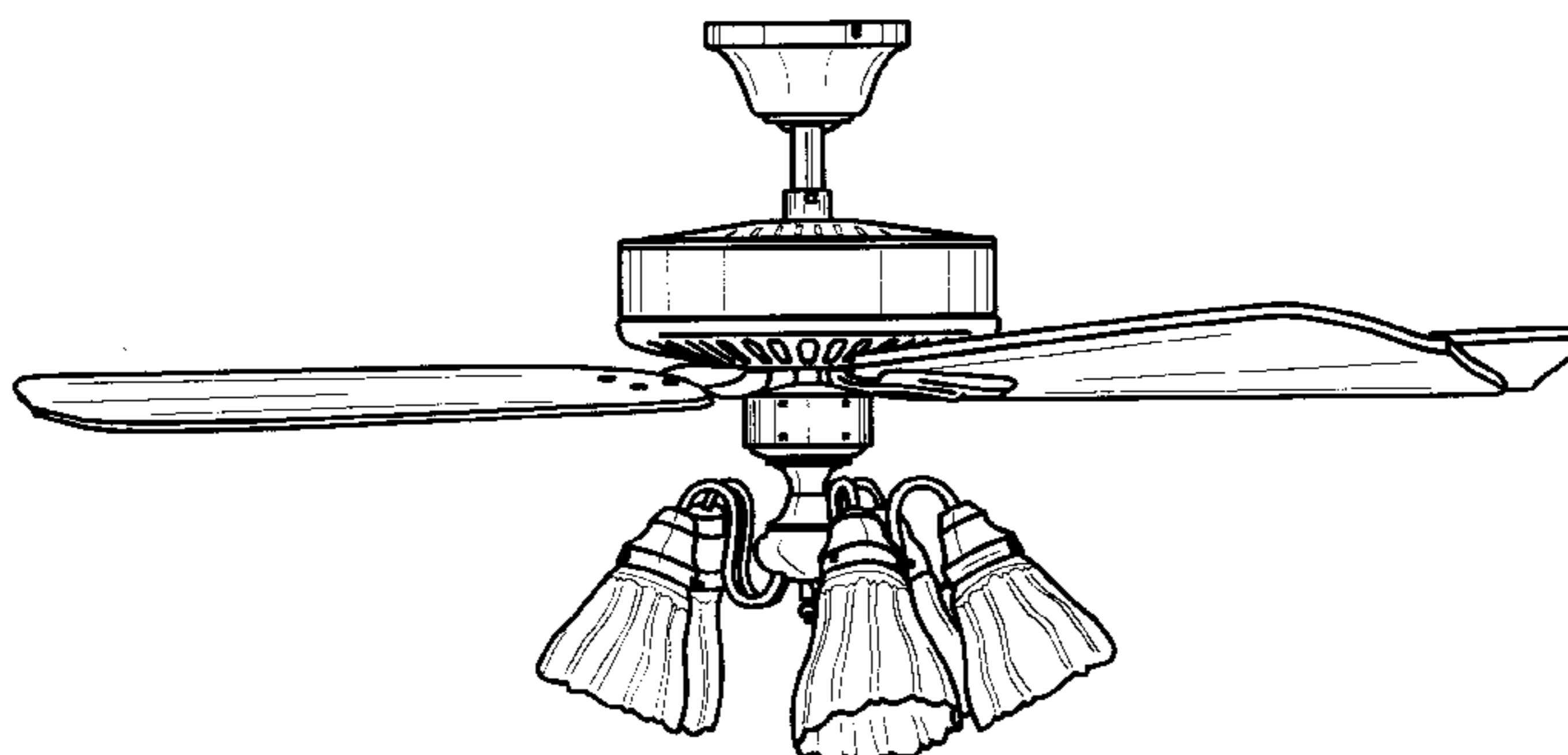
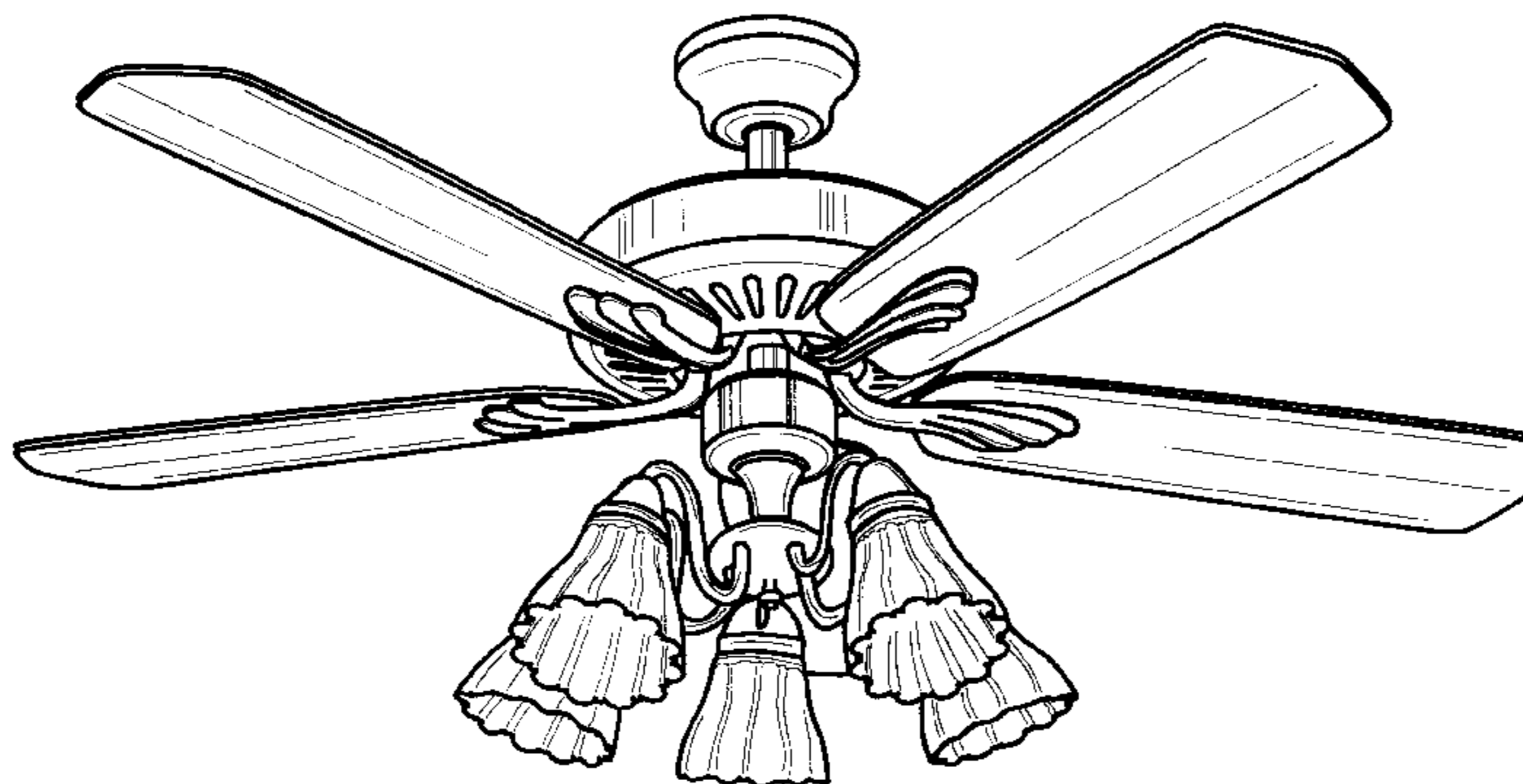
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the ceiling fan described in FIG. 1; and,

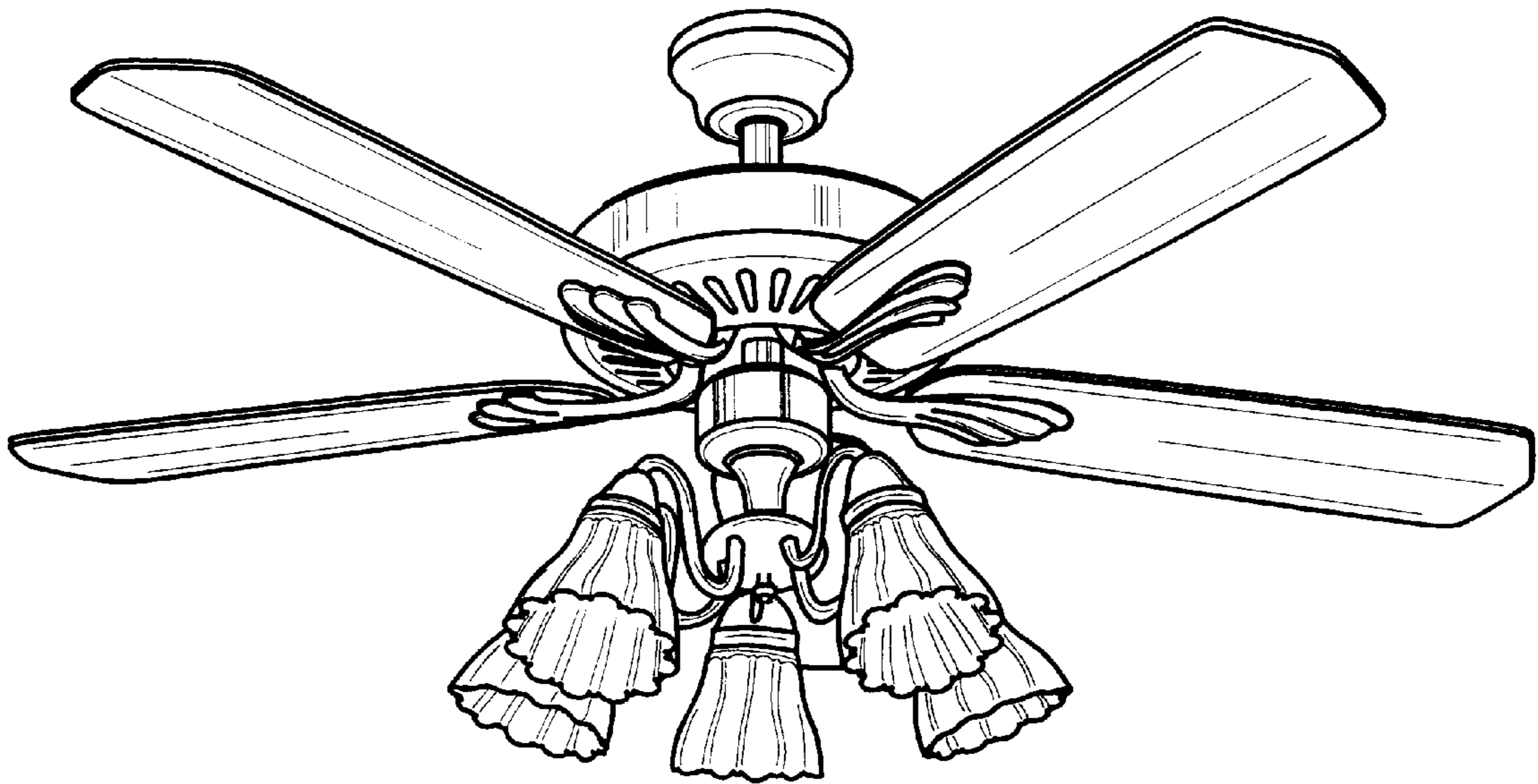

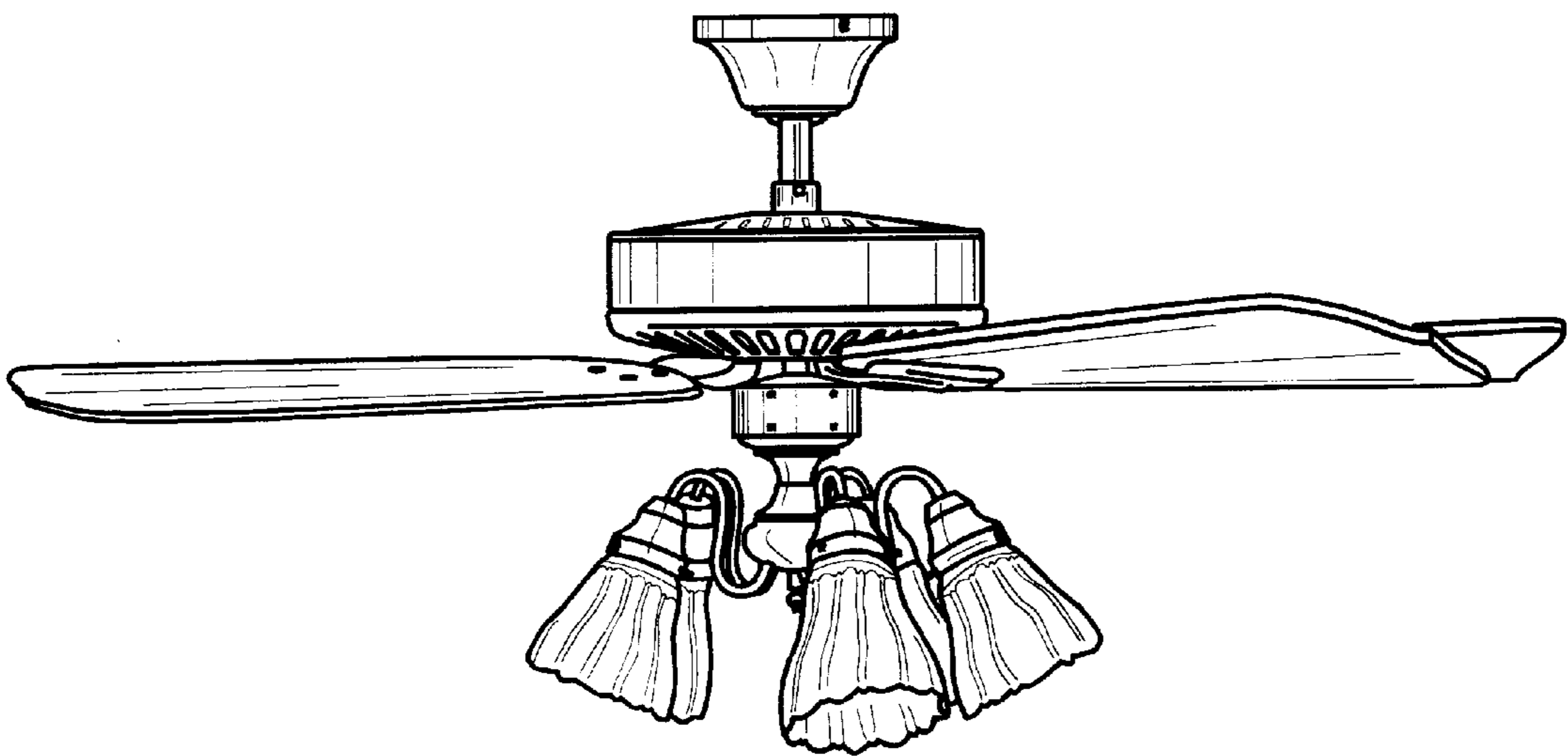

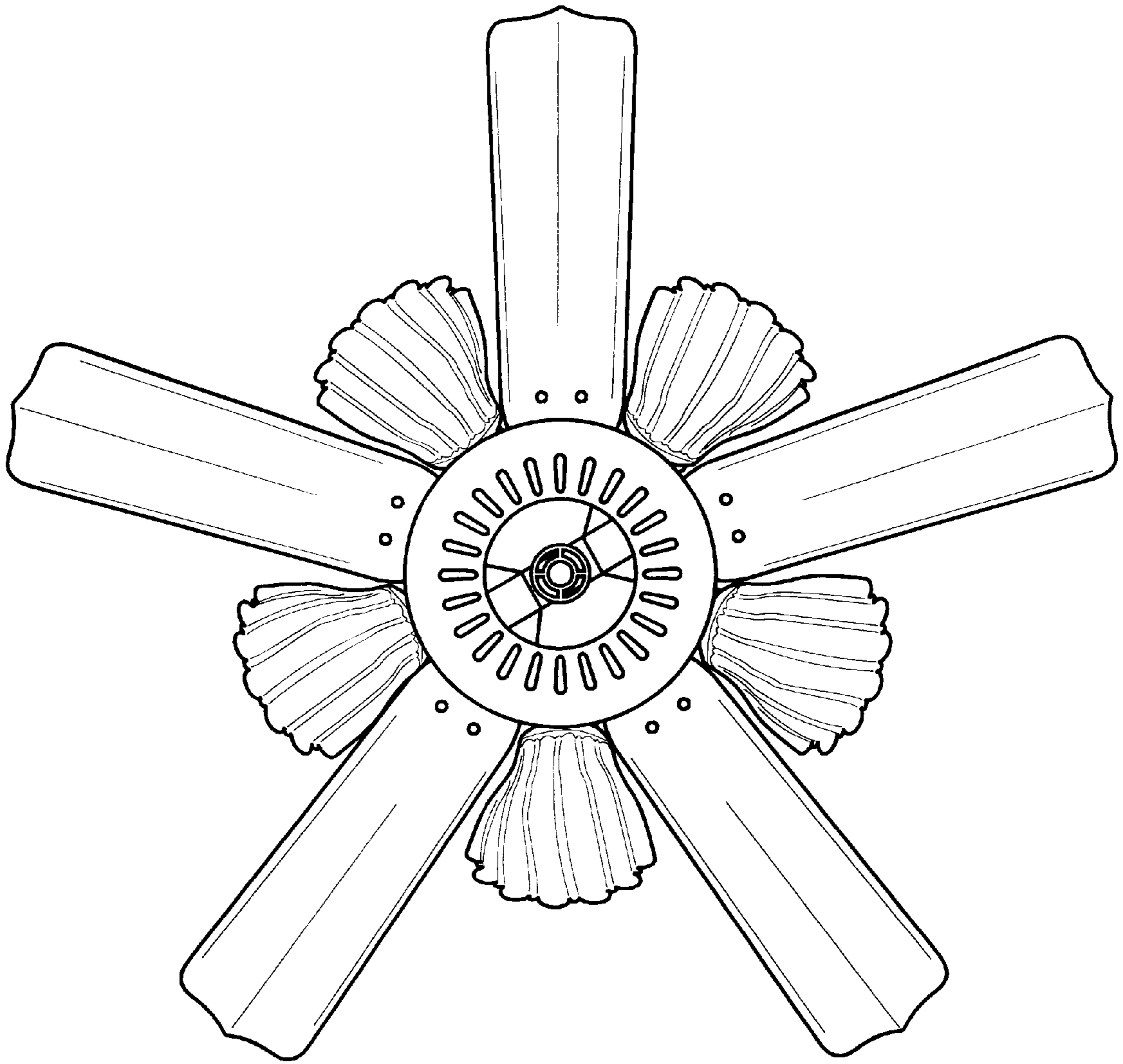

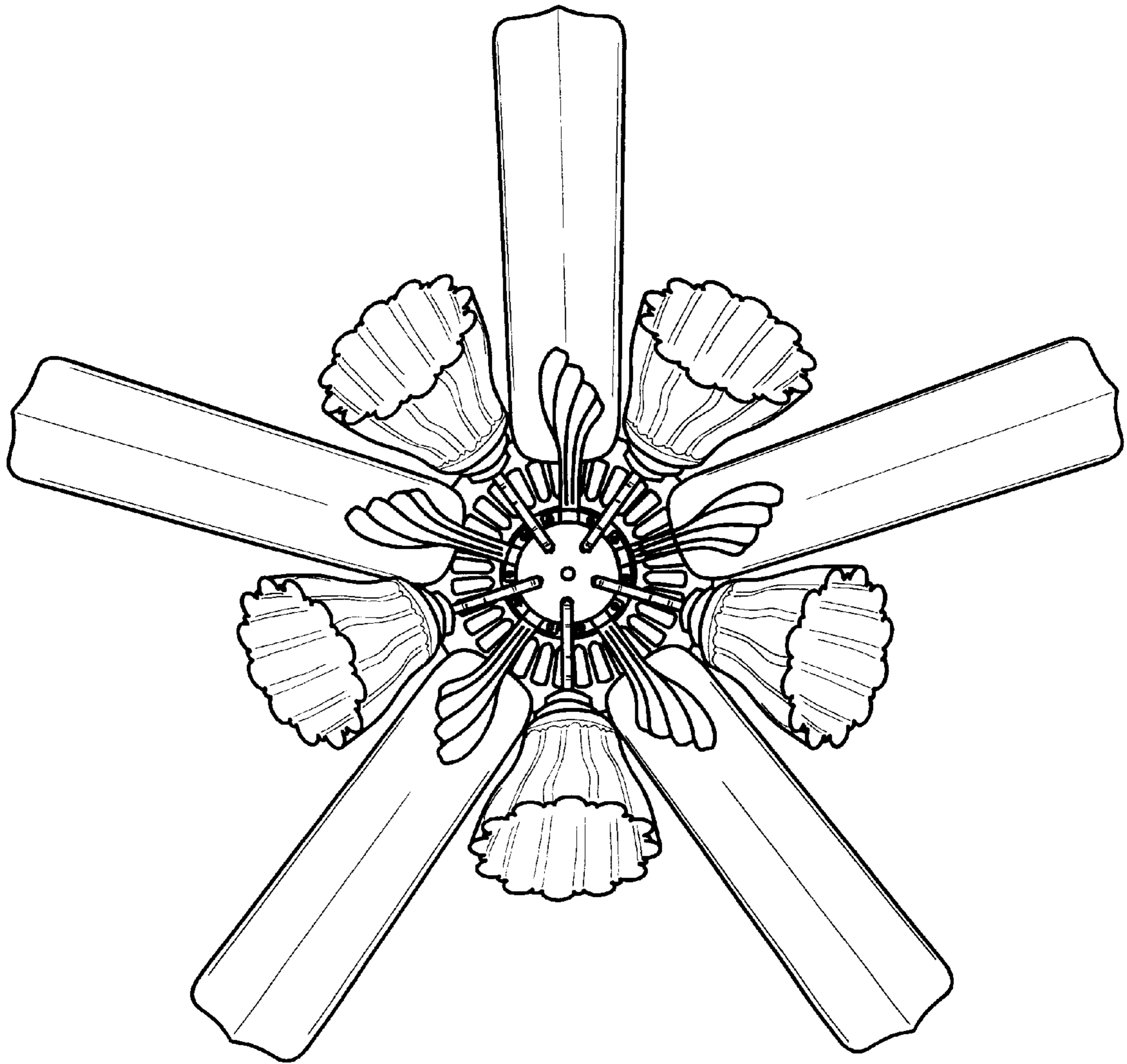
