[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tubular container with magnetic
base for displaying repair parts, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tubular container with
magnetic base for displaying repair parts embodying one
form of my design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view thereof as seen from a plane
indicated by a line 3—3 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a tubular container with
magnetic base for displaying repair parts embodying another
form of my design;

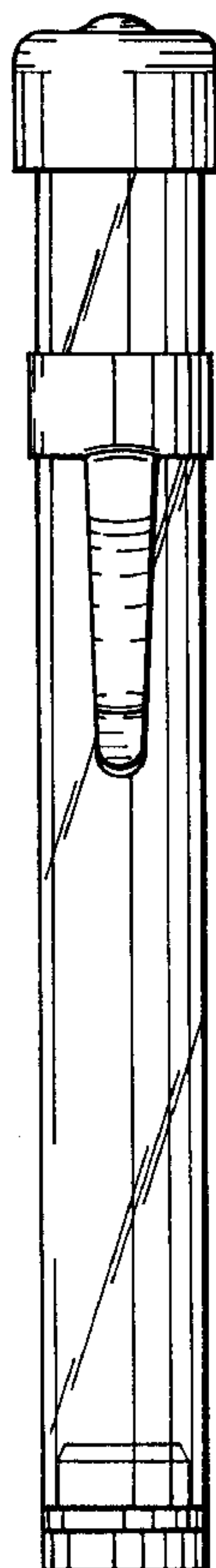
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof;

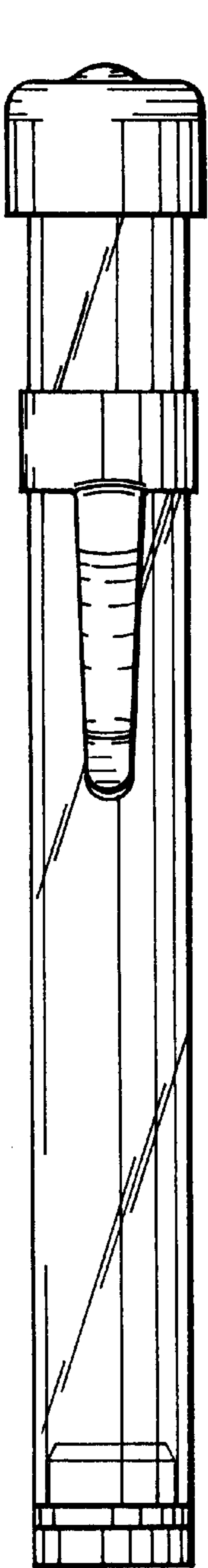

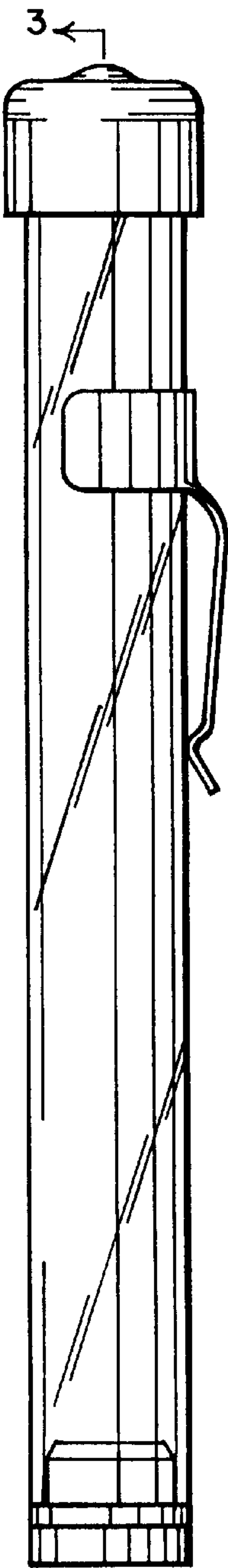

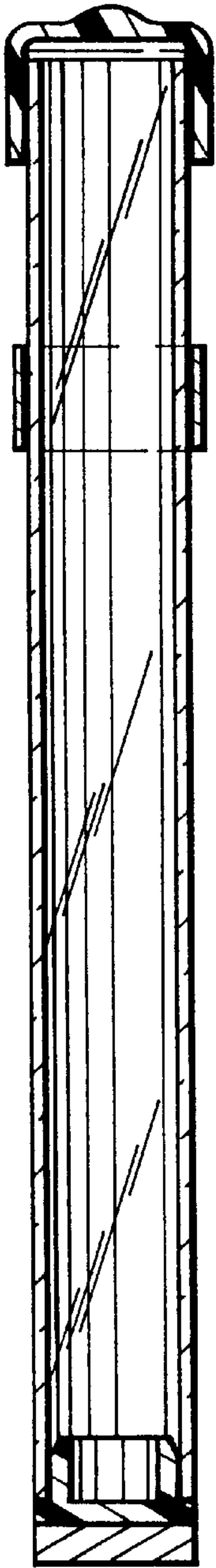

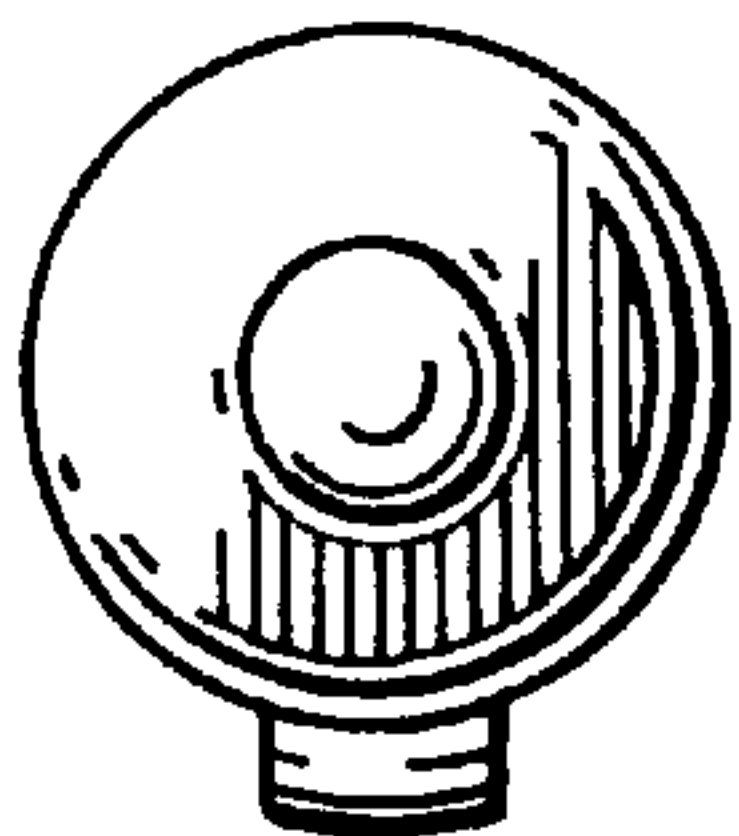

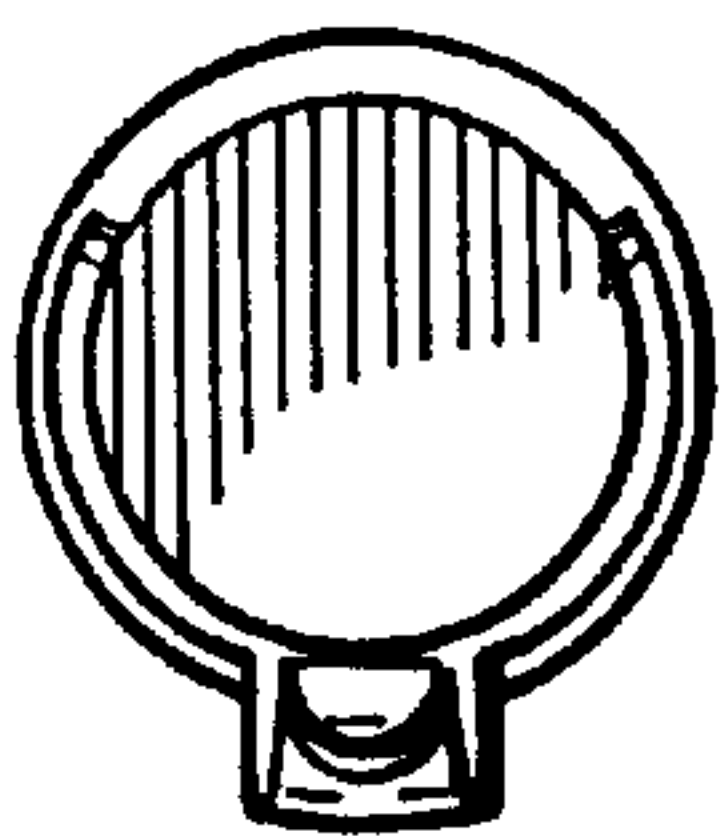

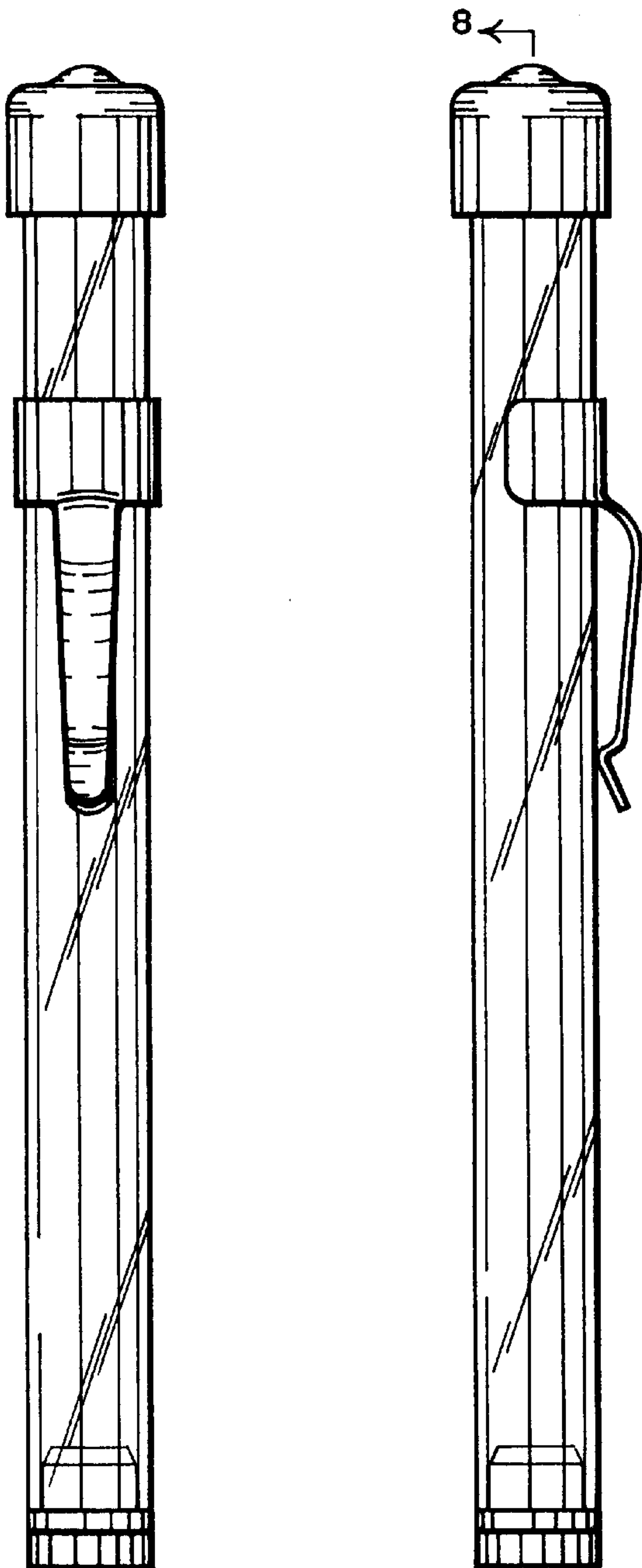

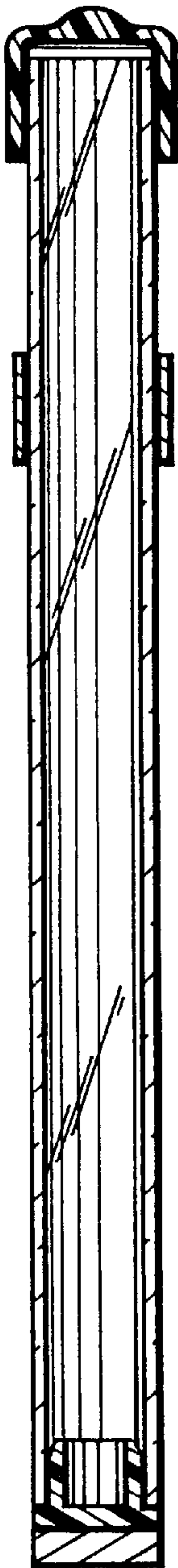

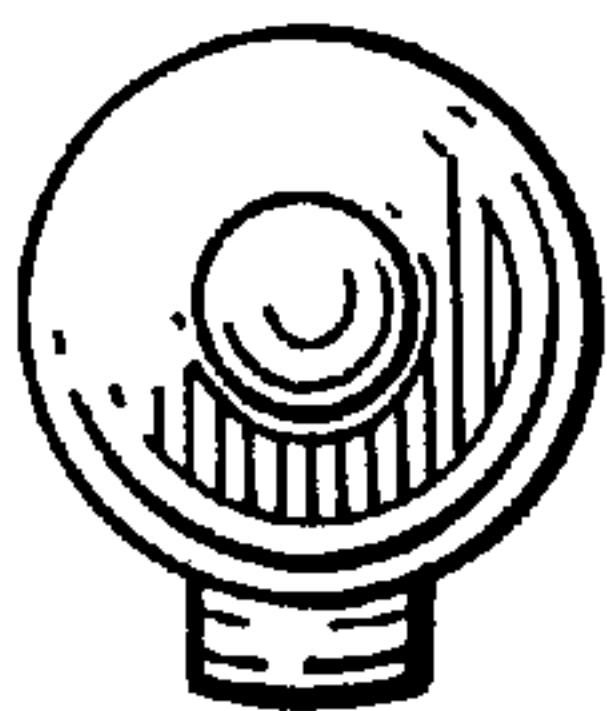

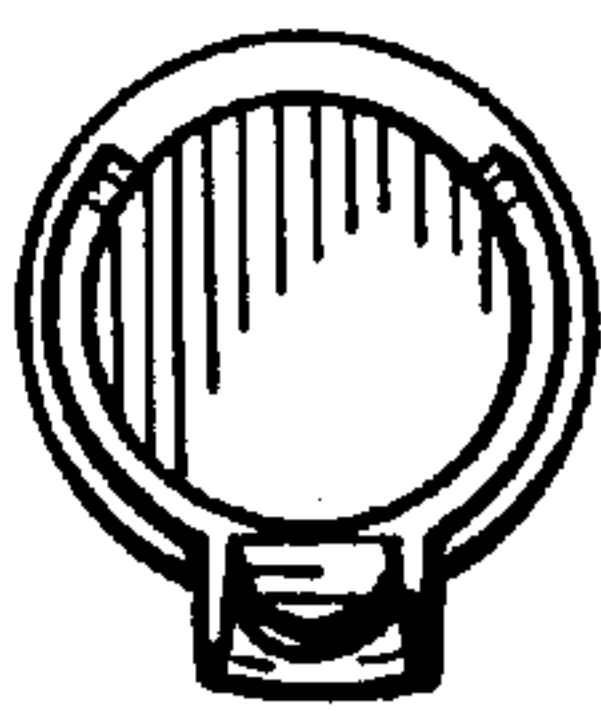
