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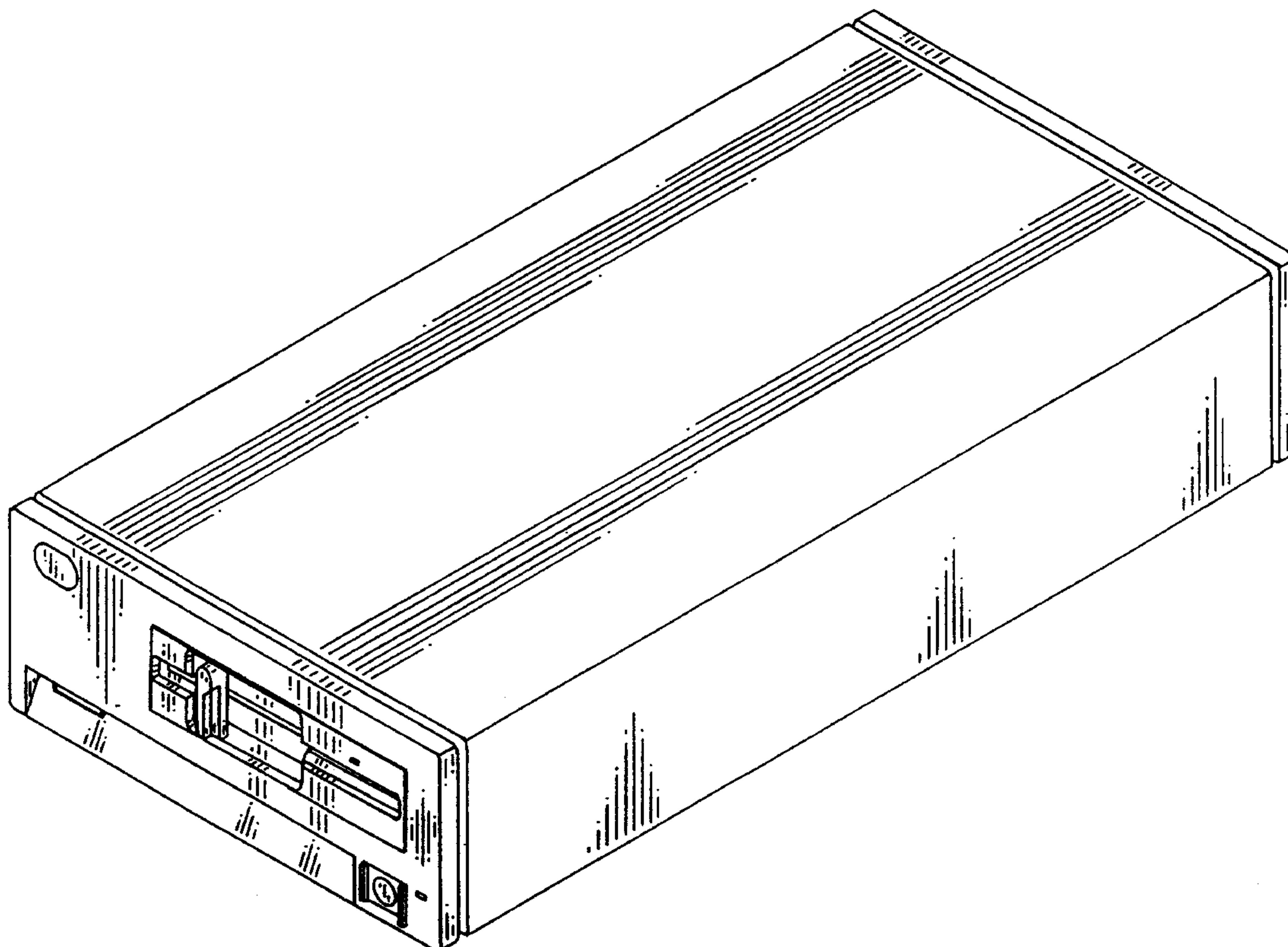
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a disk drive for a data processing system, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side isometric view of a disk drive for a data processing system, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being identical; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

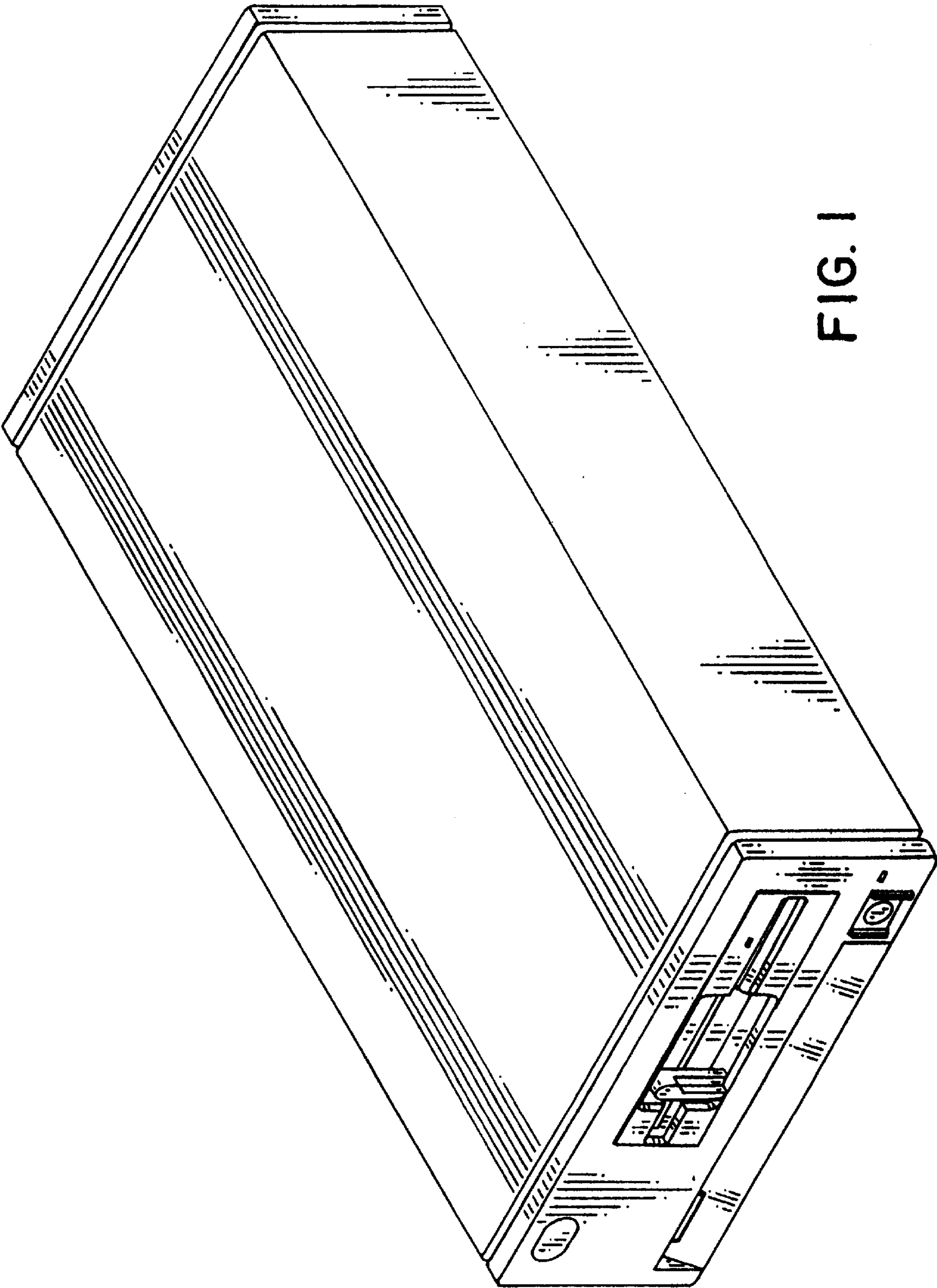

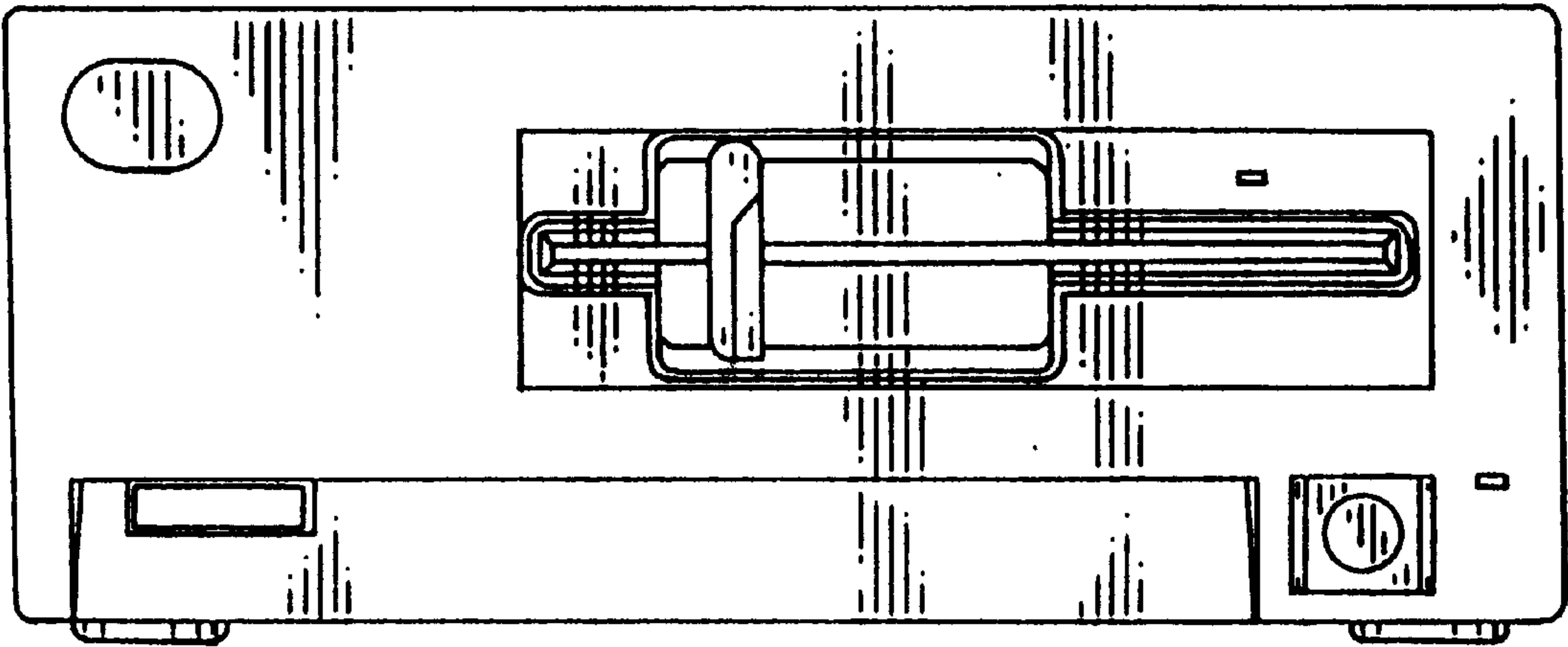

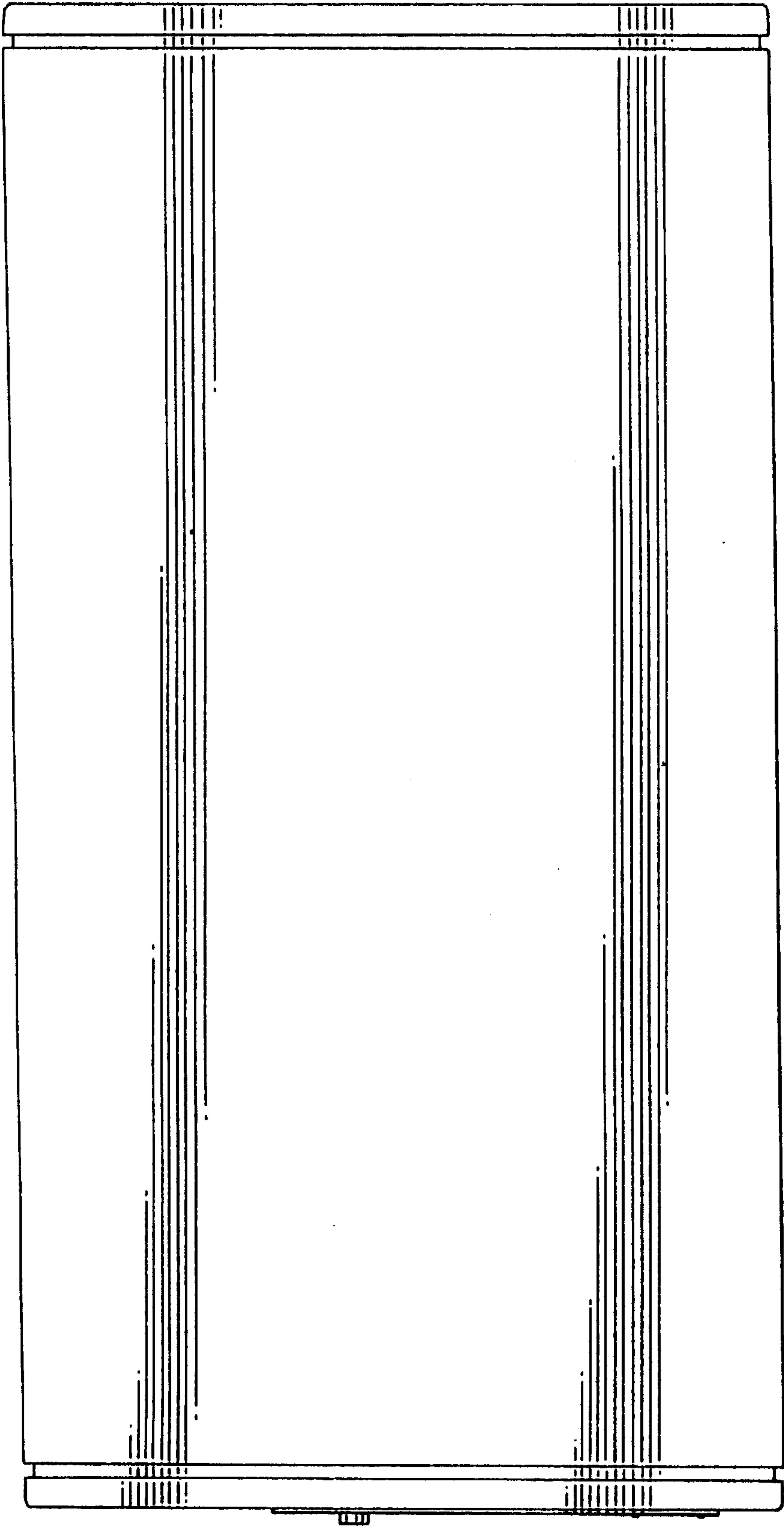

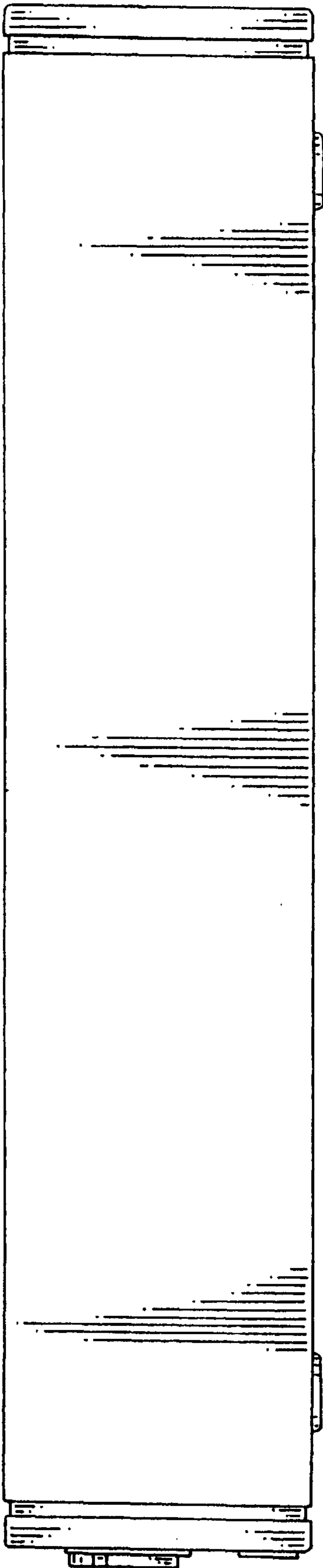

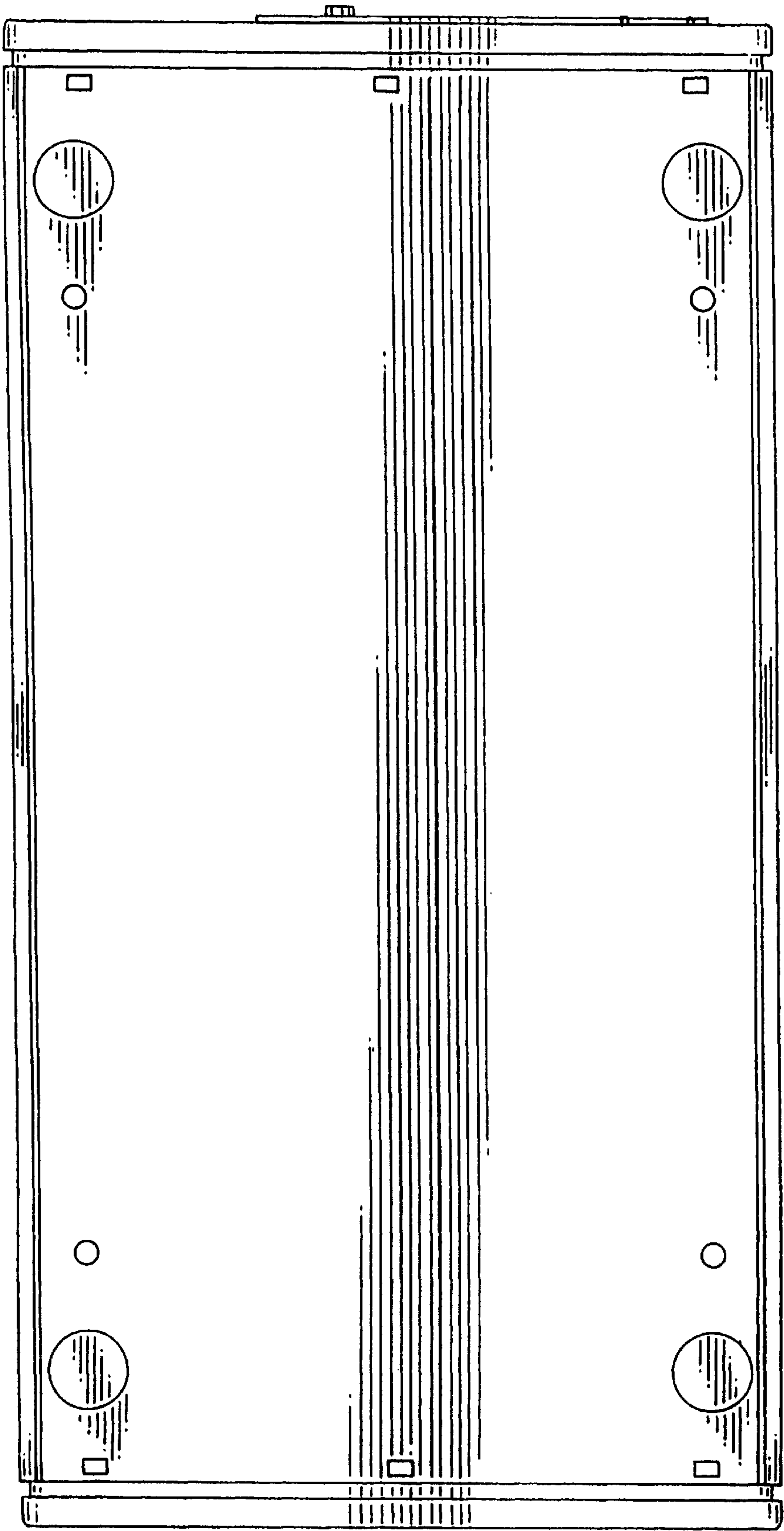

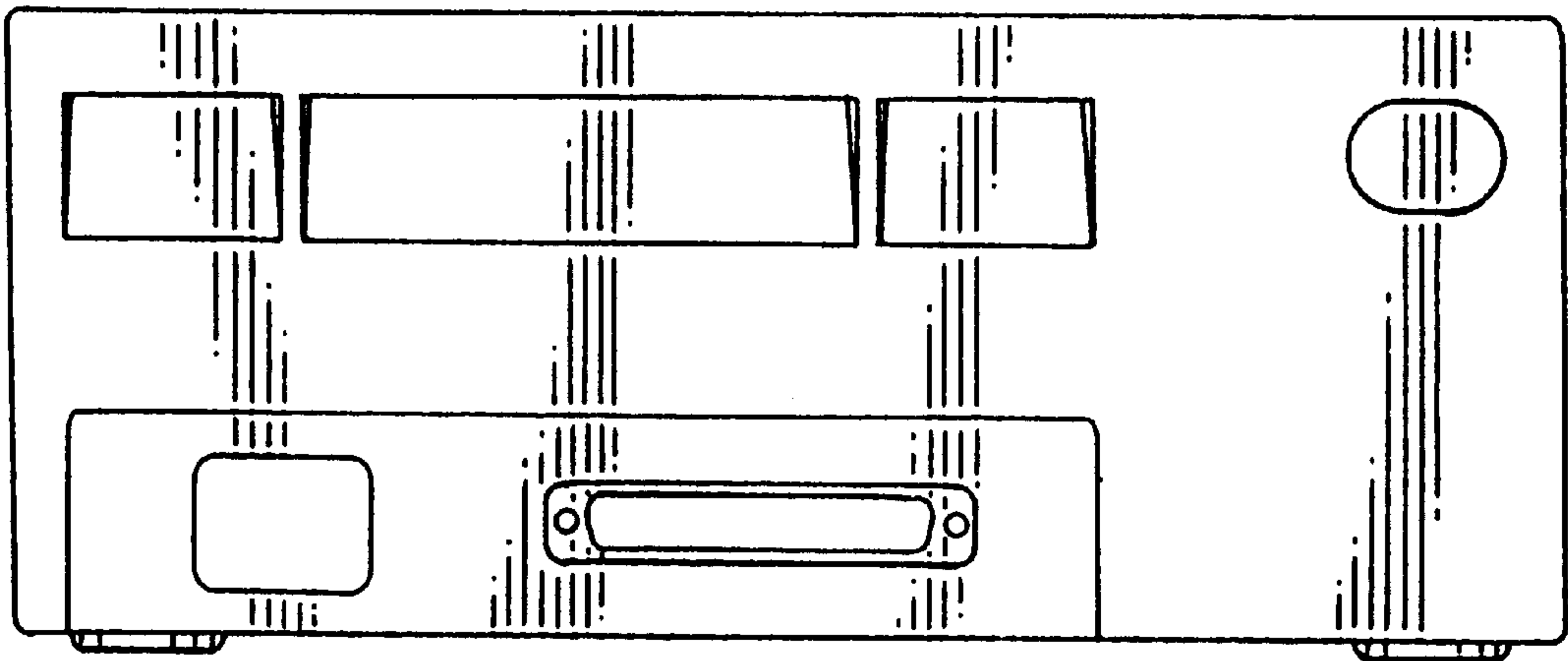
