The ornamental design for a patio chair having fleur-de-lis motif, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a patio chair having fleur-de-lis motif showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. FIGS. 2 through 6 have been shown on an enlarged scale with respect to FIG. 1.

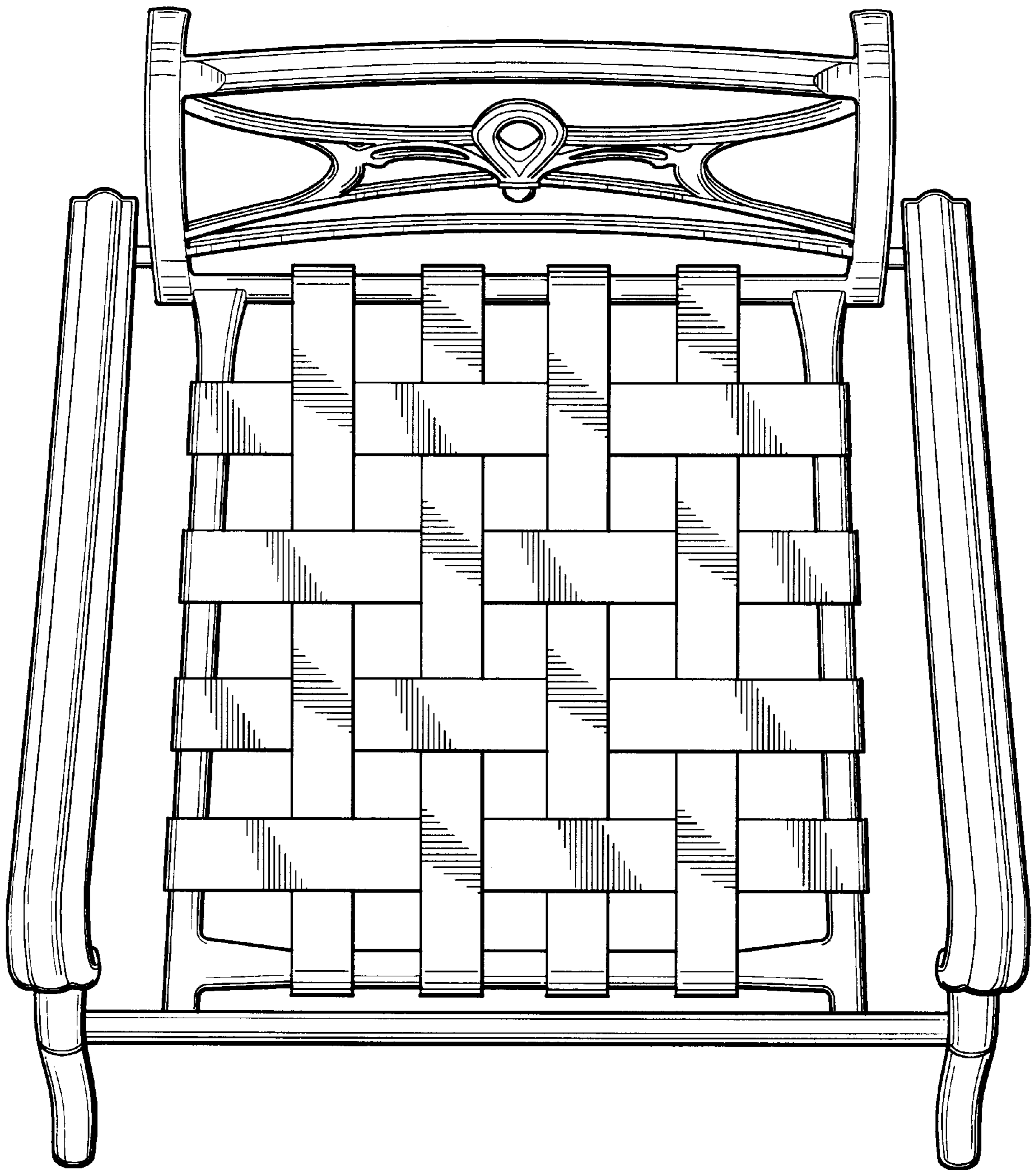

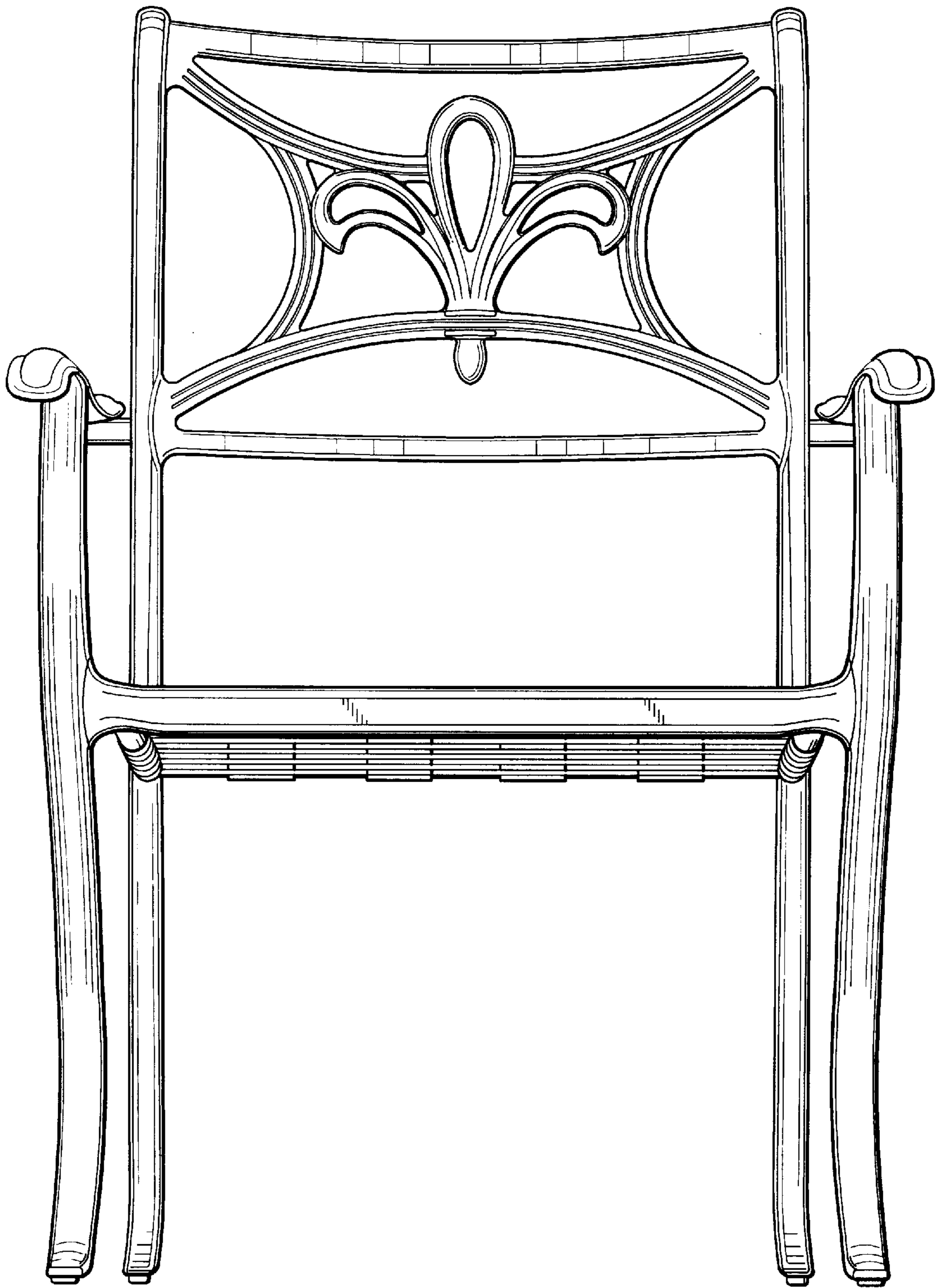

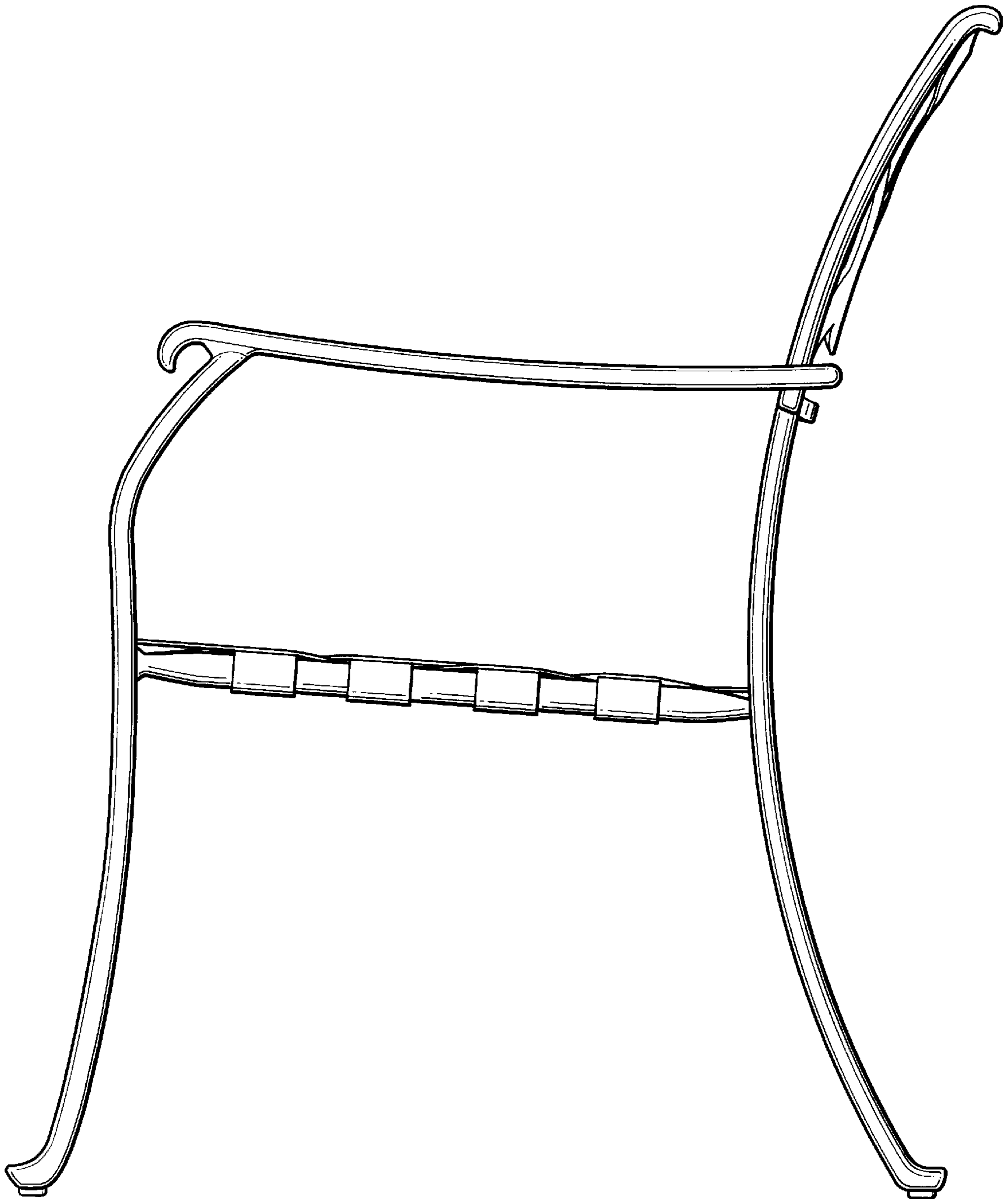

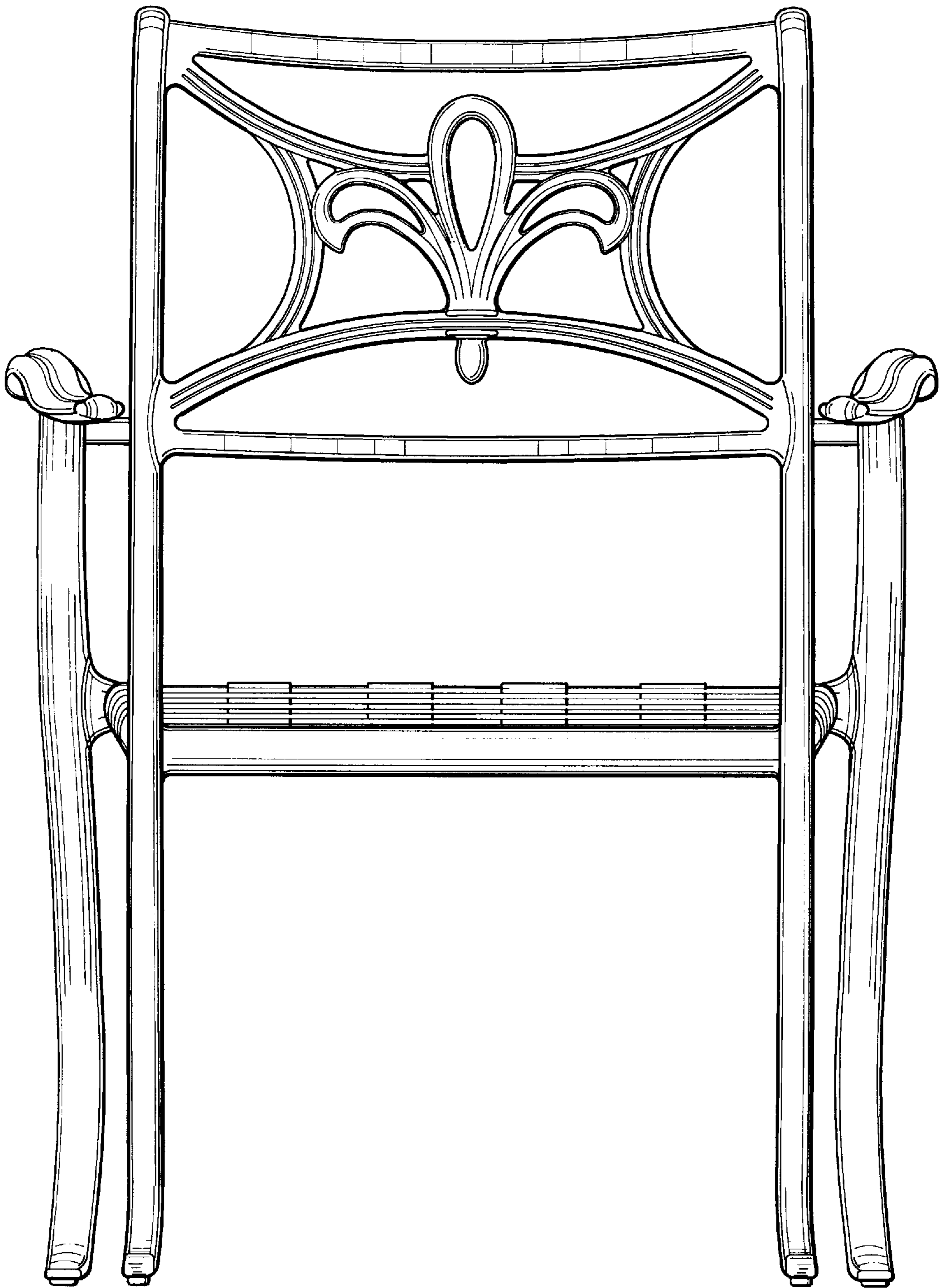

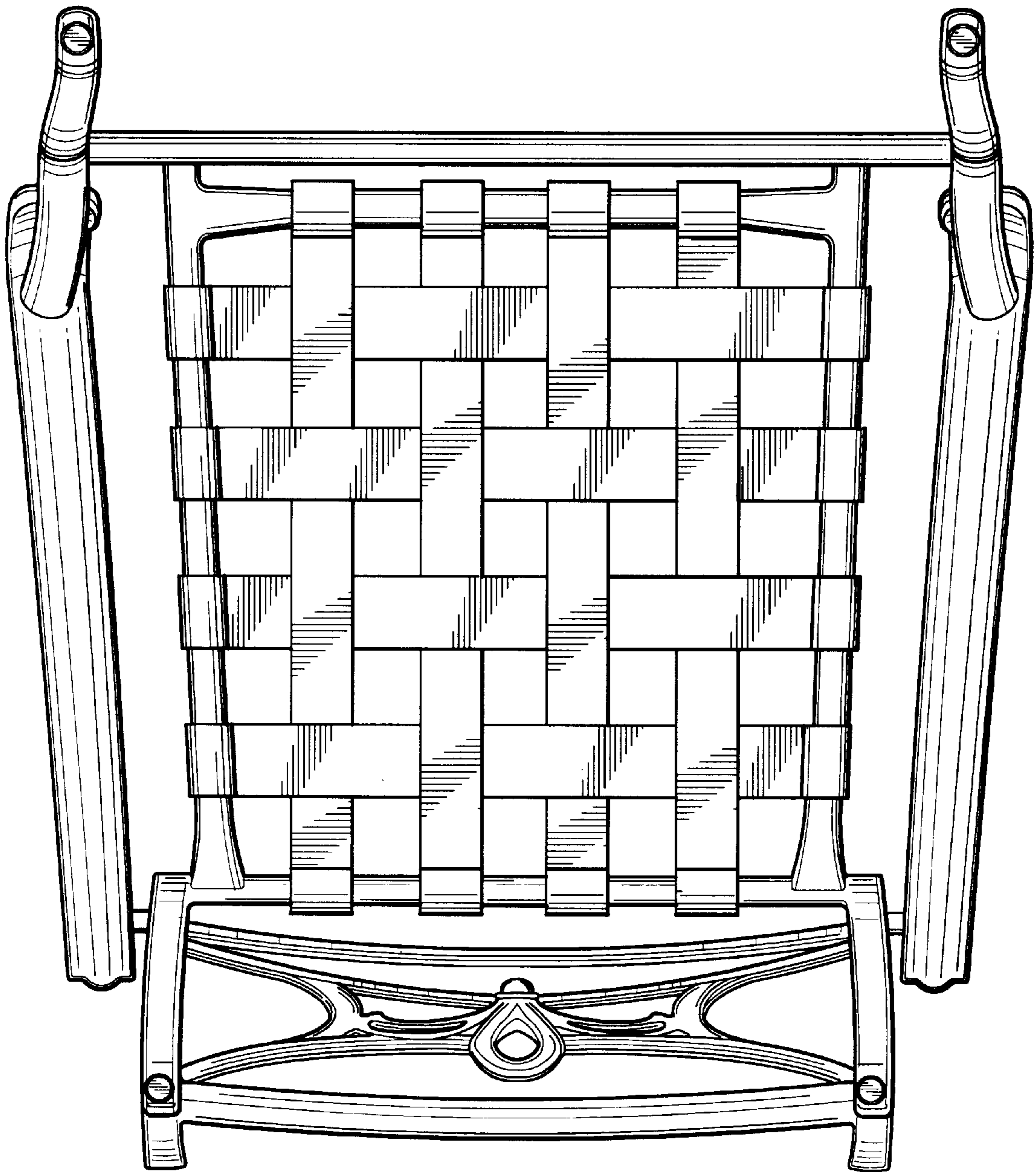
