The ornamental design for an armchair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an armchair, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a view similar to FIG. 1, the backrest being in an upright position;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, taken from the left of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a view similar to FIG. 5, the backrest being in an upright position; and,
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.

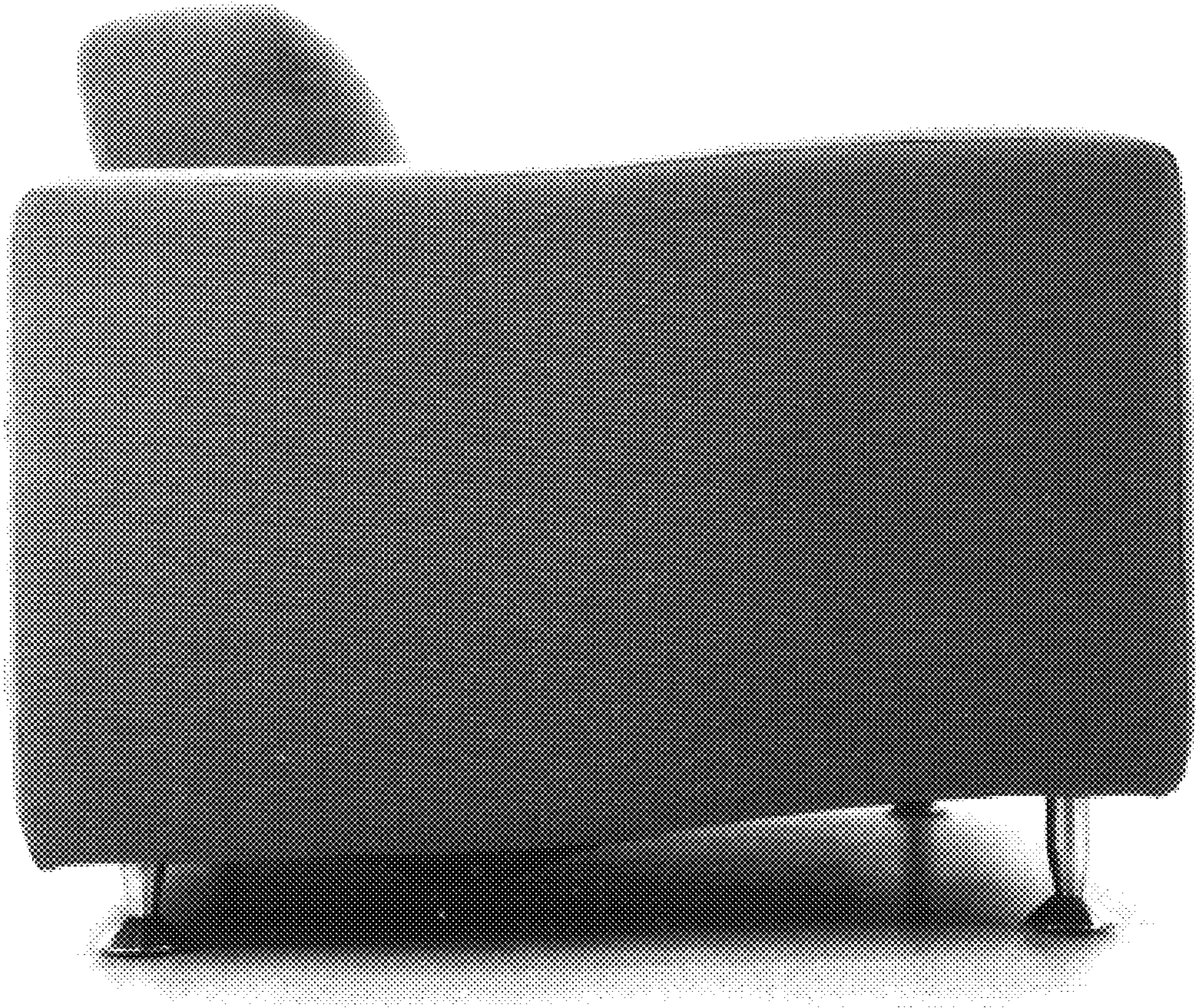

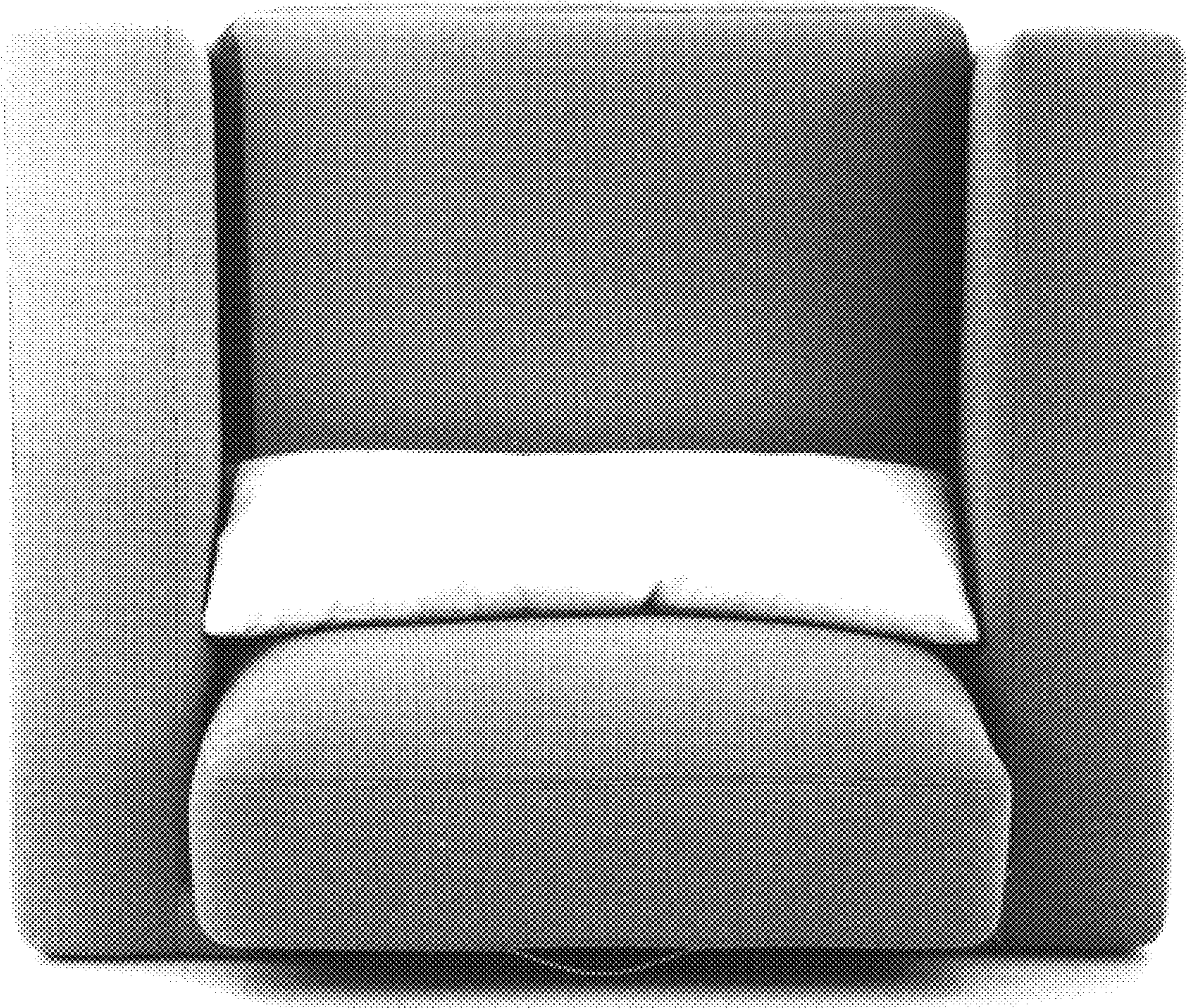
