DESCRIPTION

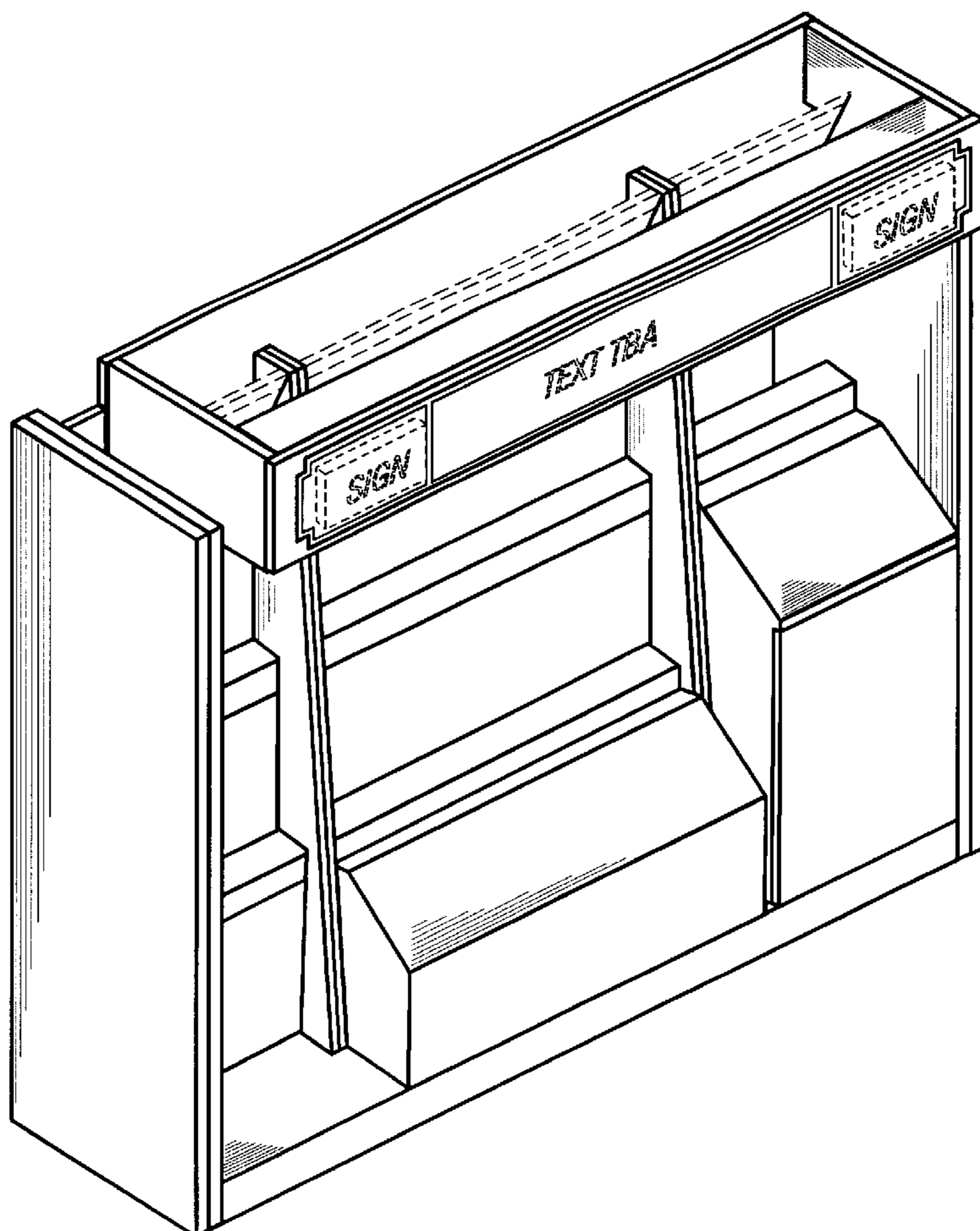
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a death care merchandise display unit from the front, side, and top, the perspective view from the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

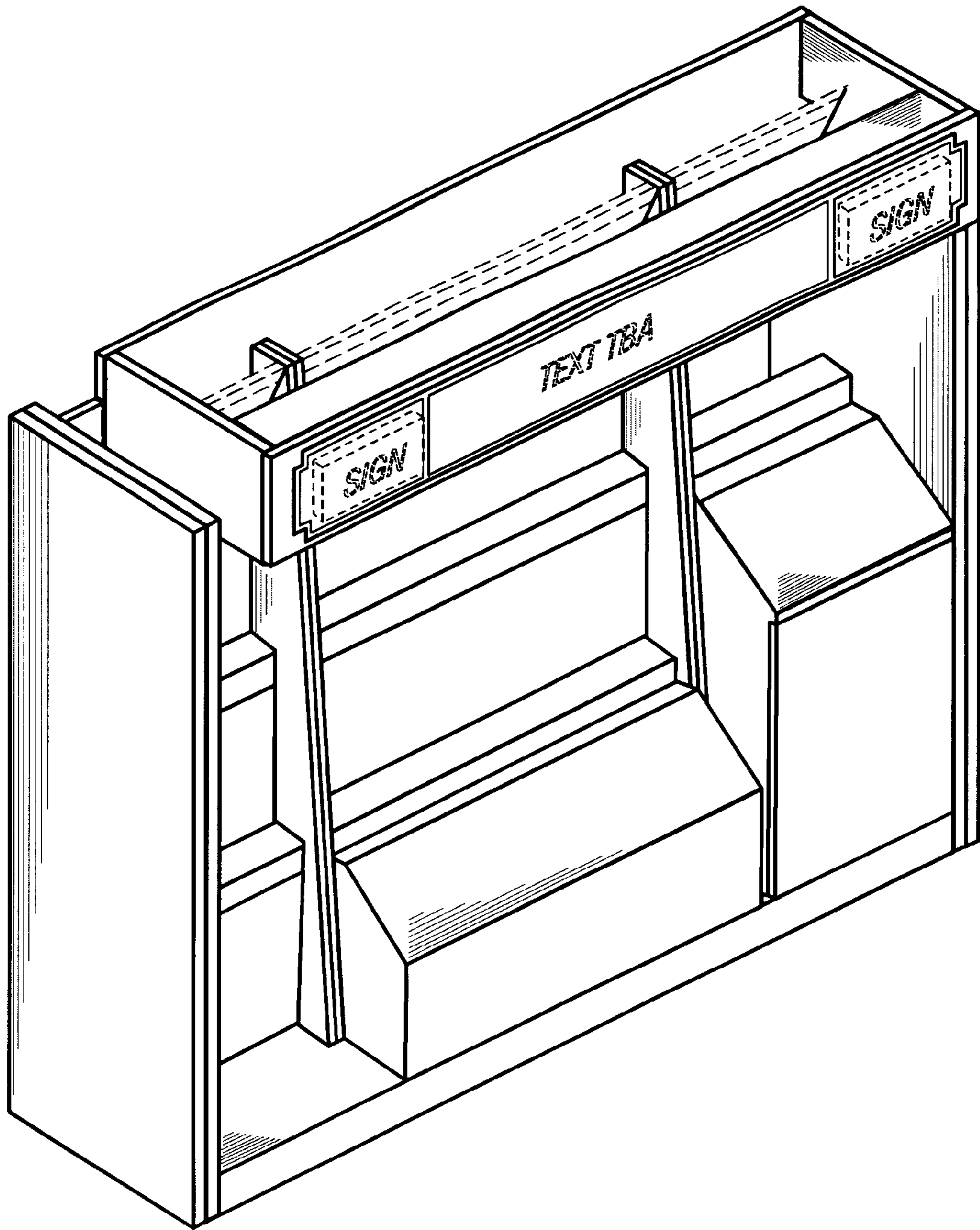

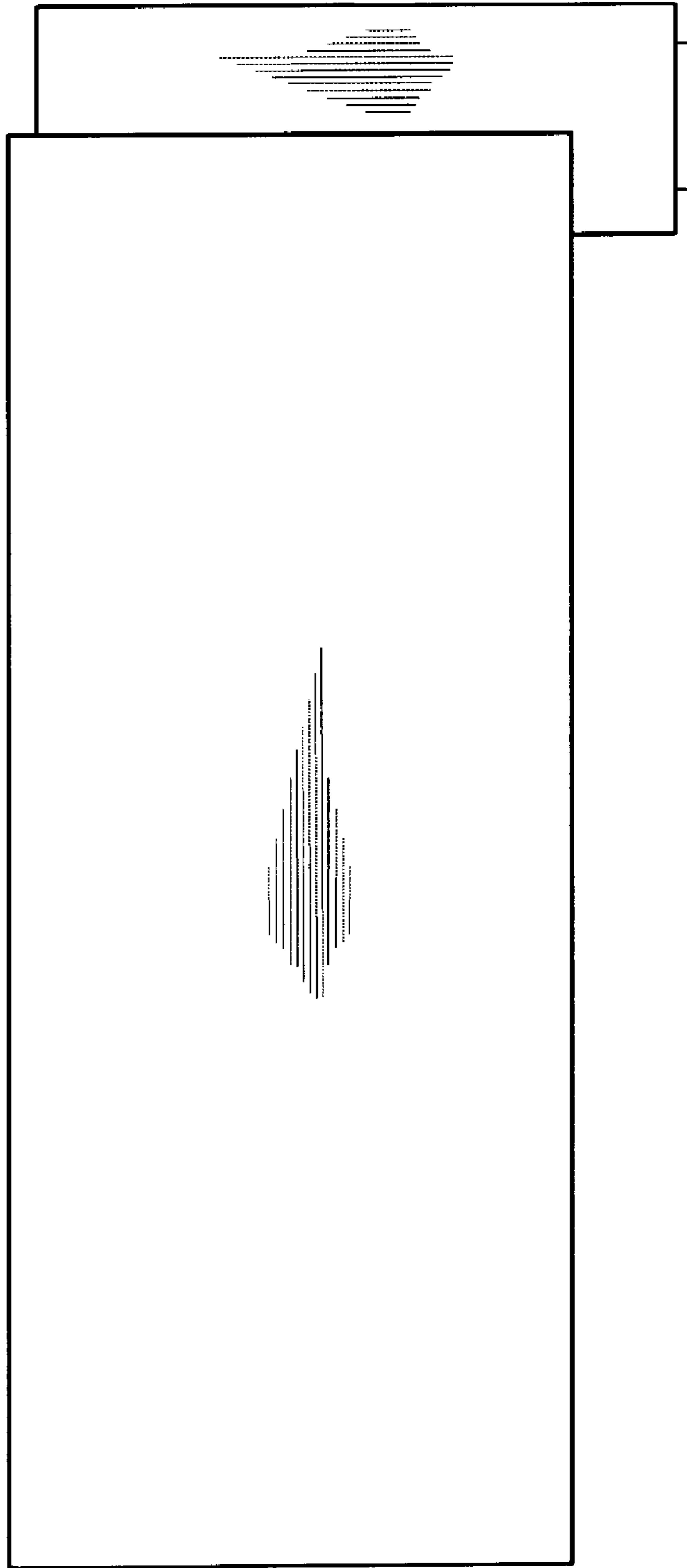
