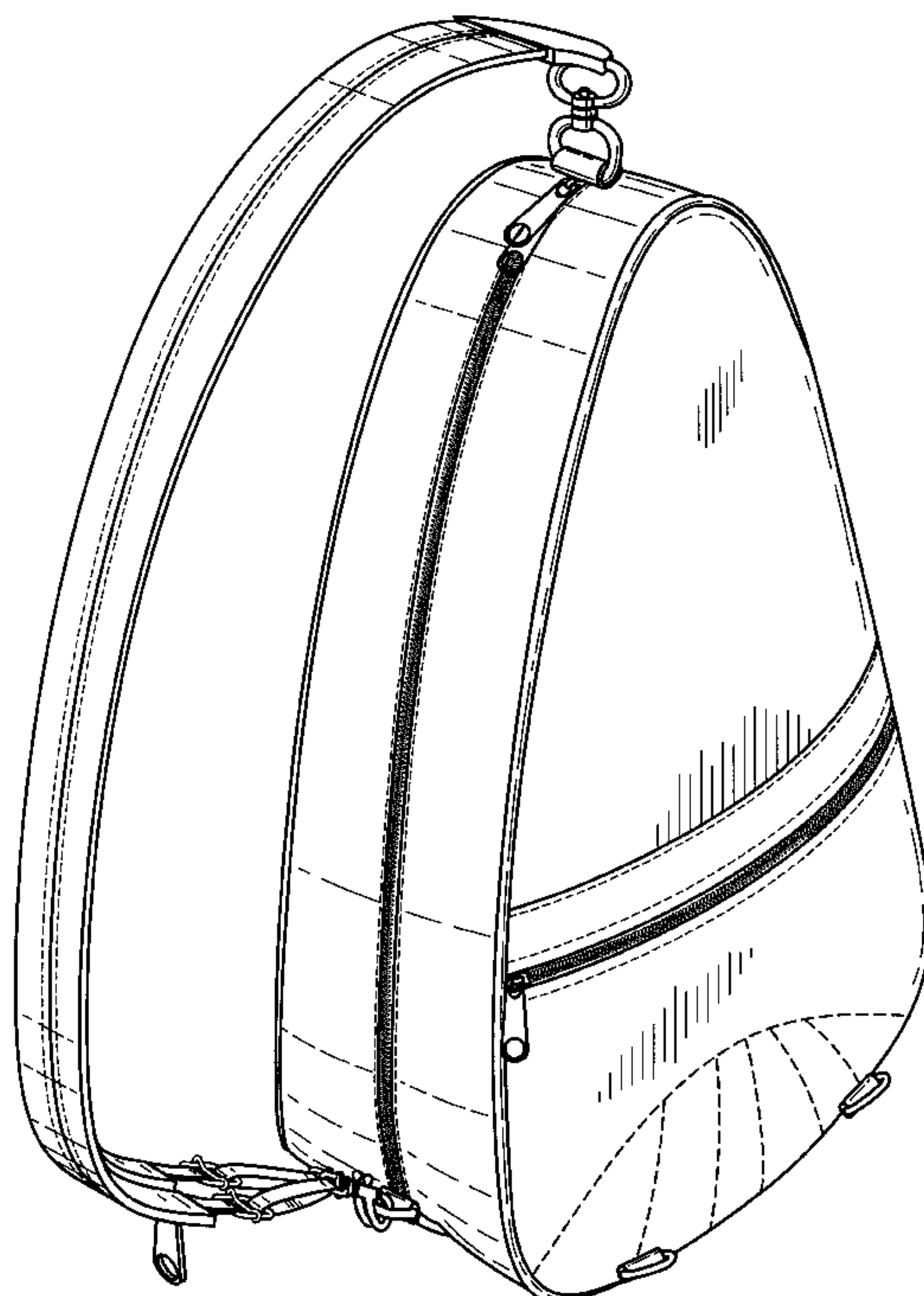
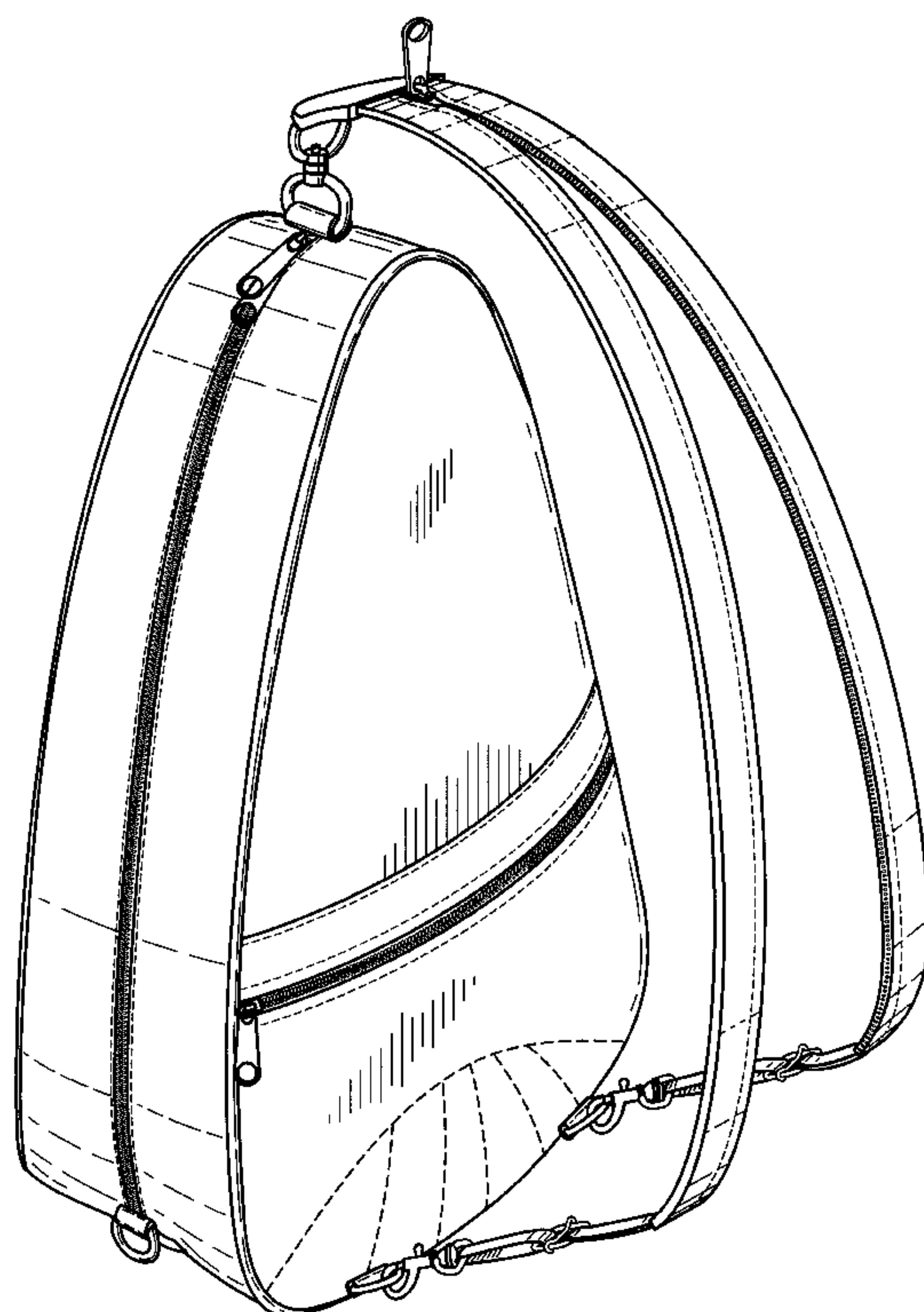
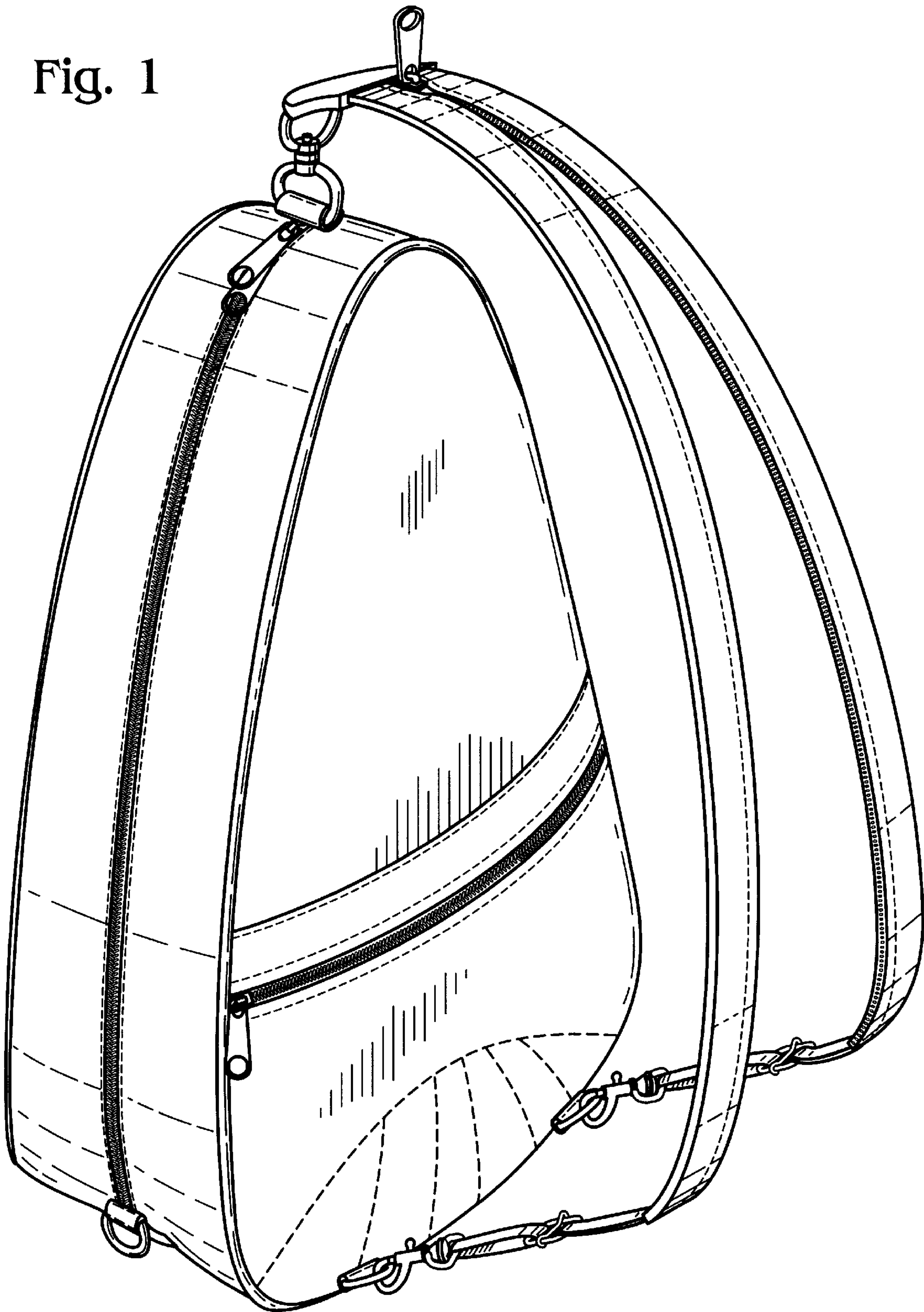

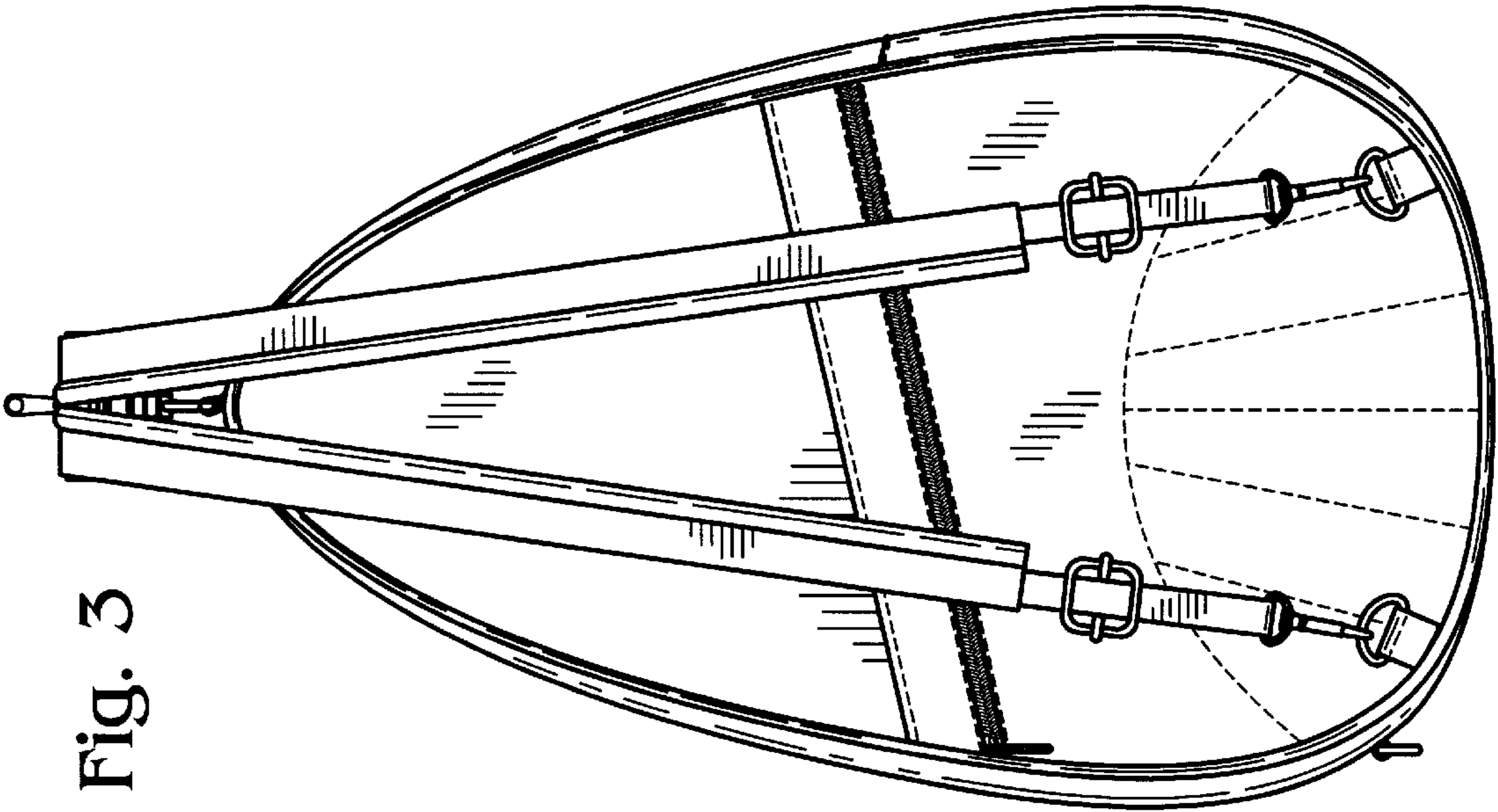

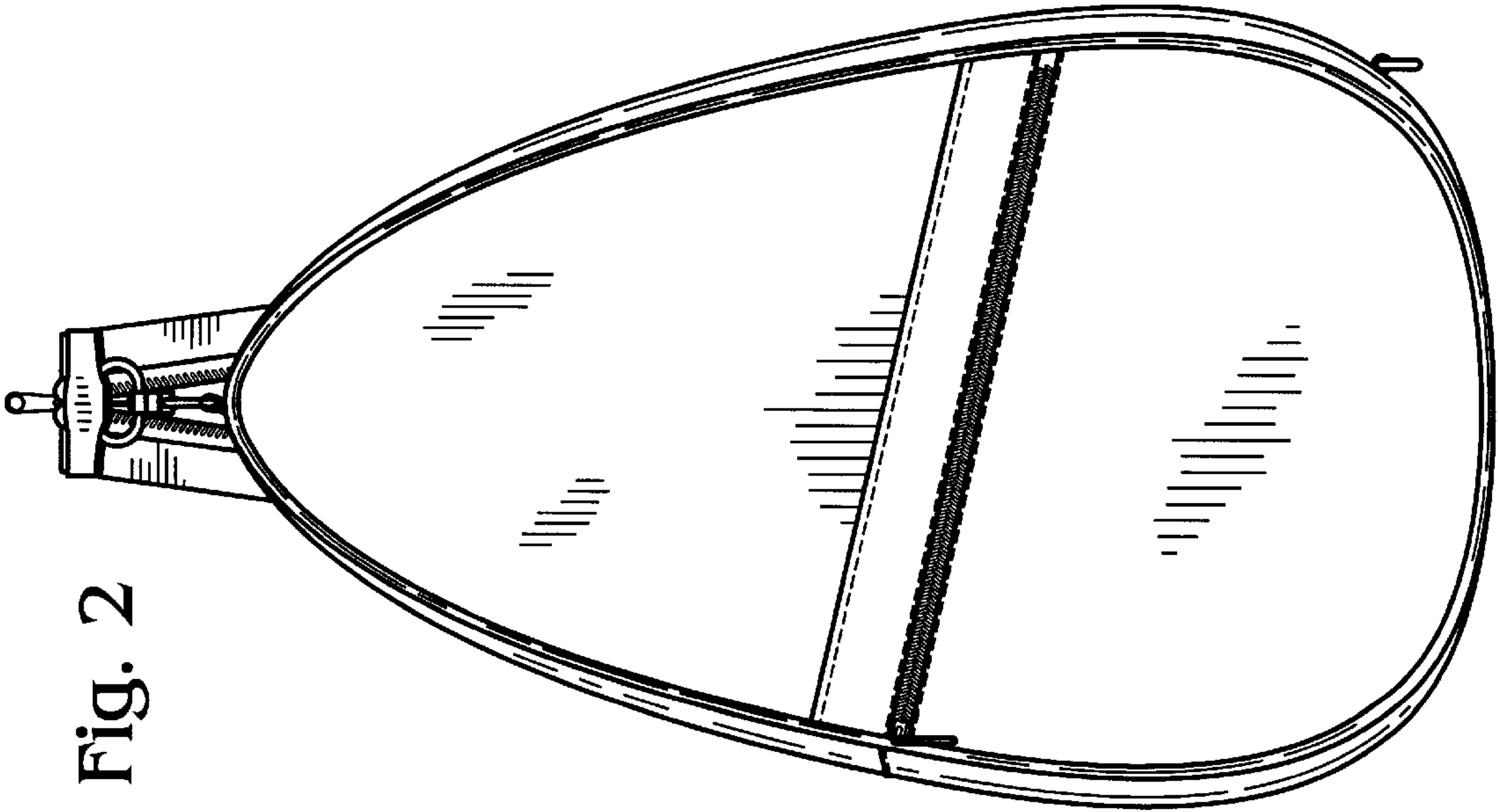

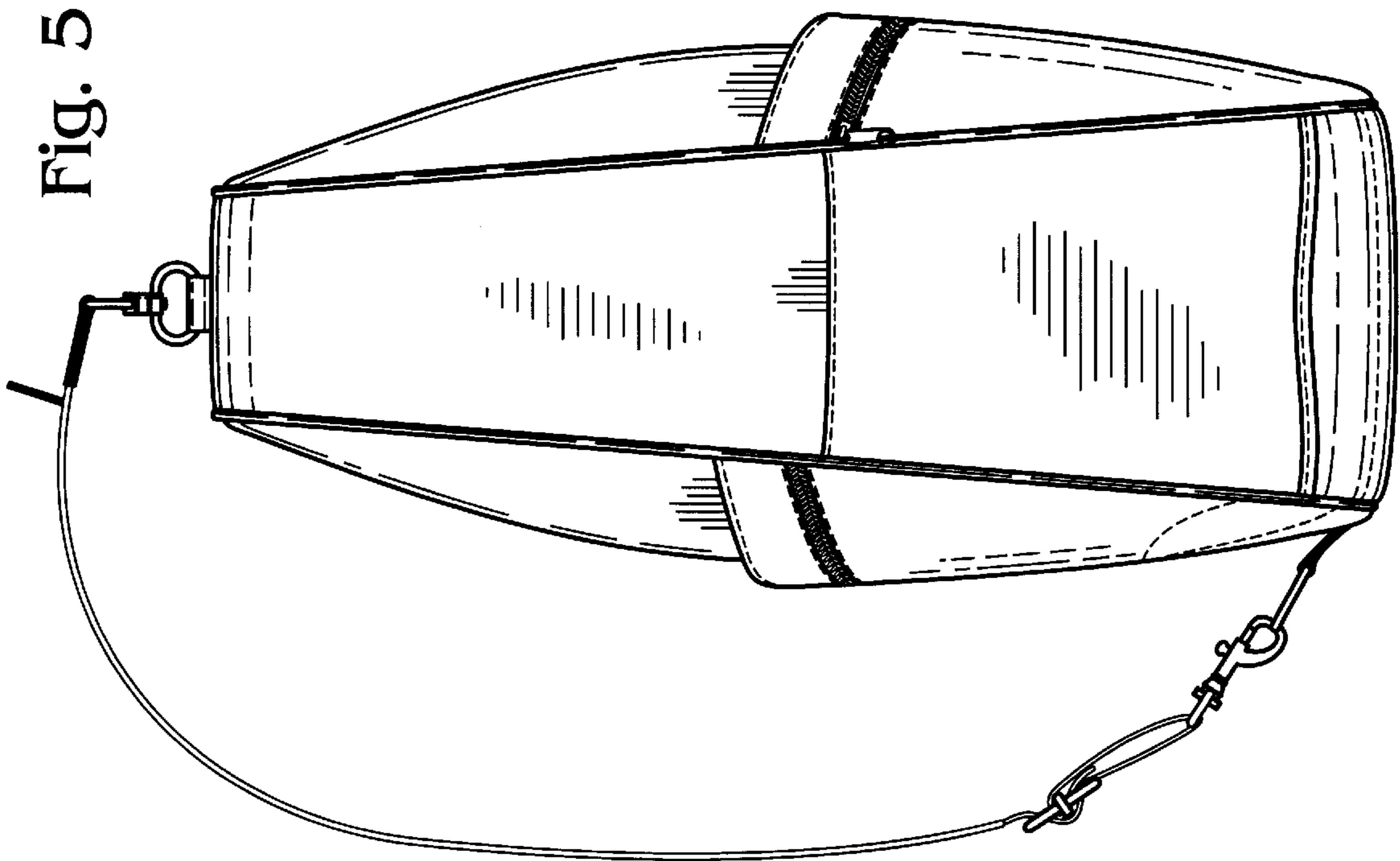

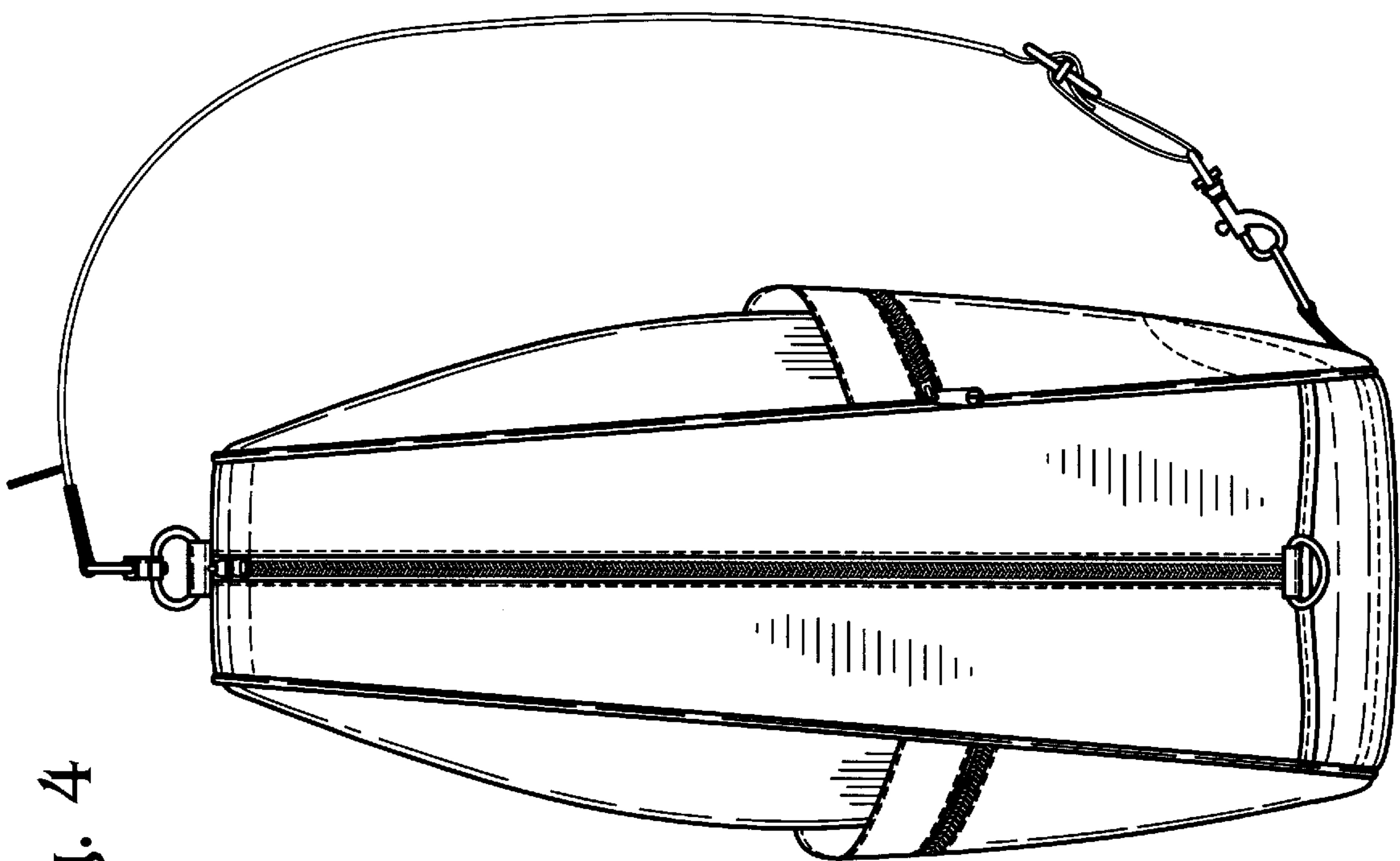

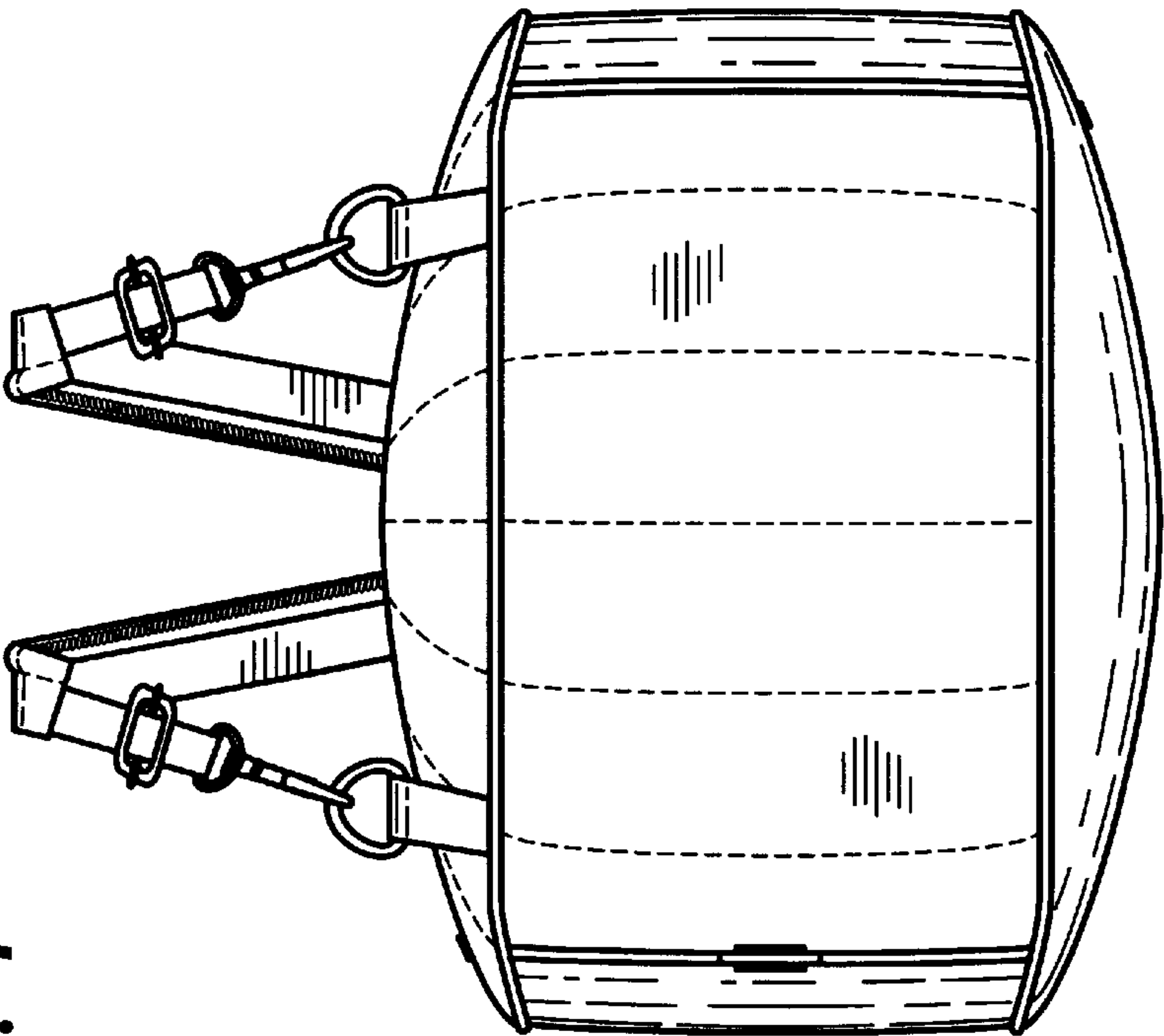

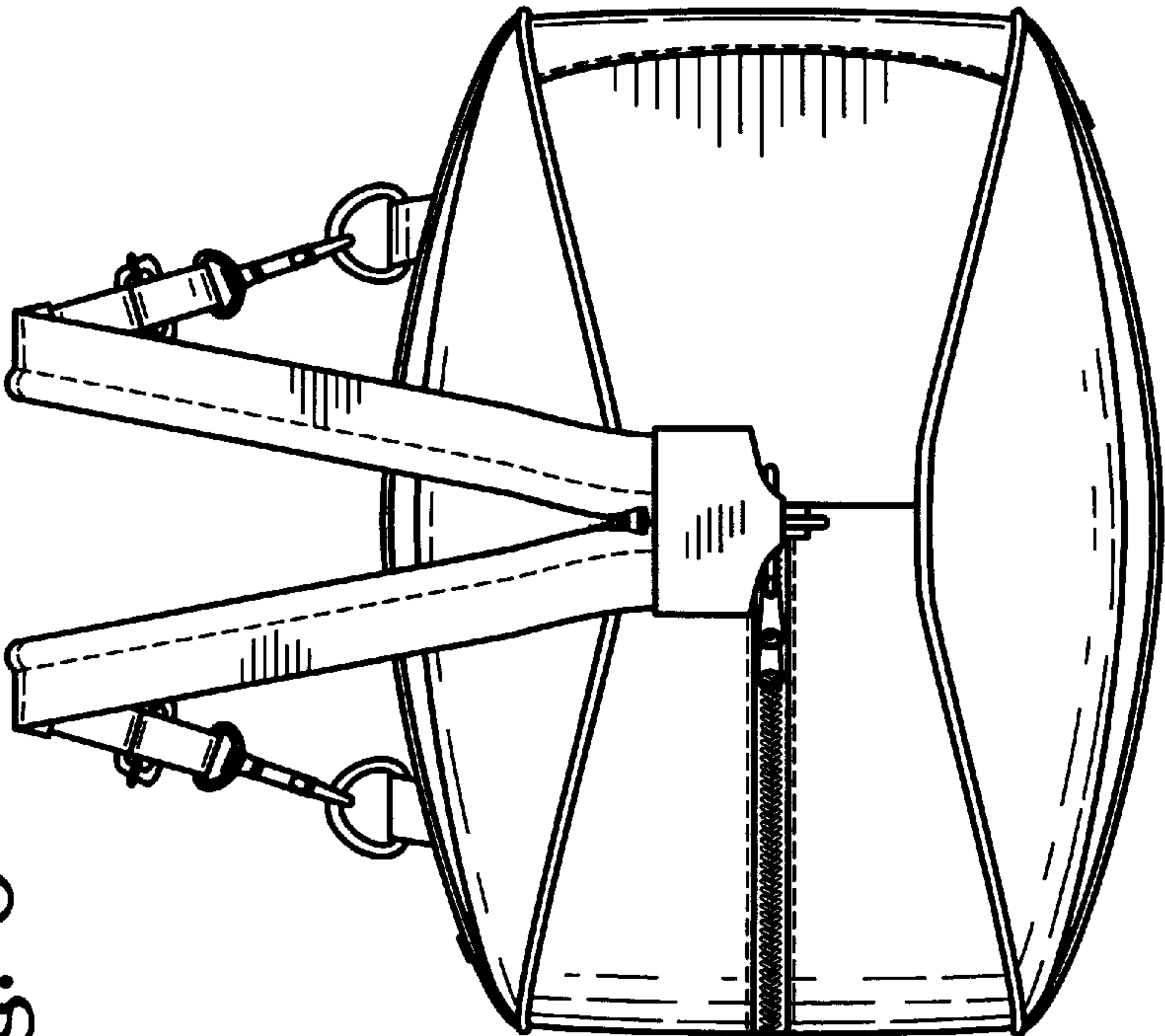
