The ornamental design for a magnetic band for body limbs, as shown and described.

FIG. 12 is a side view of the product with the magnet holders removed, shown along the short edge with the top side to the left.

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of the product, with the magnet holders removed; and,

FIG. 14 is a side view of the product, with the magnet holders removed, shown with the bottom side up.

The series of dash lines on the surface of the product as show in FIGS. 2-4, 6, 10 and 13 represent top stitching.

The broken line showing of the limbs is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

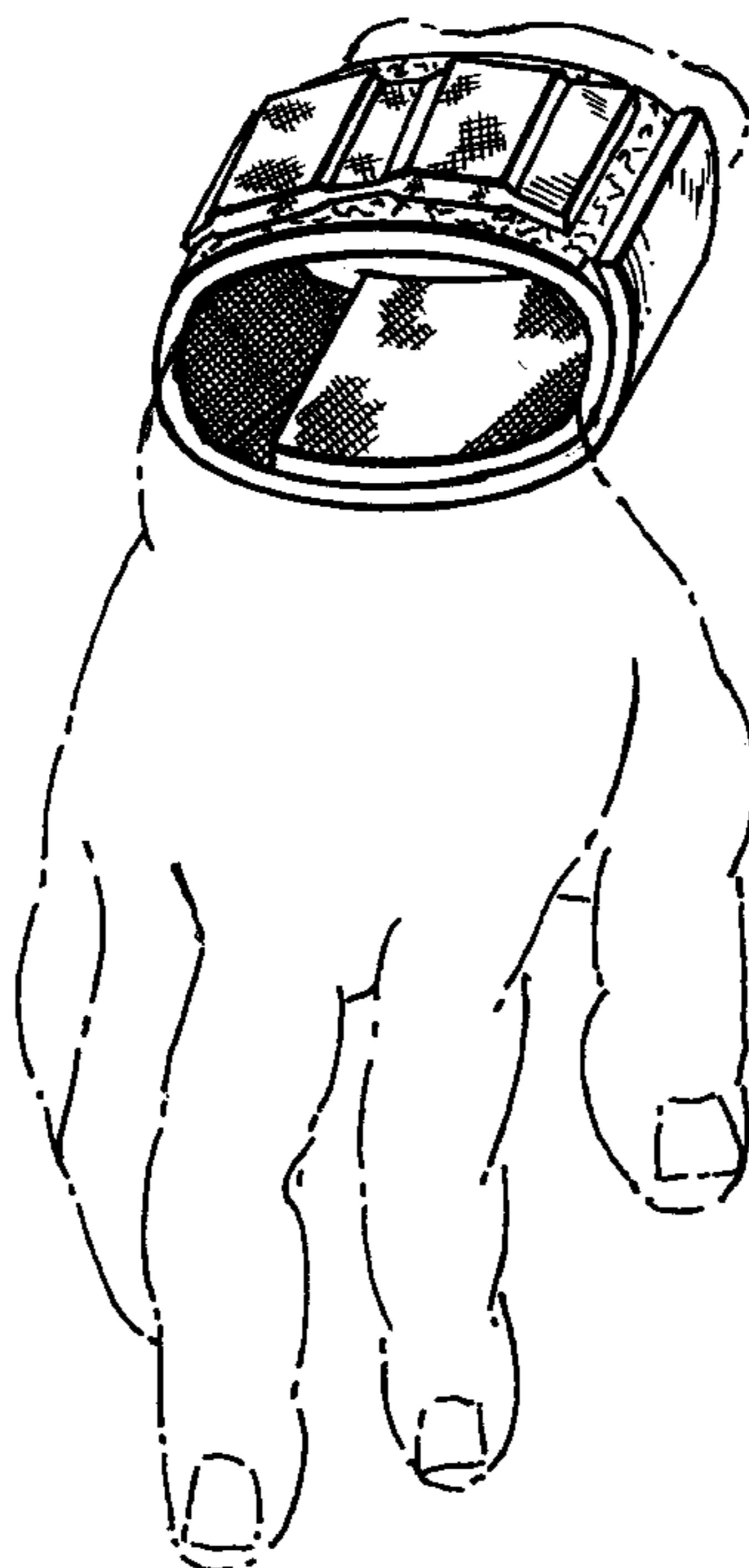

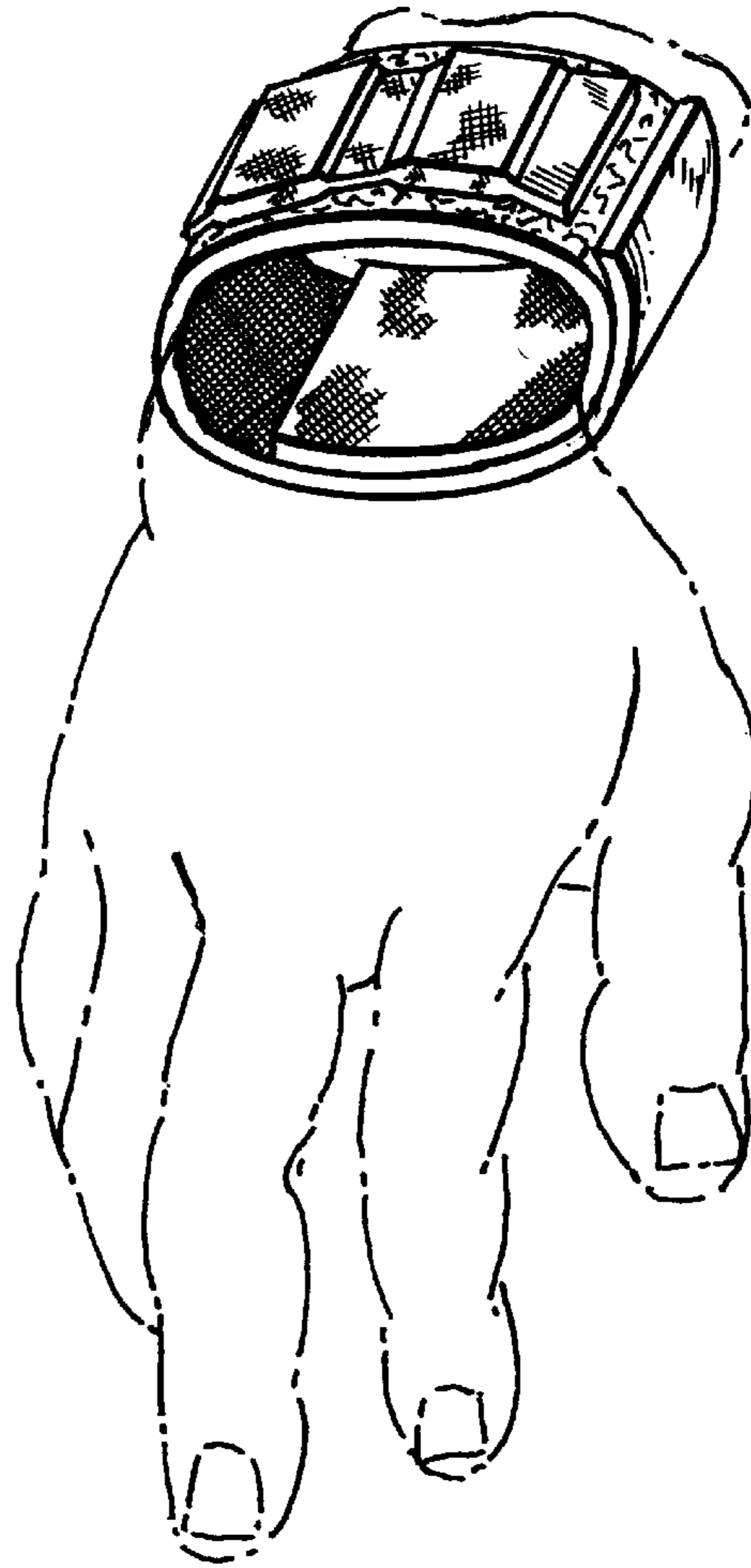
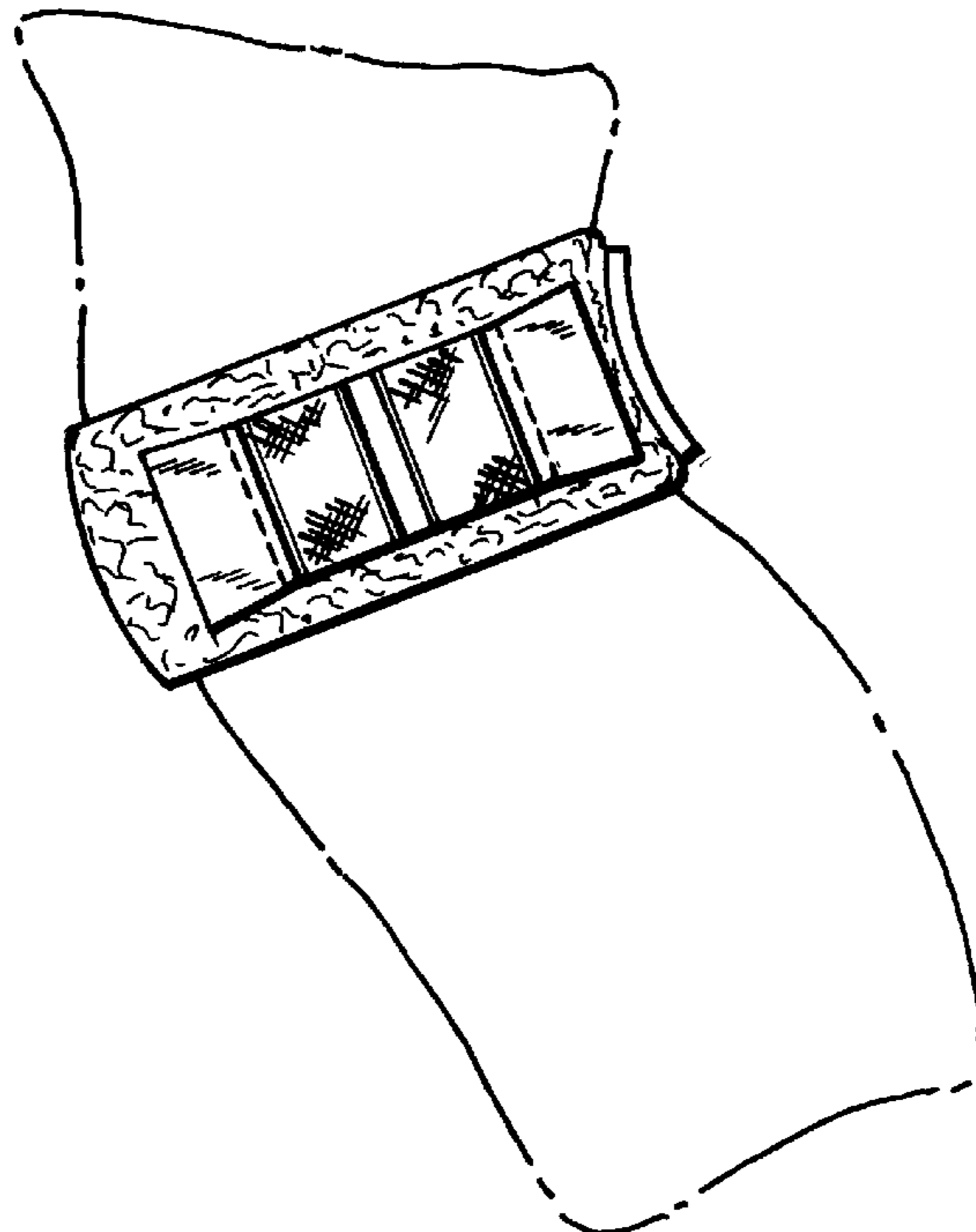

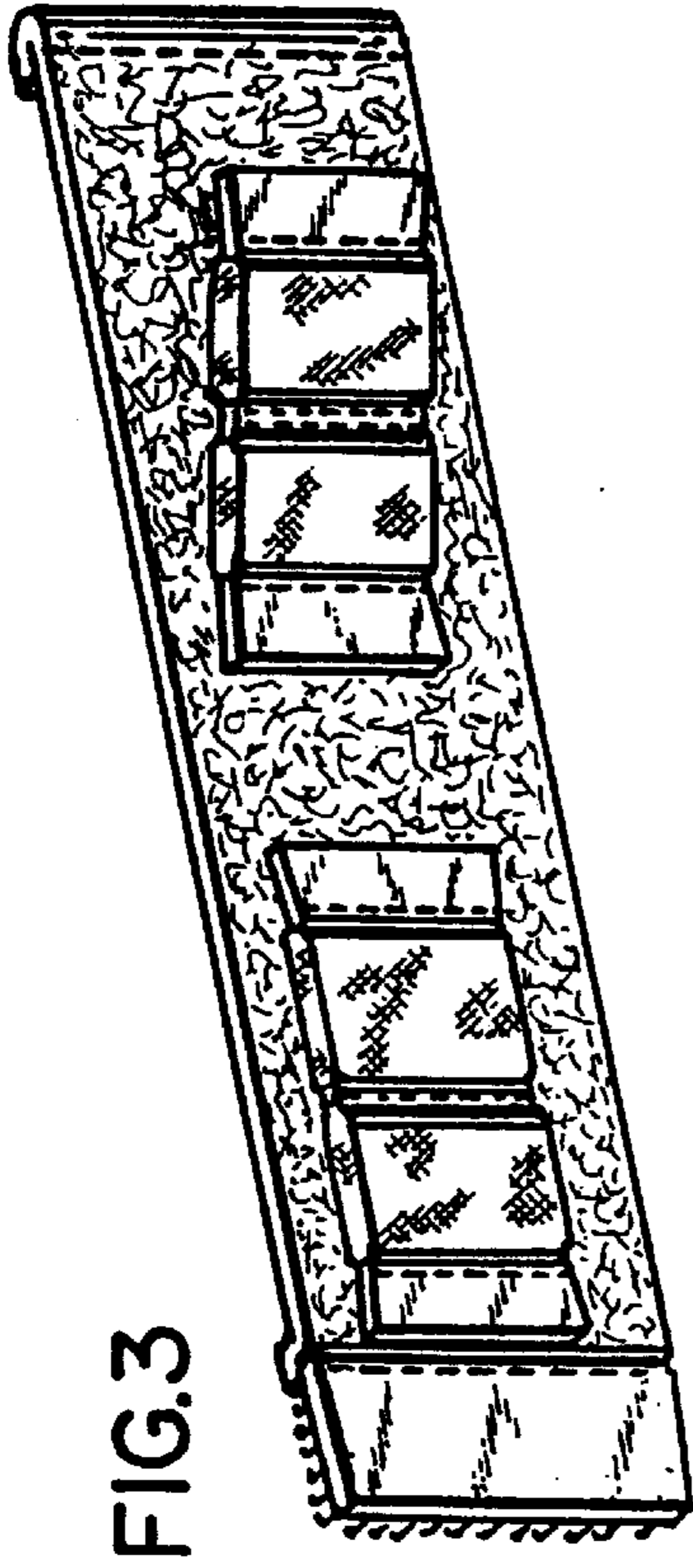

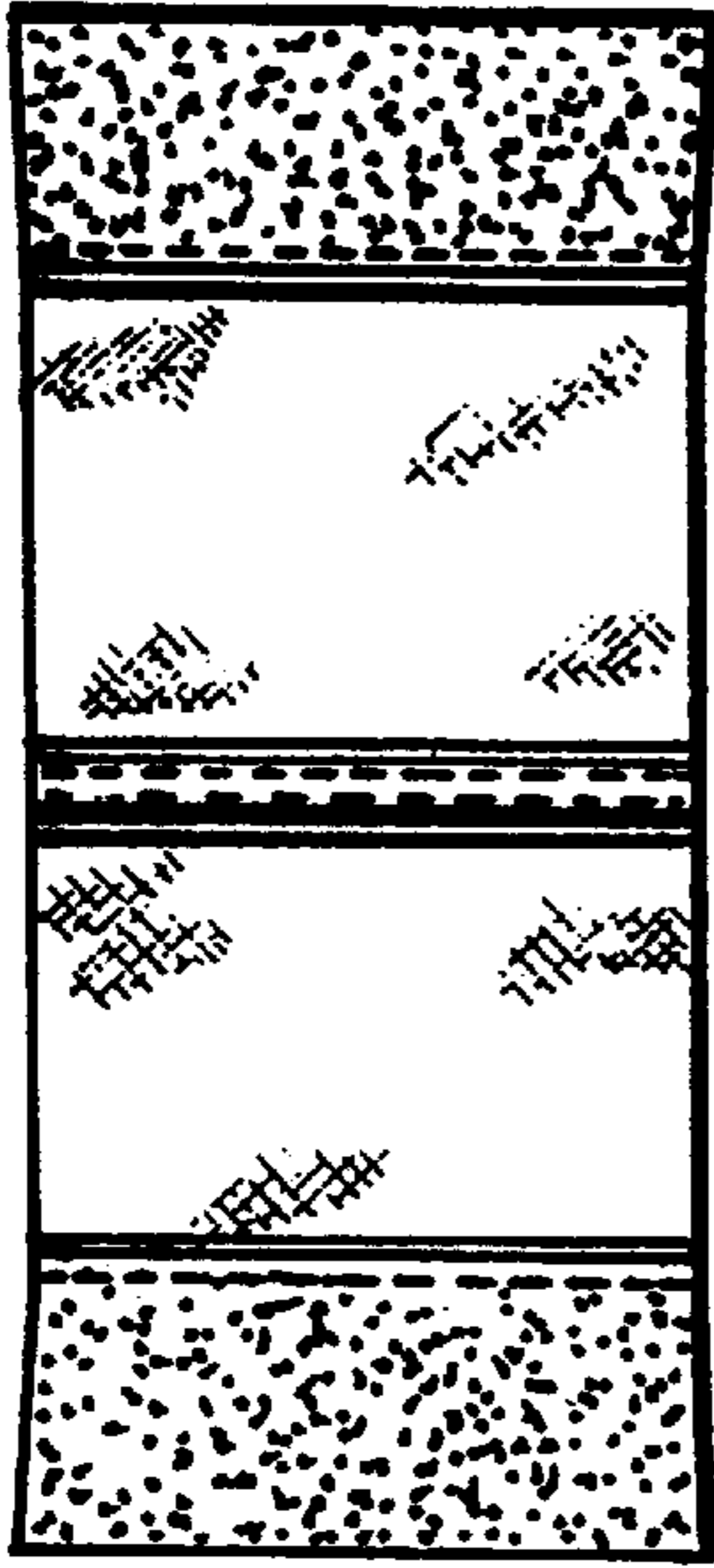

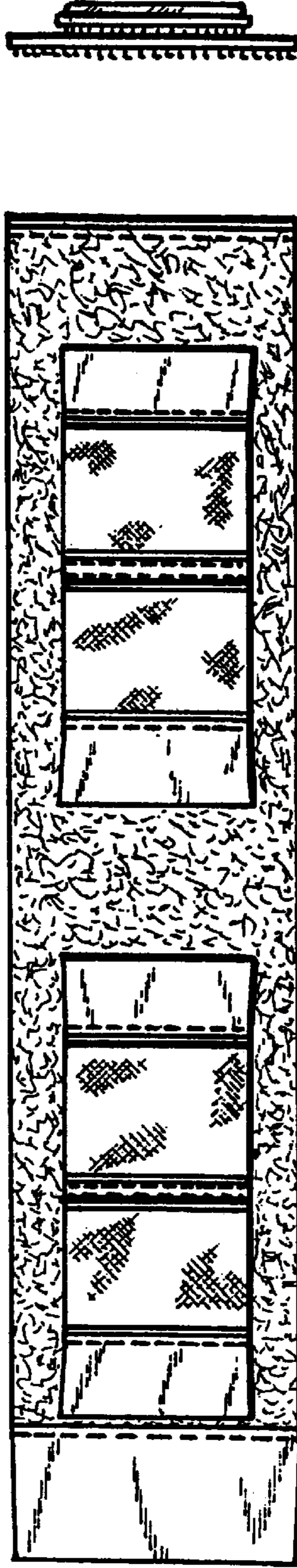

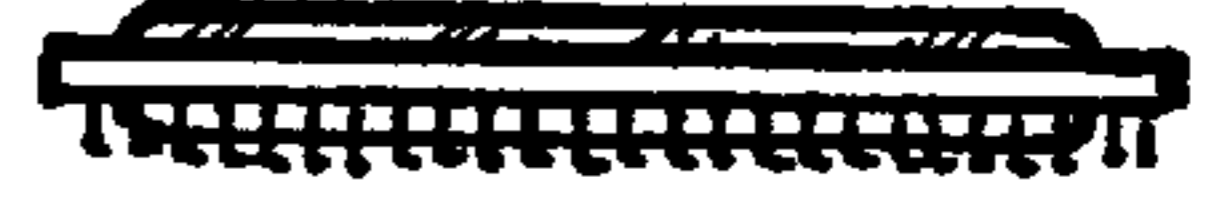

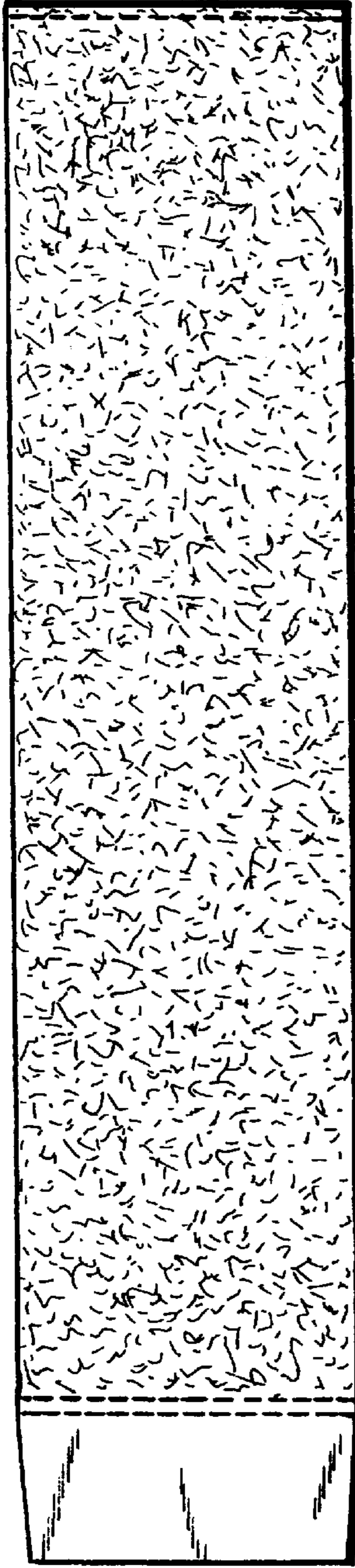

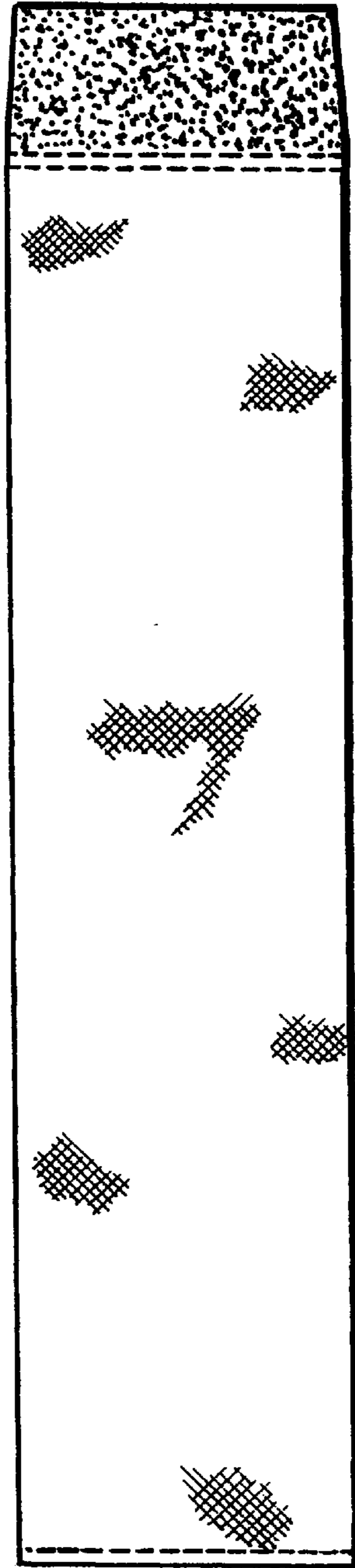
