FIG. 3 is a side view thereof;

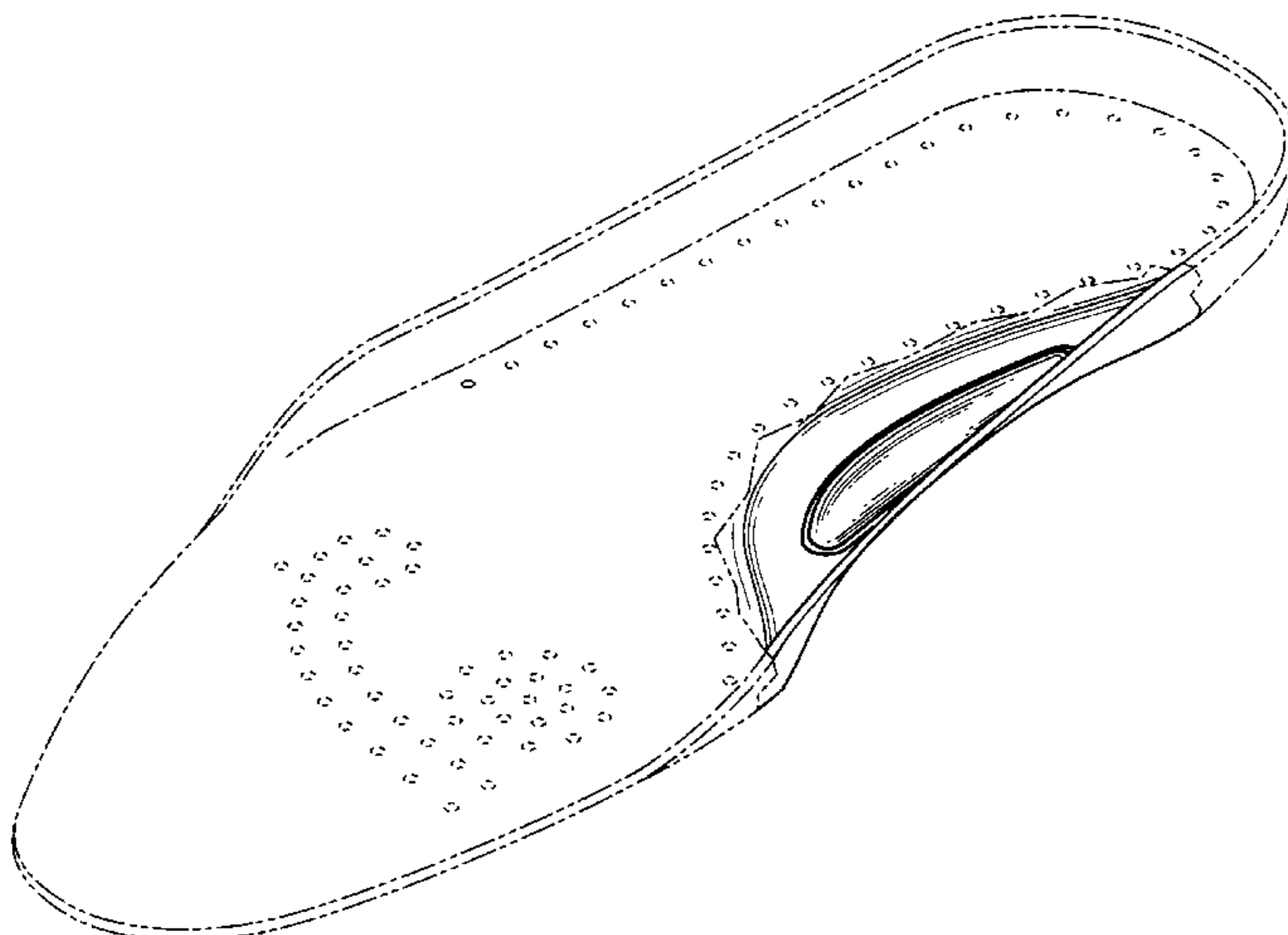
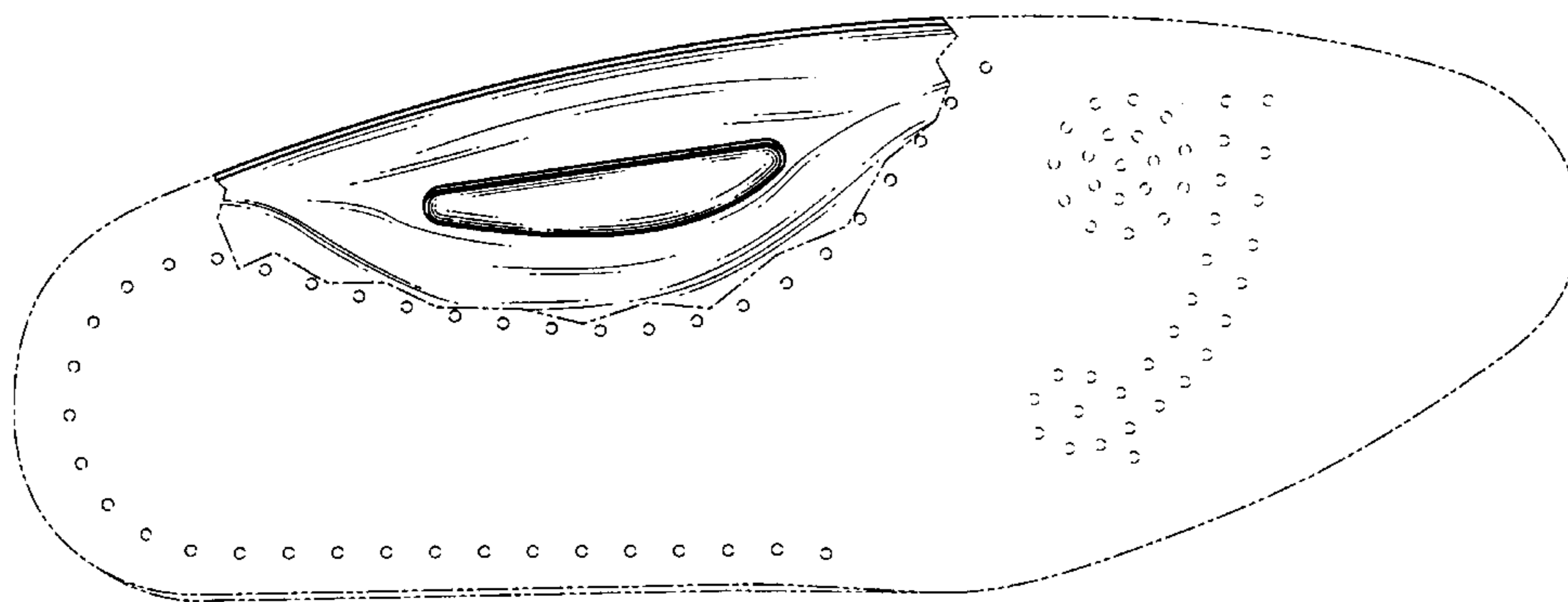
FIG. 4 is a perspective view from the front, top and side thereof, and,

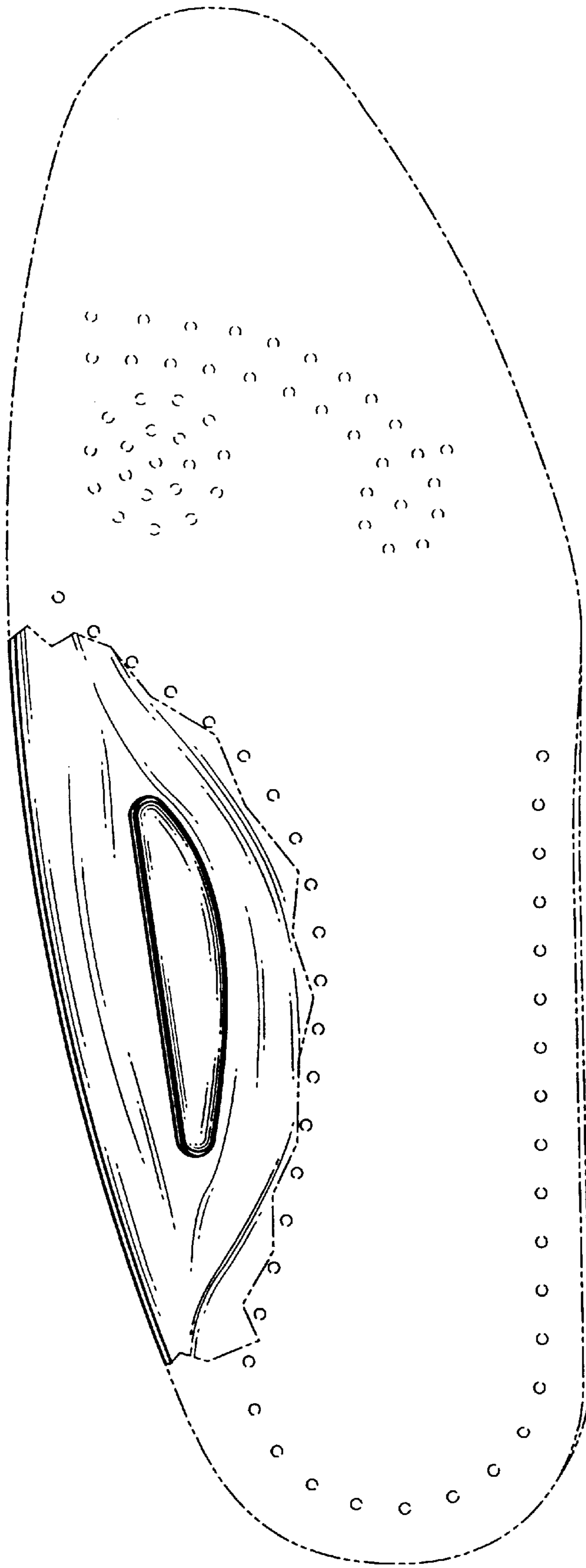

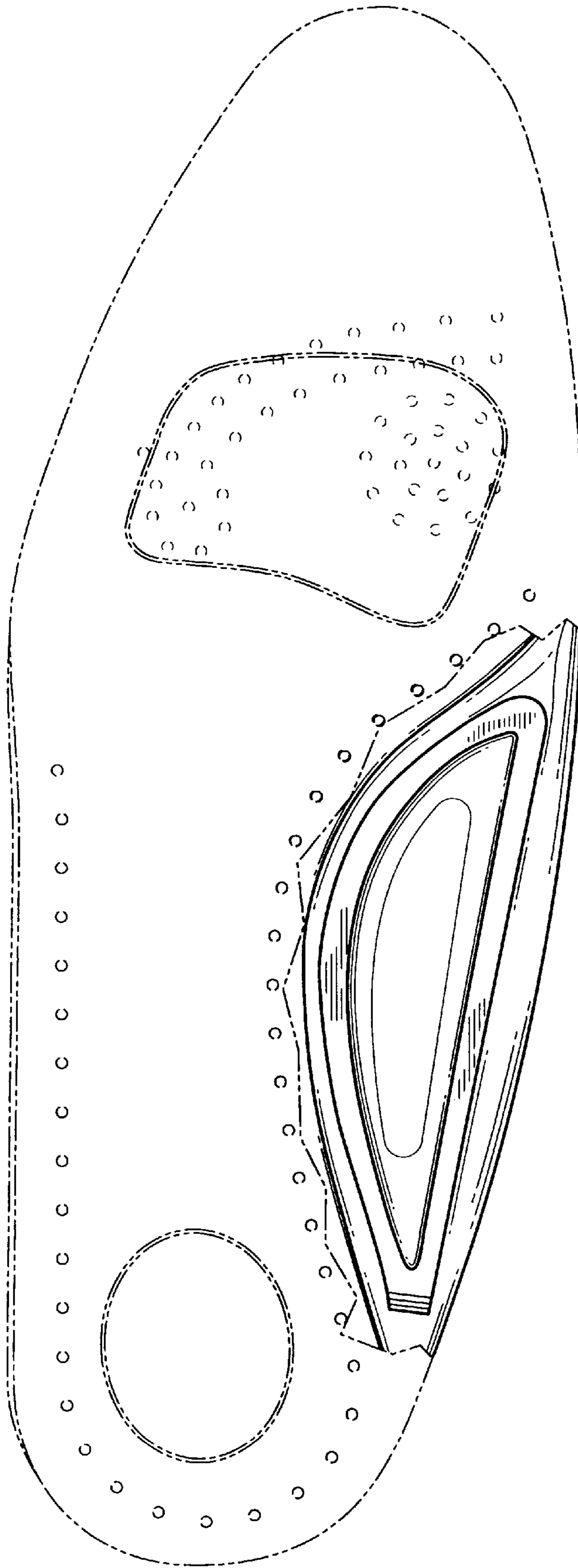

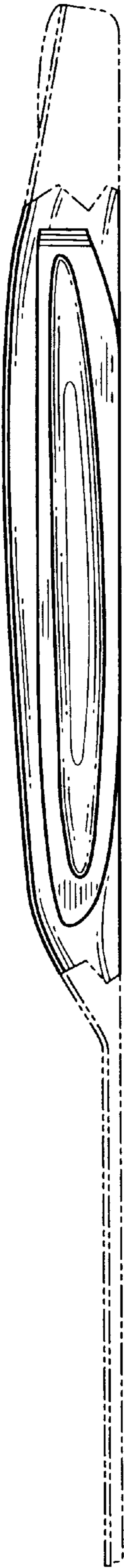

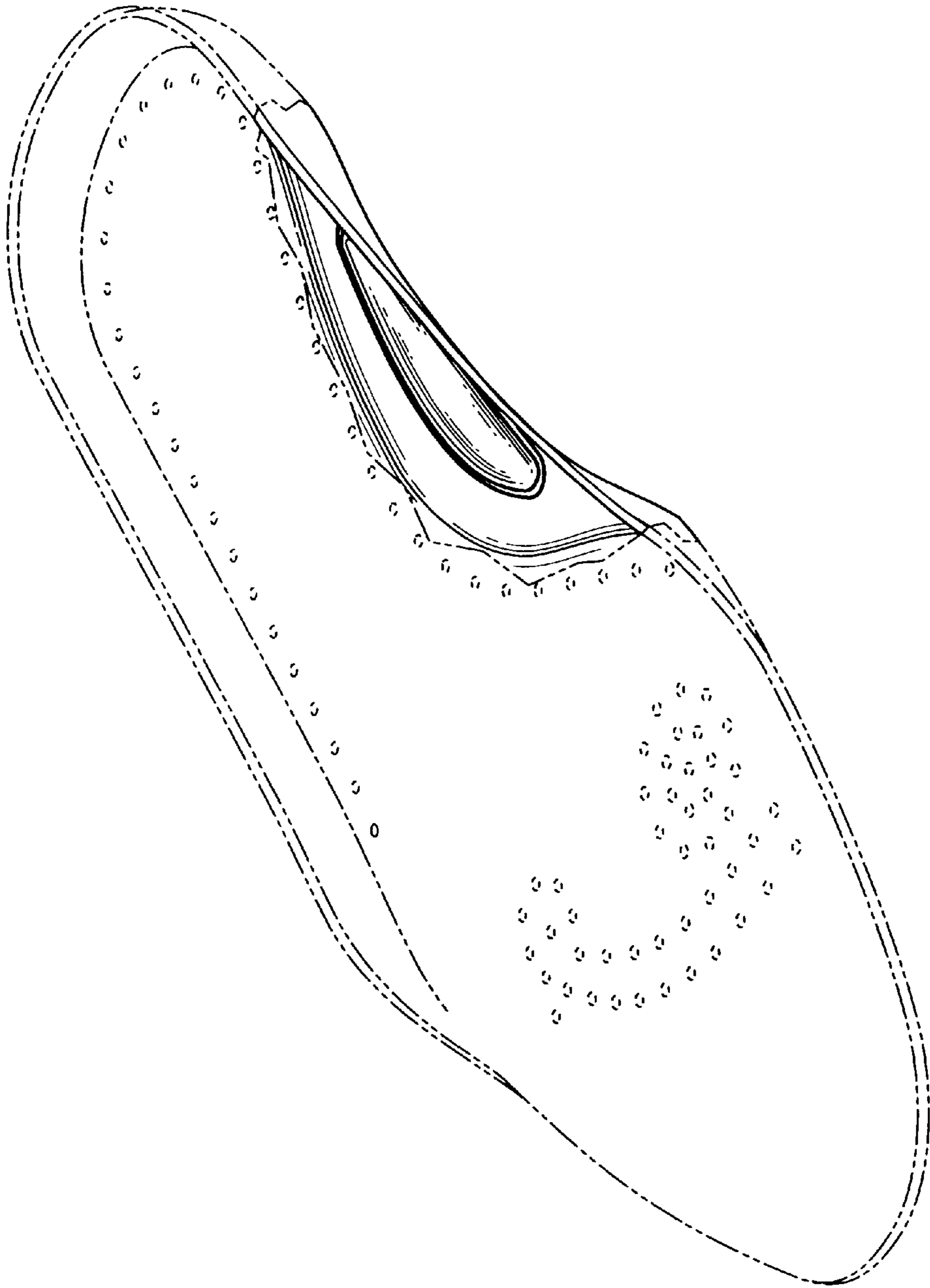

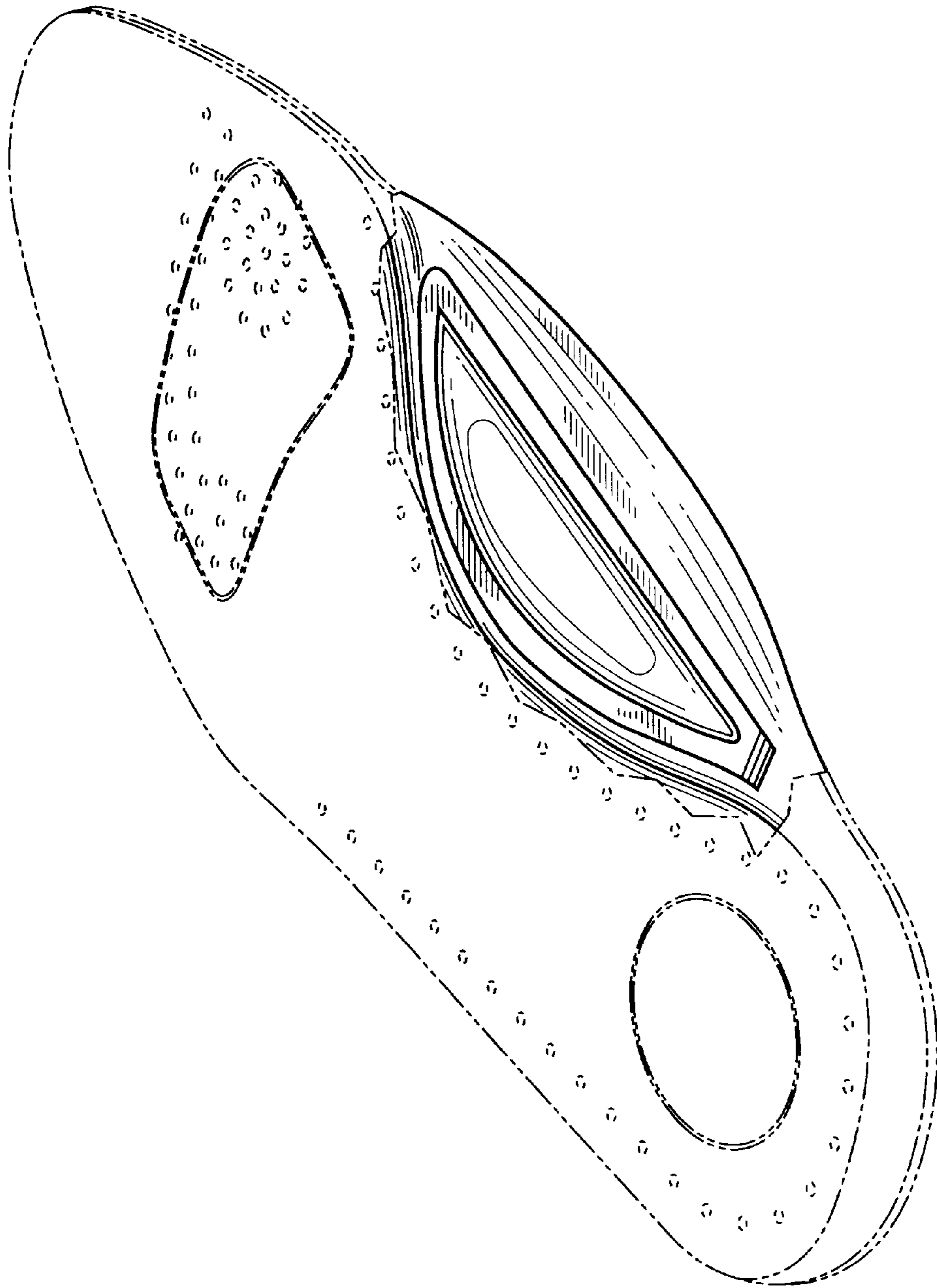
