DESCRIPTION

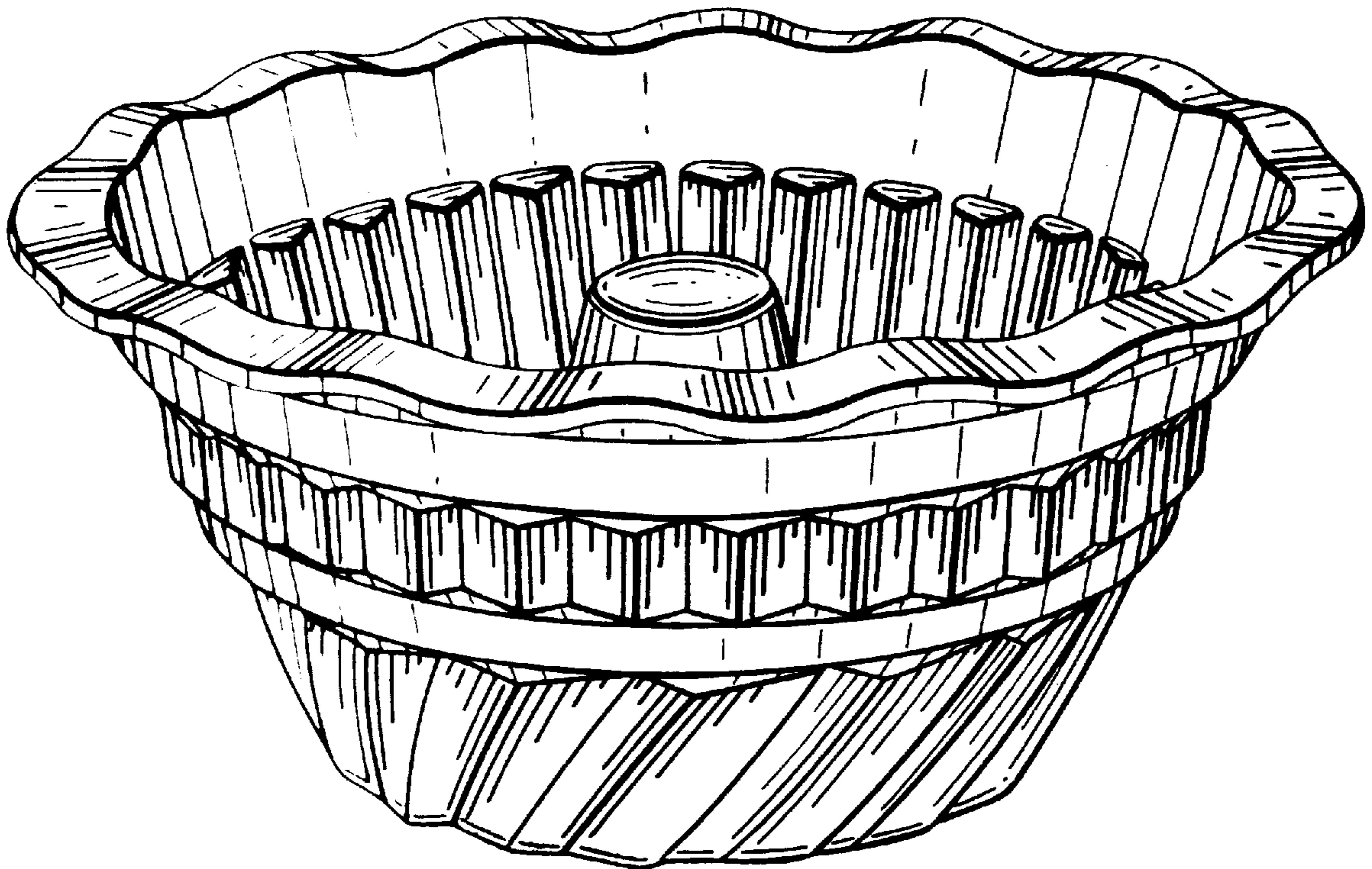
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a scalloped baking dish showing my new design;

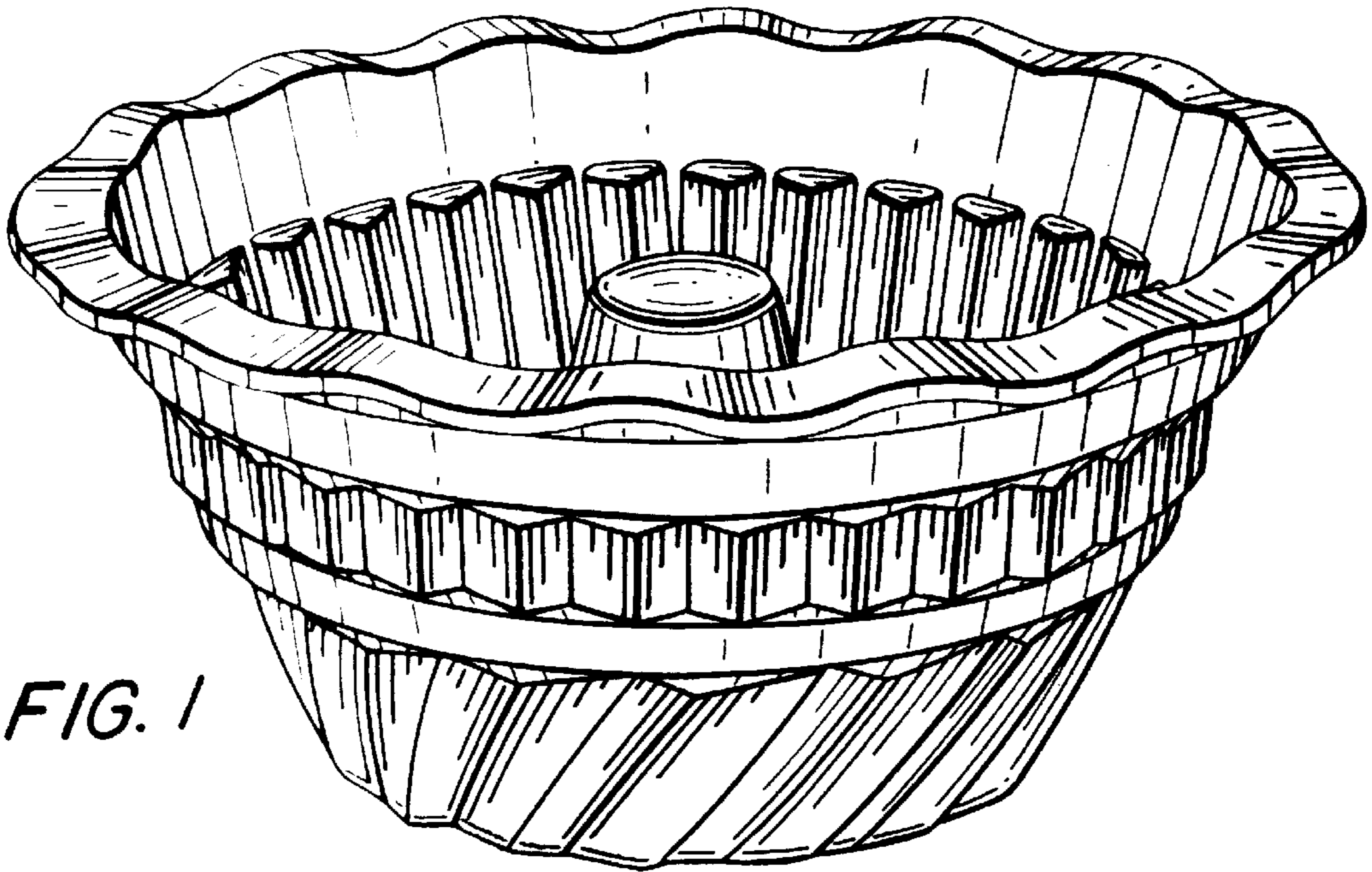

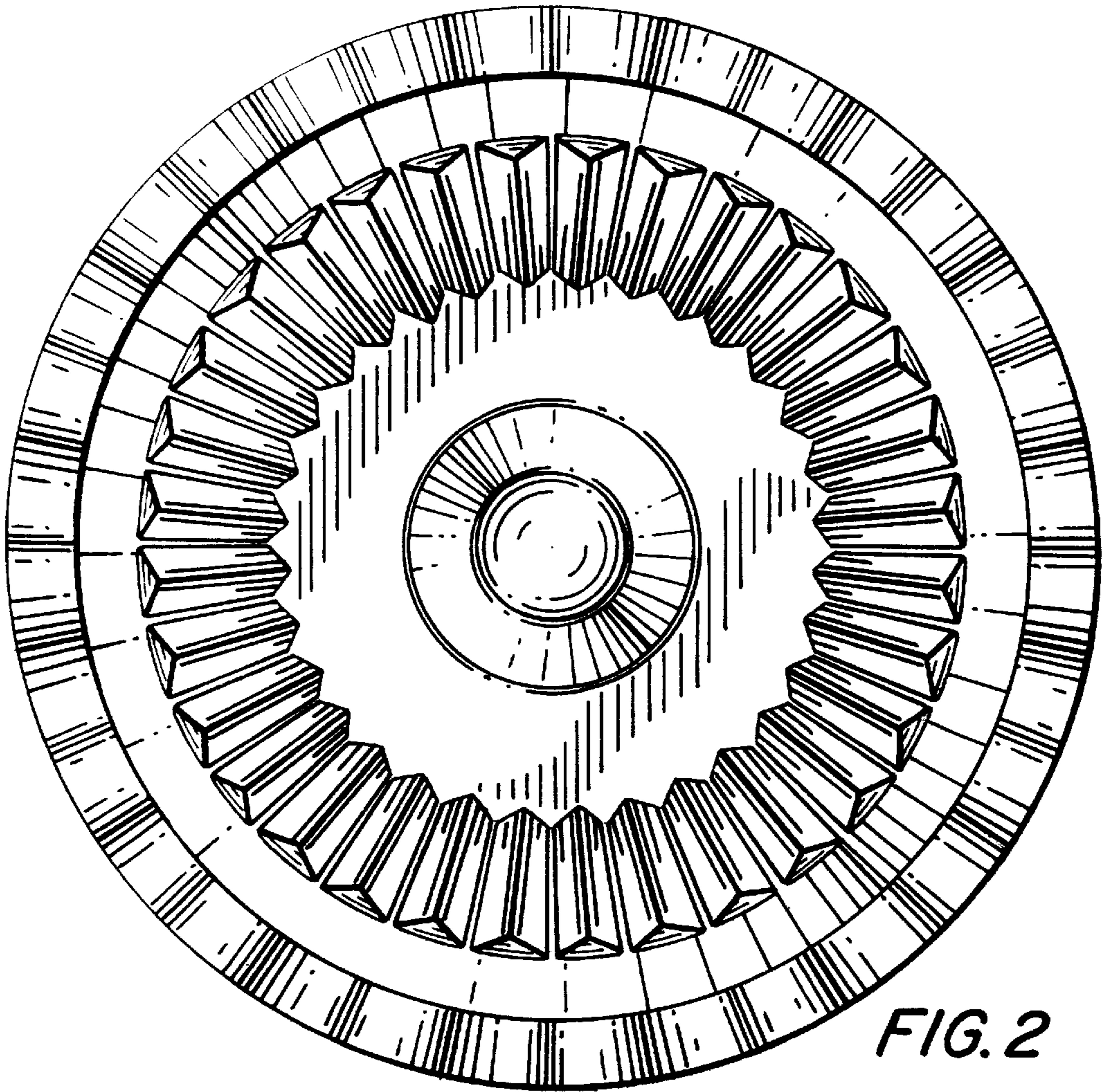

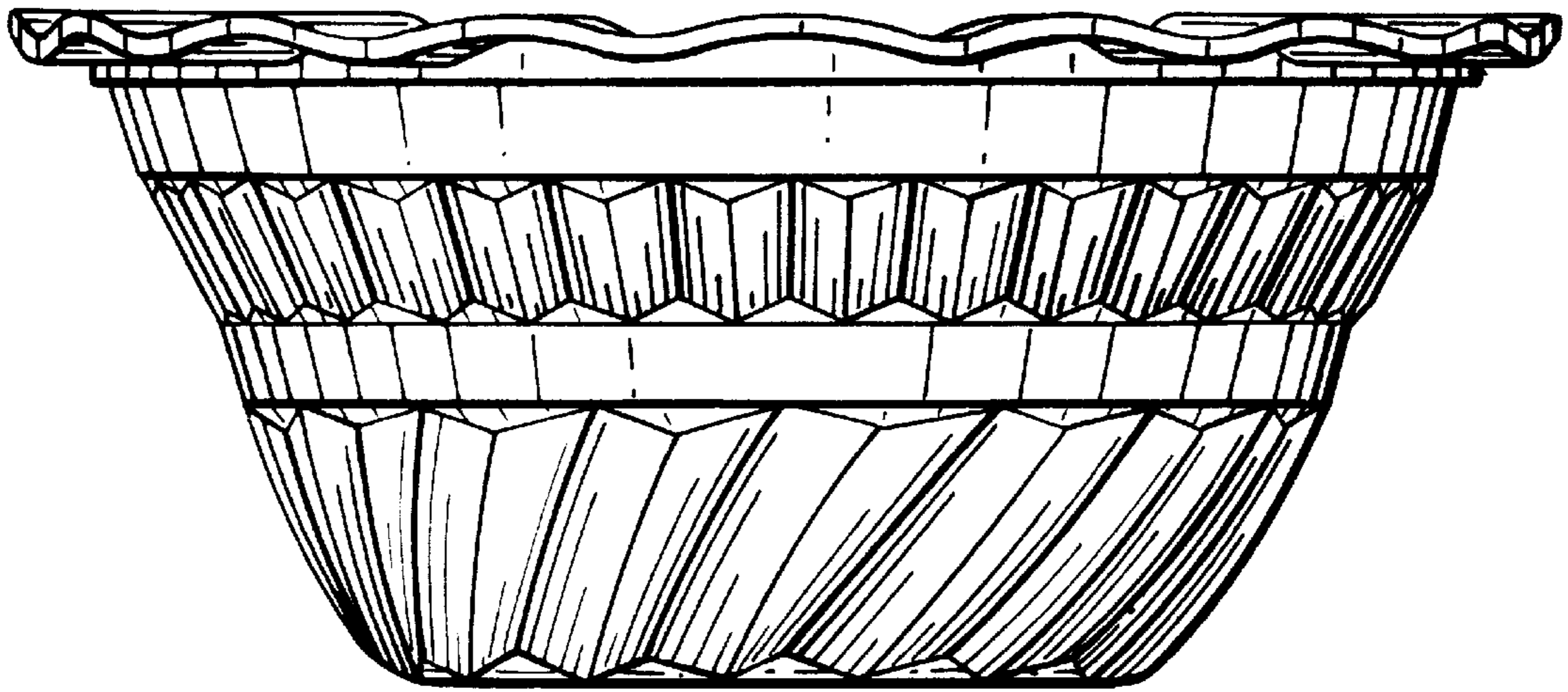
