view thereof being a mirror image of the side shown;

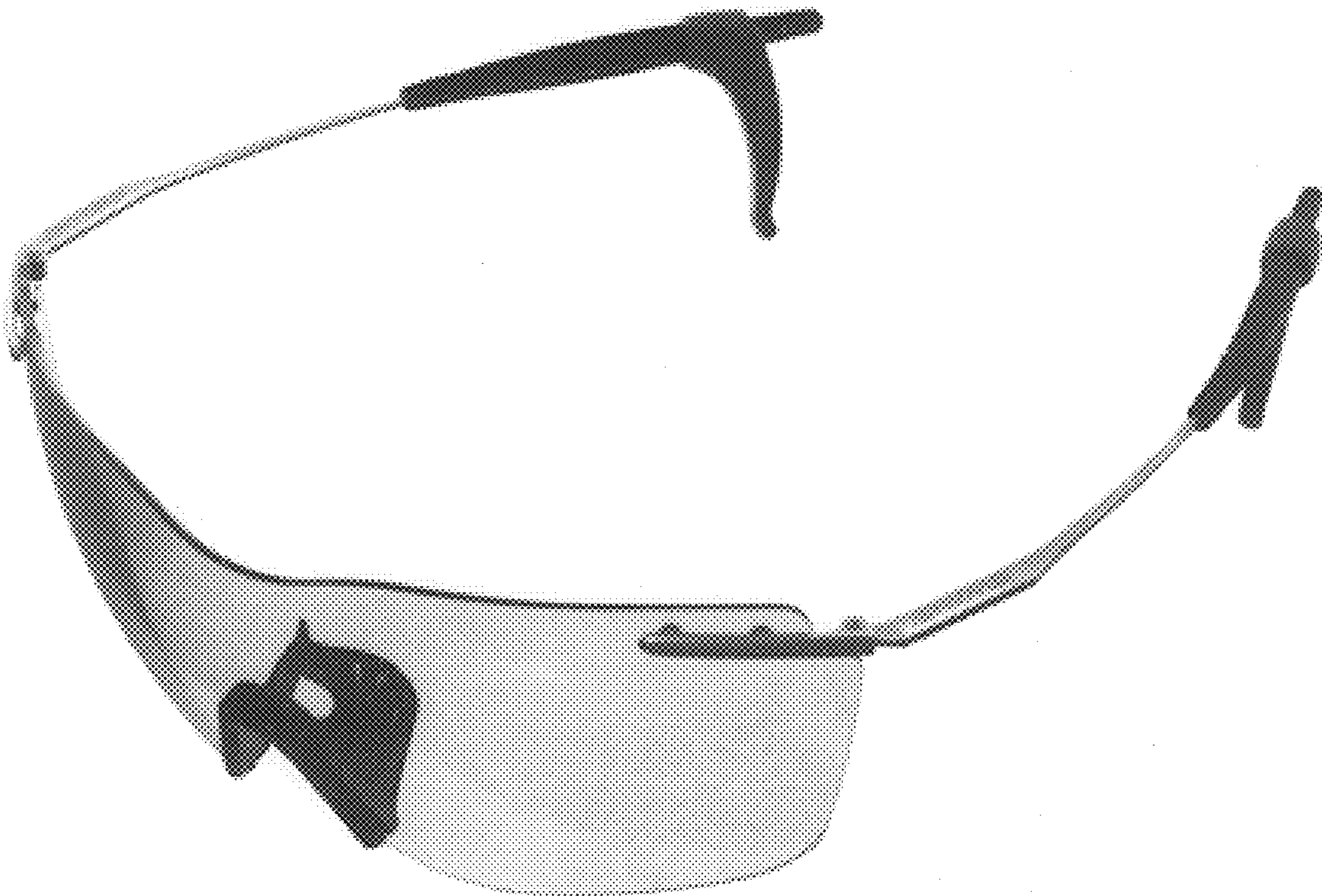
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

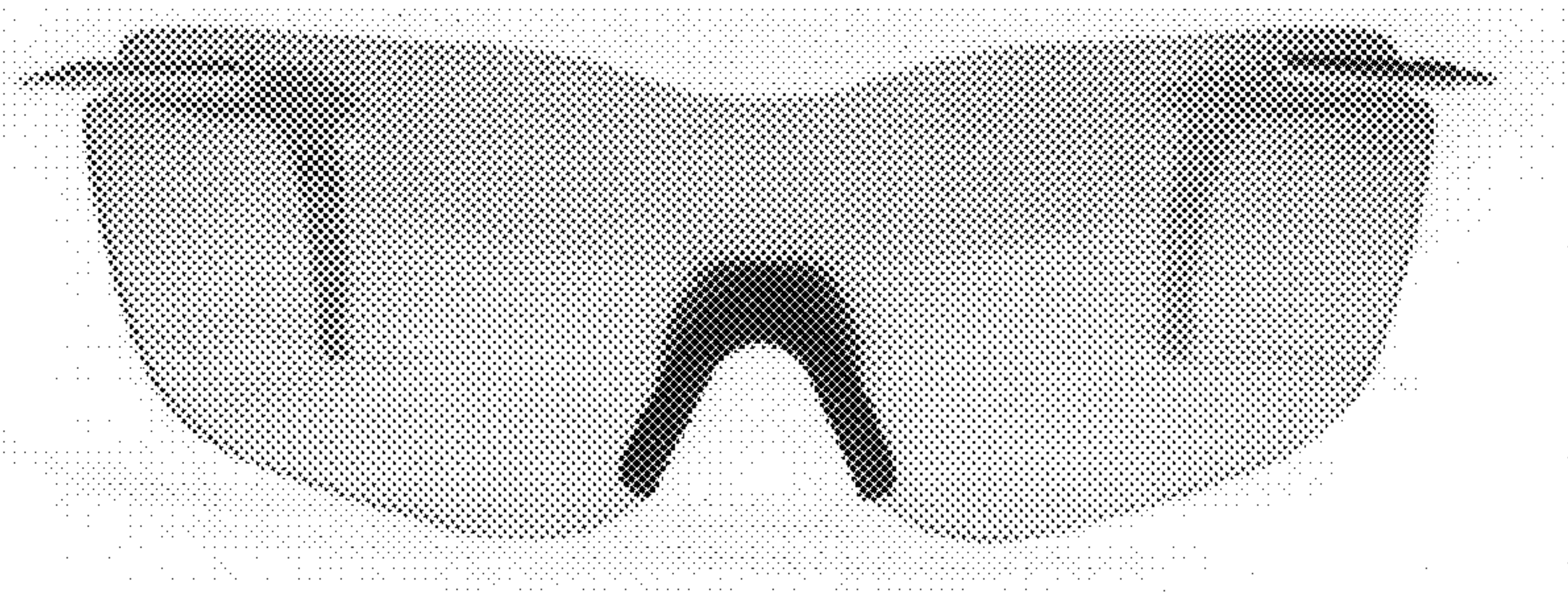

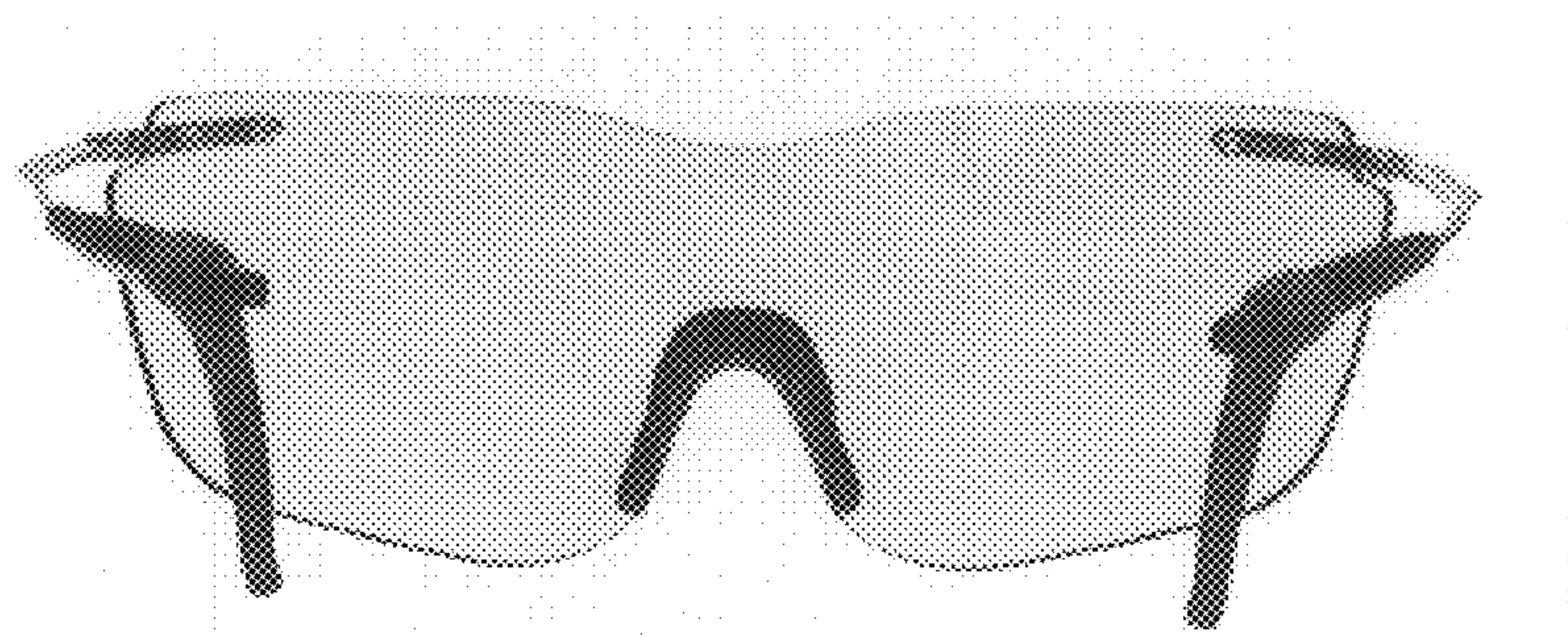

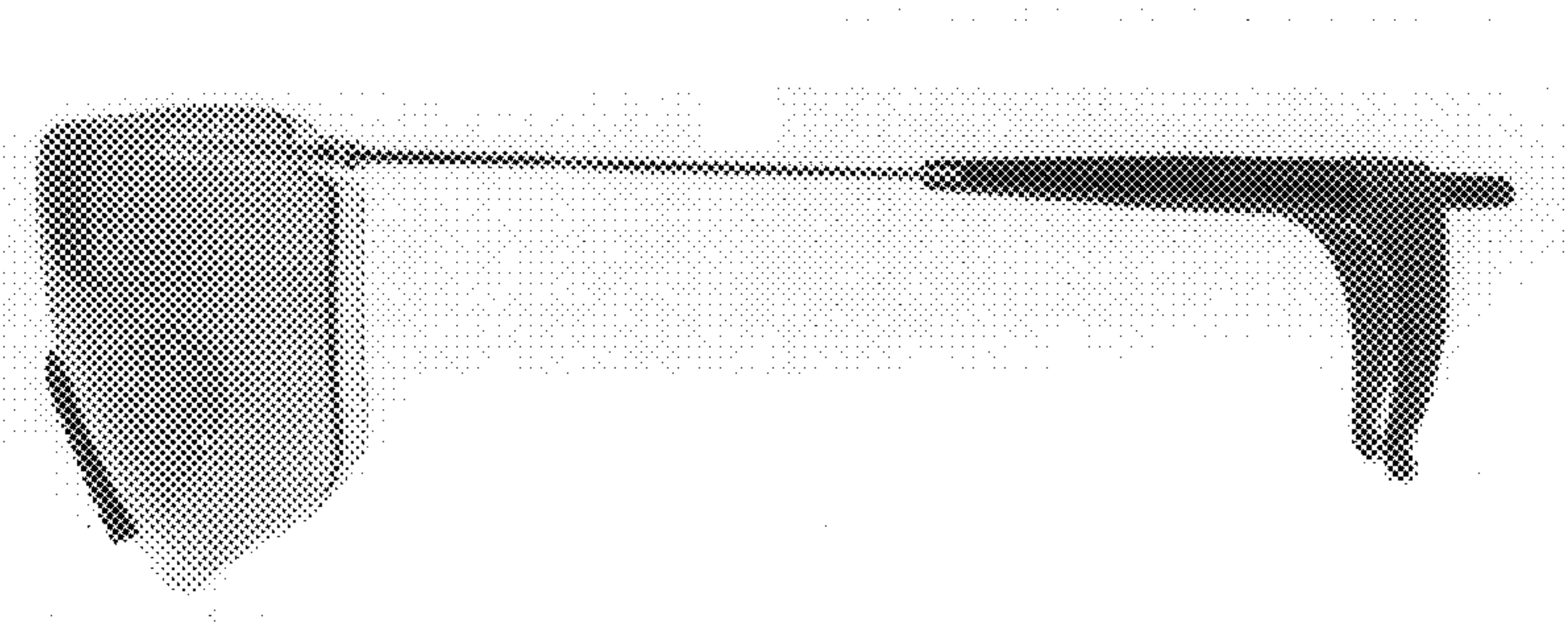

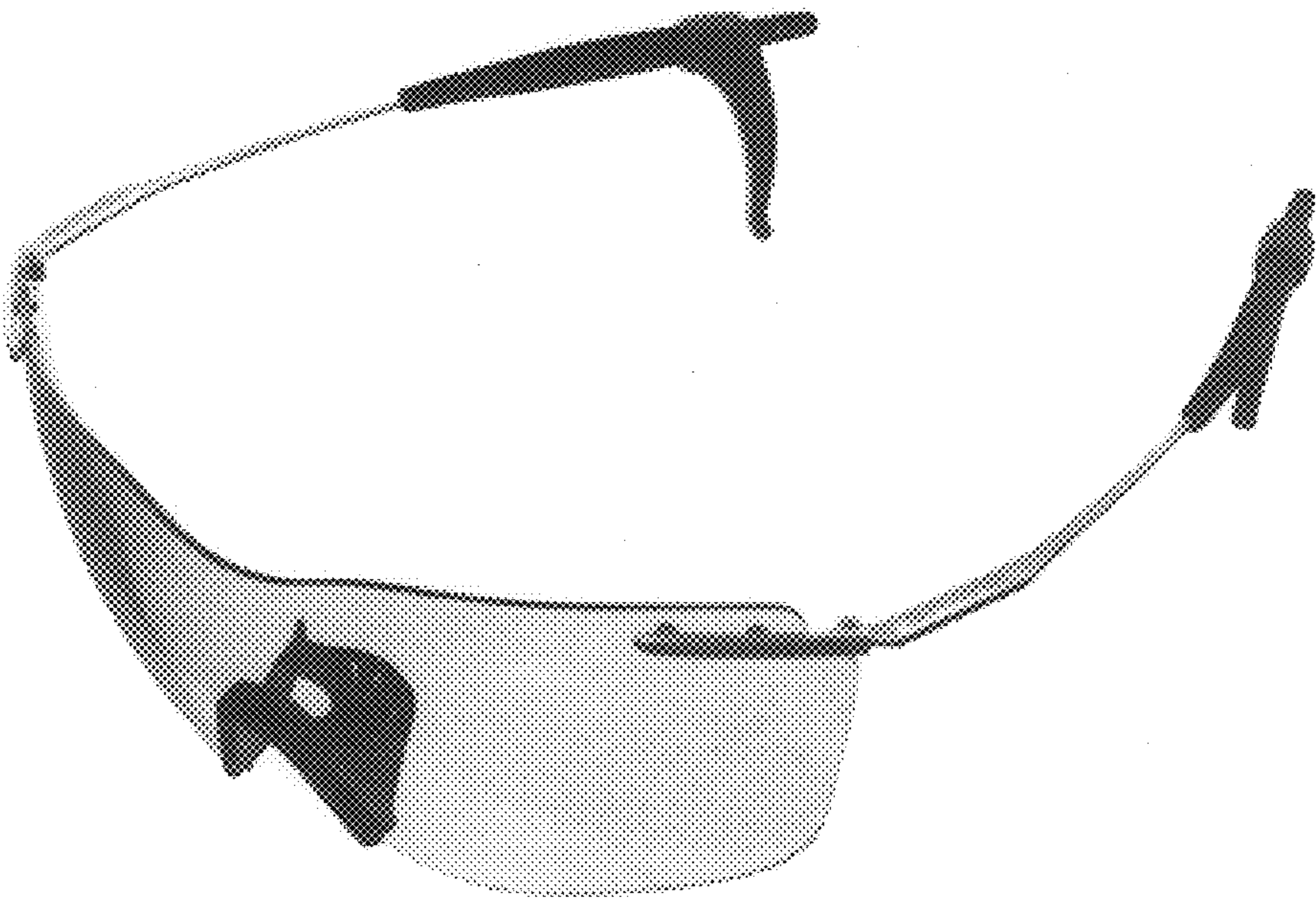

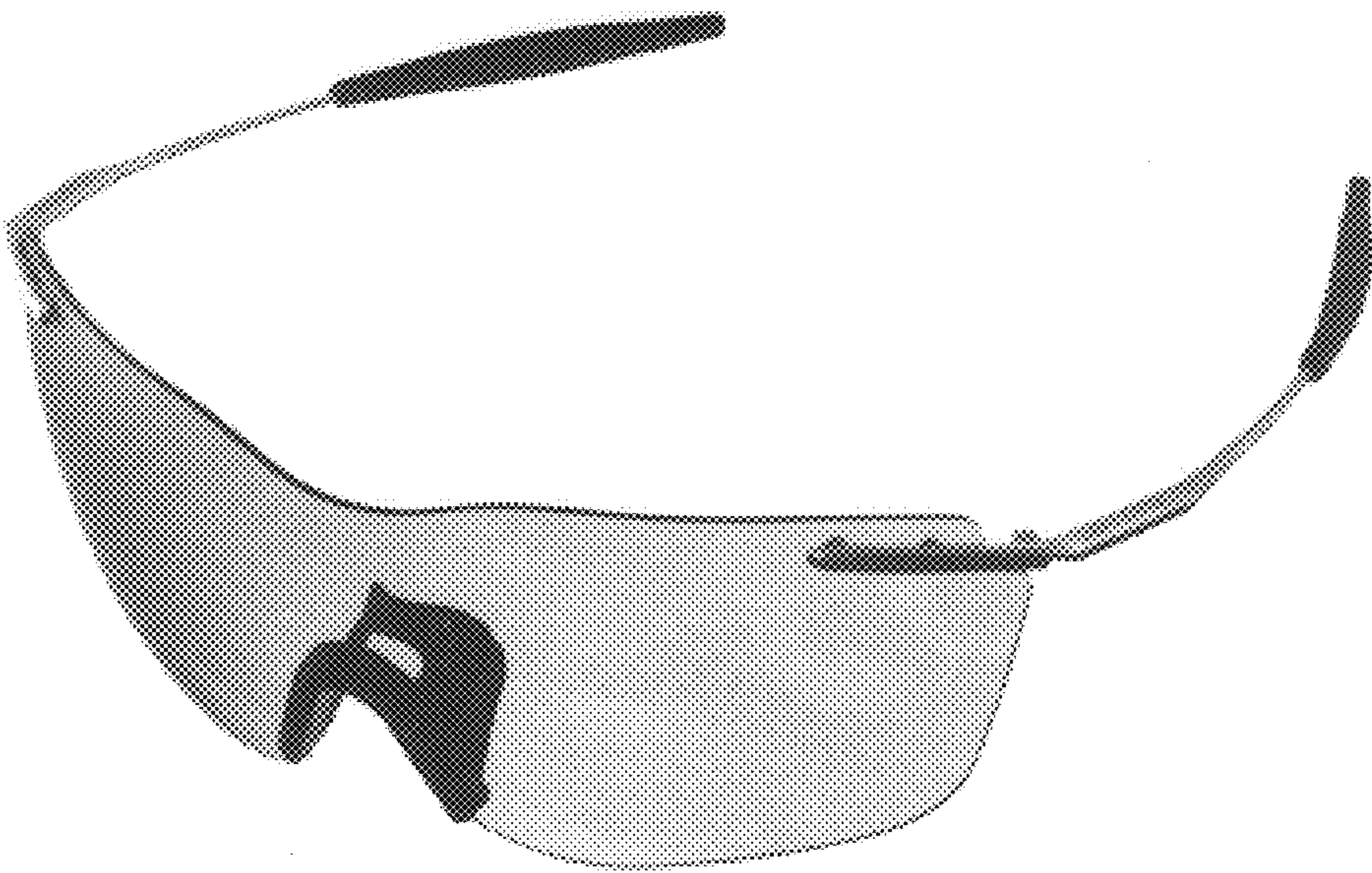
