[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tape player and recorder combined with a radio receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tape player and recorder combined with a radio receiver showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof. FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is another perspective view thereof, wherein the lid portion thereof is in the open position, the broken lines showing of the inside portion is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

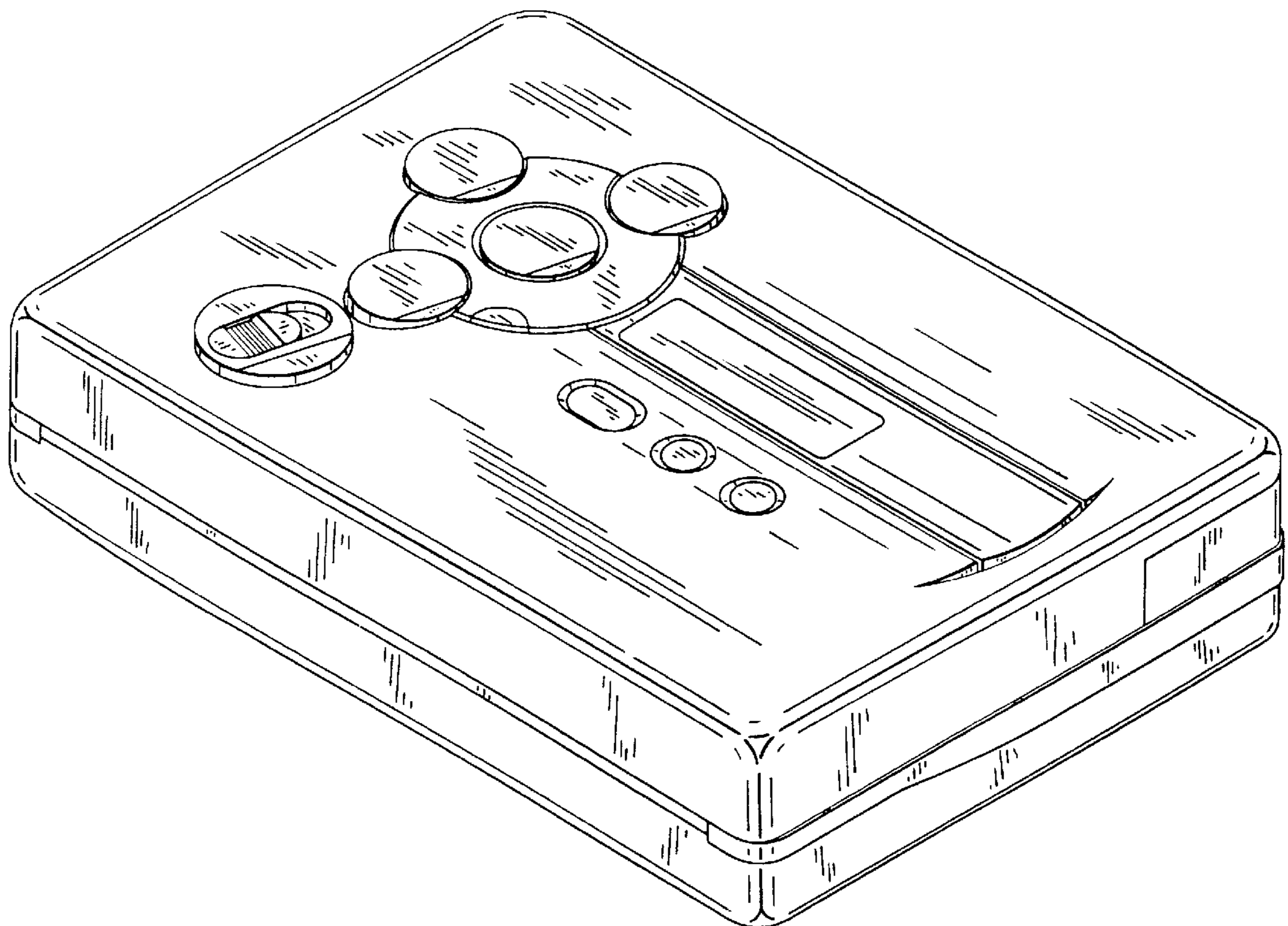

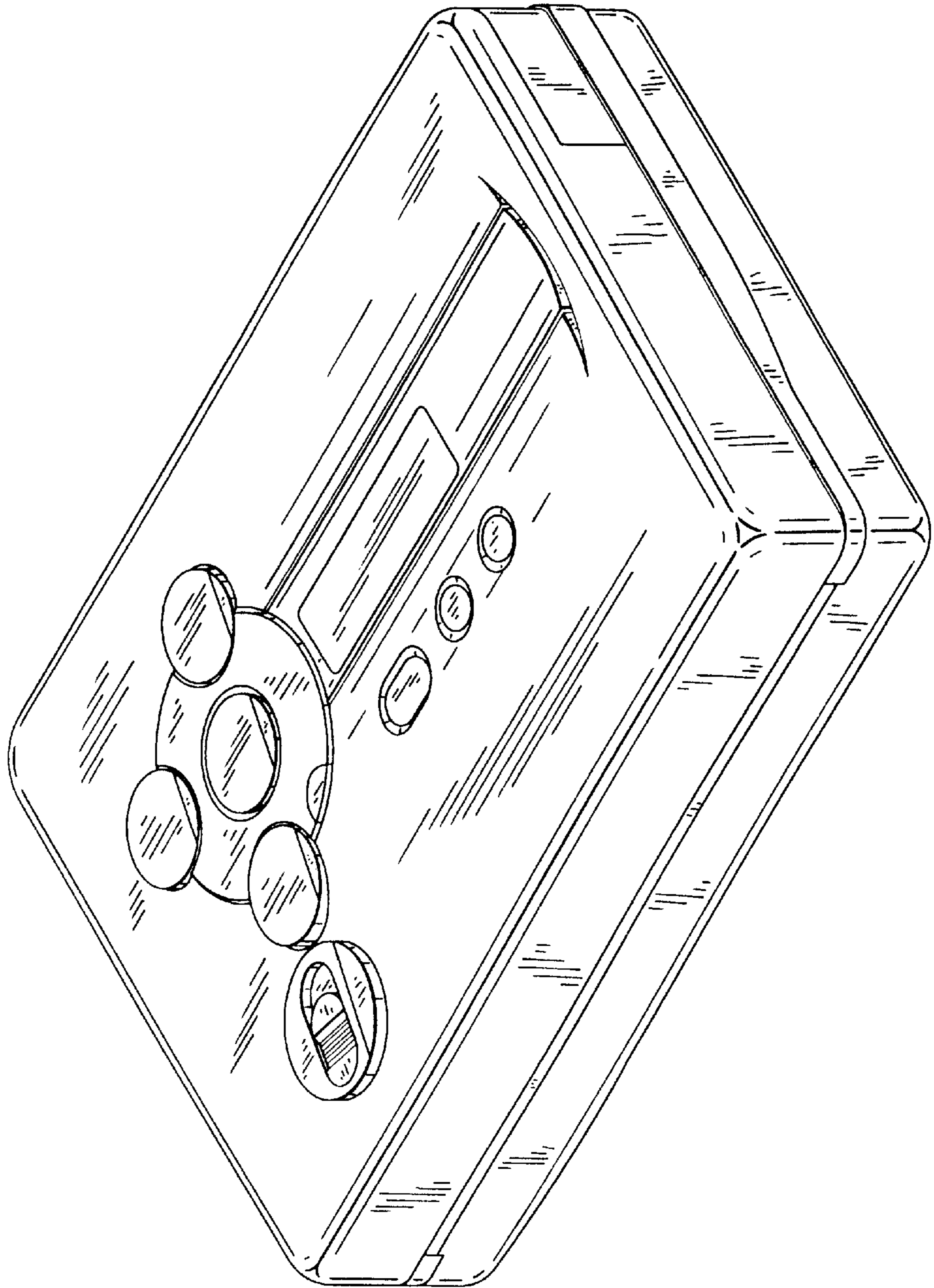

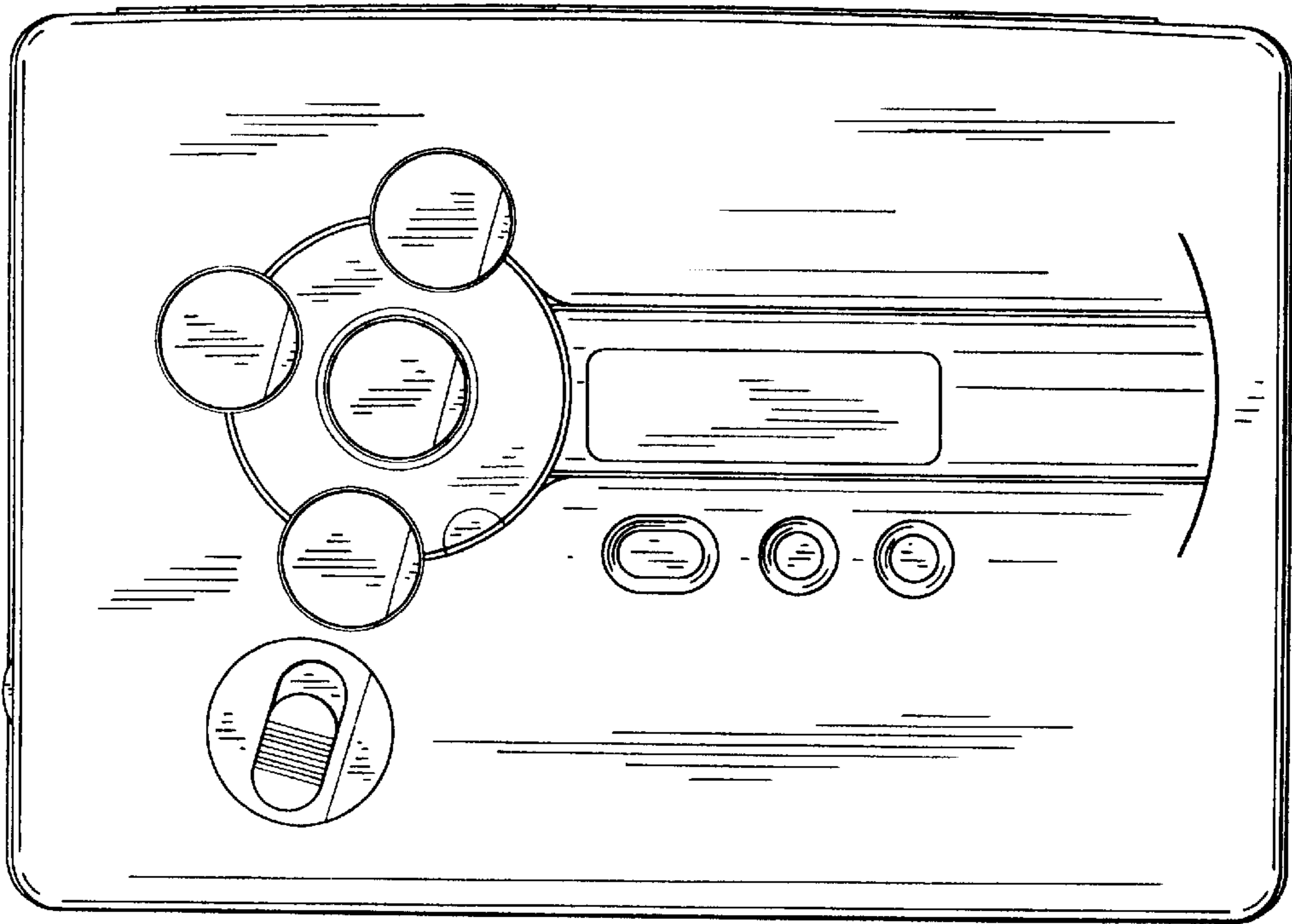

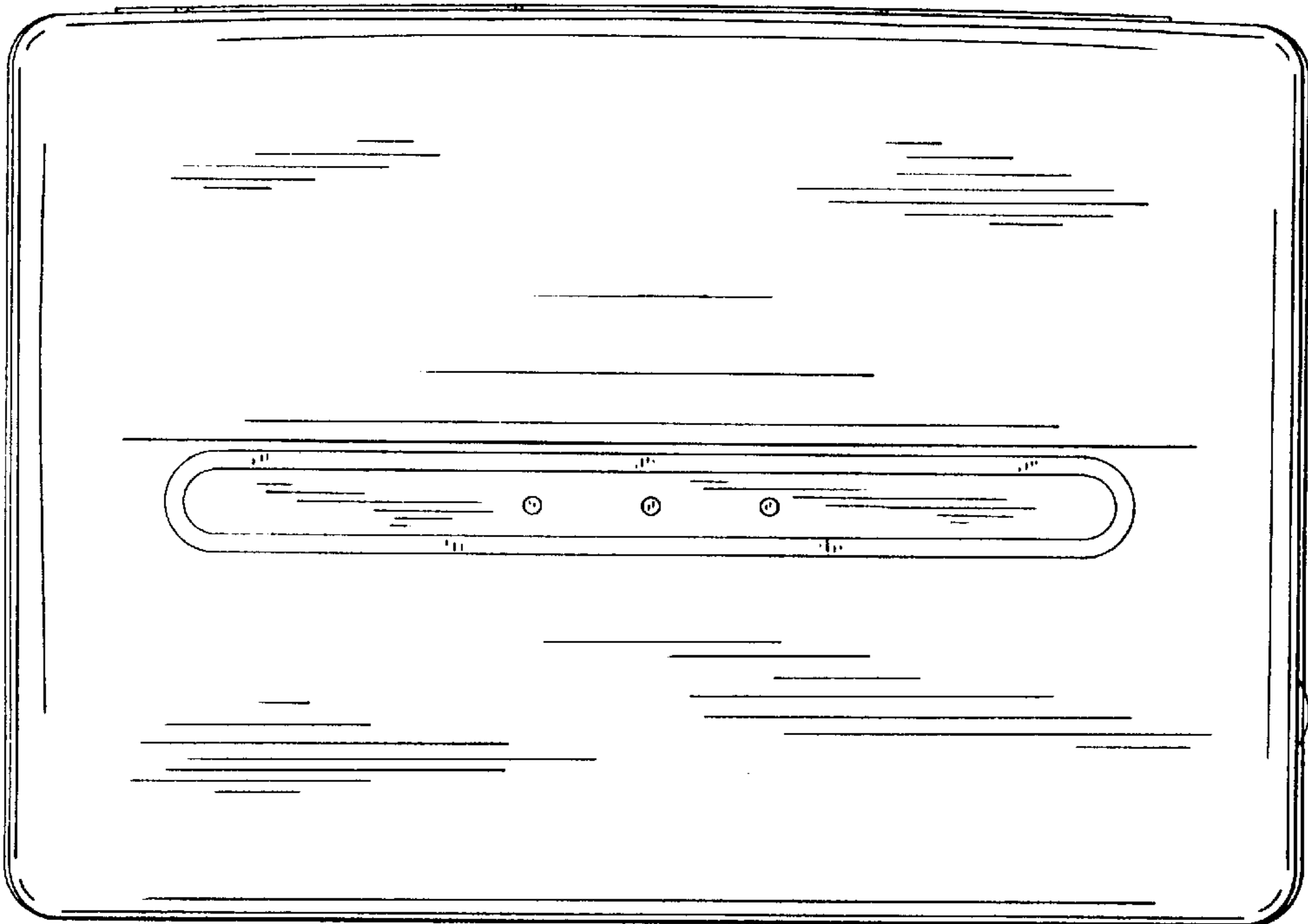

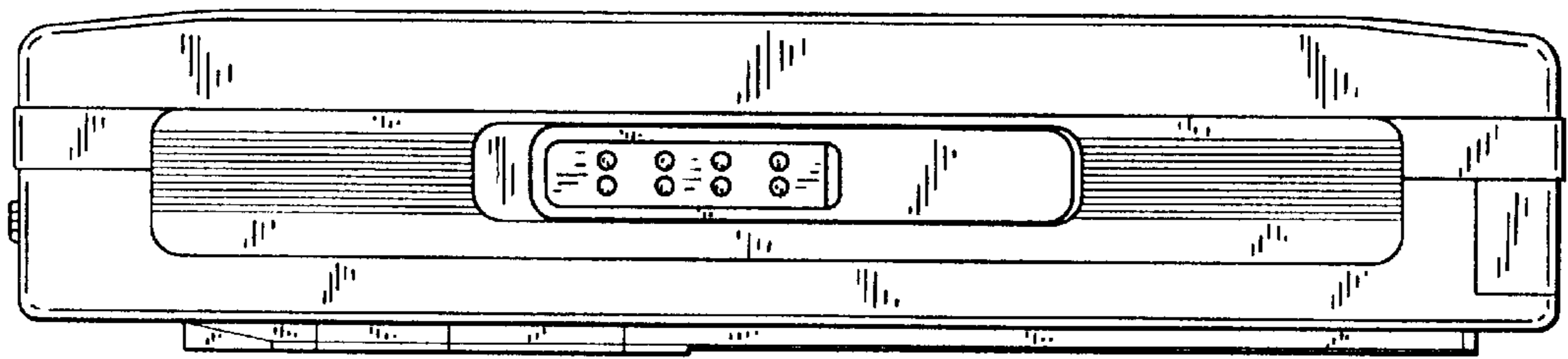

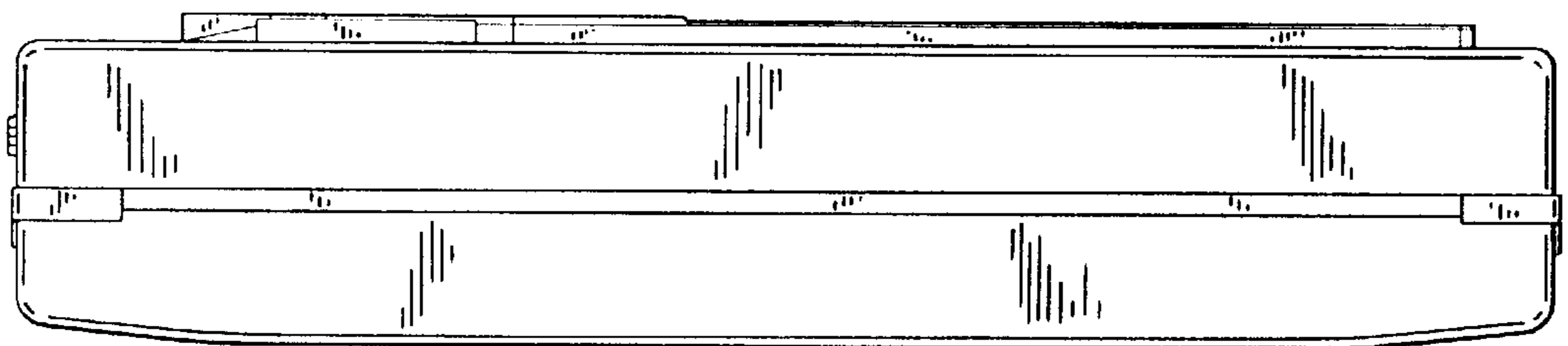

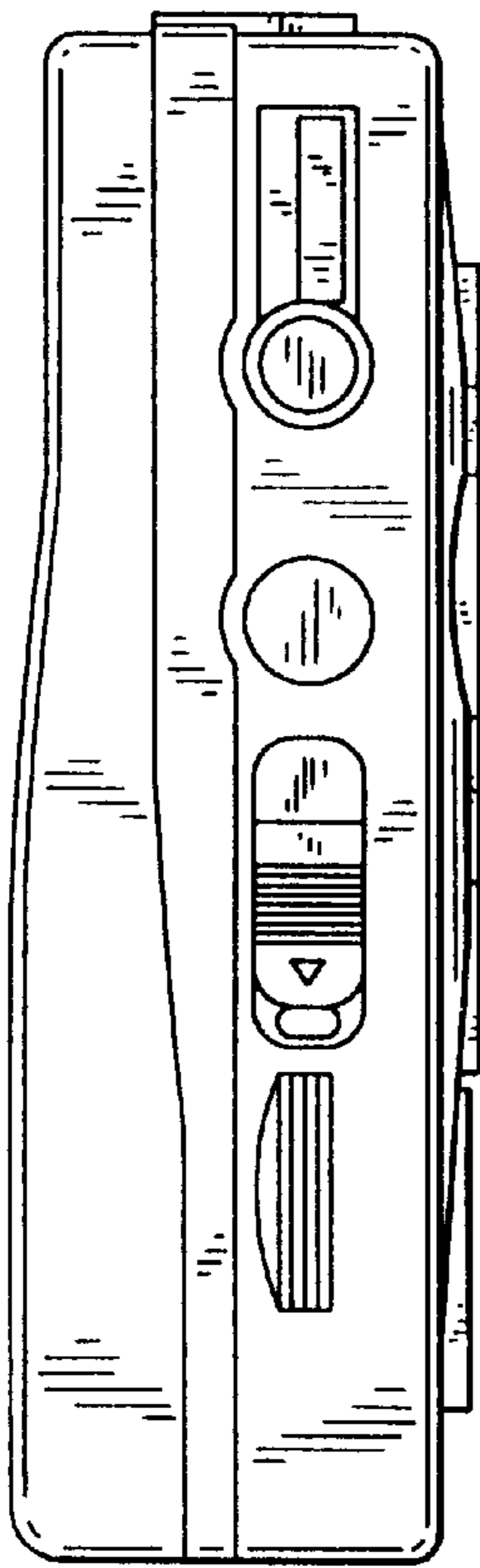

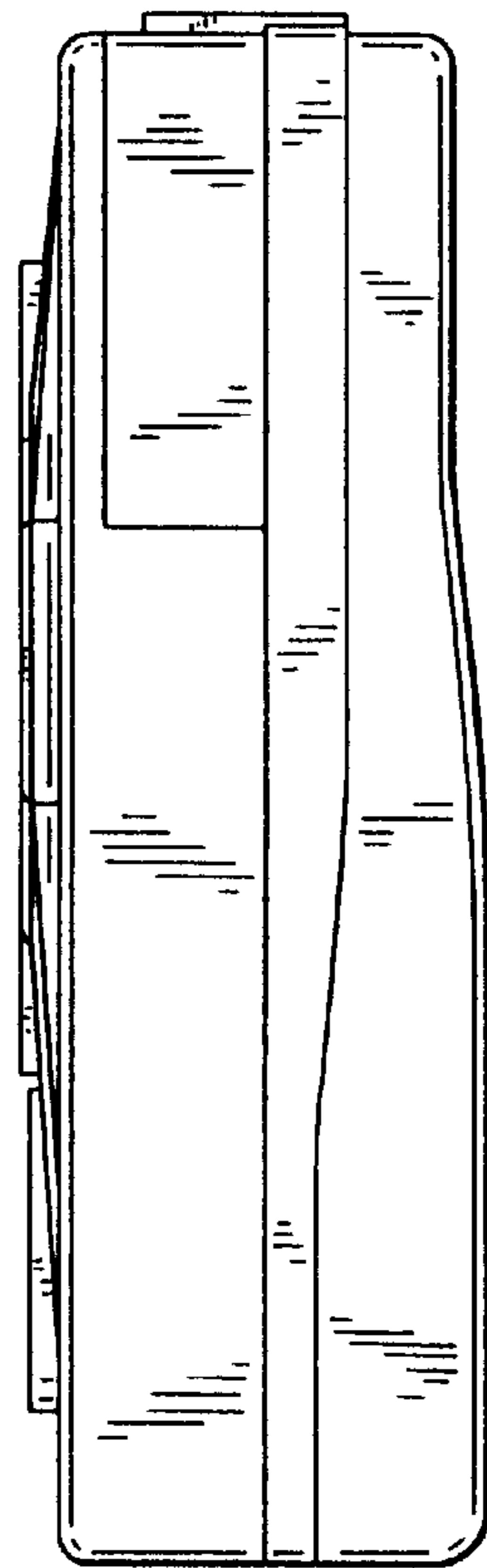
