The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the left side of
FIG. 1, the opposite side of the chair being a mirror image
of the view shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view.
FIG. 4 is a back elevational view; and,
FIG. 5 is a top view of the design.
FIGS. 2 through 5 have been shown on an enlarged scale
with respect to FIG. 1.

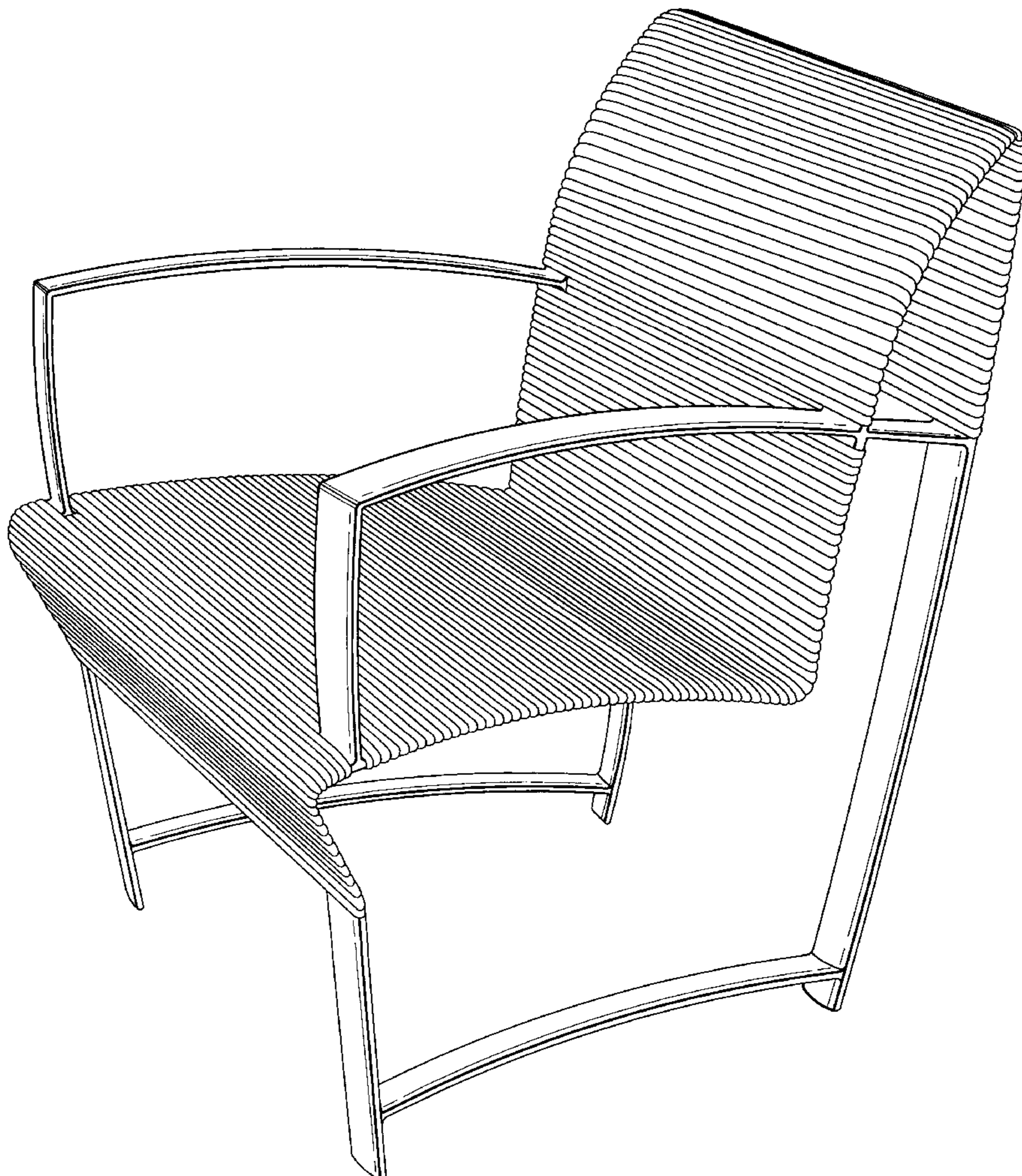

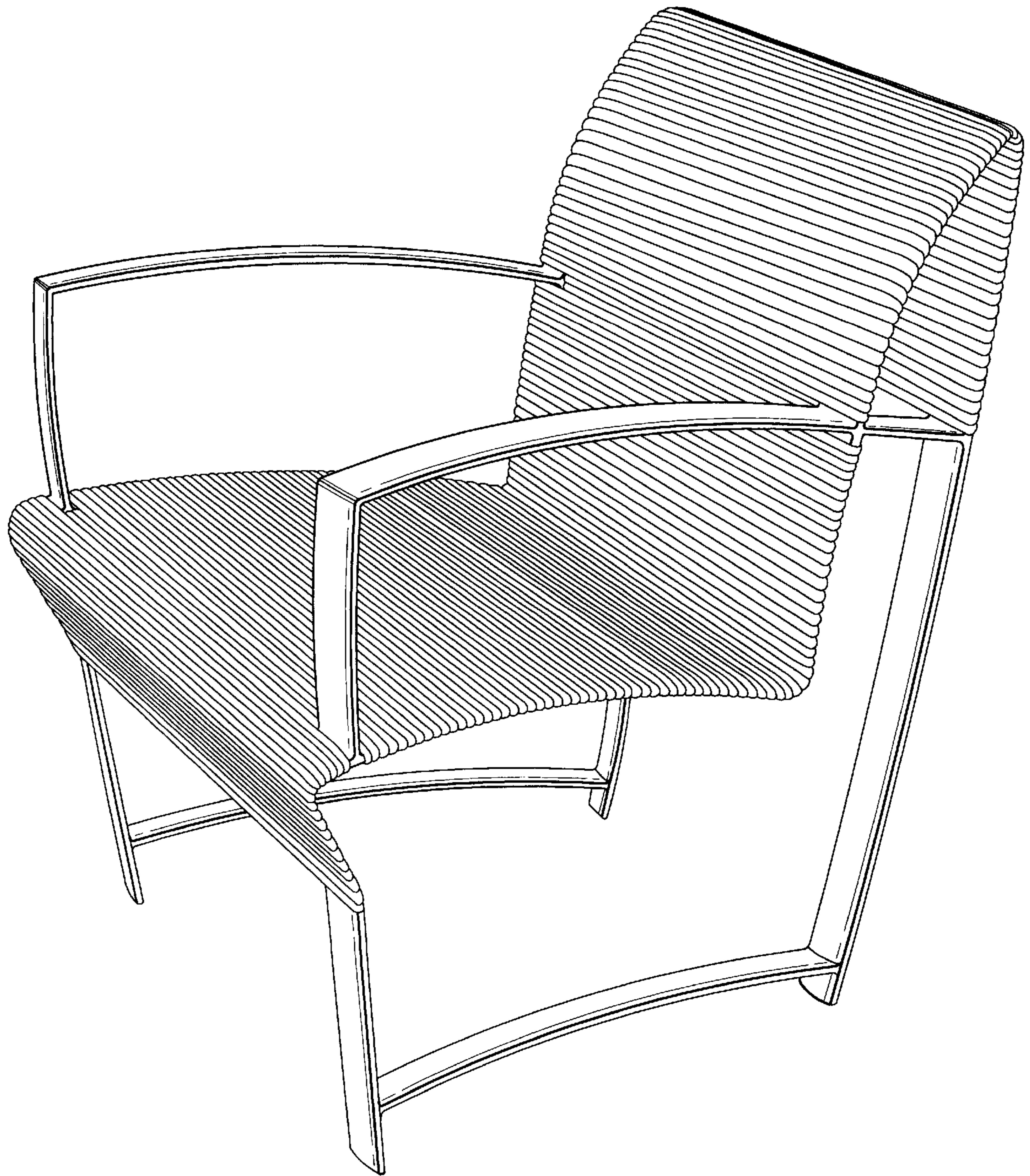

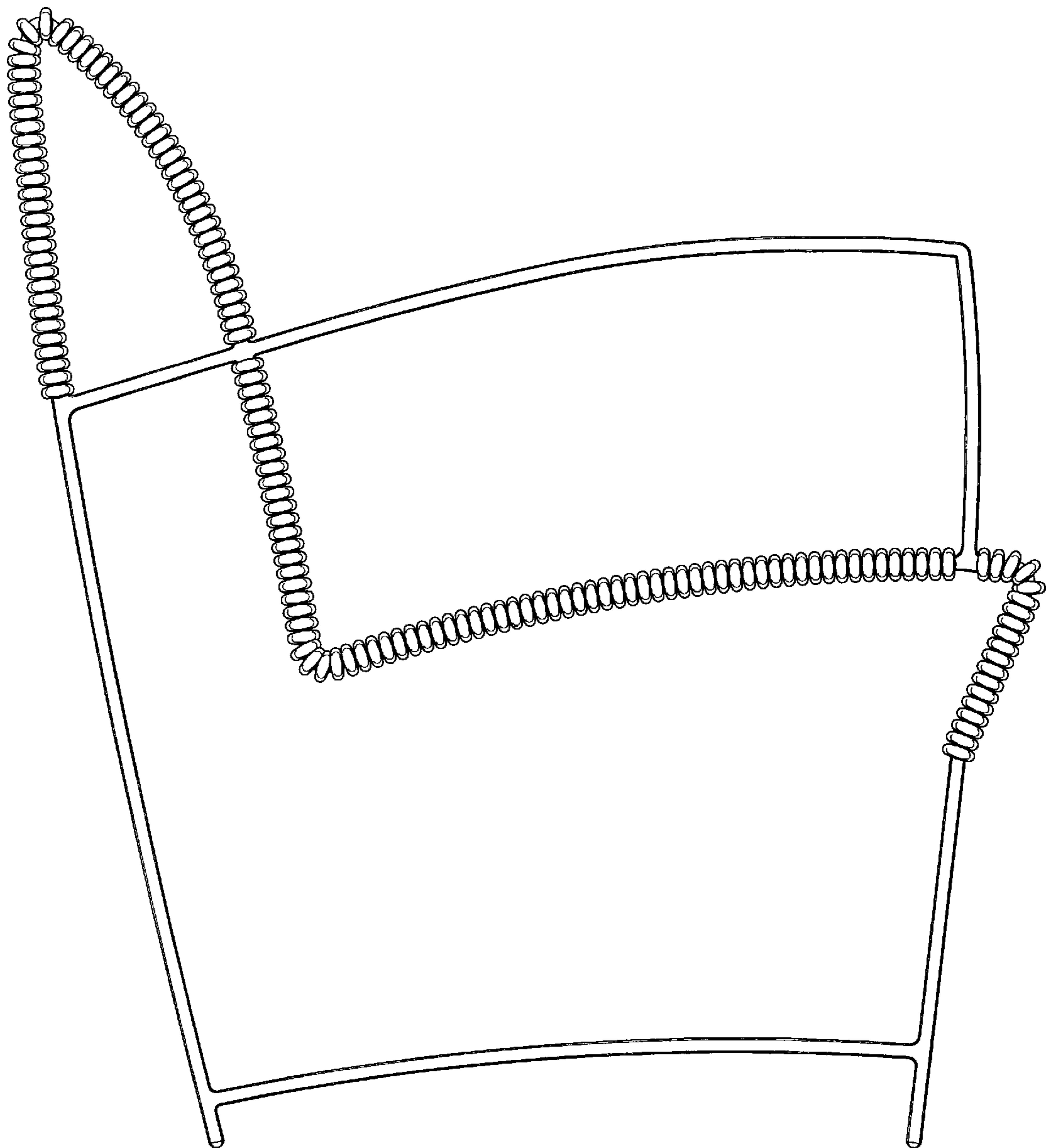

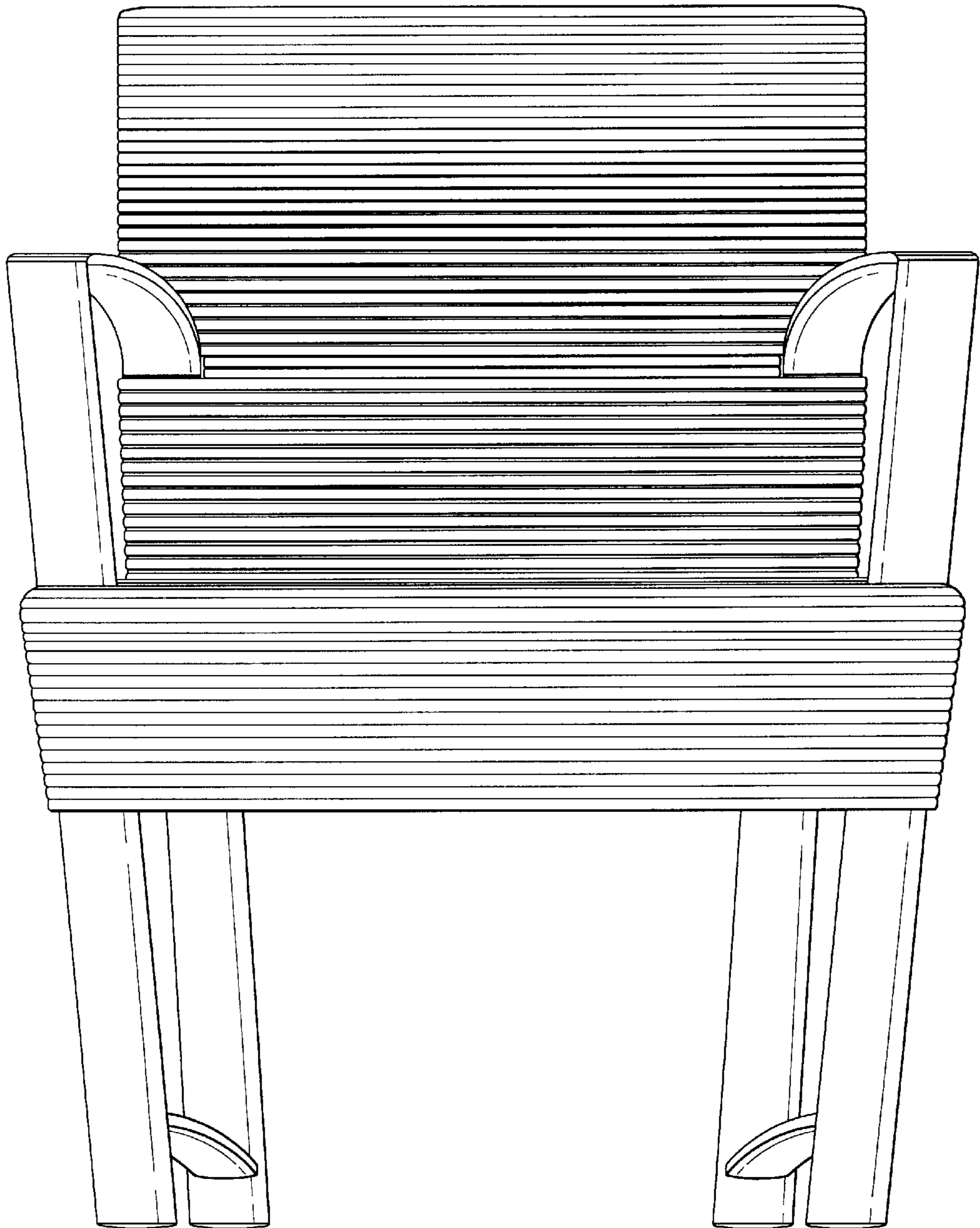

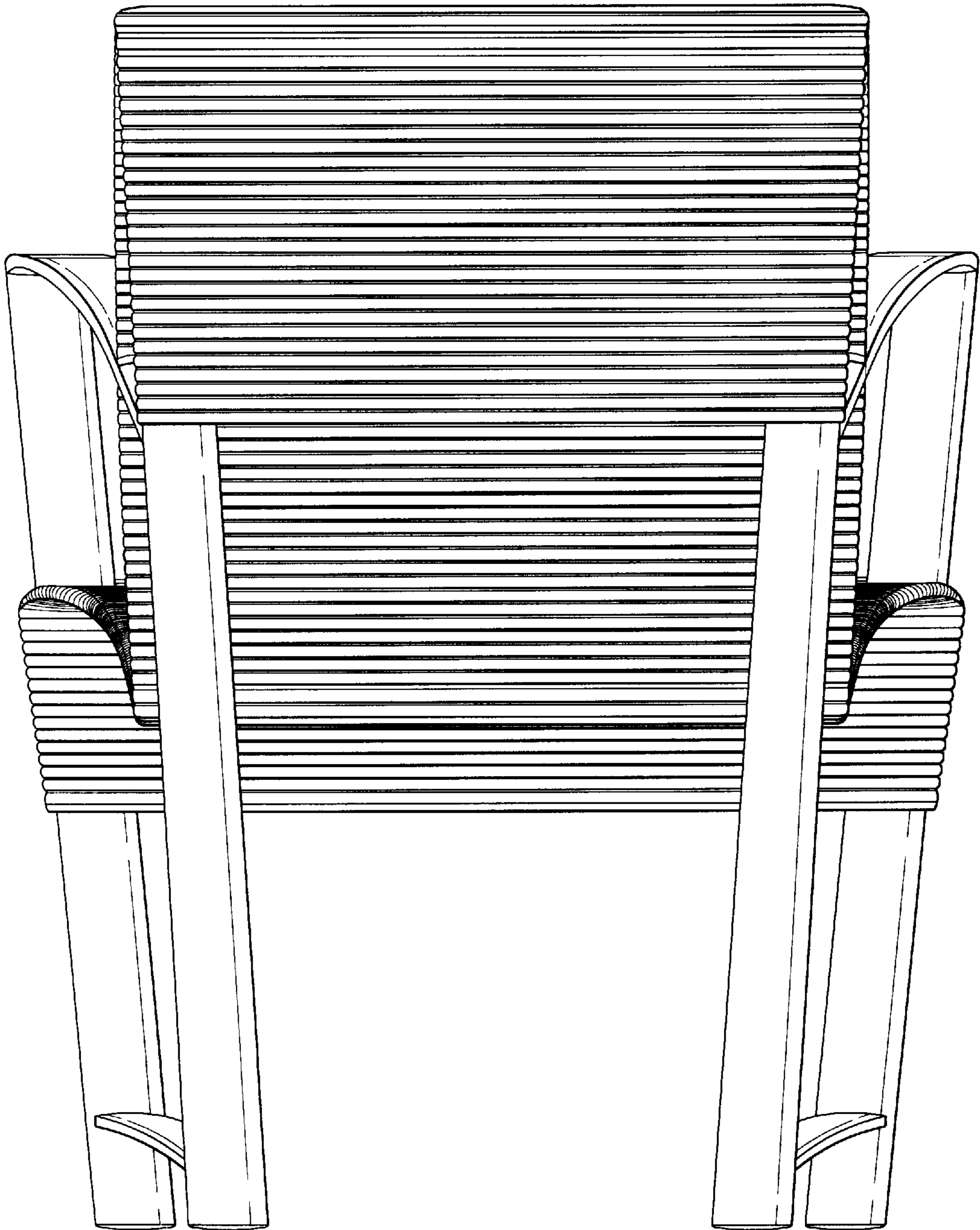
