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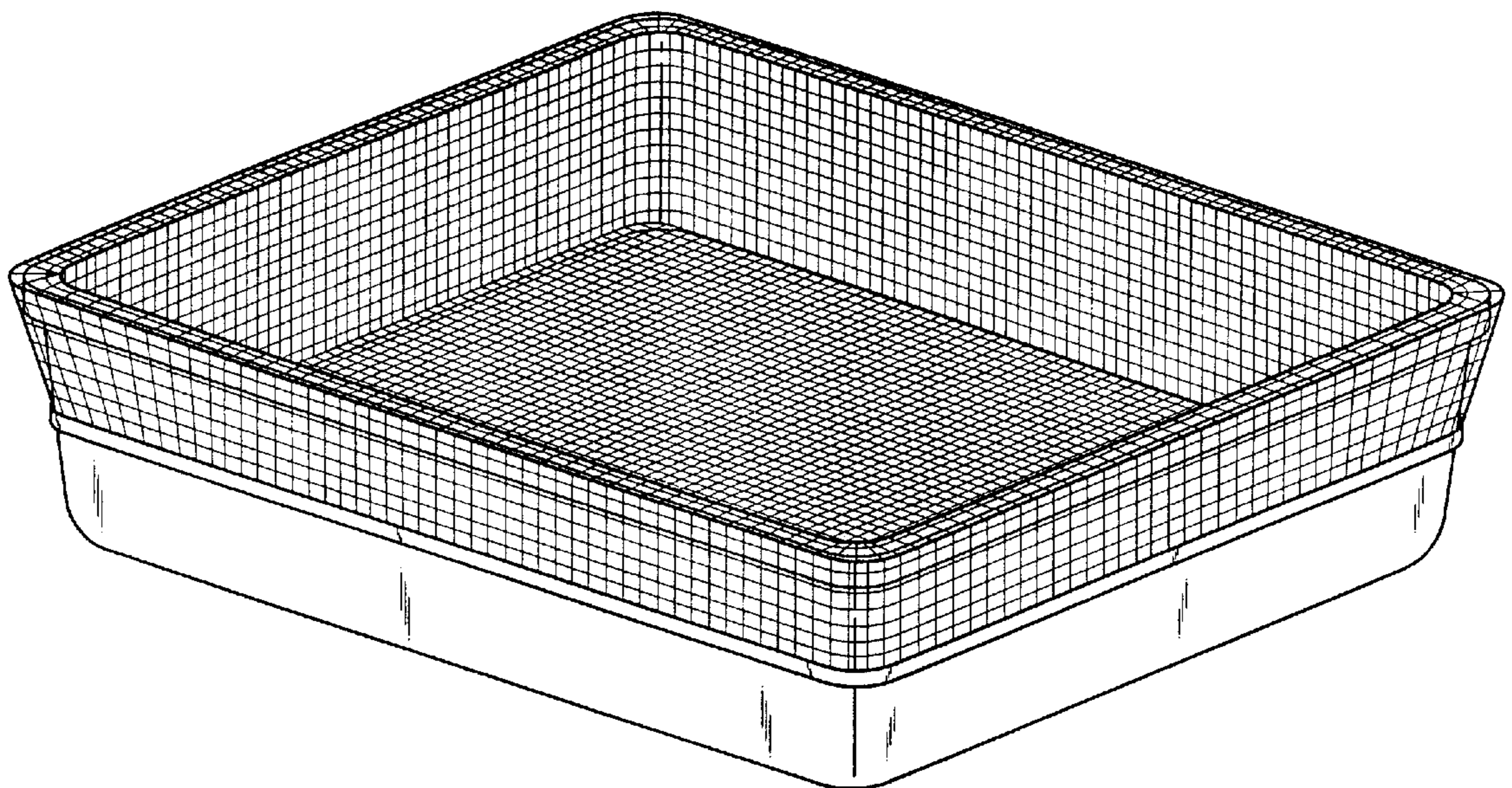

The ornamental design for a combined animal litter box and screen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined animal litter box and screen;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image of the front view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side view.

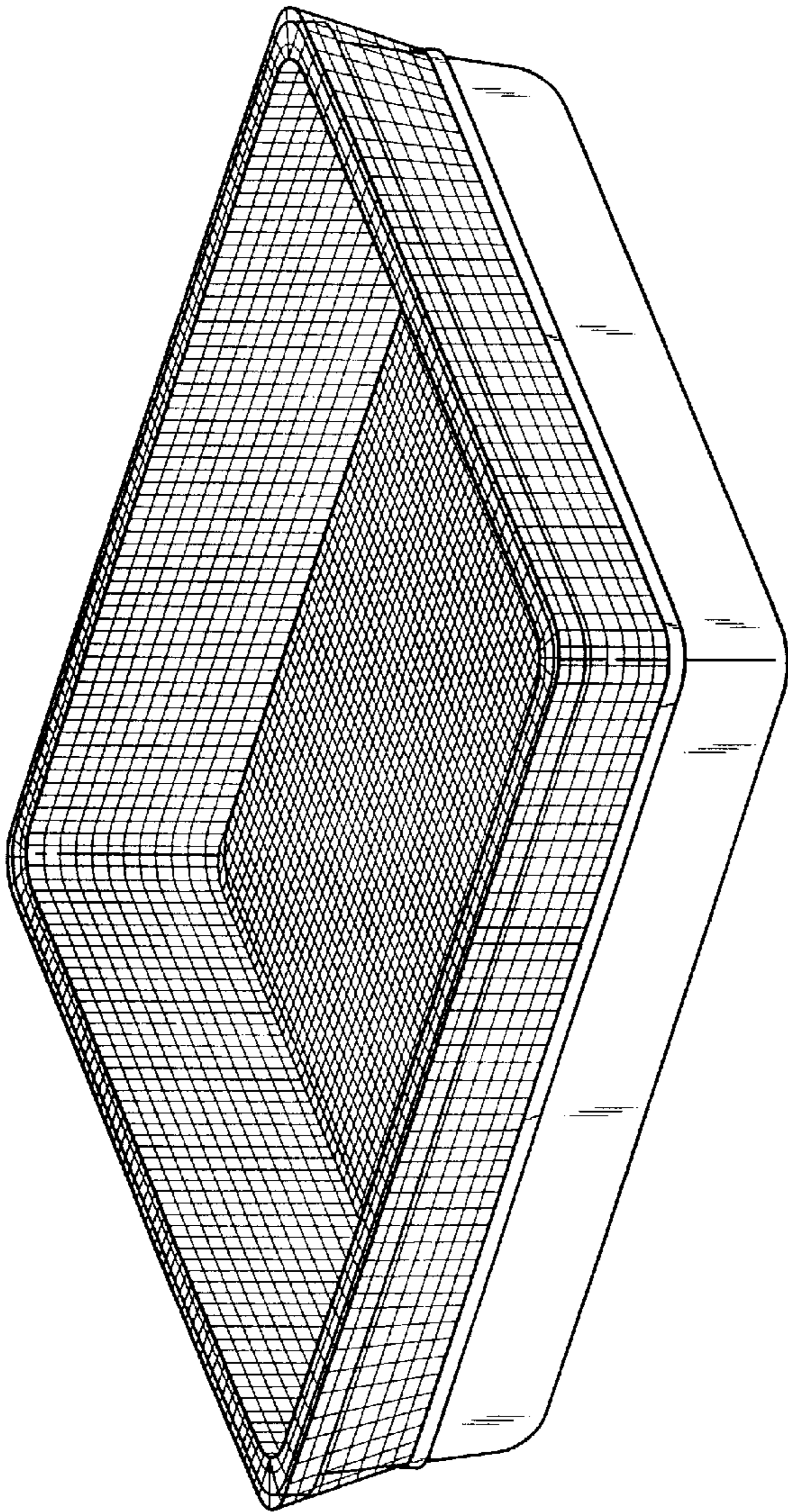

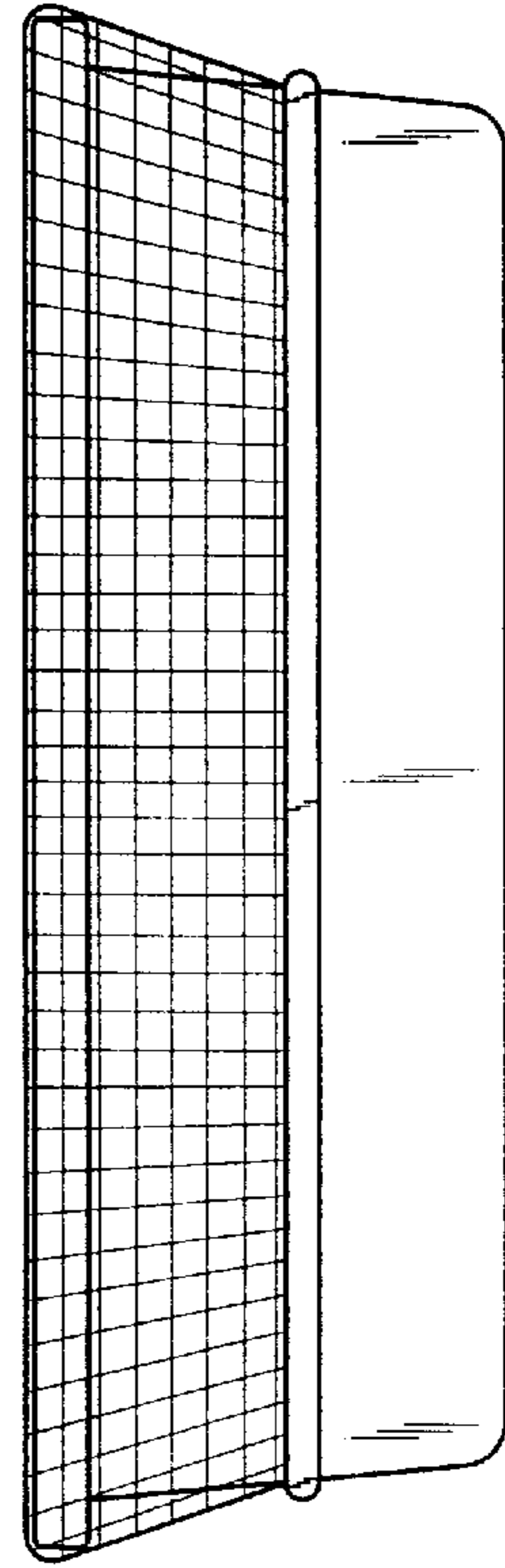

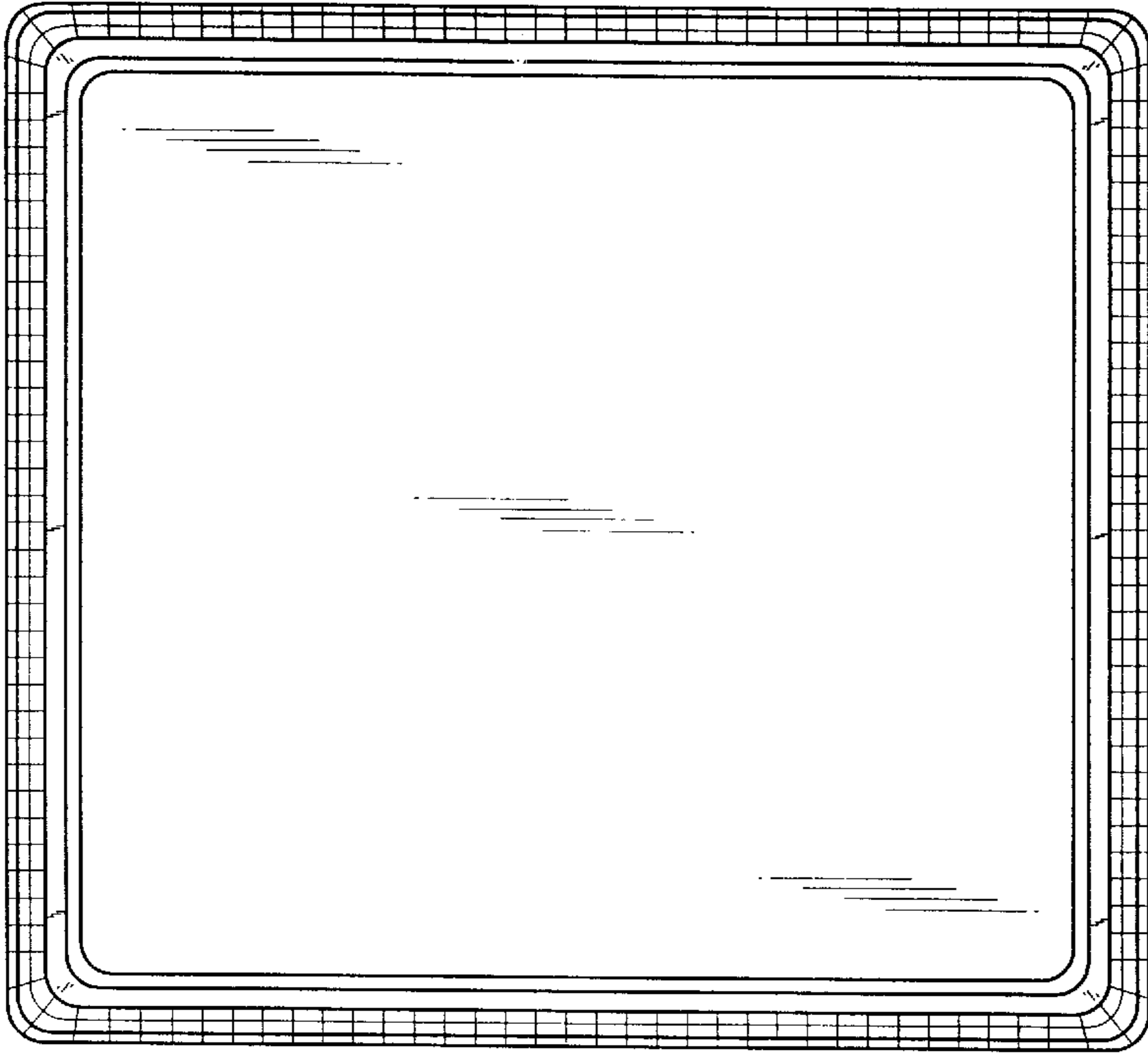

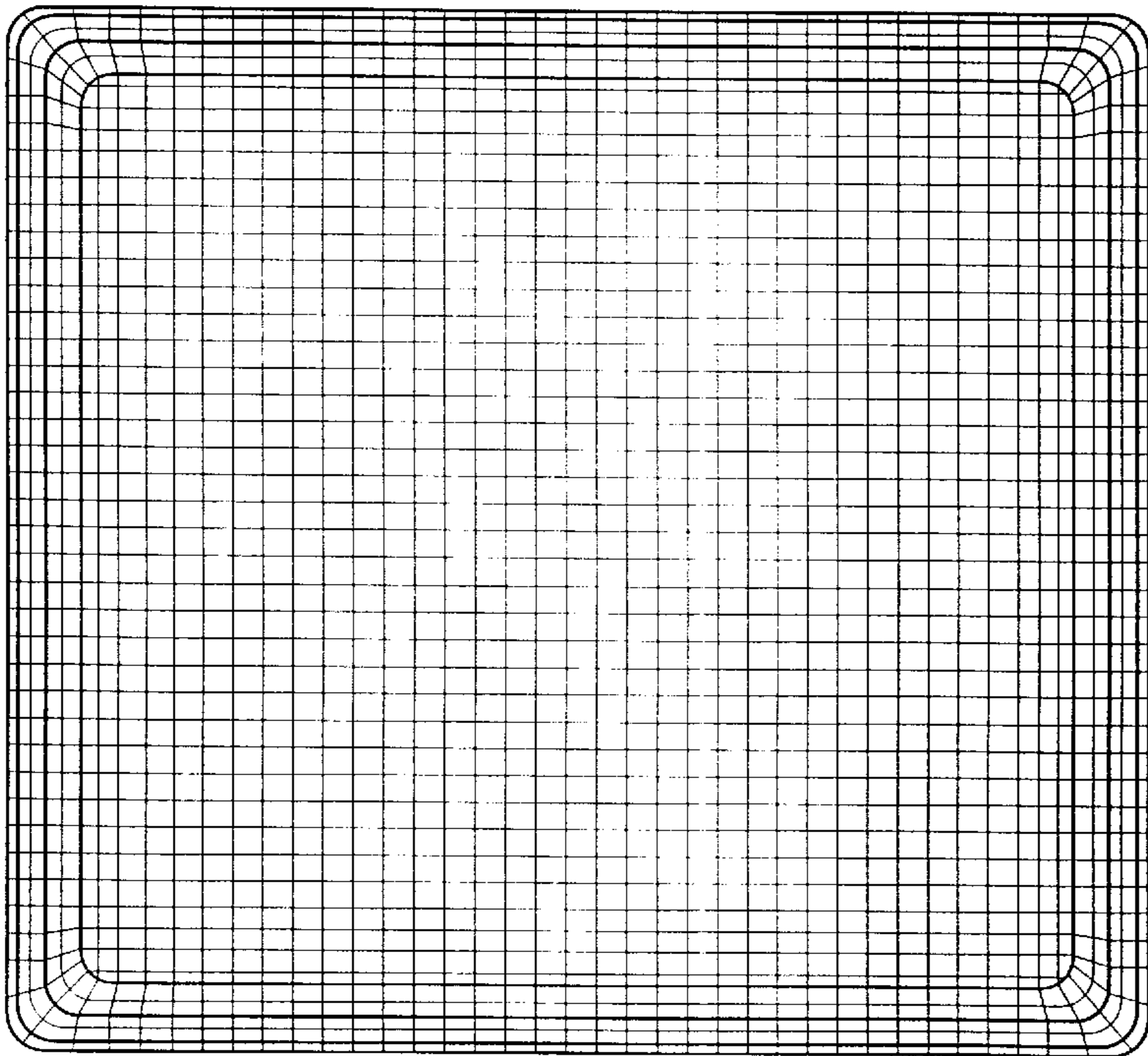

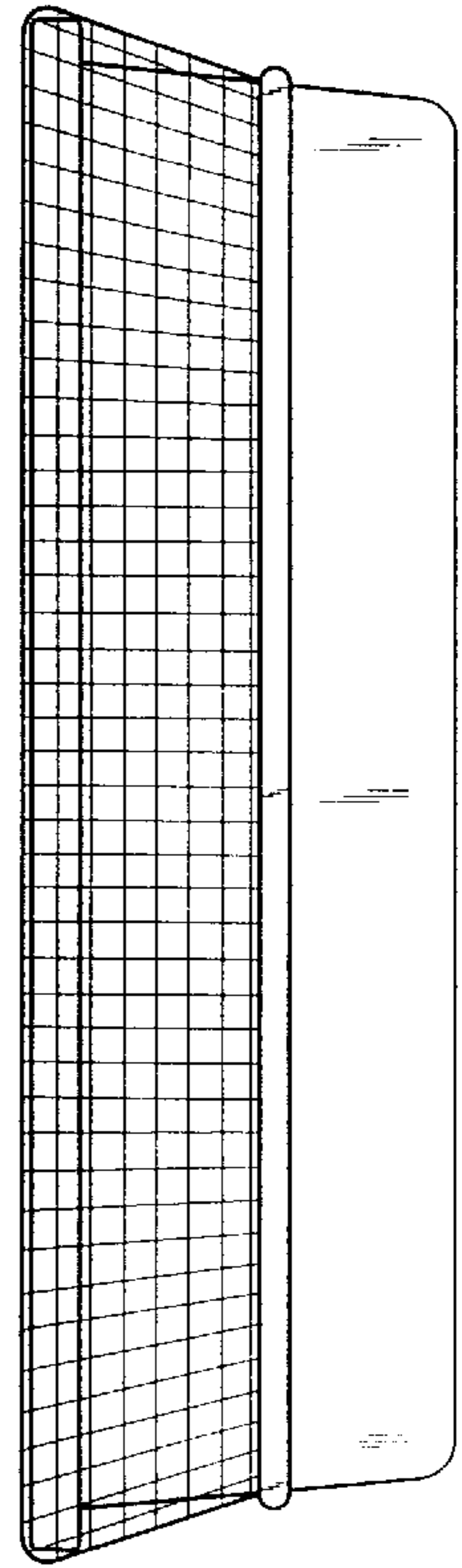
